of illustration.

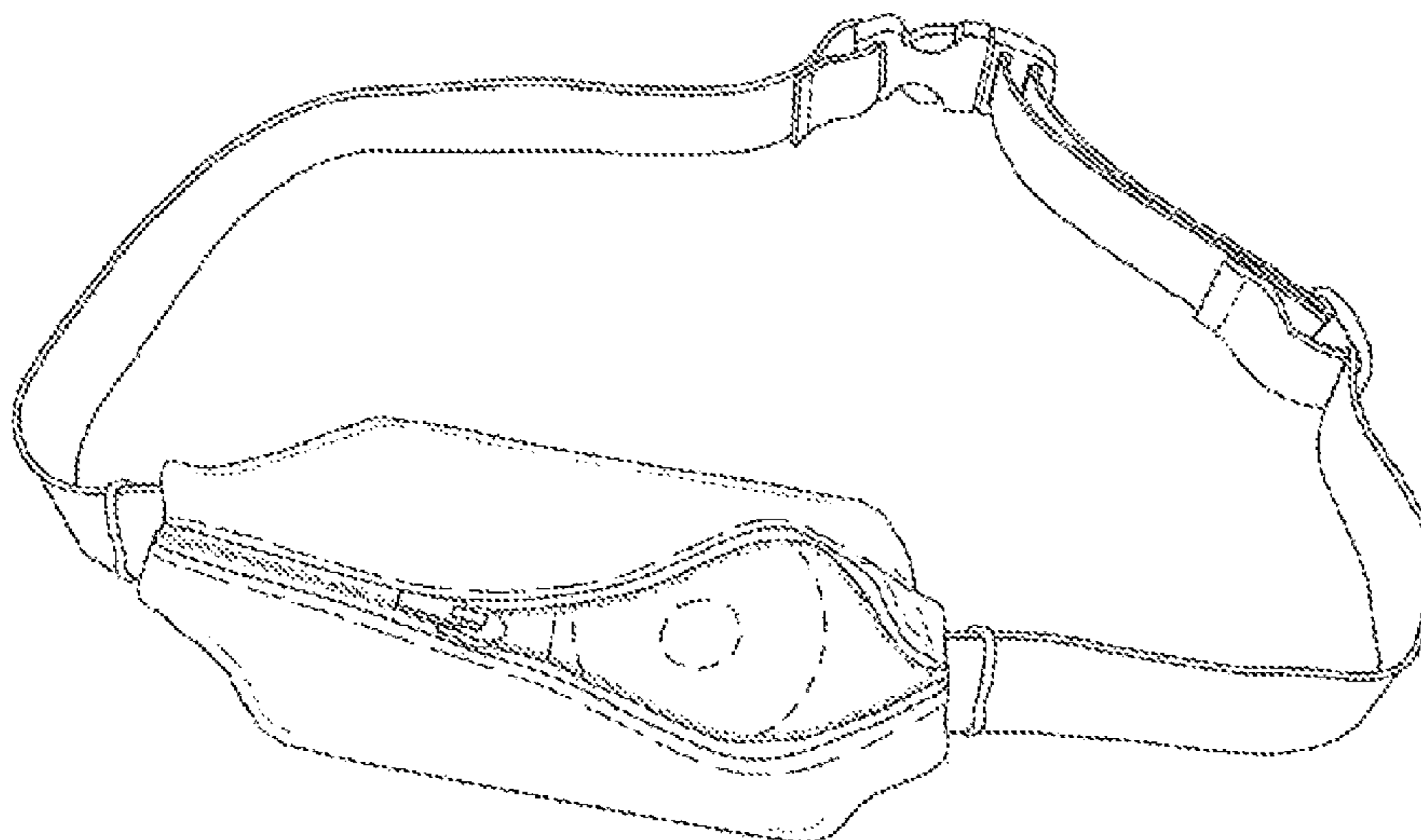
FIG. 4 is an