The ornamental design for a portable lamp, as shown and described.

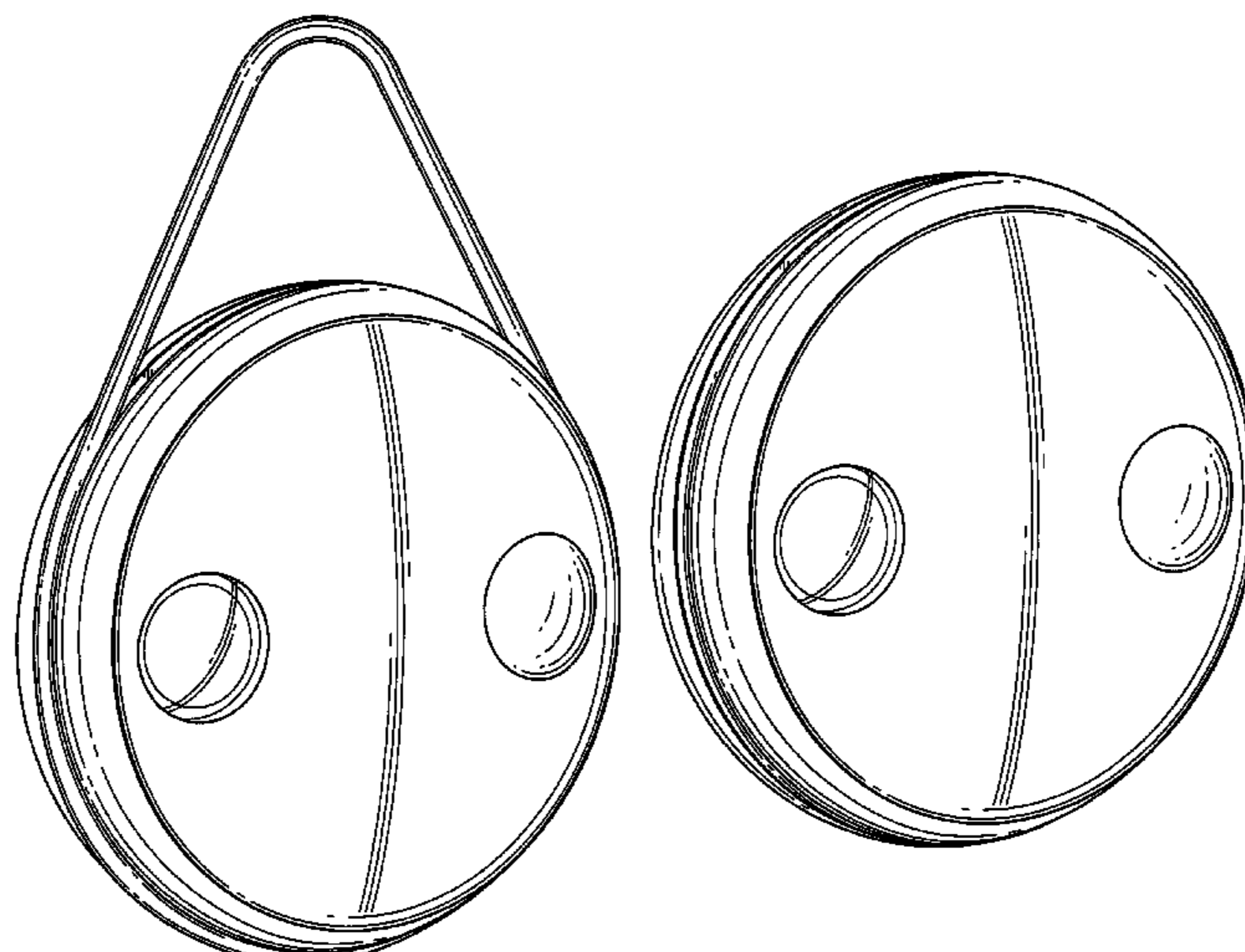
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the new design for a portable lamp as seen from the front, left side; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof.

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the new design for a portable lamp as seen from the front, left side; FIG. 9 is a top plan view of the second embodiment; FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the second embodiment; FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment; FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of the second embodiment; FIG. 13 is a right side view of the second embodiment; and, FIG. 14 is a left side view of the second embodiment.

