FIG. 10 is a top view thereof;

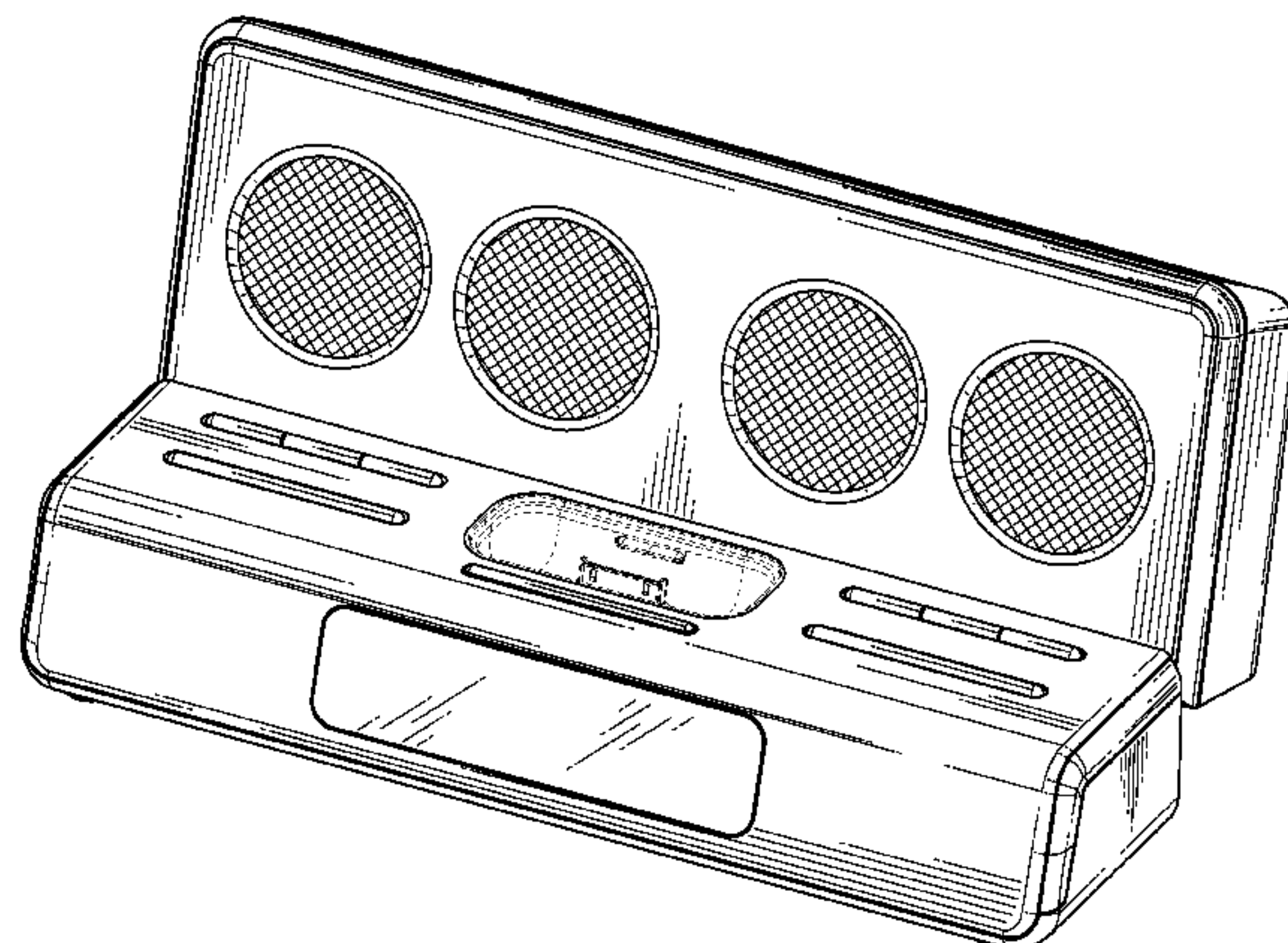
