FIG. 4 is a top view of the submarine tub toy holder illustrated in FIG. 1.

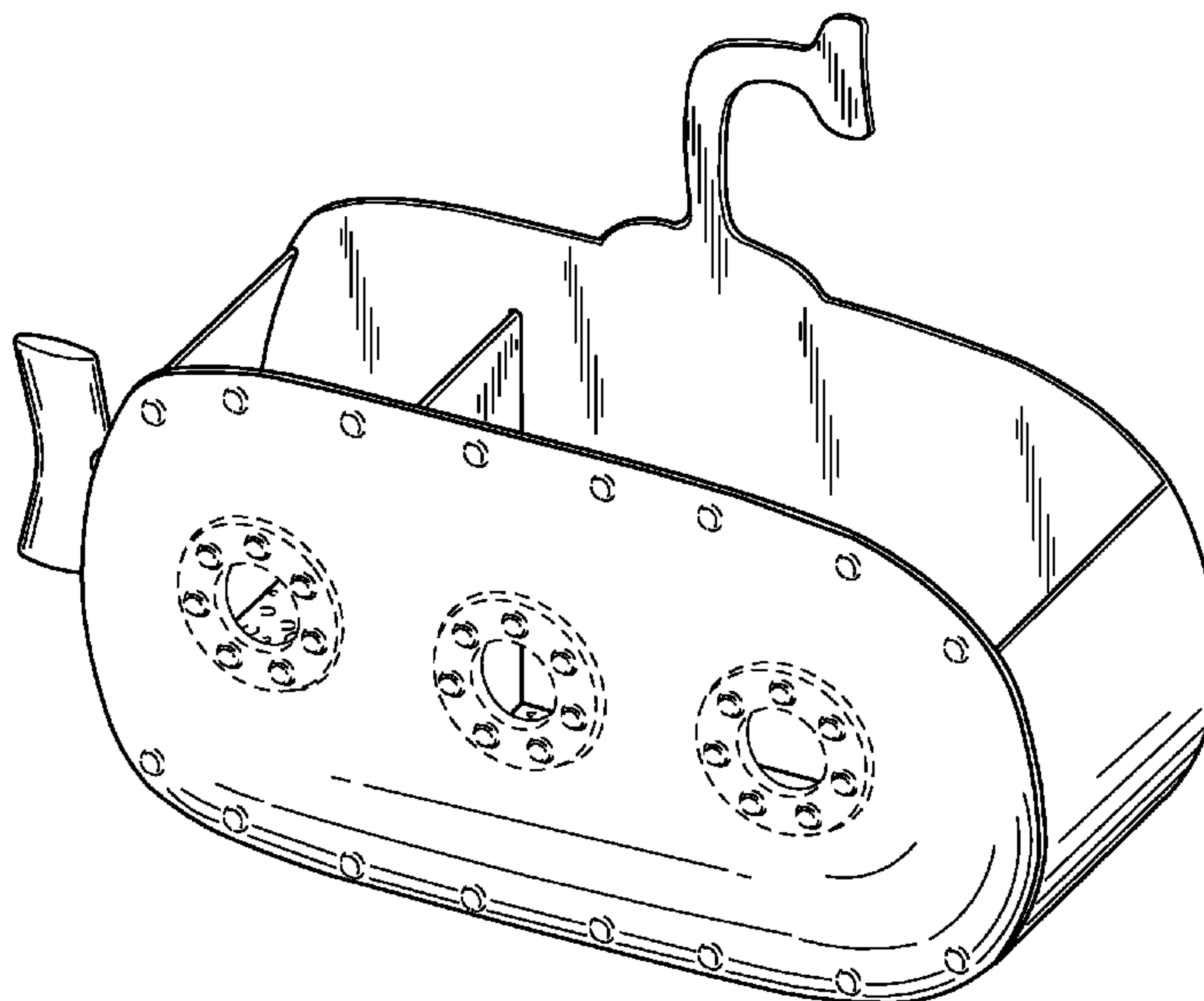
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the submarine tub toy holder illustrated in FIG. 1.

