The ornamental design for a thumb-mounted stylus, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a thumb-mounted stylus showing my new design in use;

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;

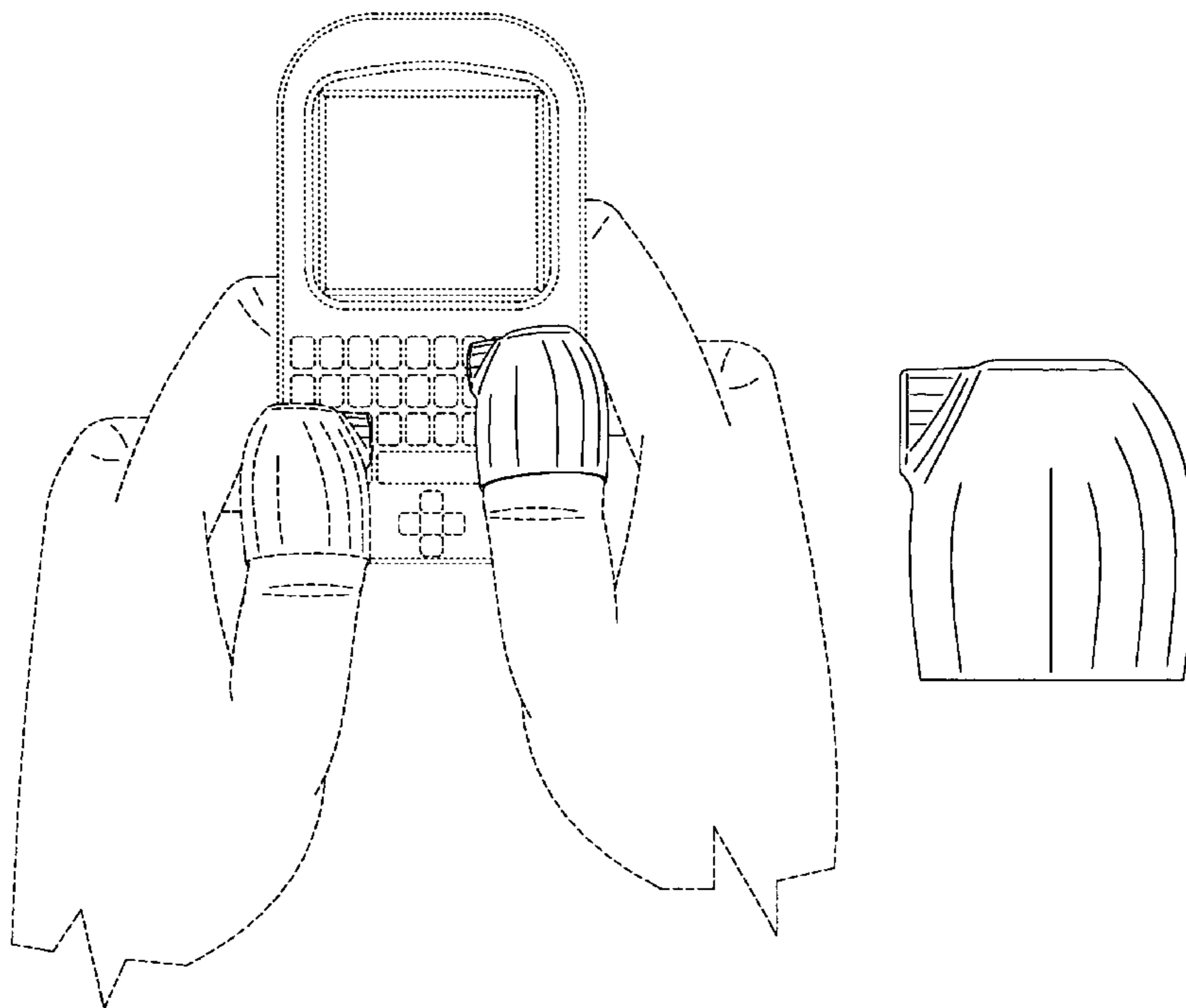
FIG. 5 is a back side view thereof;

