FIG. 5 is a right side view of the automatic table tennis ball server of FIG. 1;

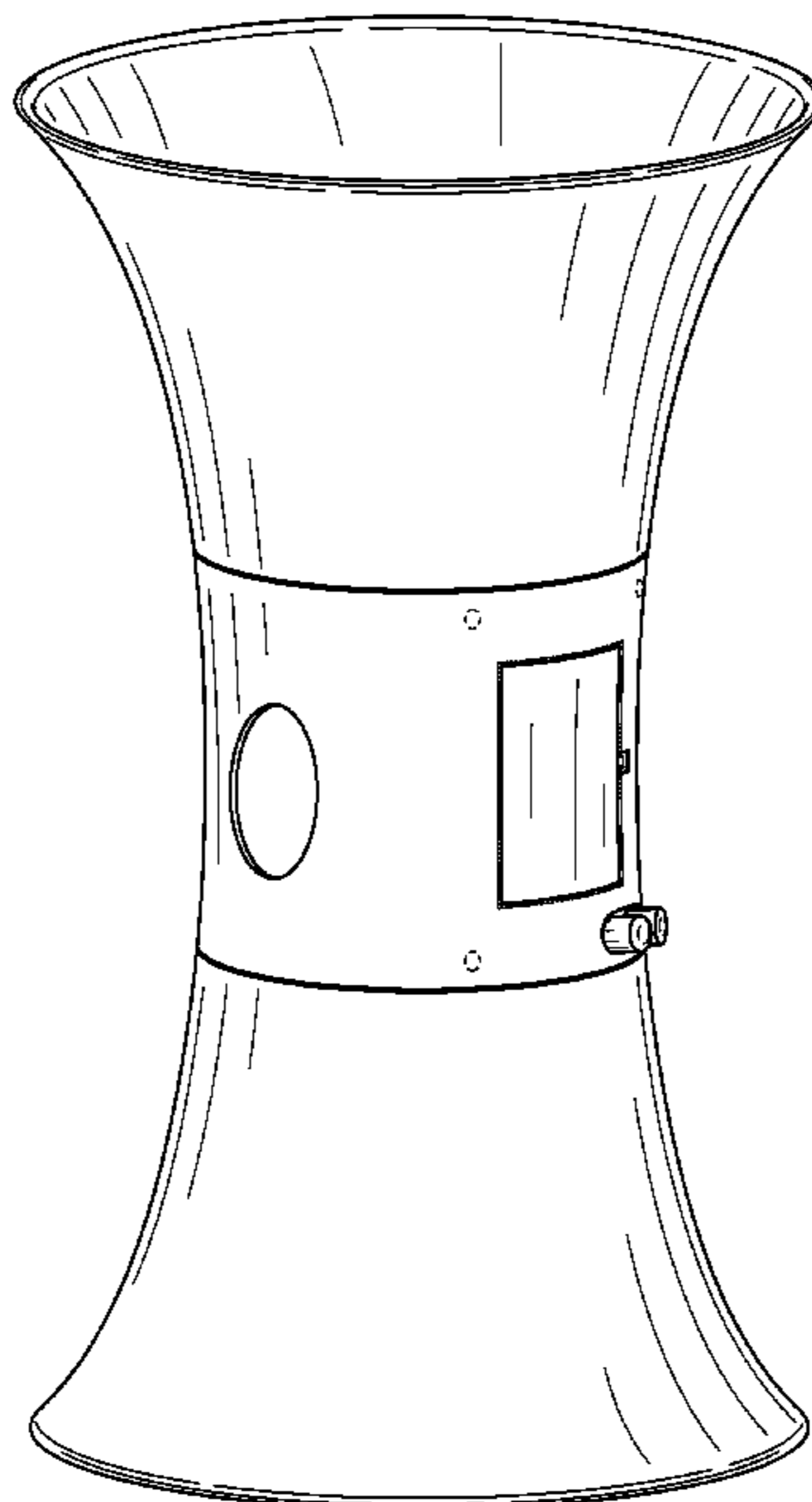
