the connector in an extended position.

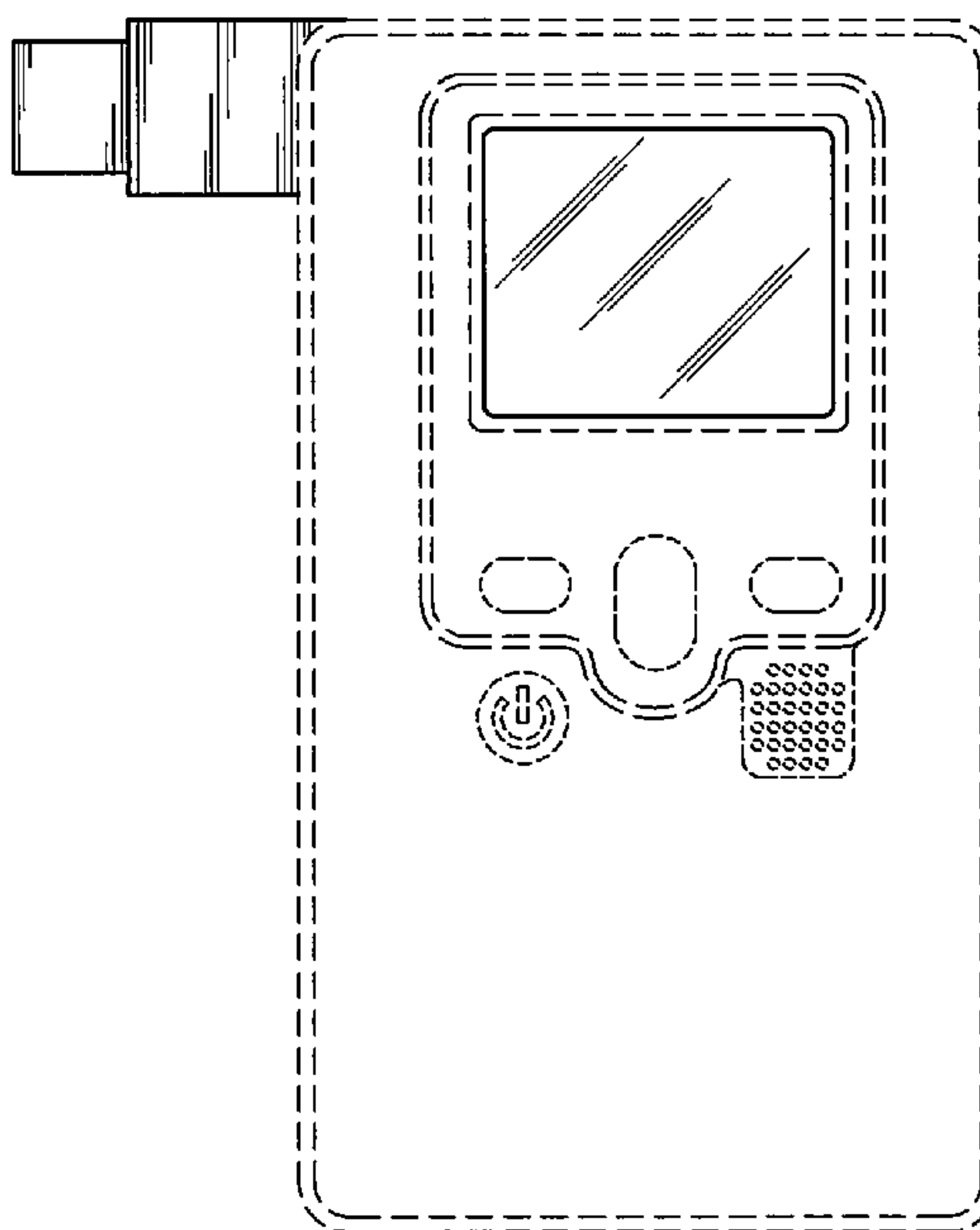
