FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a sofa in accordance with the new design;

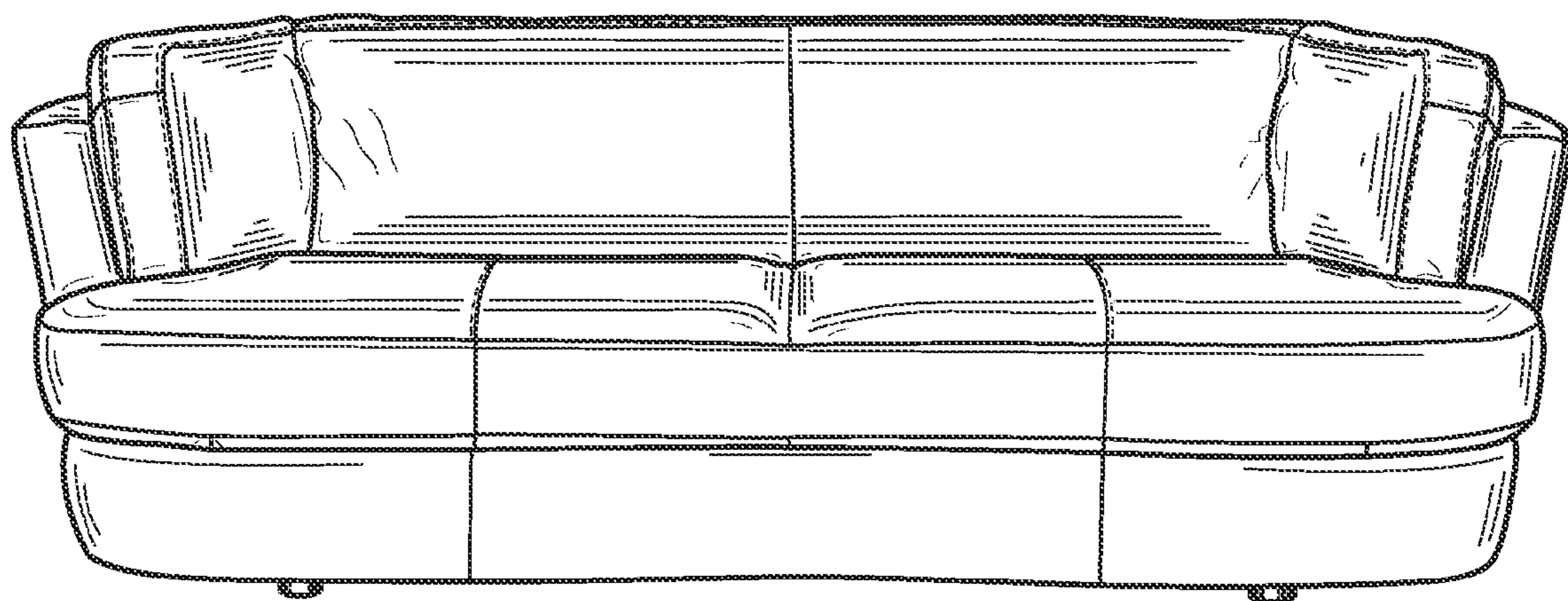
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

