FIG. 4 is a rear view of this embodiment;

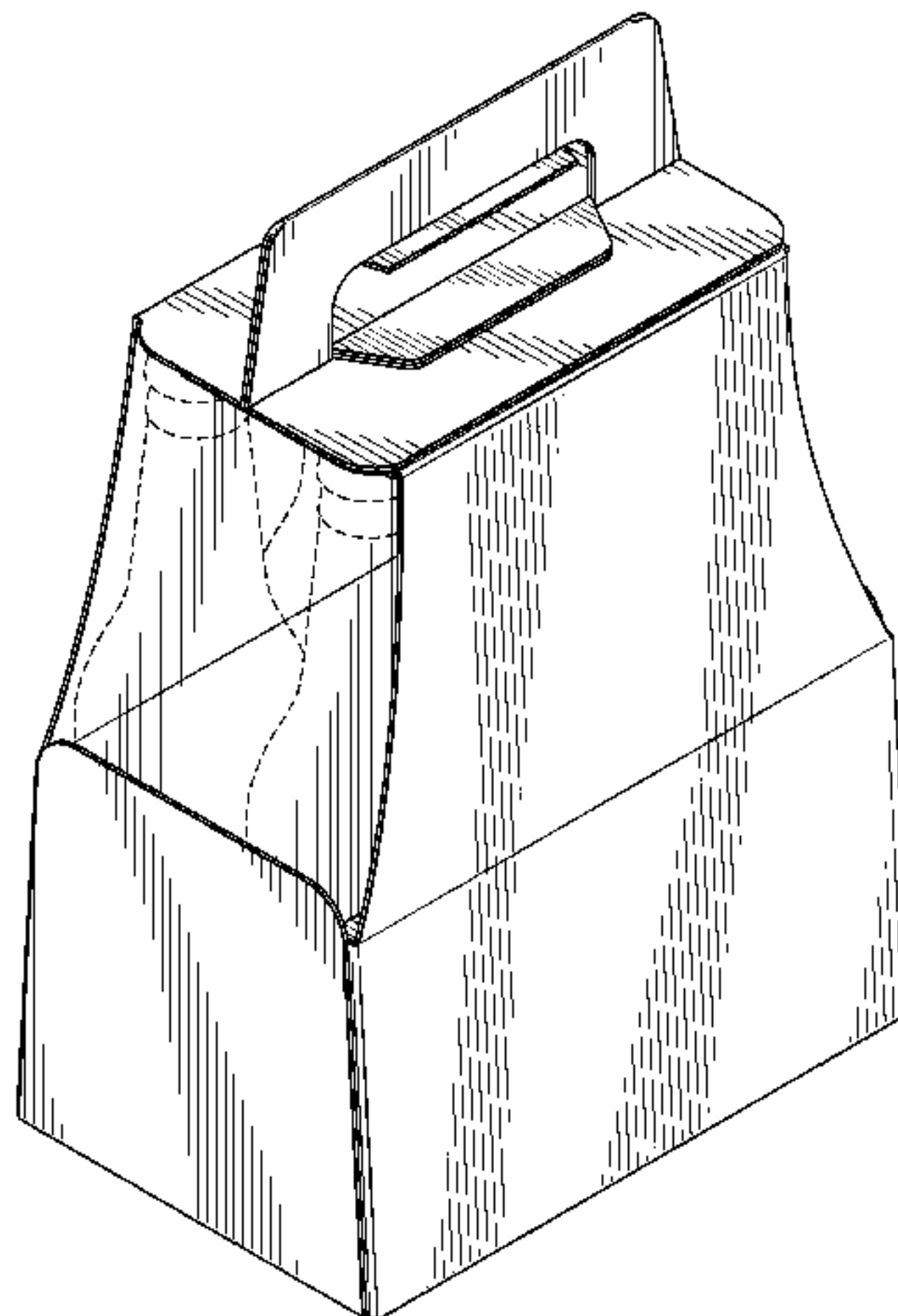
FIG. 5 is a top view of this embodiment;

