(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a set of pallet guard terminators, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a socket terminator of a set of pallet guard terminators showing our new design;

FIG. 14 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 16 is a right side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 17 is a front elevation view showing the set of pallet guard terminators in connection with a pallet guard arrangement;

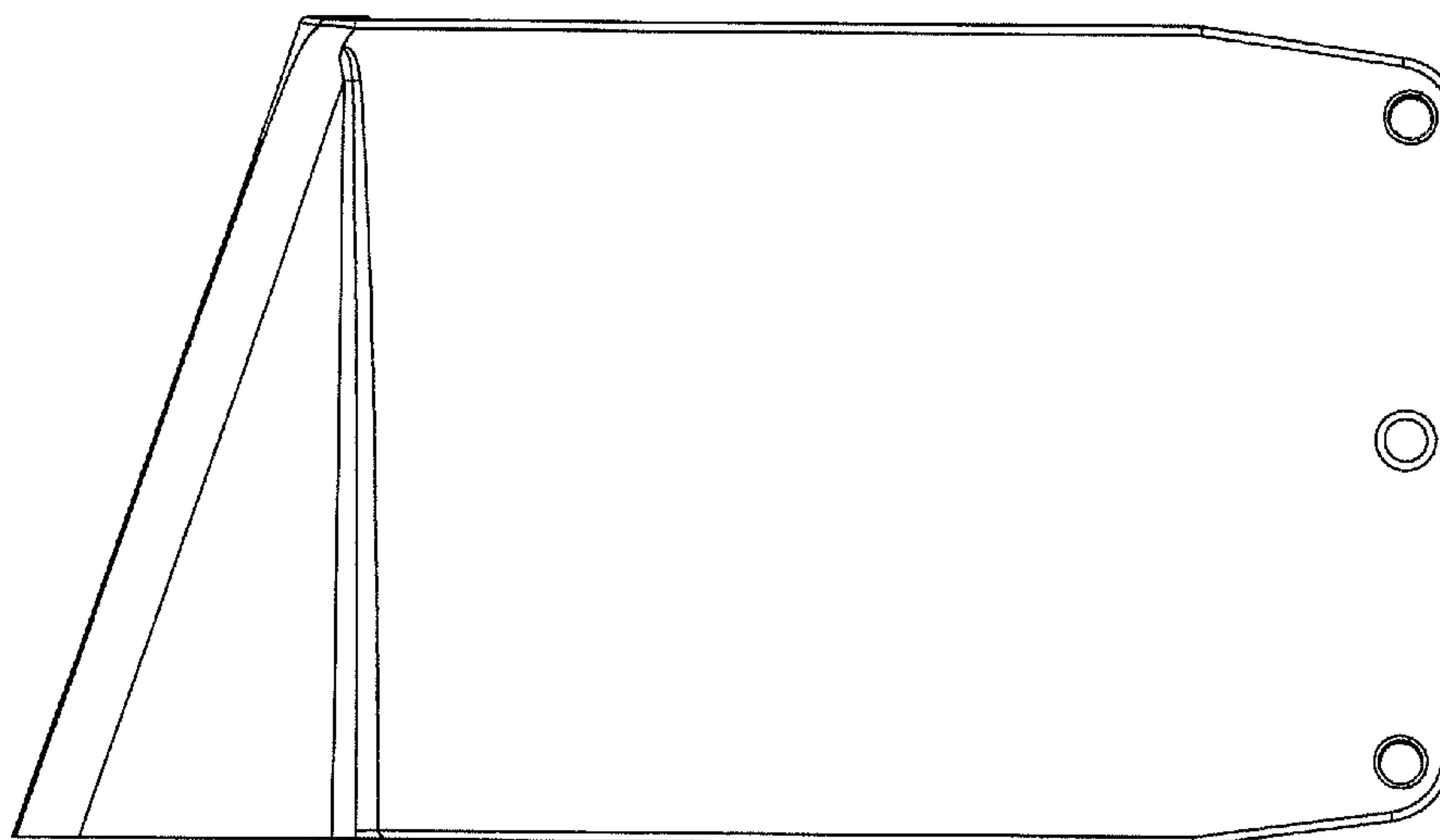
FIG. 18 is a front perspective view thereof; and,