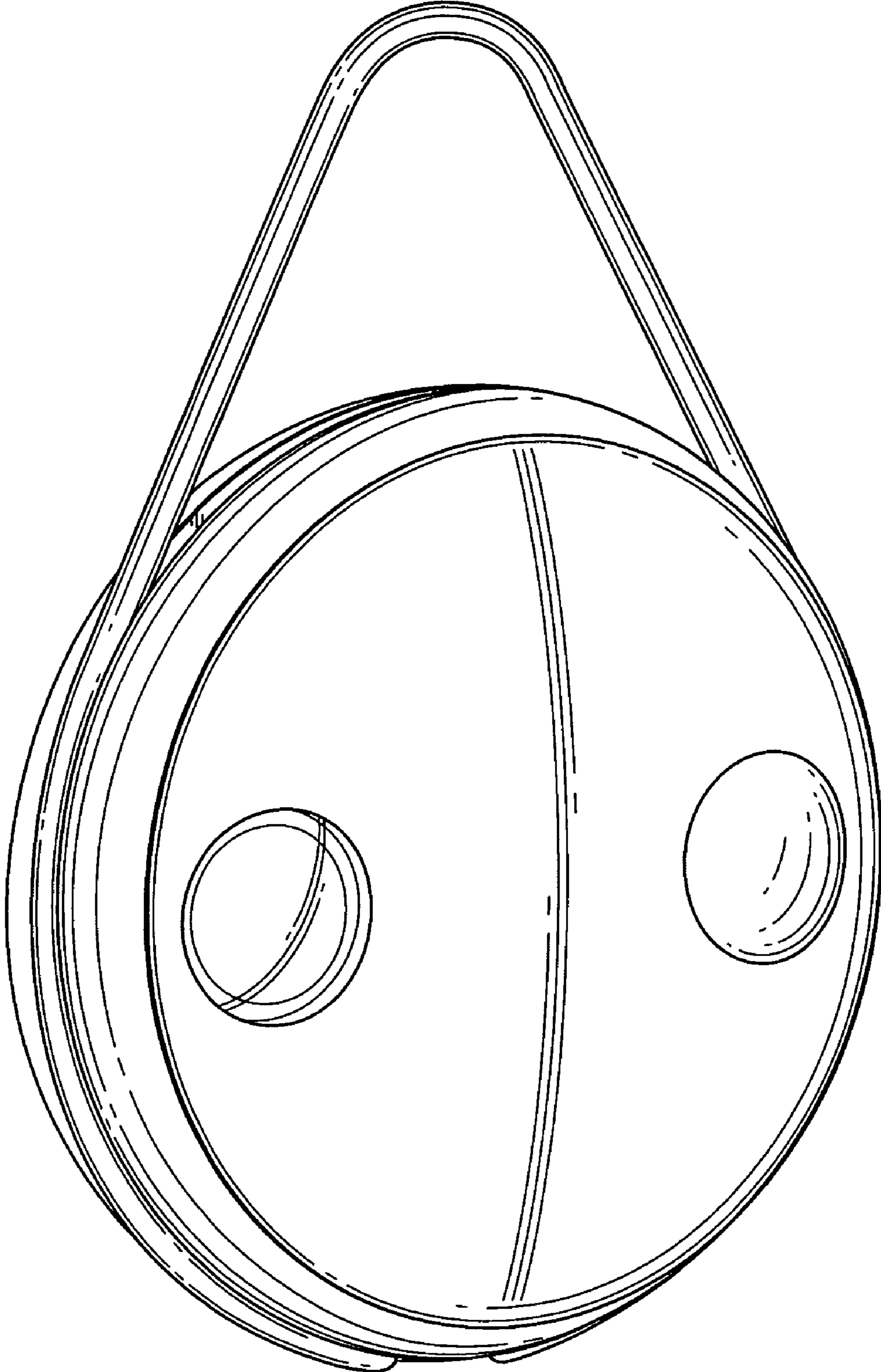

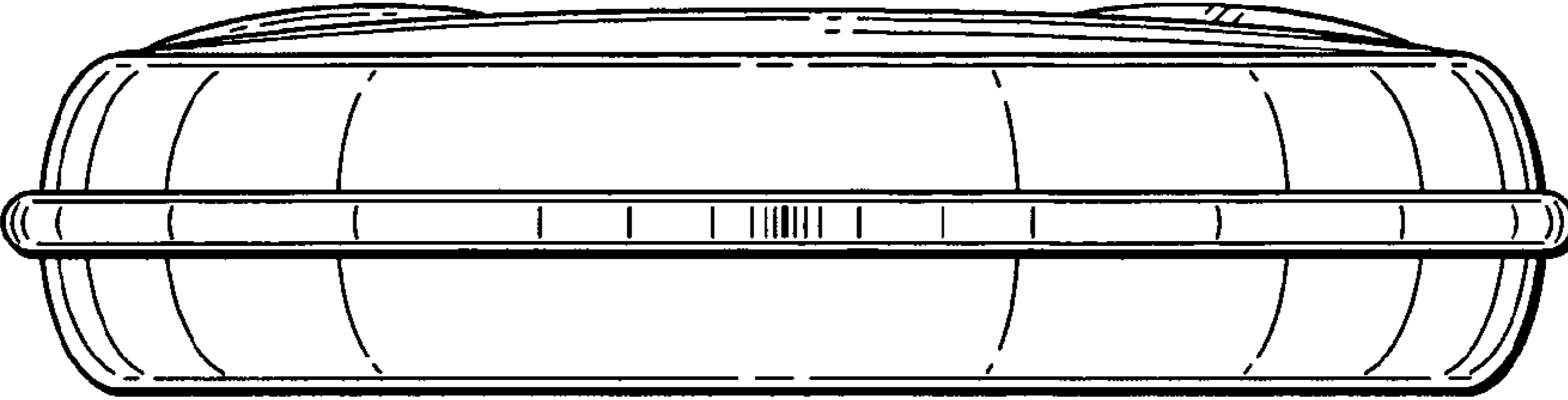