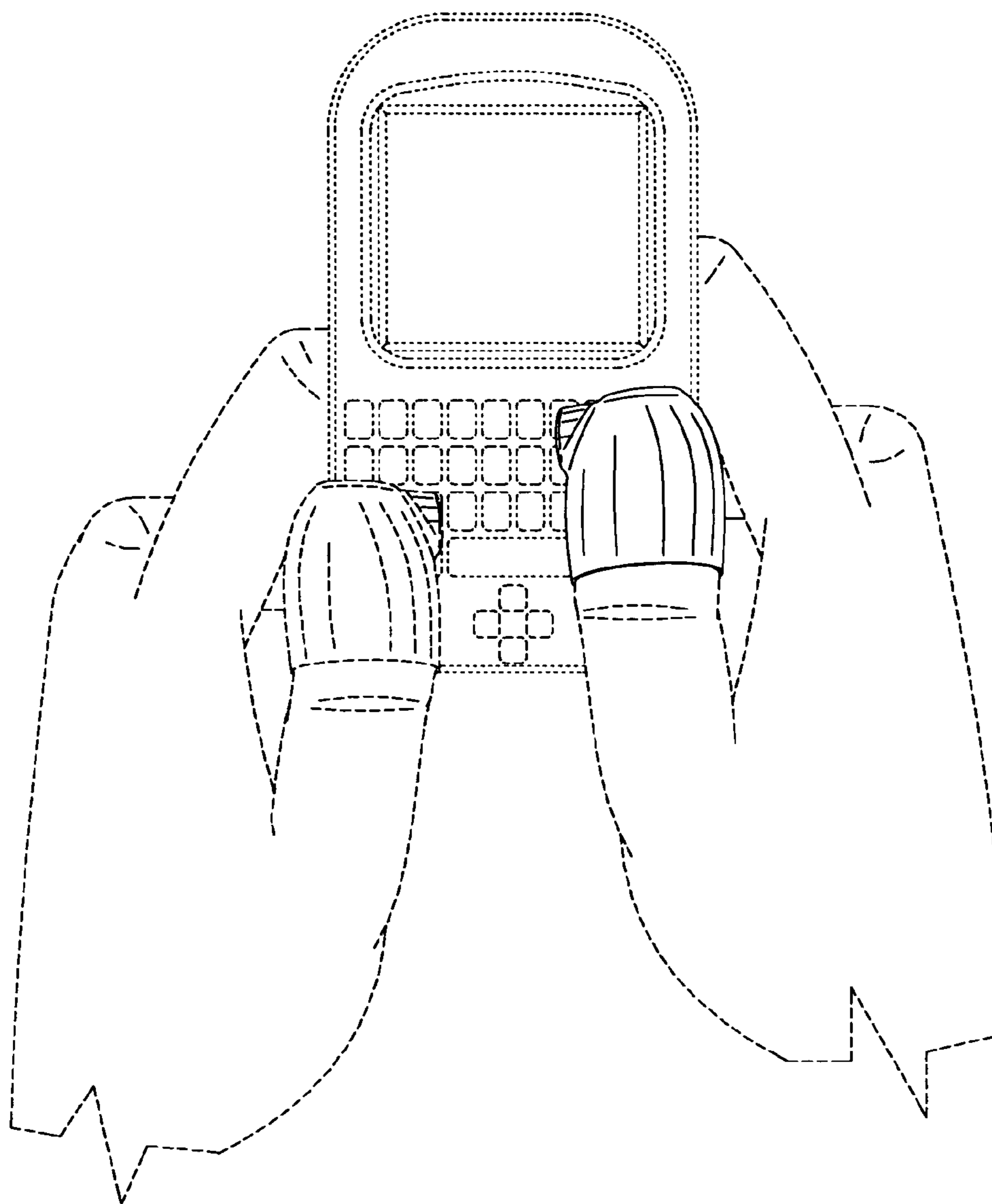

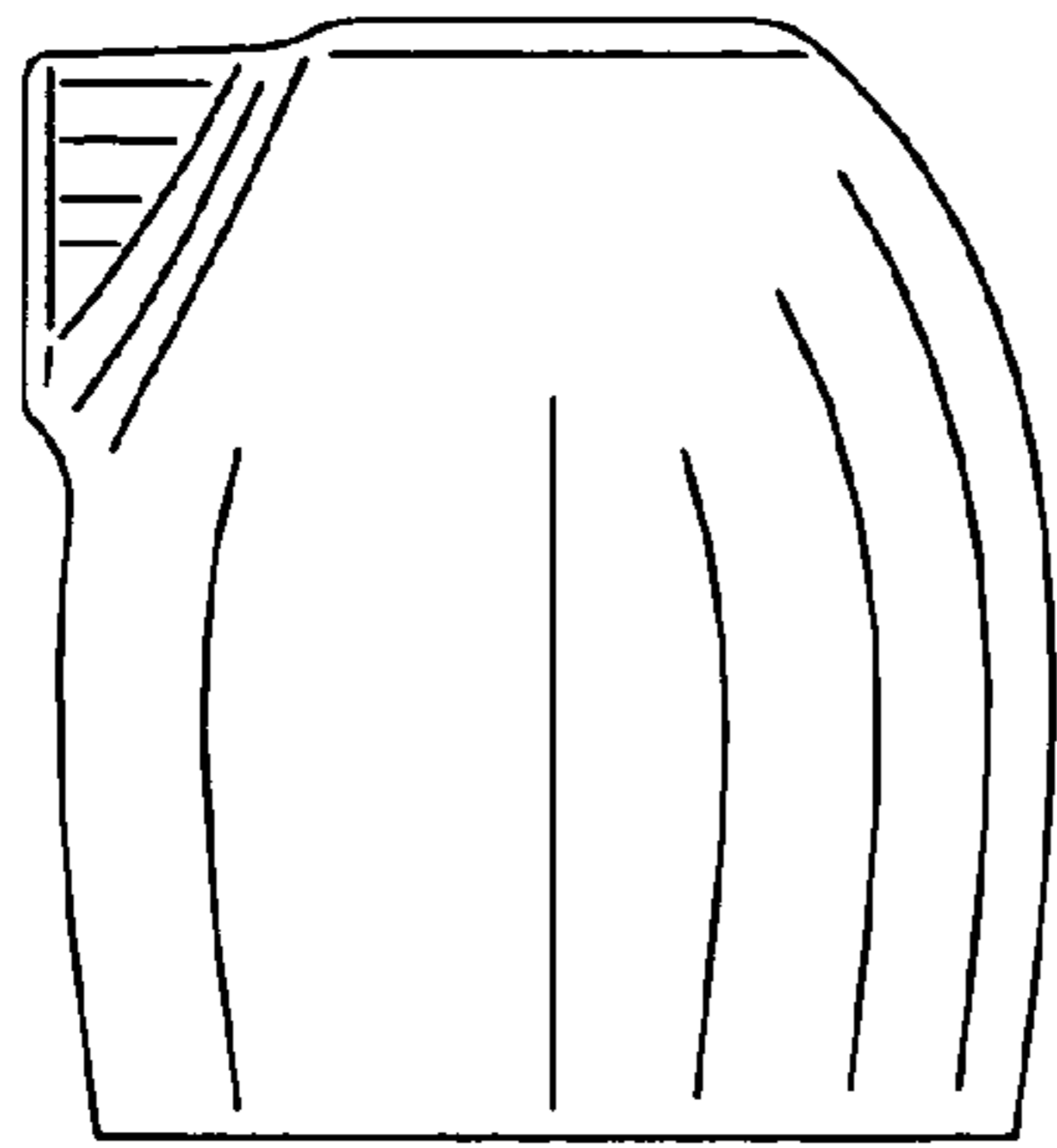

