(57) **CLAIM**

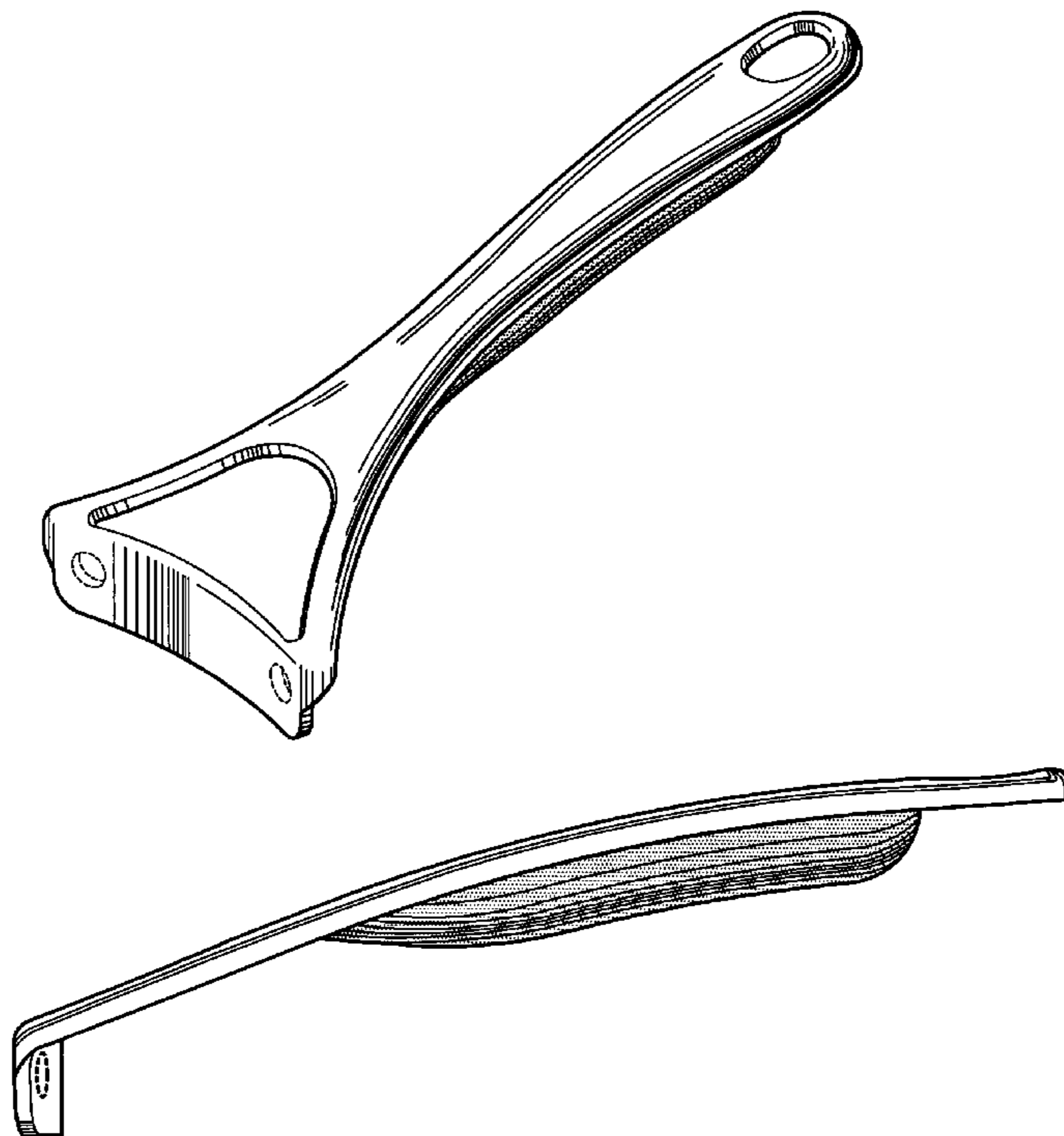
The ornamental design for a bottom grip cookware handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from above of the “bottom grip cookware handle”, showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a back elevation view.

The broken lines in FIGS. 1, 3, 4, 5 and 6 immediately adjacent the shaded areas represent the bounds of the claim and all other broken lines represent unclaimed portions of the design. None of the broken lines form a part of the claimed design.

