(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a package, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a package showing a first embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a package showing a second embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 7 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view;

FIG. 9 is a left side view thereof; and

FIG. 10 is a right side view thereof.

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a package showing a third embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 12 is a front view thereof;

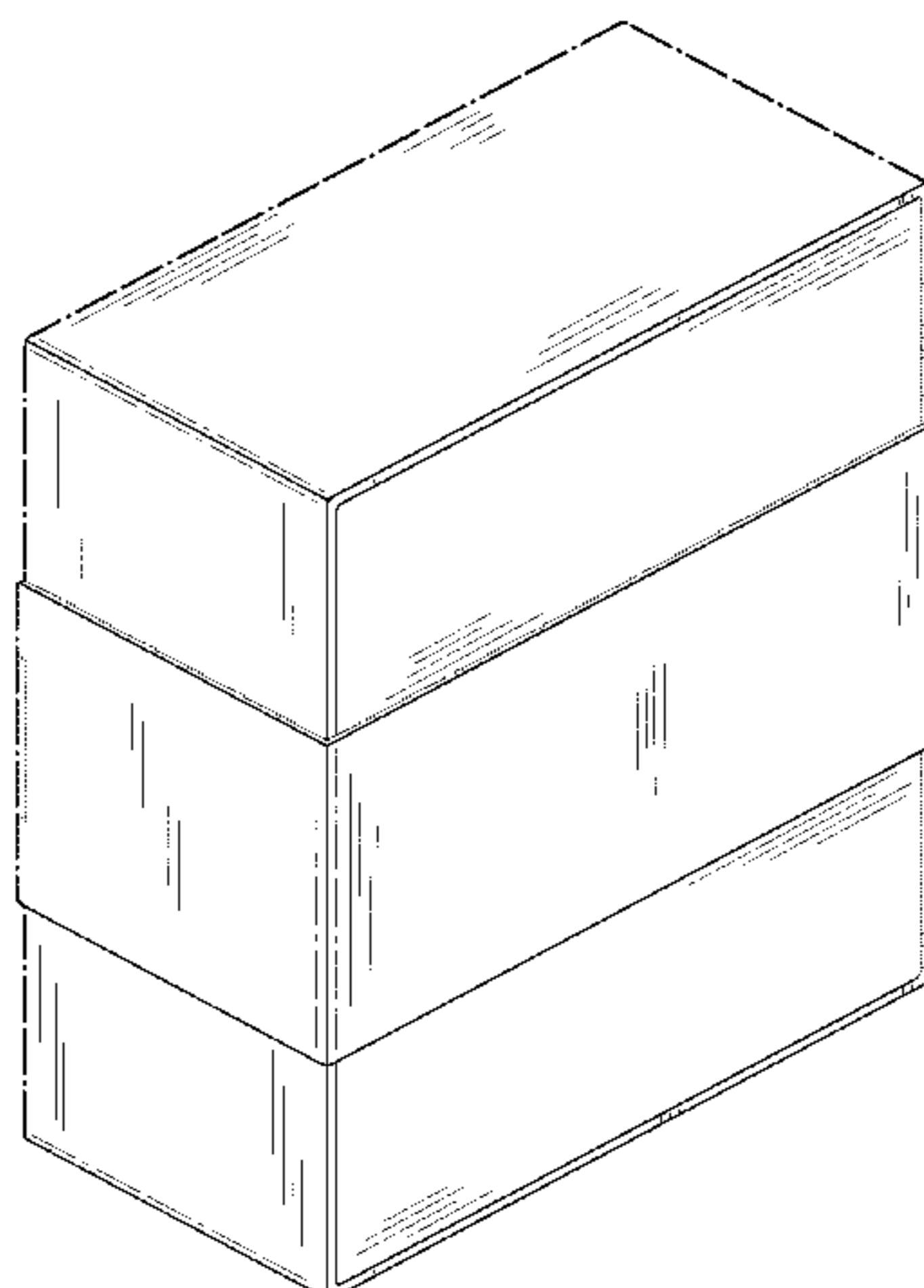
FIG. 13 is a top view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view;