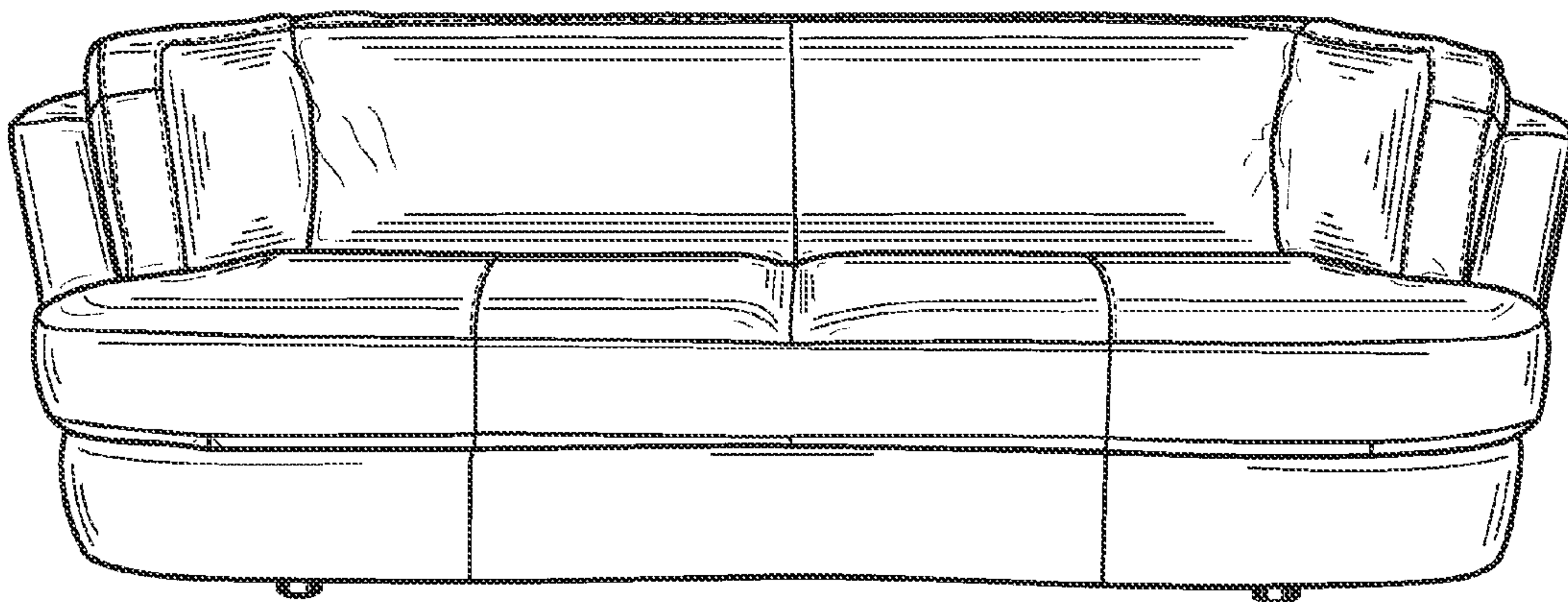

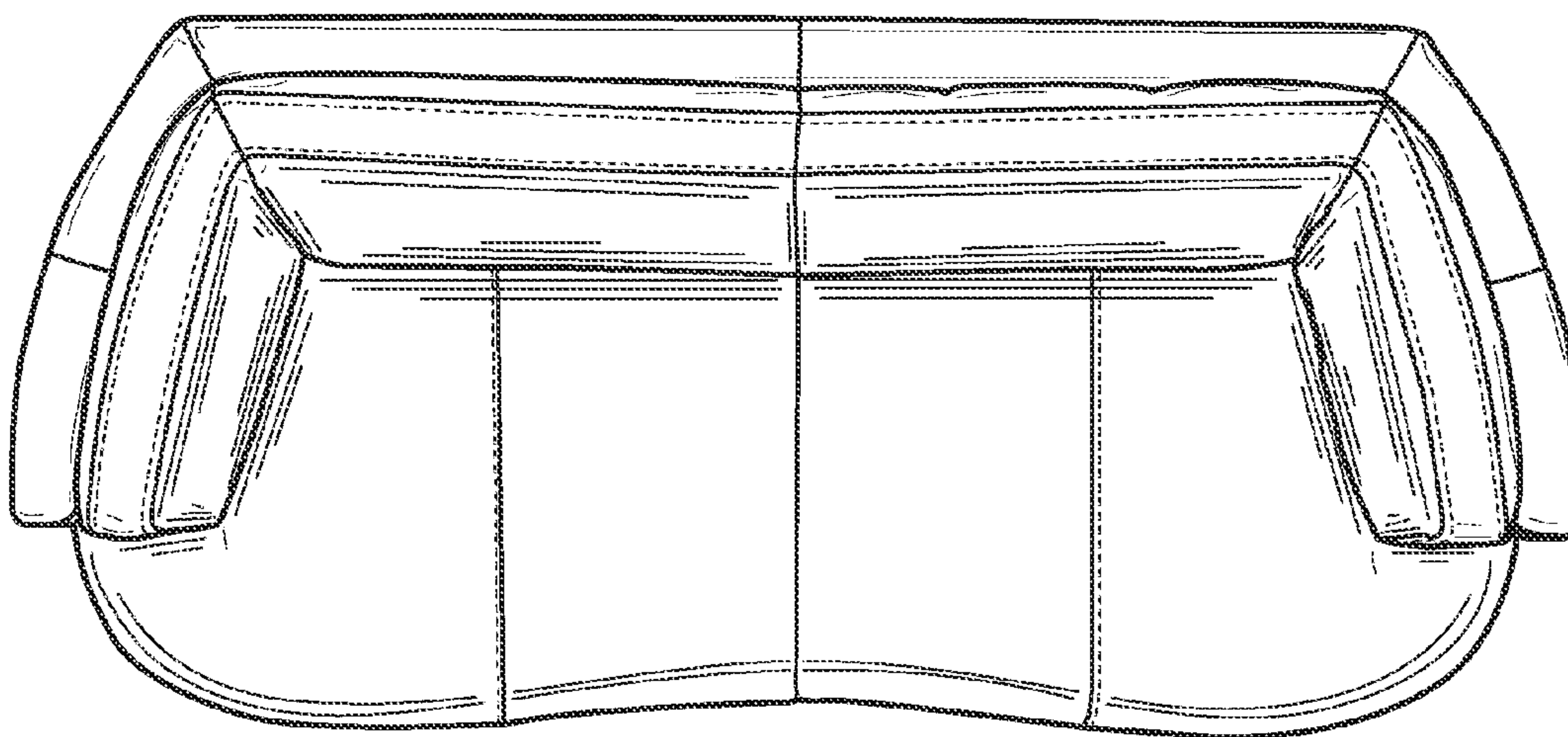

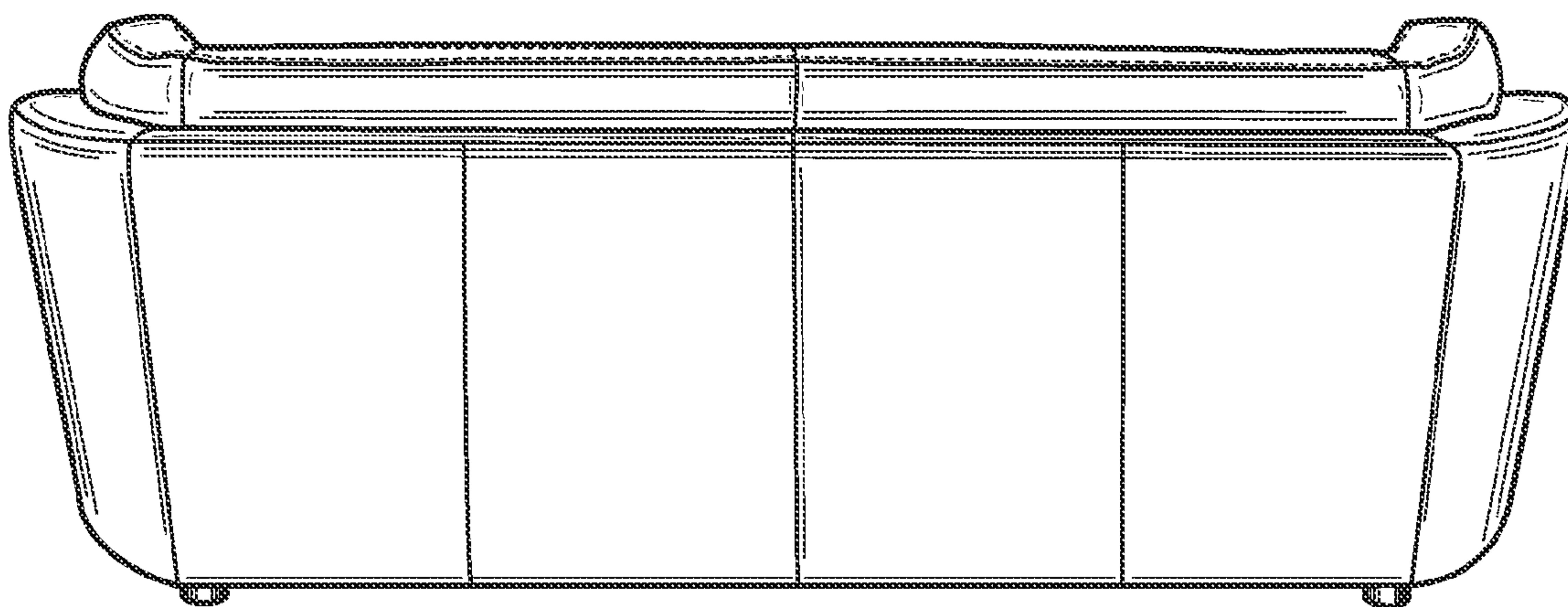