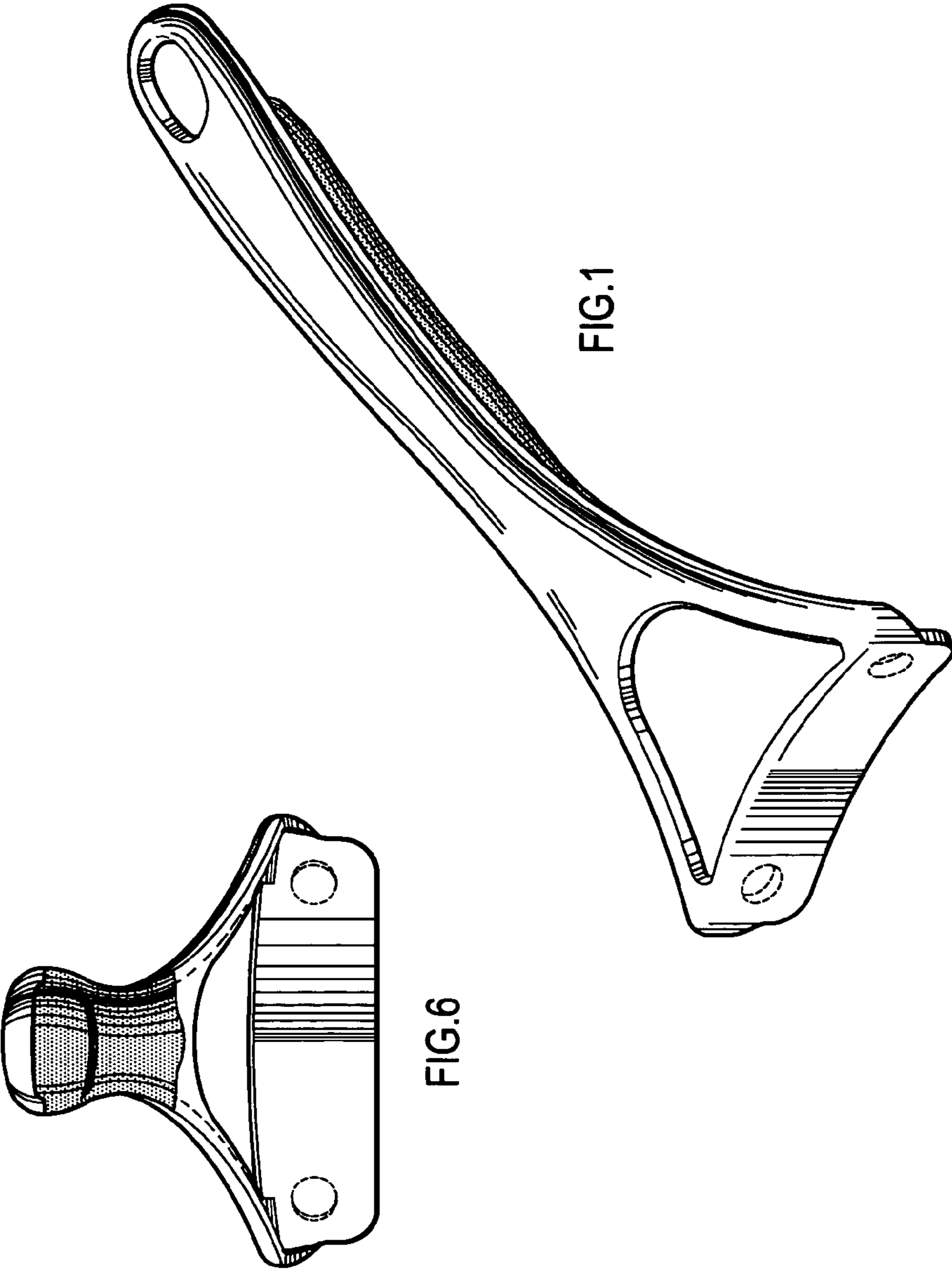

