The ornamental design for a reversible sink facade, as shown and described.

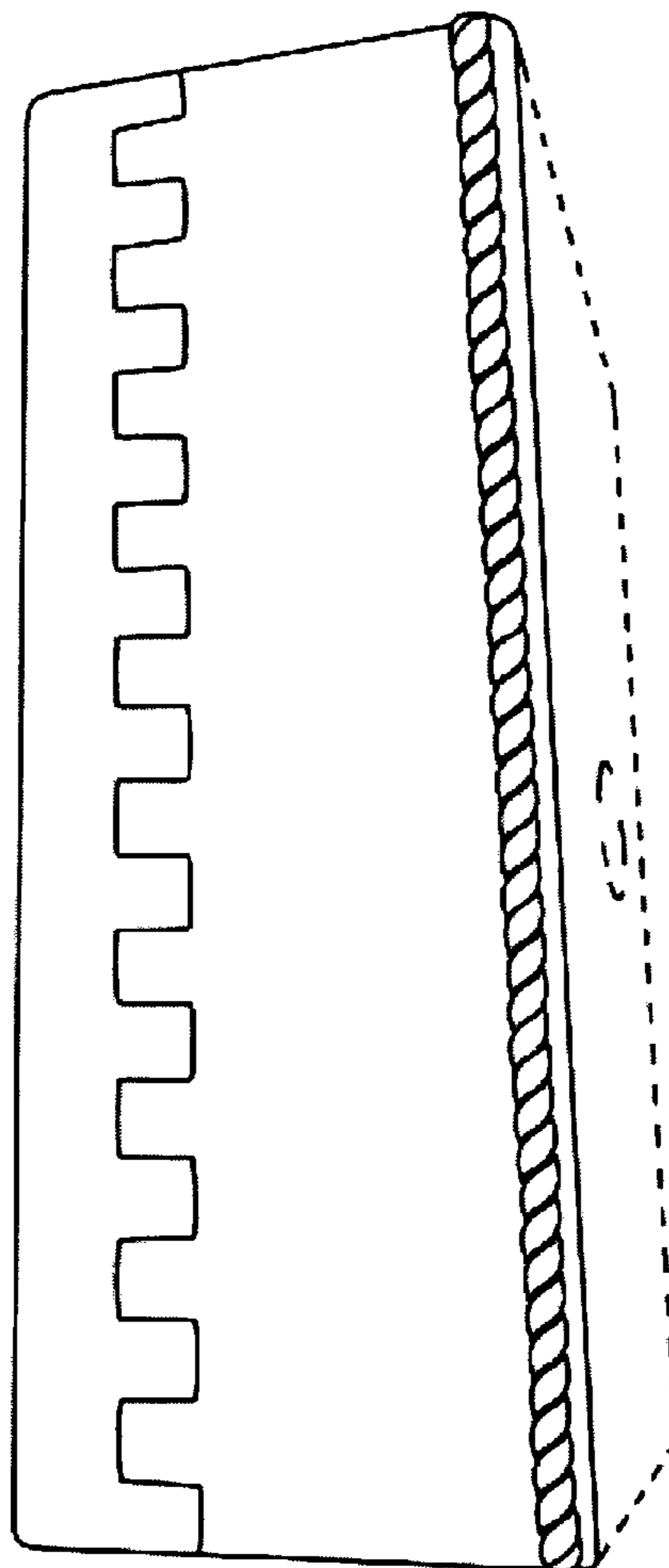
