(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a protective sports spat for cleated or spiked sports shoes, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a protective spat for cleated or spiked sports shoes showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

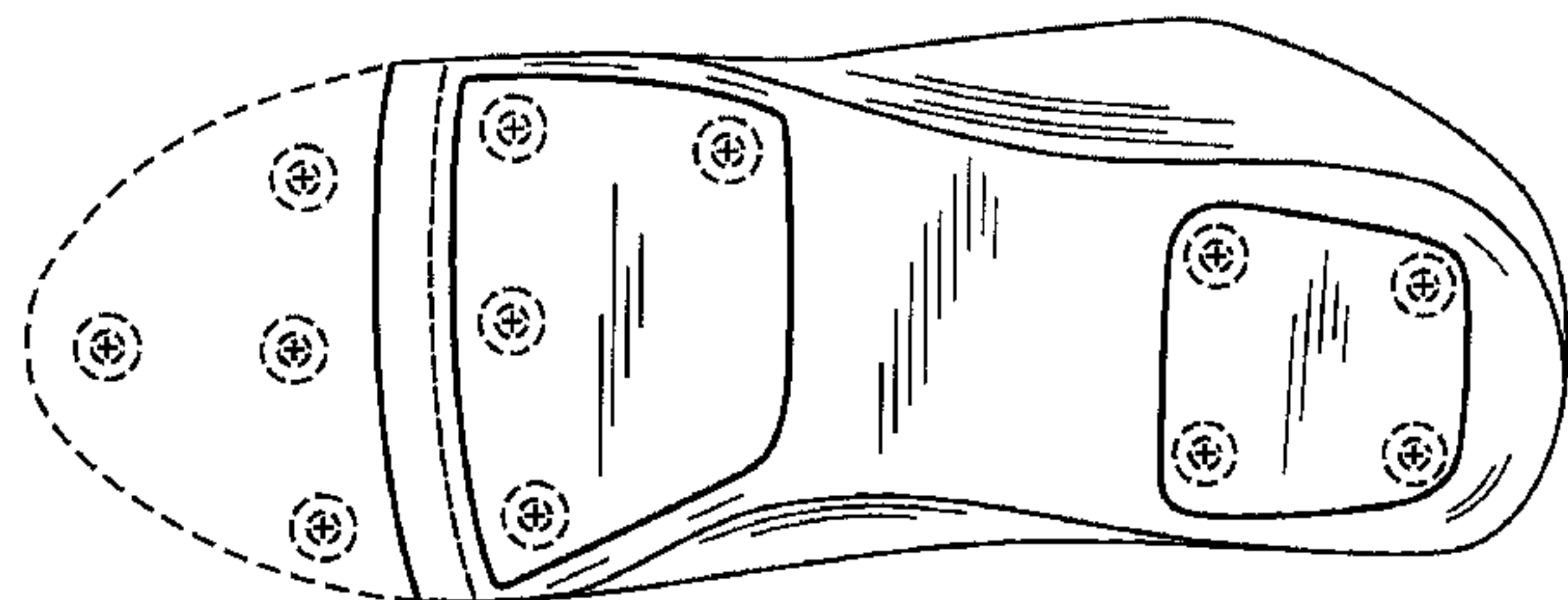
