FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof, the sides, top and bottom being identical to respective FIGS. 3, 4 and 5; and,

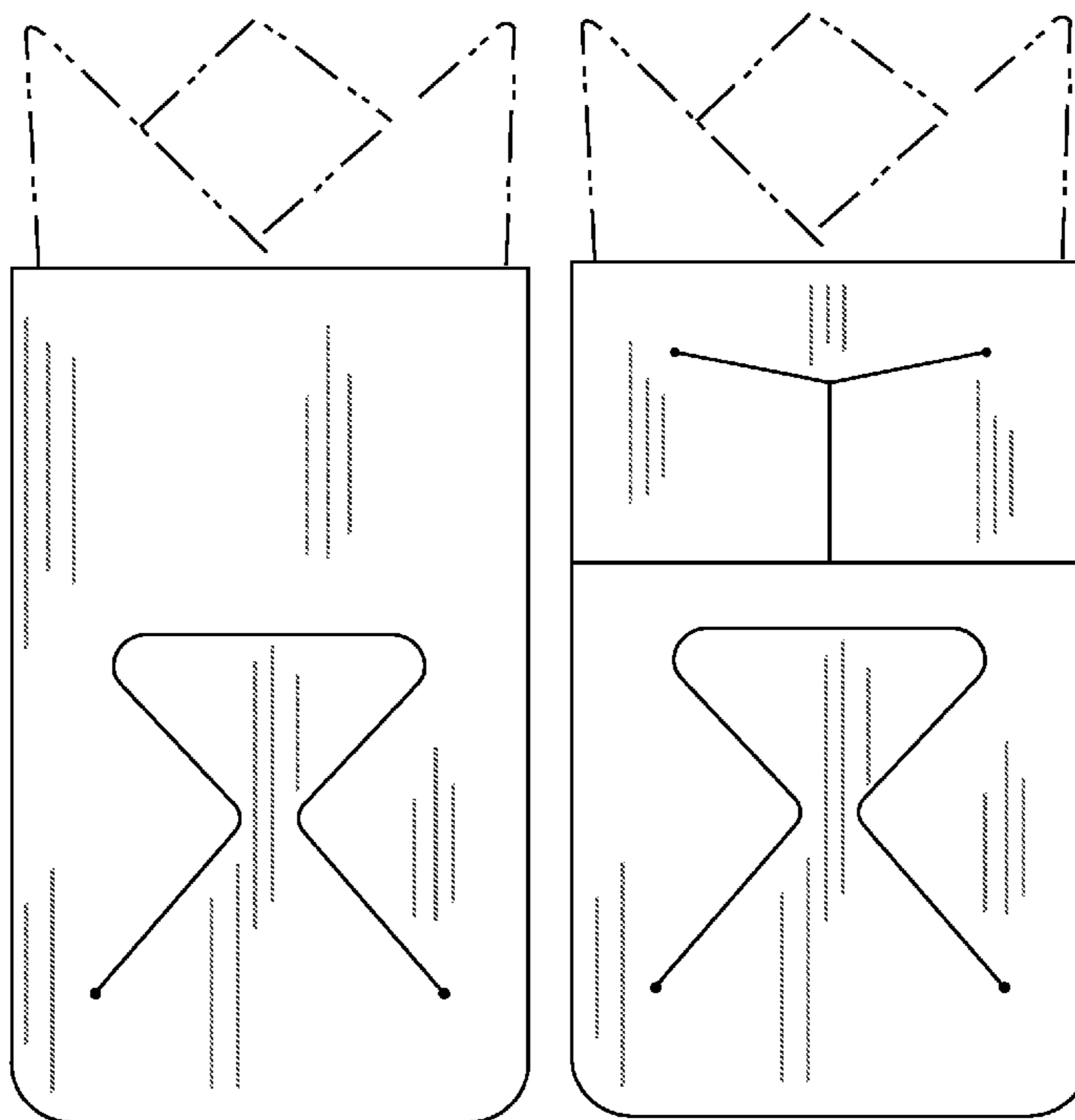

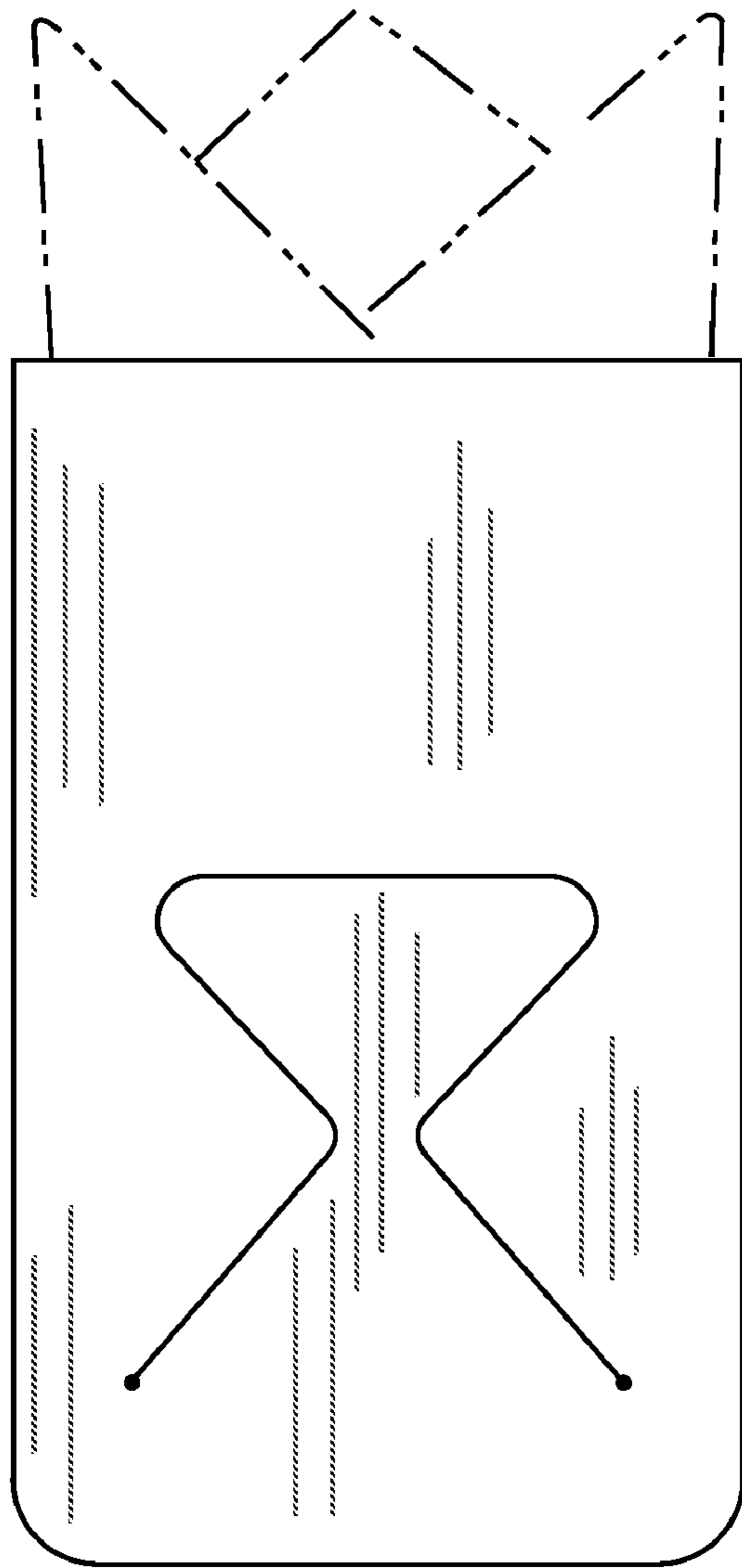