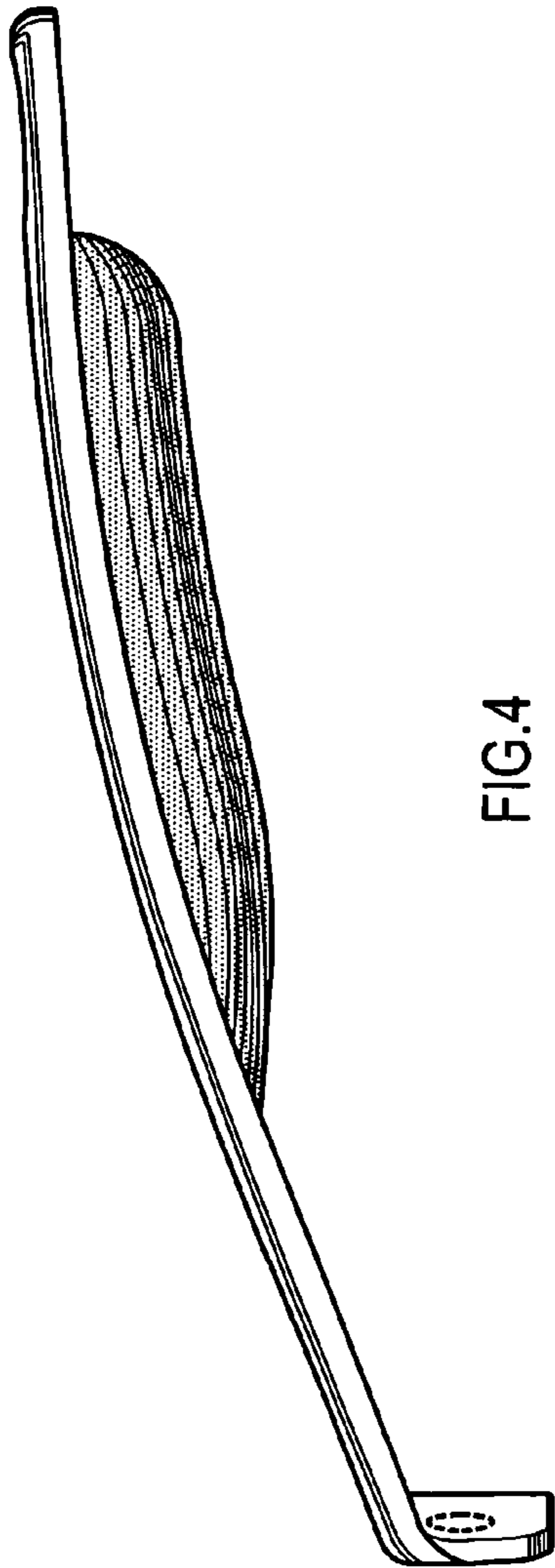

