FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;

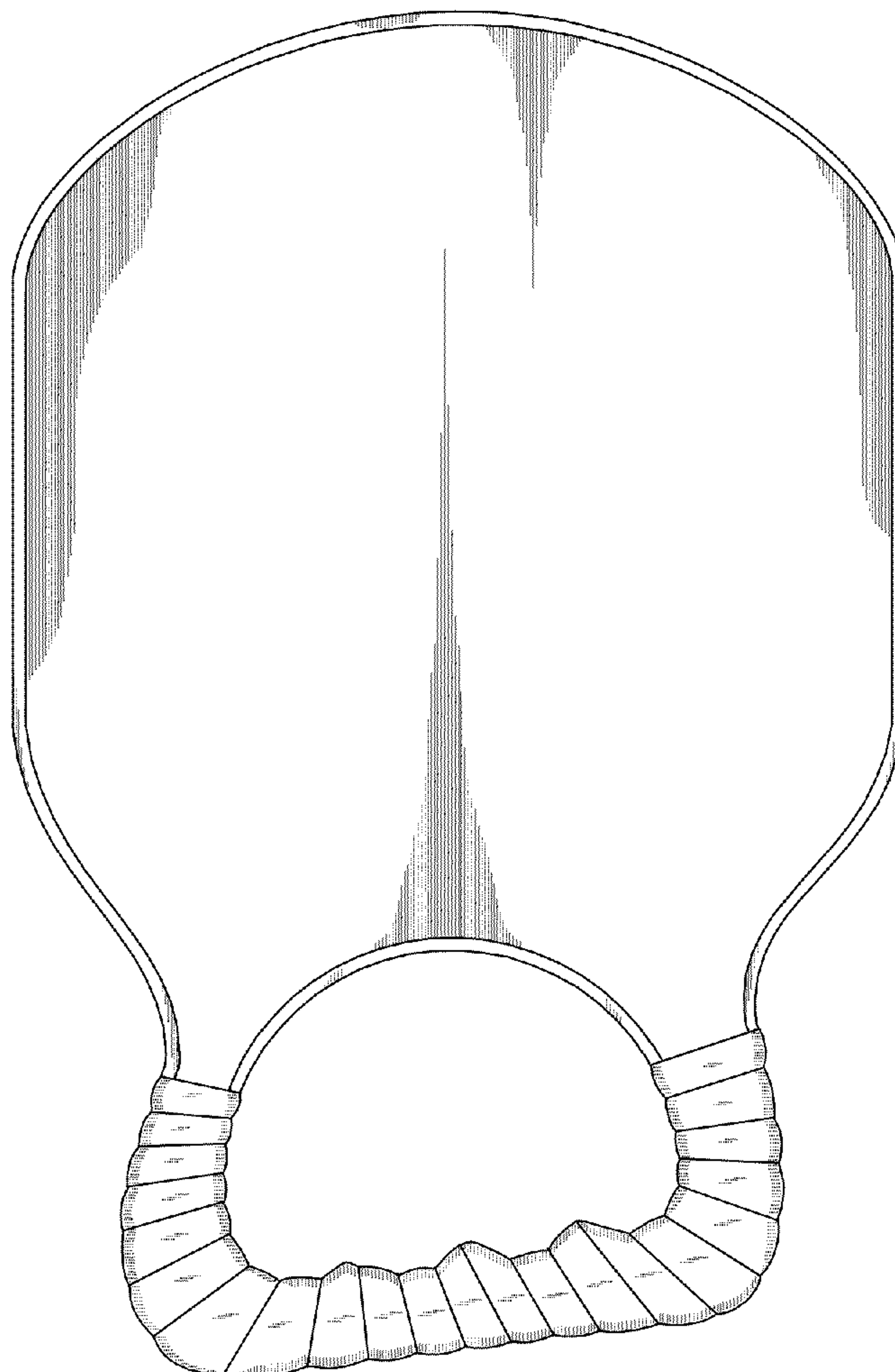
FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;