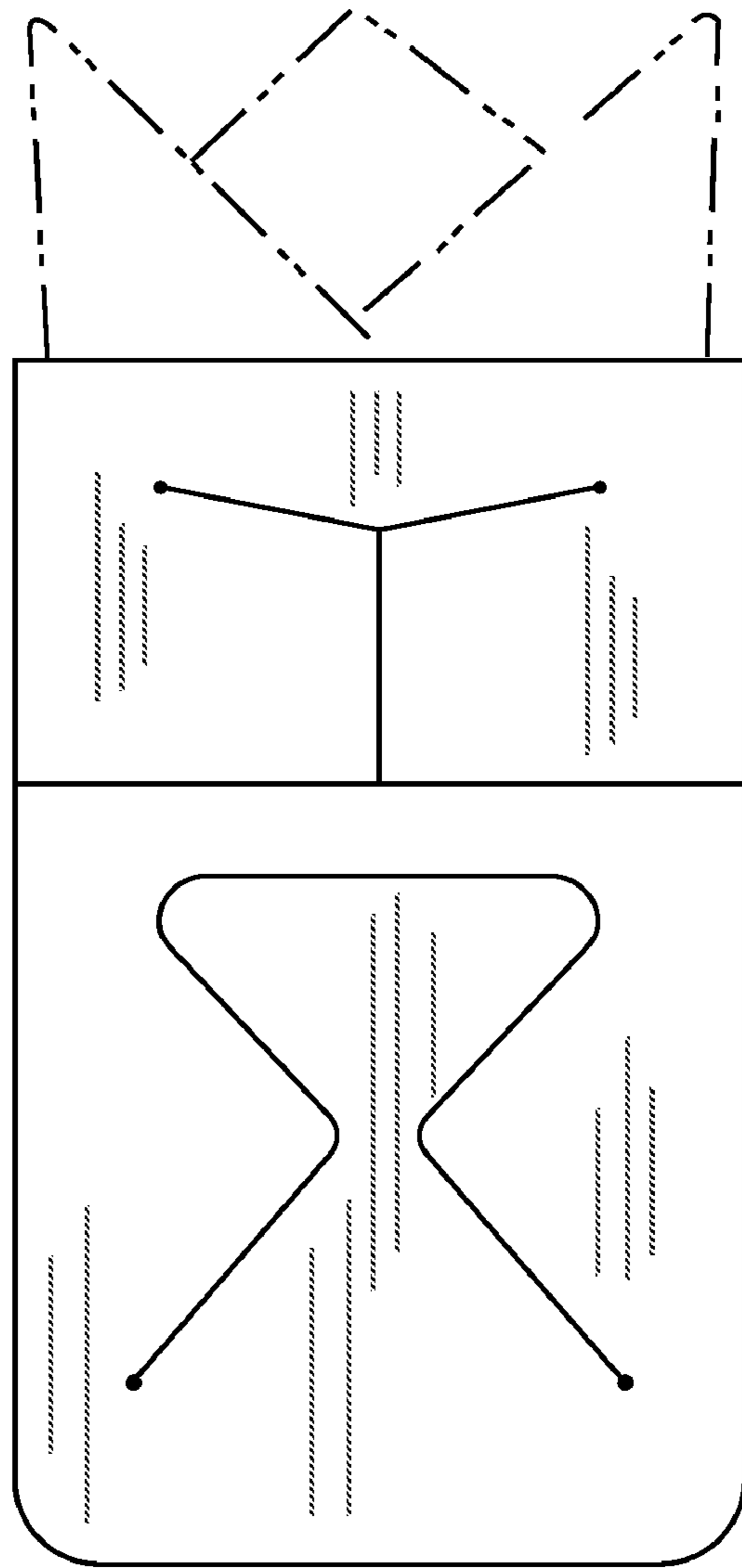

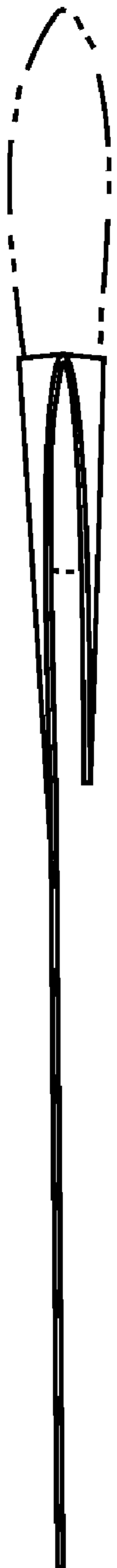