FIG. 6 is a top view of the automatic table tennis ball server of FIG. 1; and,

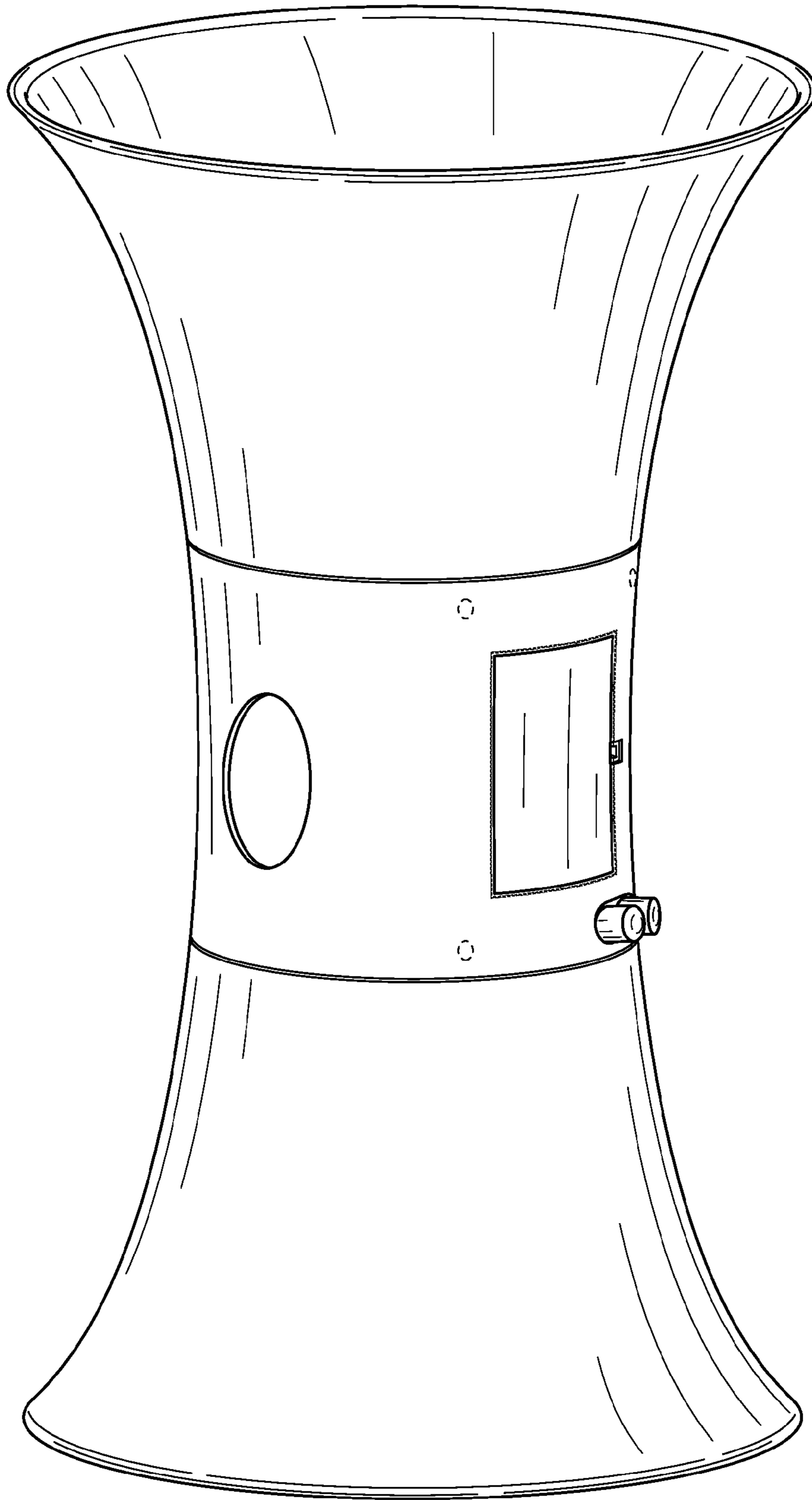

