FIG. 1 is a isometric view of a dry condiment dispenser showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side being a mirror image.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation being a mirror image.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a isometric view of a dry condiment dispenser showing an alternate embodiment of our new design.

FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side being a mirror image.

FIG. 8 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation being a mirror image.

FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof.

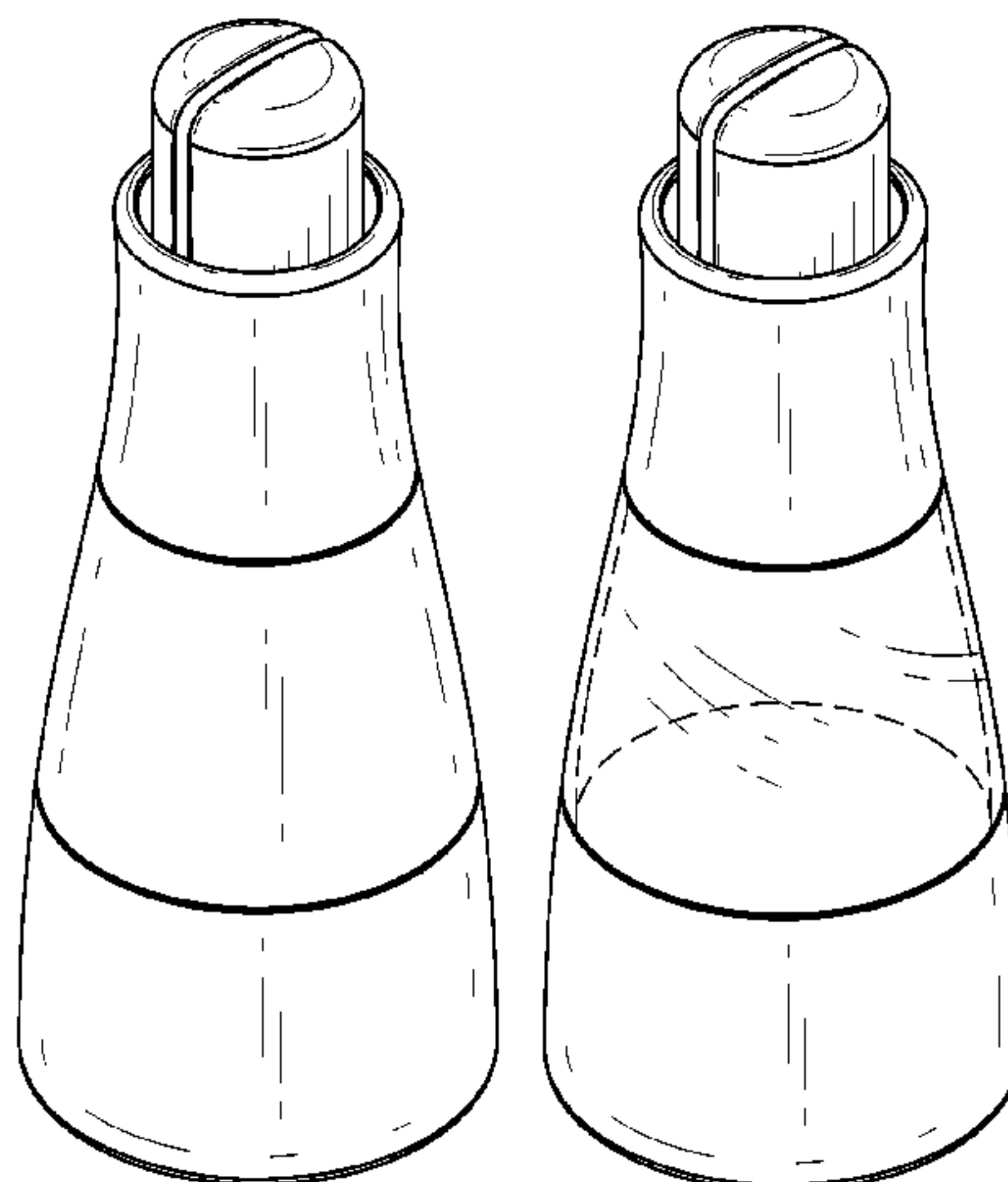

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