FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the necklace organizer as shown in FIG. 1; and,

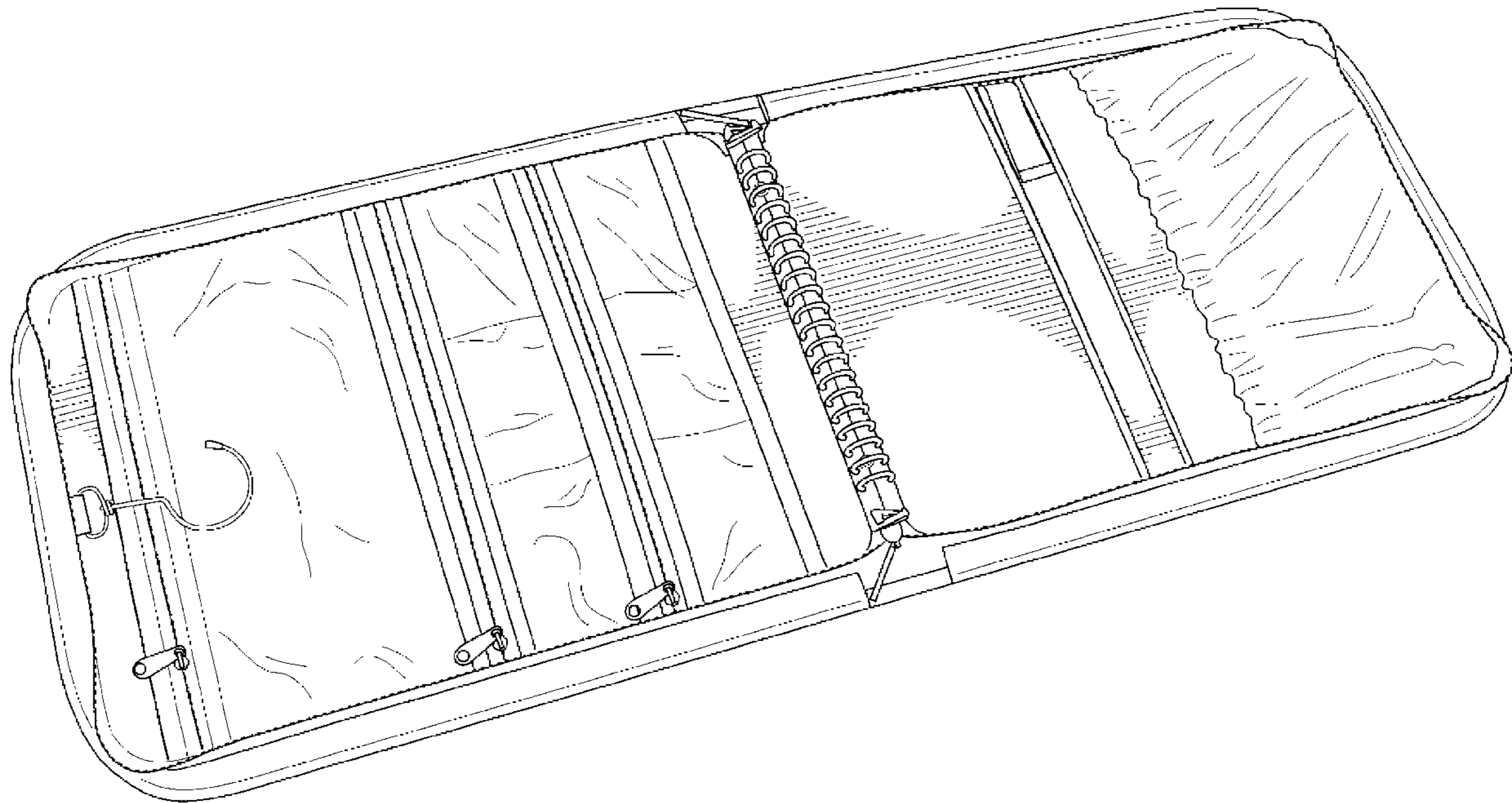
FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view of the necklace organizer as shown in FIG. 1.