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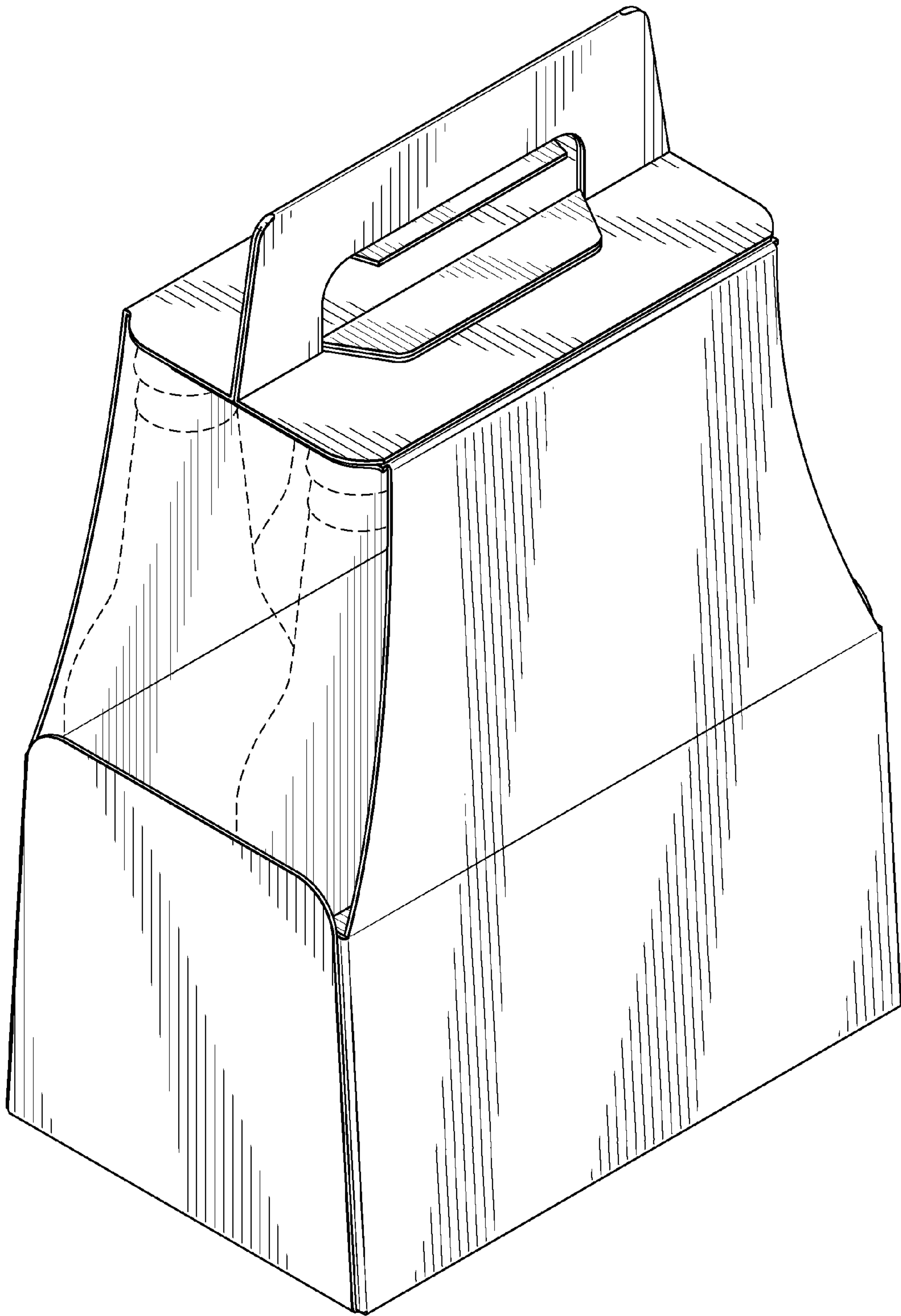