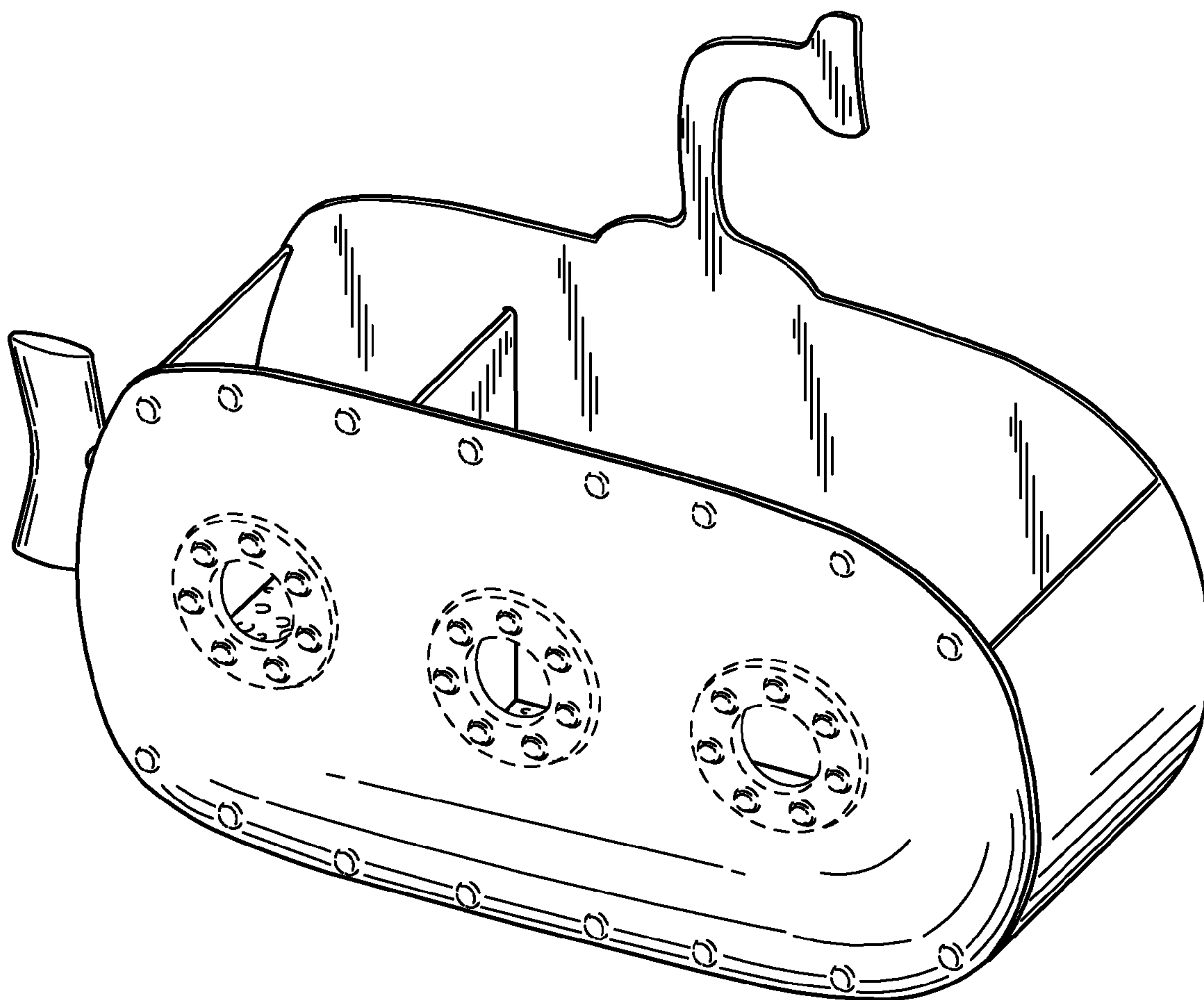