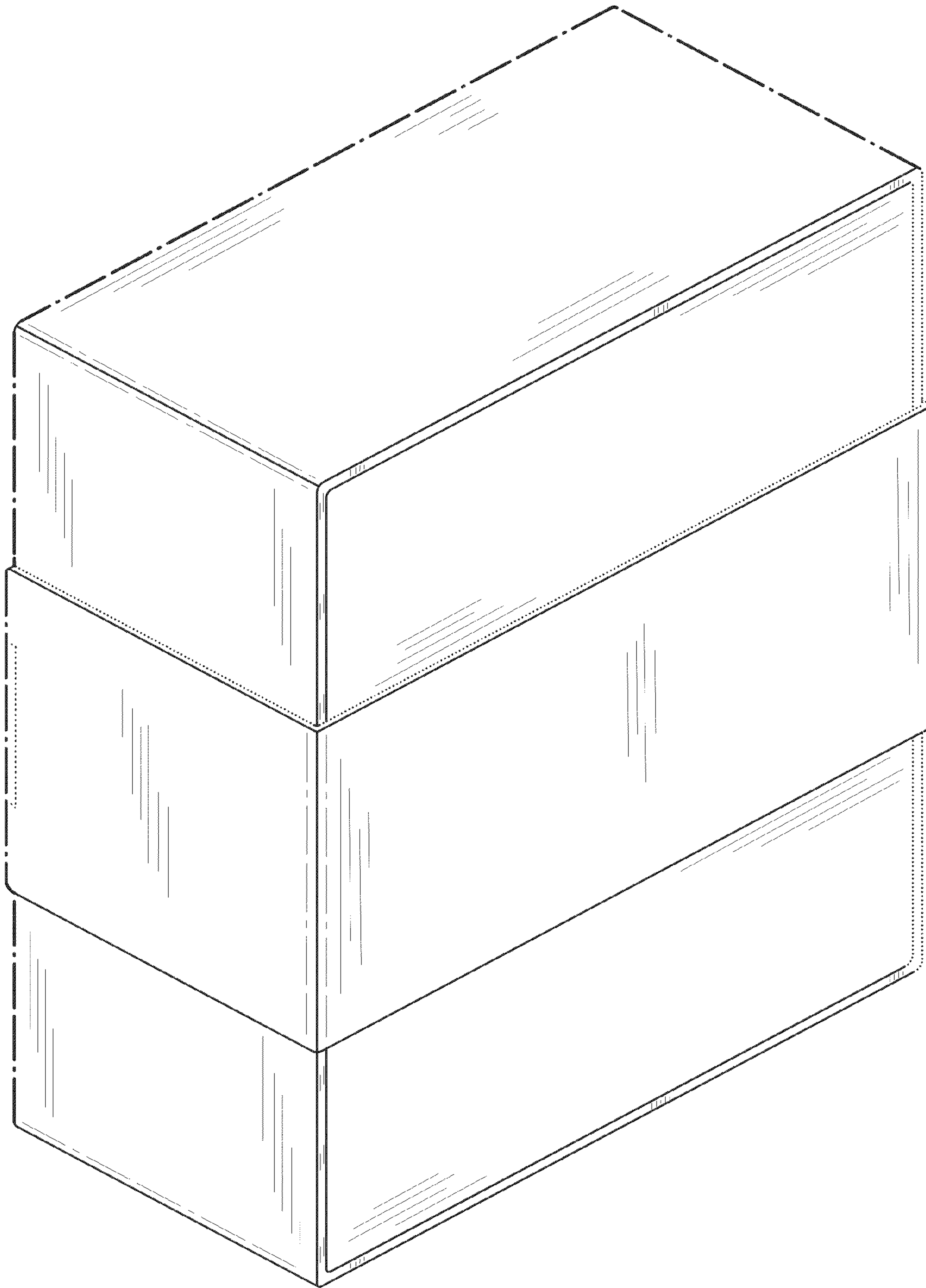

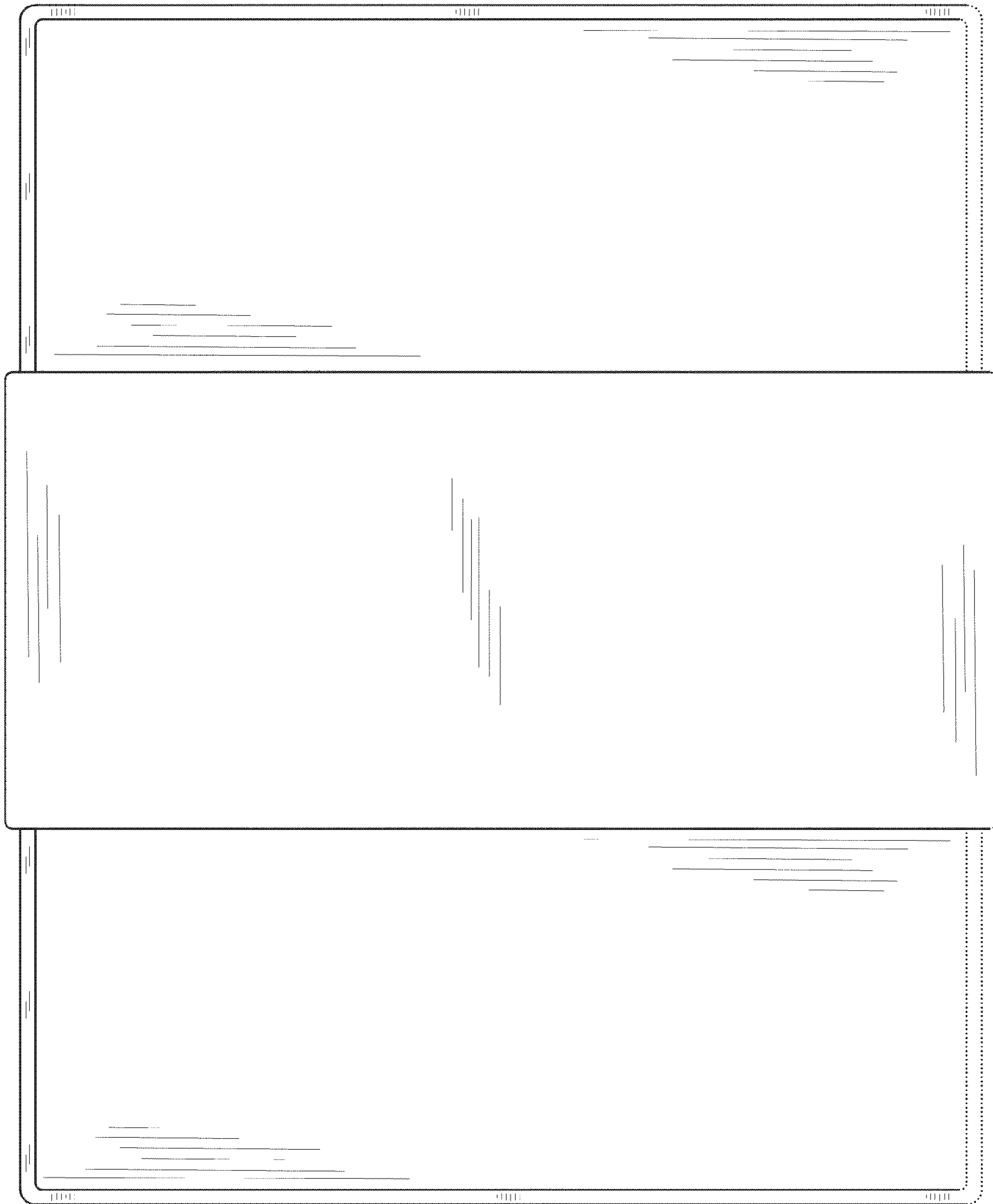