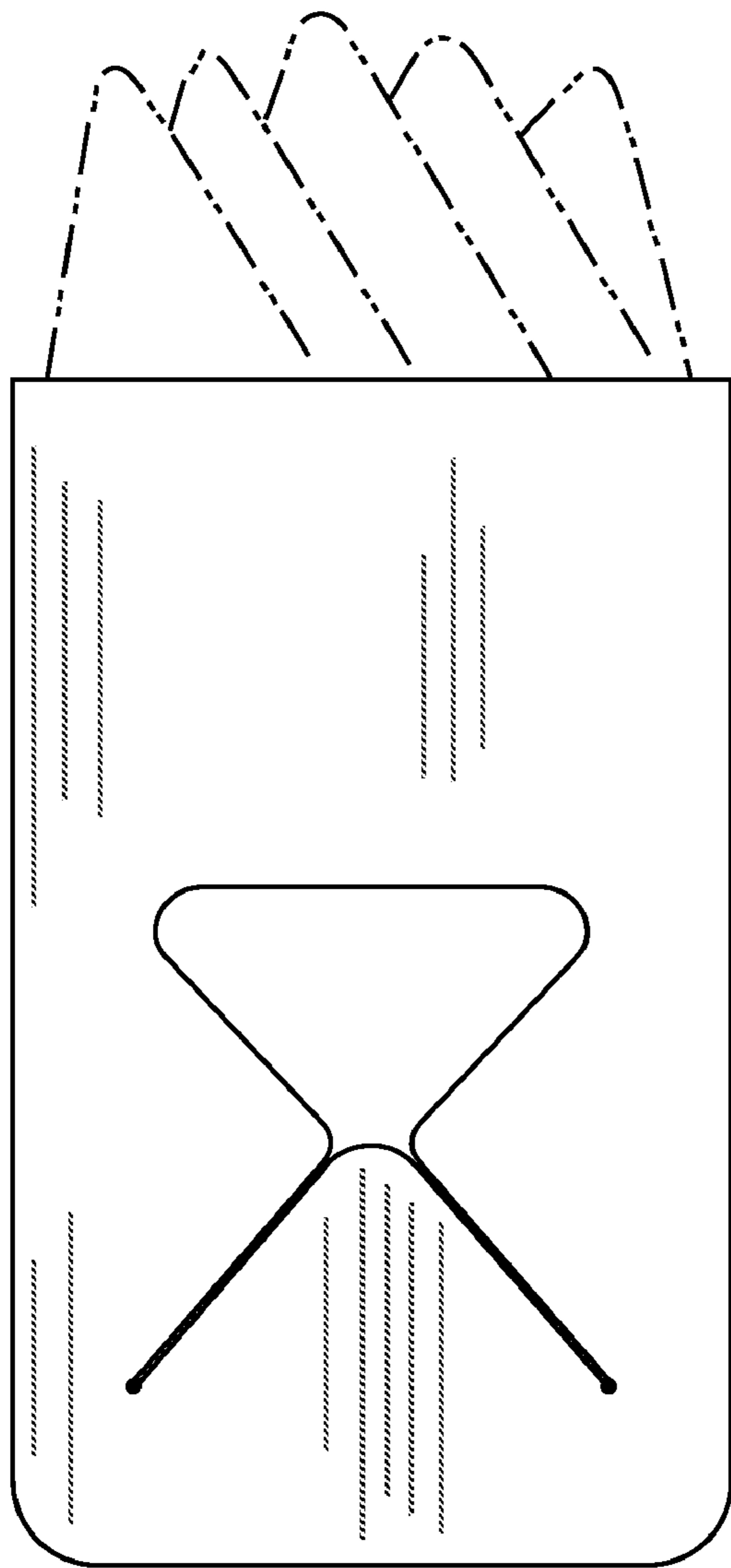