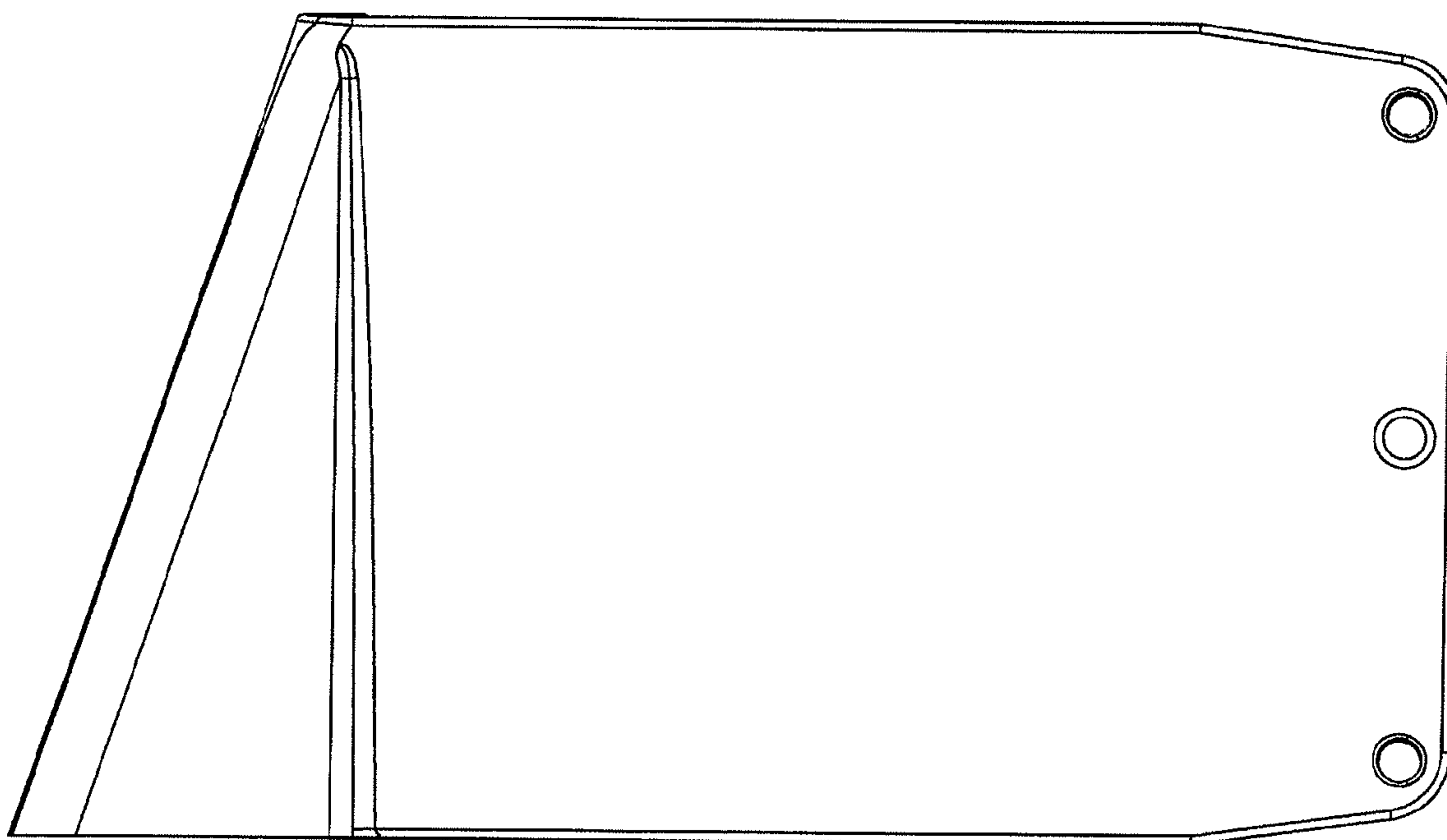

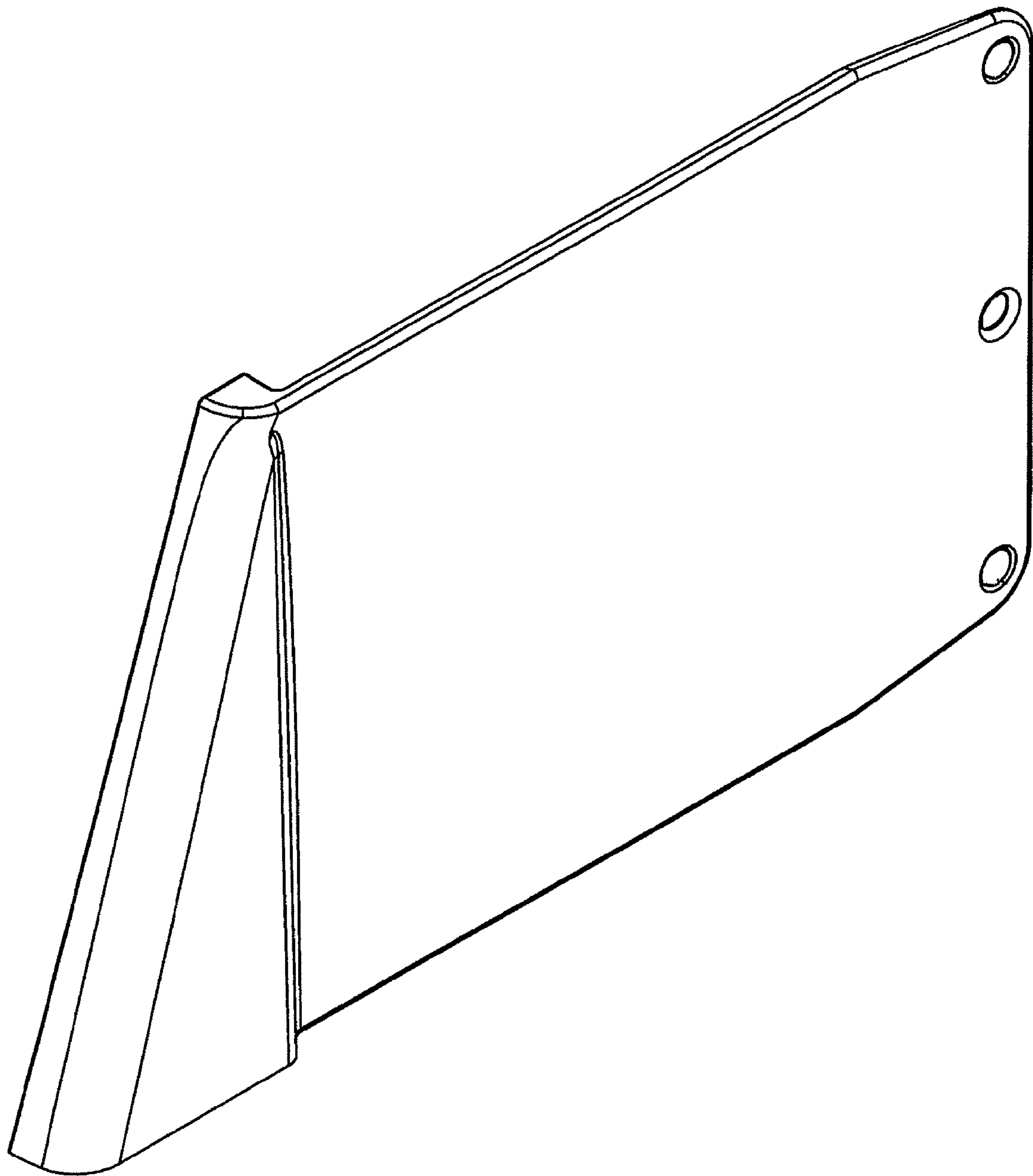

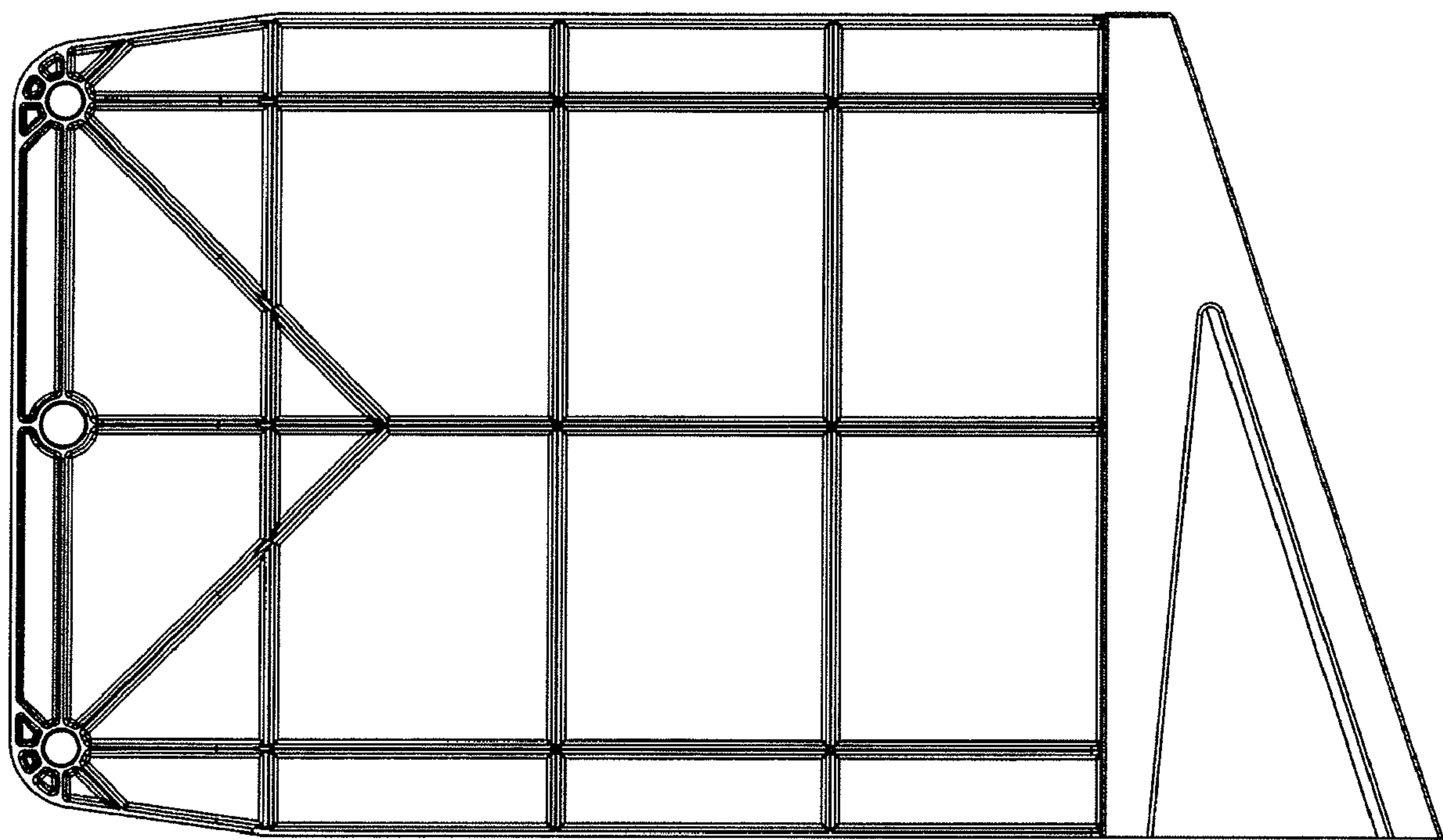