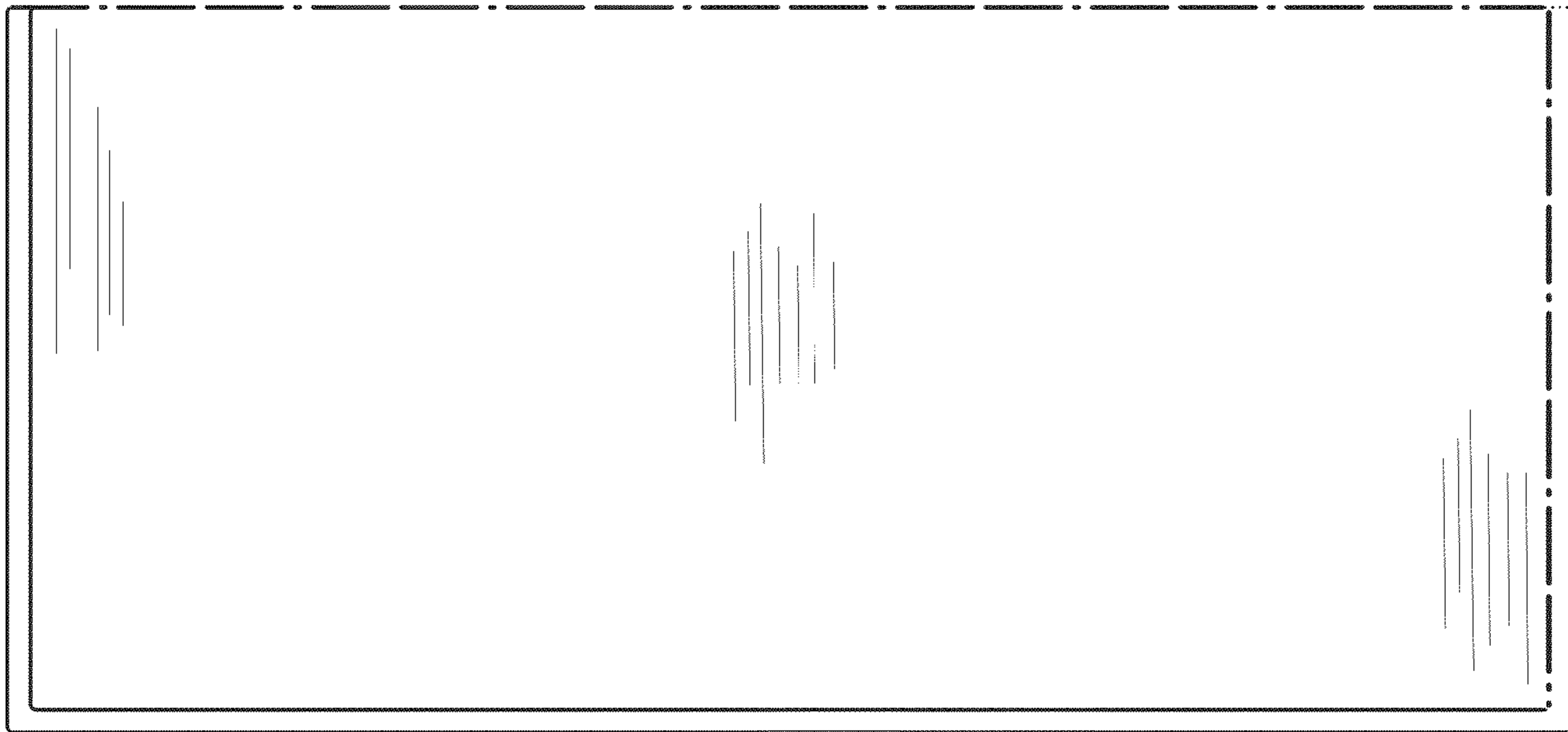

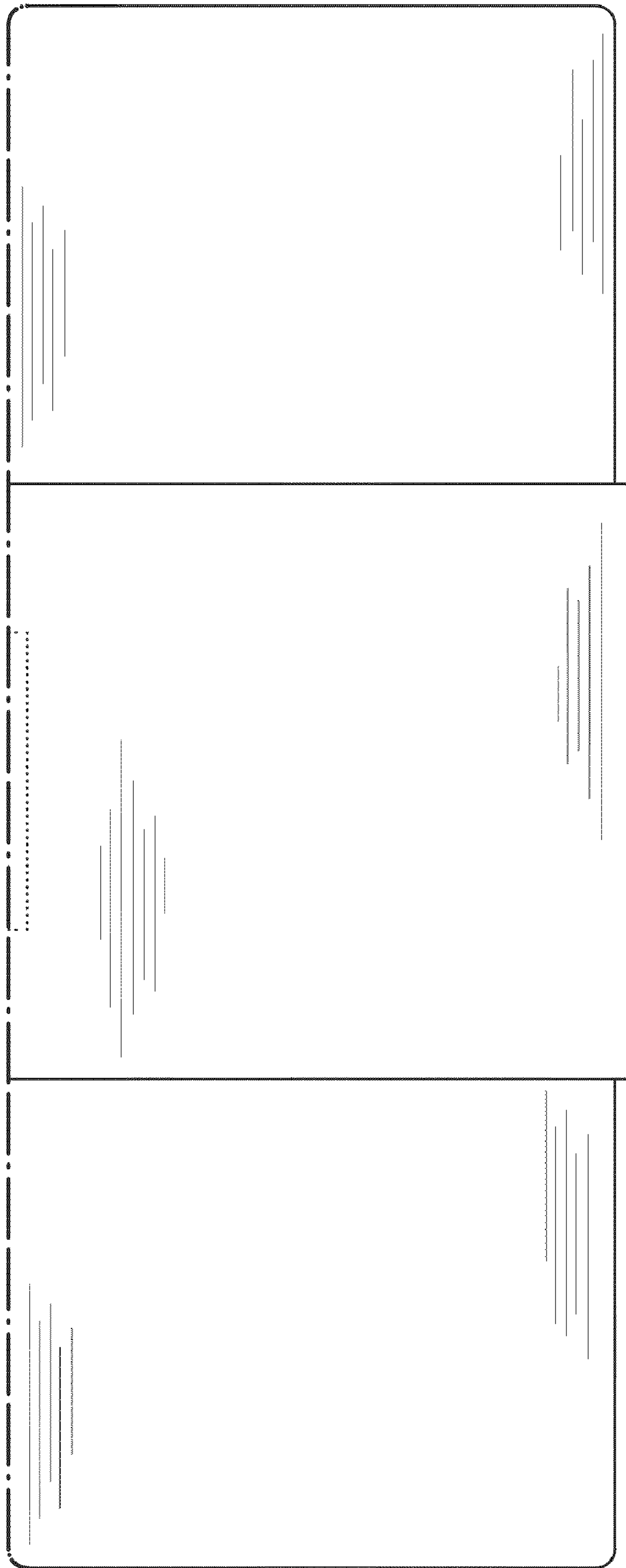