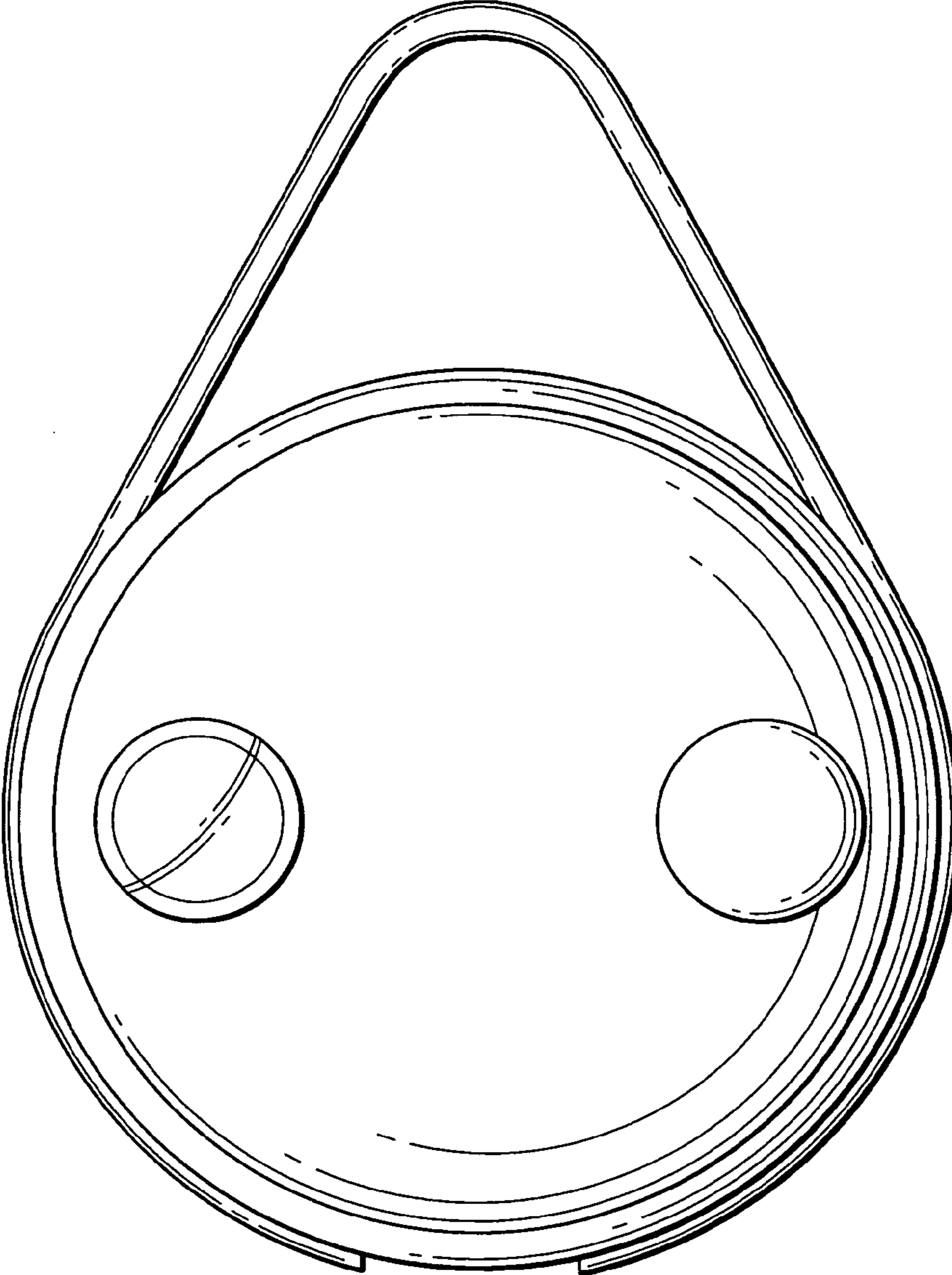

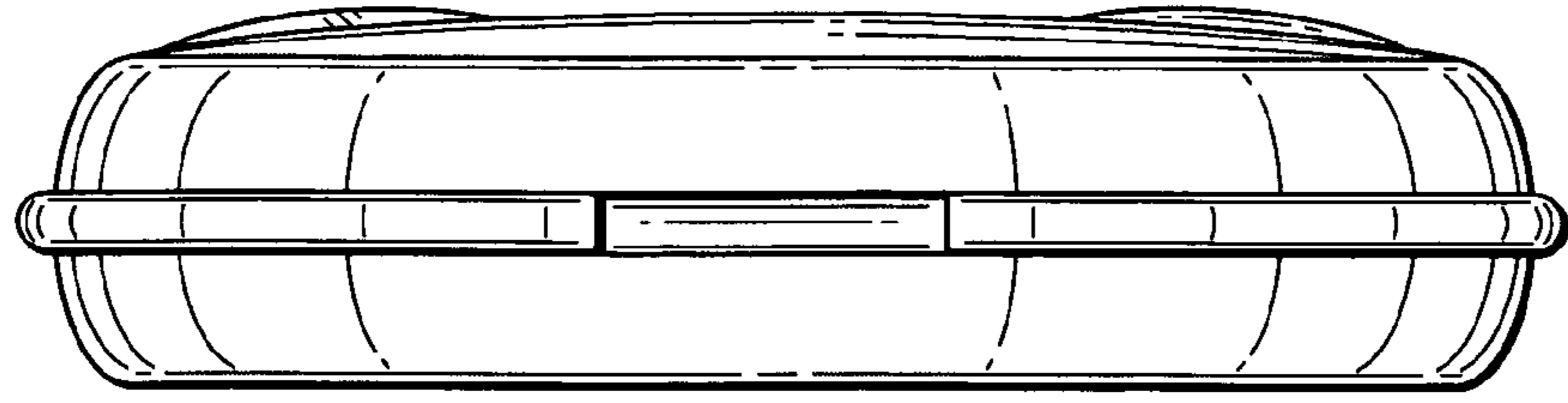

