The ornamental design for an earring envelope with buckle,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an earring envelope with
buckle in an open position showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the invention shown in a
closed position;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the invention, shown in a
closed position;

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevation view of the invention in the
closed position;

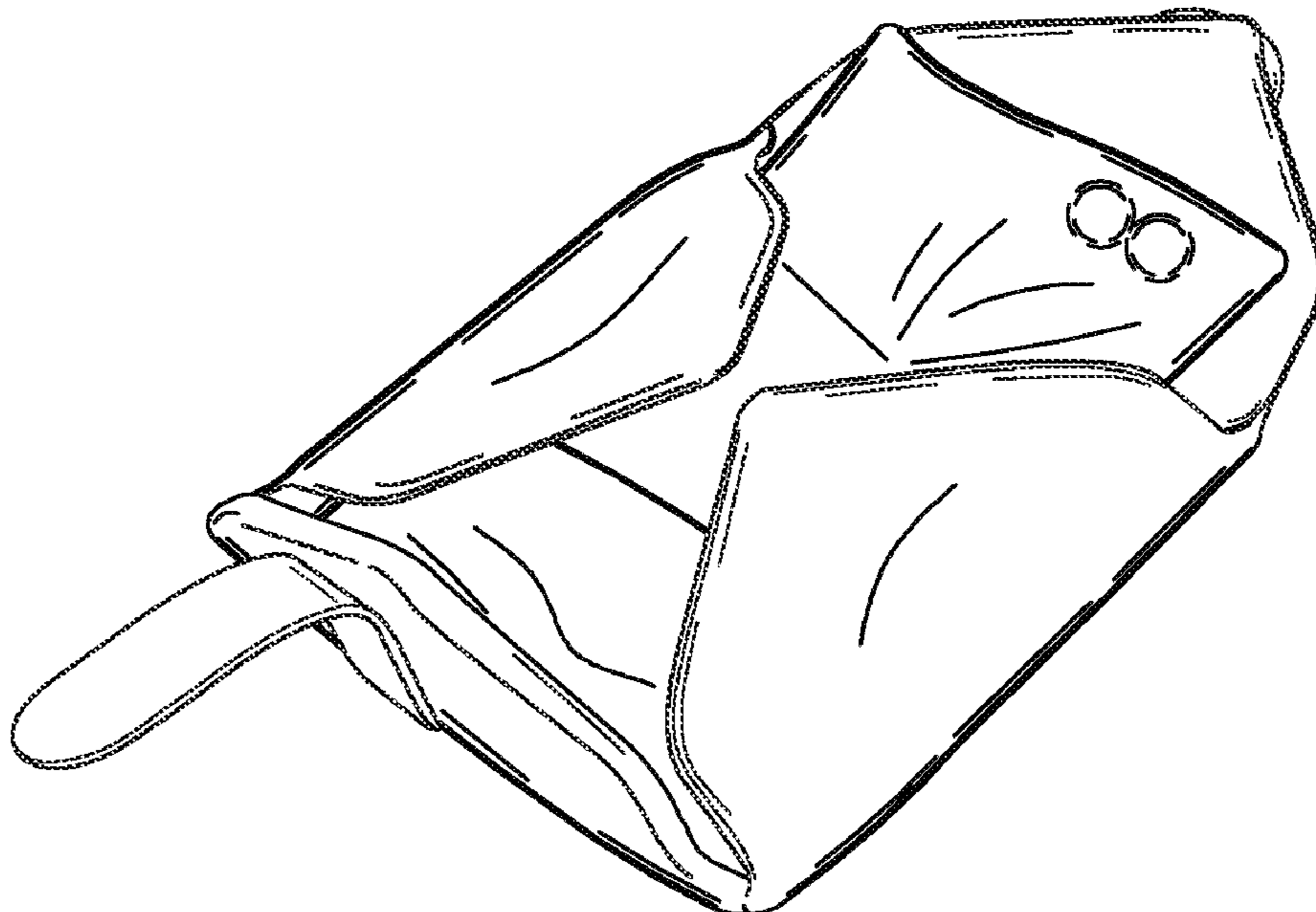
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view of the invention in the
closed position;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the invention; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan-view of the invention.