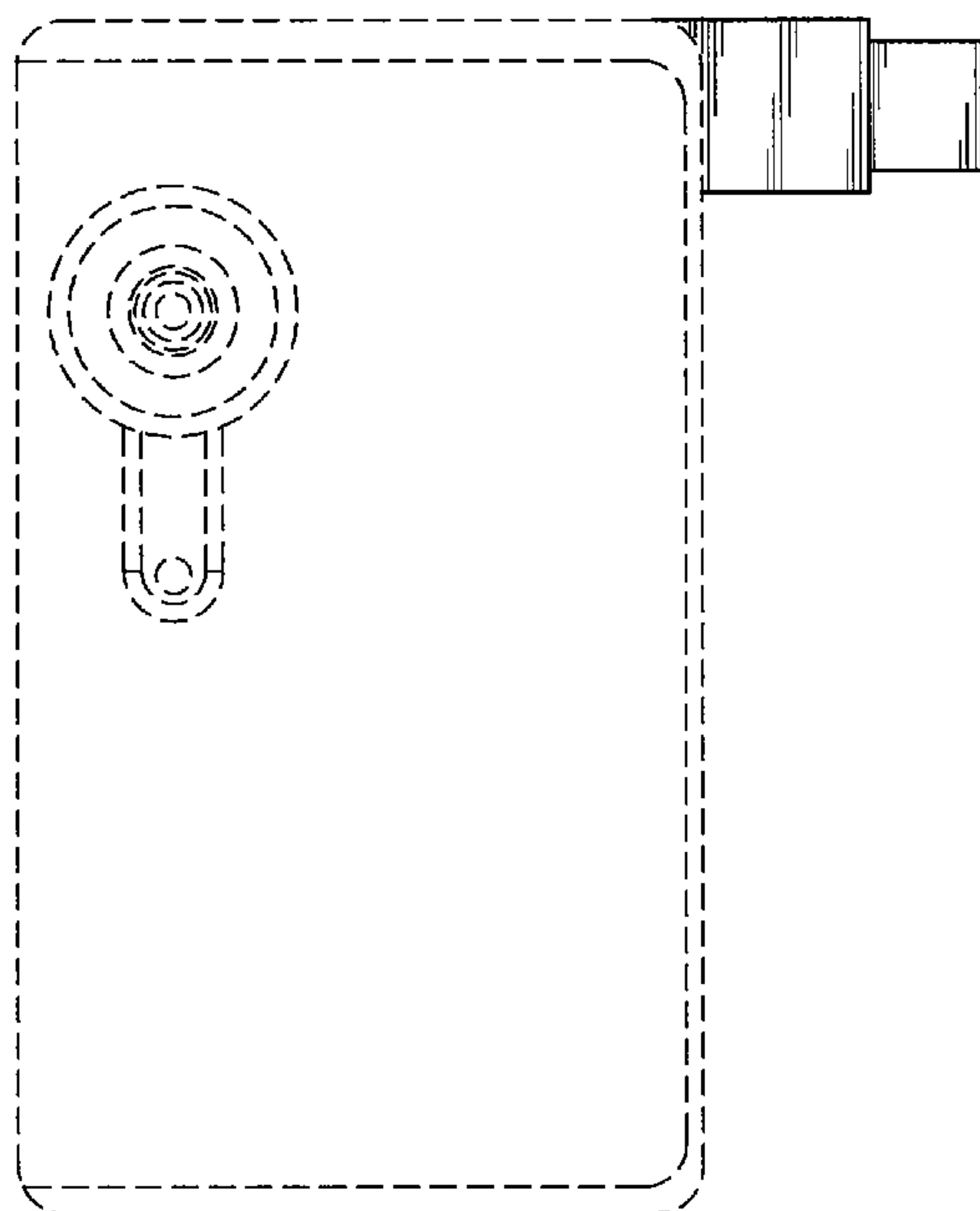