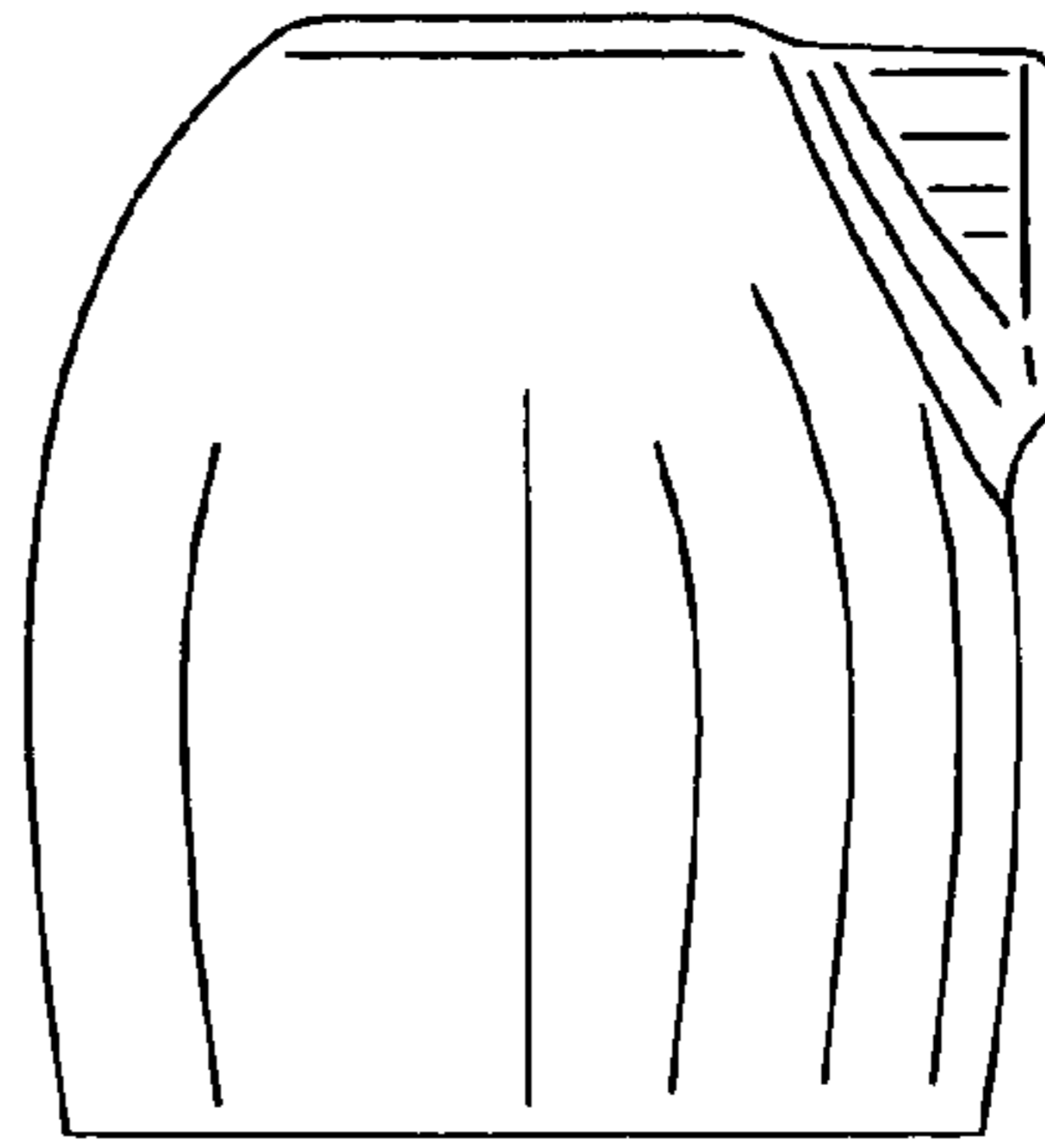

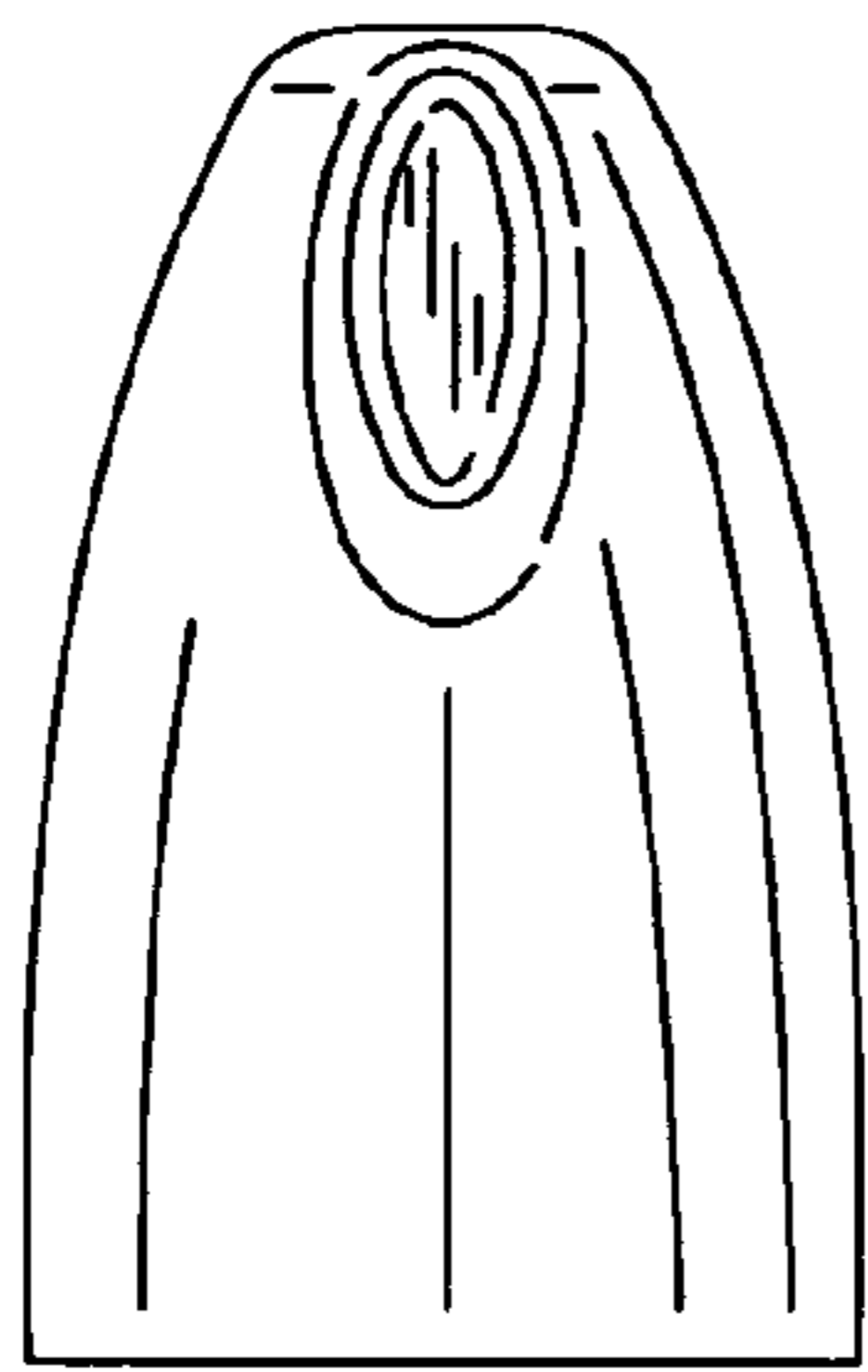