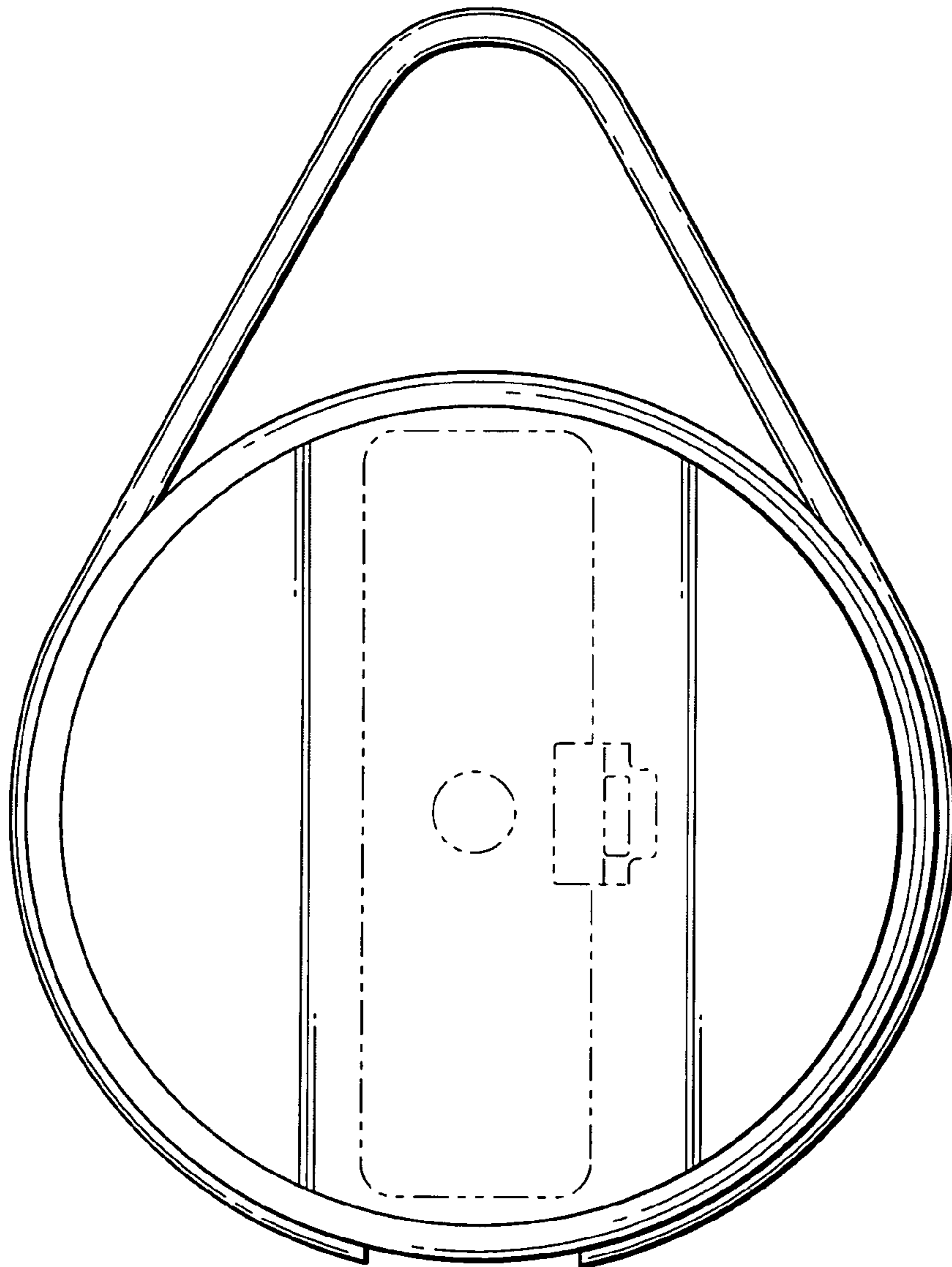

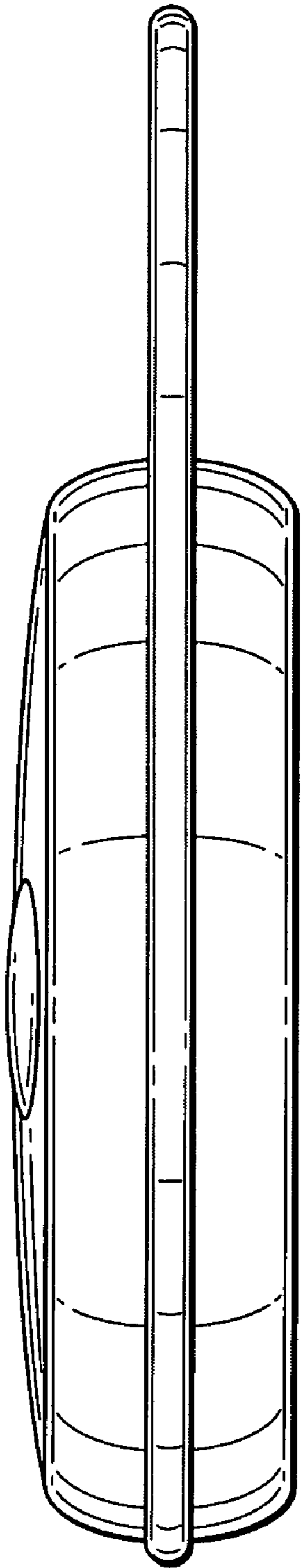