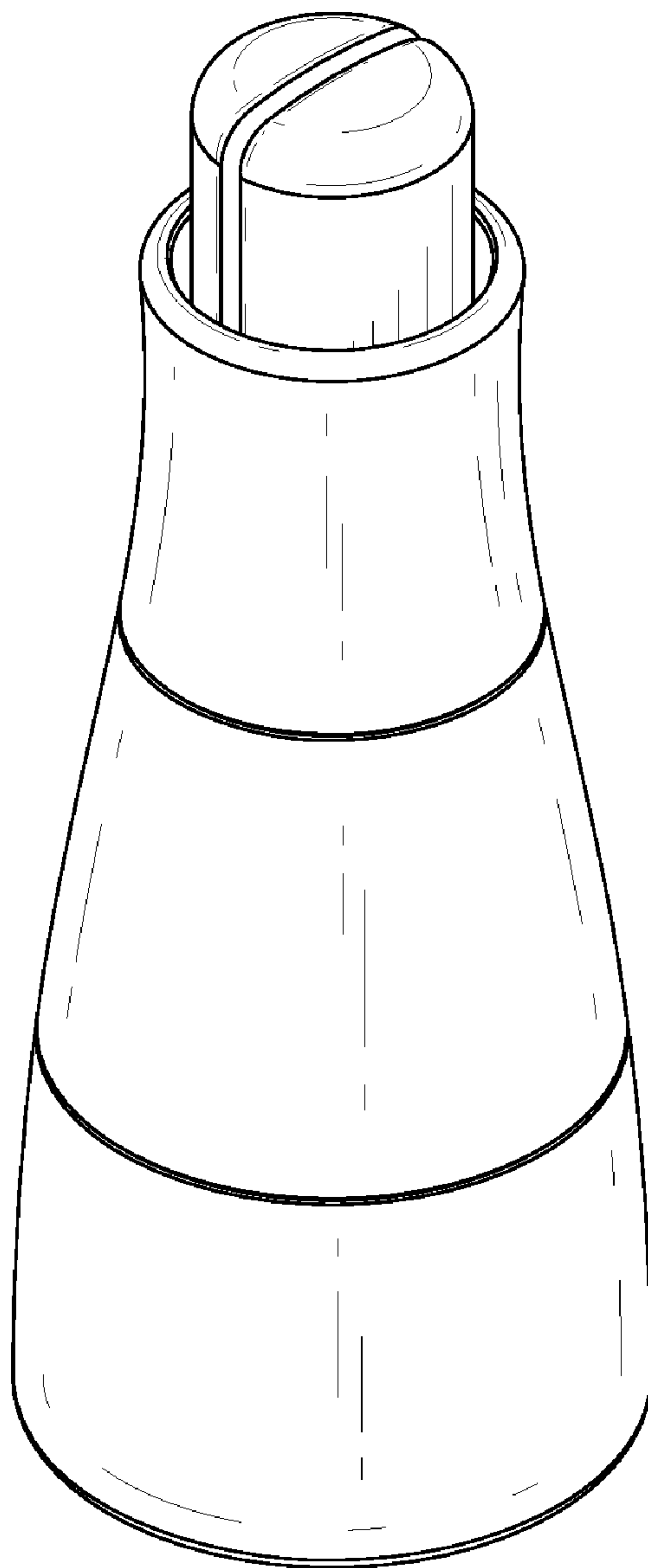

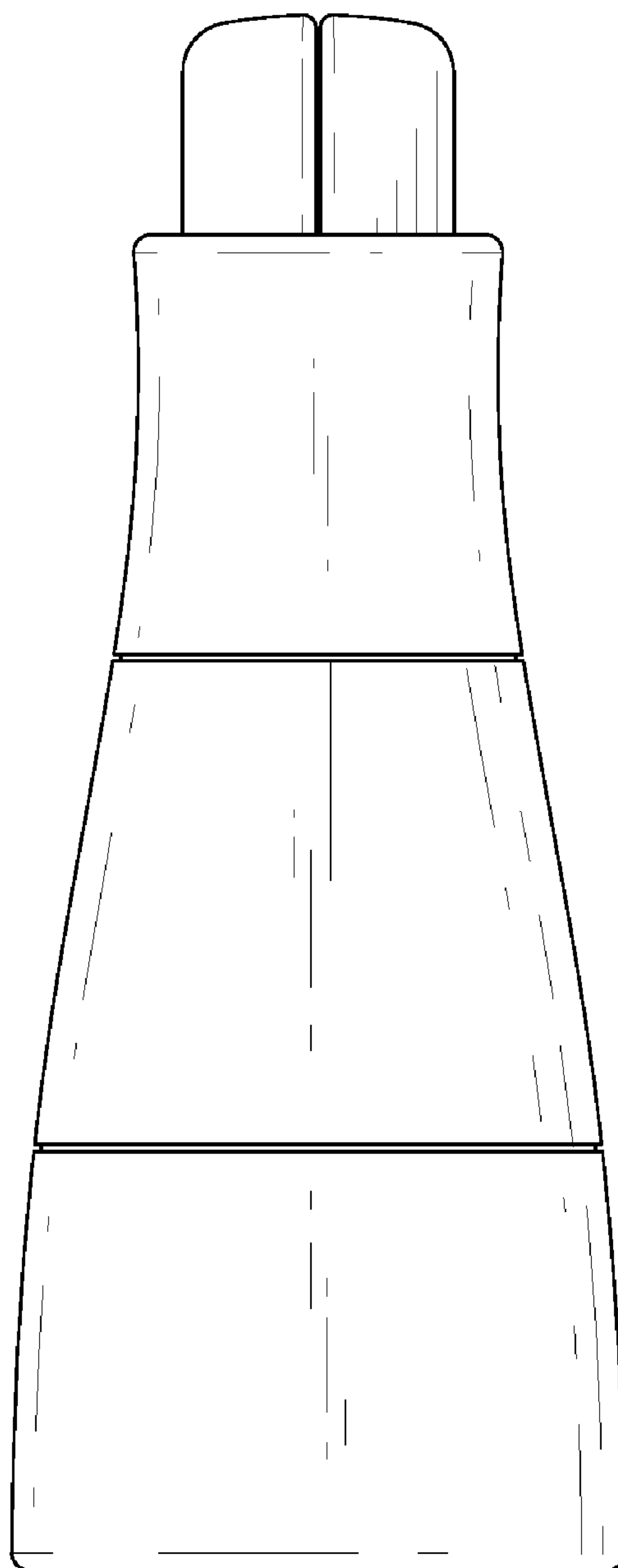

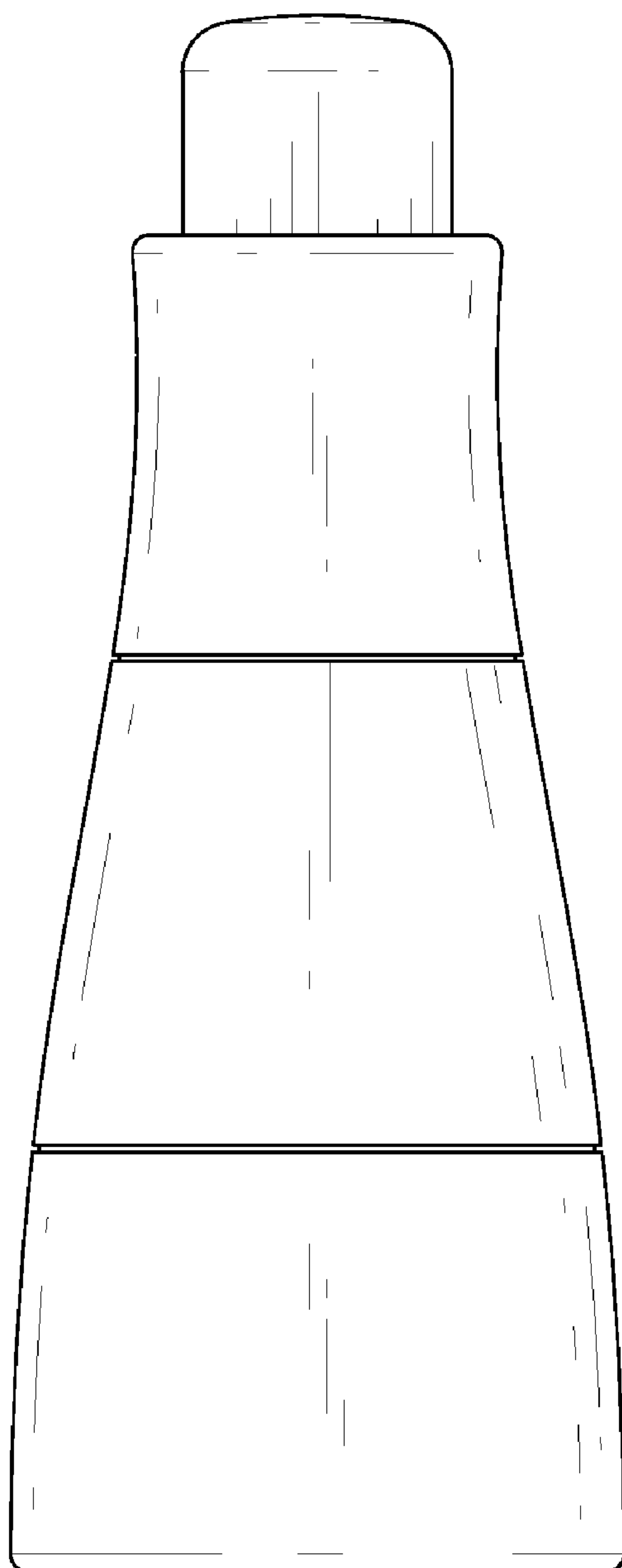