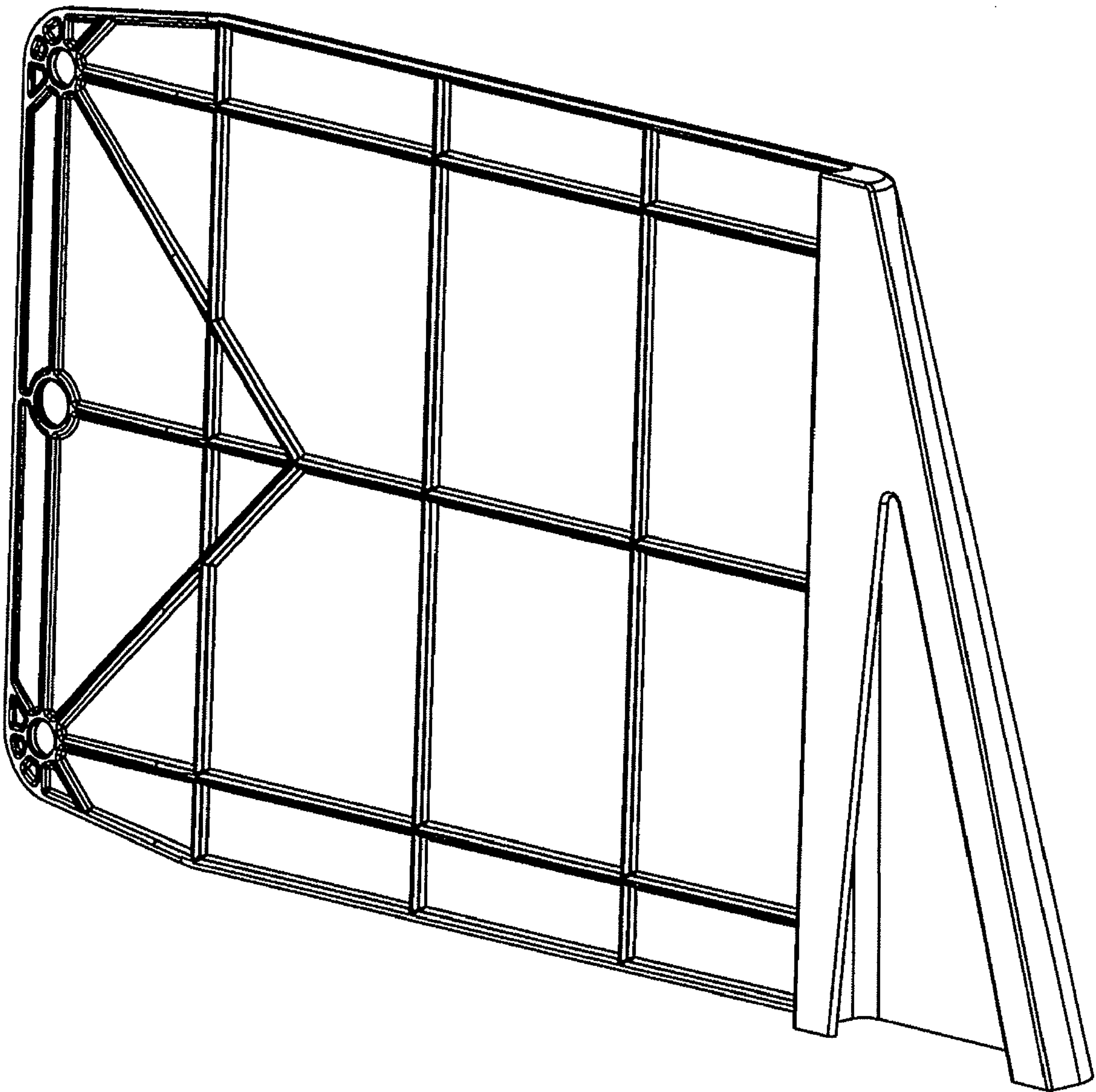

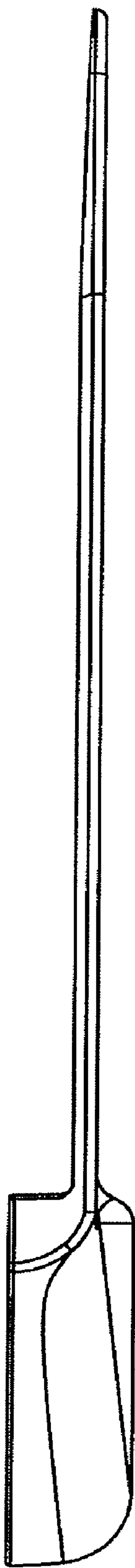