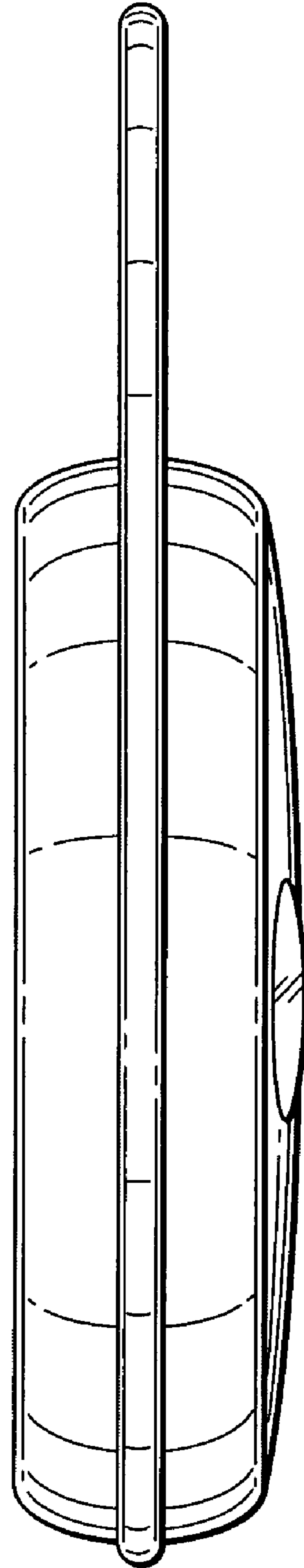

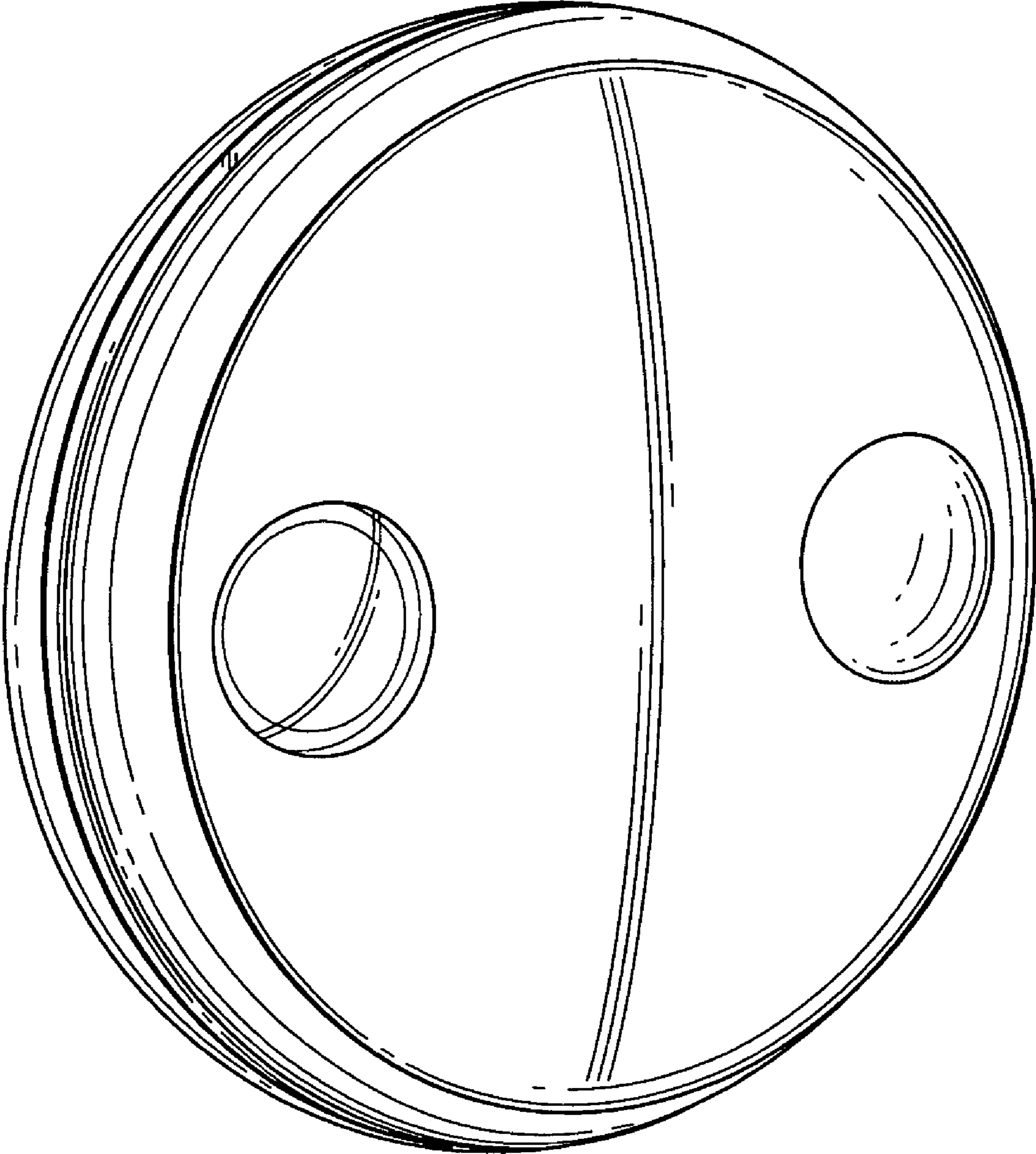