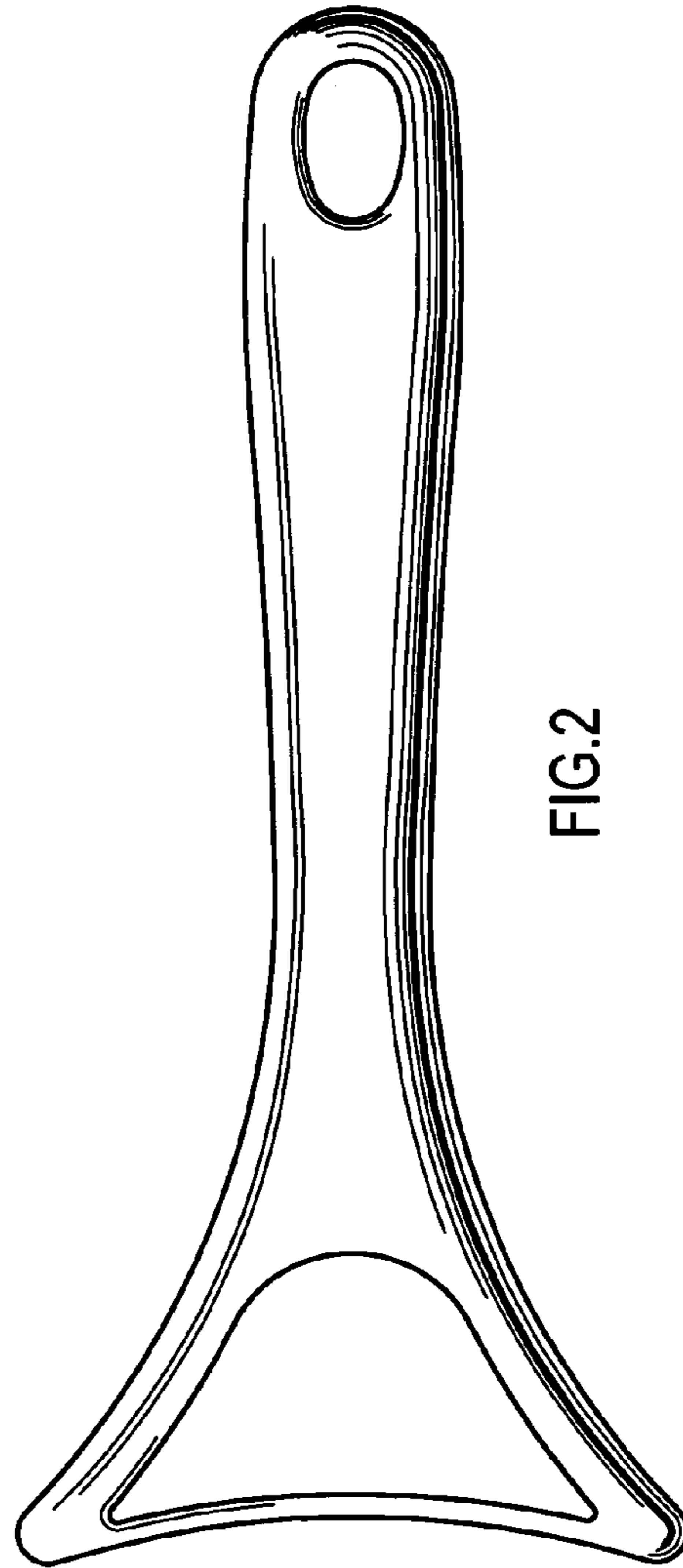

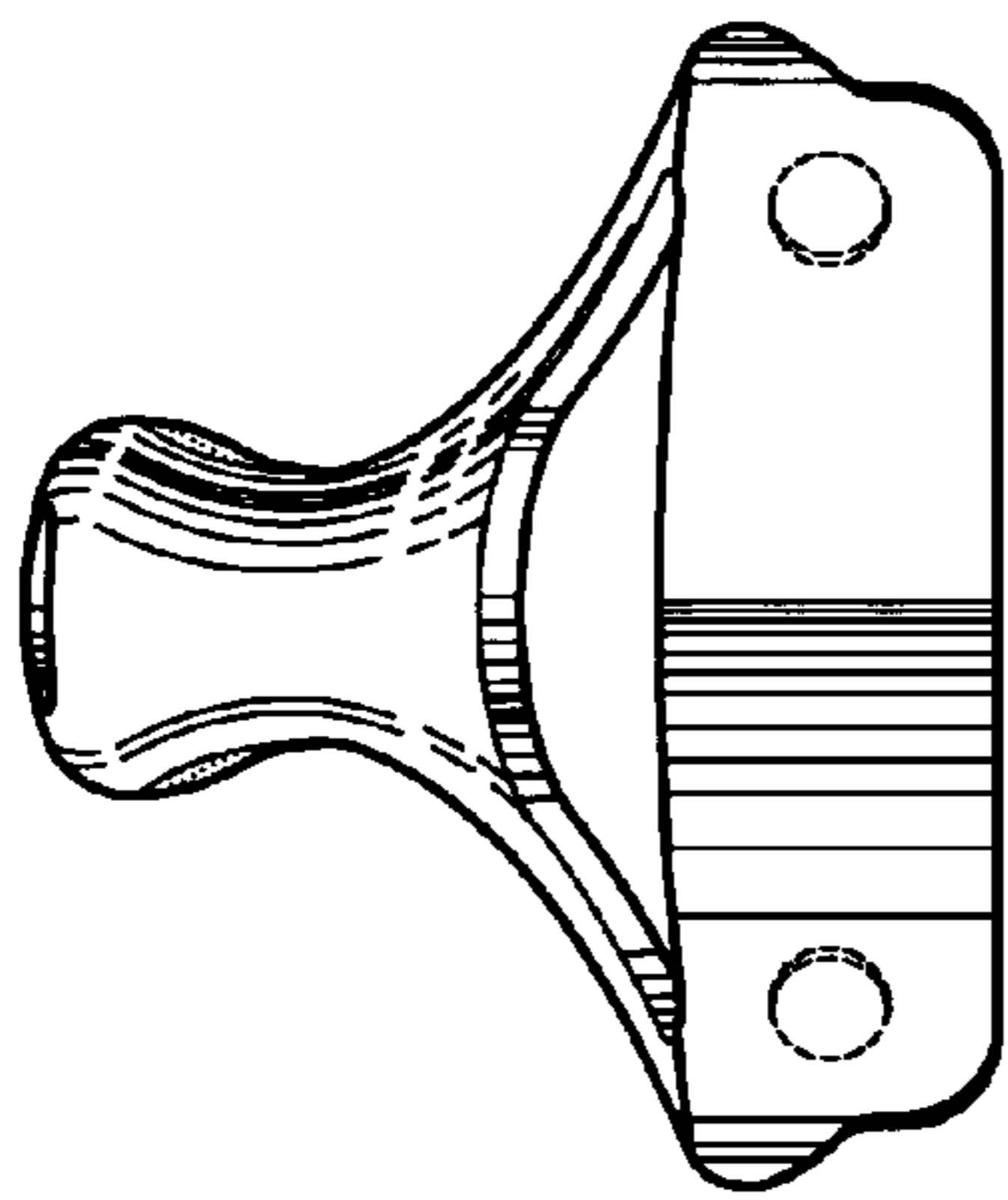