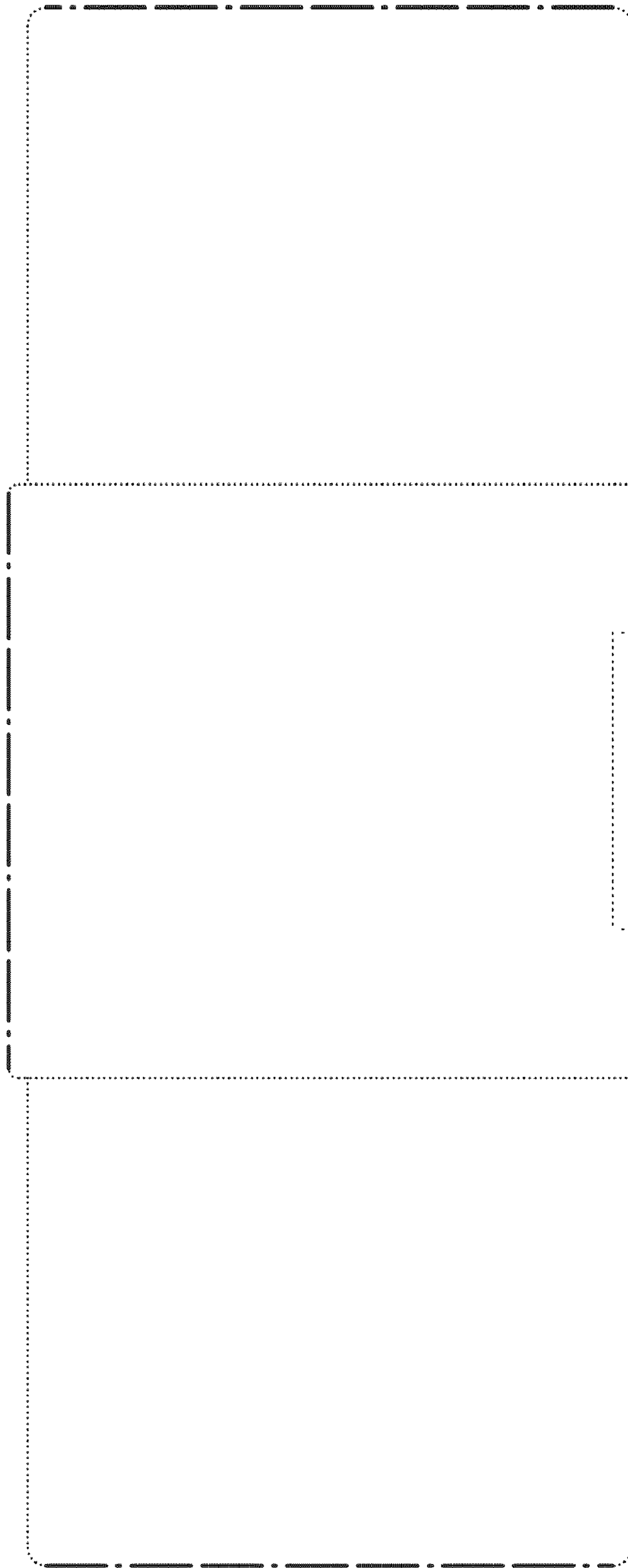

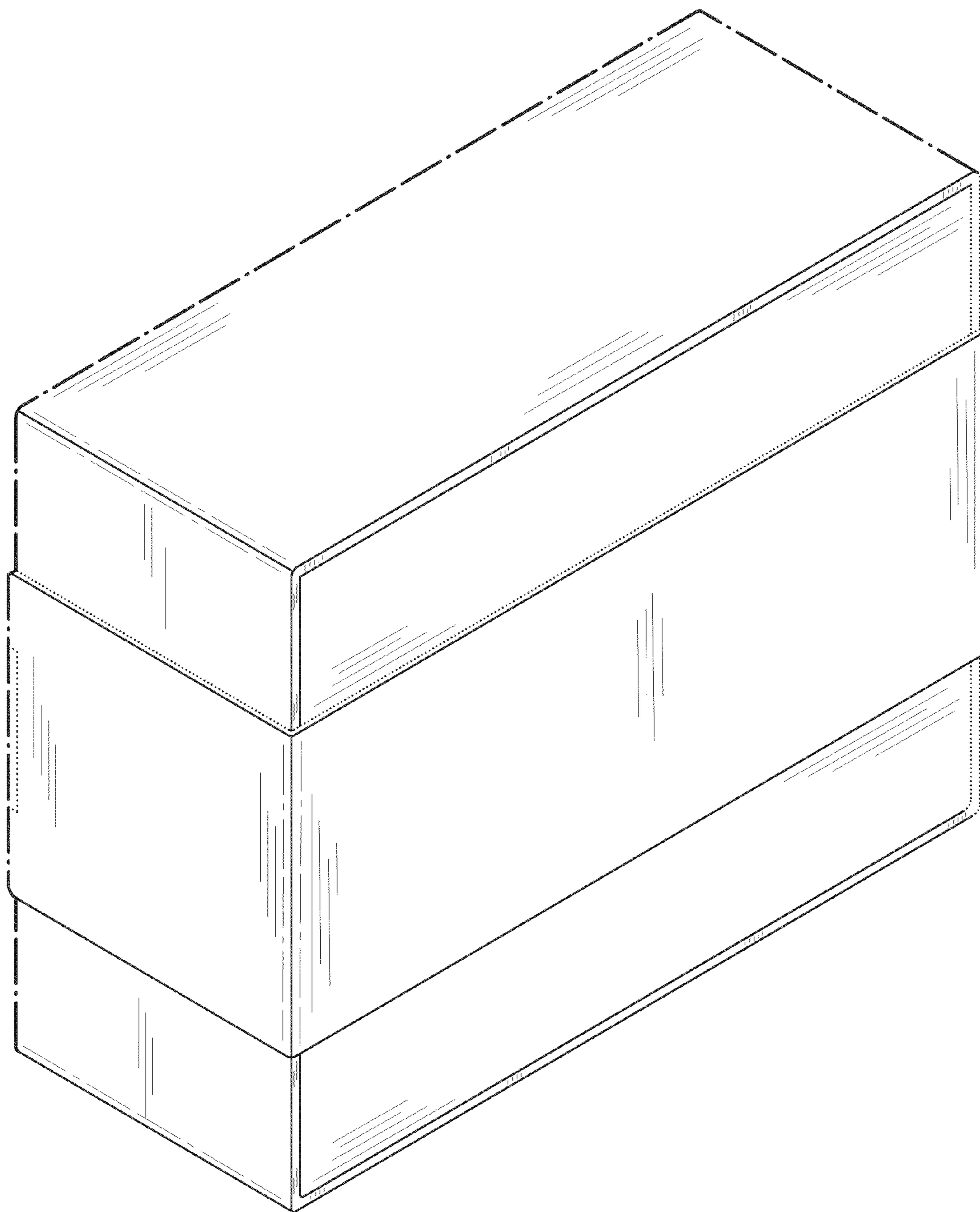