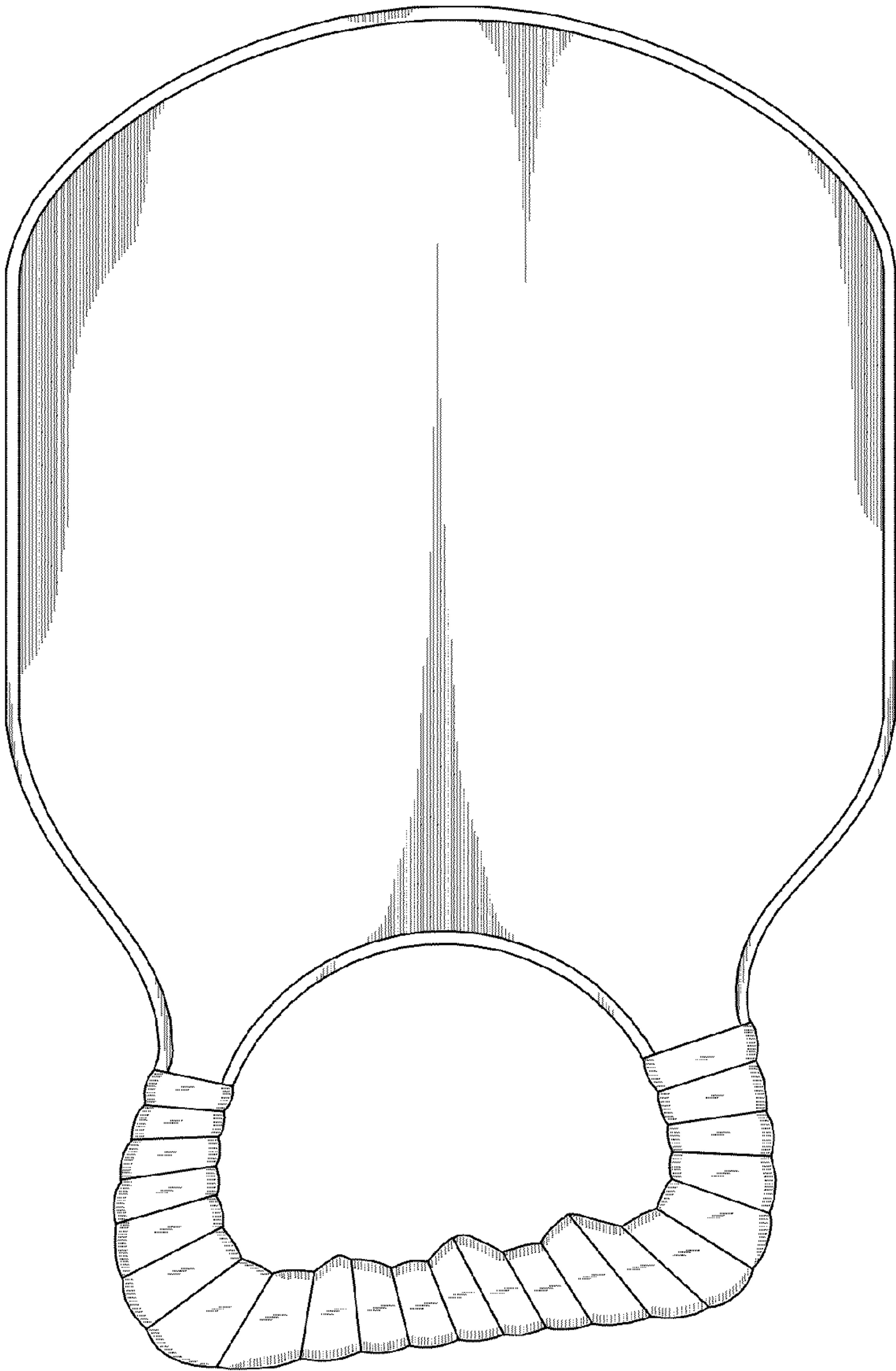

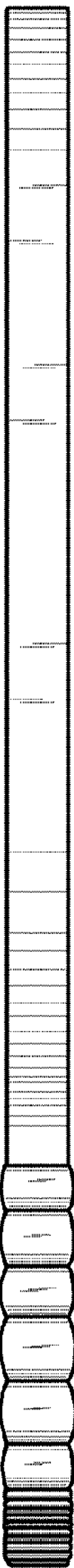