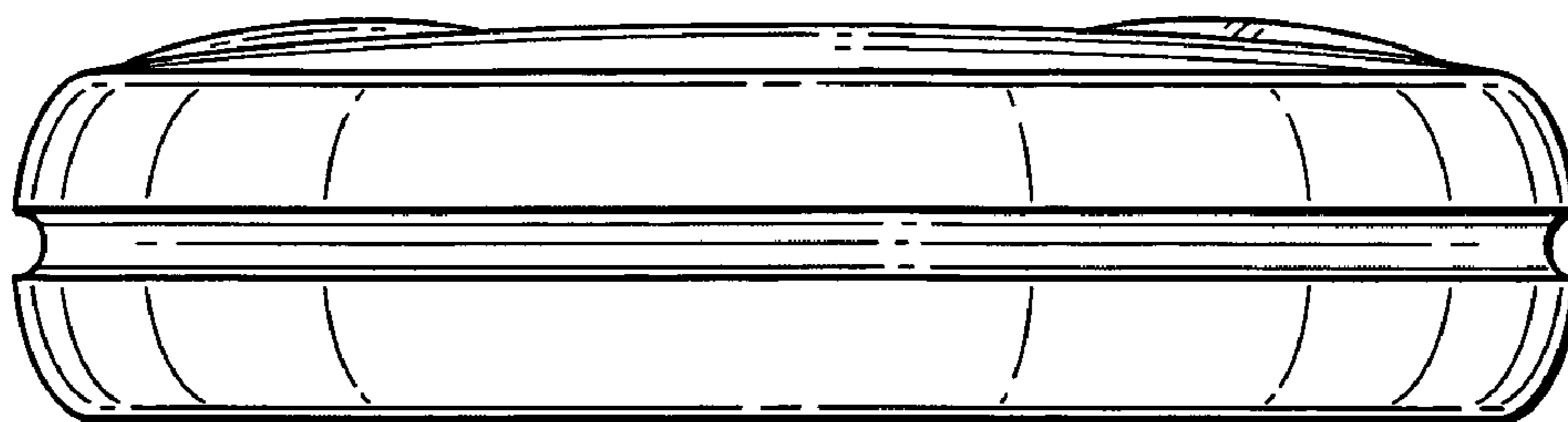

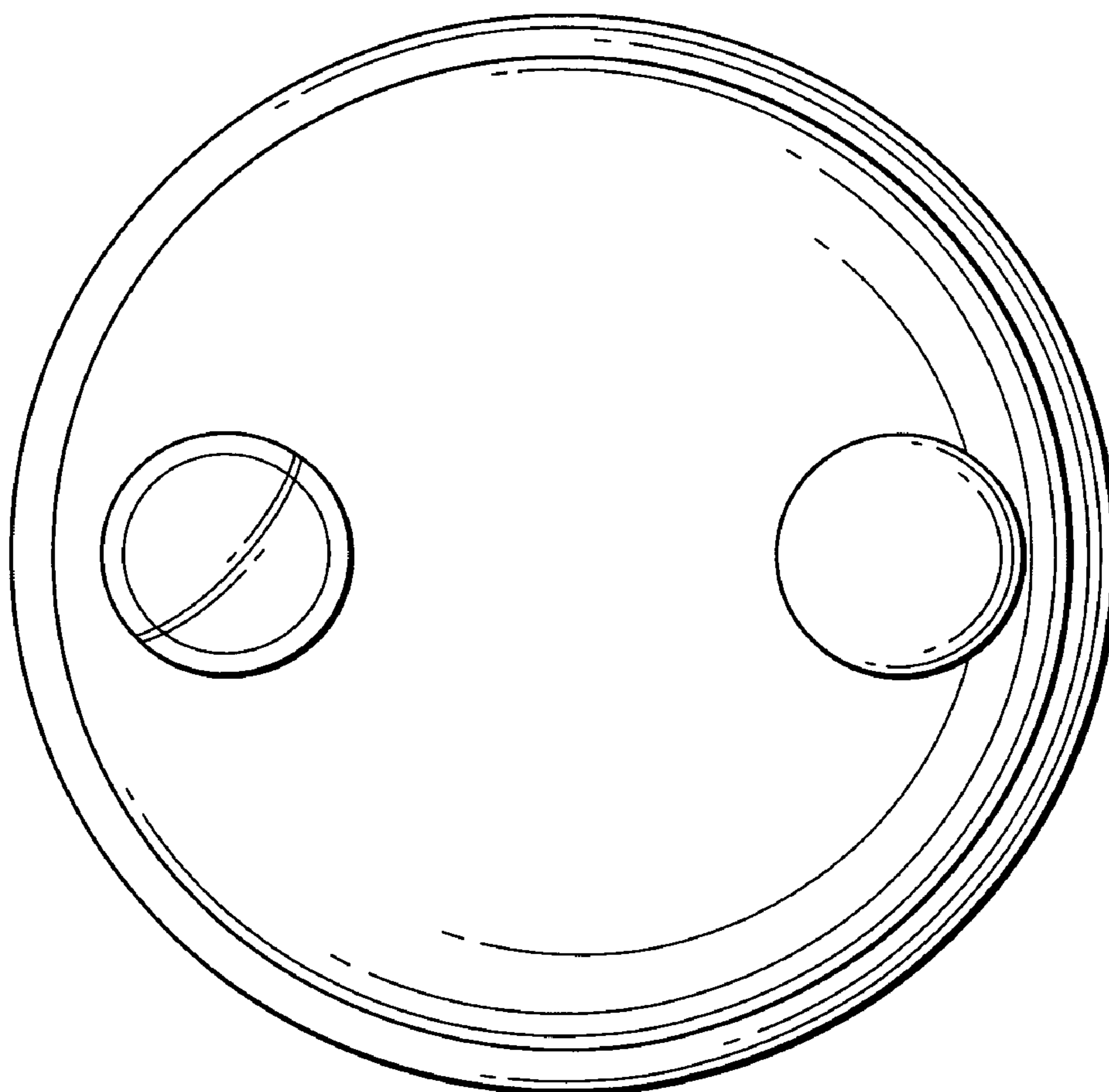