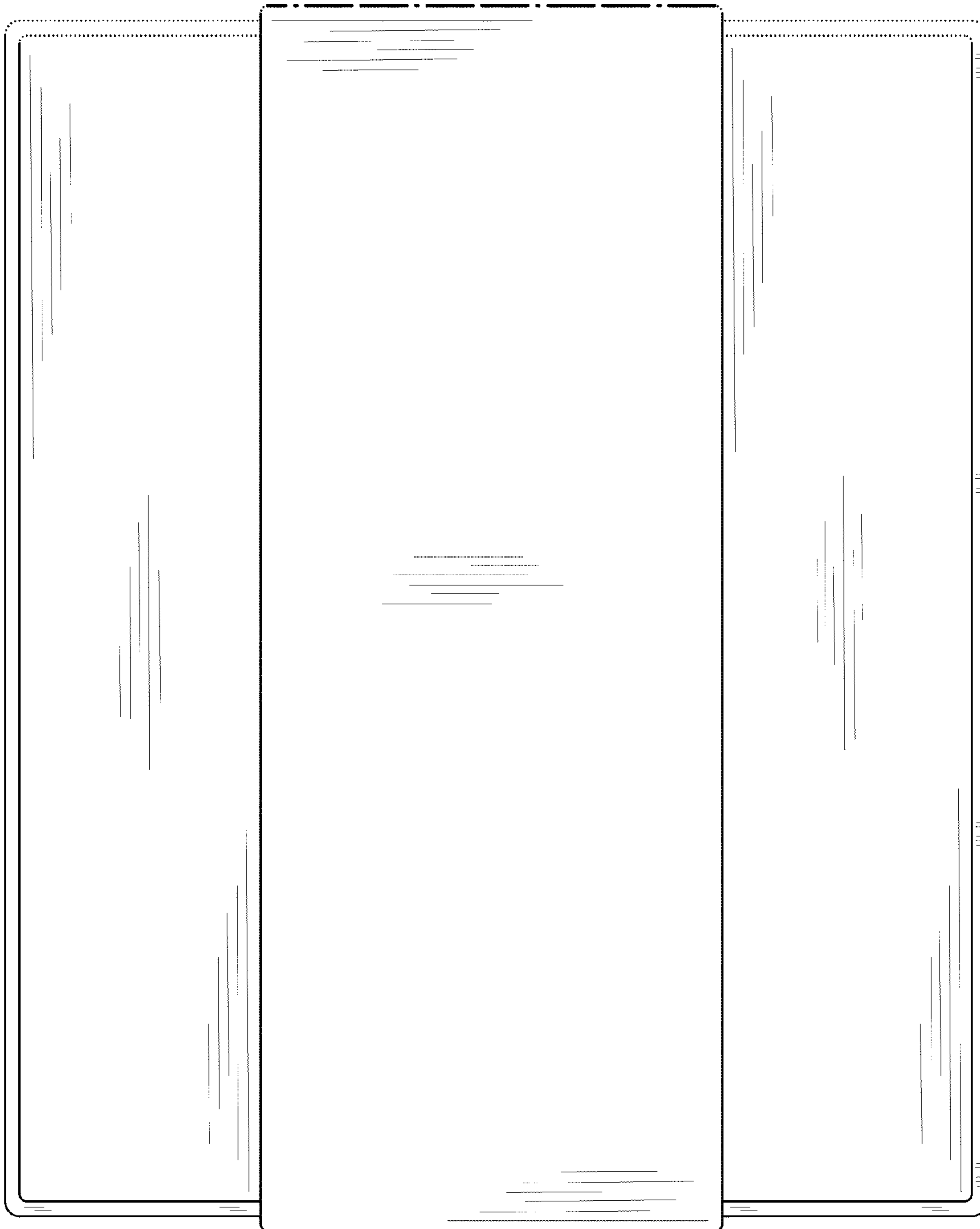

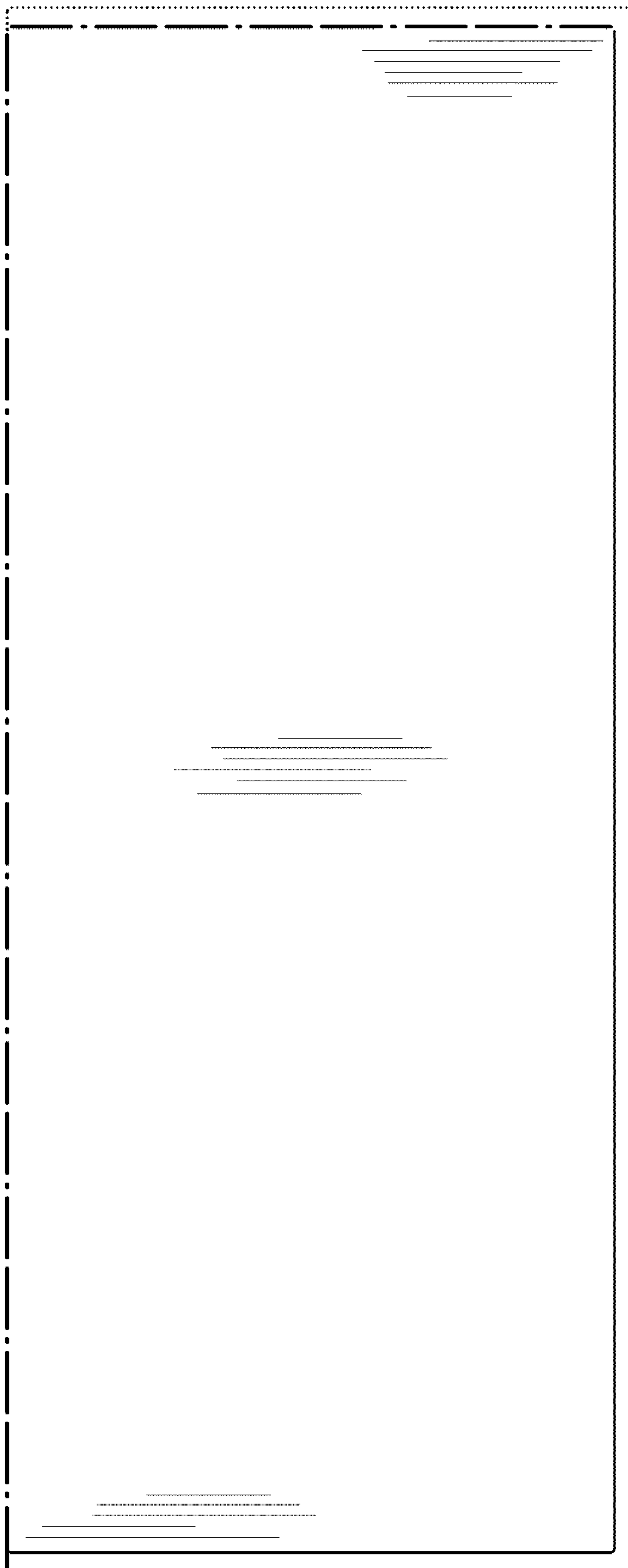

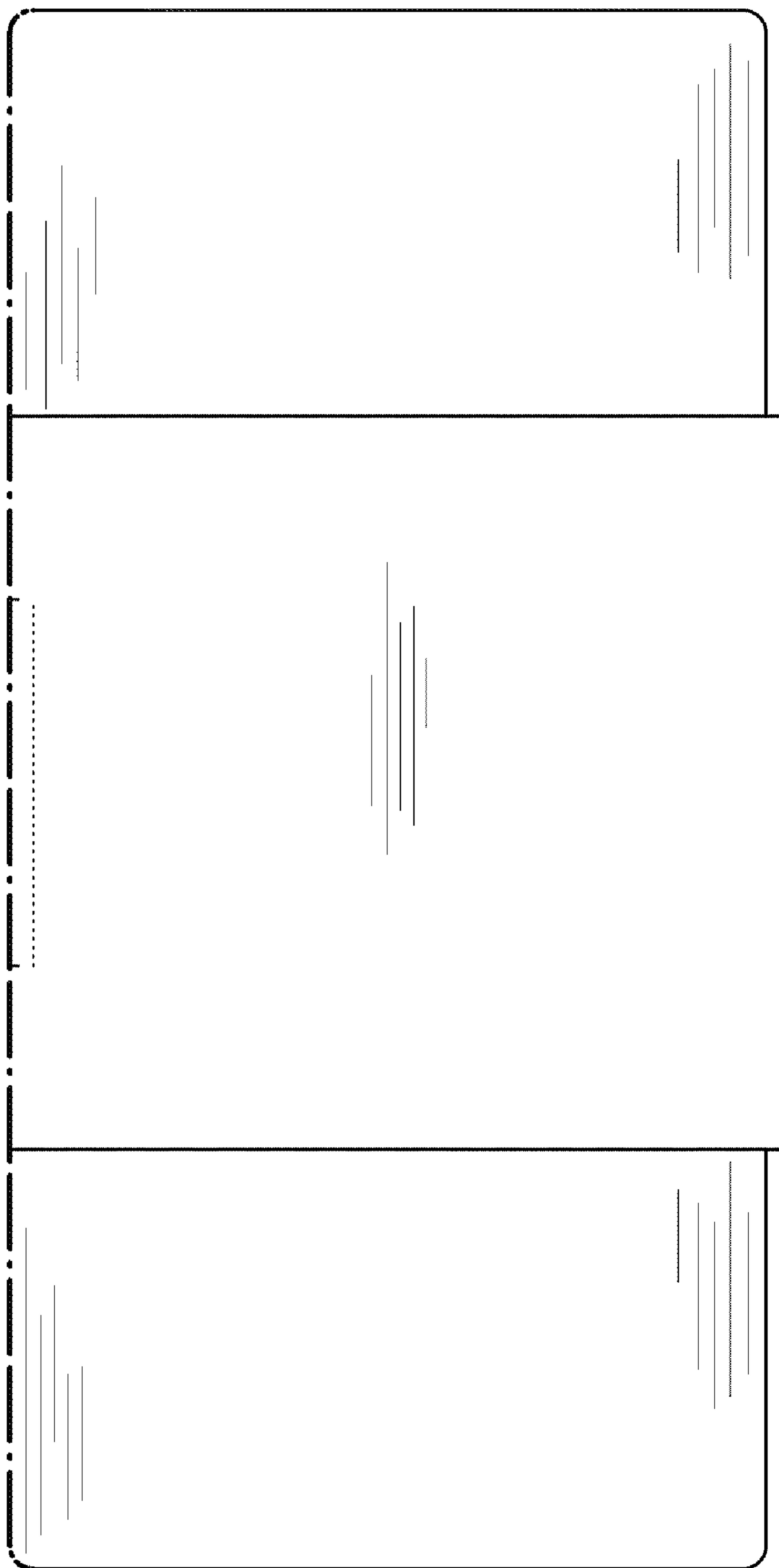

