The ornamental design for an angulus oris dilating implement, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an angulus oris dilating implement showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image of the side view shown;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;