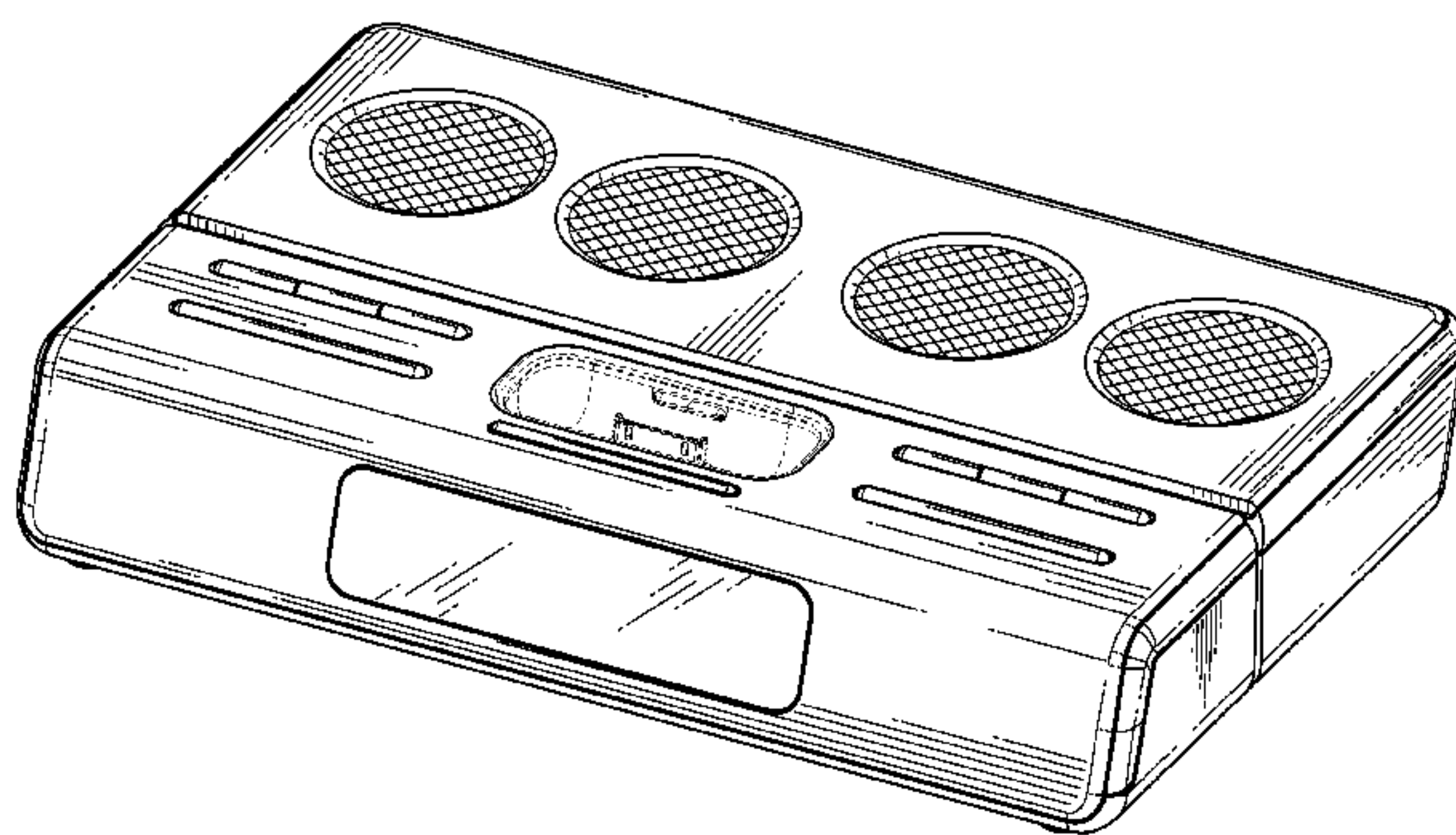
FIG. 11 is a bottom view thereof;

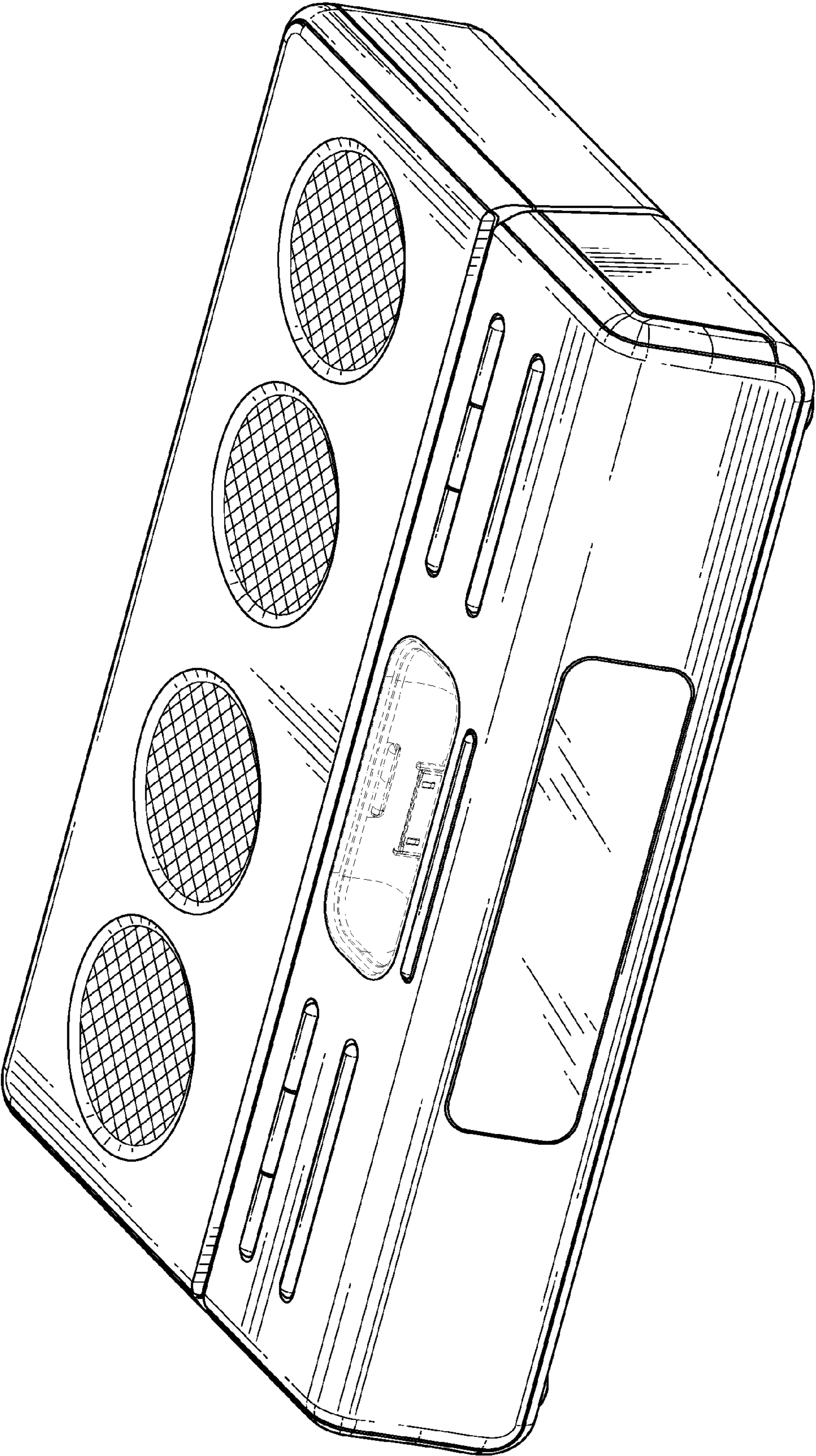