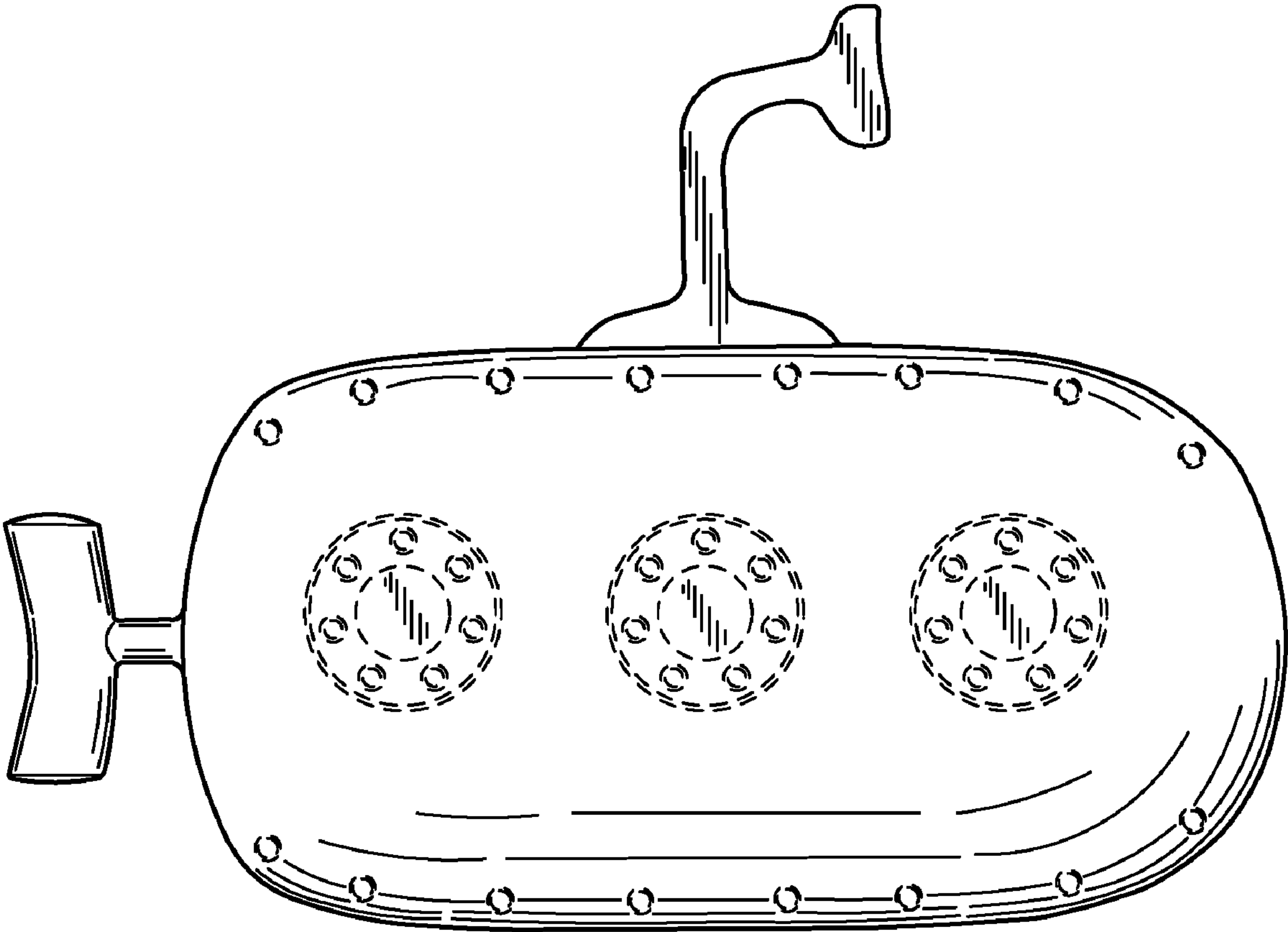