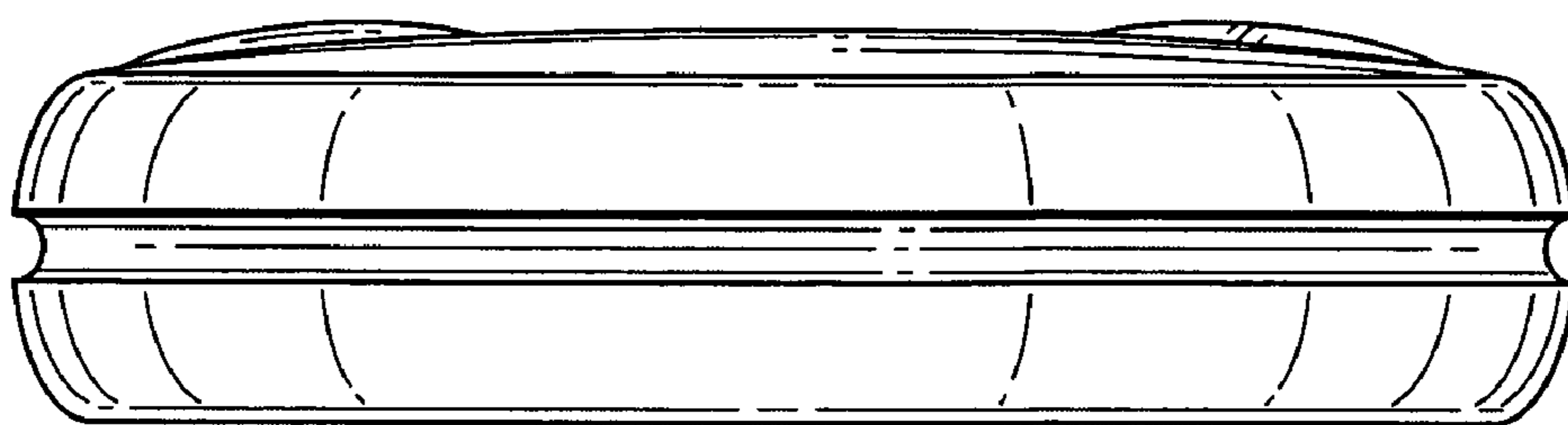

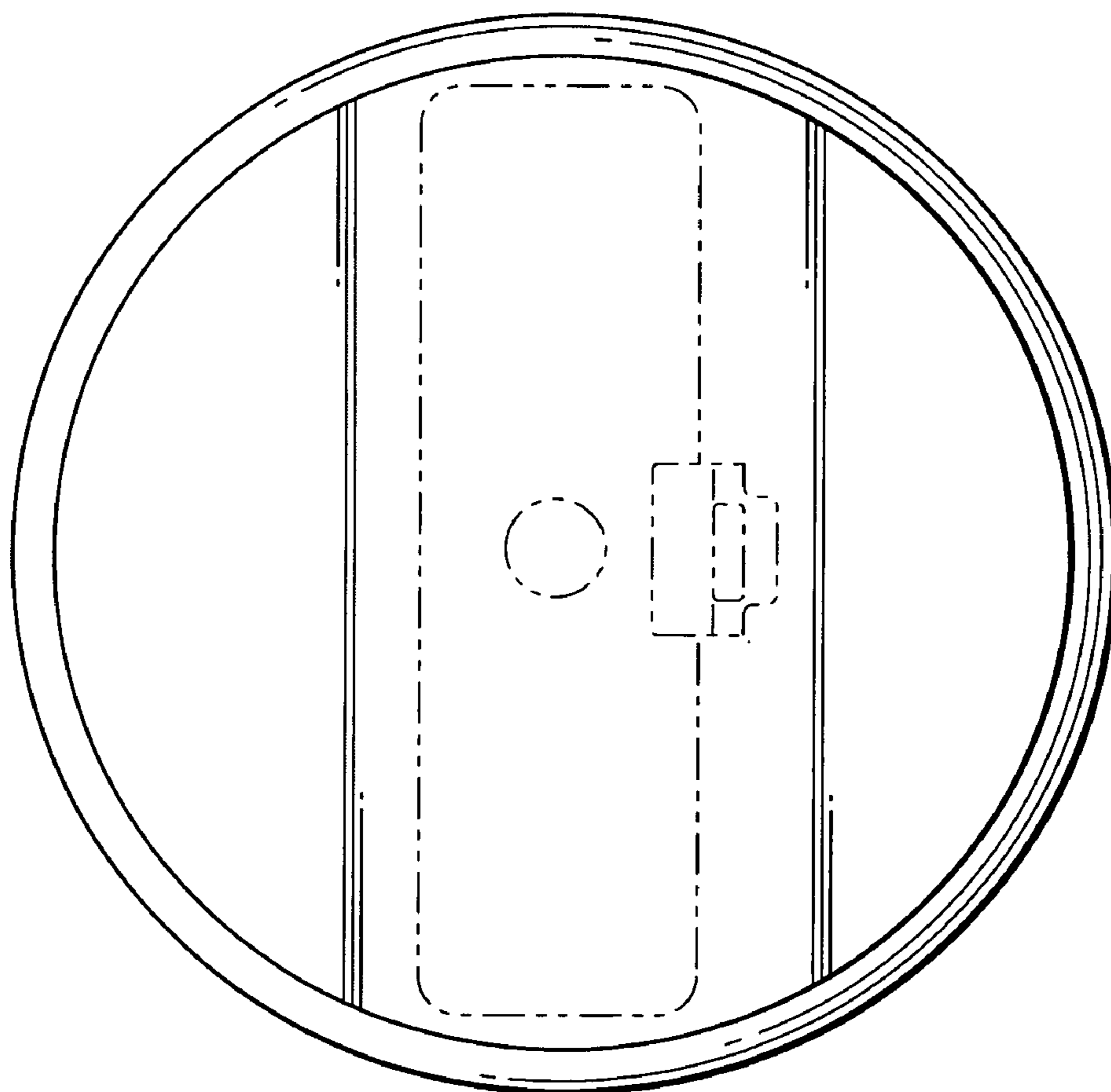