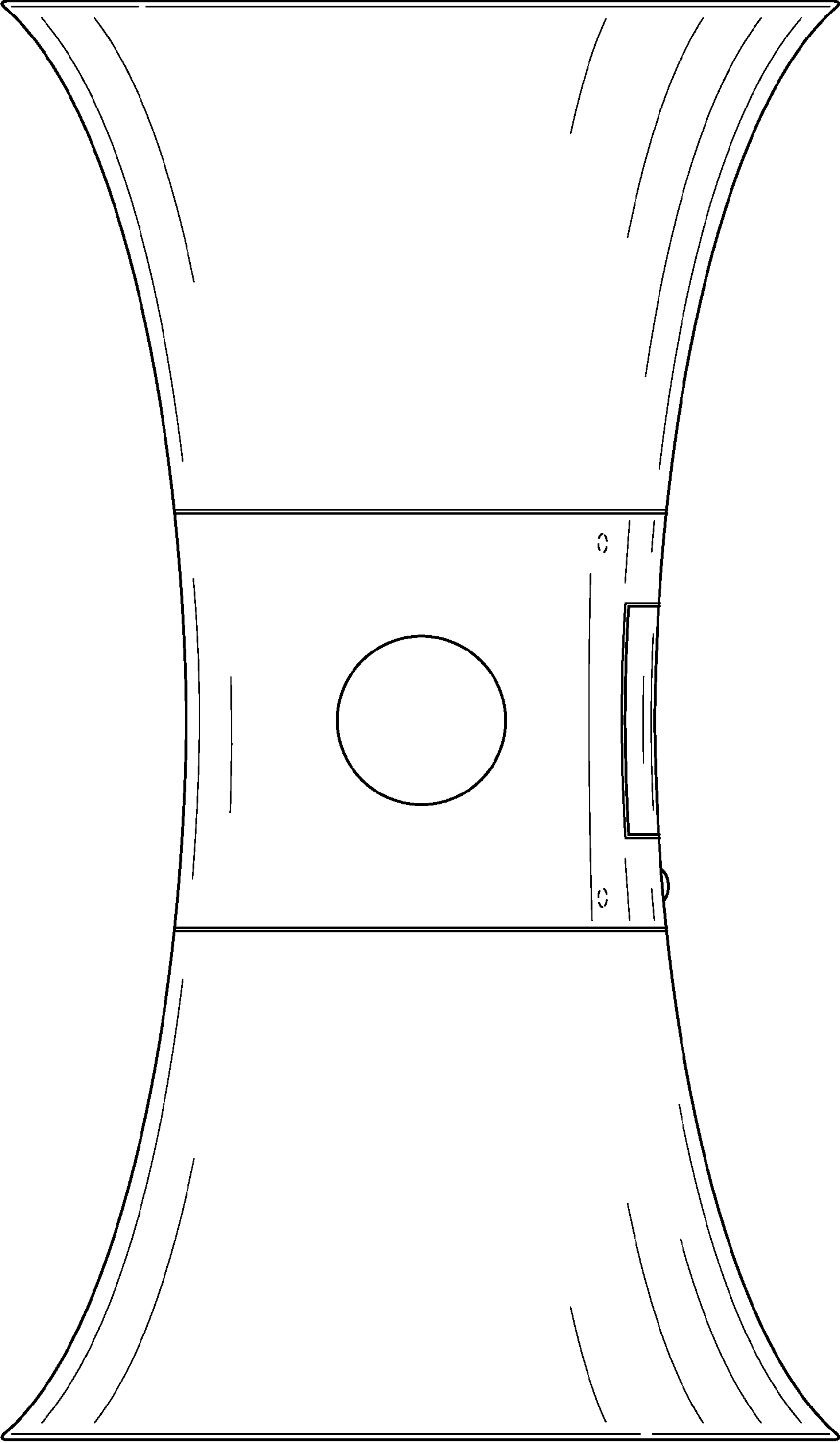

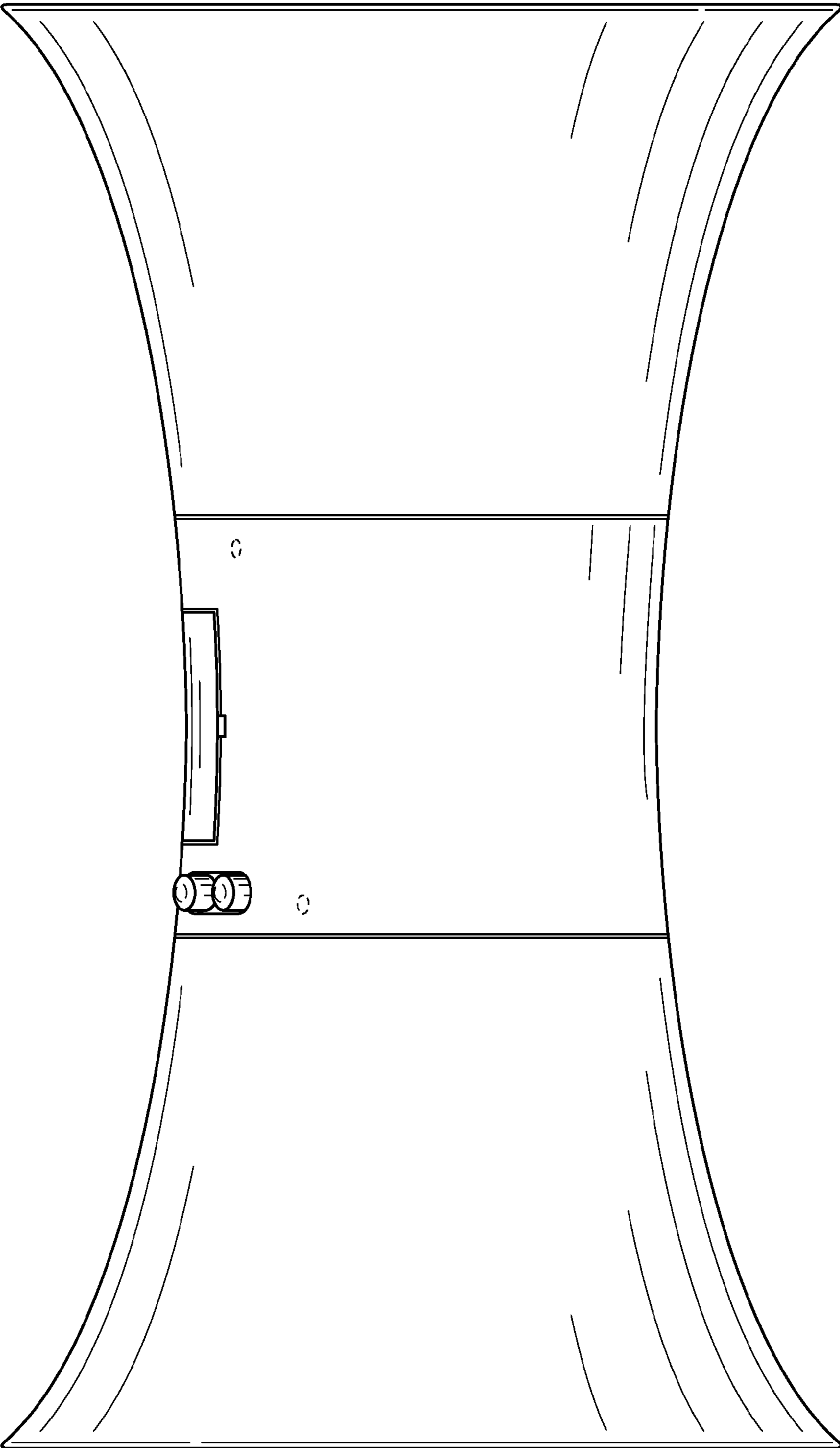