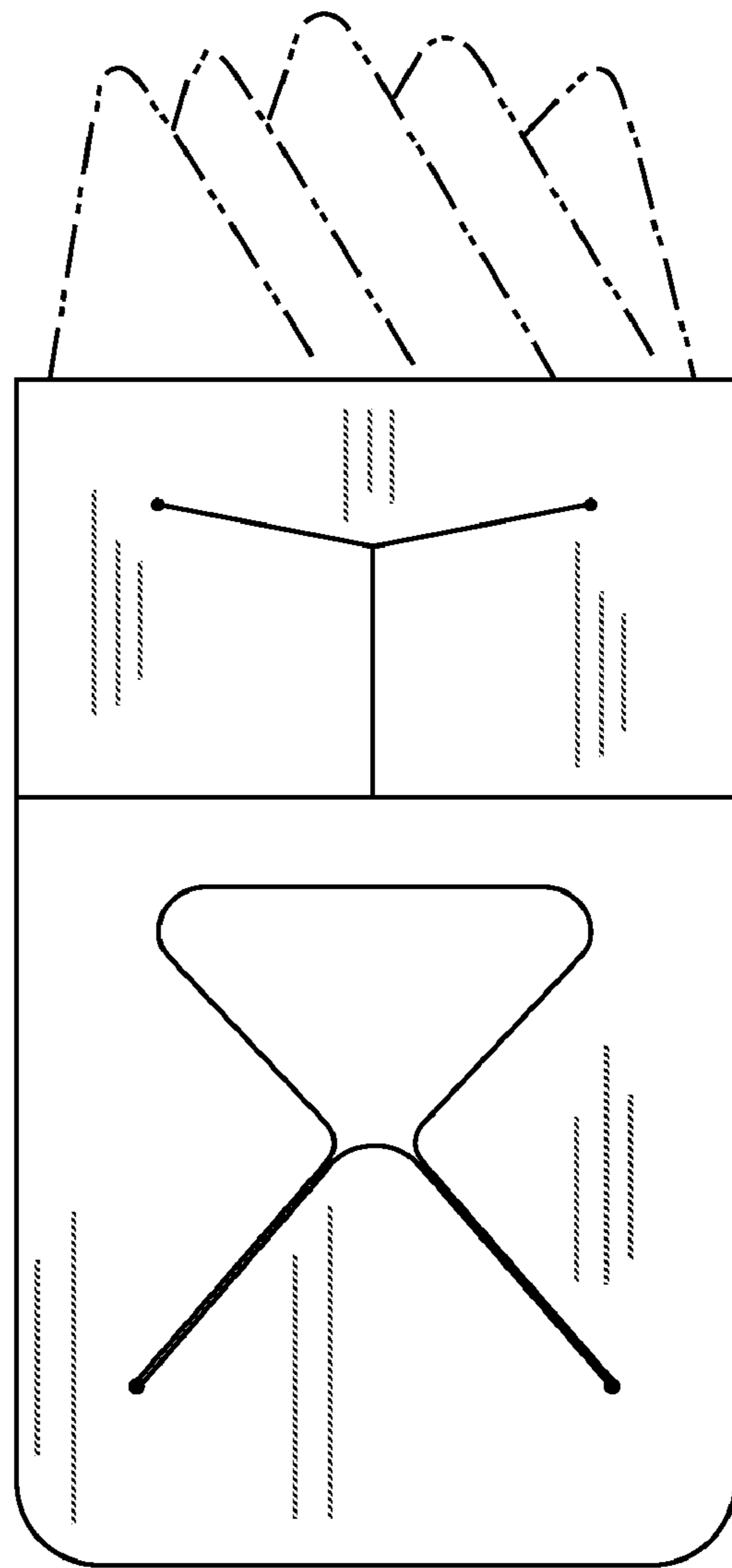

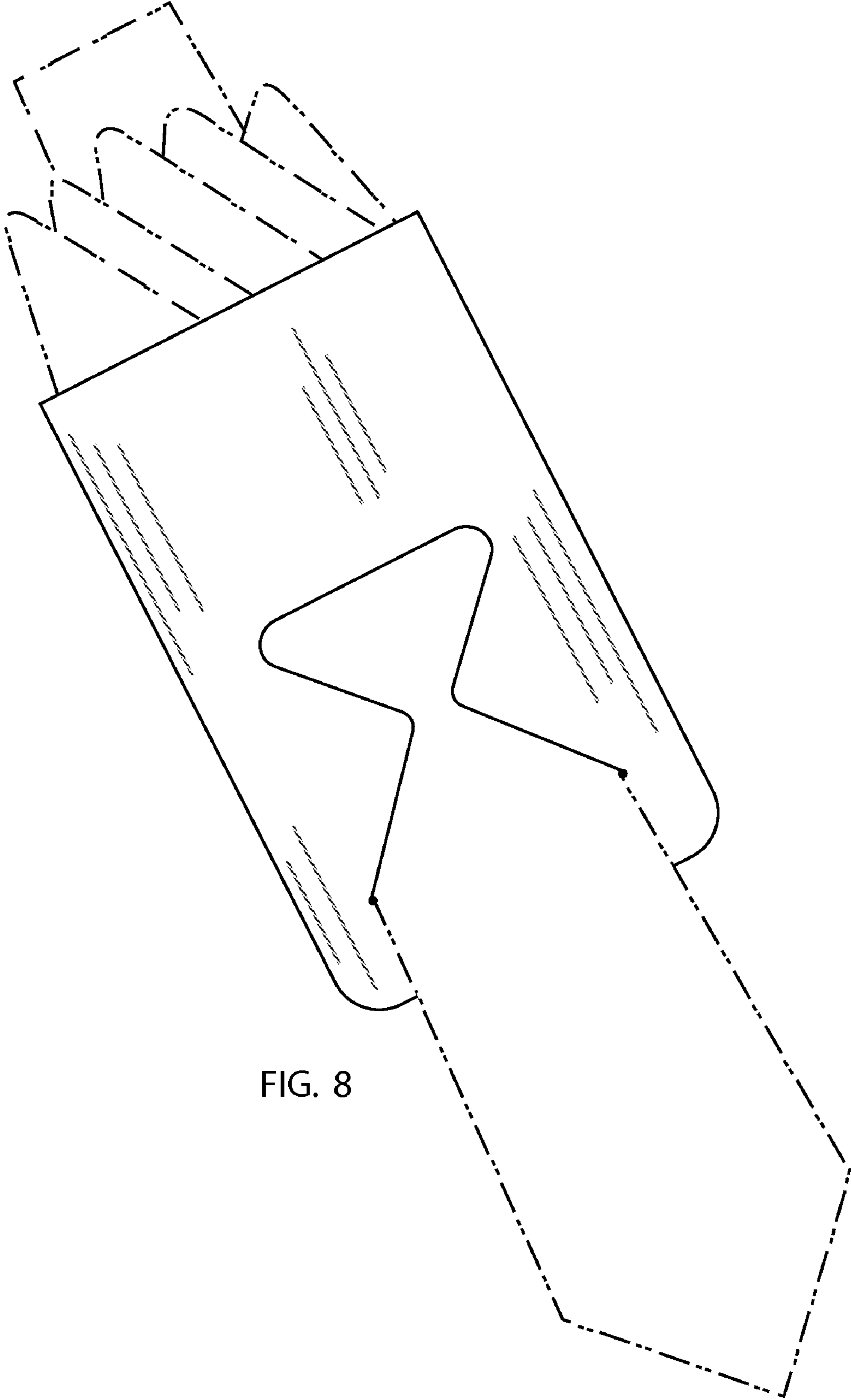