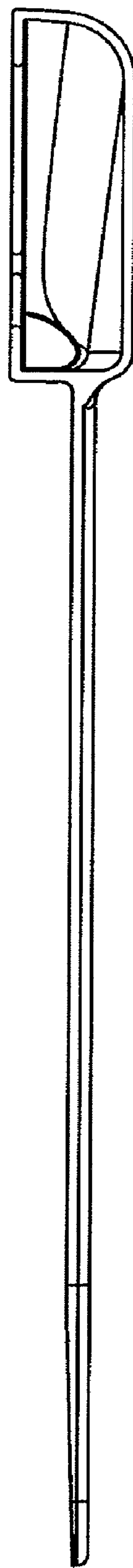

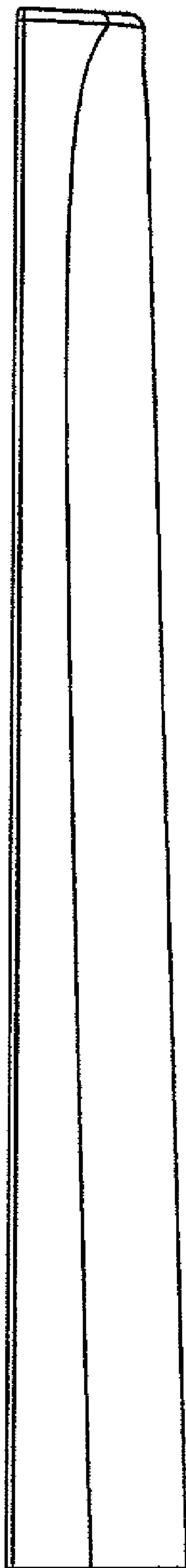

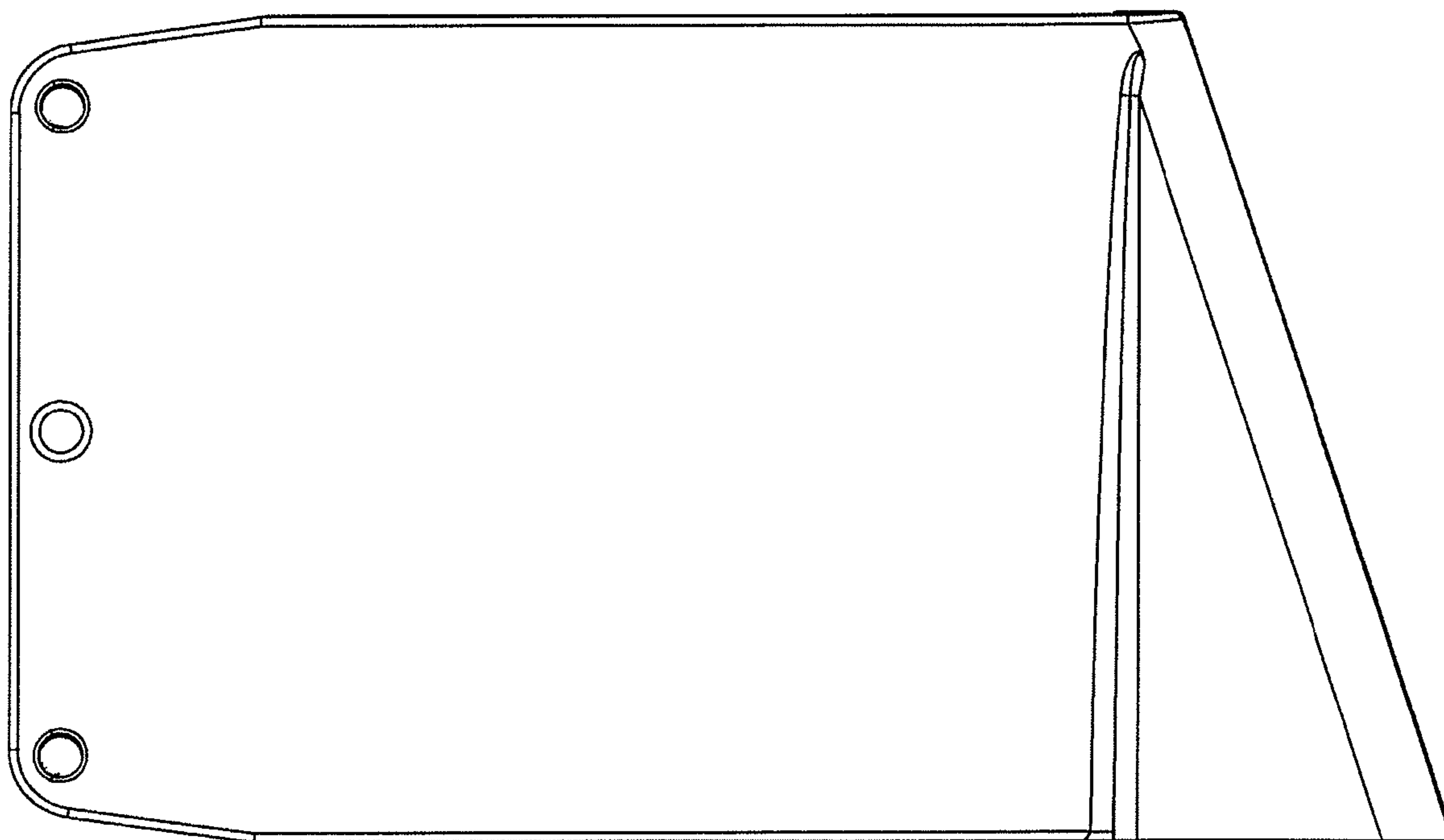