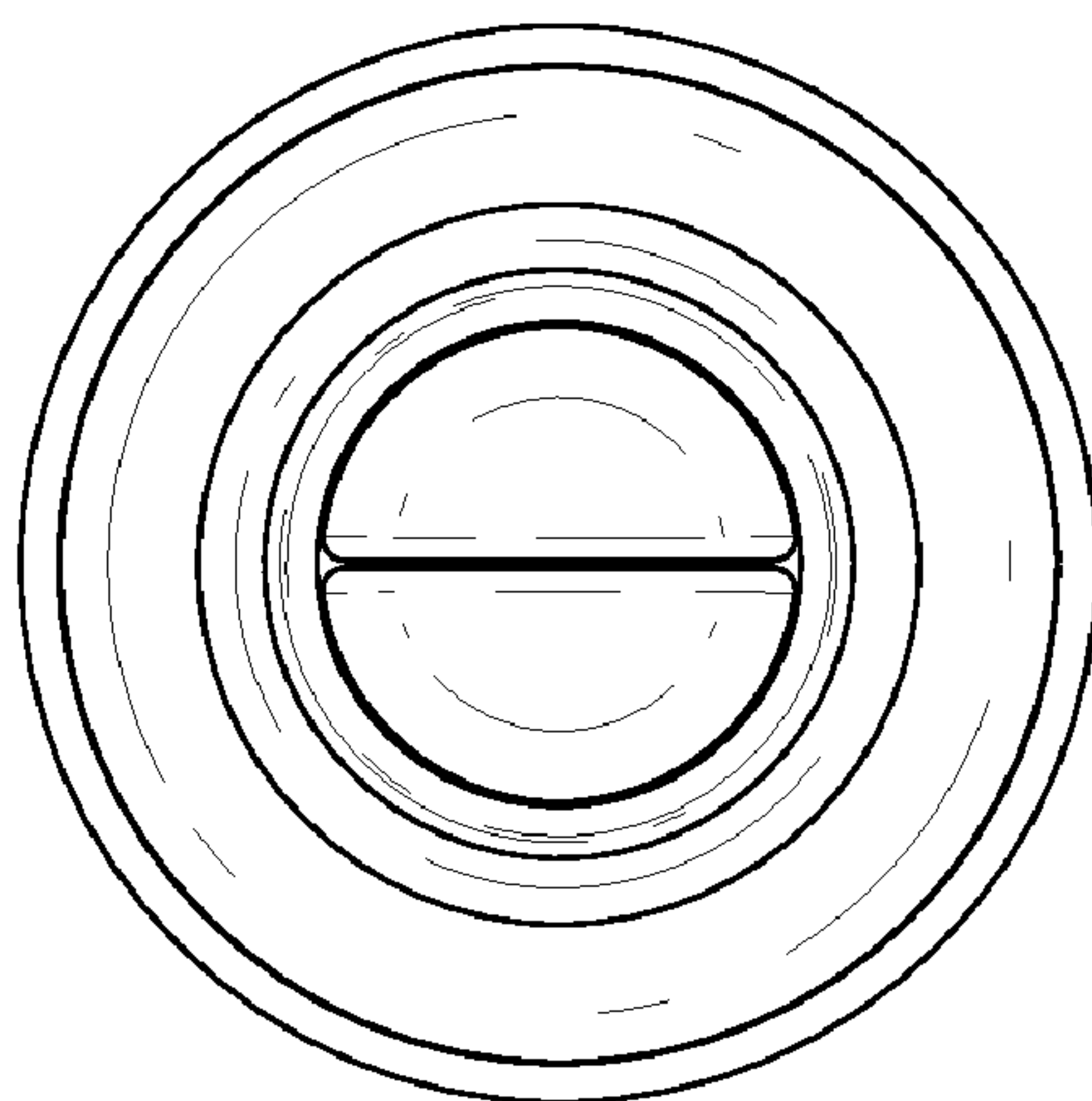

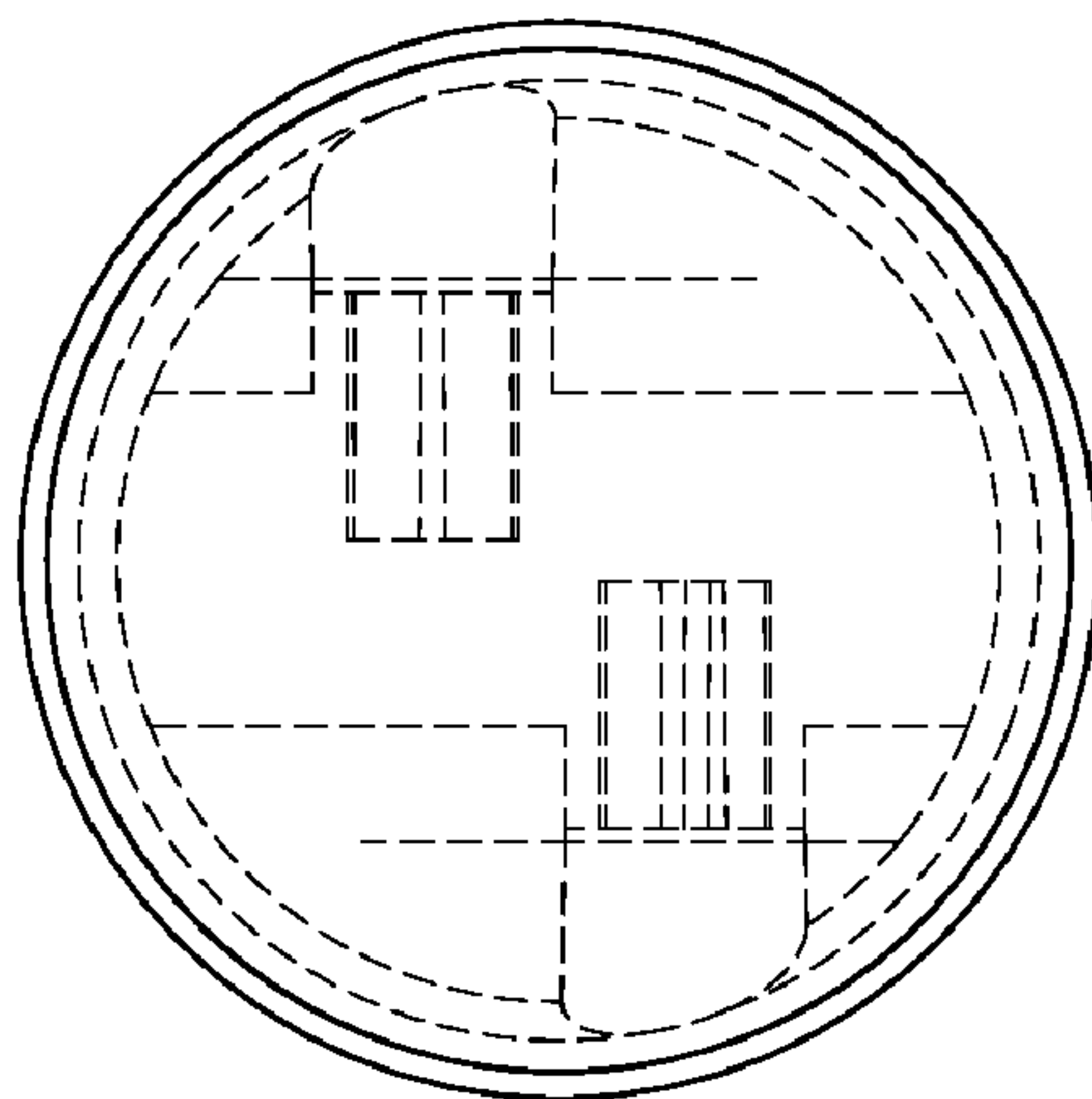

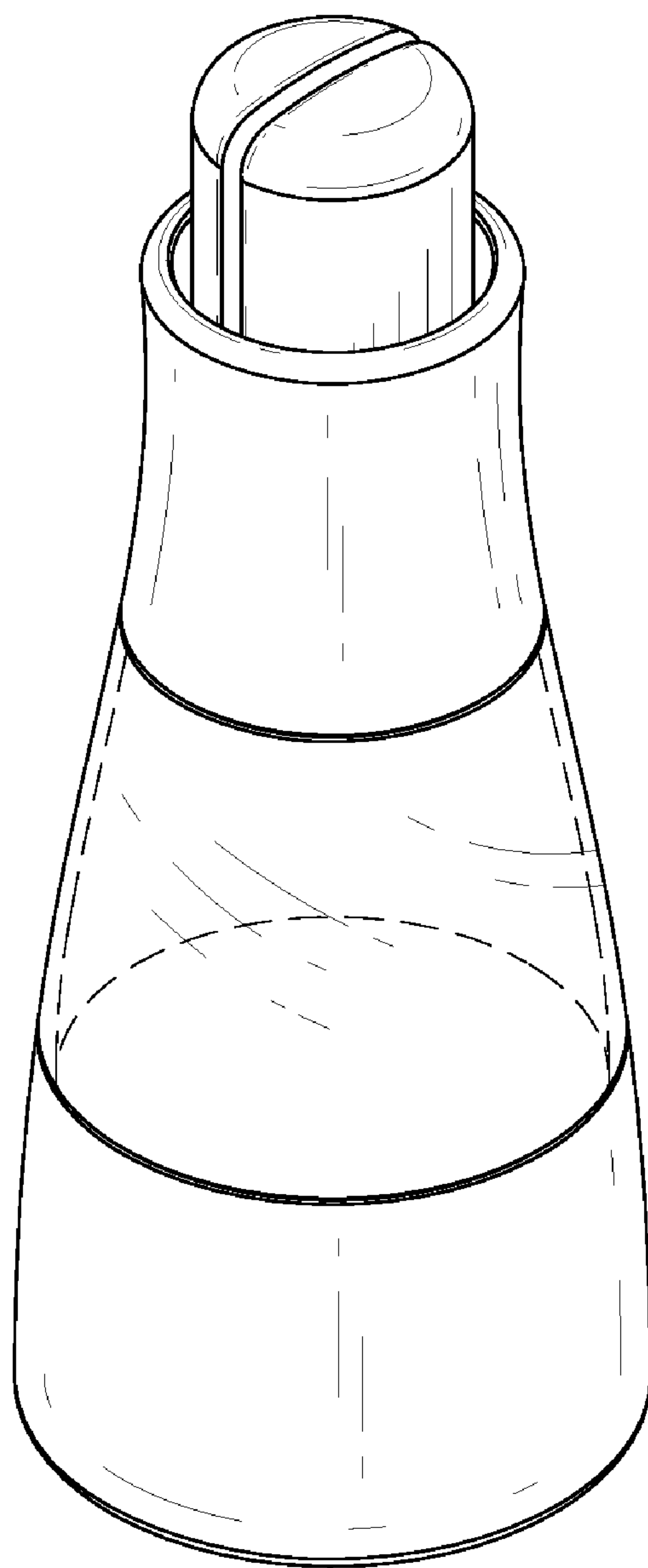

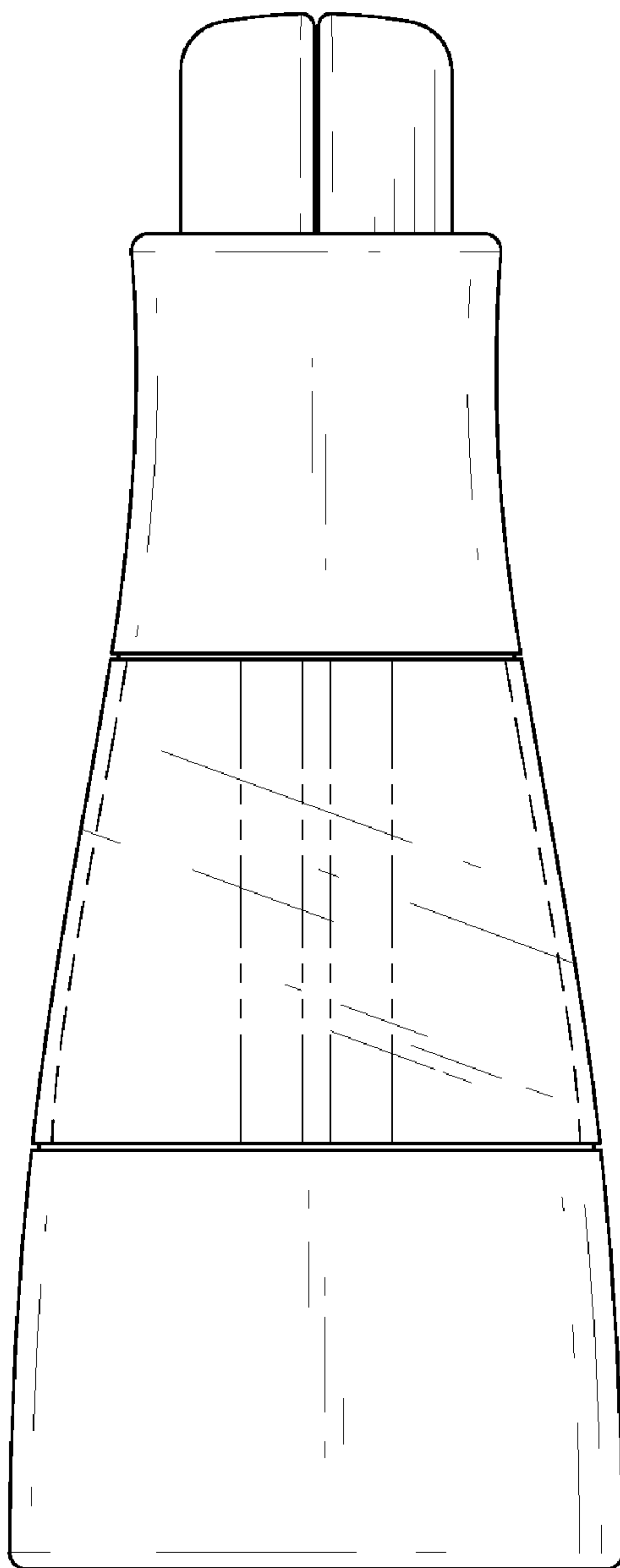

