FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a edible candle showing my new design;

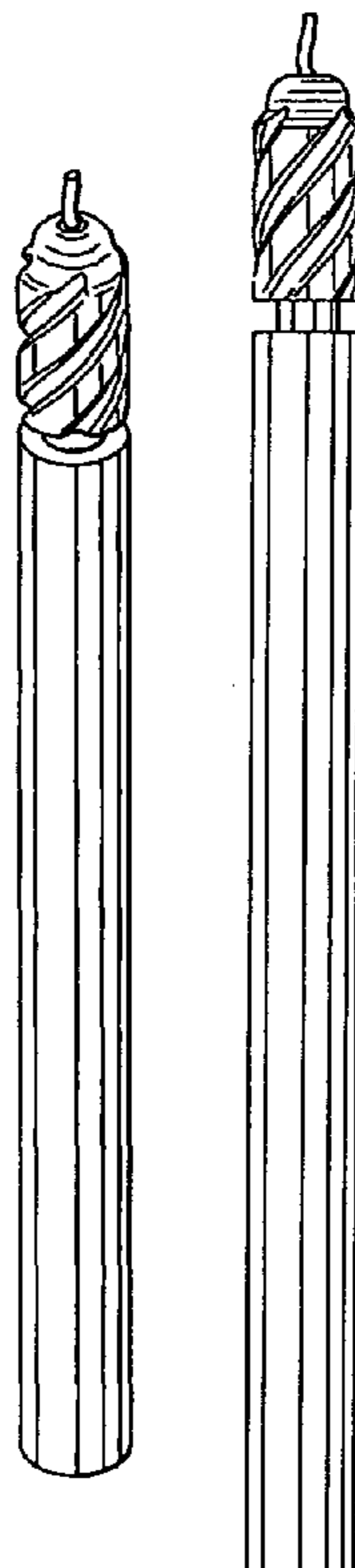
FIG. 2 is a front view, the back view being a mirror image thereof;

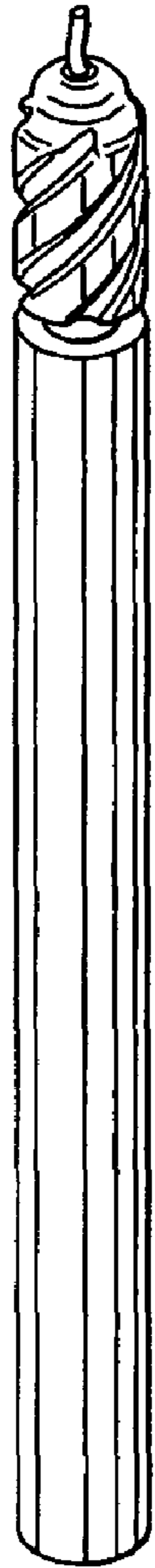

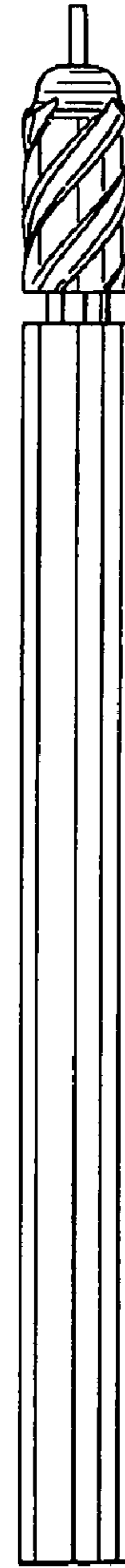