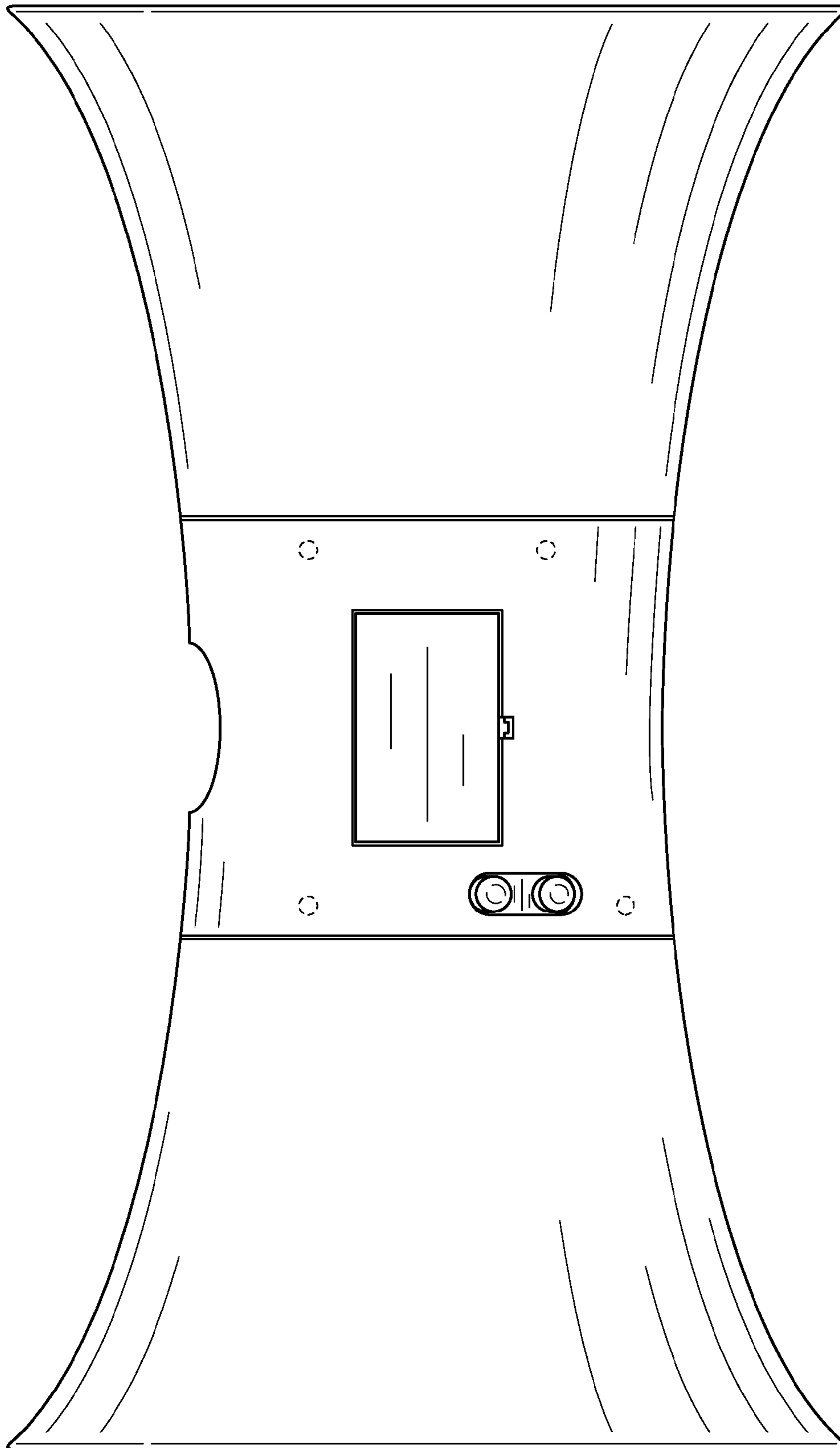

