The ornamental design for a neck support for shampoo bowls, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a neck support for shampoo bowls showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view with the left side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;

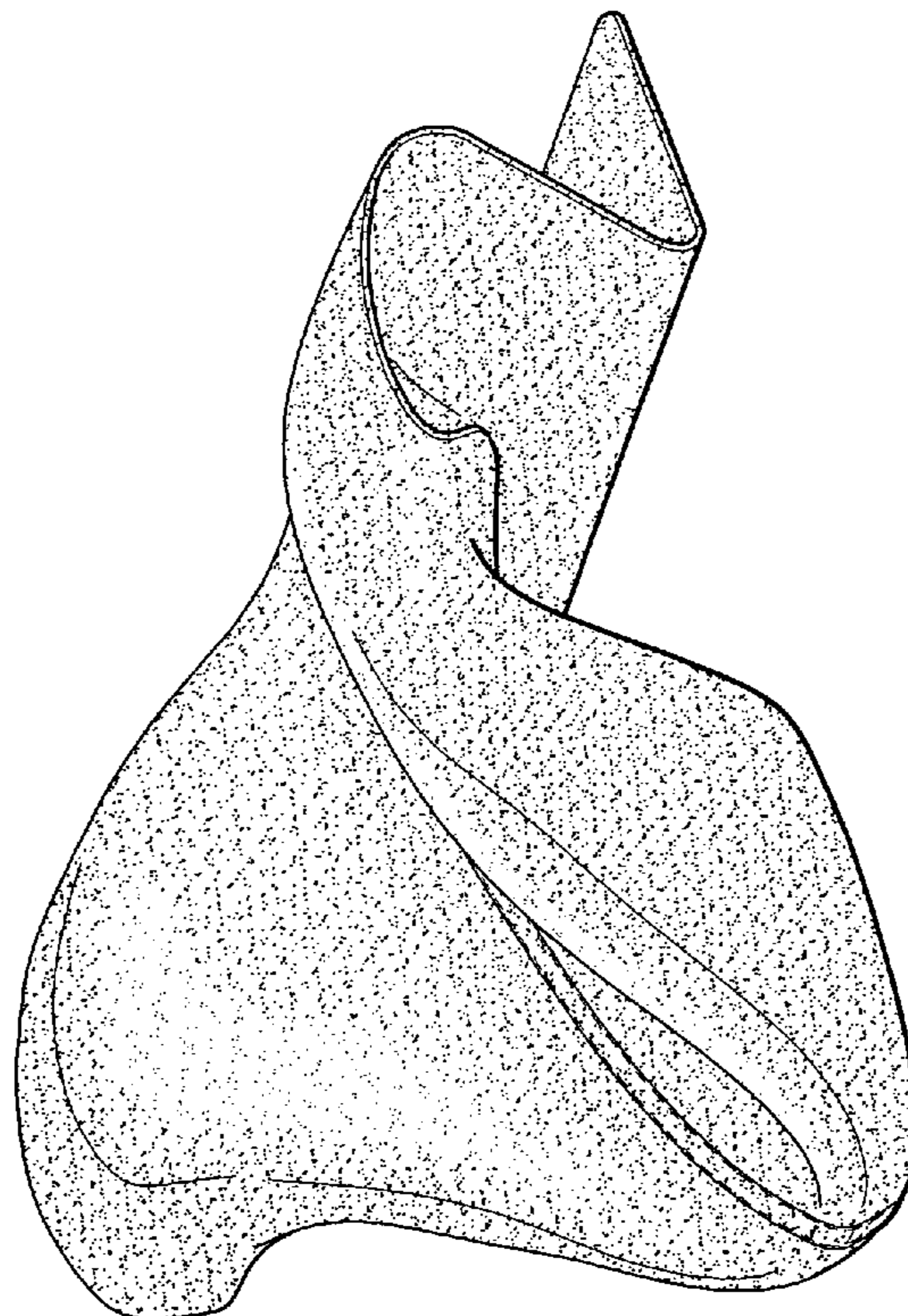
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,

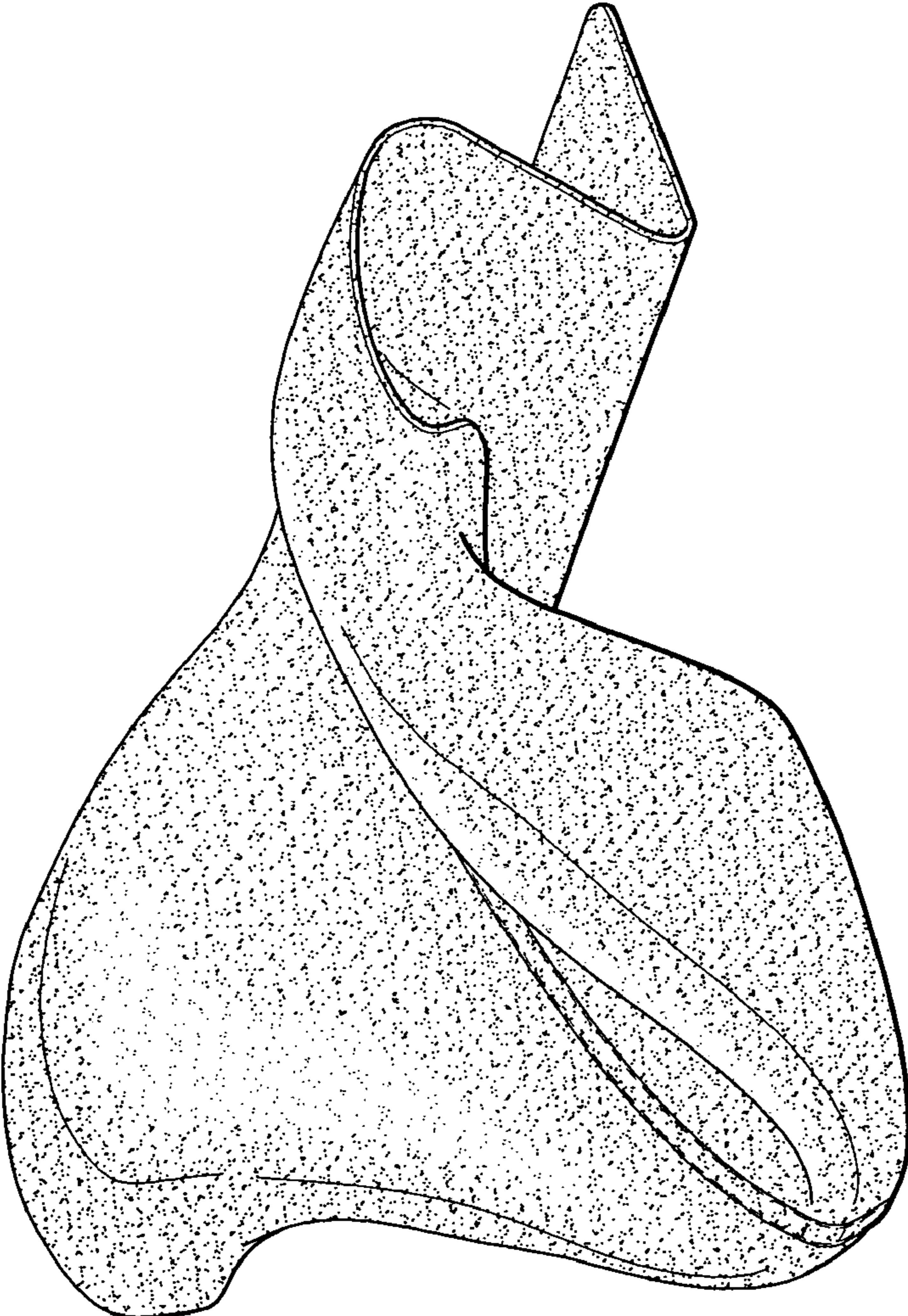
FIG. 7 is an environmental perspective view thereof.