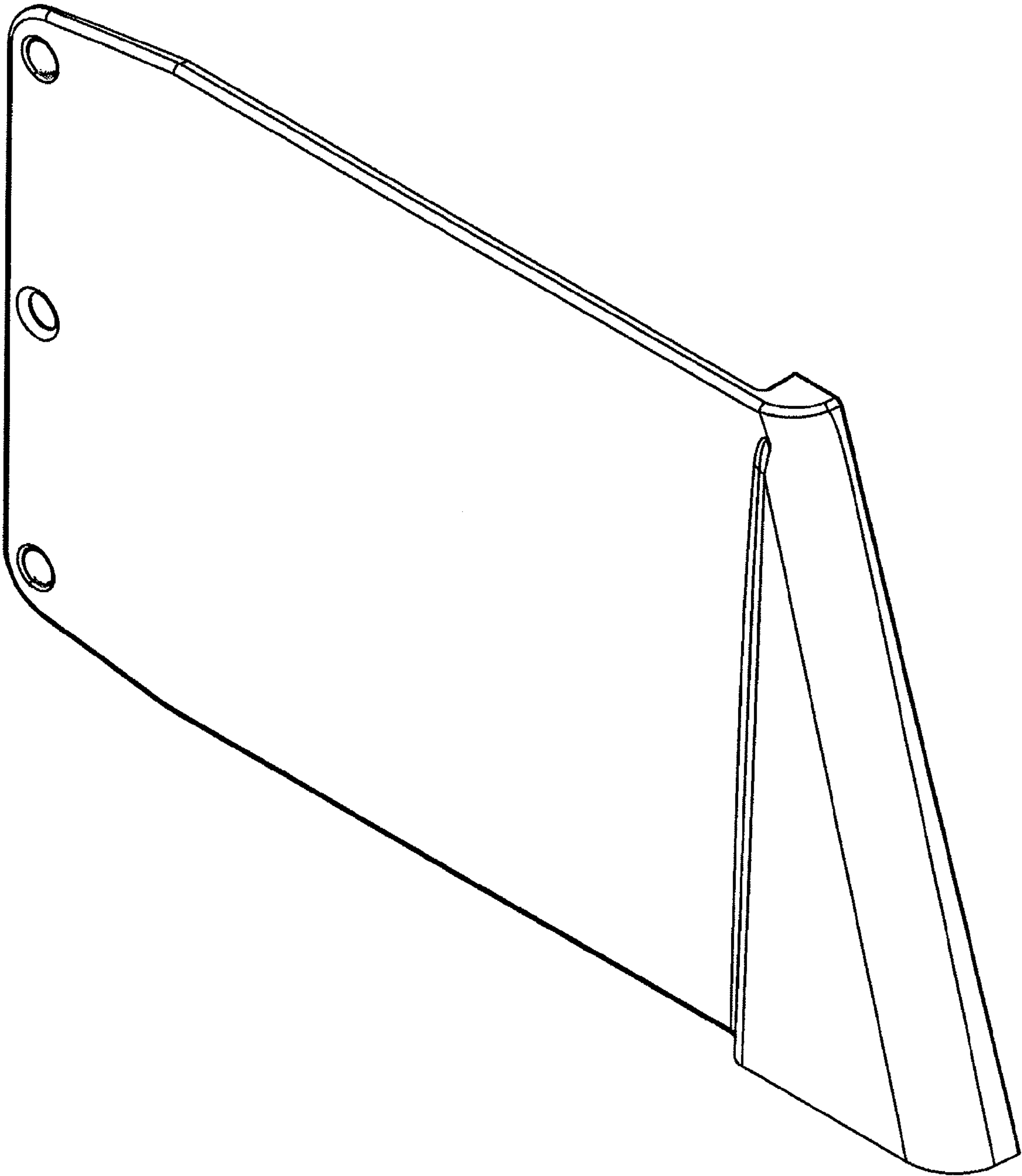

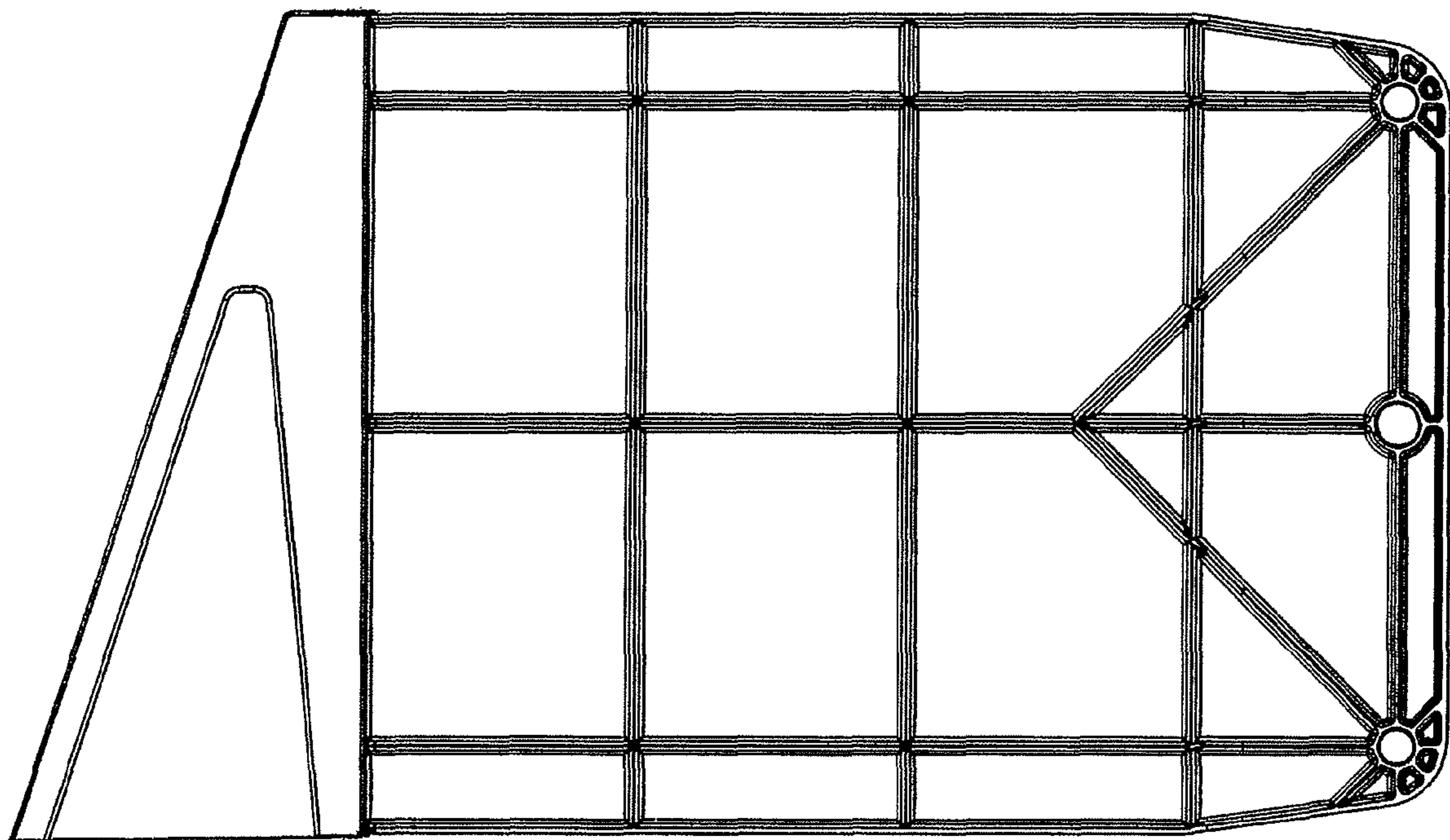

