FIG. 4 is the opposite elevation of the check stand shown in FIG. 1;

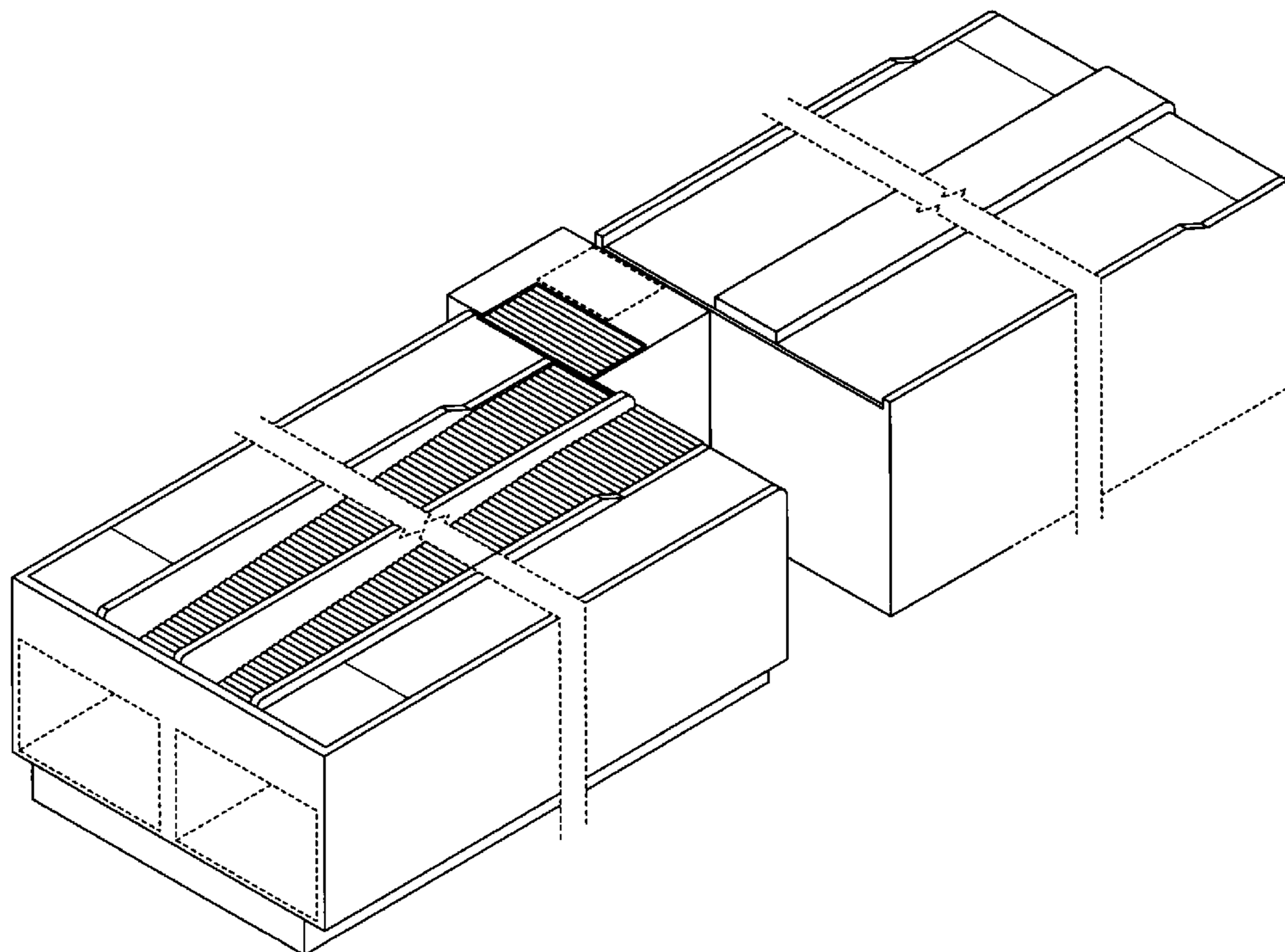
FIG. 5 is an end elevation