The broken line showing of the chair and the sink in FIG. 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

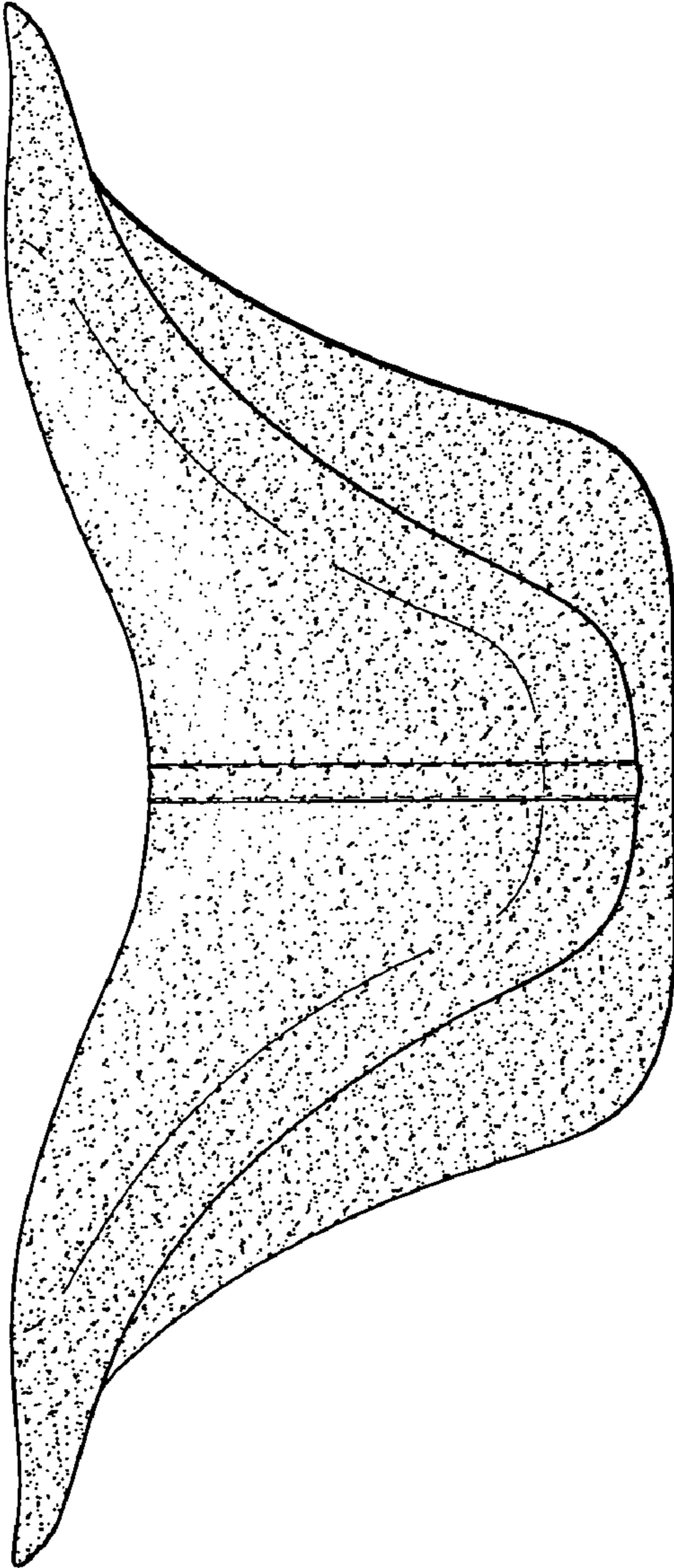
The broken lines located in the center of