DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom right perspective view of a boot in accordance with the new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

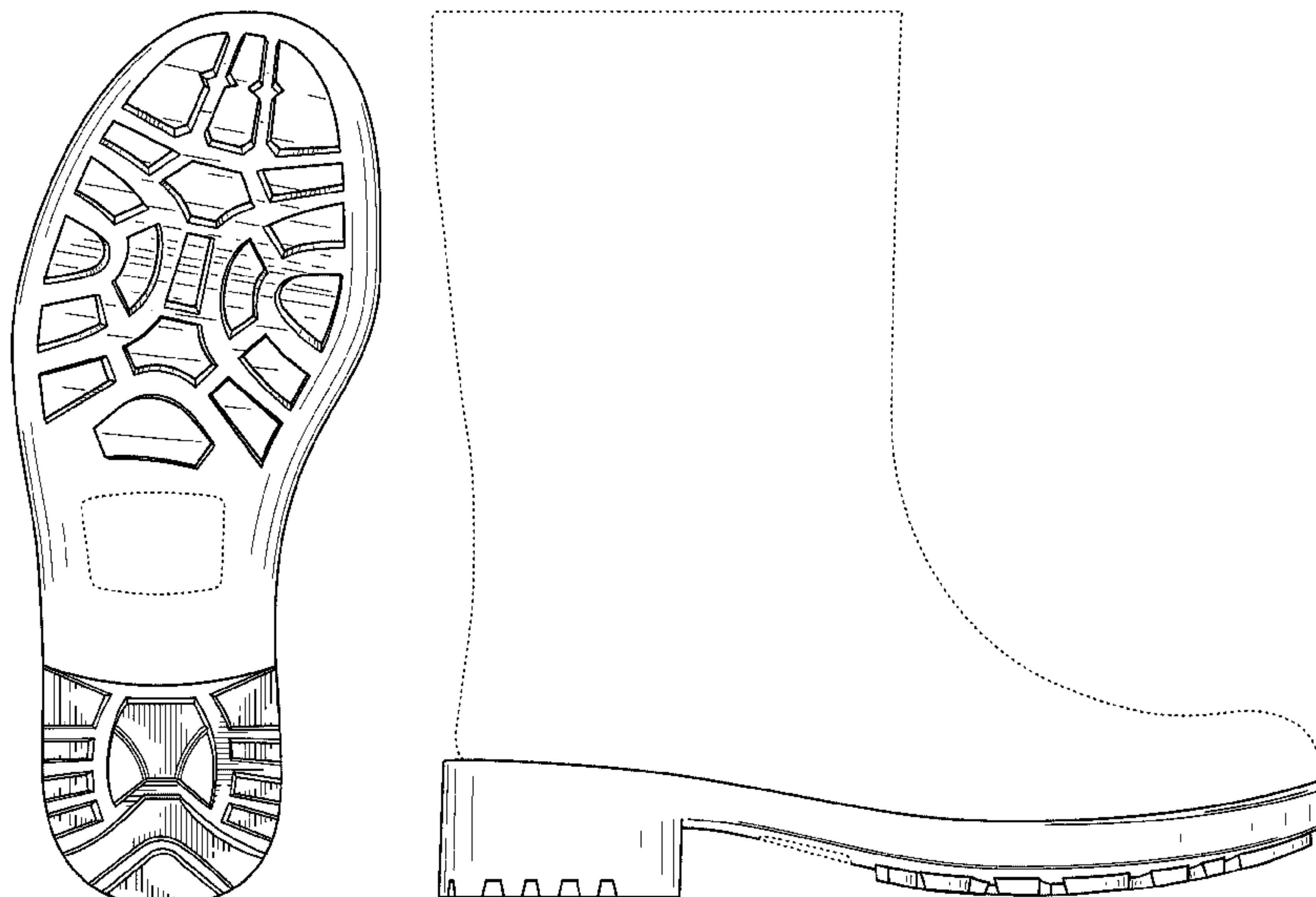
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;