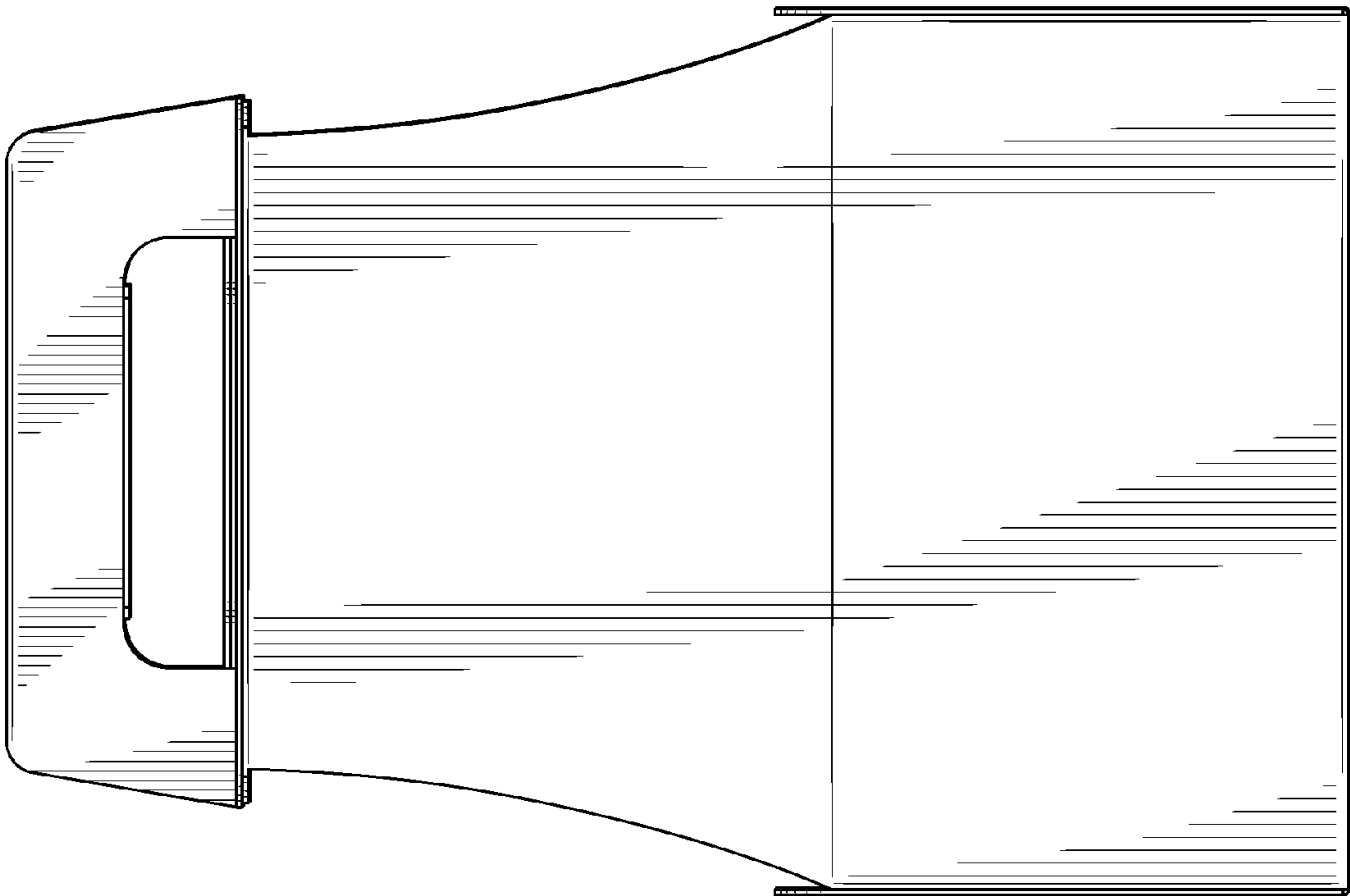

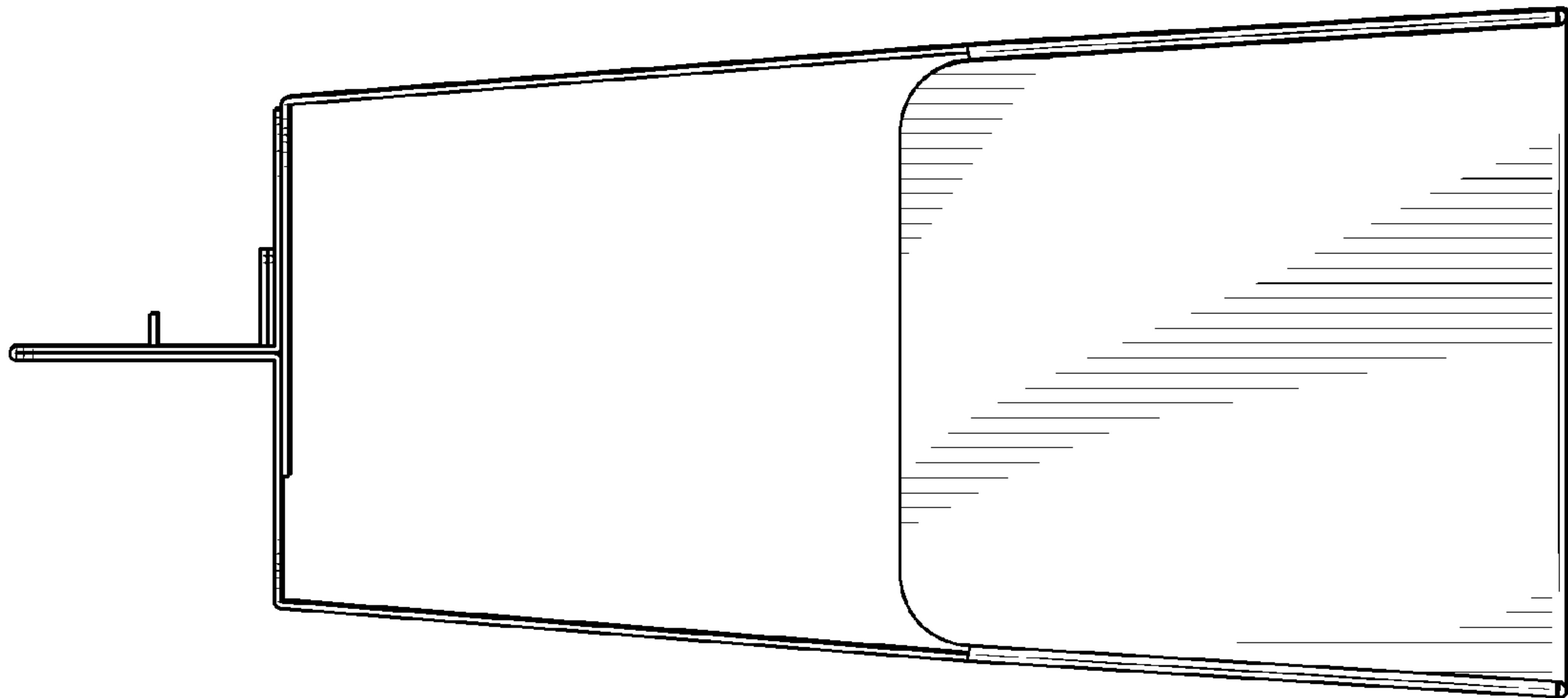