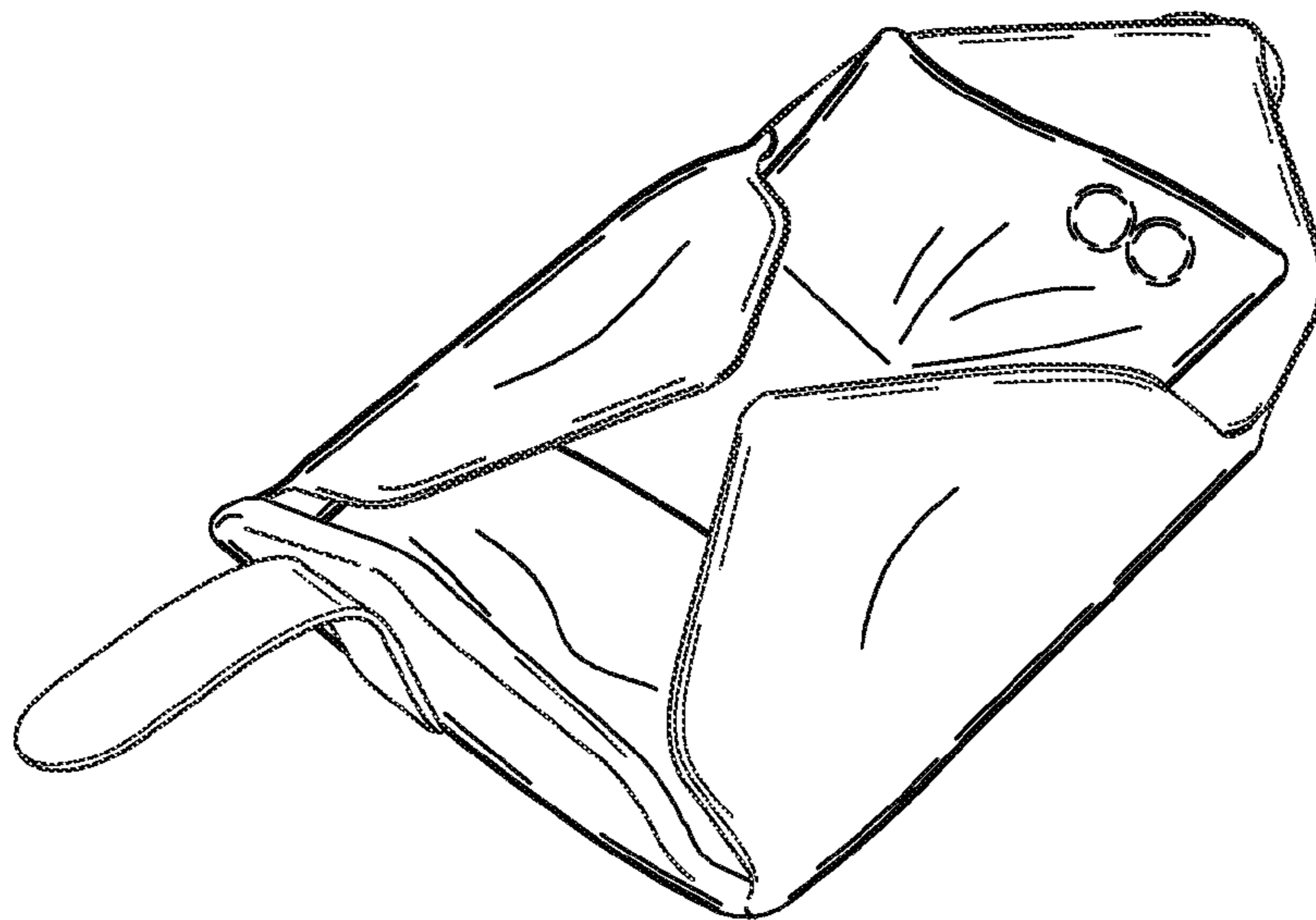

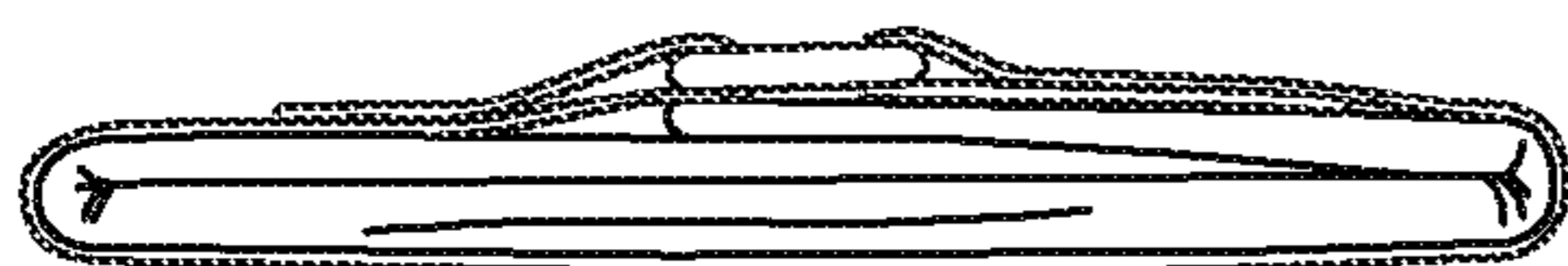