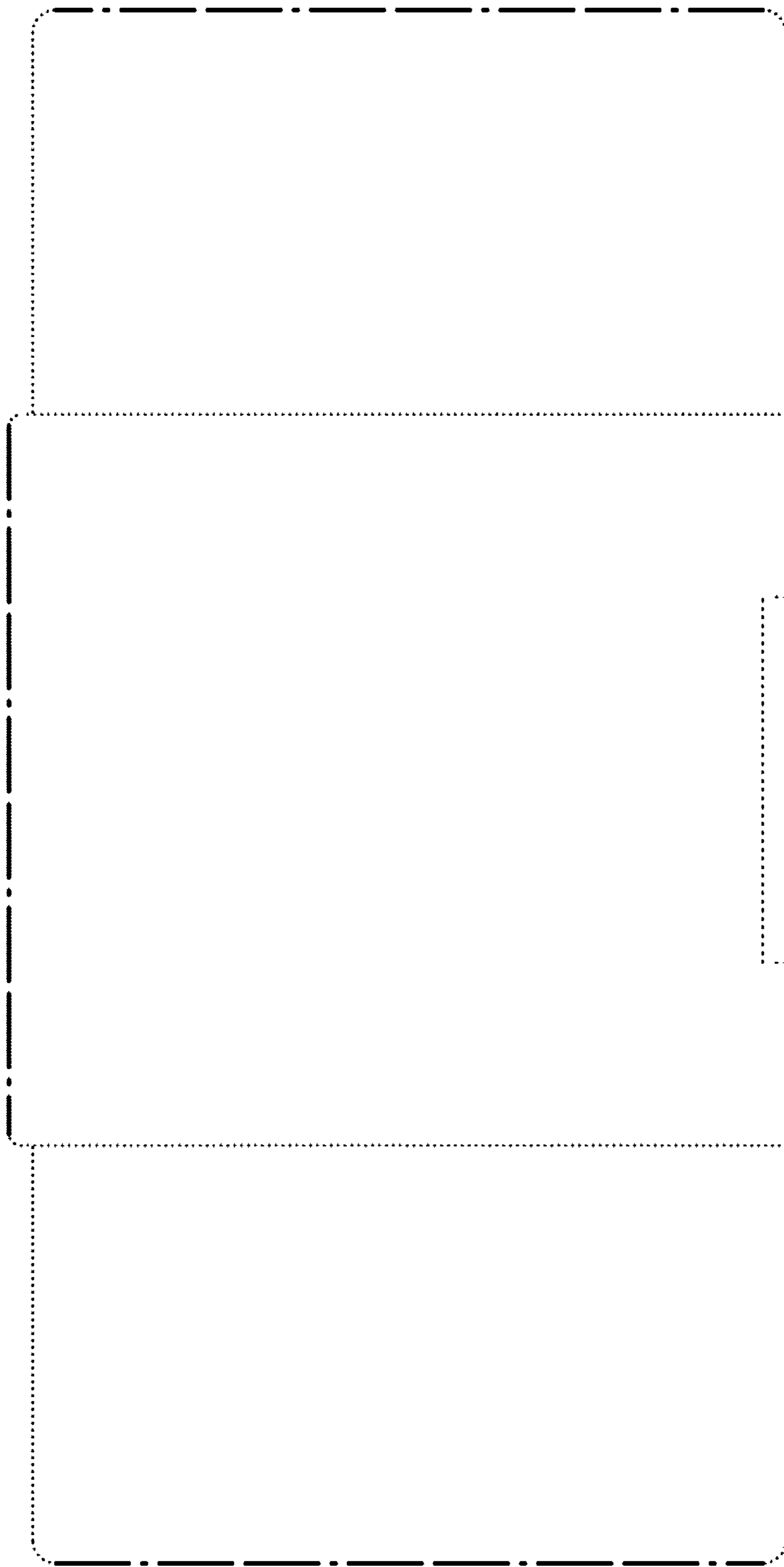

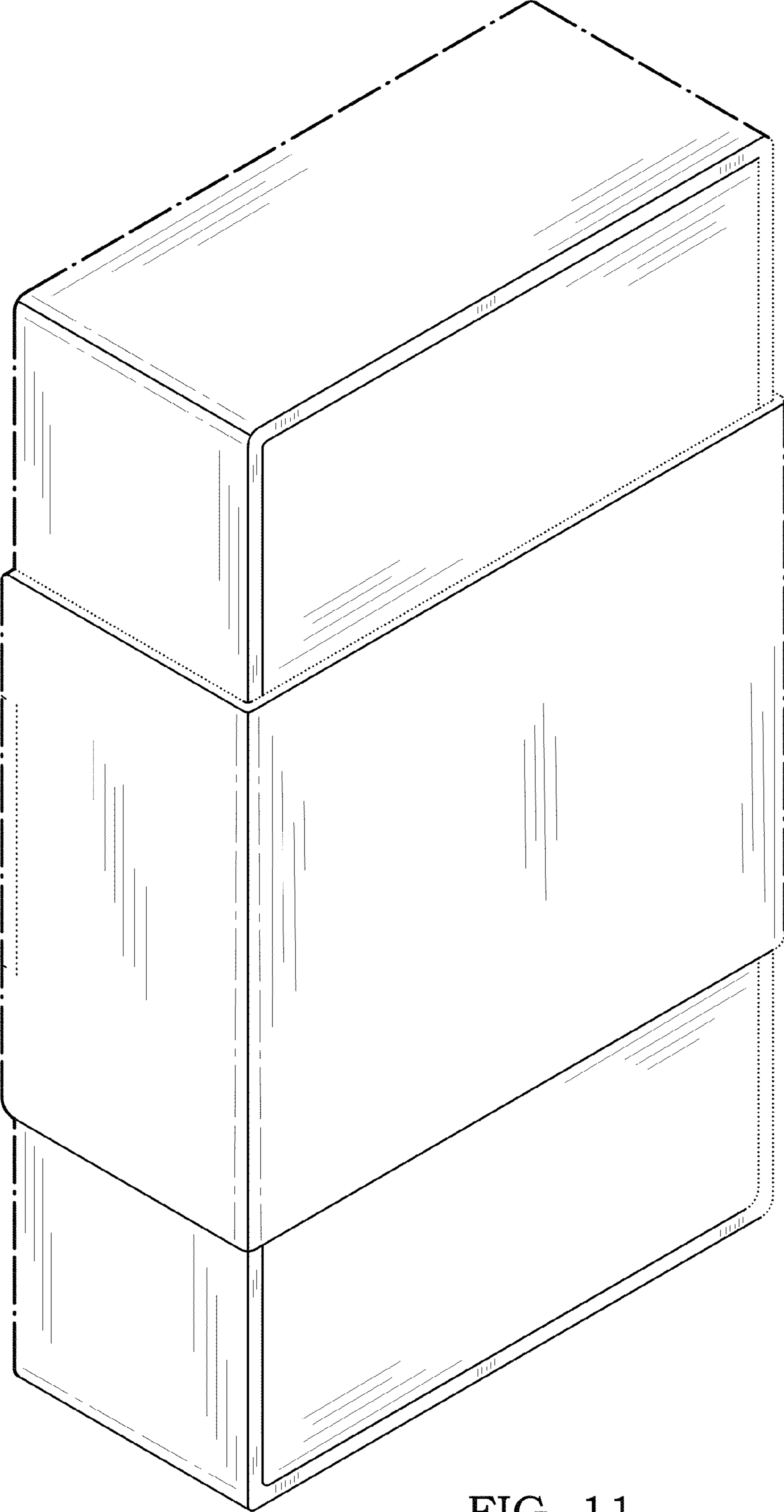