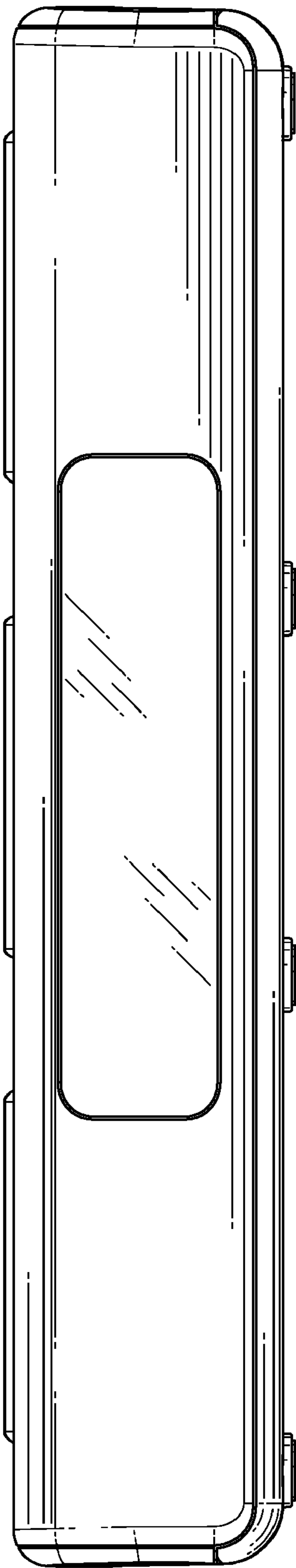

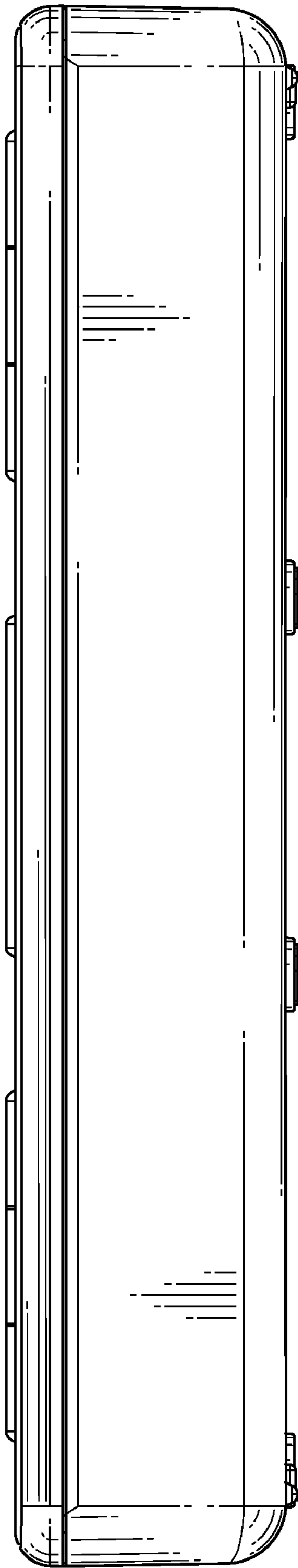

