FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

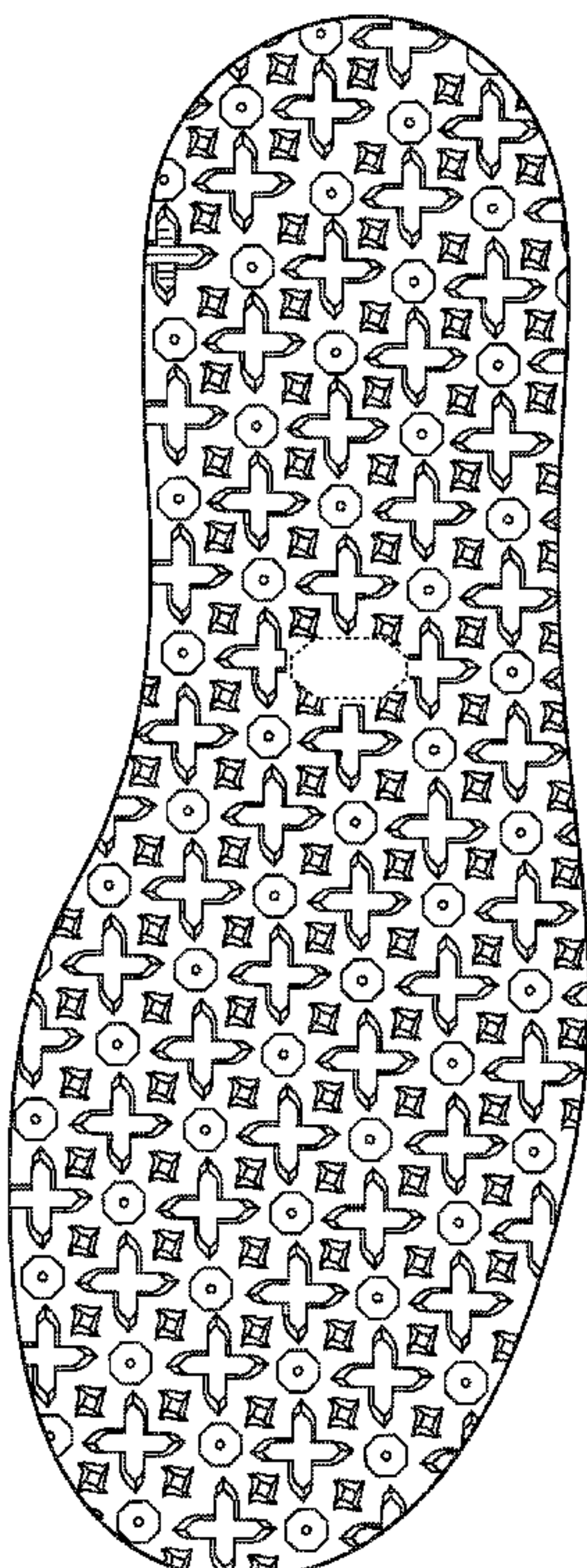