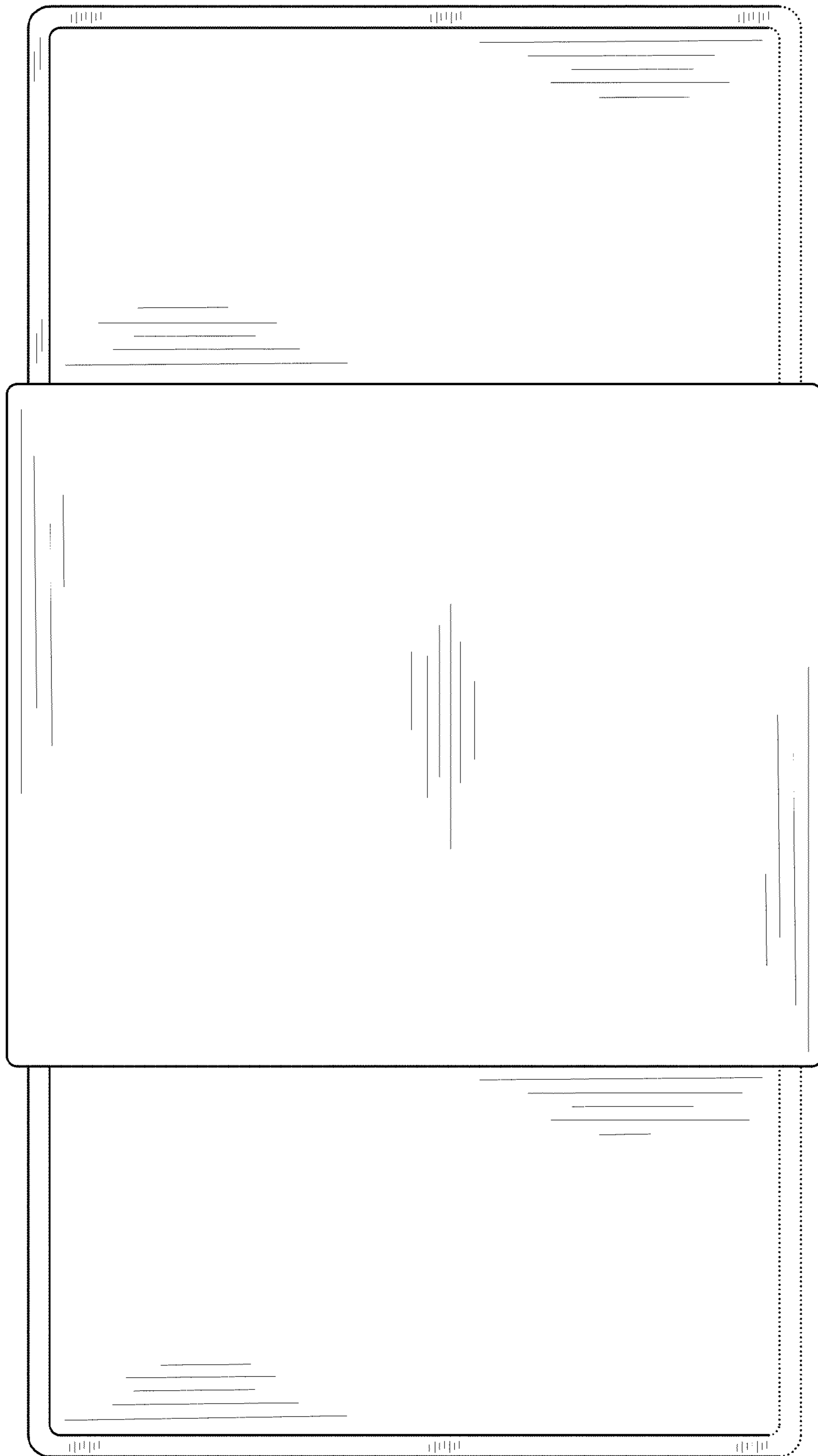

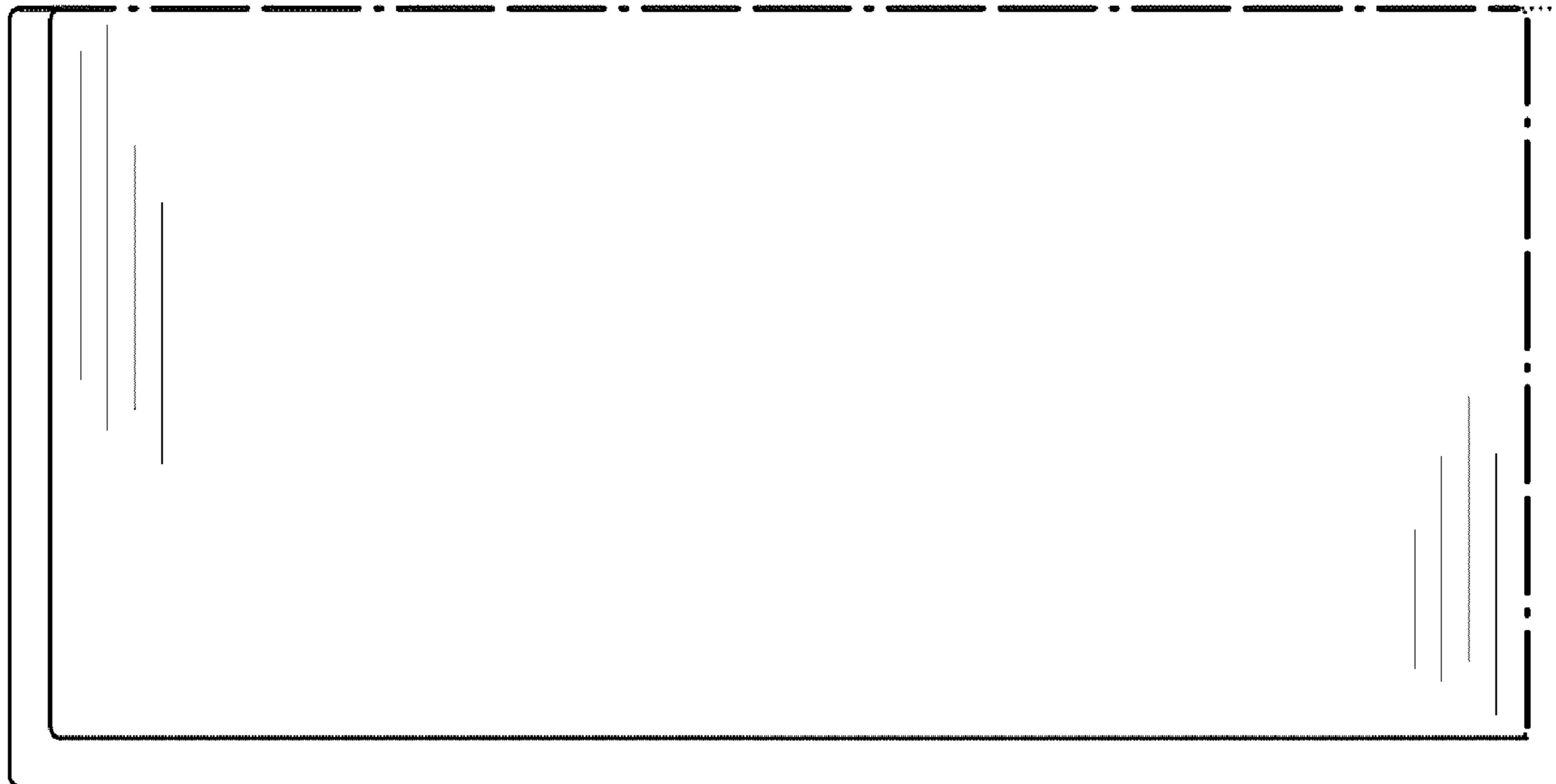