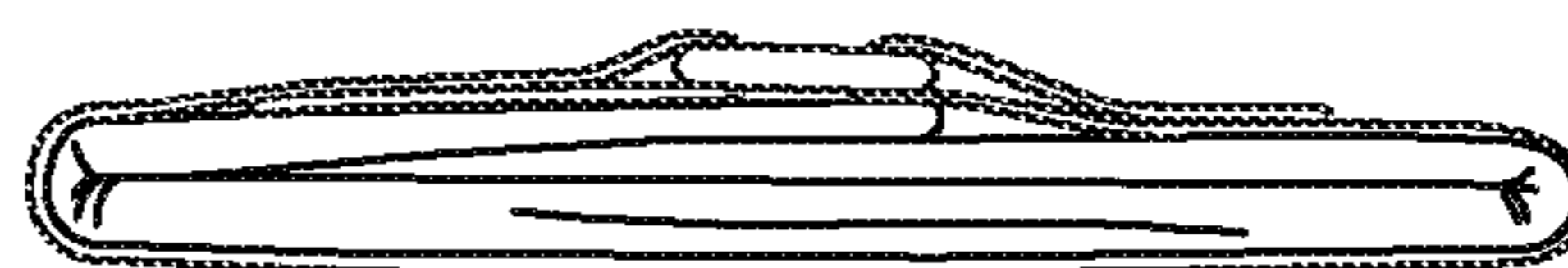