the neck support shown in FIGS. 1-3 and 5-6 of the drawings represent stitching.

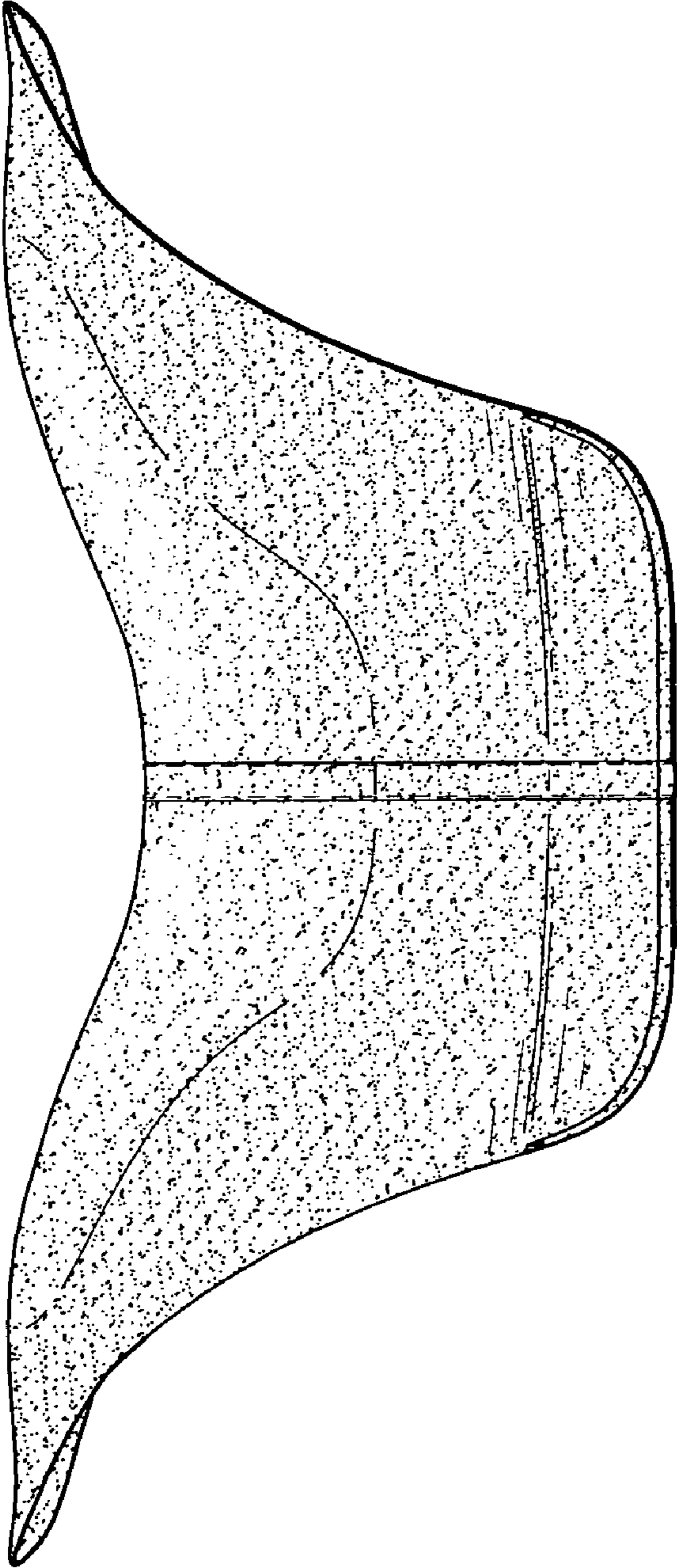

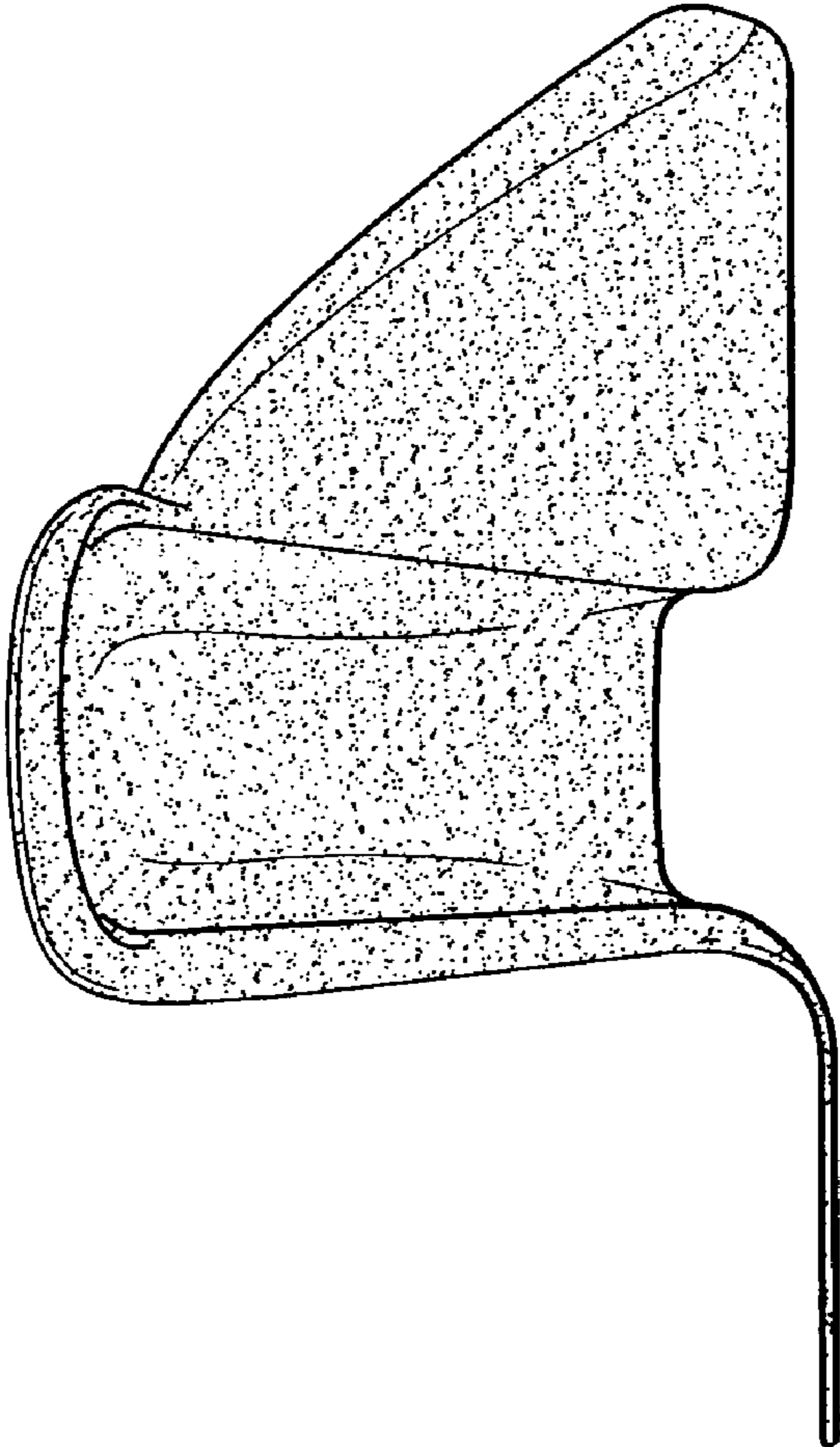

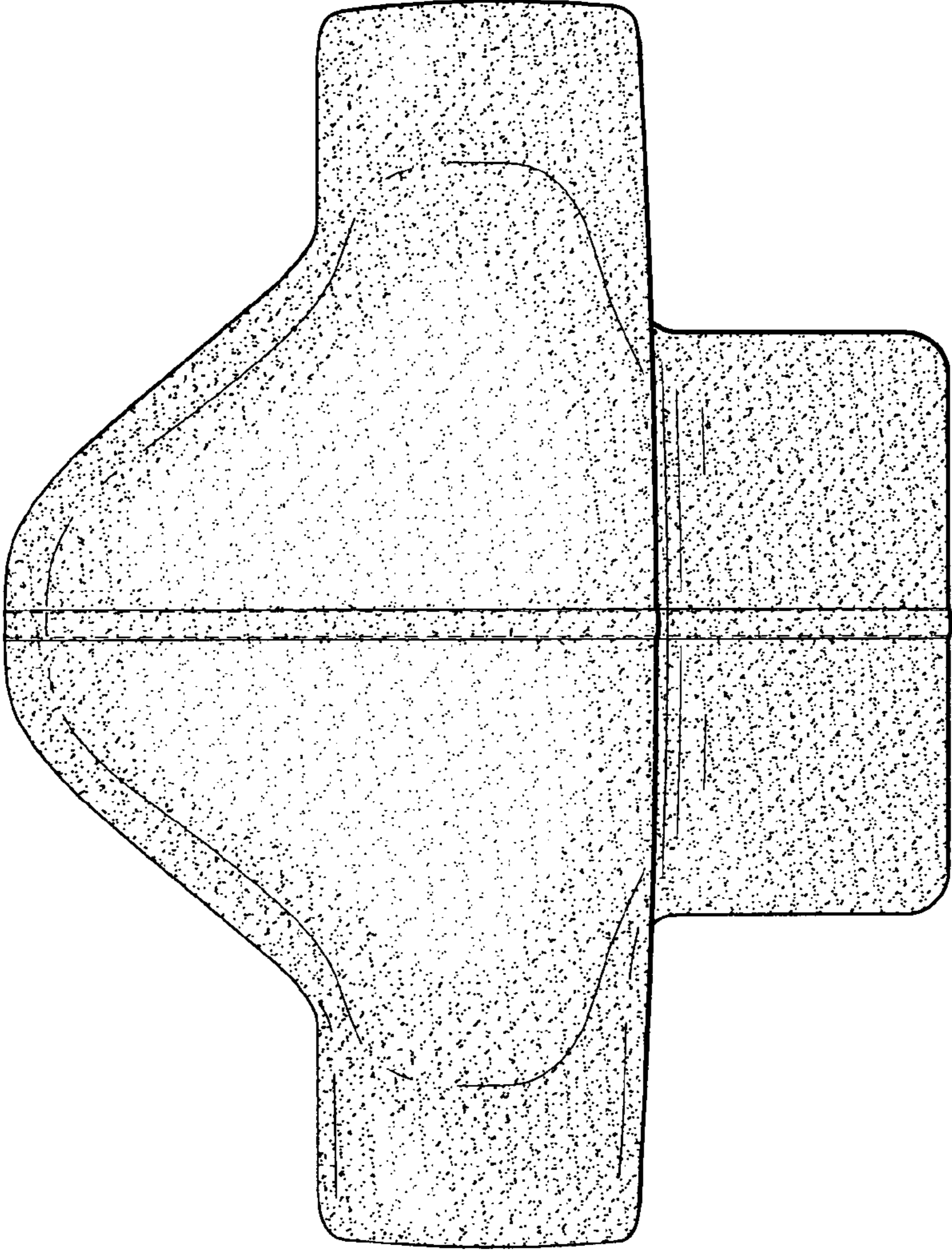