of the check stand shown in FIG. 1, and,

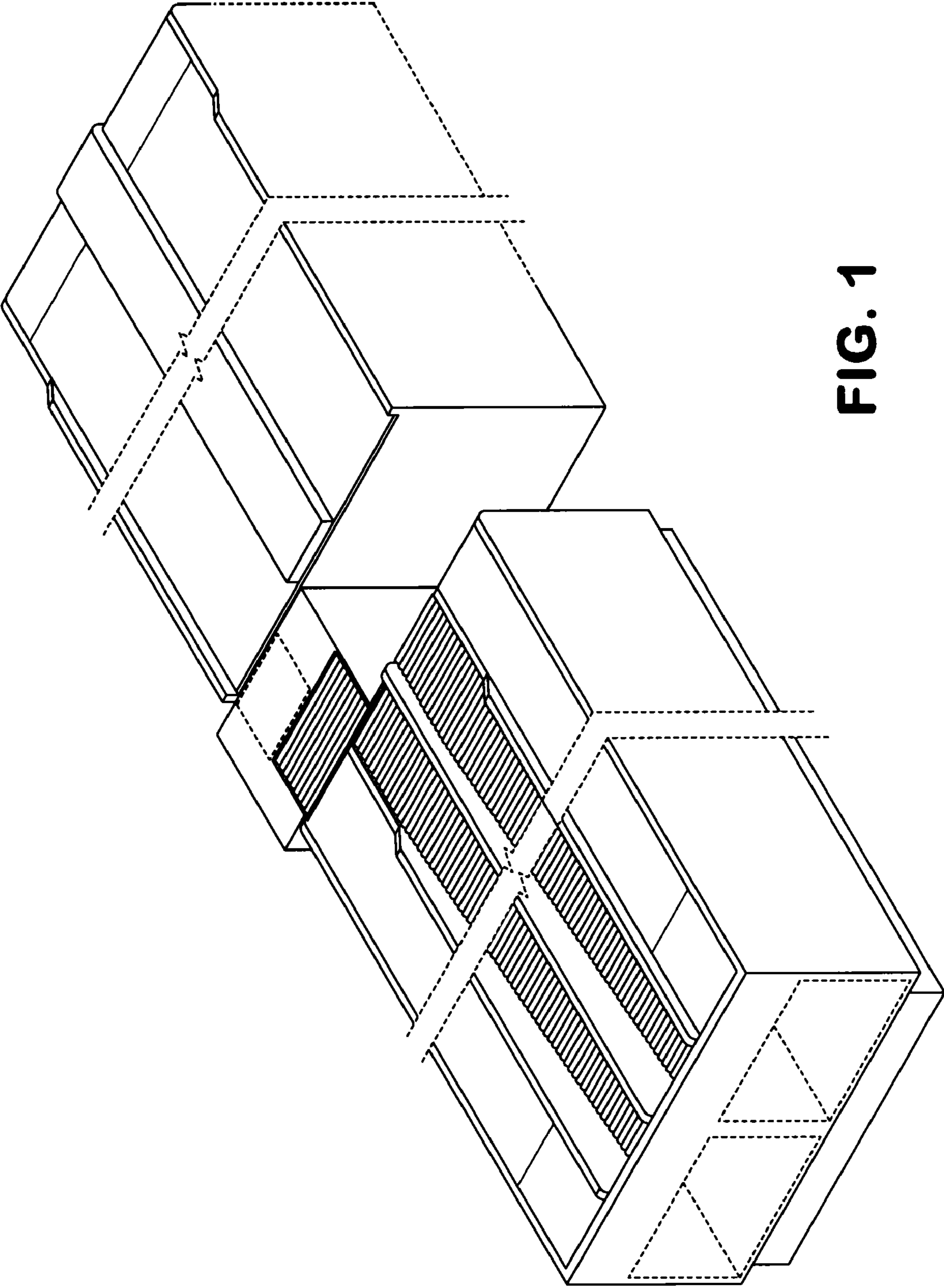
FIG. 6 is the opposite end of the check stand shown in FIG. 1.