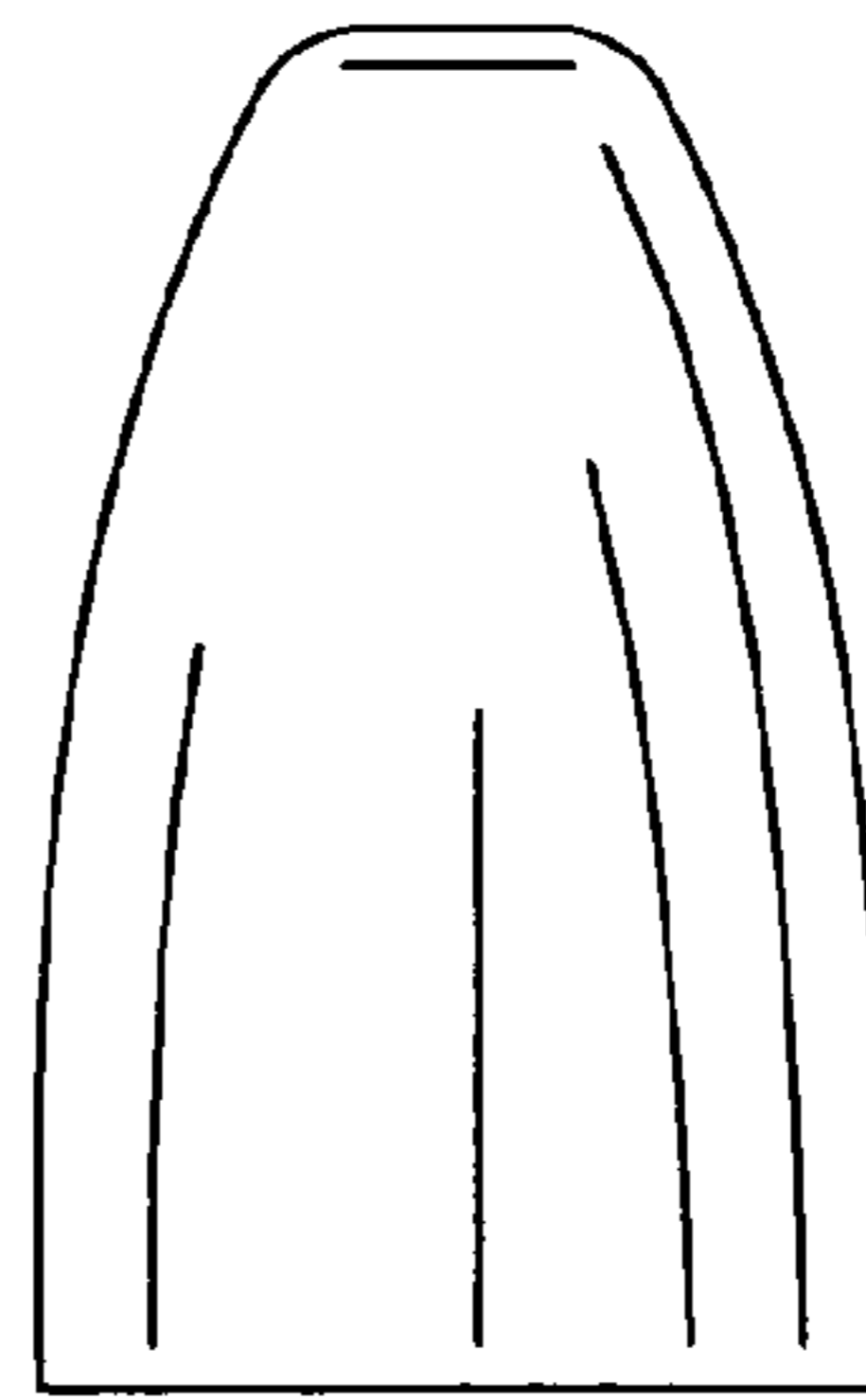