**DESCRIPTION**

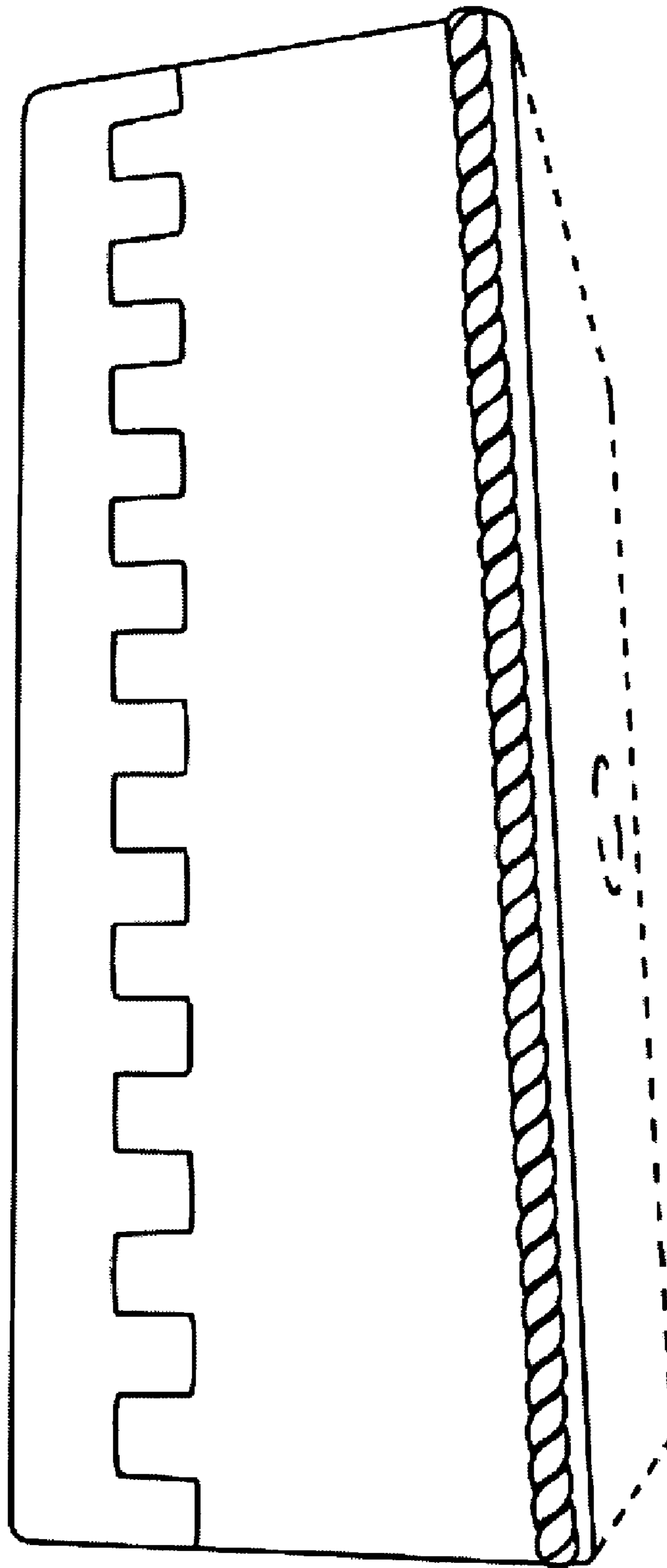

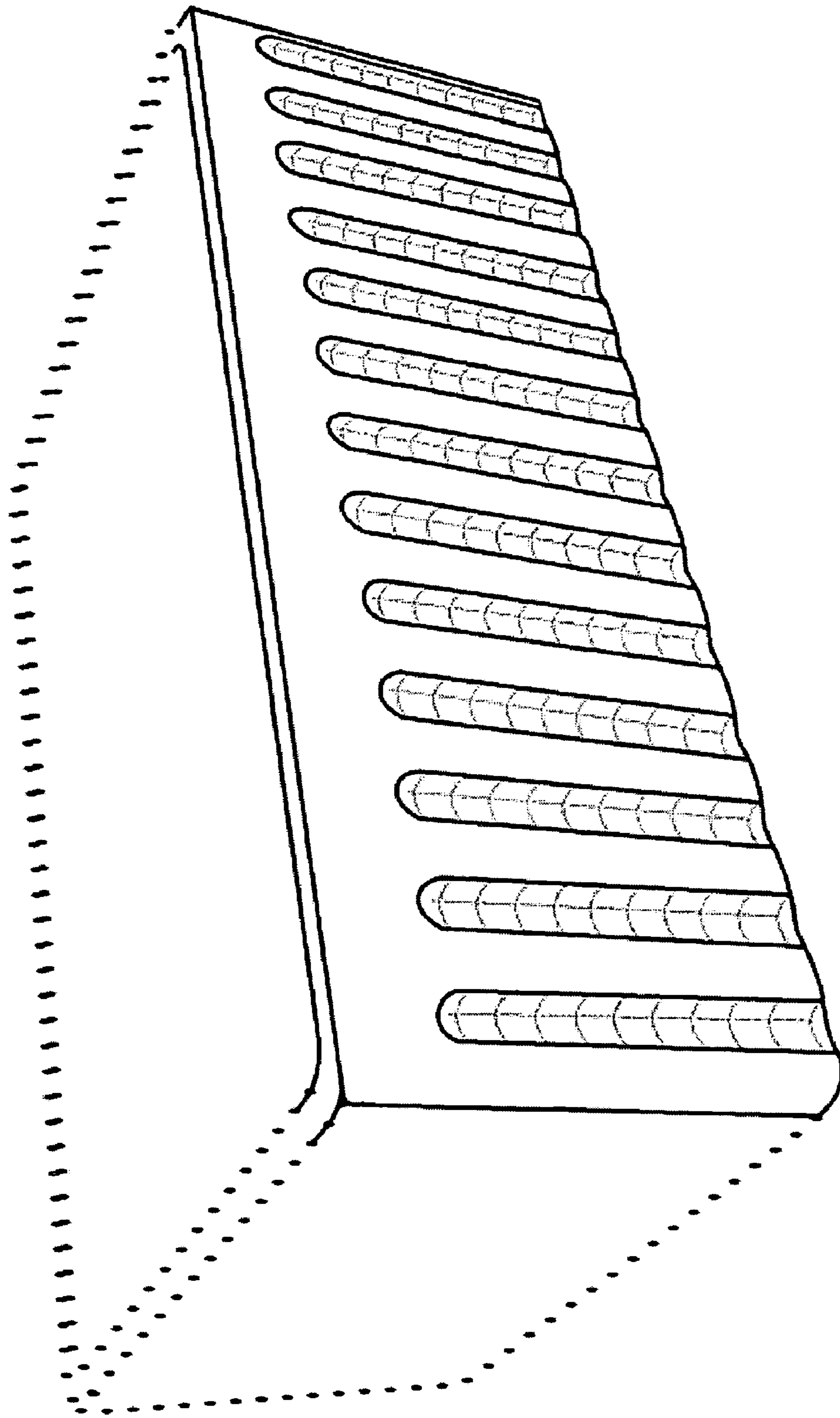