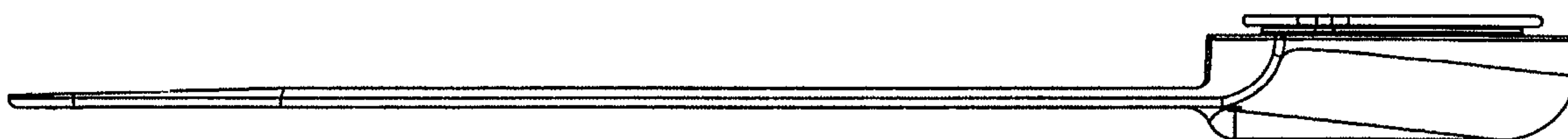

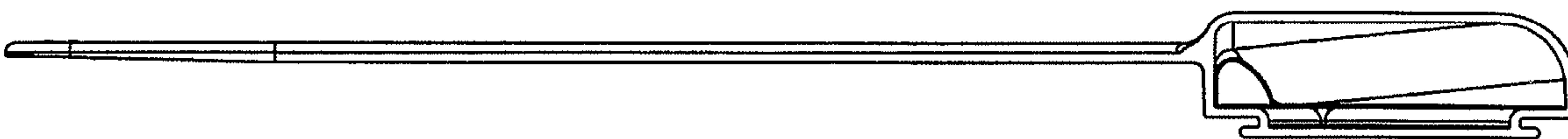

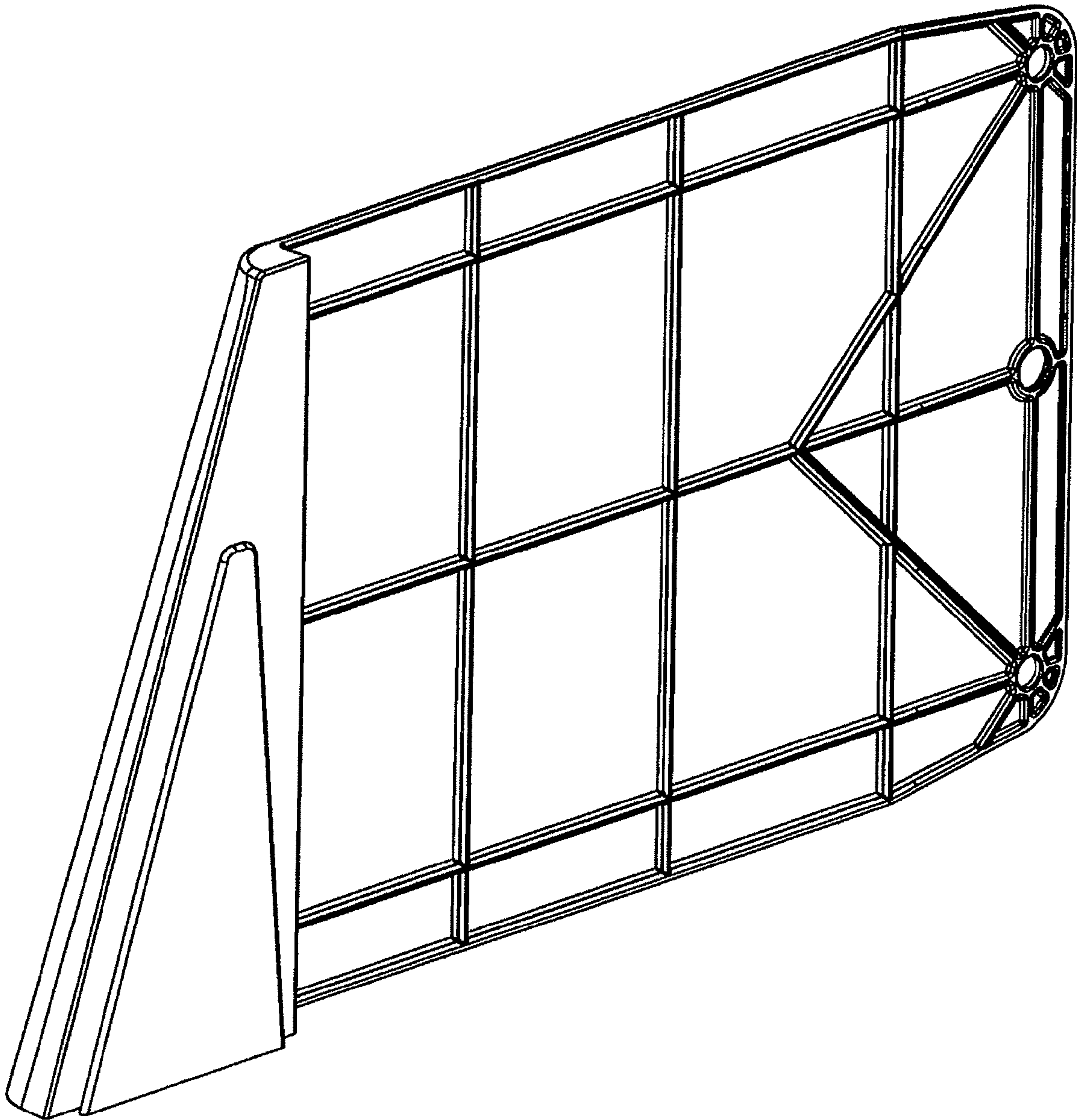