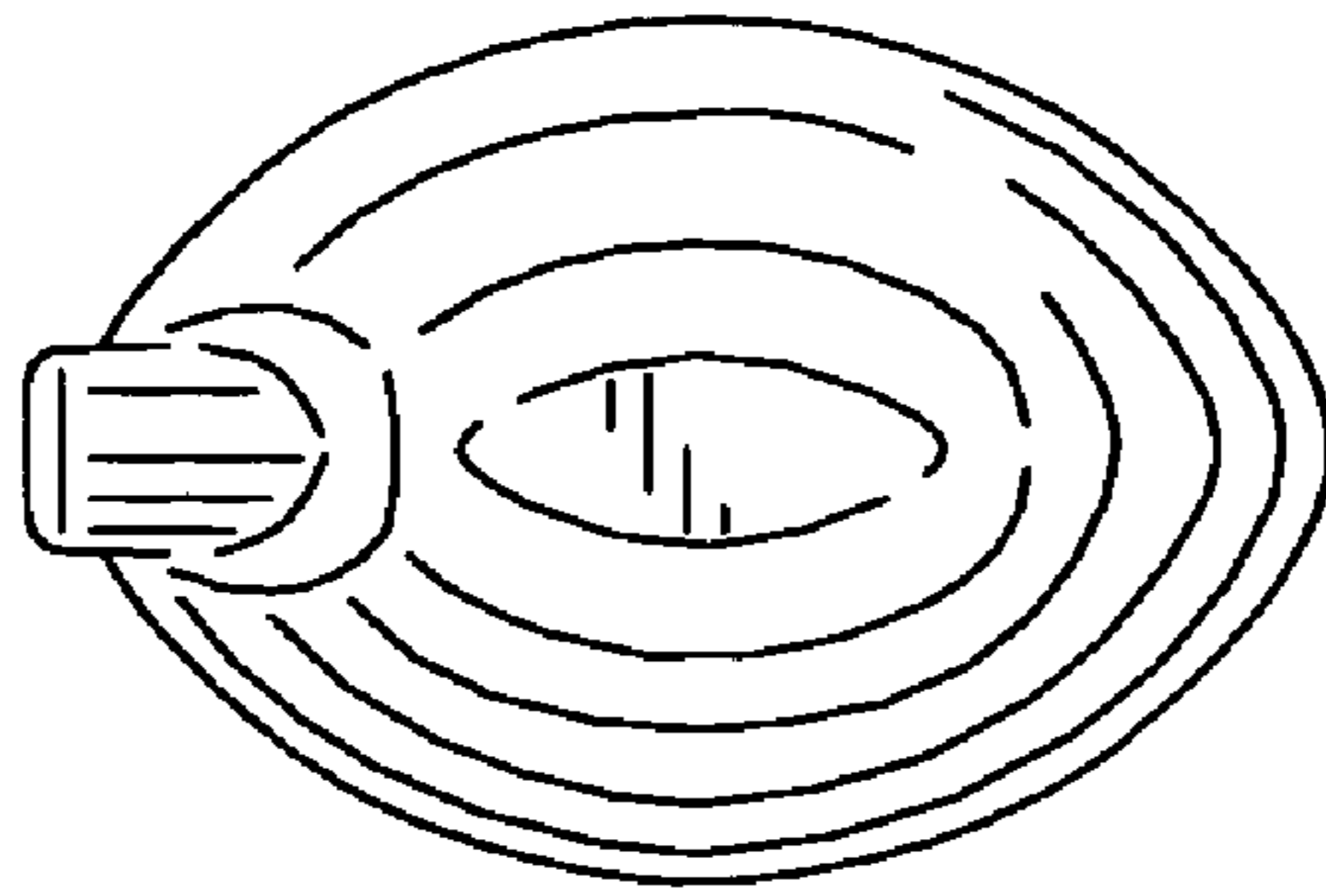

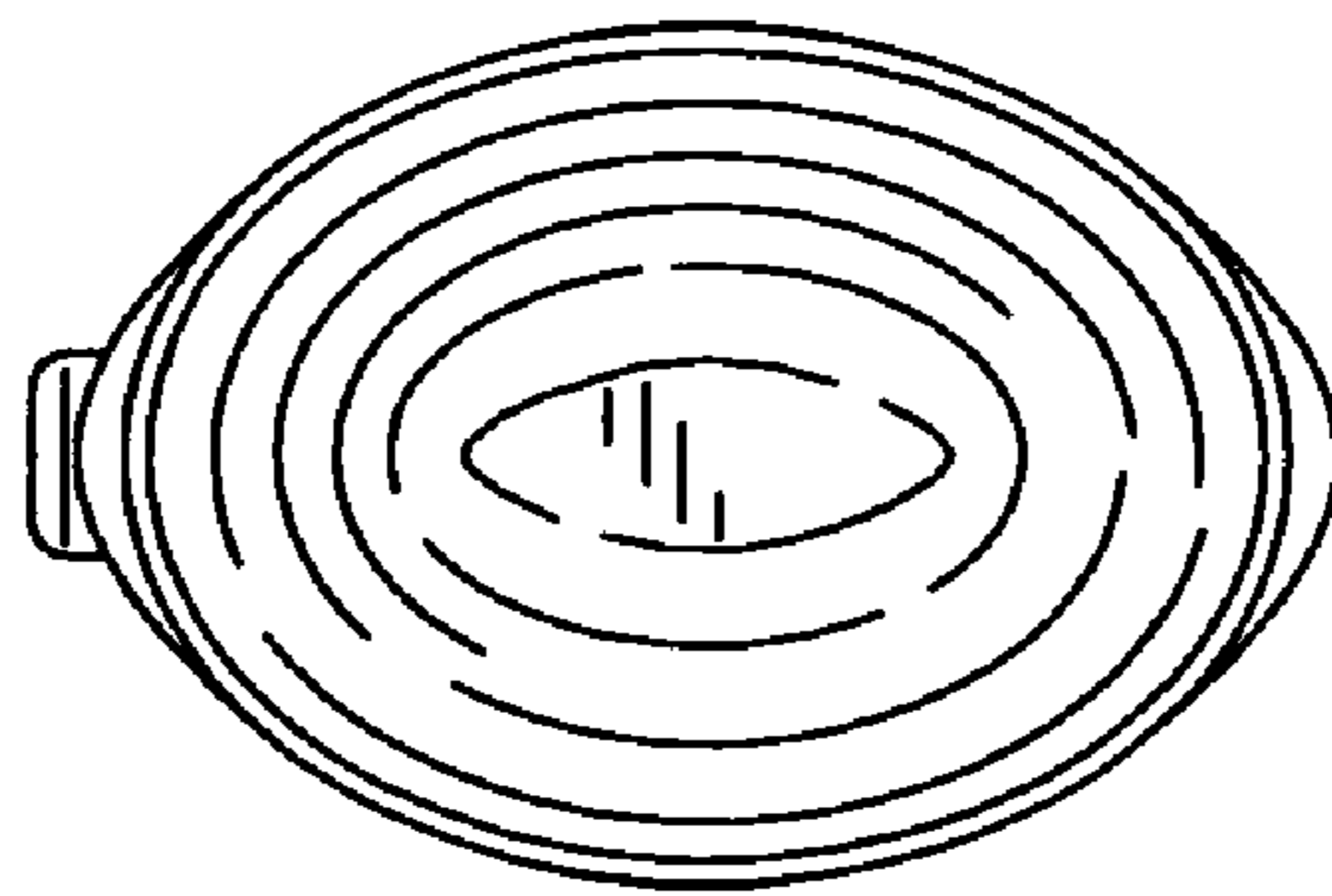
