FIG. 4 is a top view of the ice fishing depth finder of FIG. 1.


FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the ice fishing depth finder of FIG. 1.















FIG. 4 is a top view of the ice fishing depth finder of FIG. 1.


FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the ice fishing depth finder of FIG. 1.