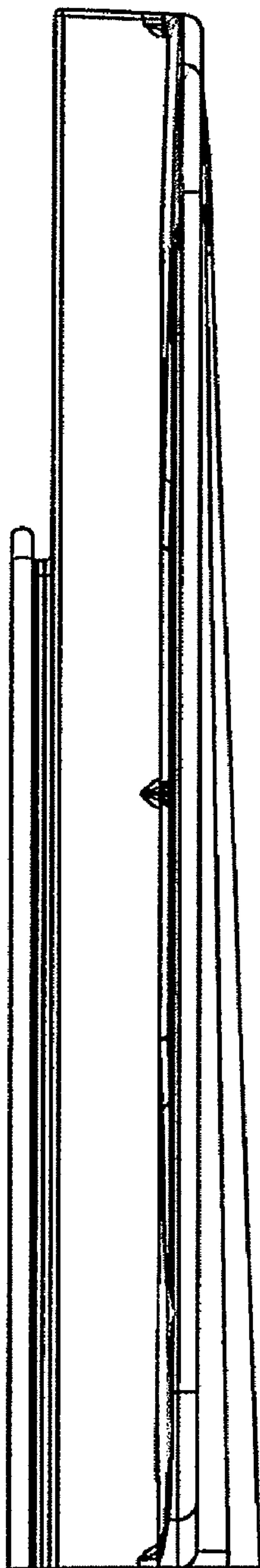

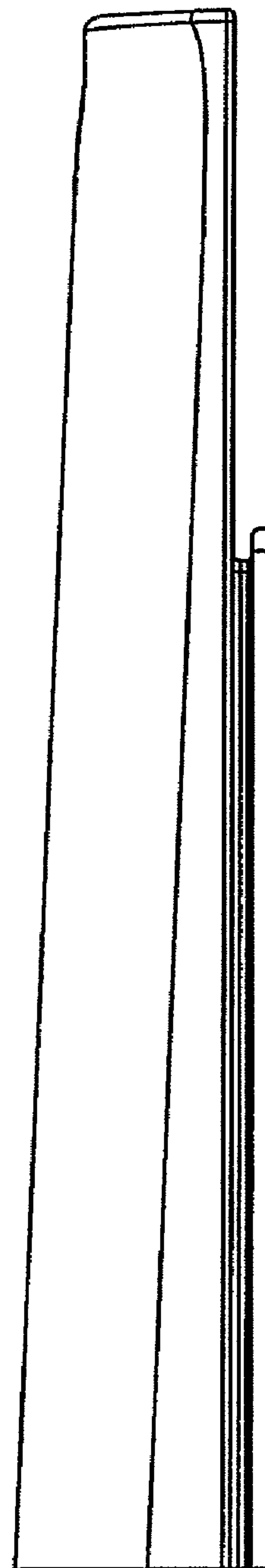