isometric view showing the back, top and side of

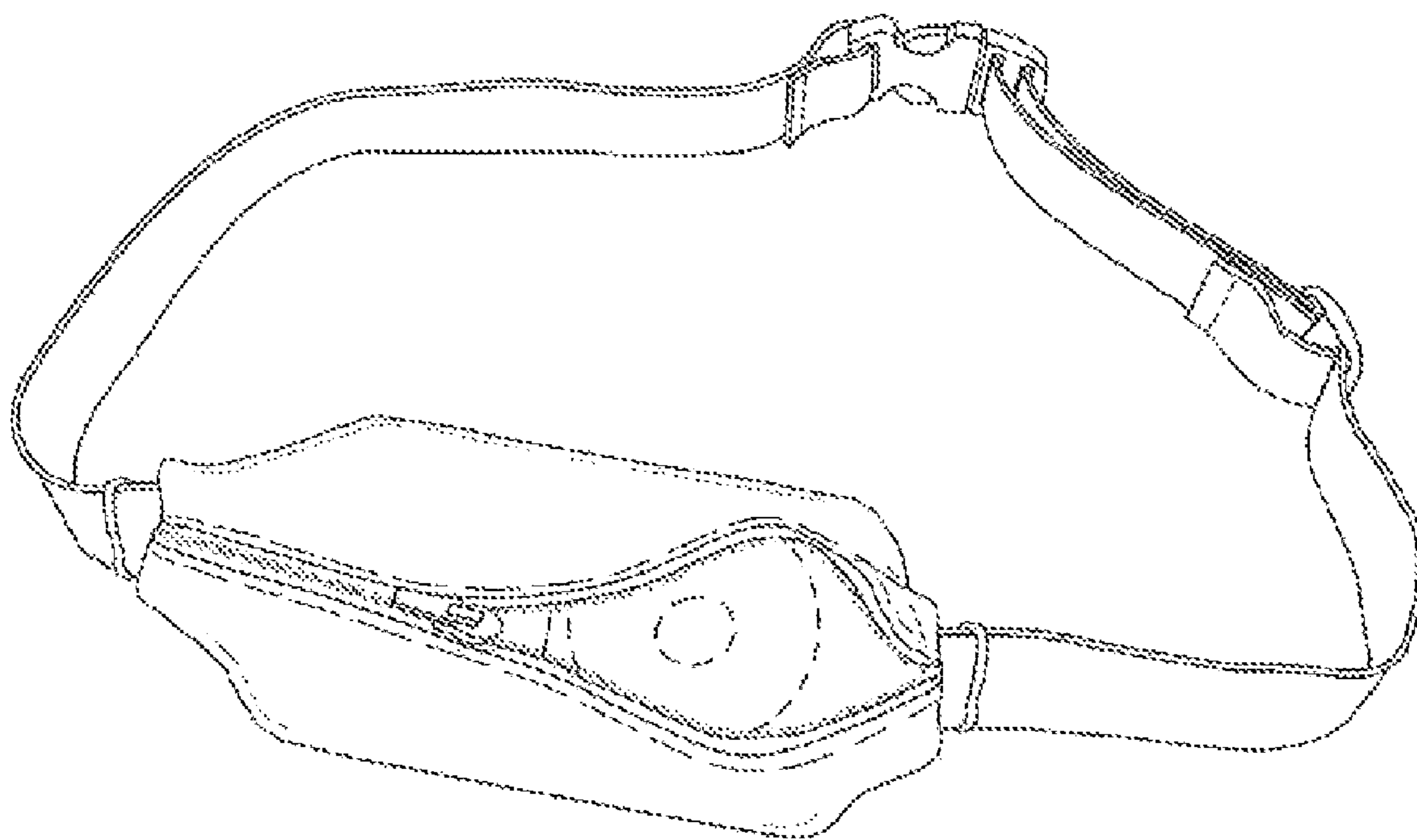