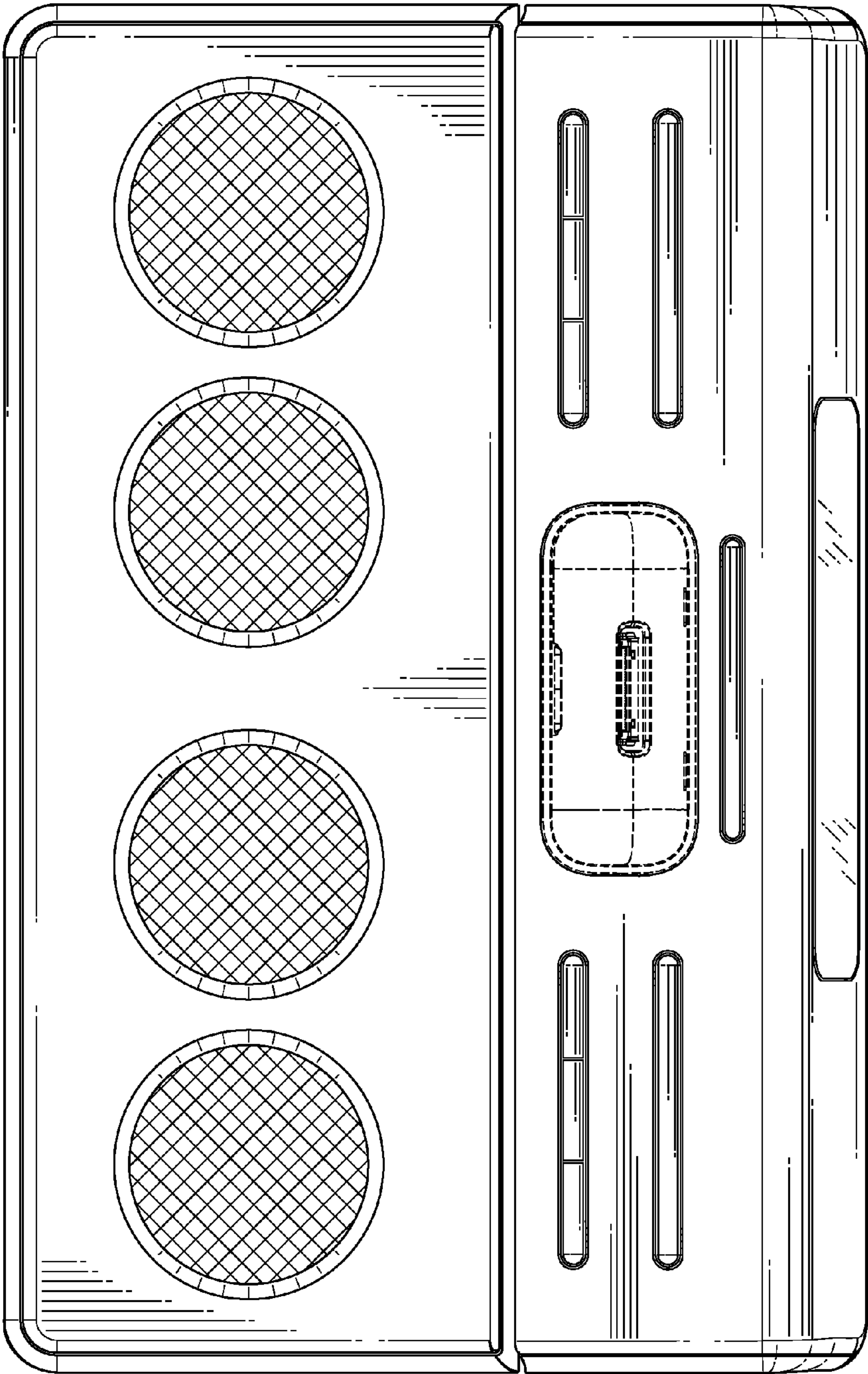

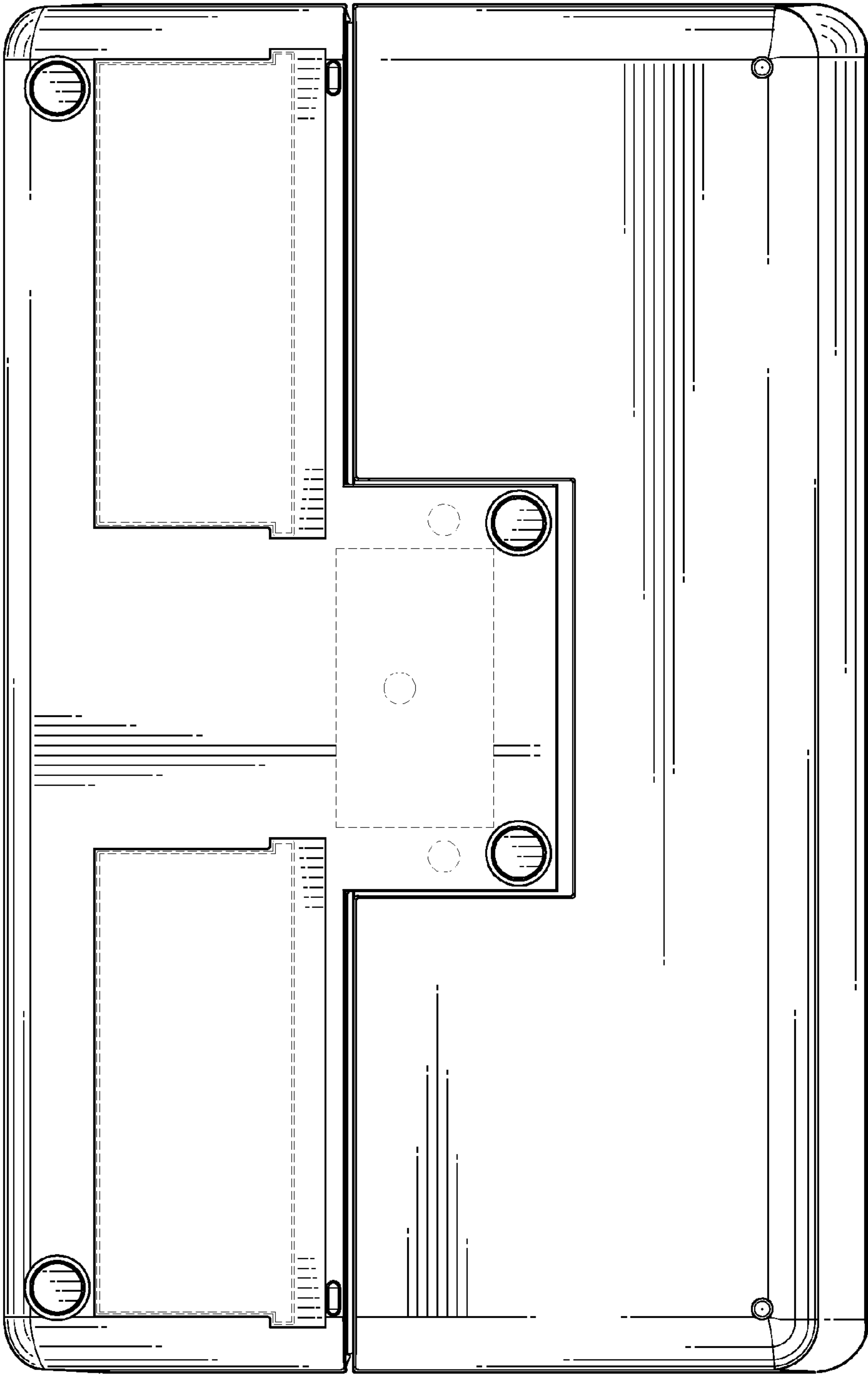