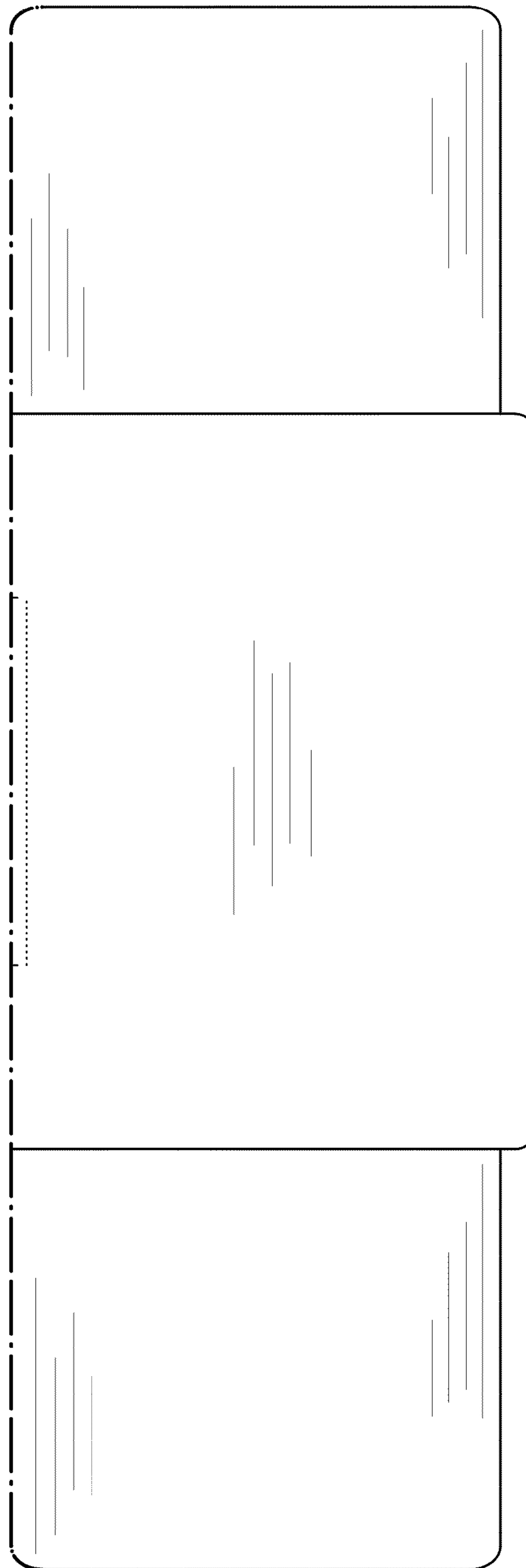

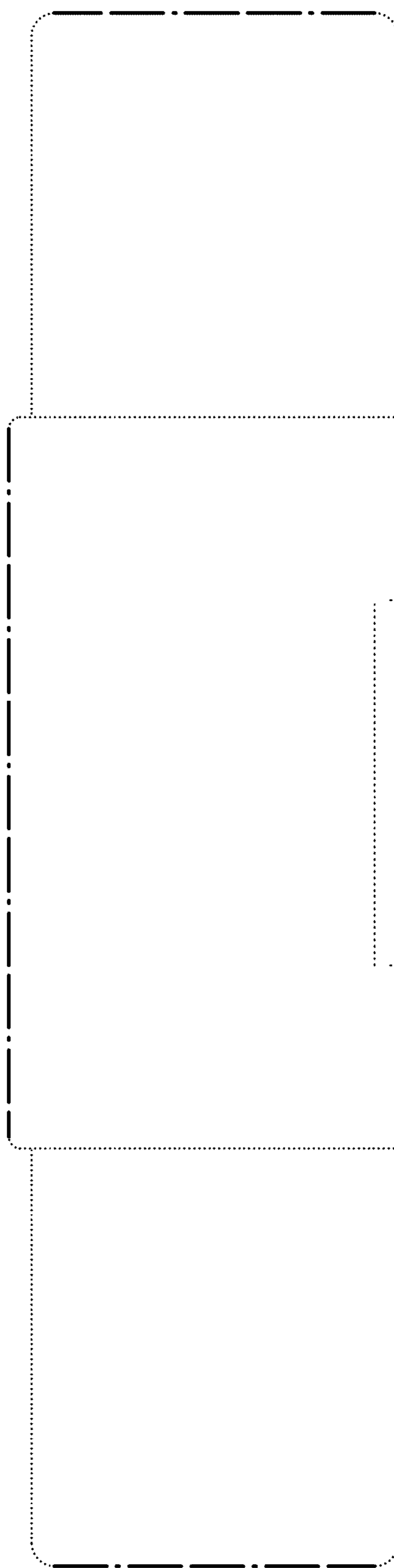