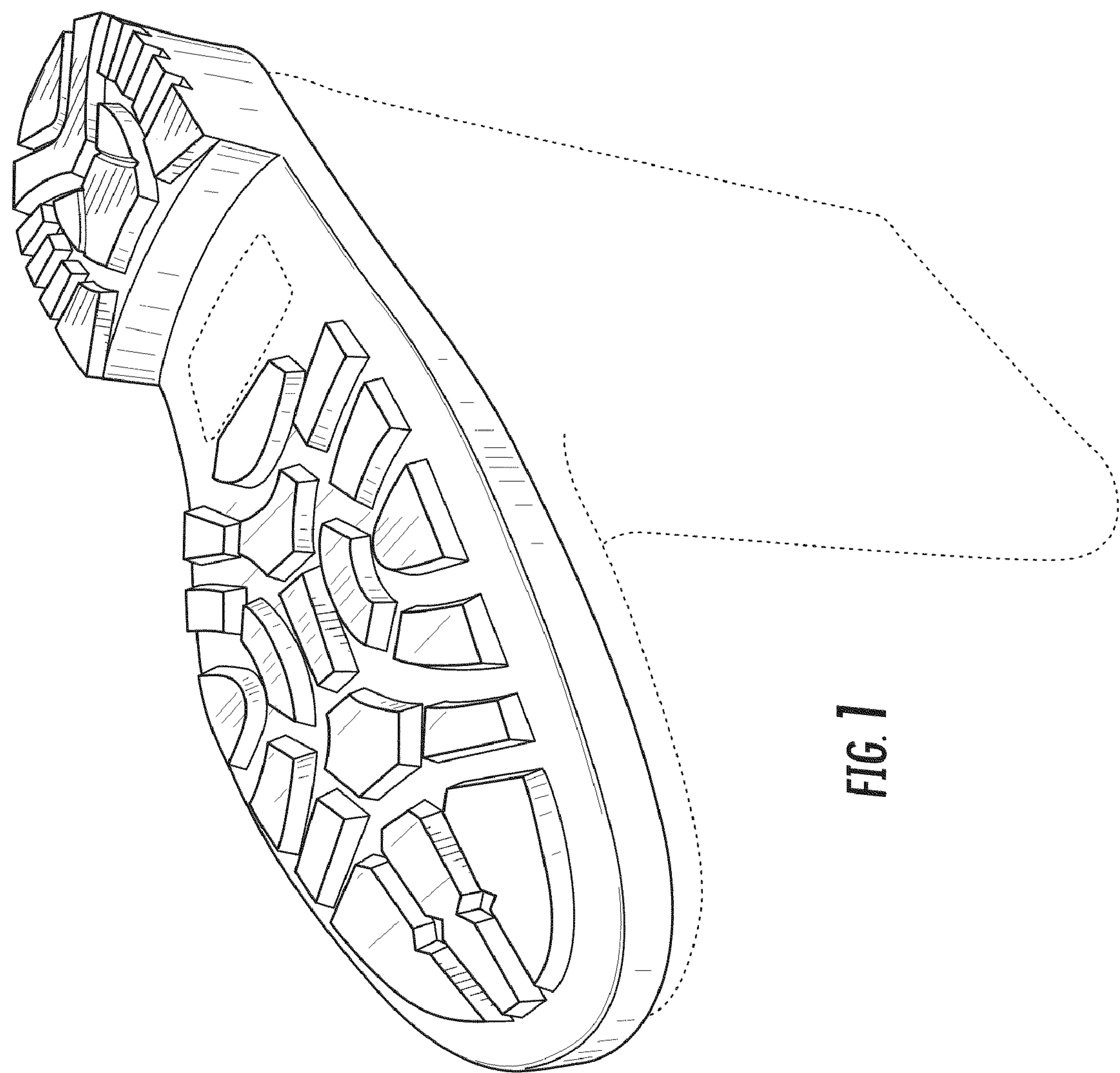

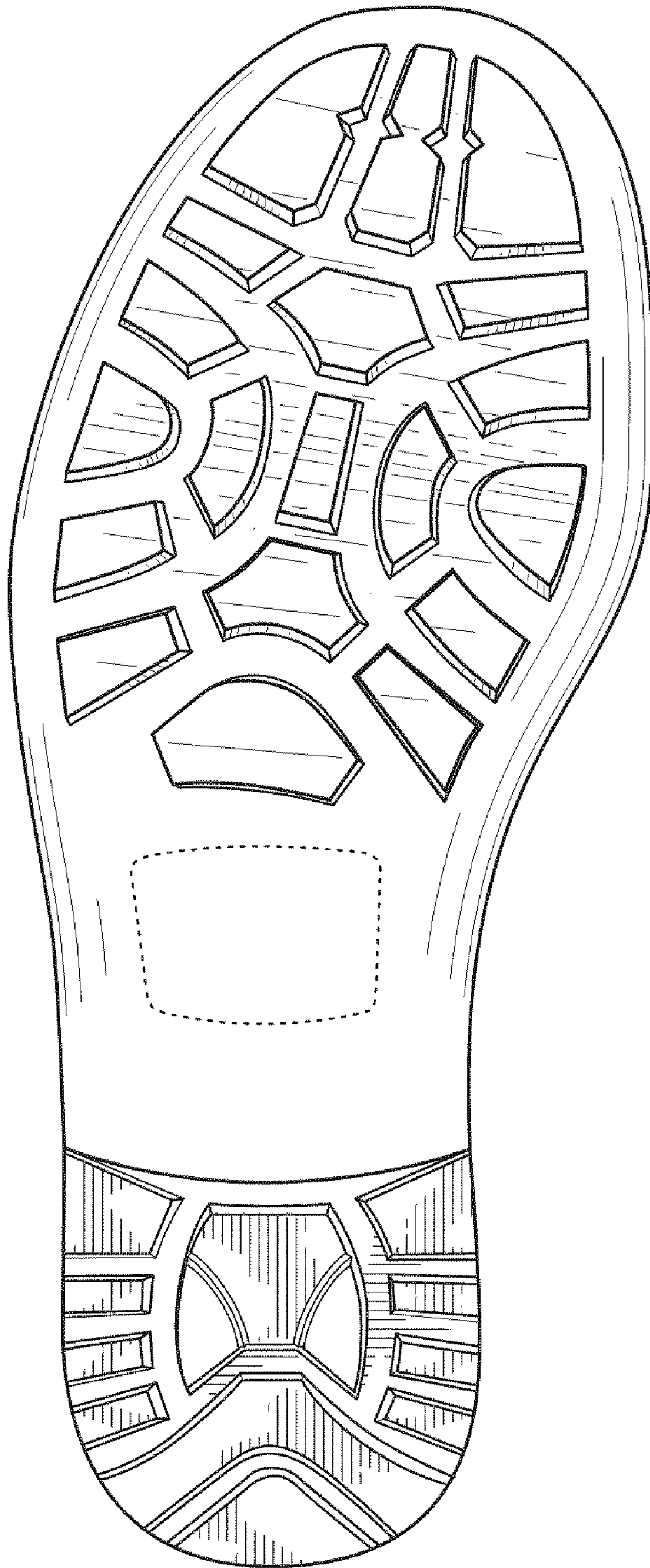