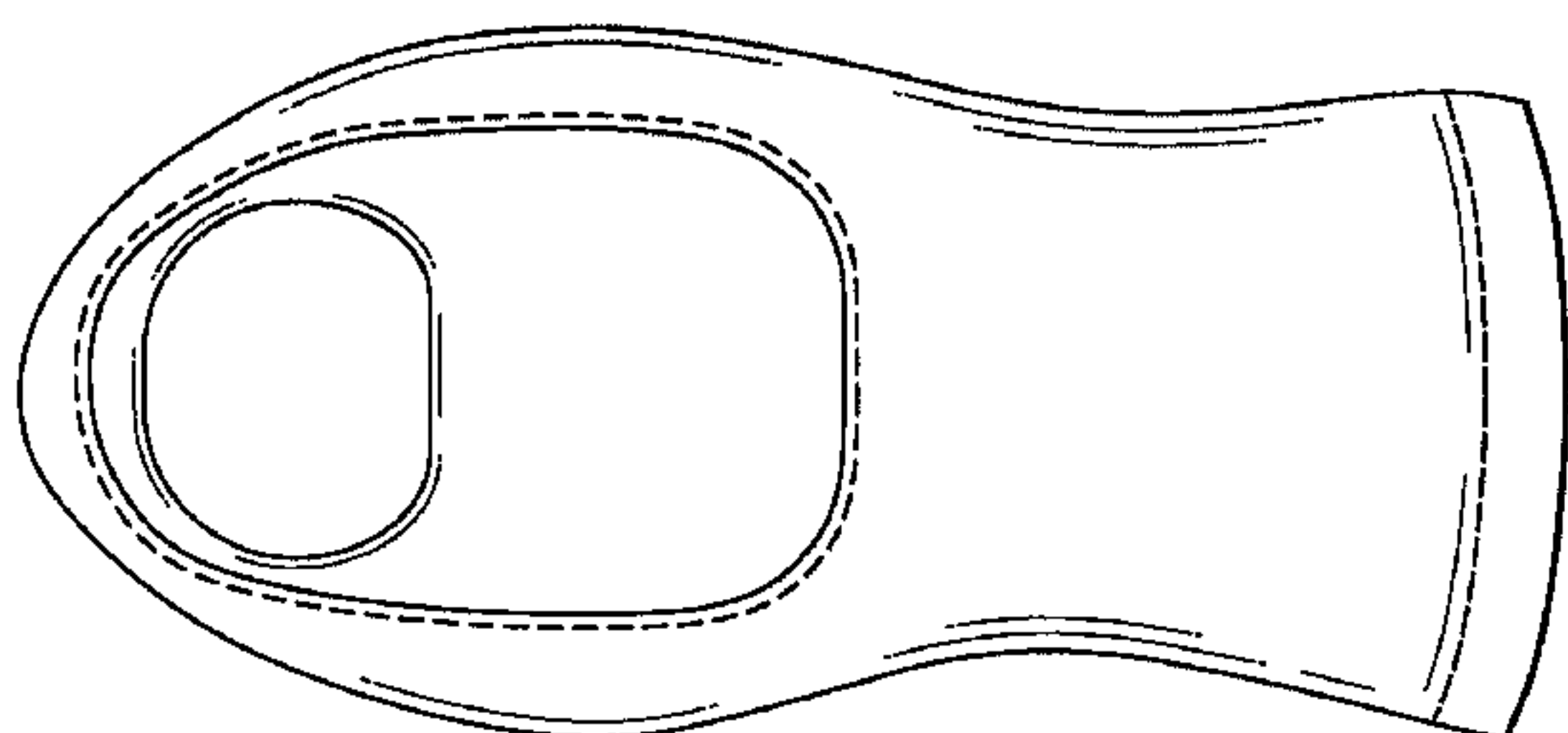
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, in use condition;