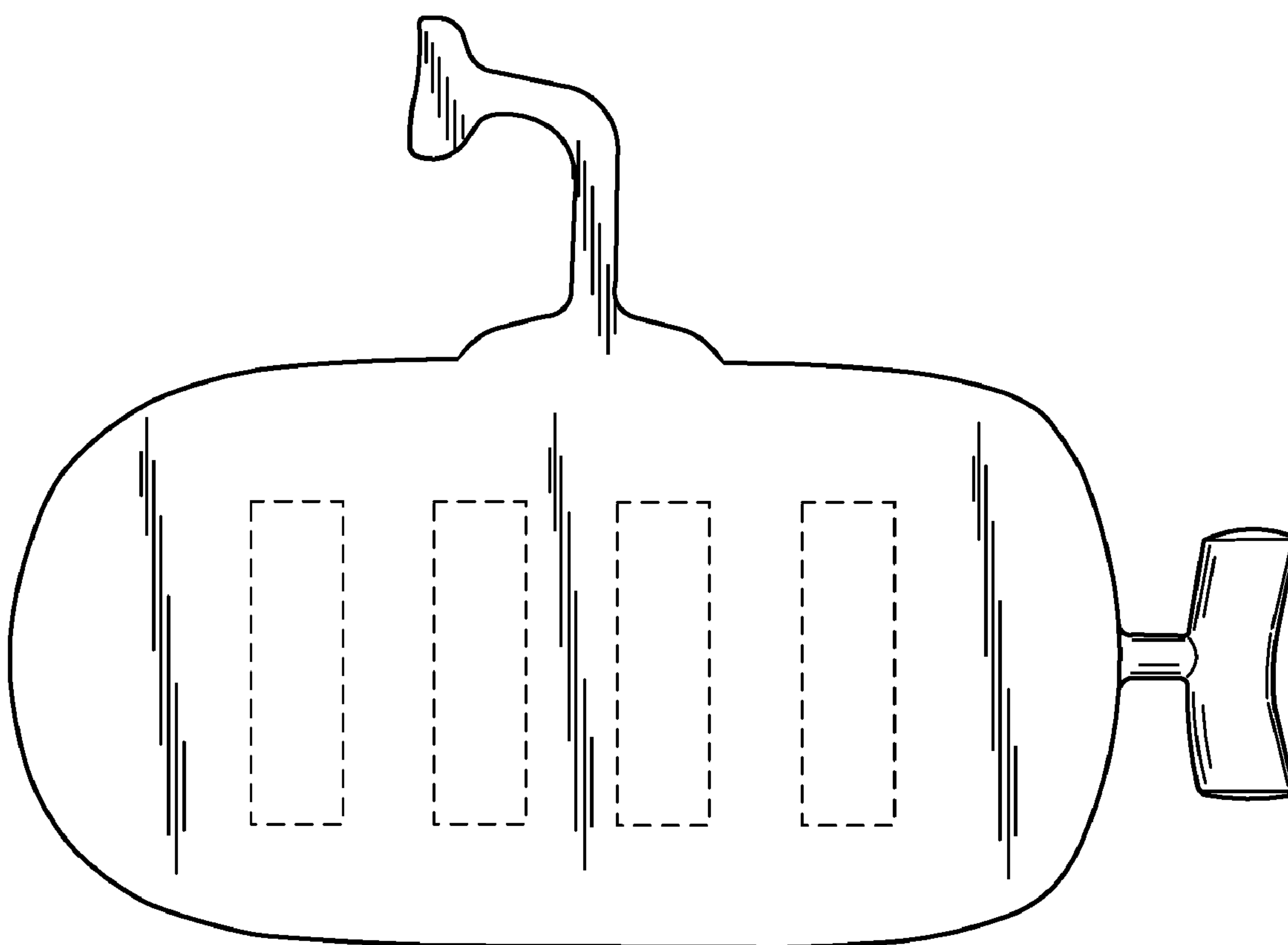

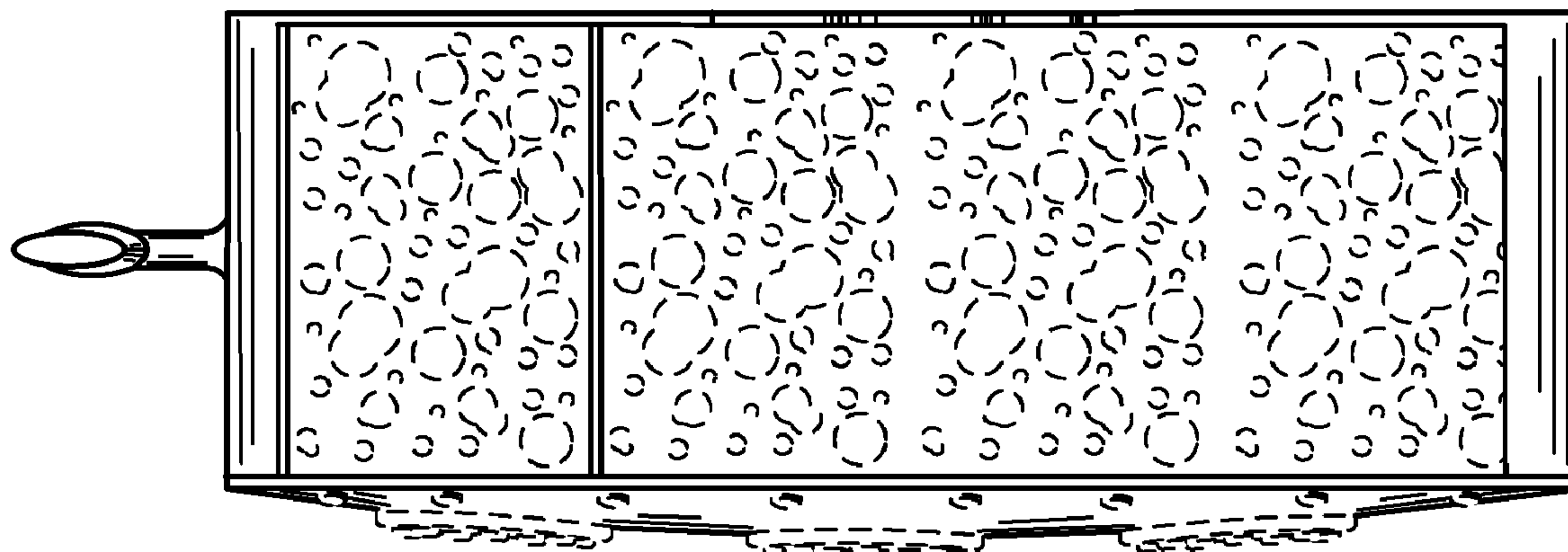