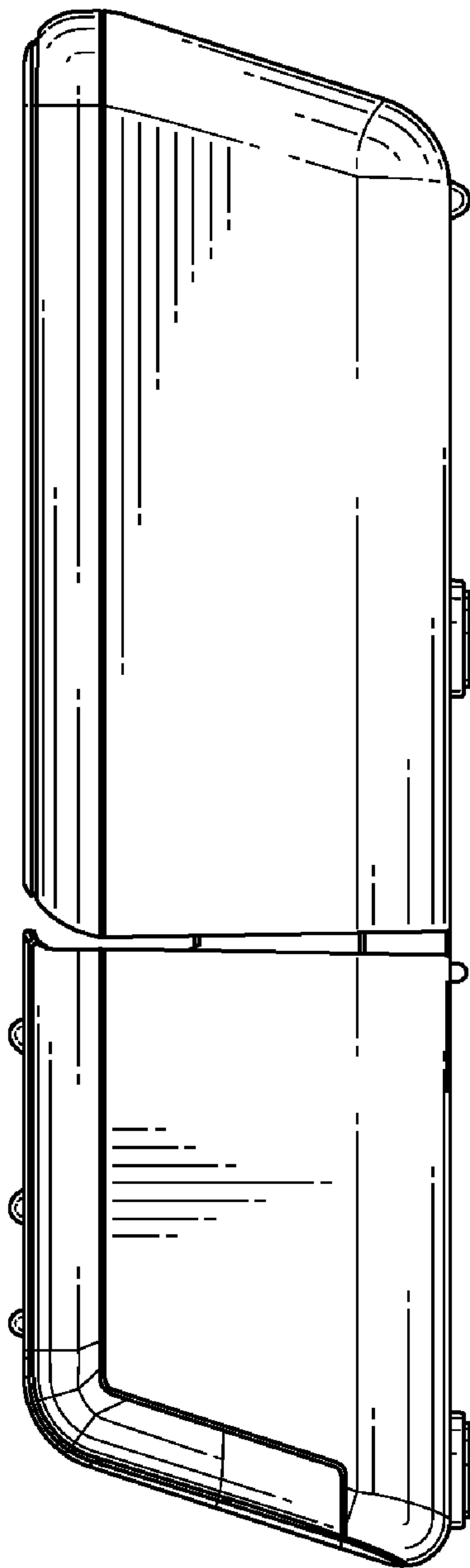

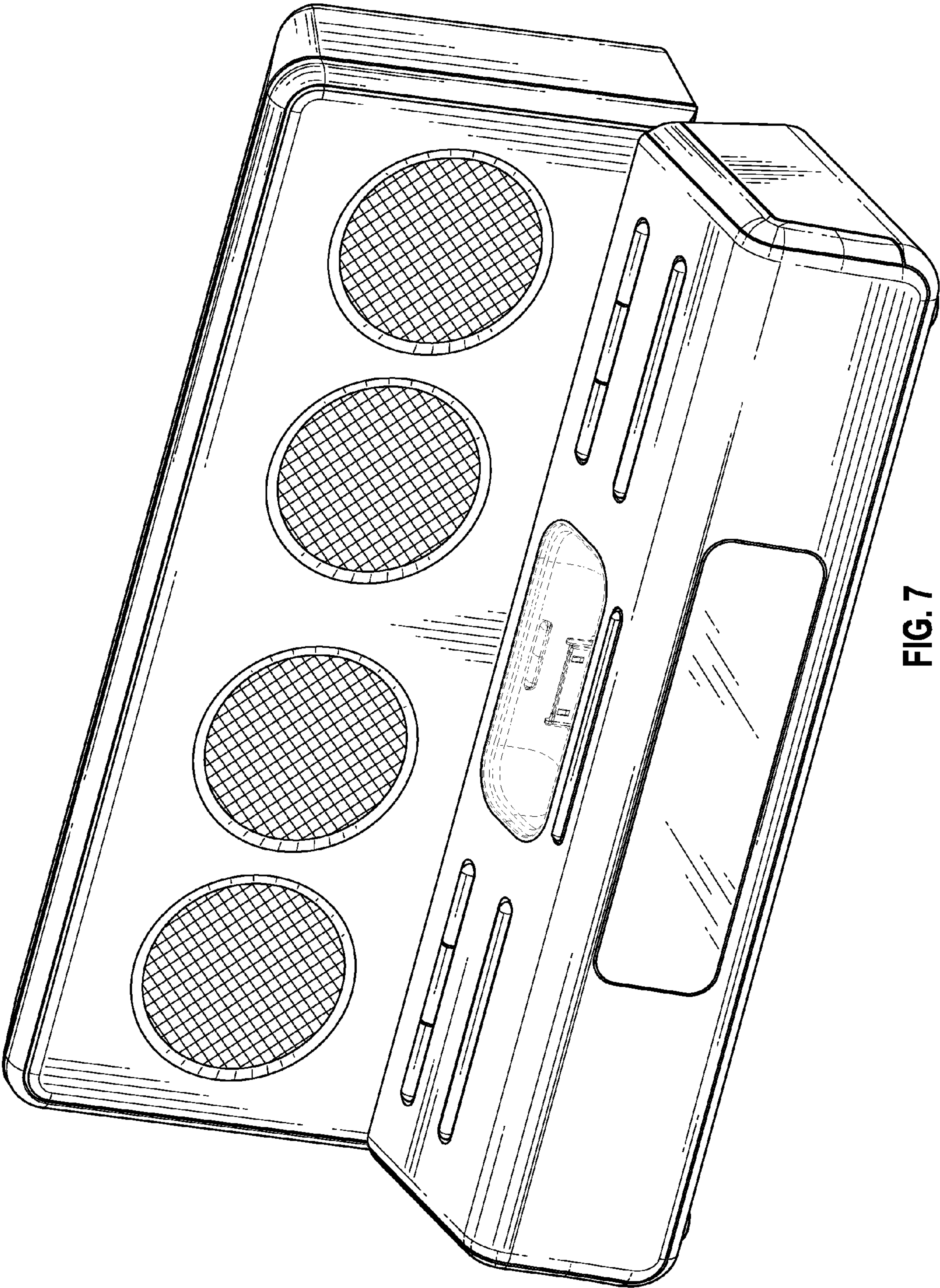