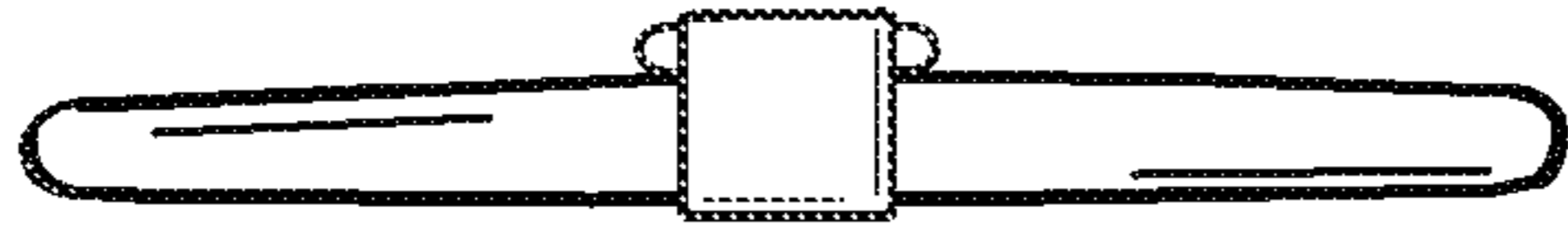

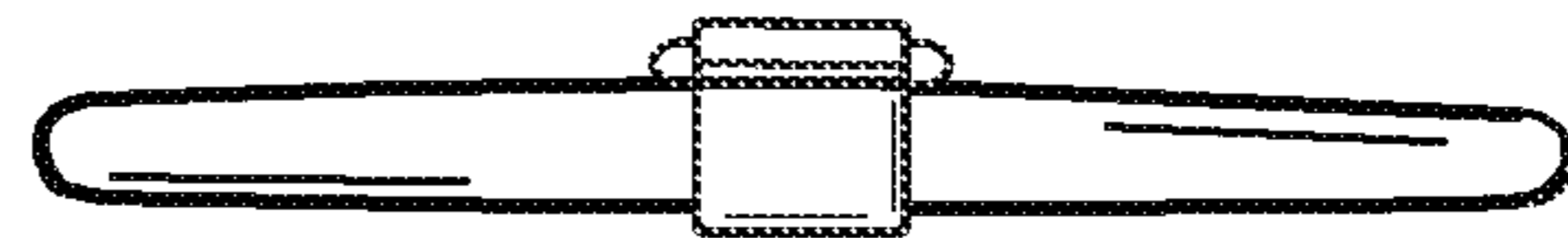

