The ornamental design for a stretch bar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stretch bar showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

1 Claim, 5 Drawing Sheets

A perspective view of a stretch bar. It consists of a vertical handle with a horizontal grip at the top and a base at the bottom. The handle has a series of small, circular indentations or holes along its length. The grip is wider than the handle and has a textured surface. The base is a small, rectangular plate at the bottom of the handle.

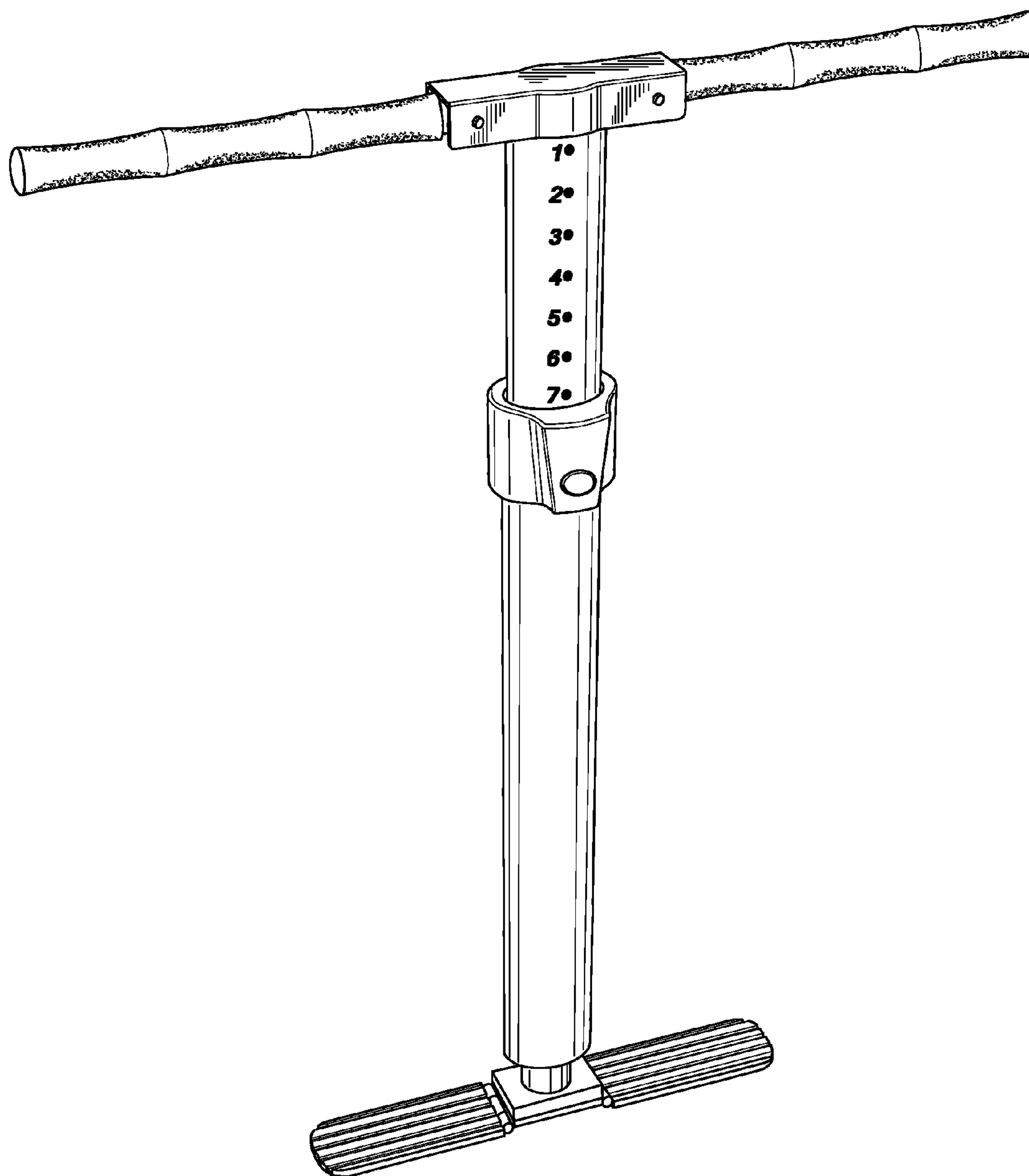

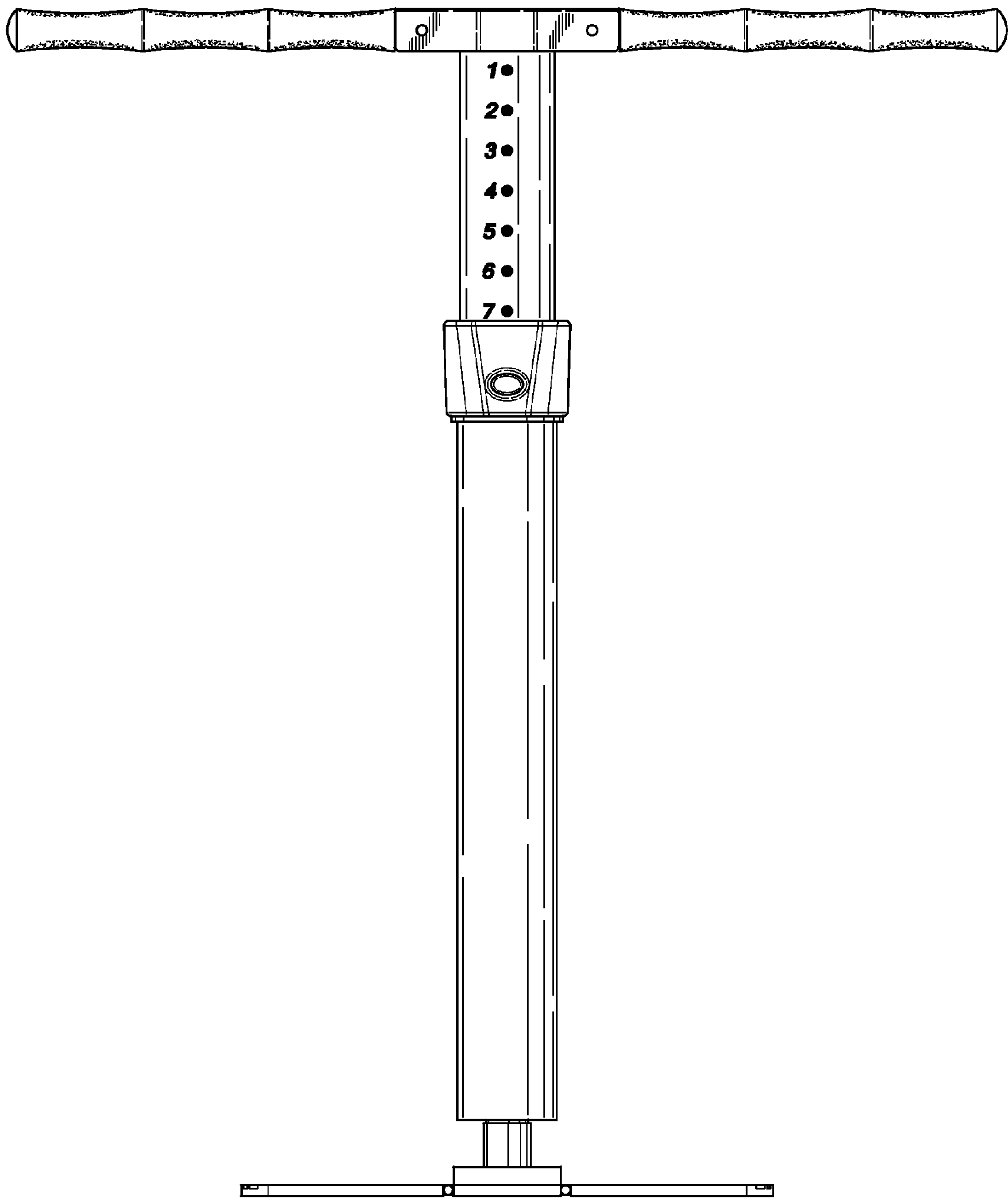