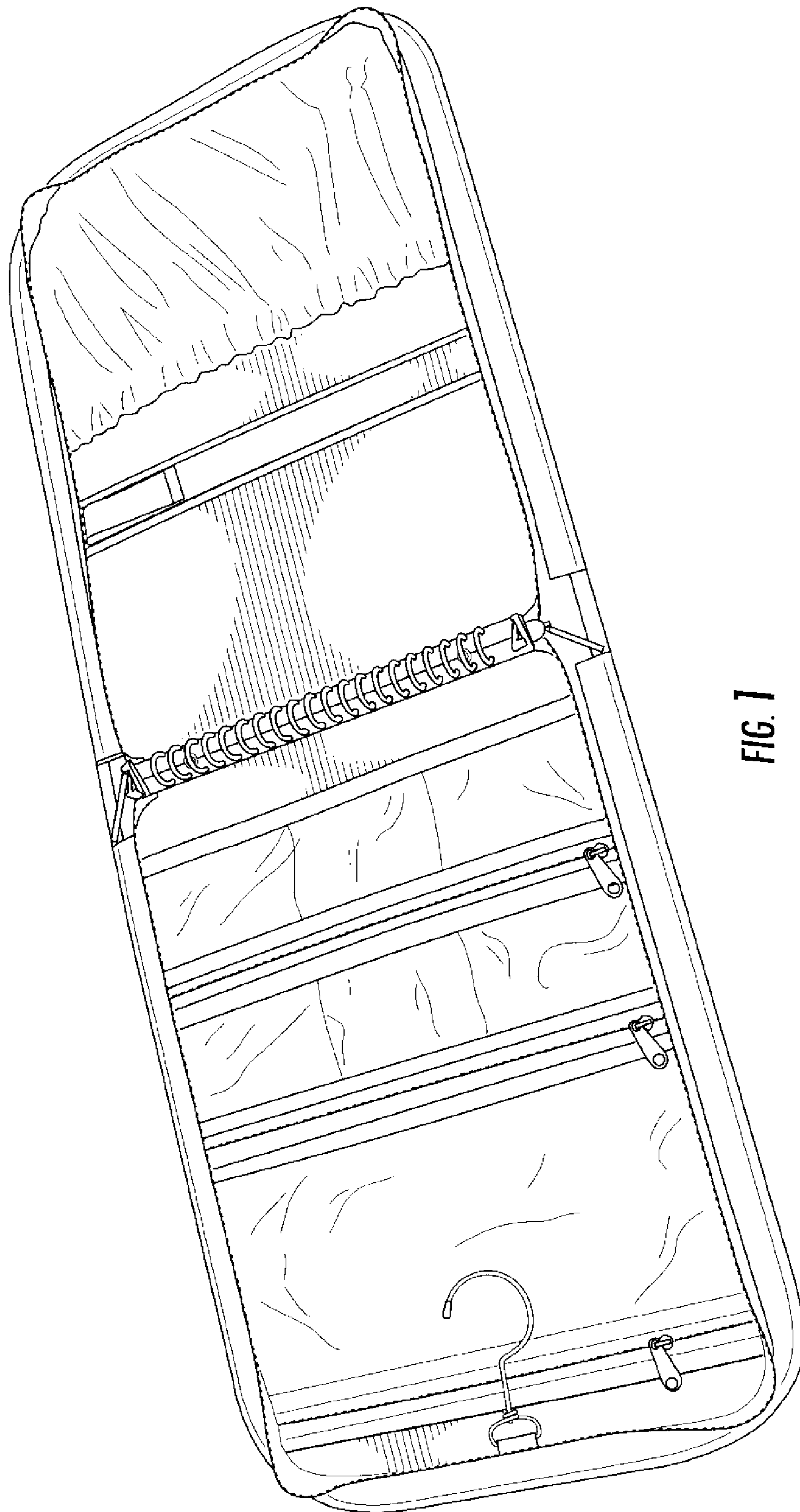

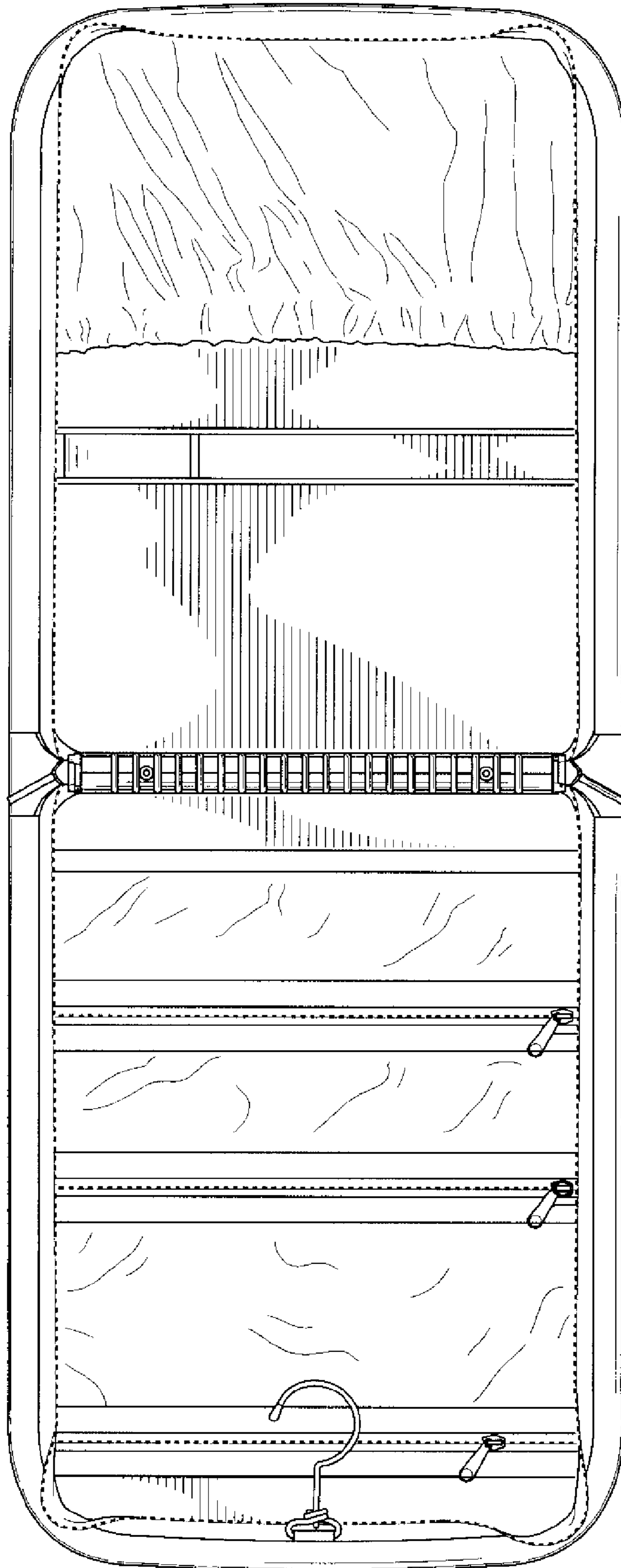