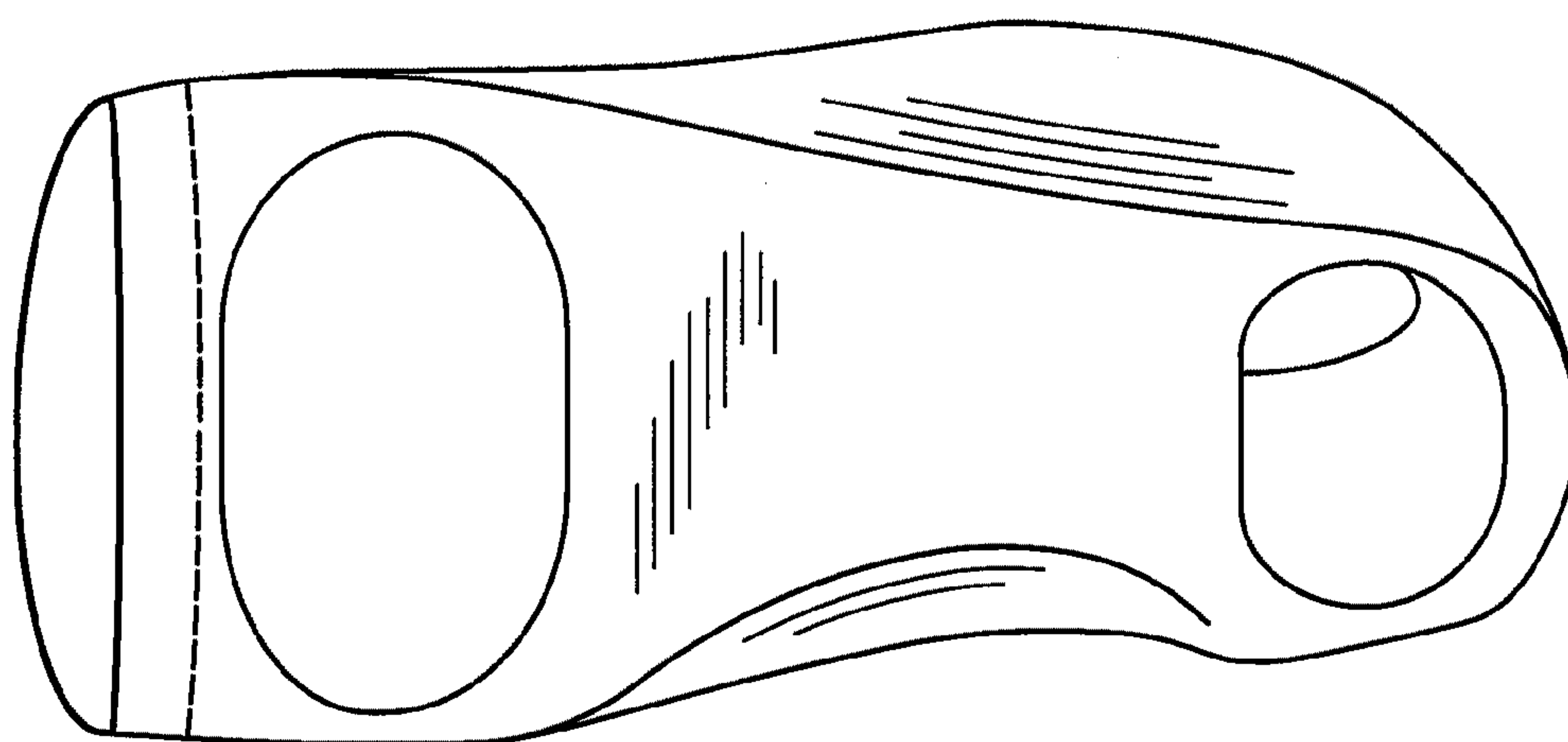

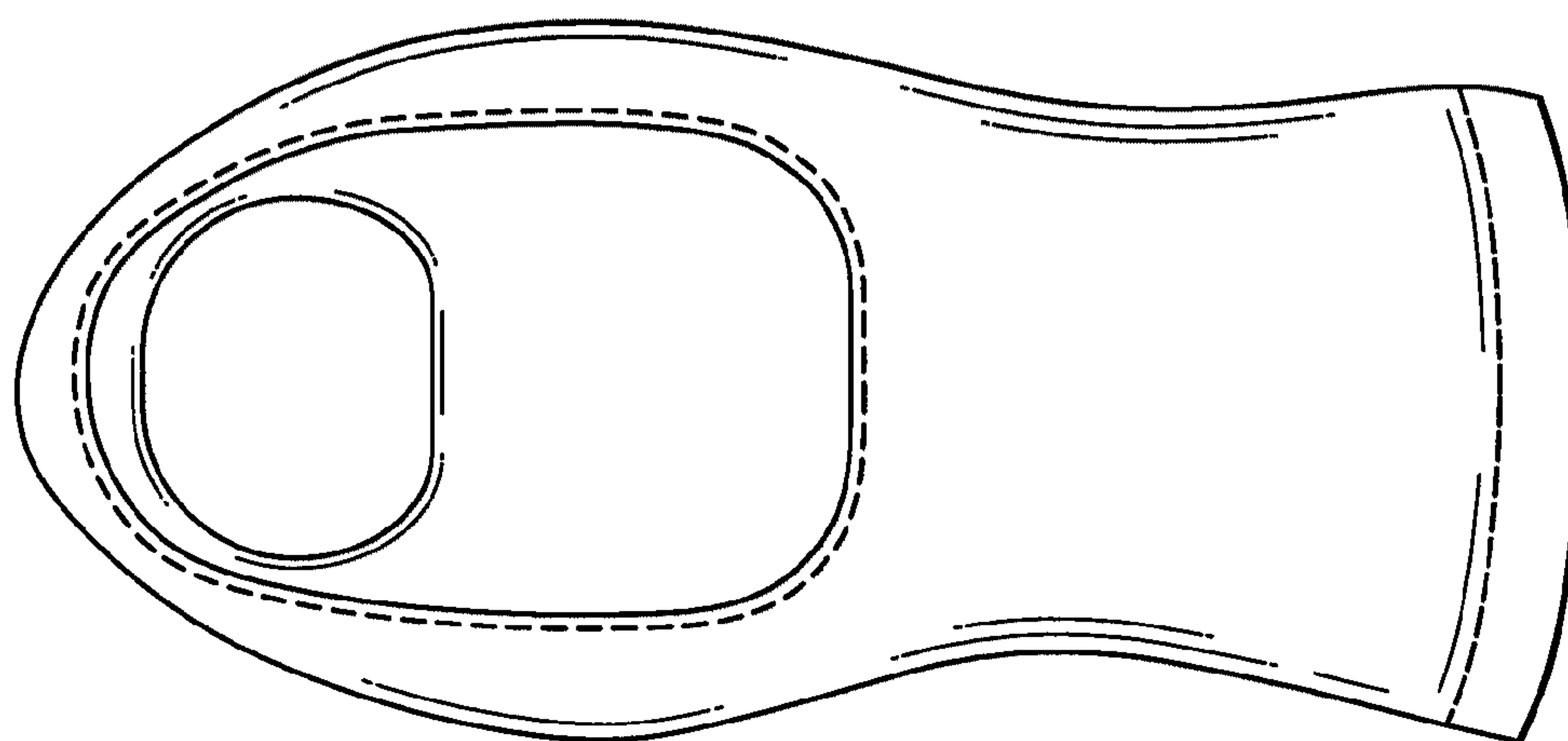