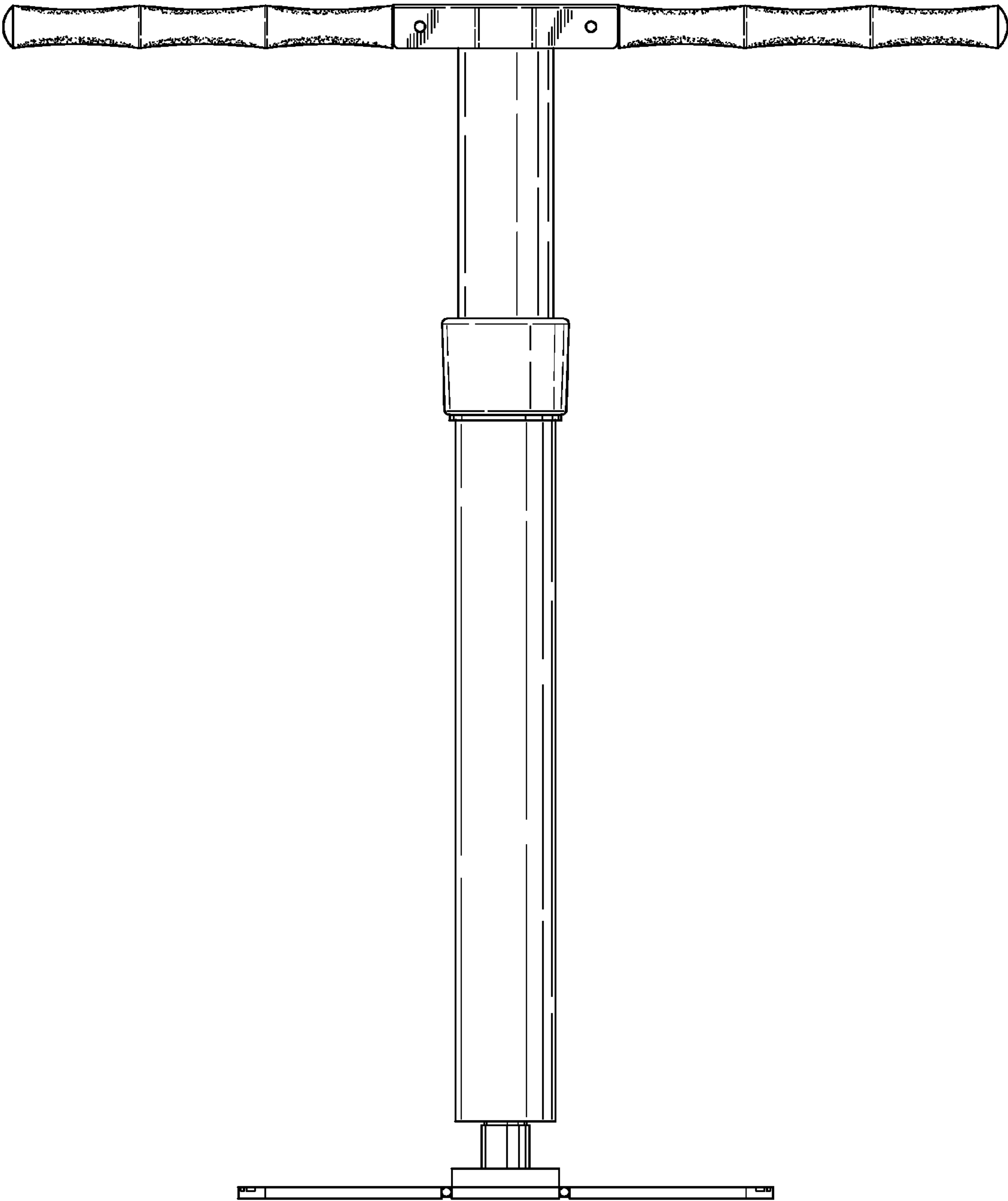

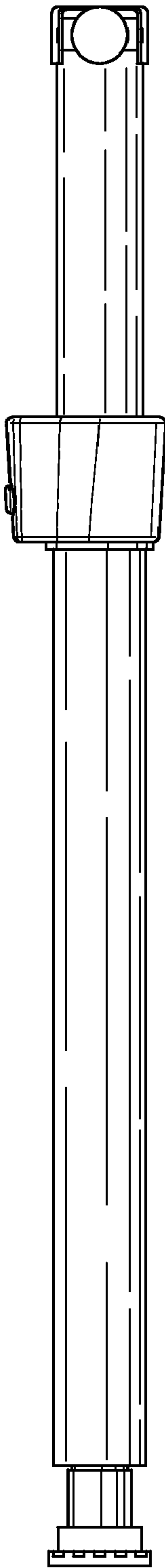

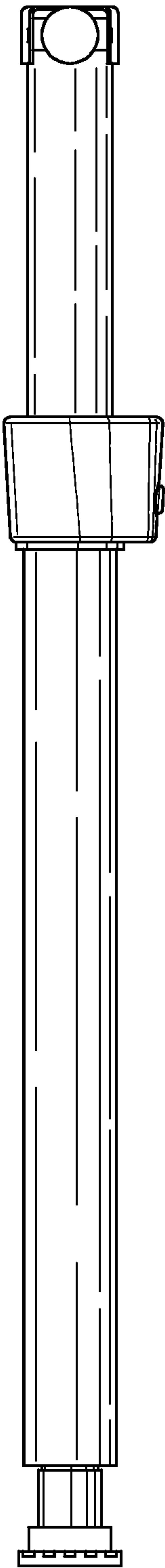

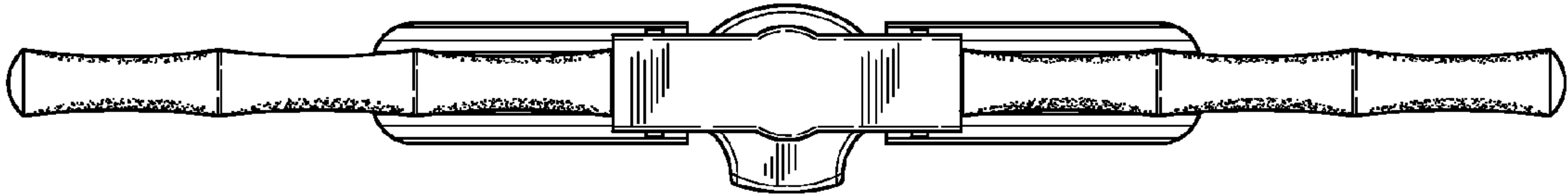

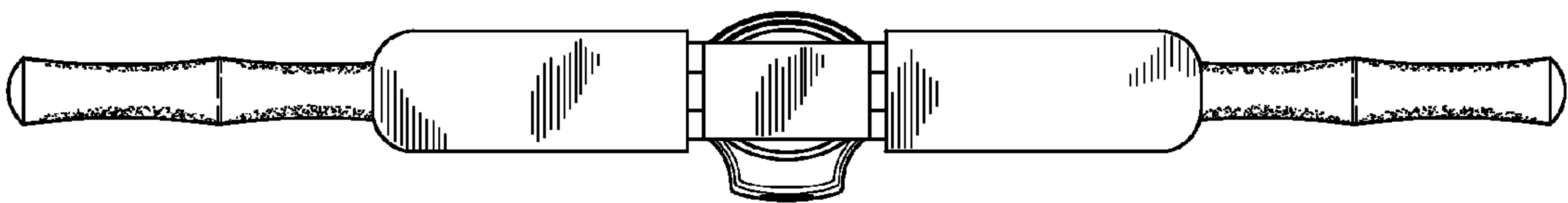