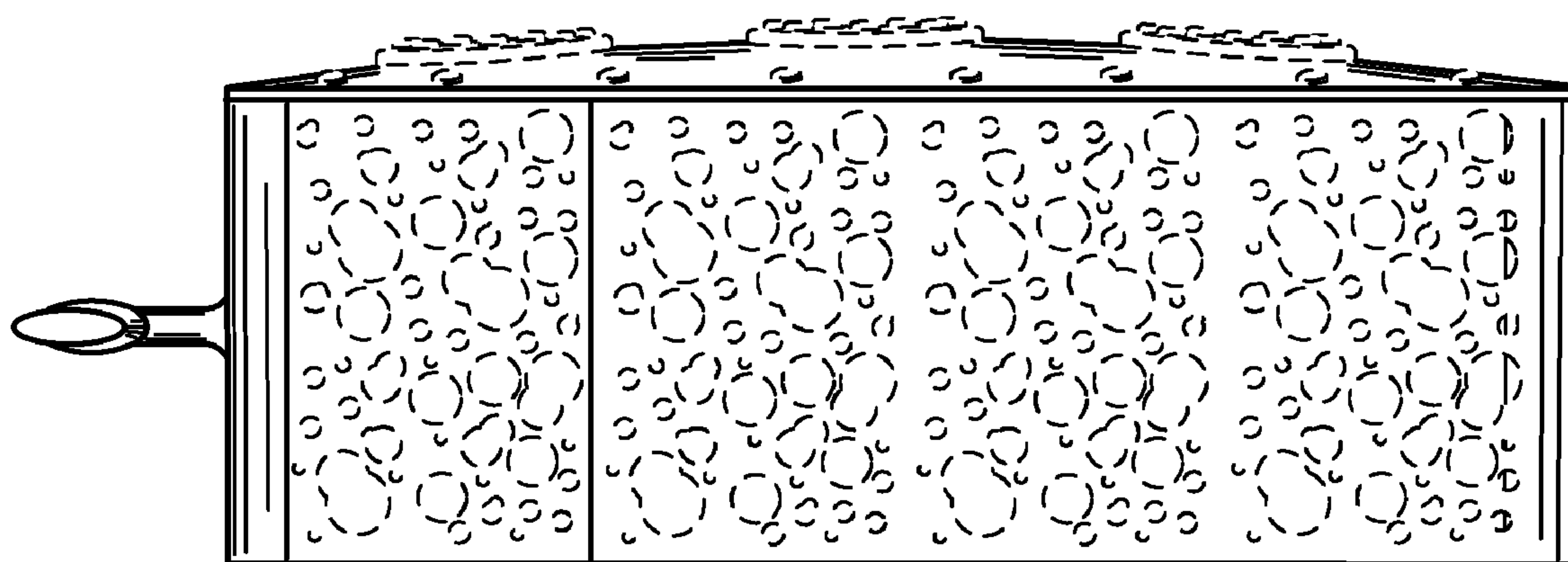