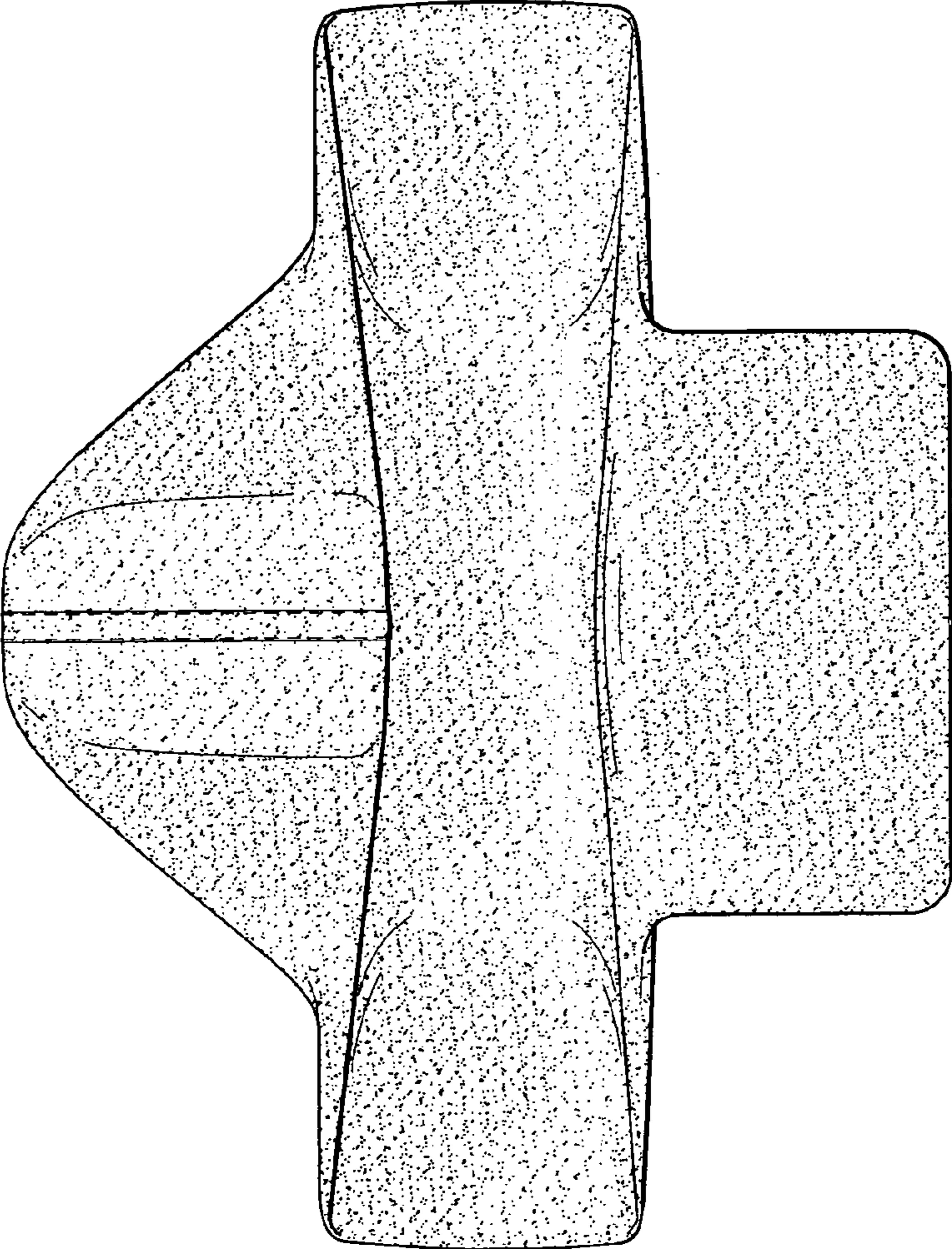

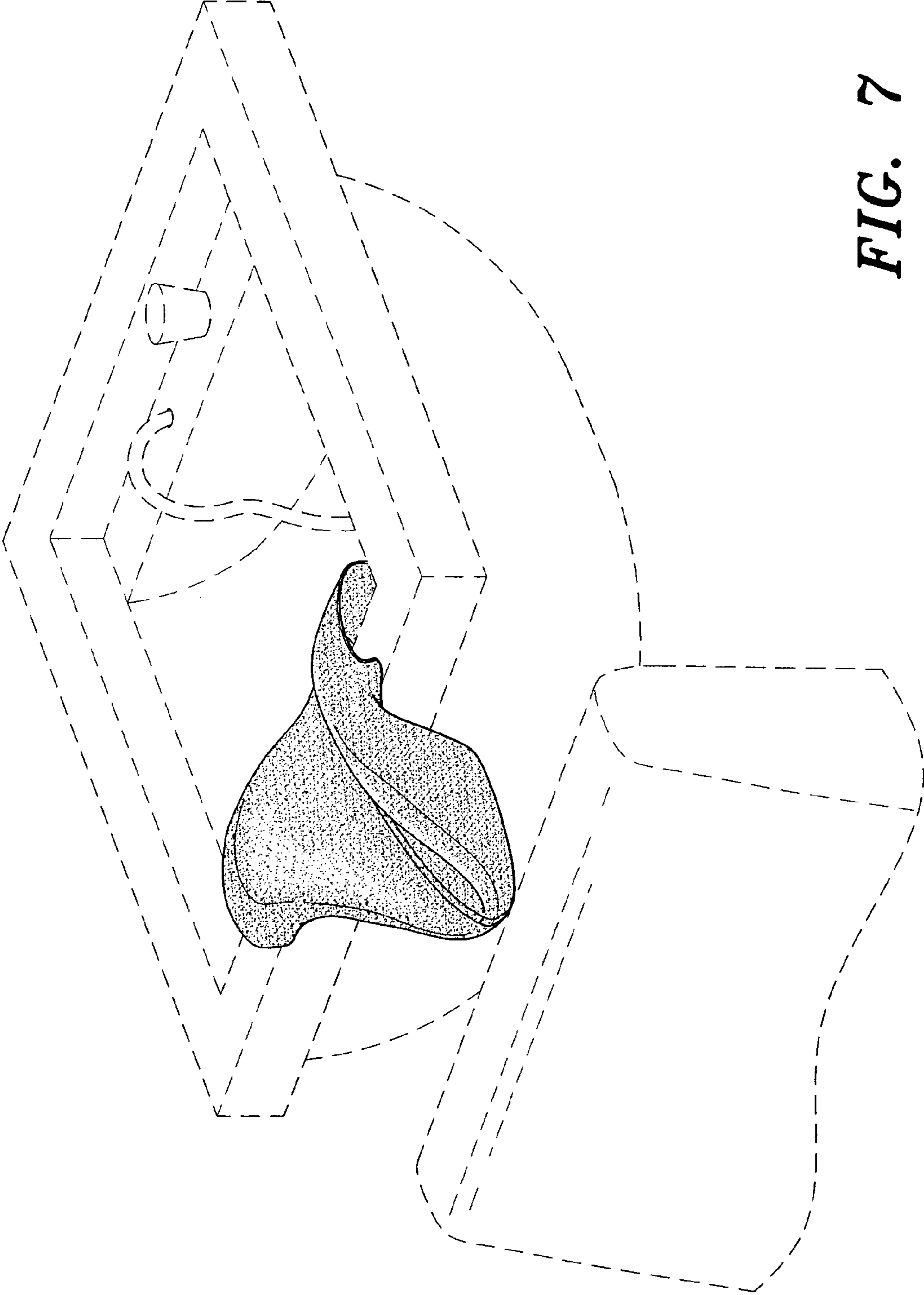