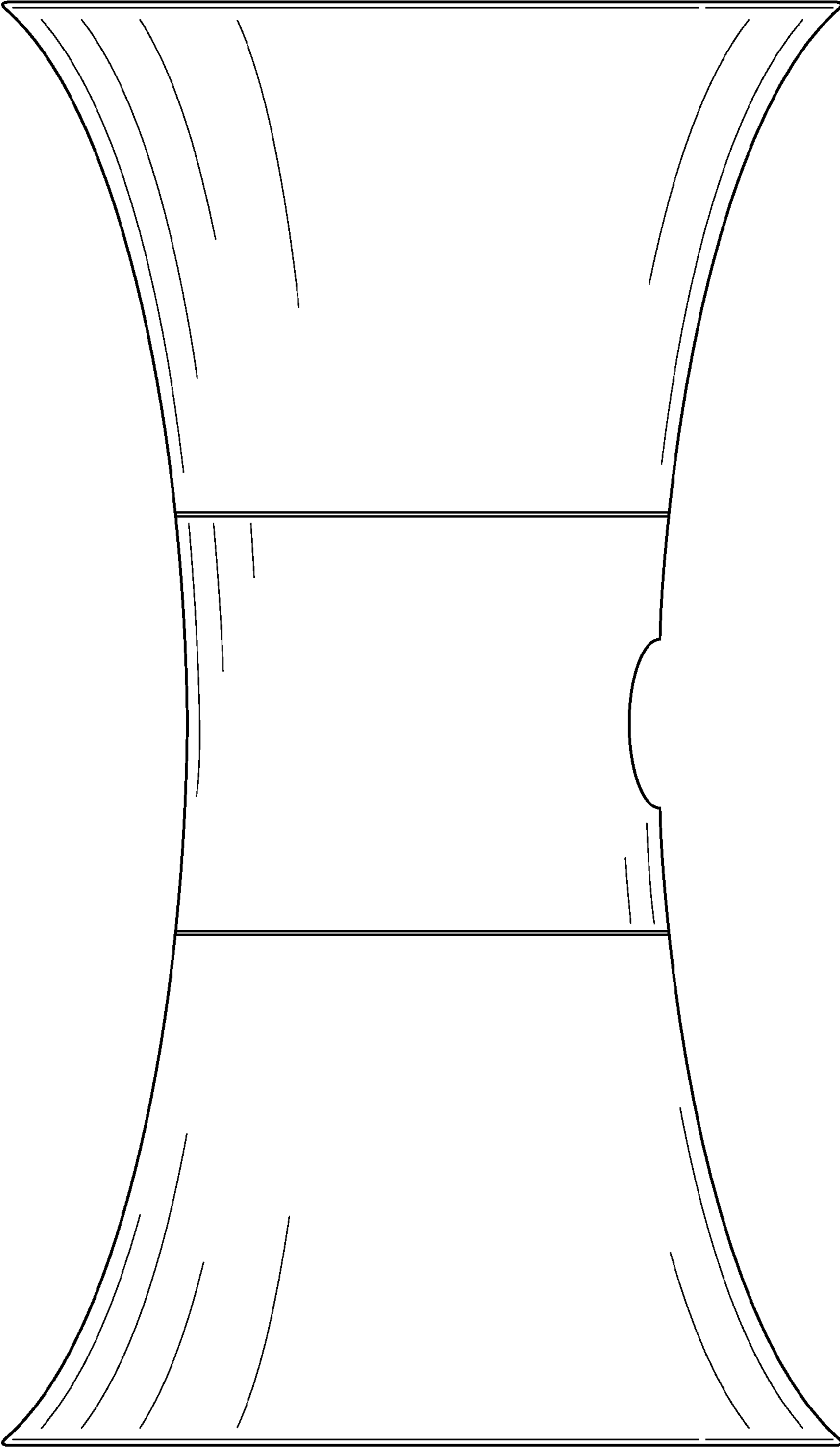

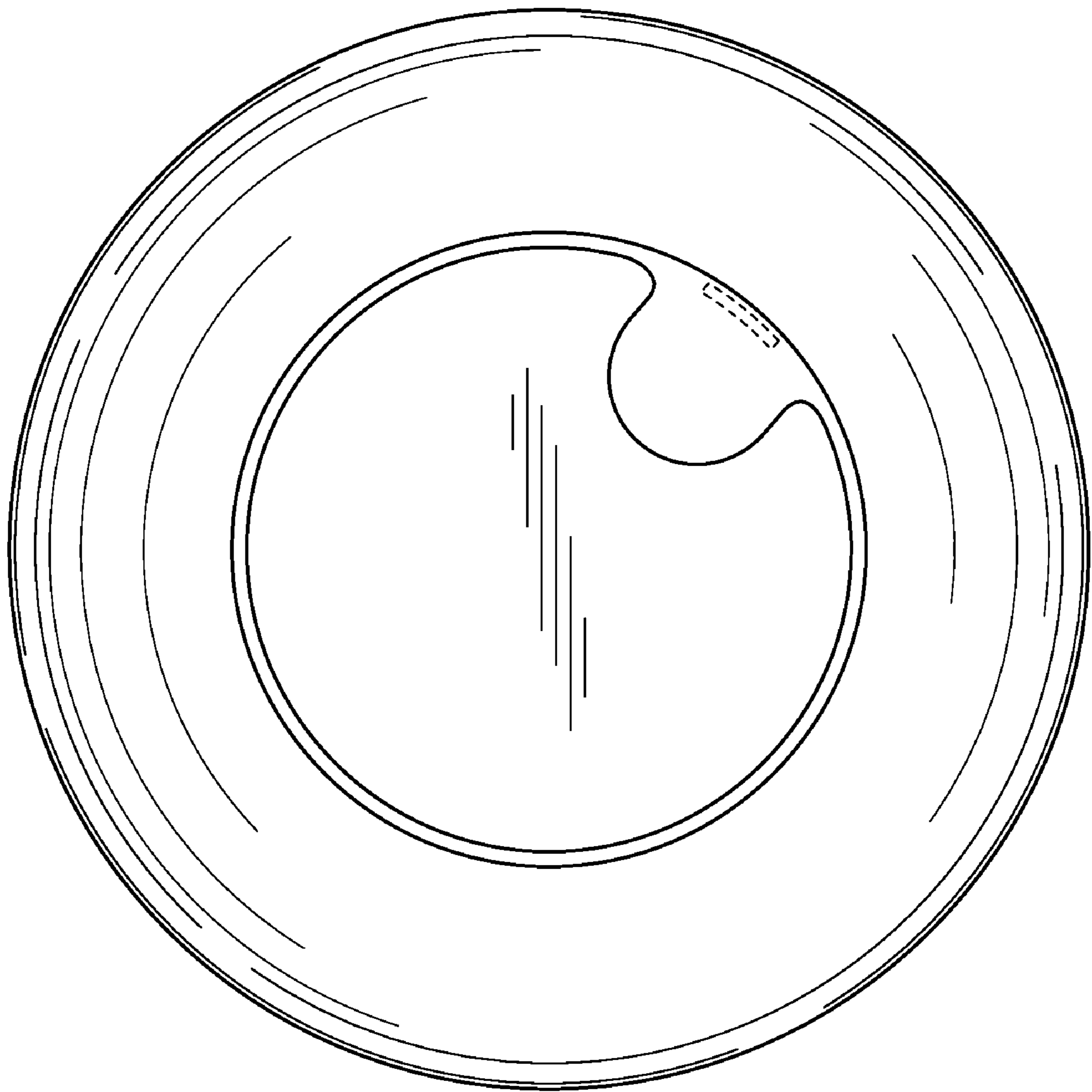

