FIG. 1 is a perspective view of two spectacle side-piece protectors, showing the manner of use thereof;

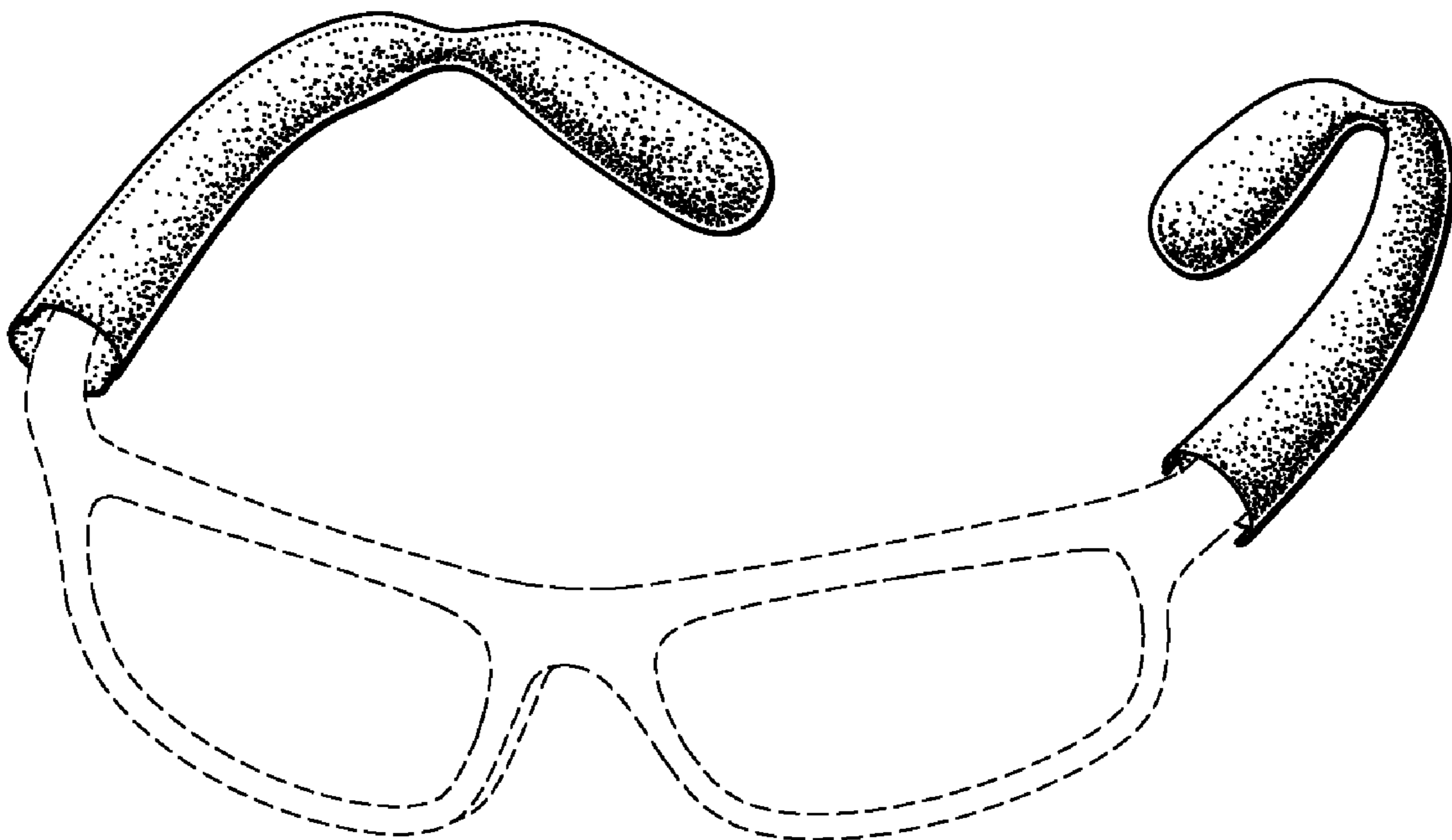
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a spectacle