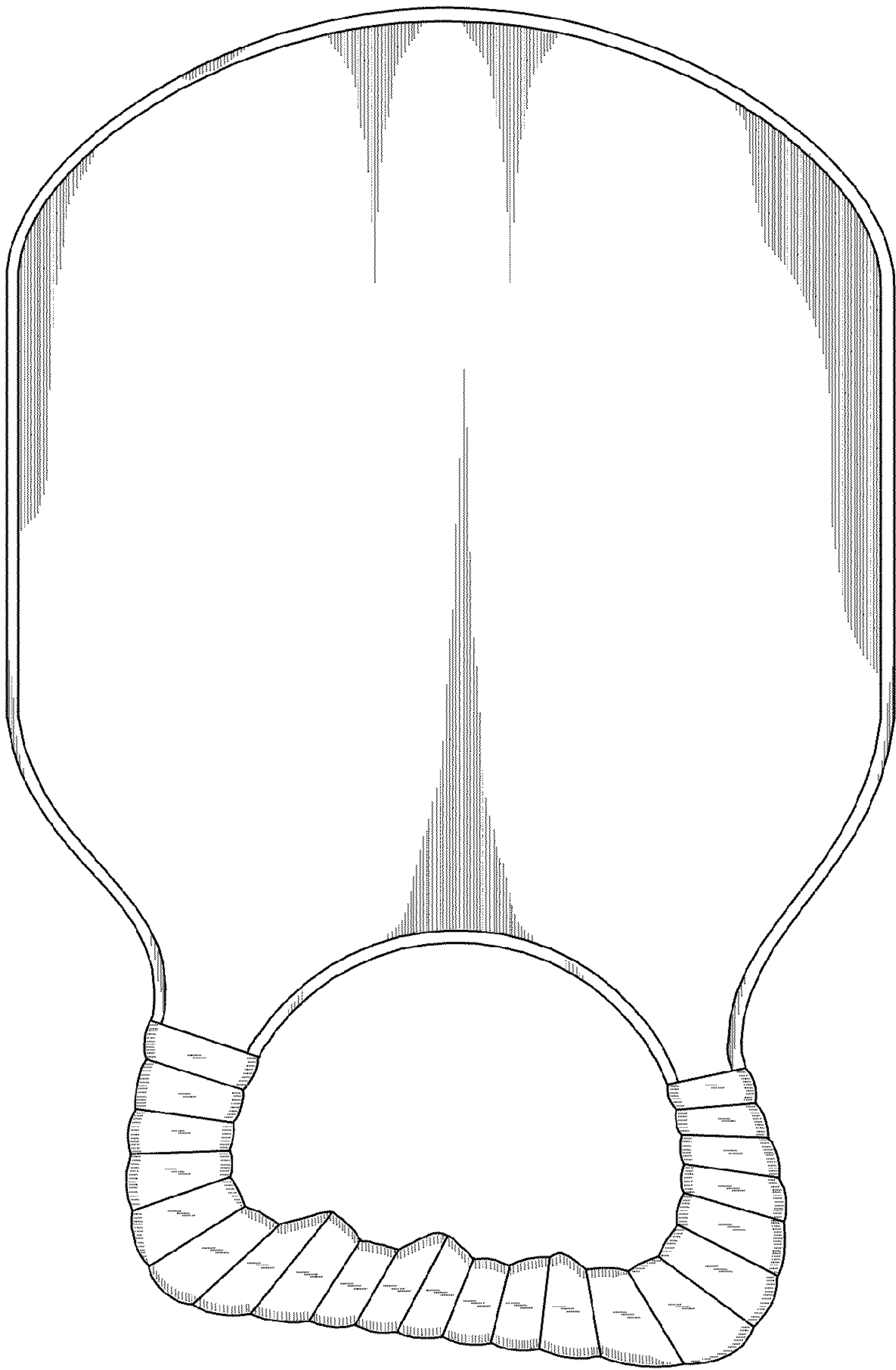

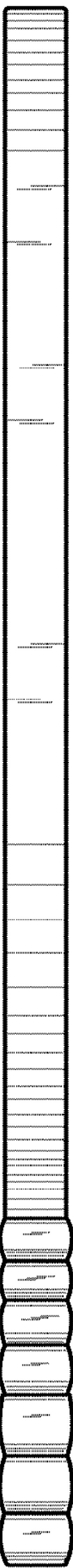