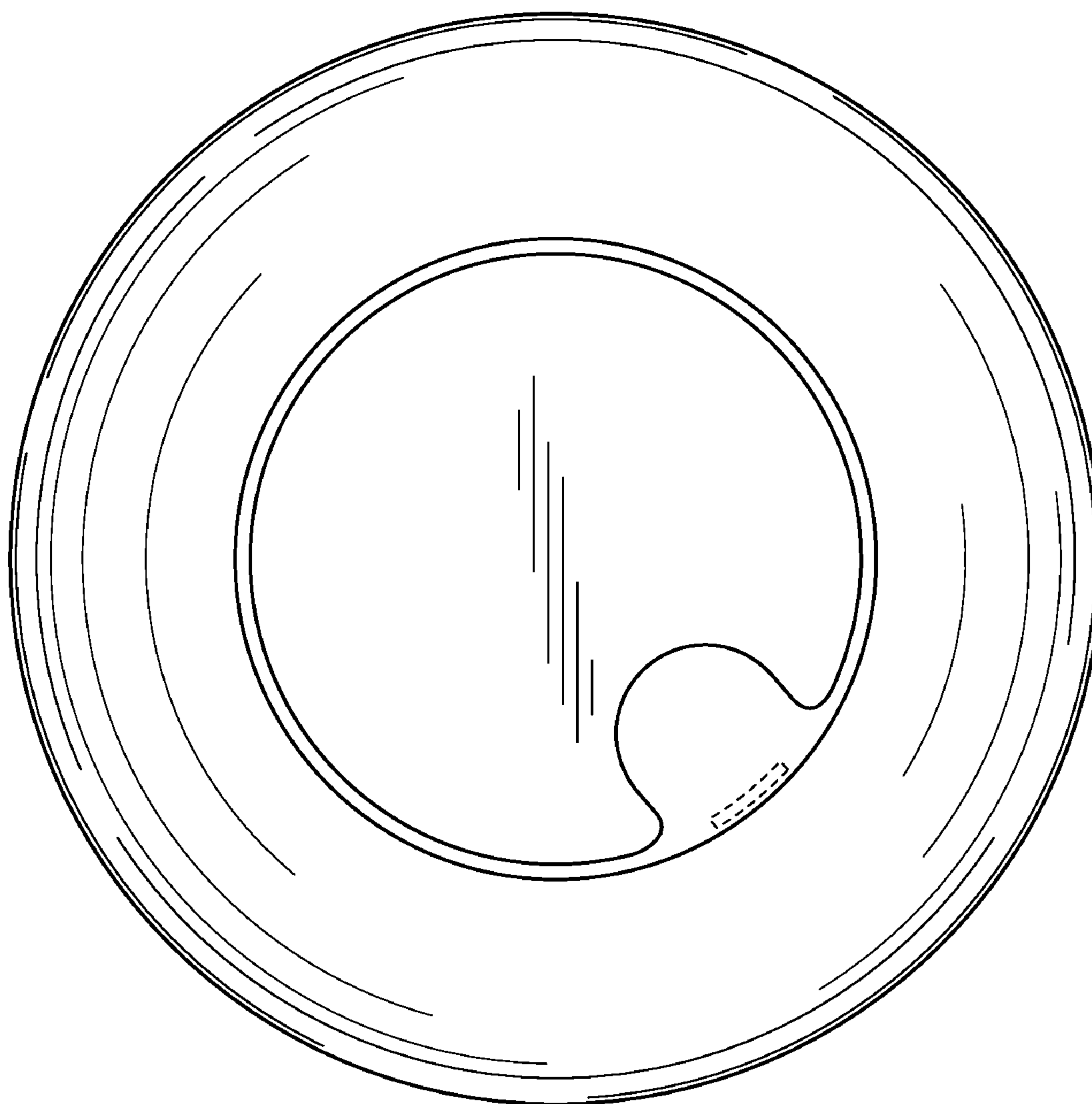