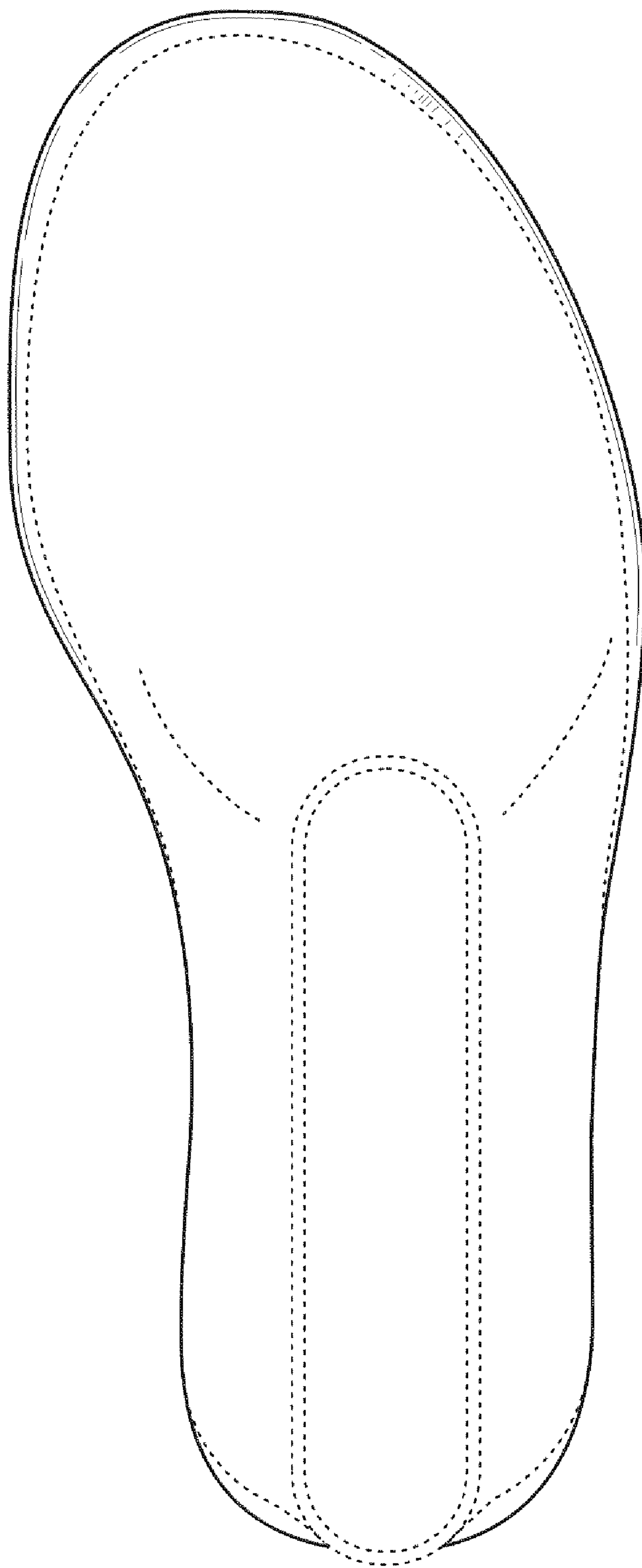

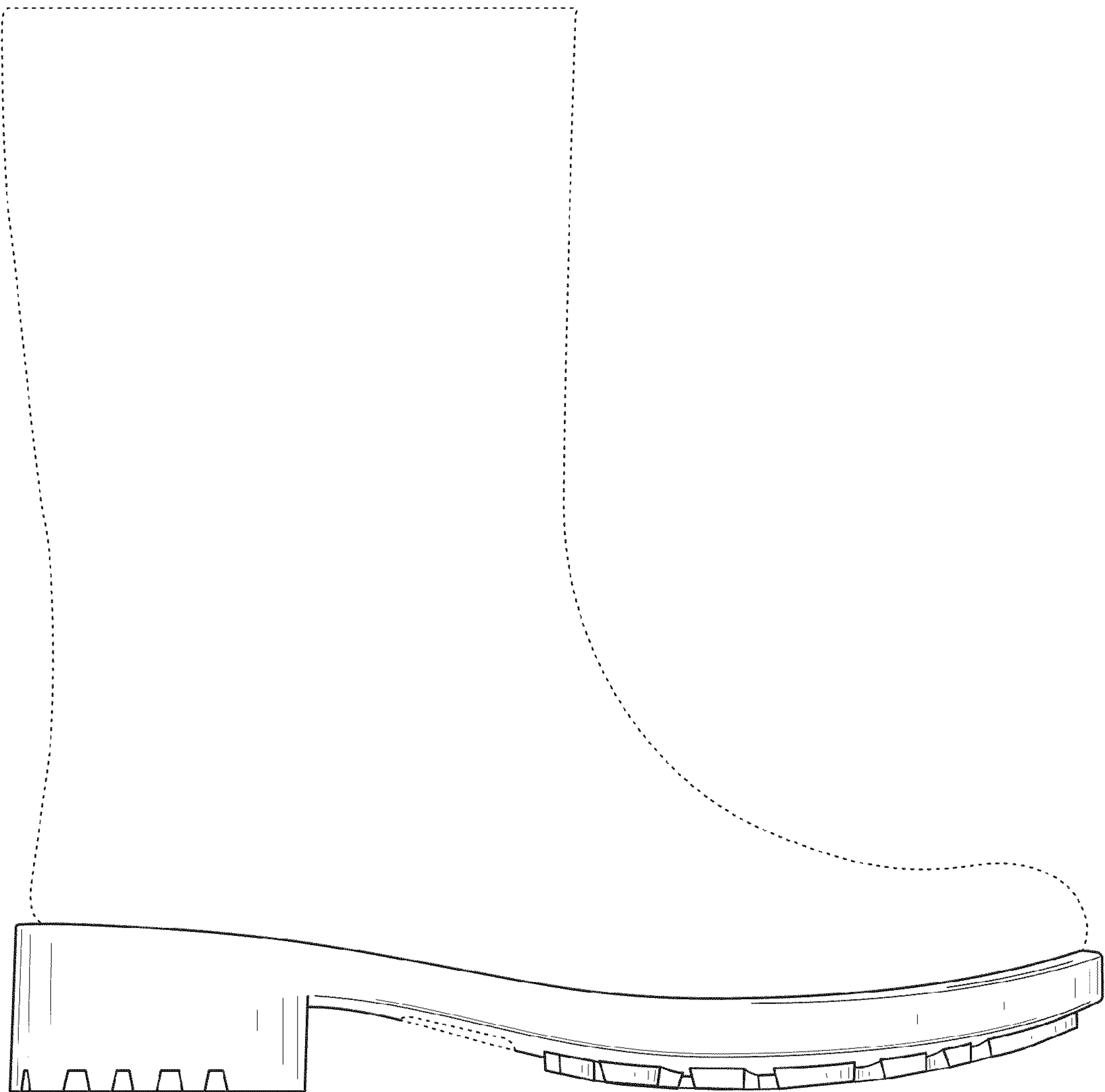