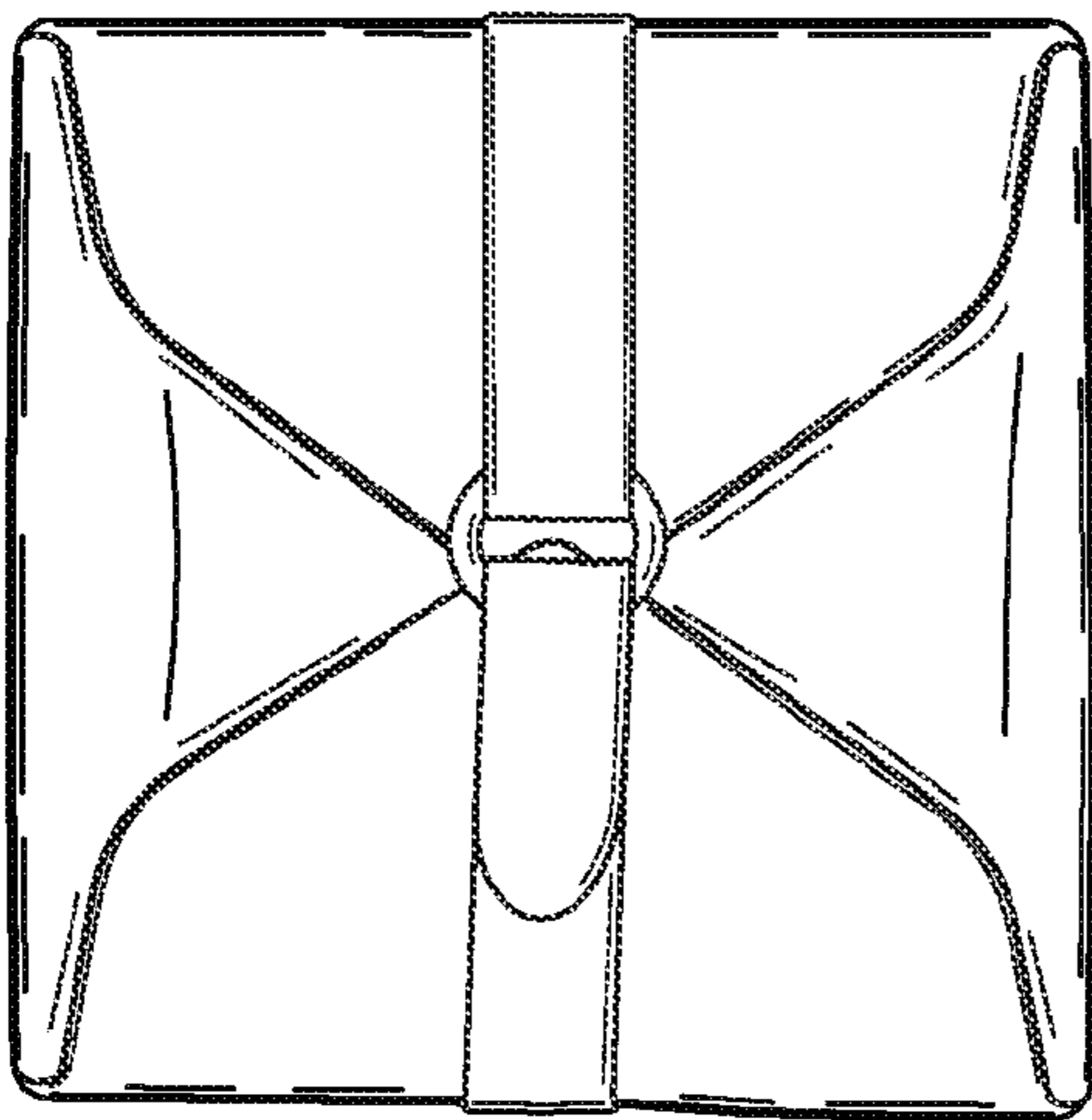

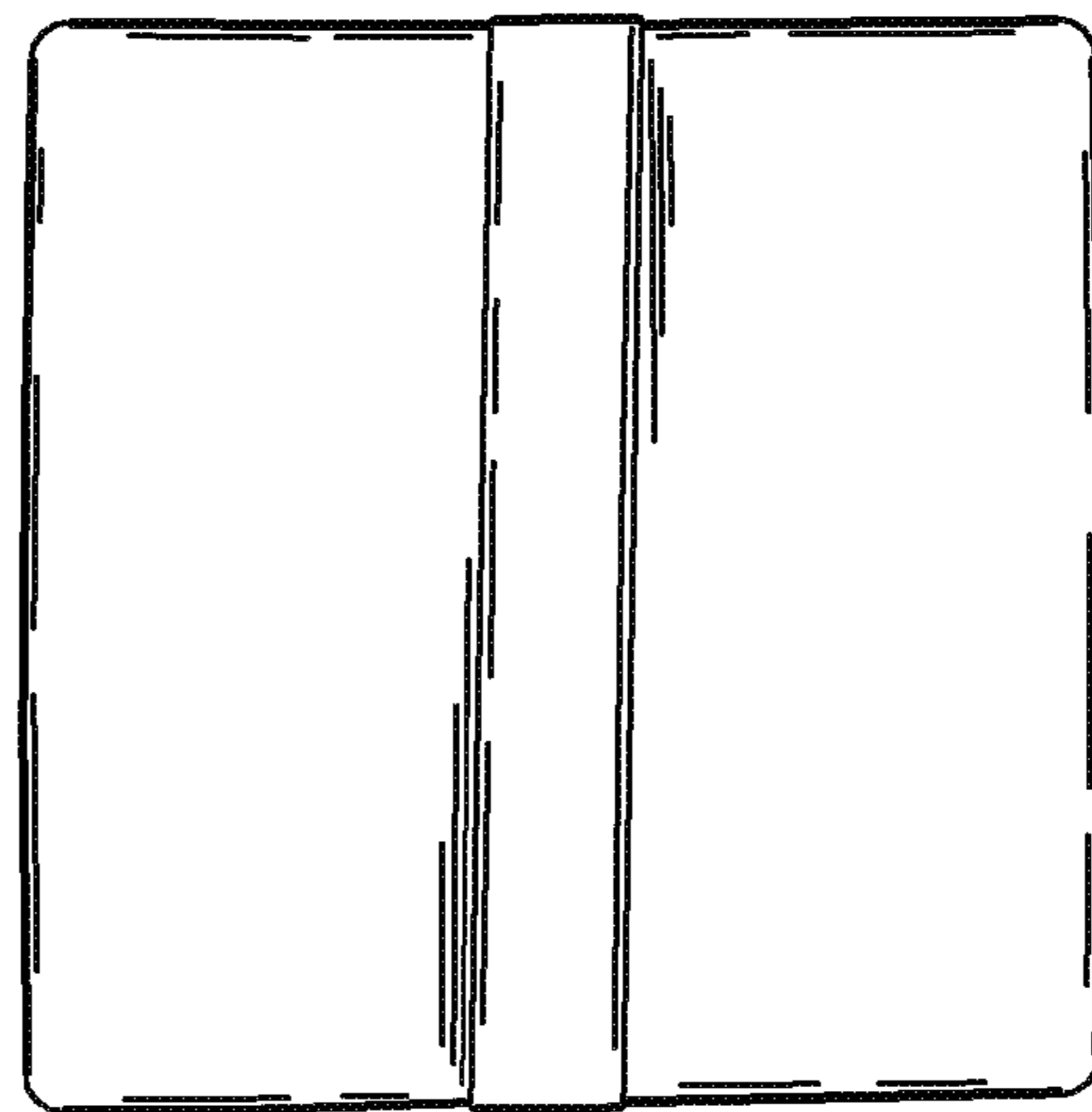