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof, with the connector in

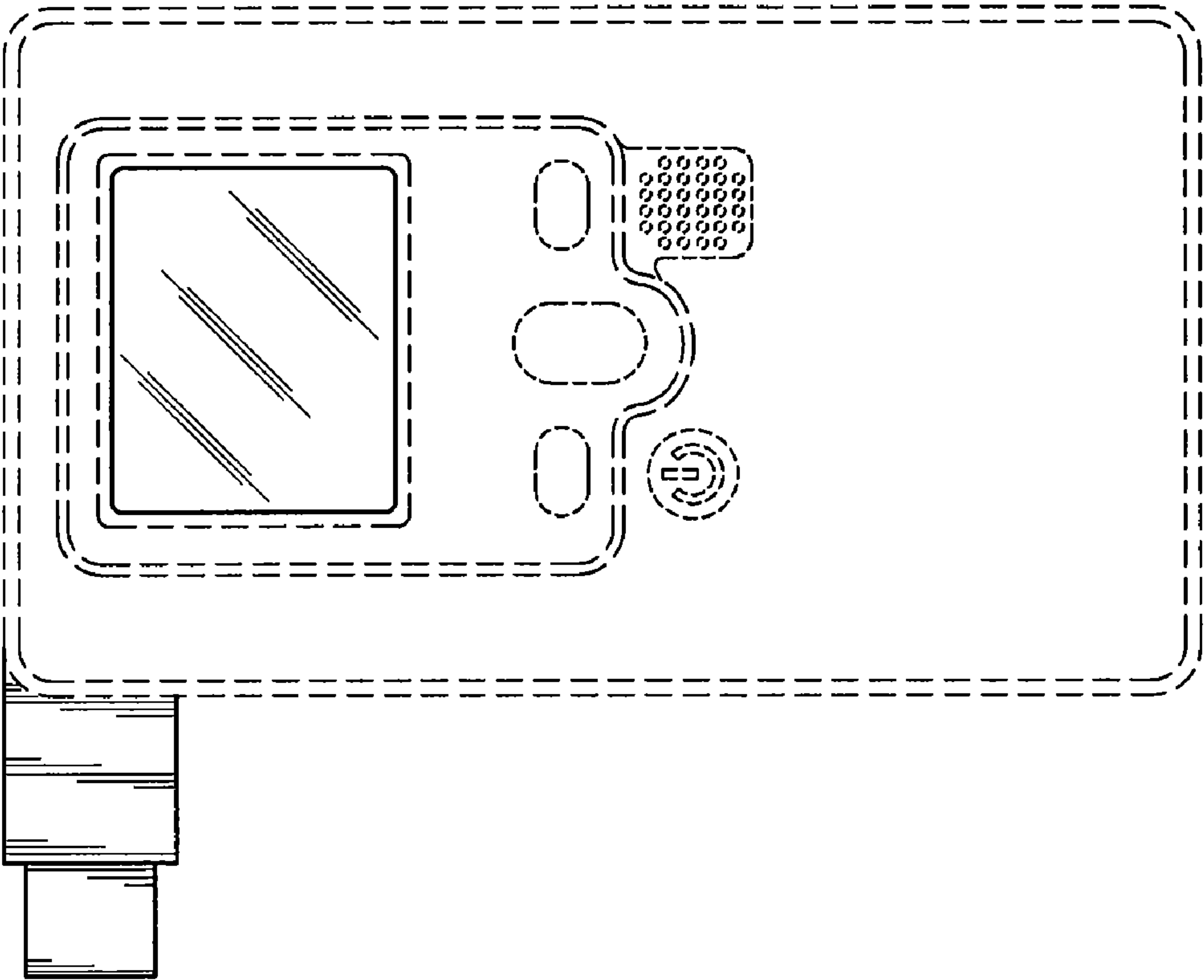

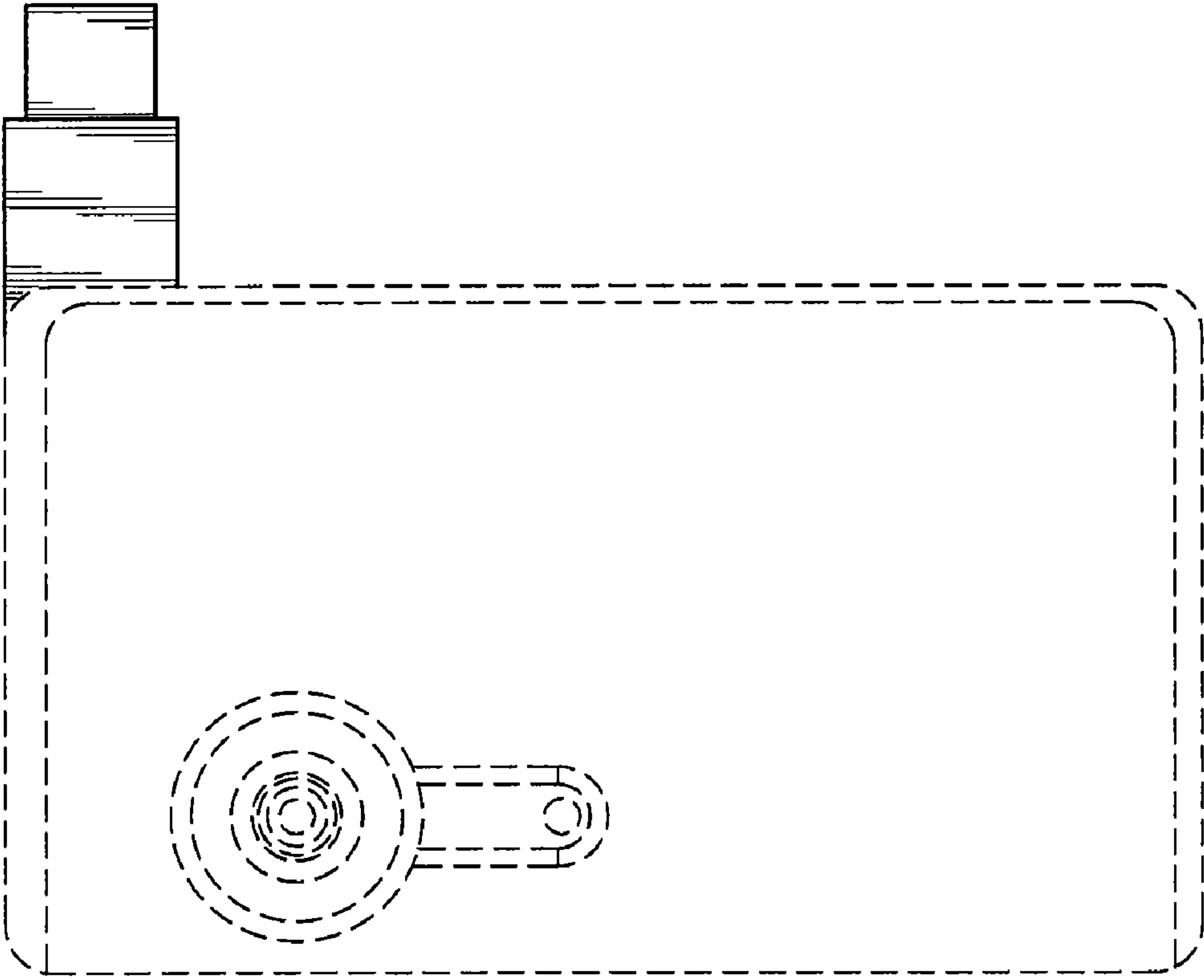