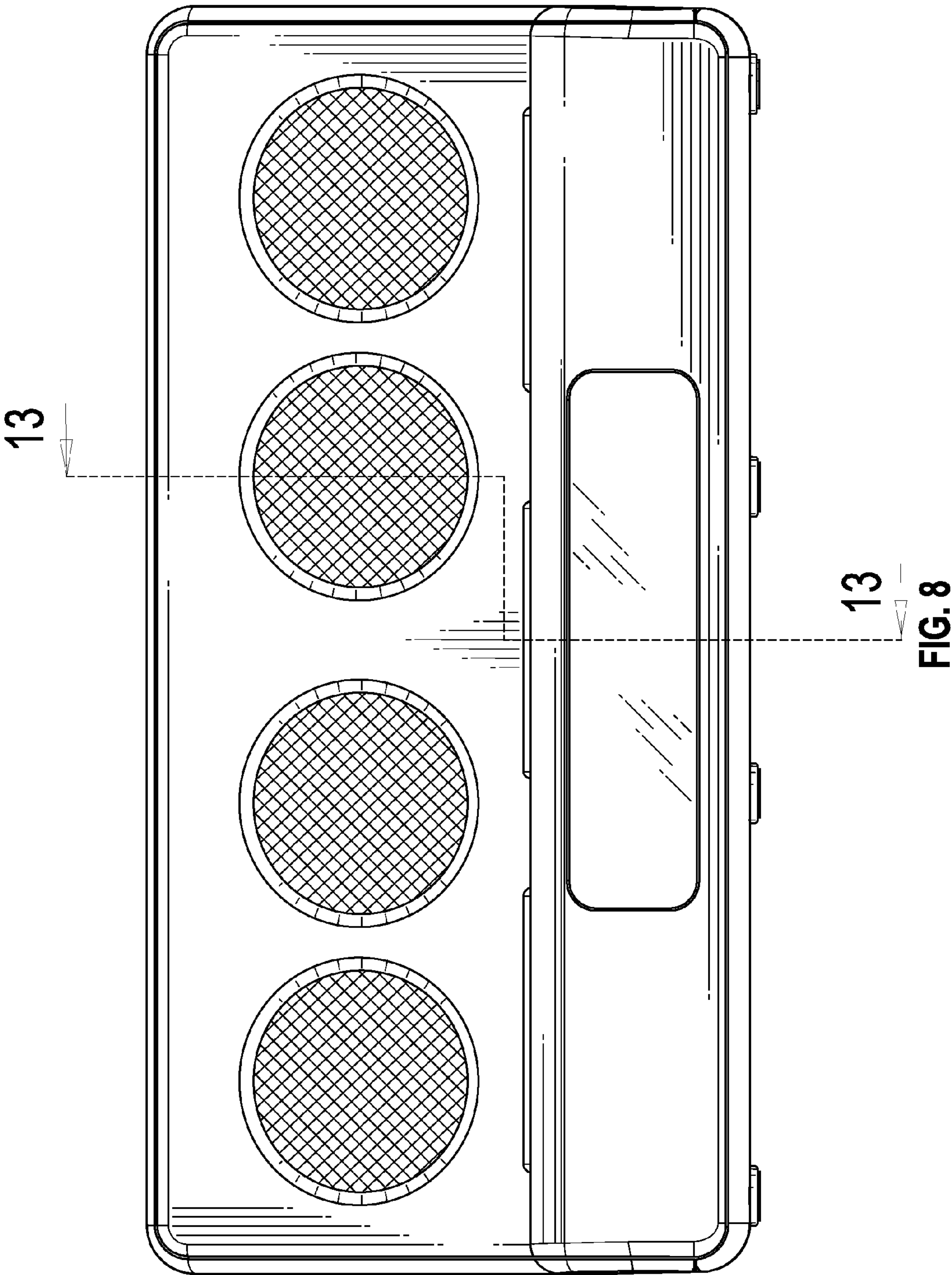

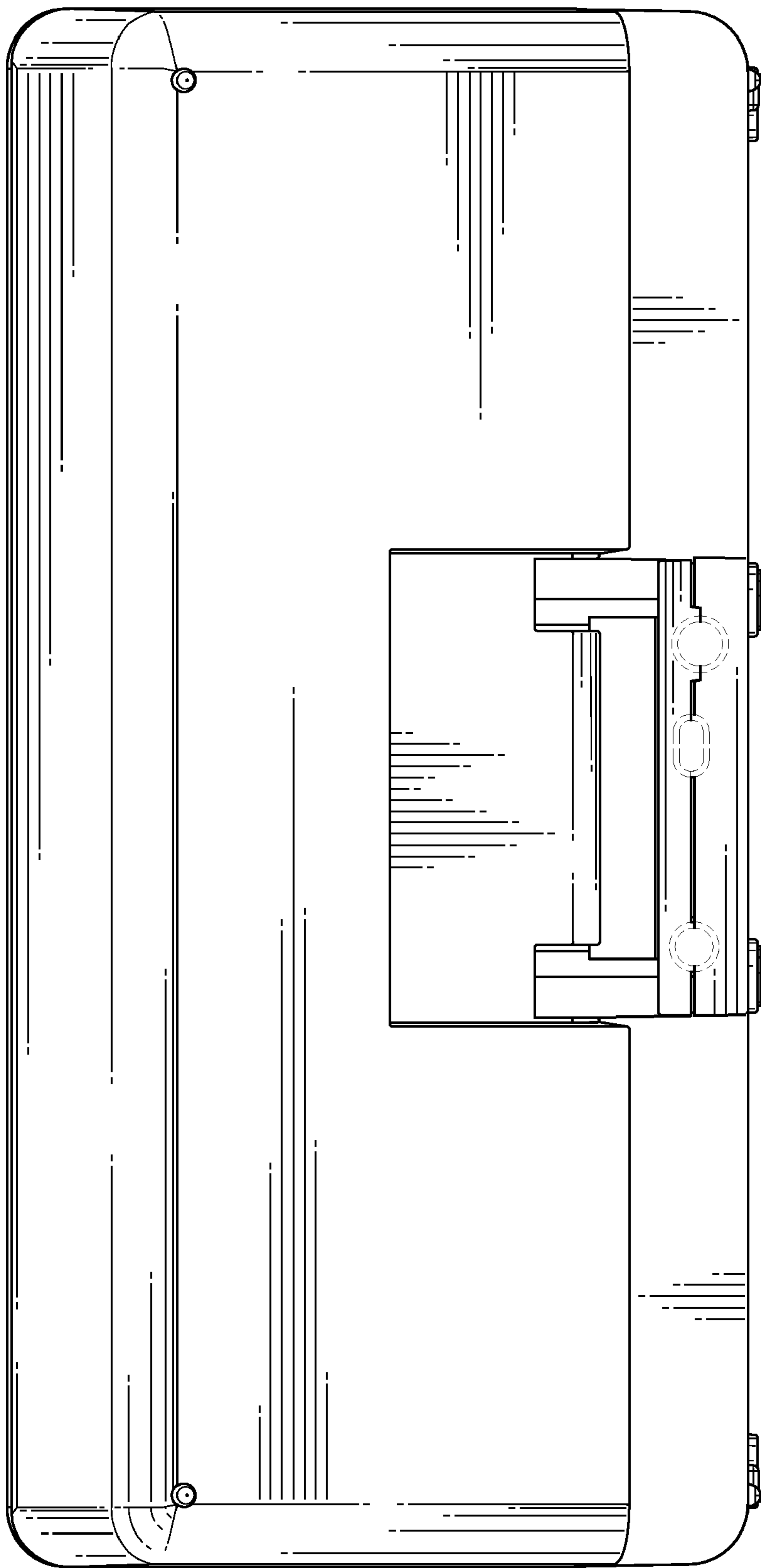

