(57) CLAIM


The ornamental design for an earring envelope with buckle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an earring envelope with buckle in an open position showing my new design;
- FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the invention shown in a closed position;
- FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the invention, shown in a closed position;
- FIG. 4 is a left-side elevation view of the invention in the closed position;
- FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view of the invention in the closed position;
- FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the invention; and,
- FIG. 7 is a bottom plan-view of the invention.

The broken lines showing a pair of earrings fixed to a cushion in FIG. 1 are included for the purpose of illustrating the invention in use, and they form no part of the claimed design.