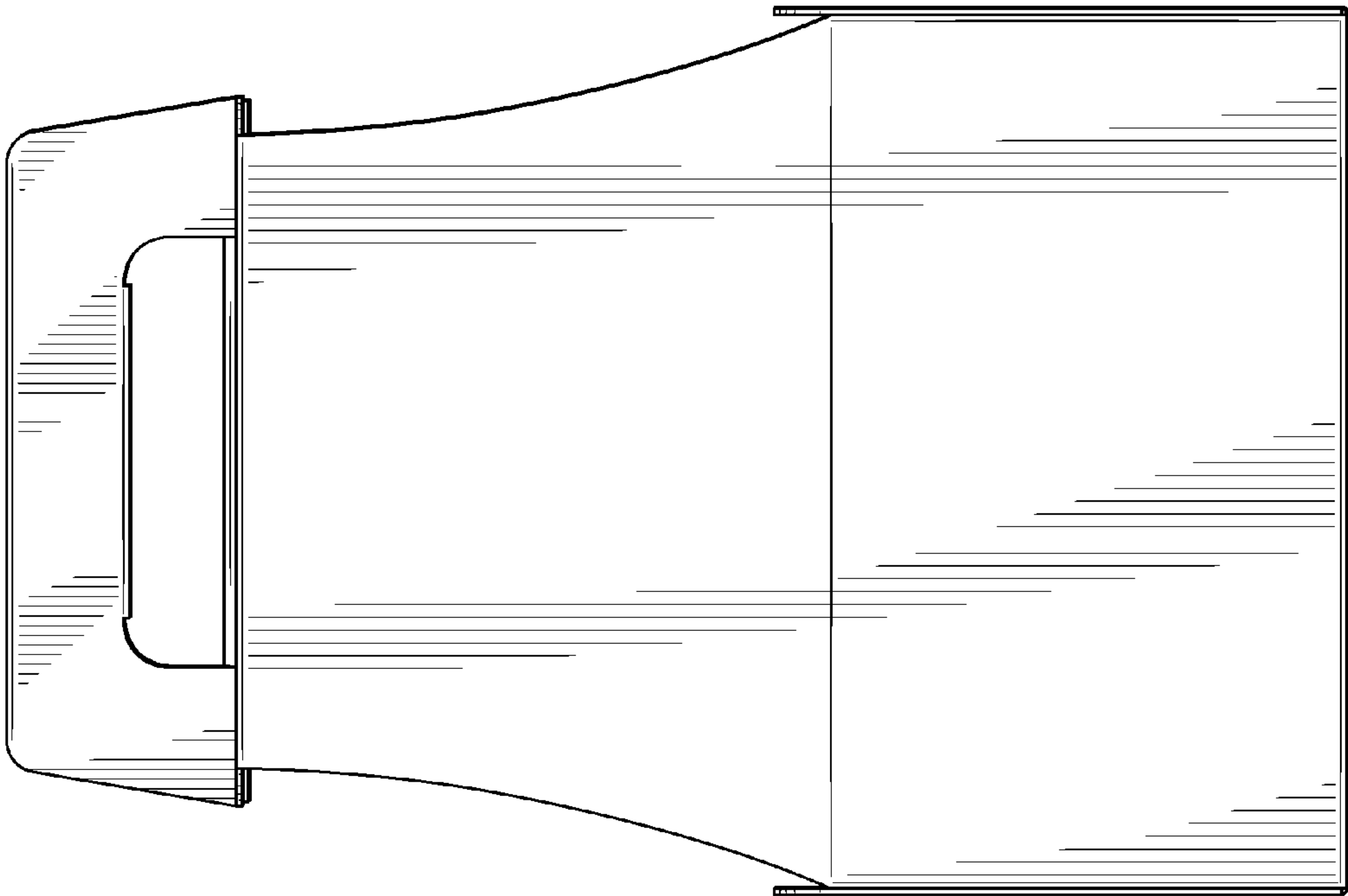