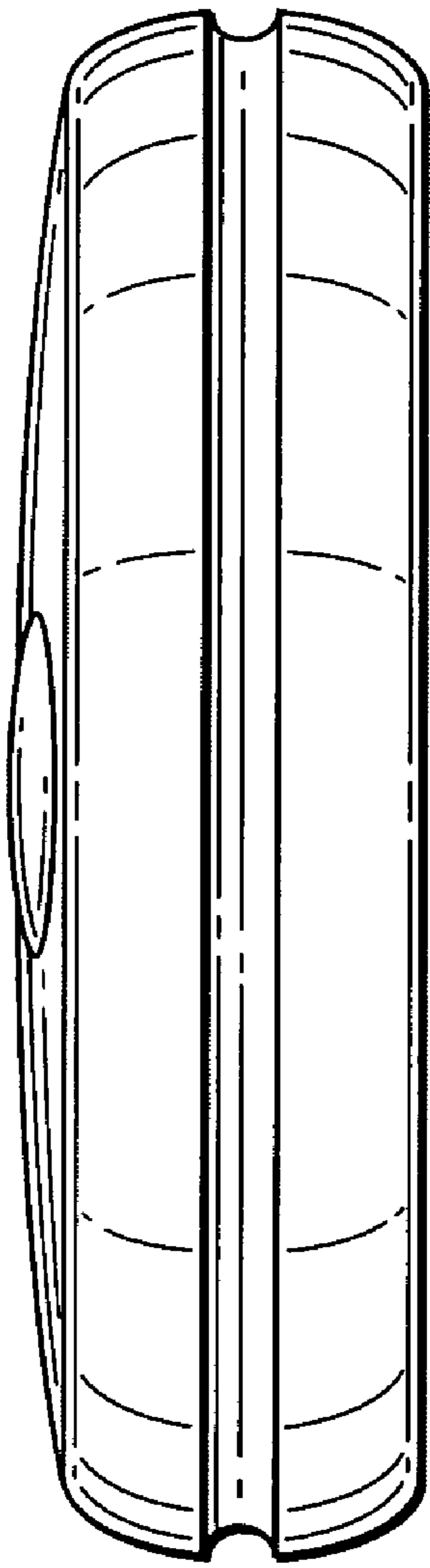

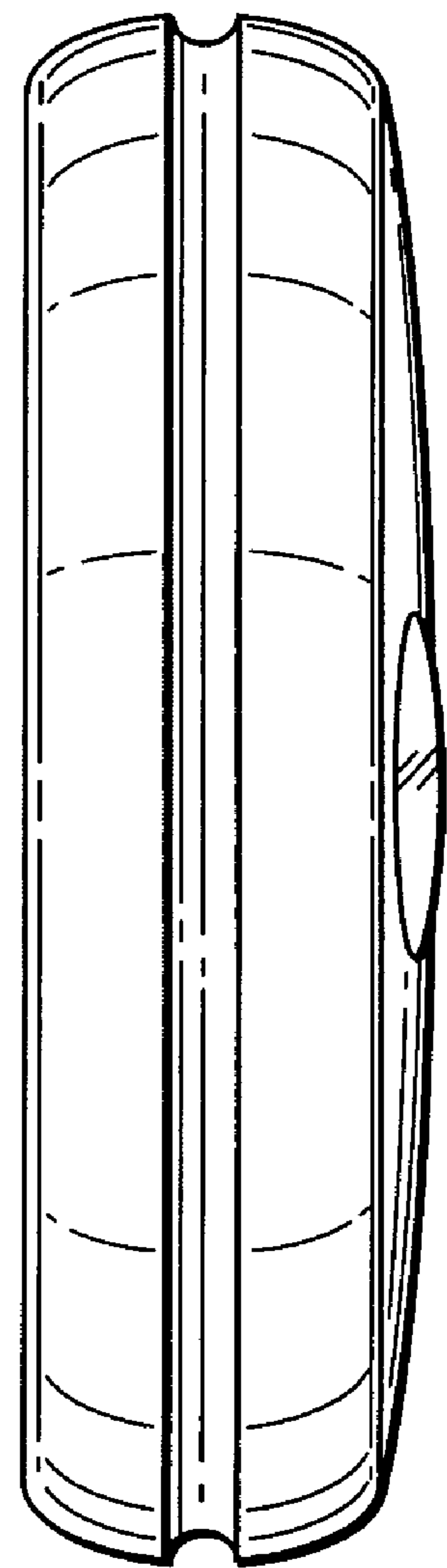