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof, rotated 180 degrees;

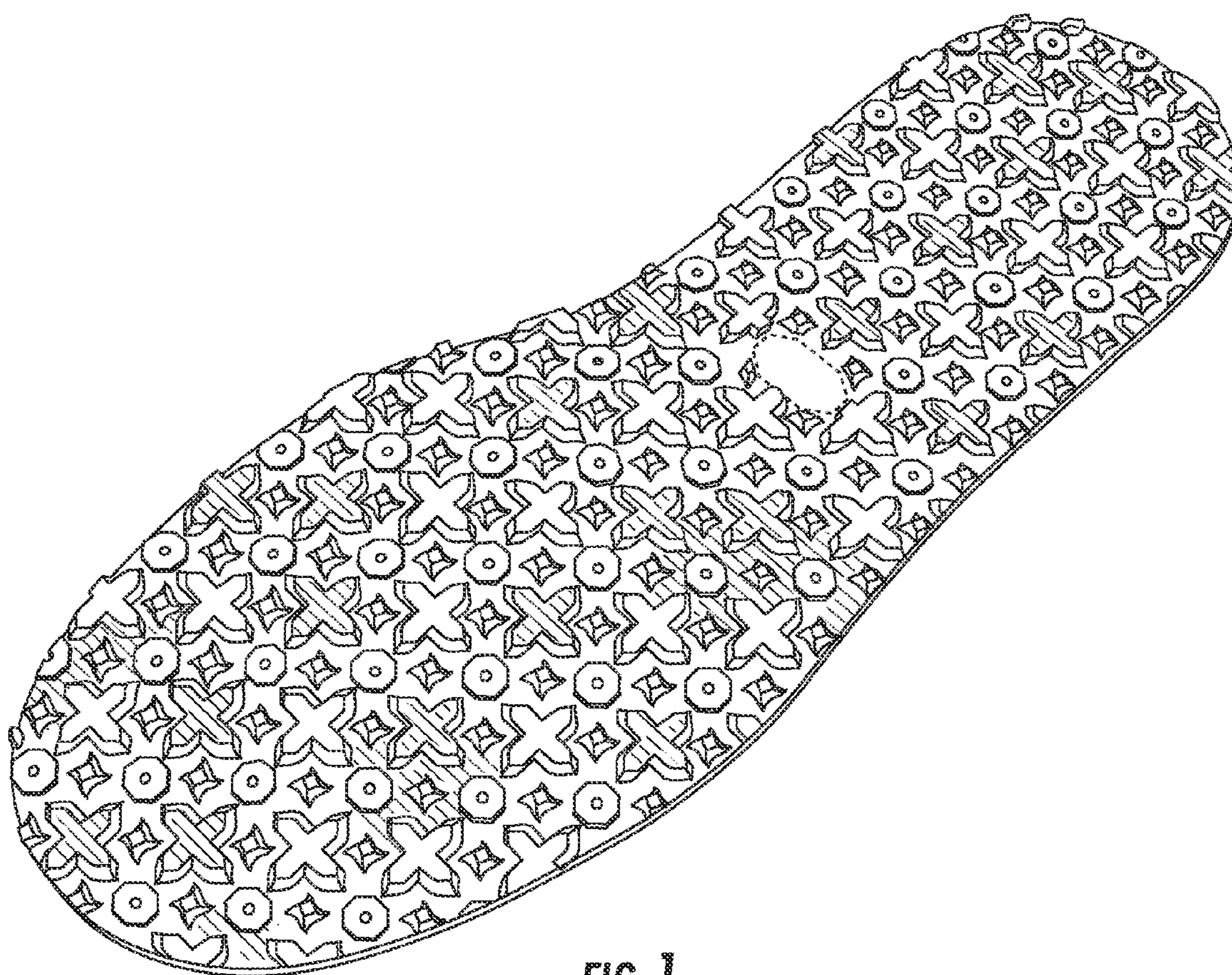