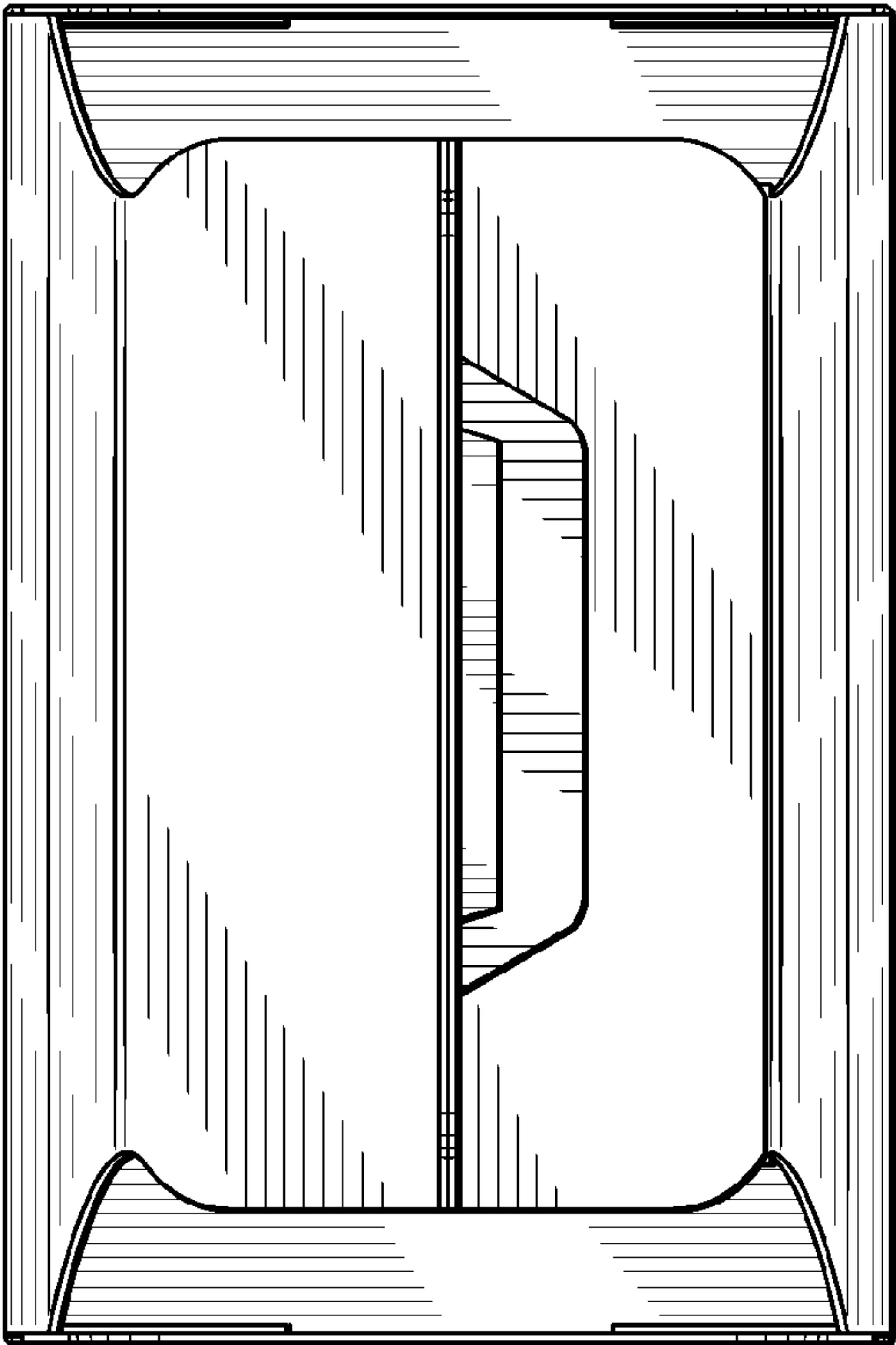

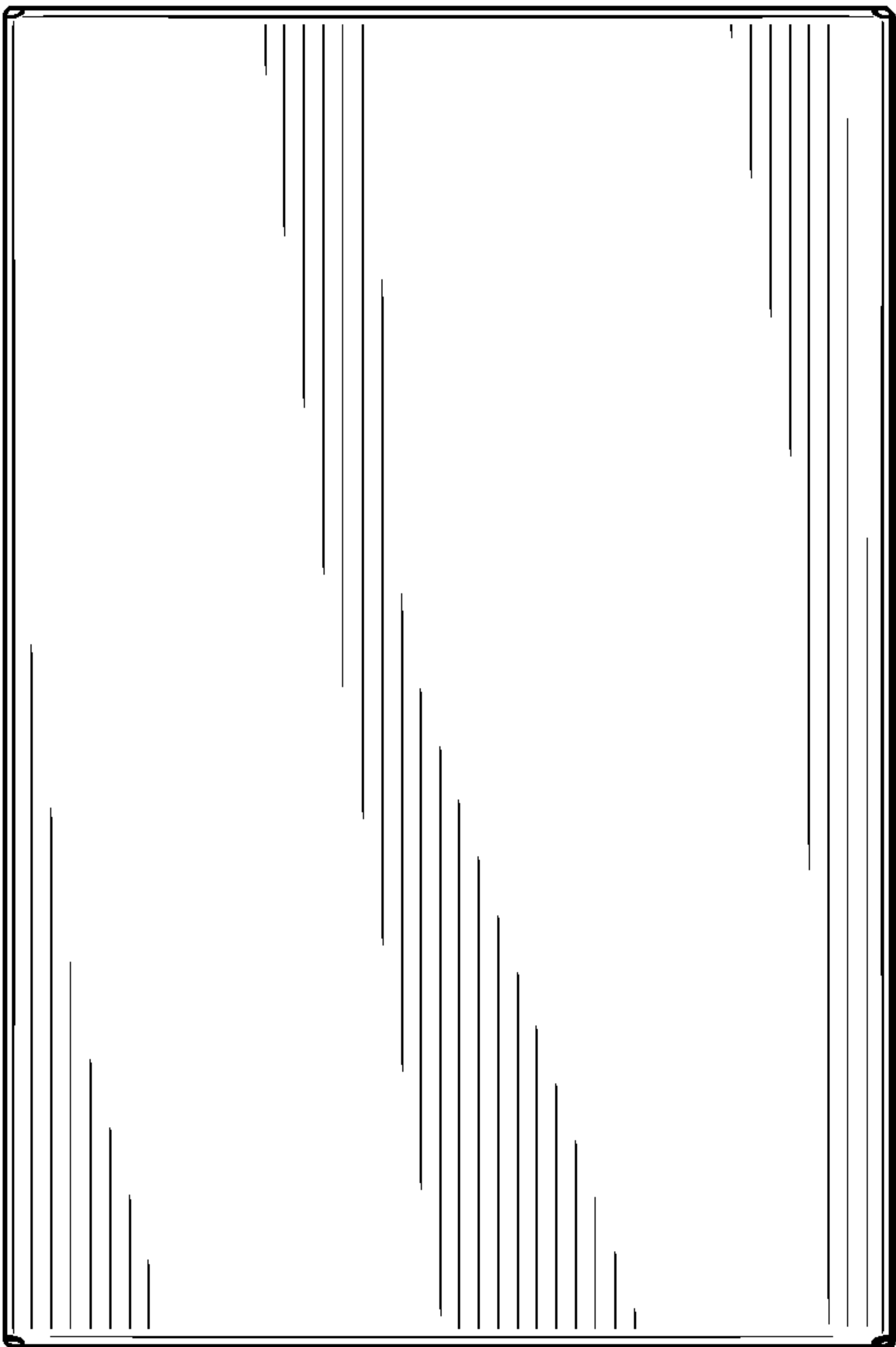