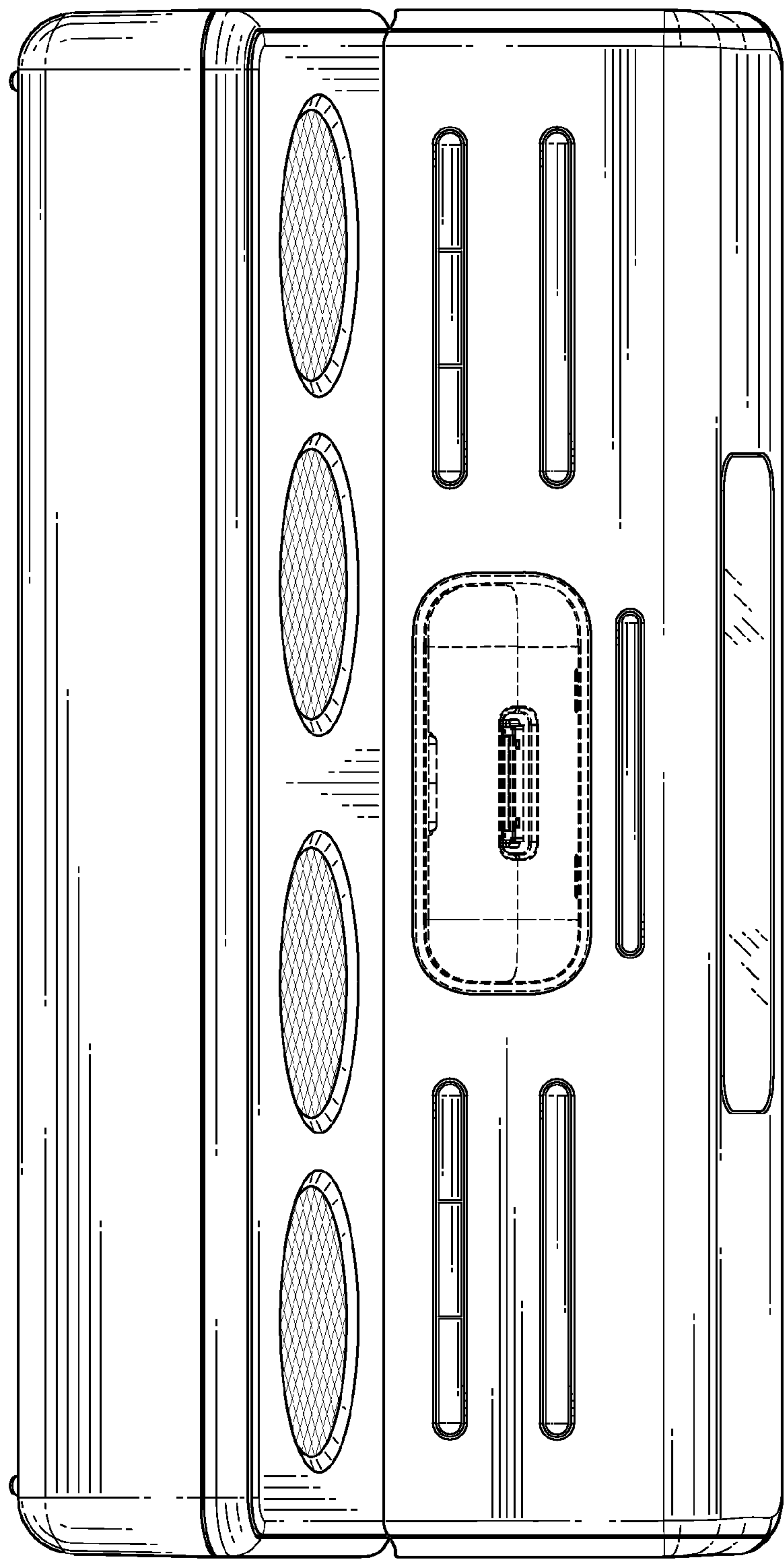

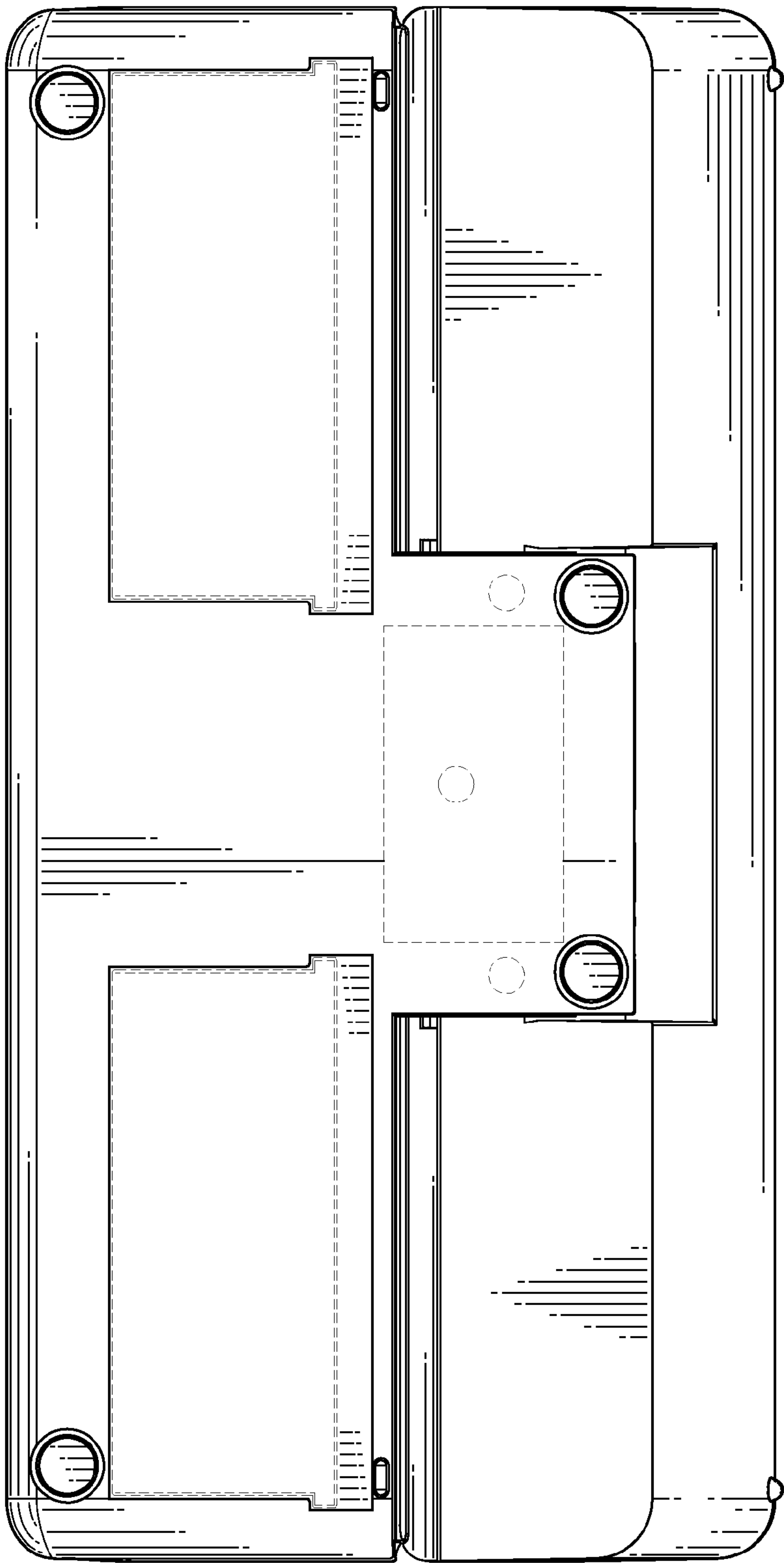