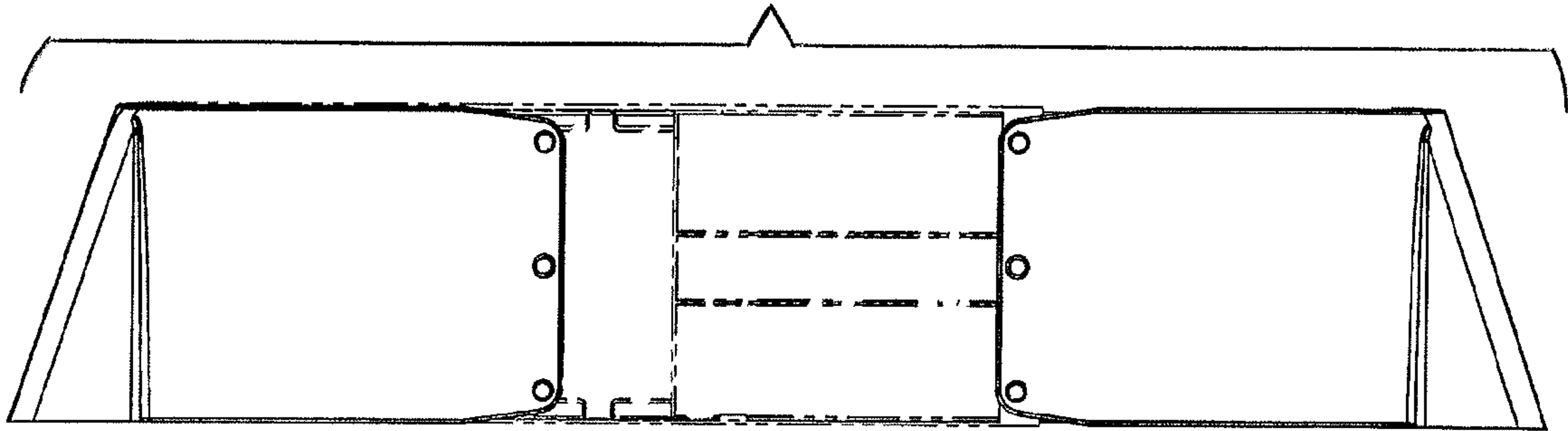

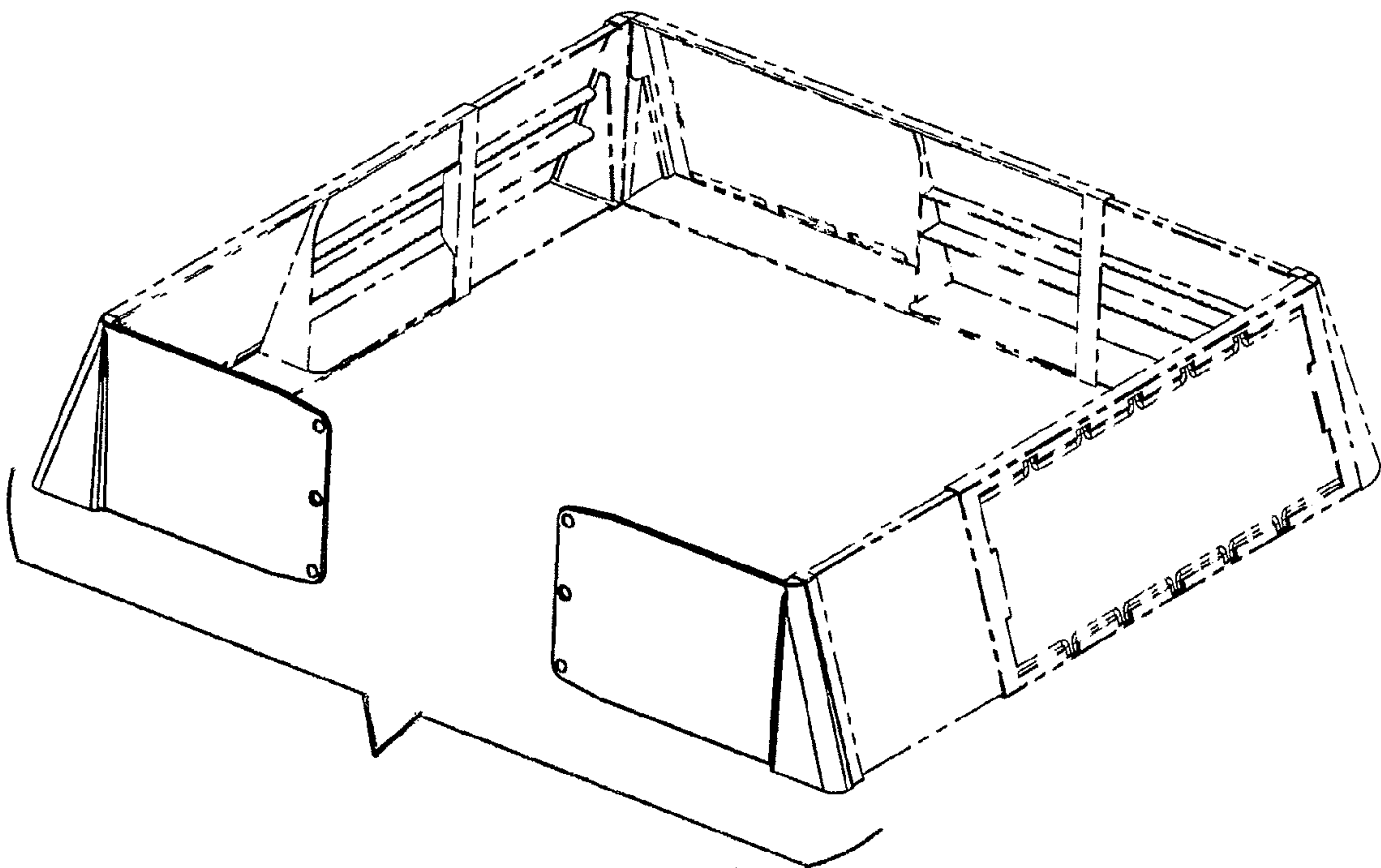

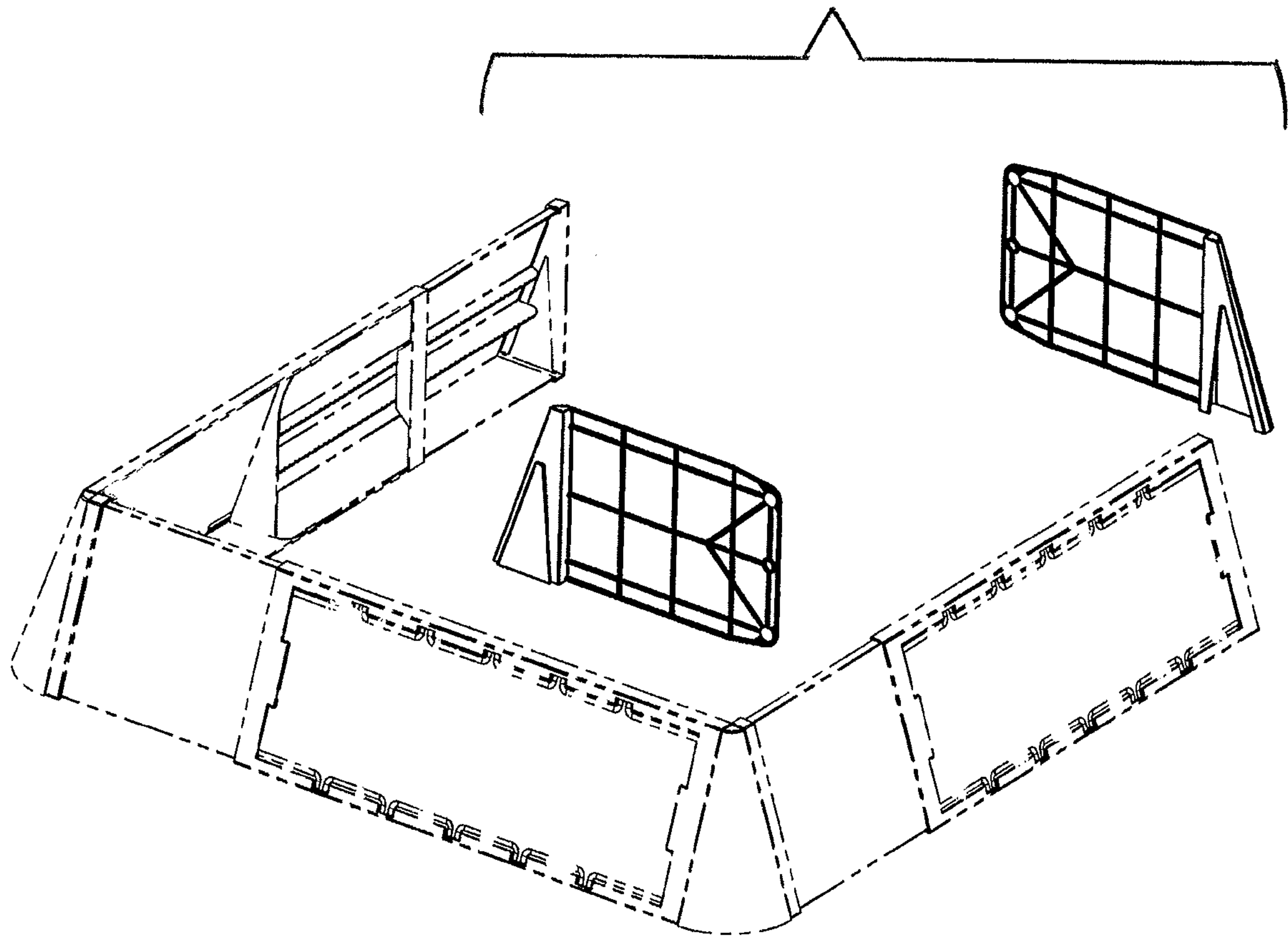
