#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the one-piece toilet of FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the one-piece toilet of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the one-piece toilet of FIG. 1; and,


FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the one-piece toilet of FIG. 1.


The broken line showing portions of the toilet are included for the purpose of illustrating a portion of the toilet that forms no part of the claimed design.