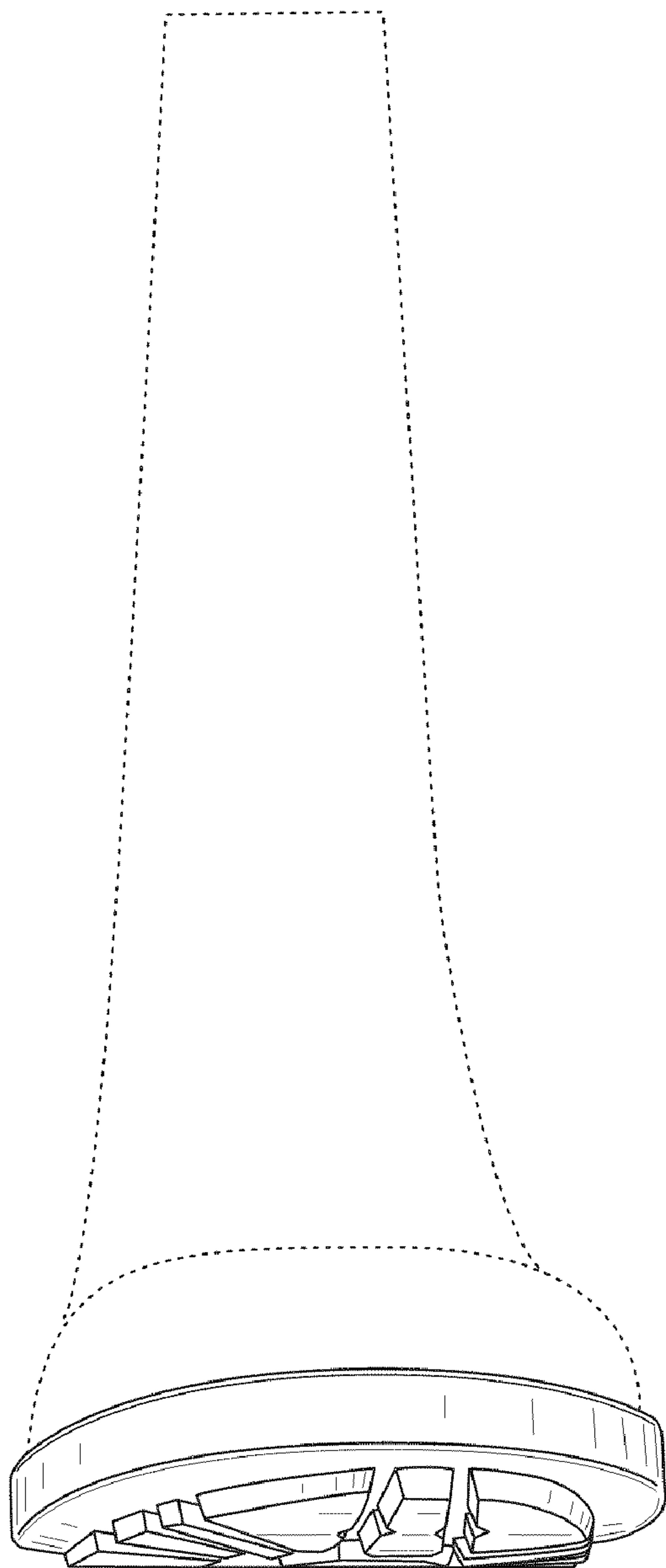

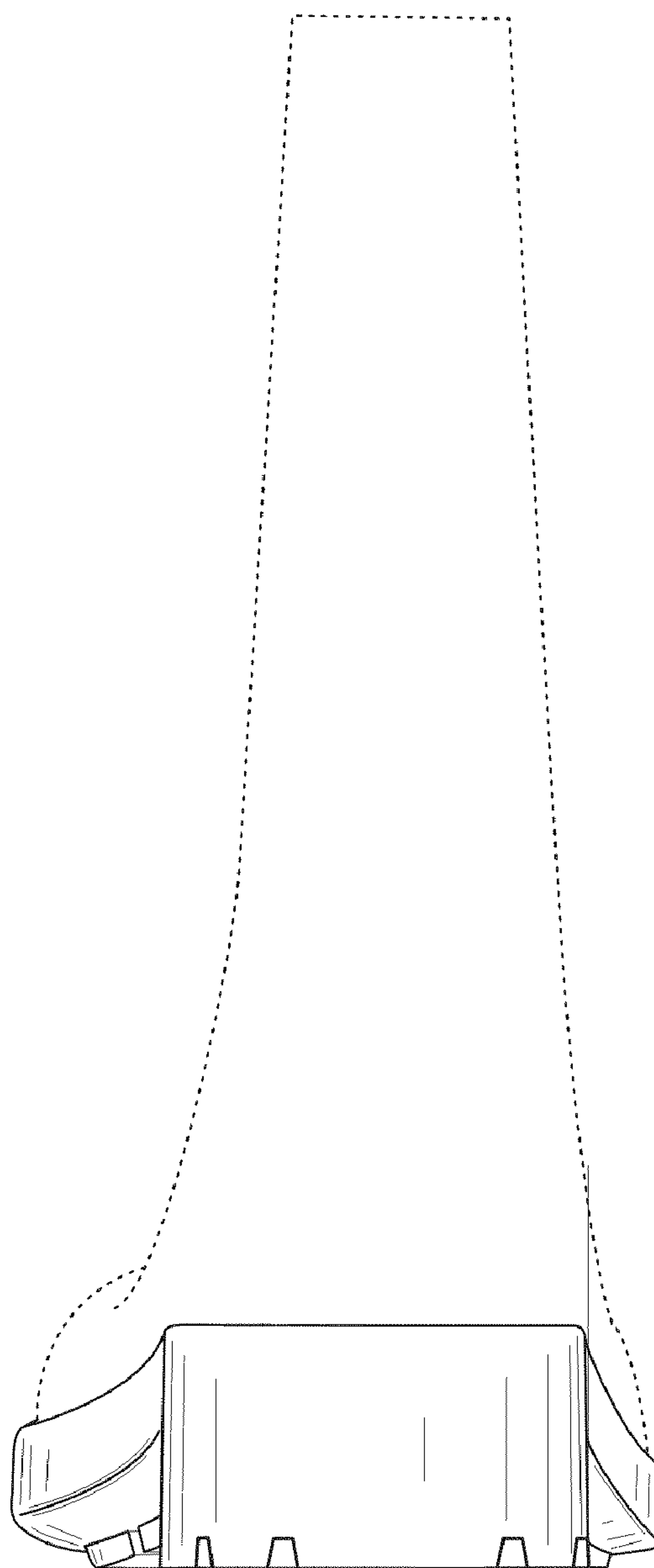