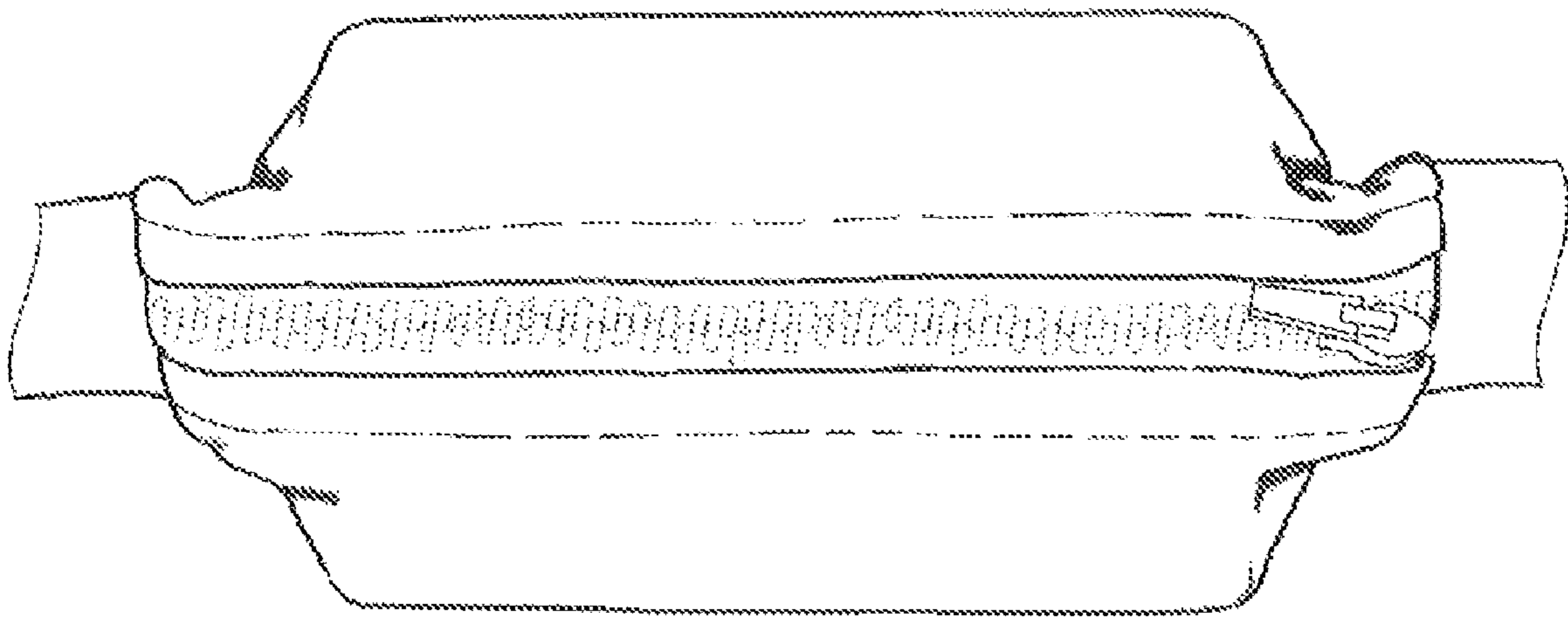