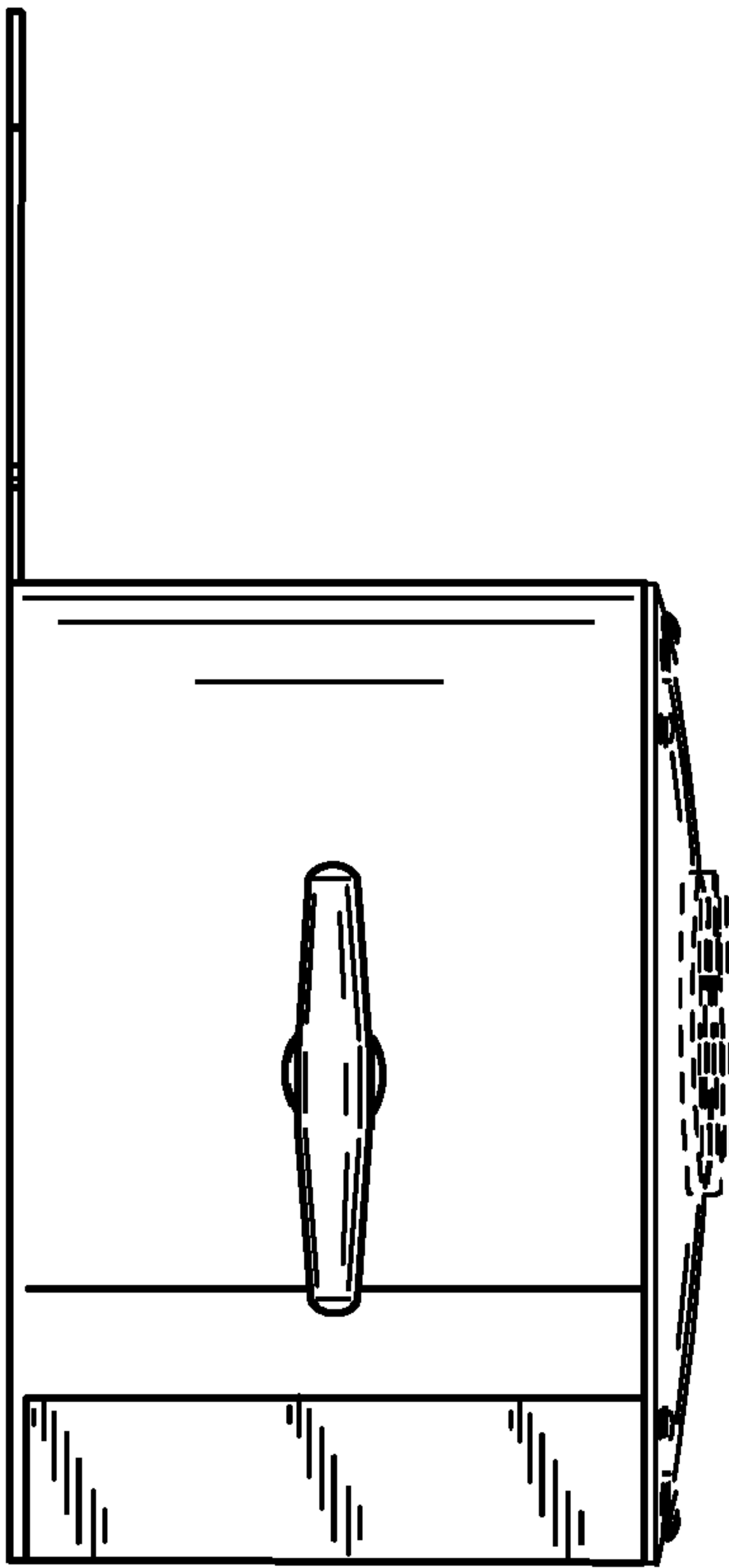