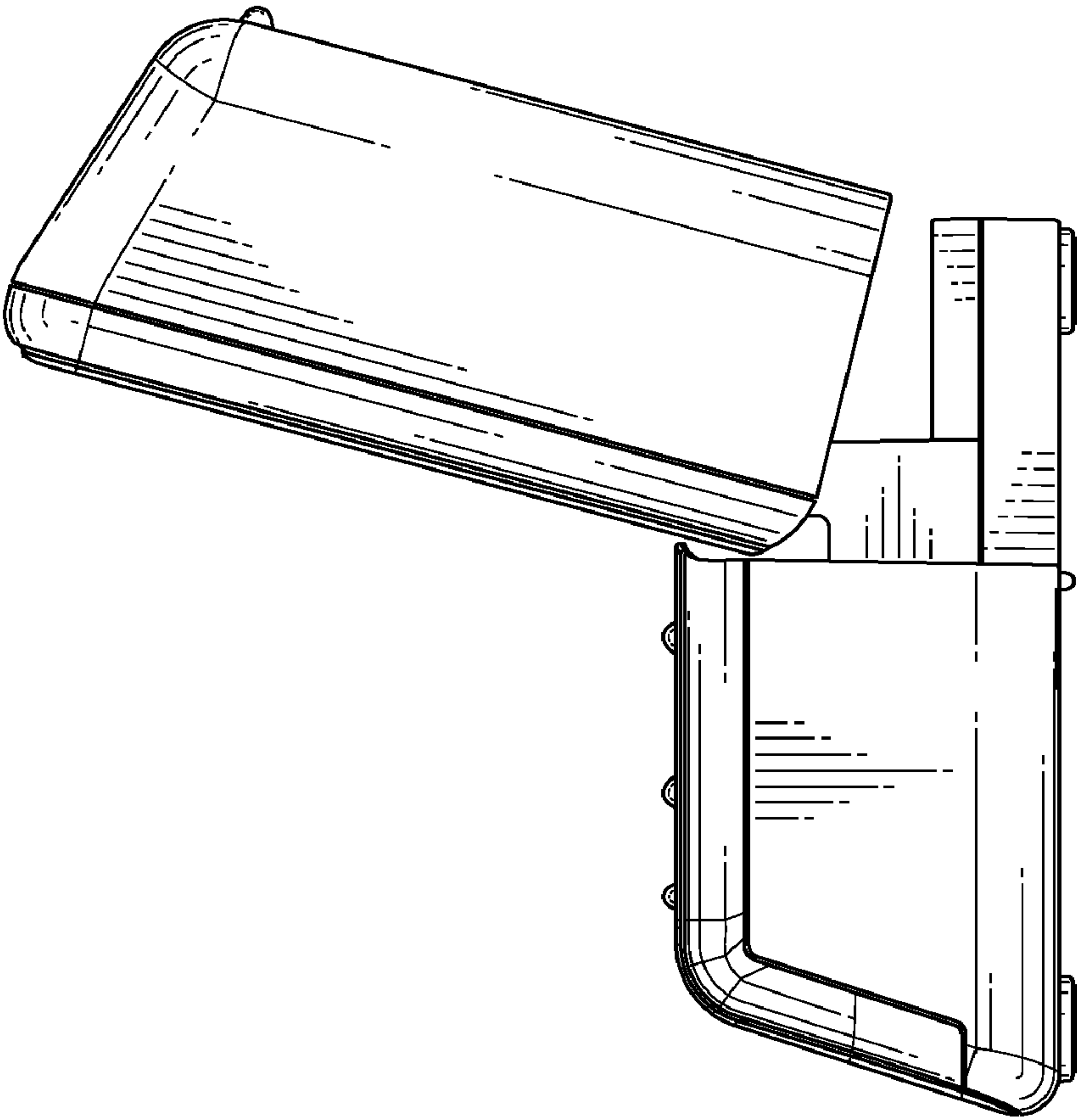

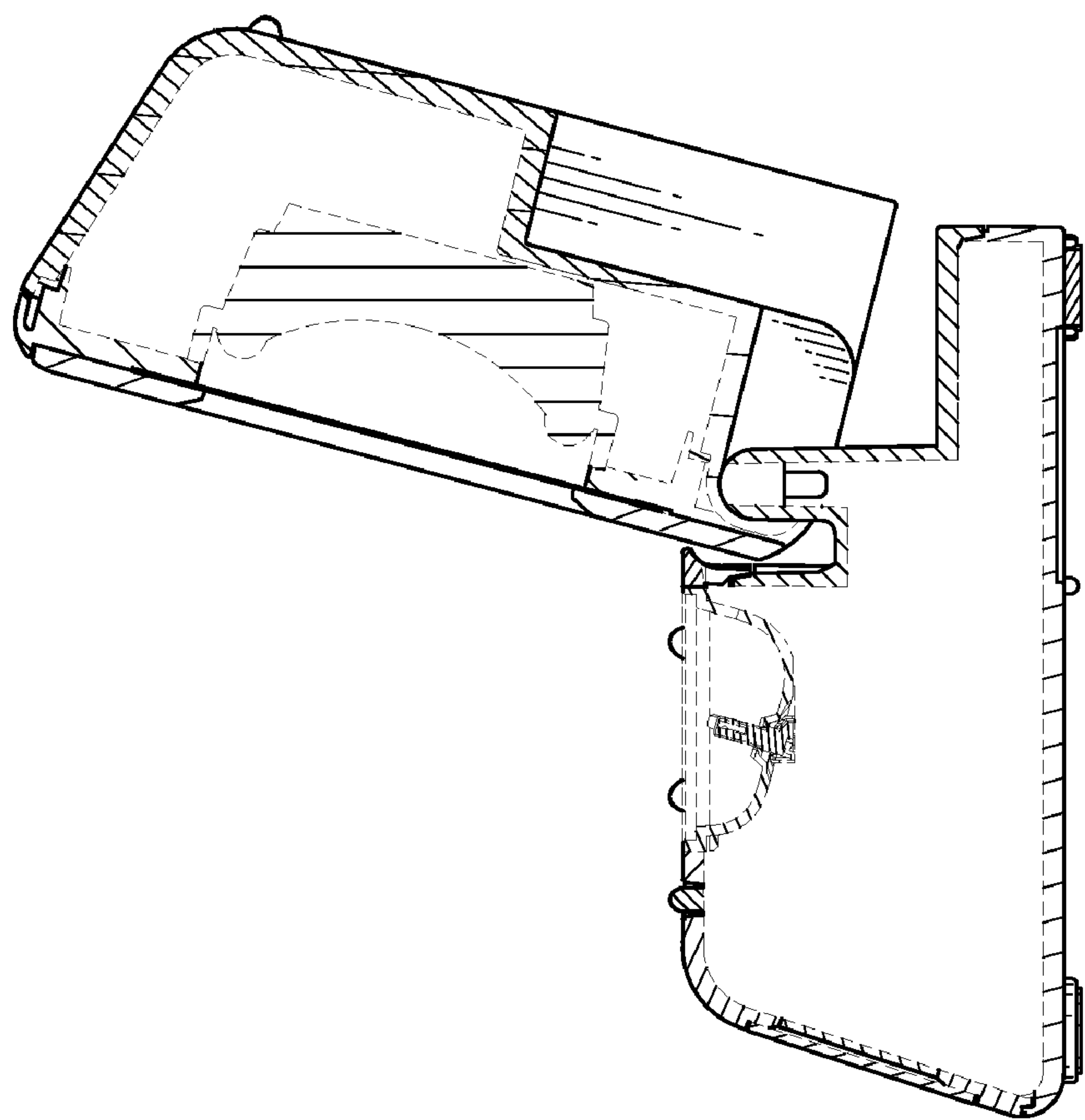