side-piece protector according to the invention;

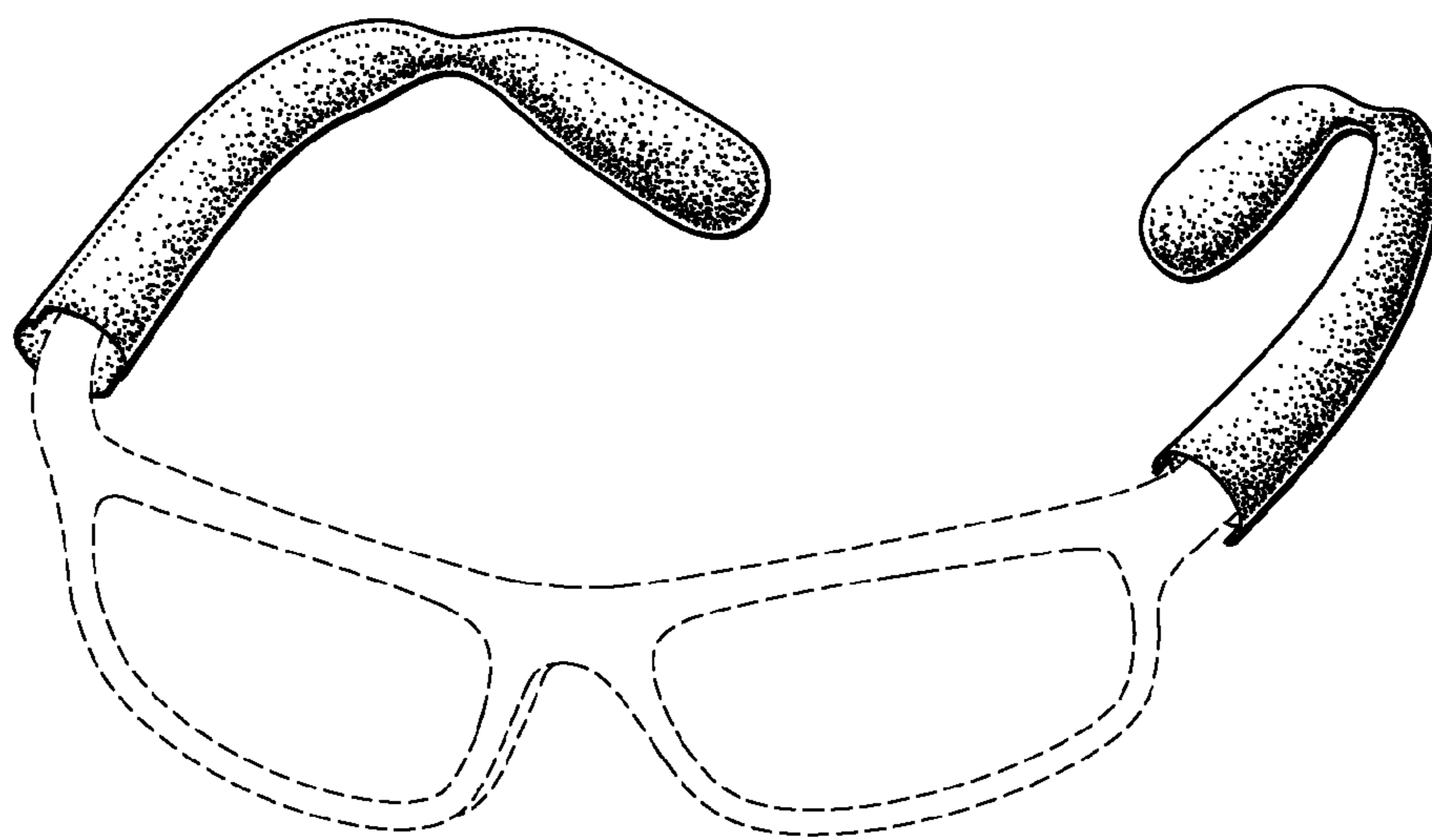
FIG. 3 is a plan view of one side thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a plan view of the opposite side thereof.