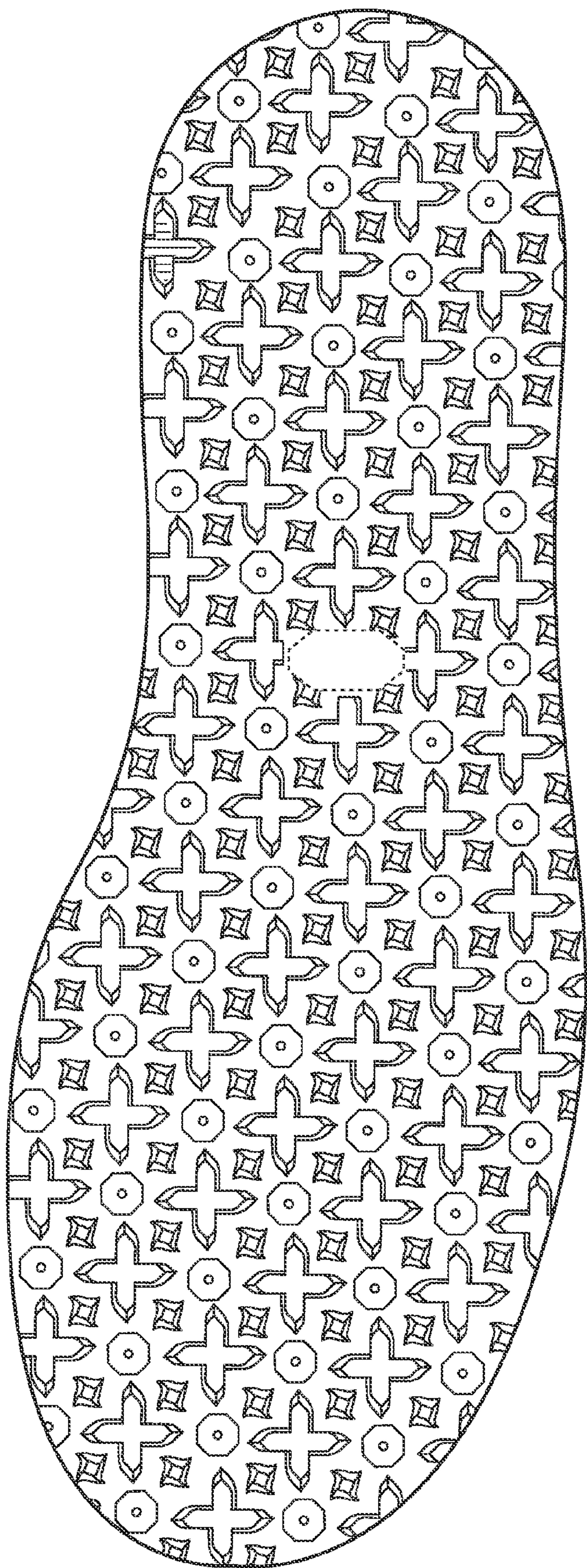

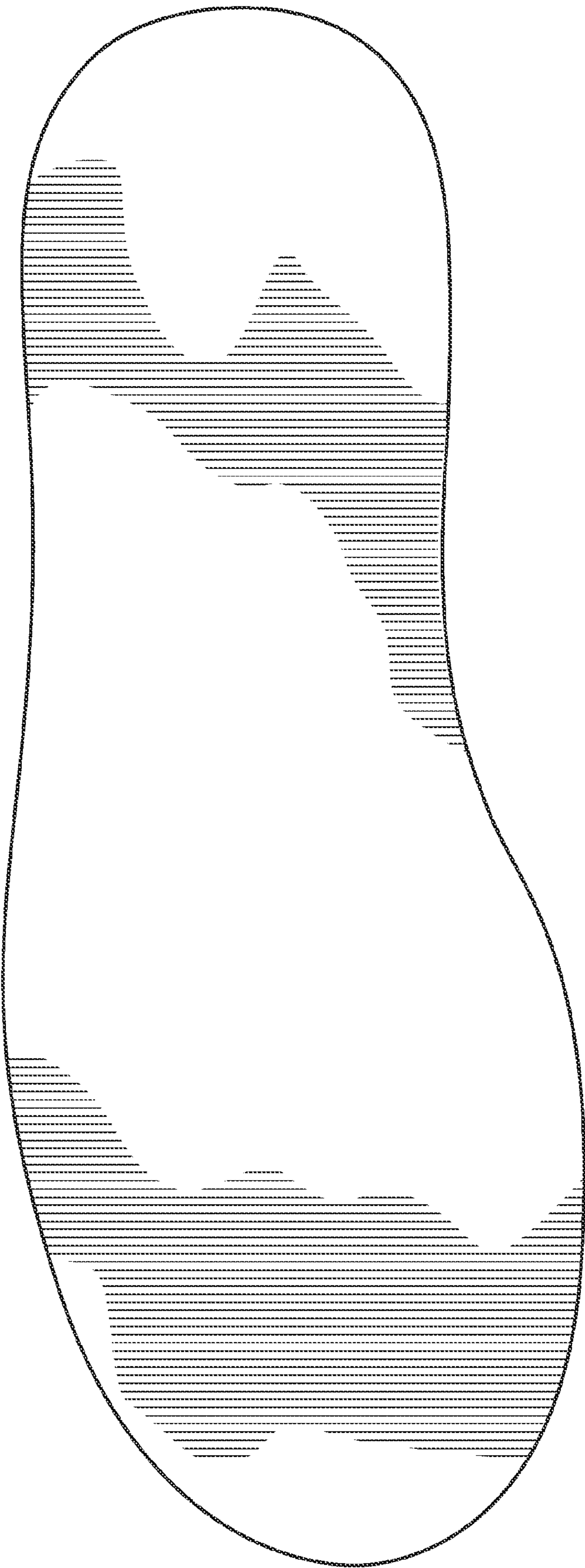