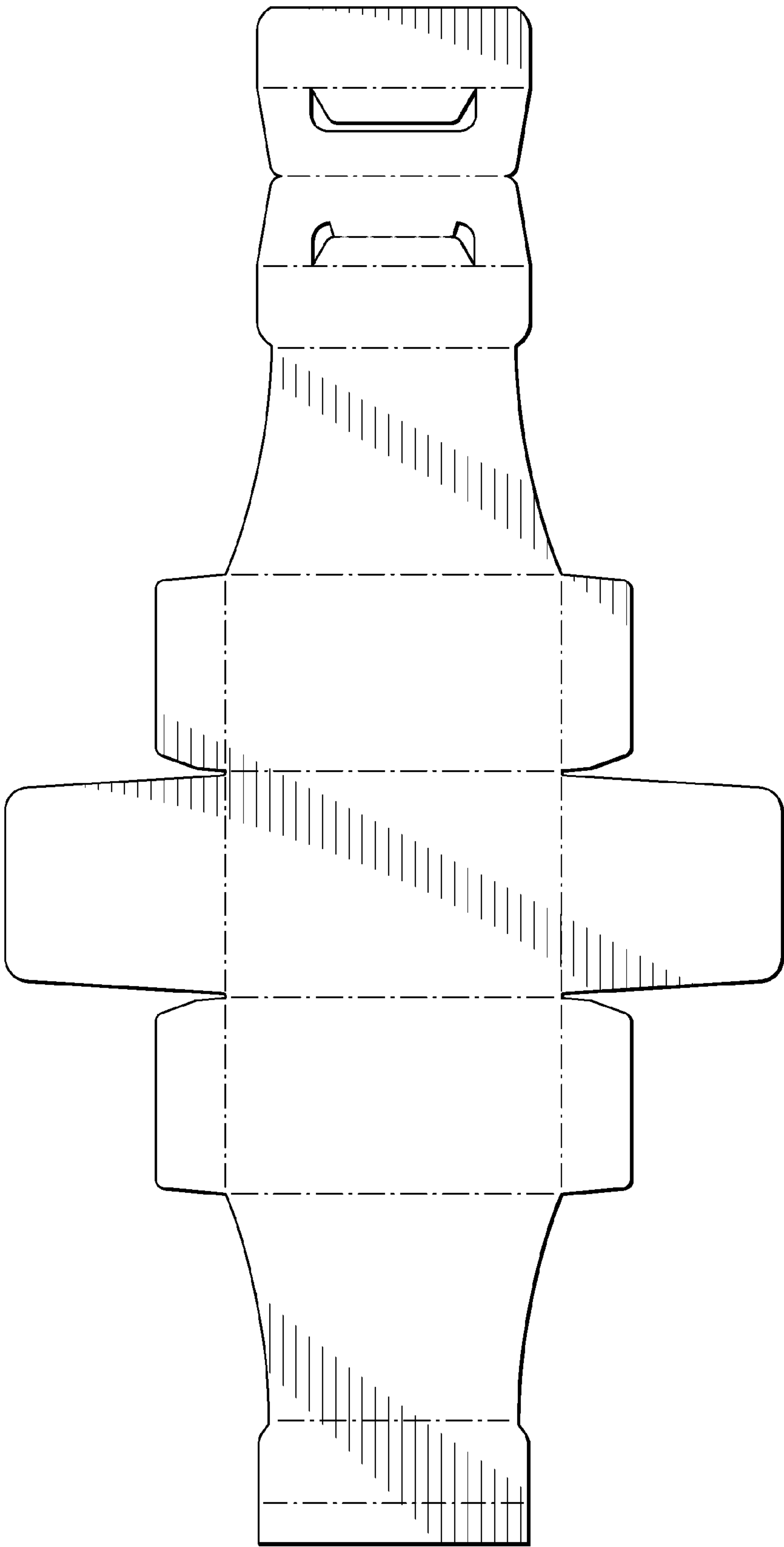