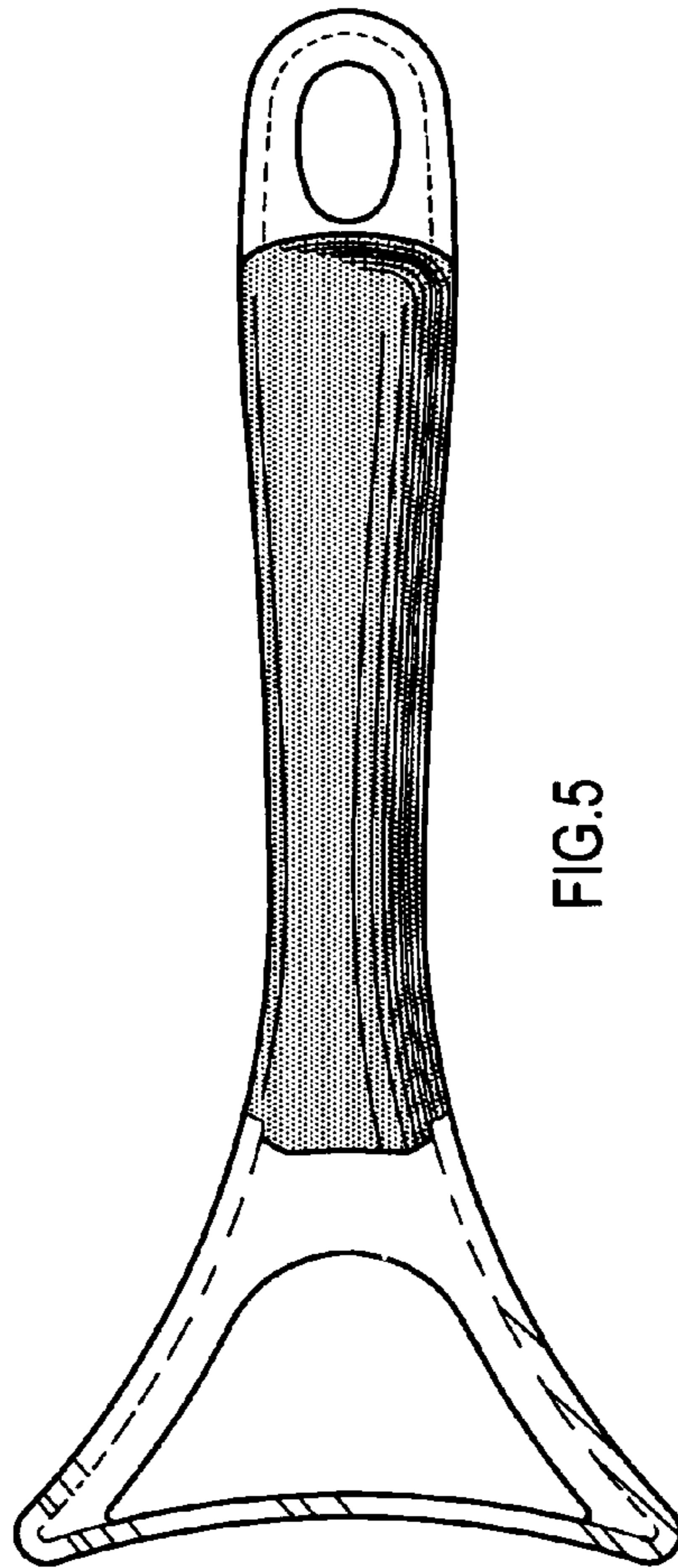