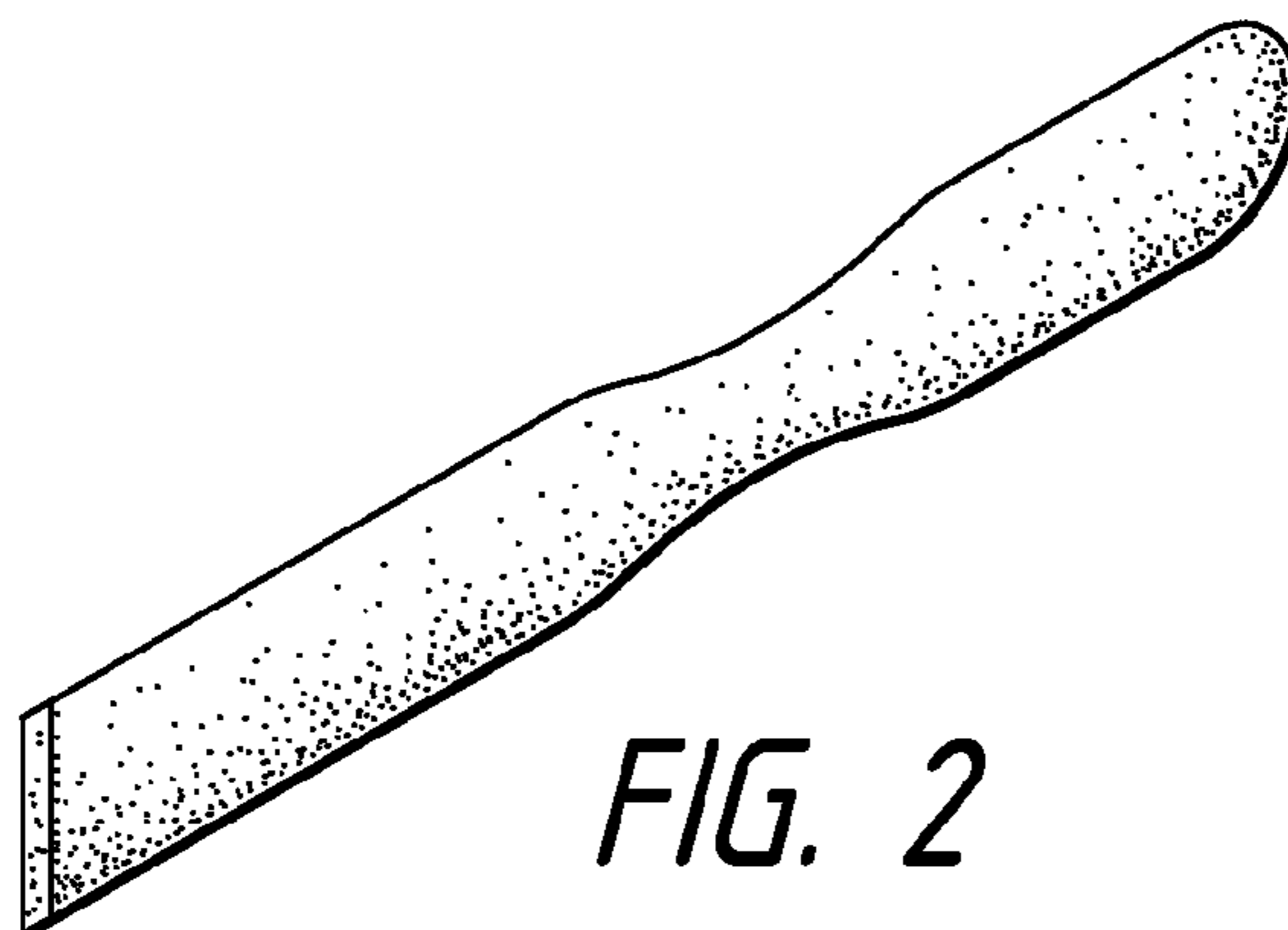