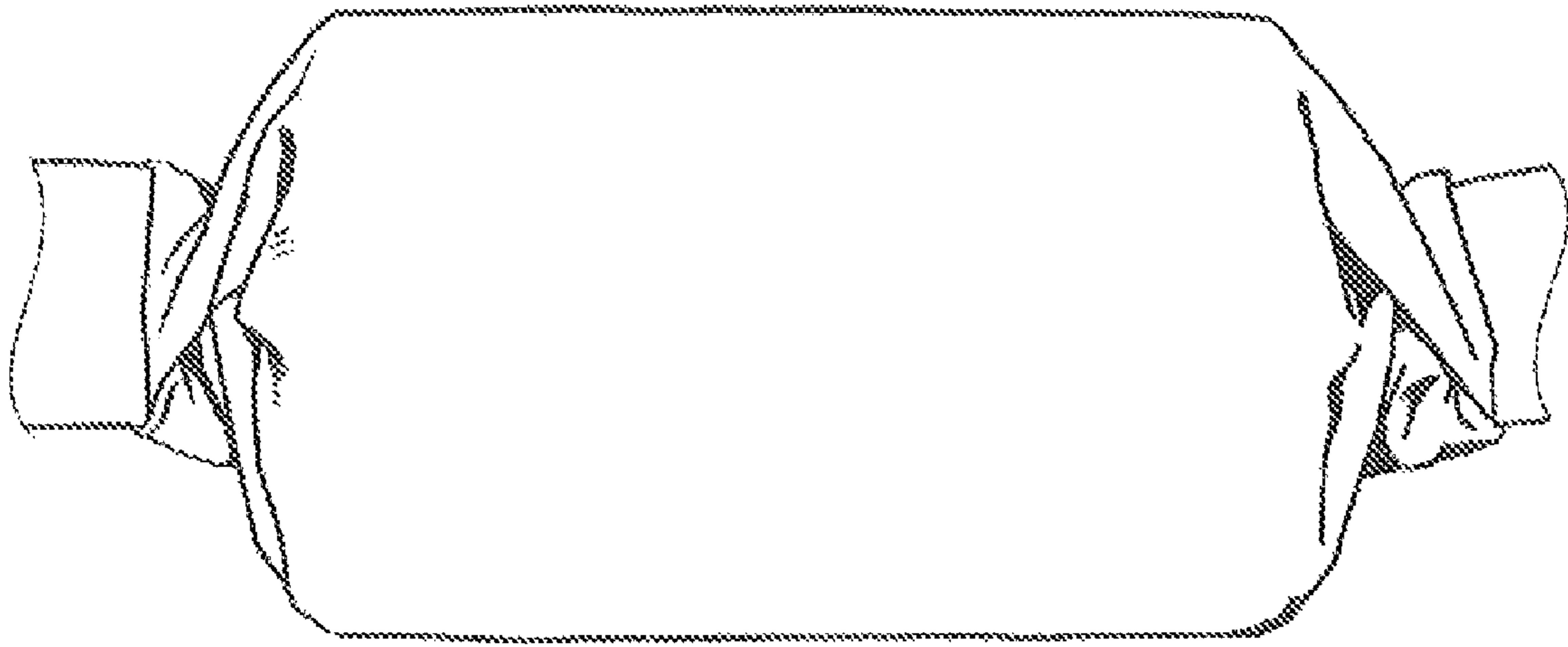

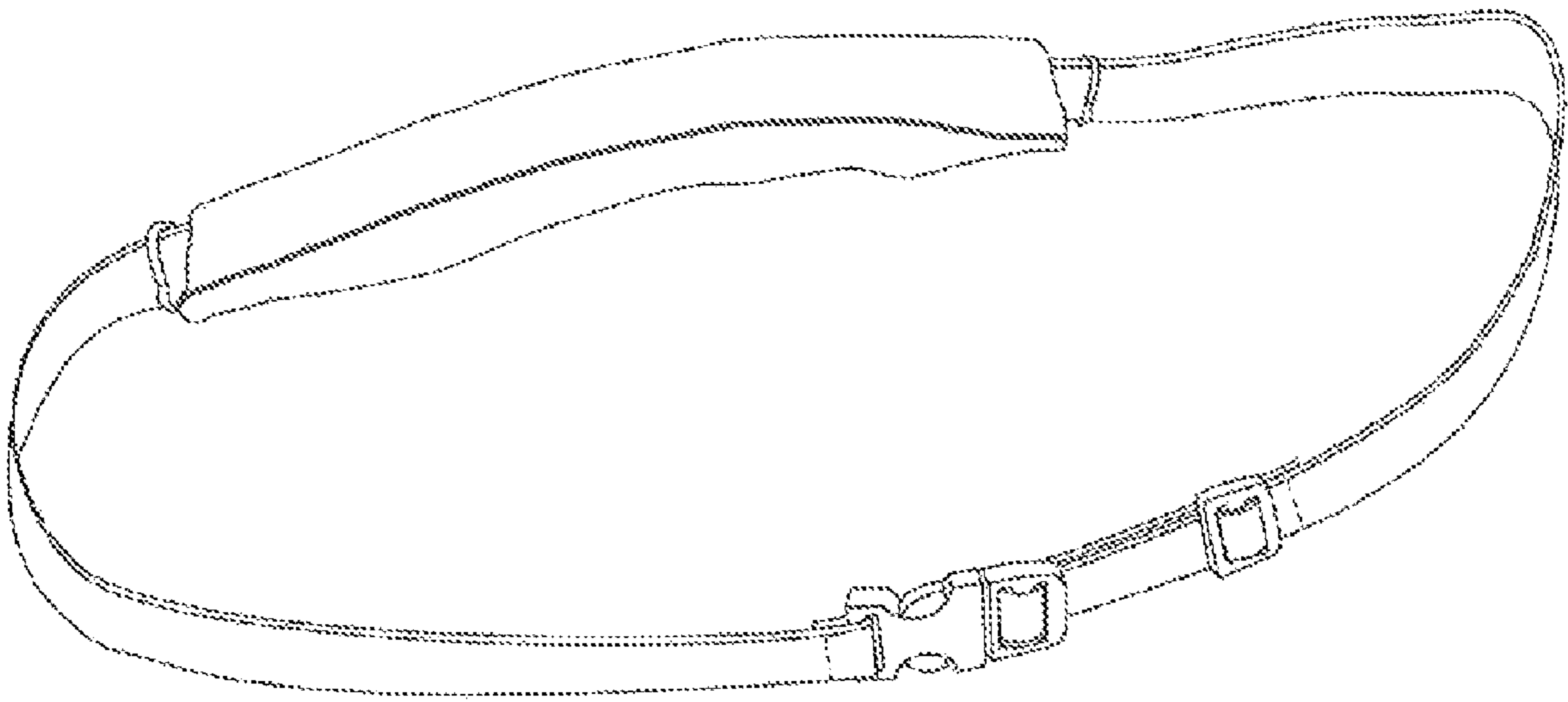