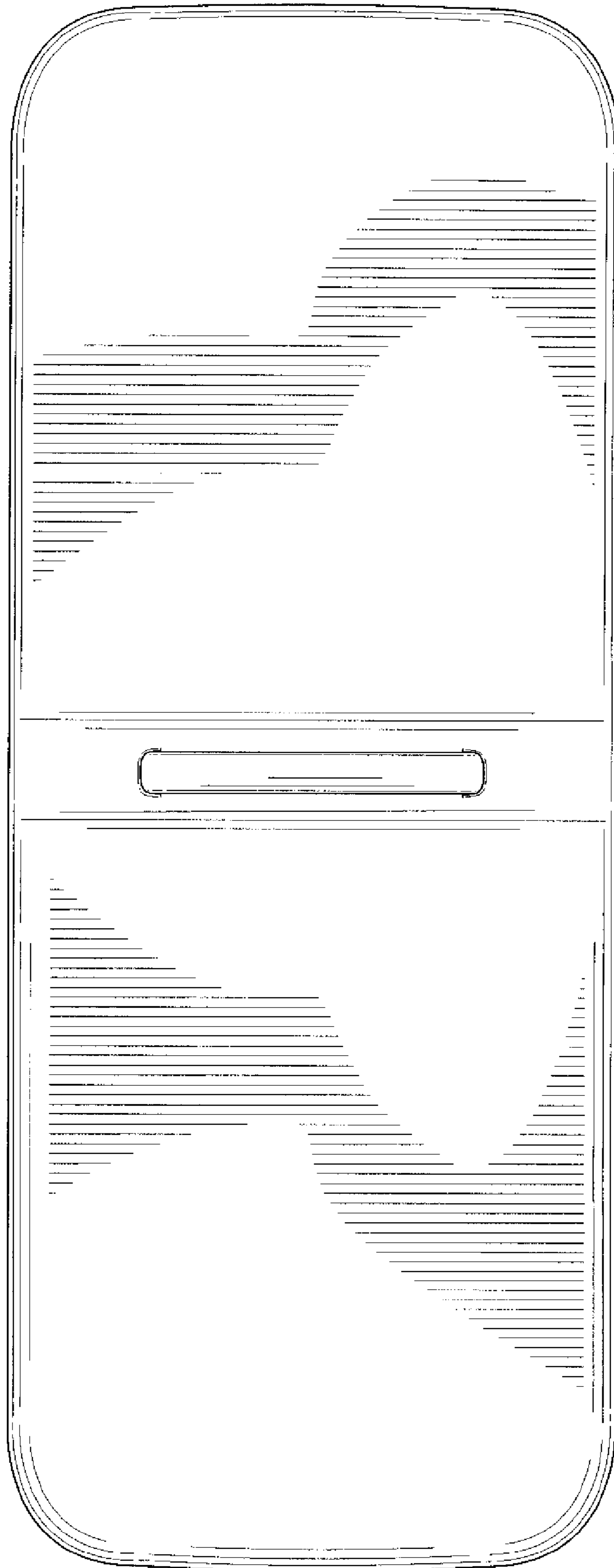

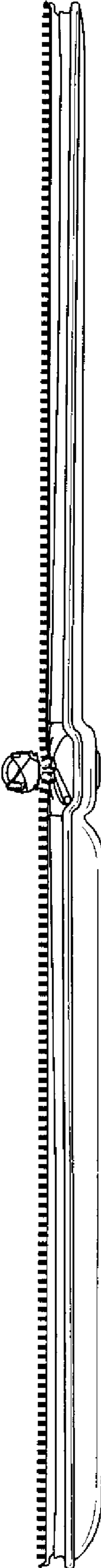

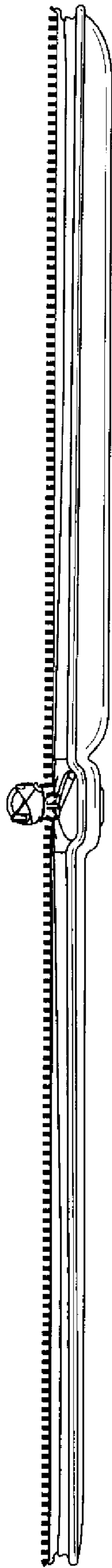