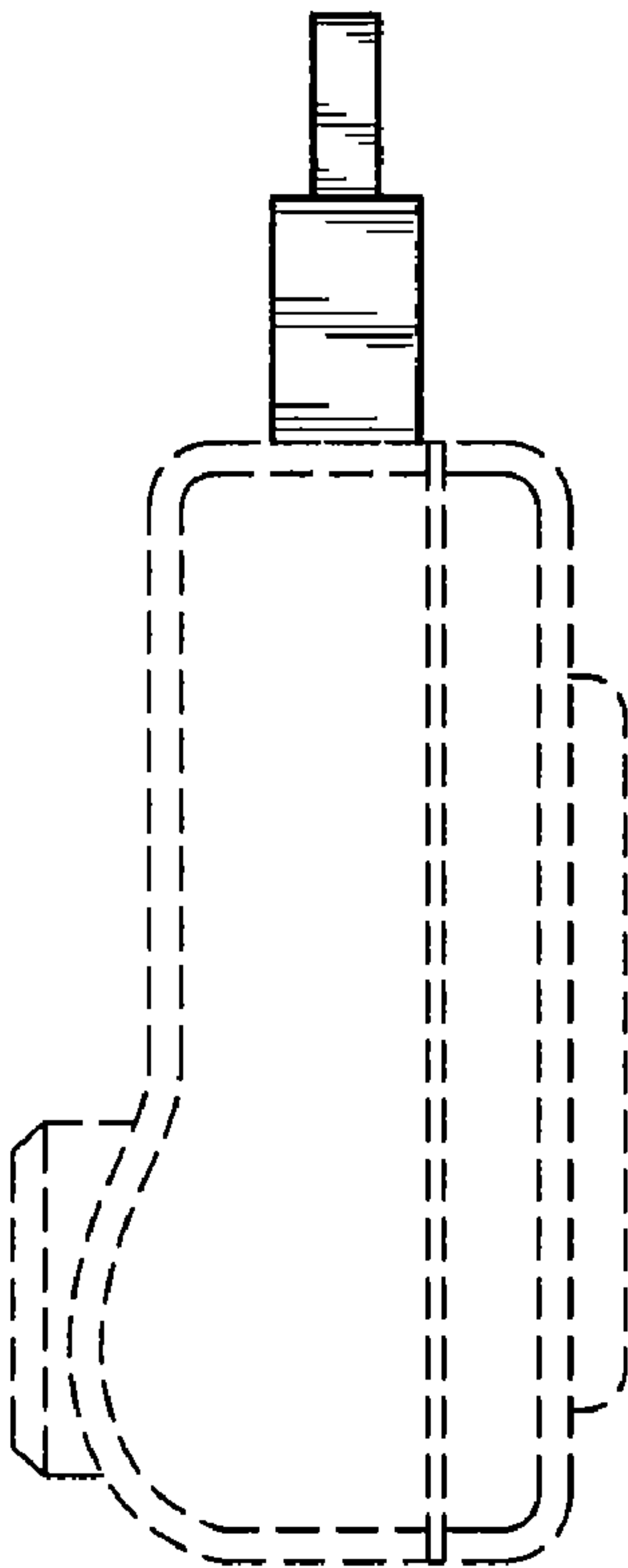

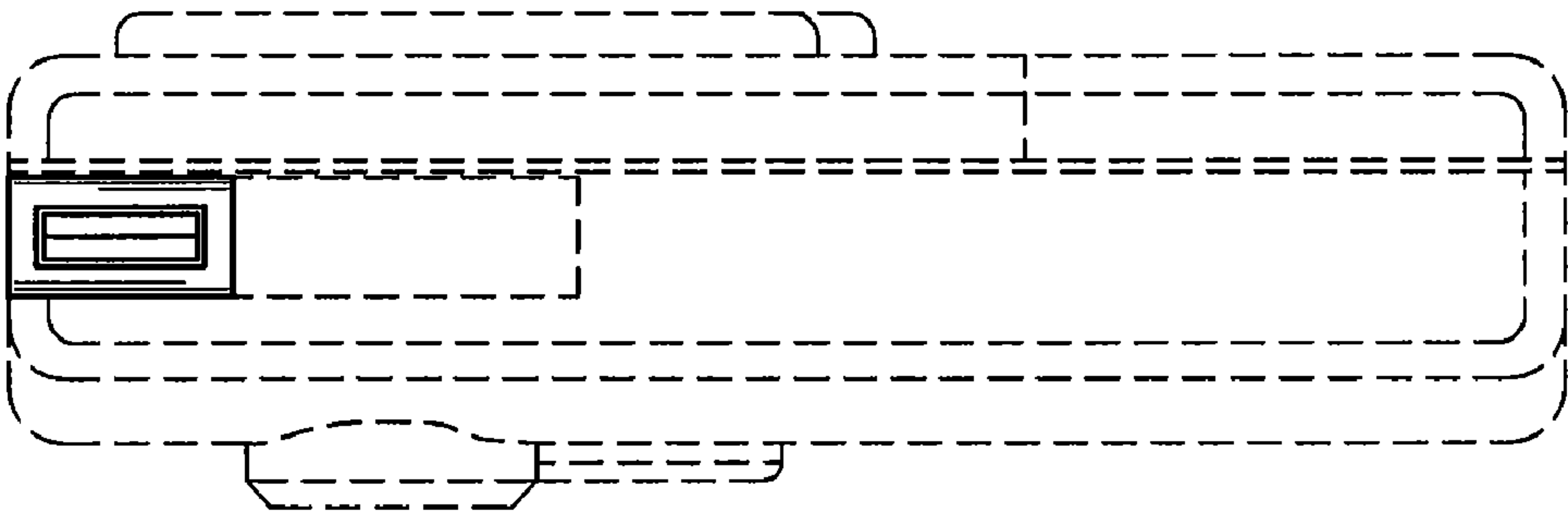