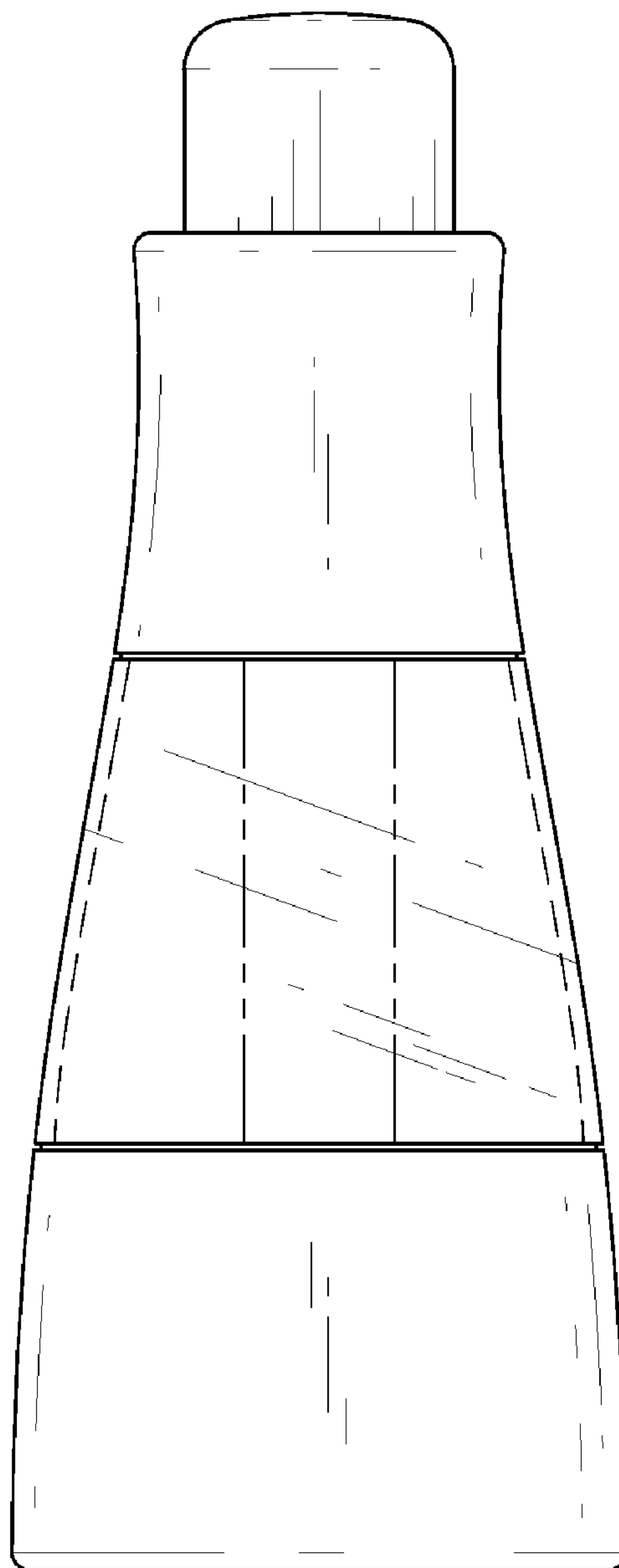

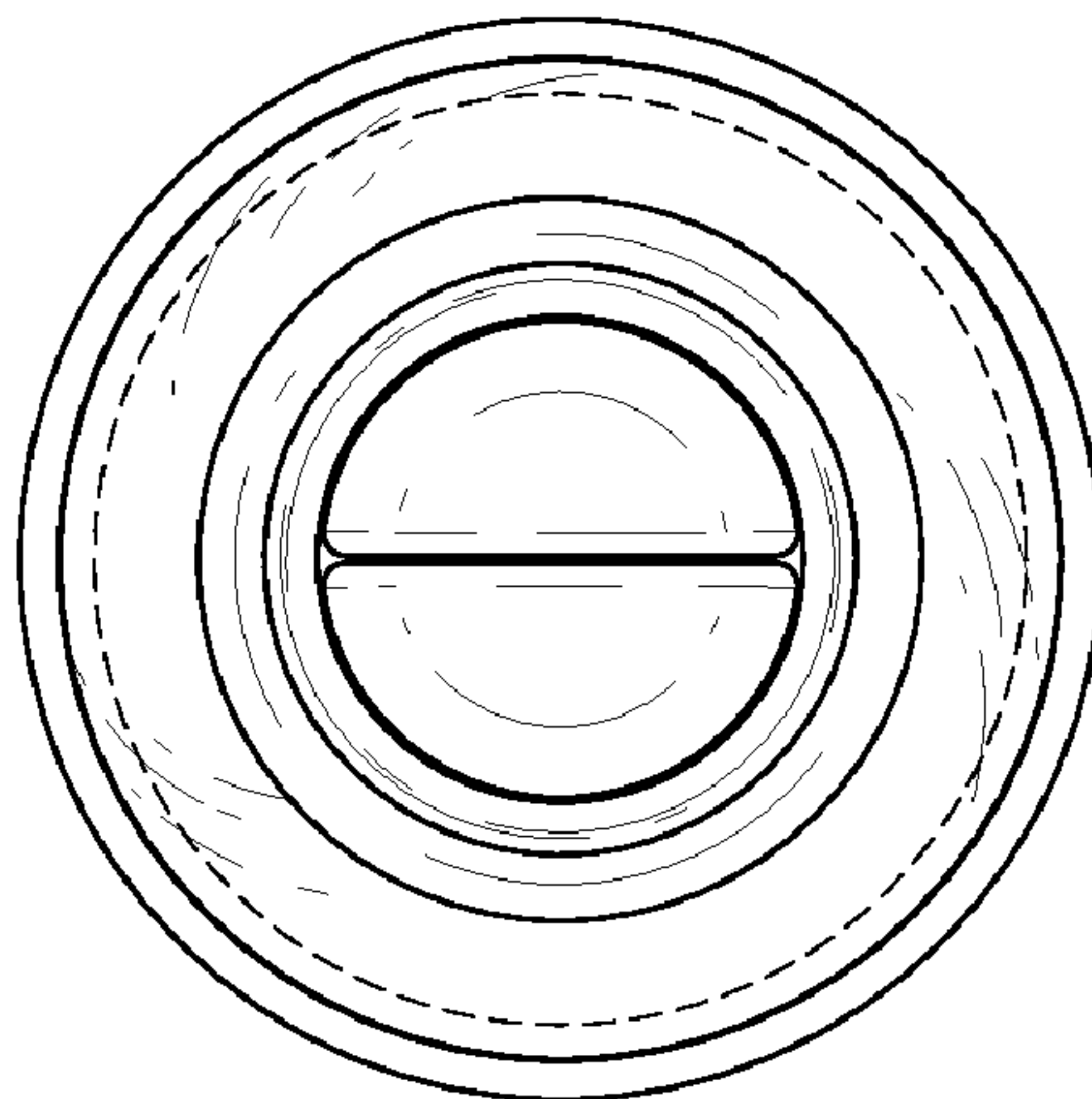

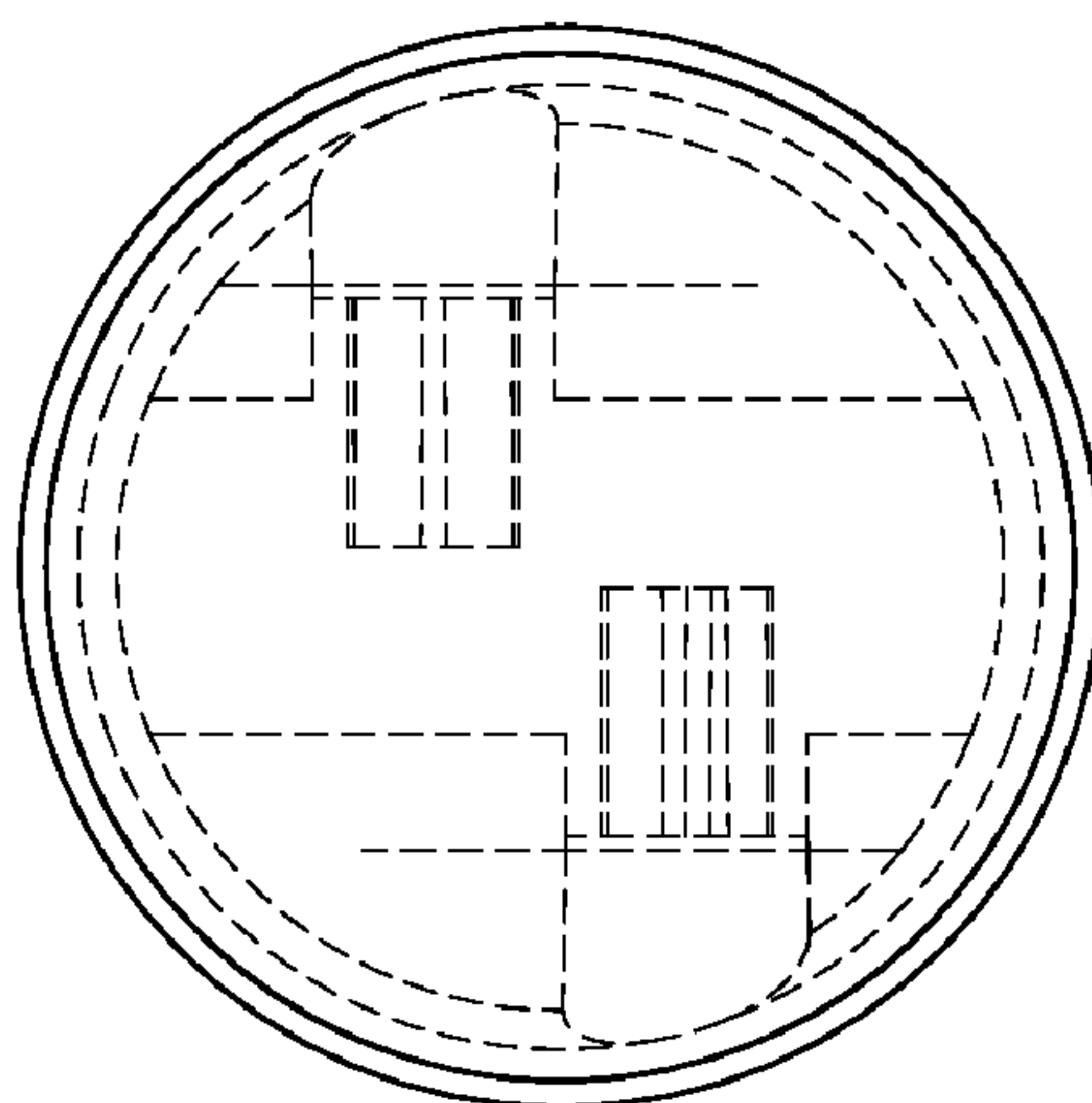