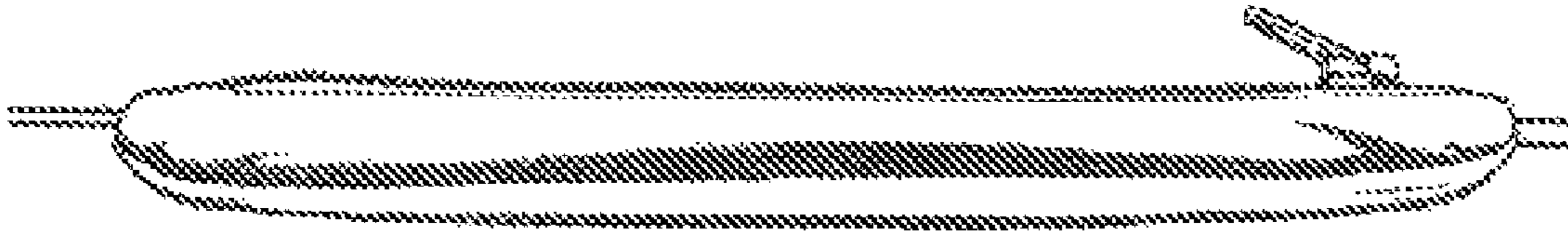

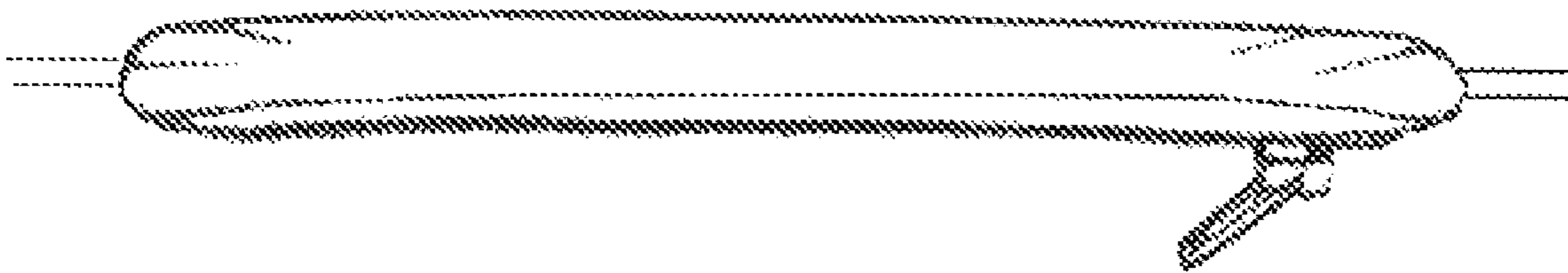