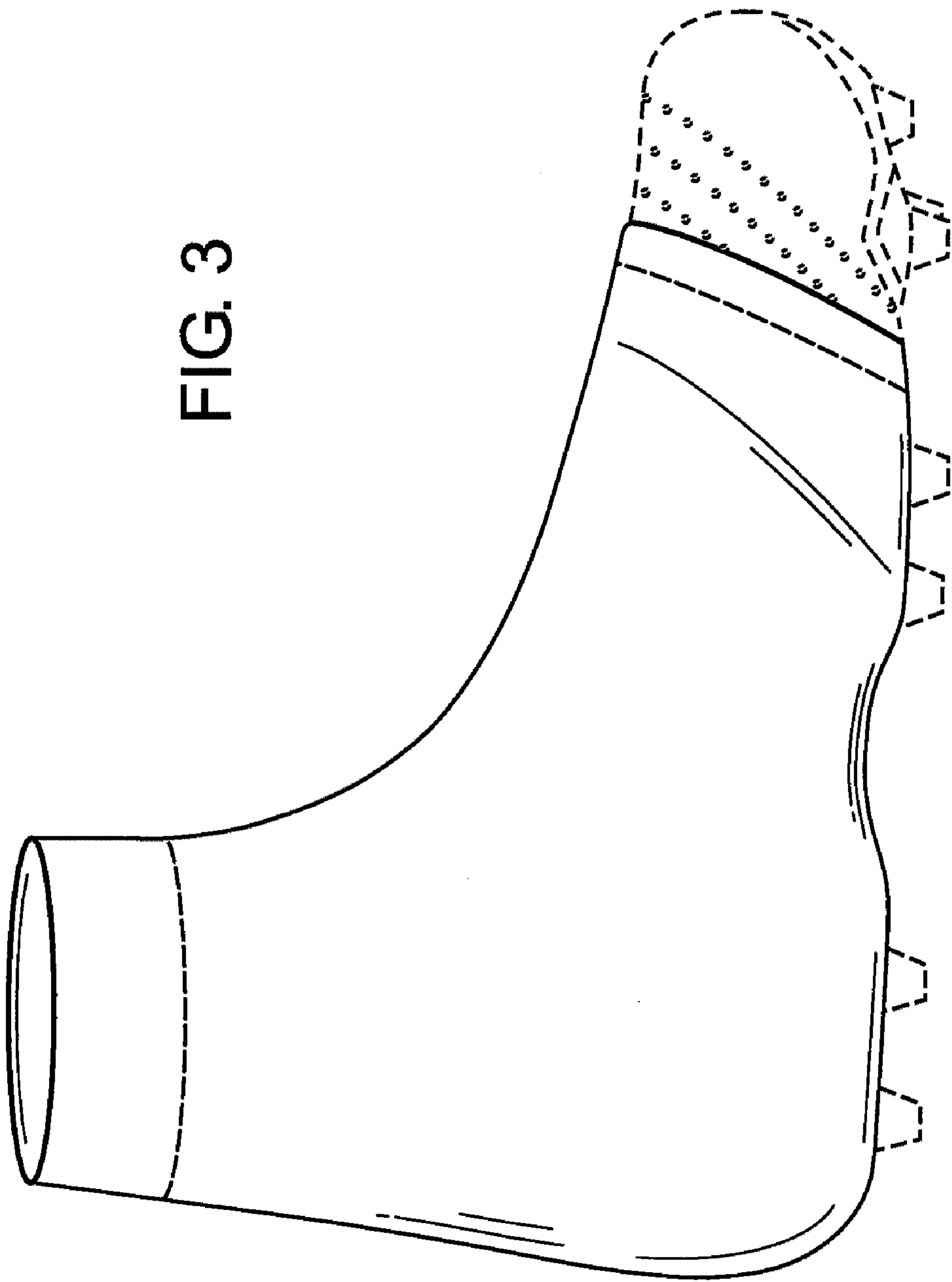

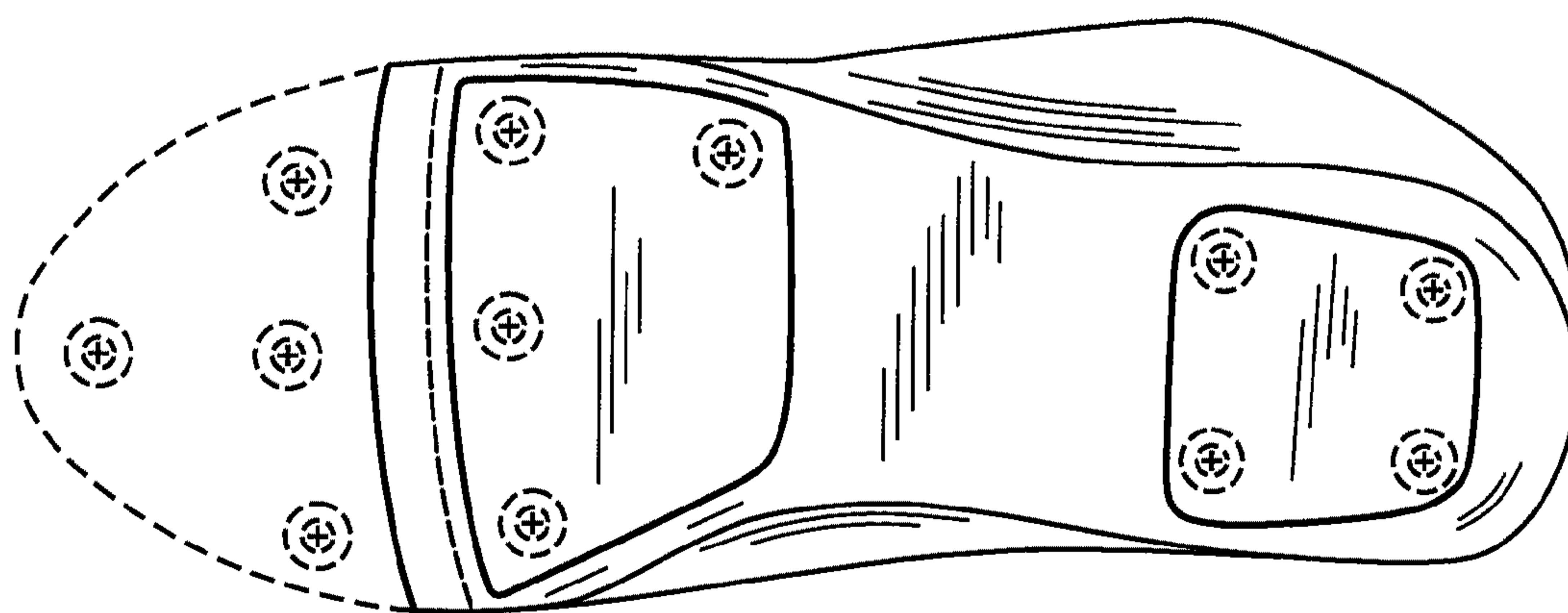

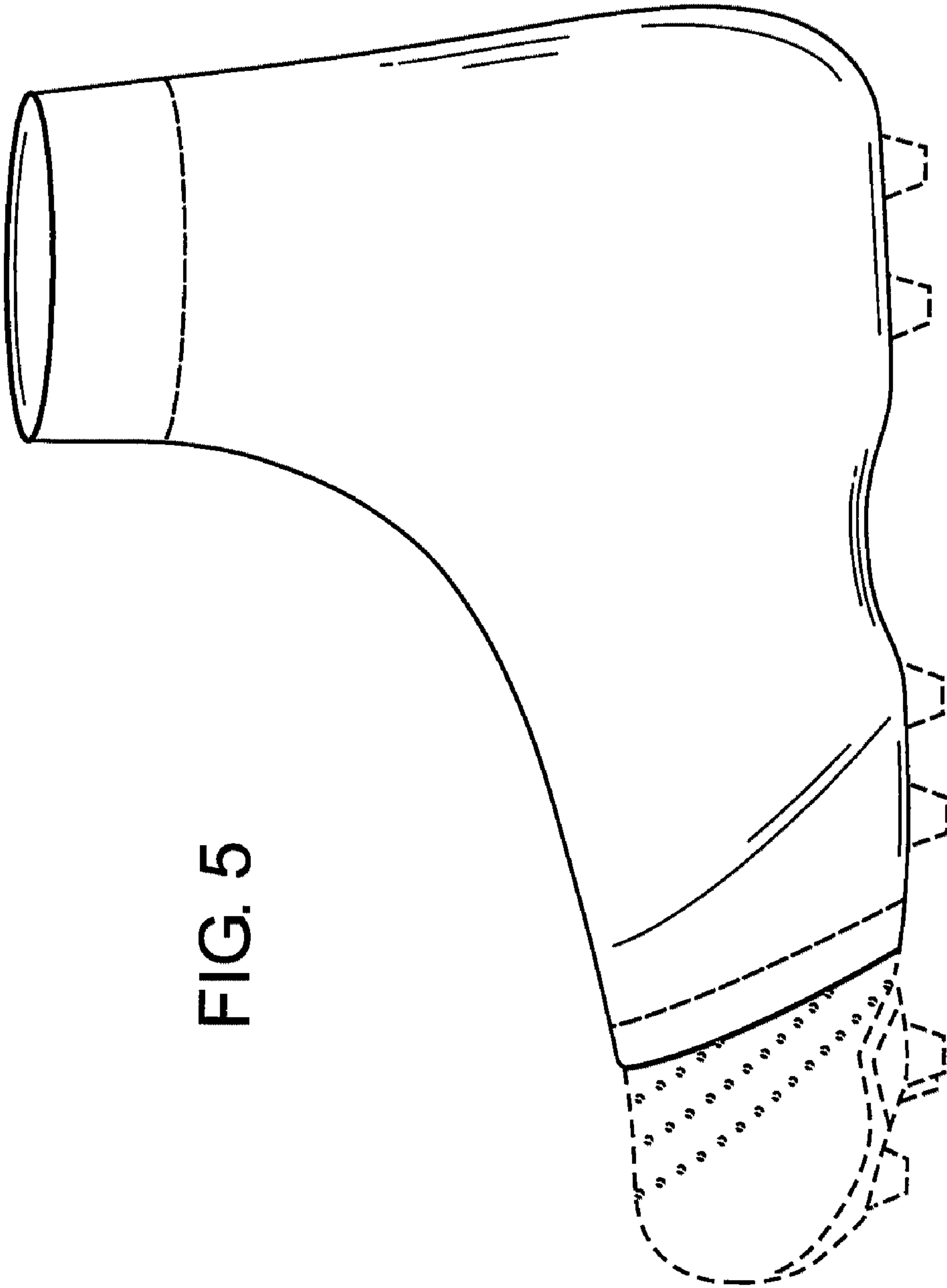