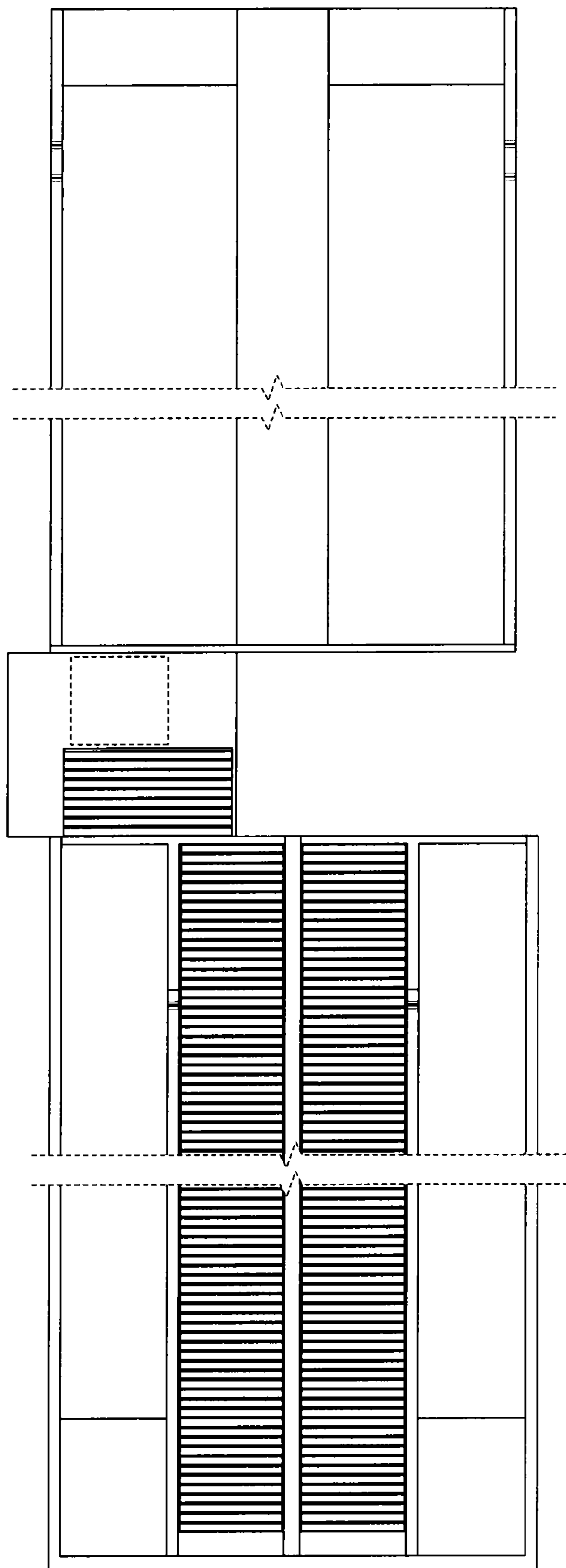
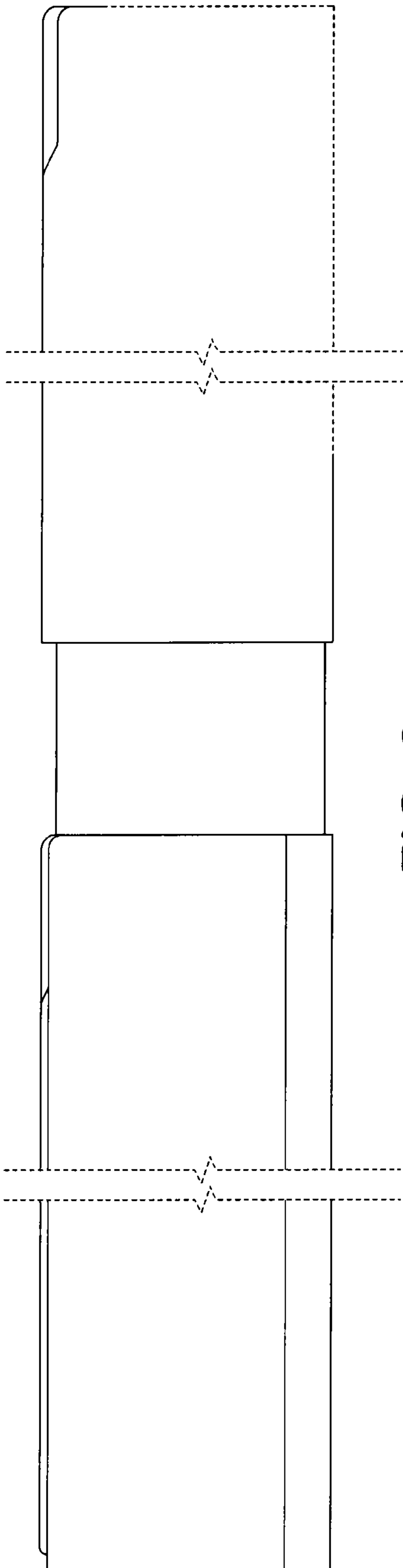
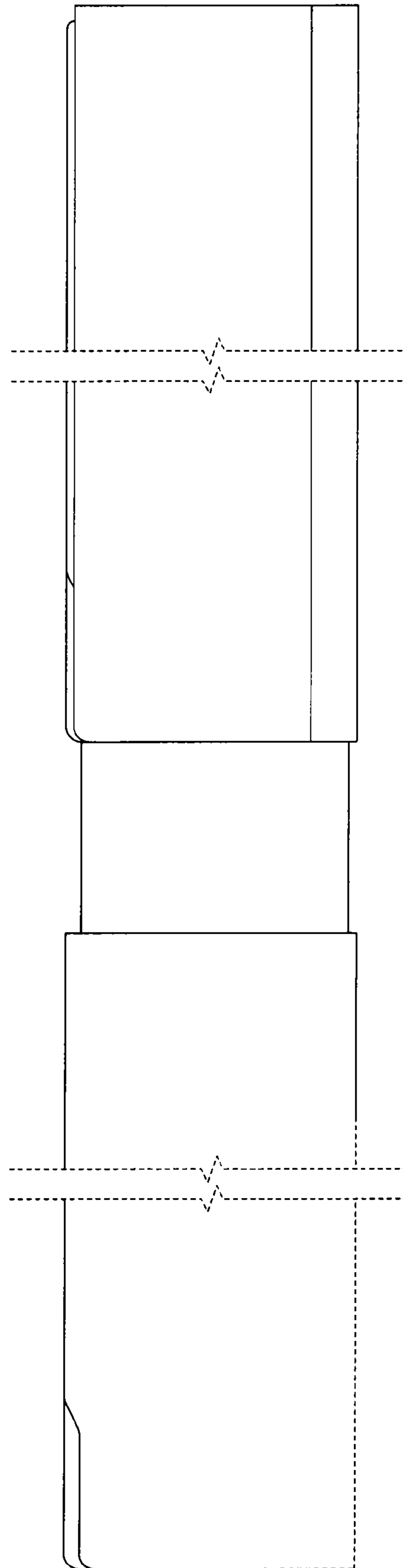


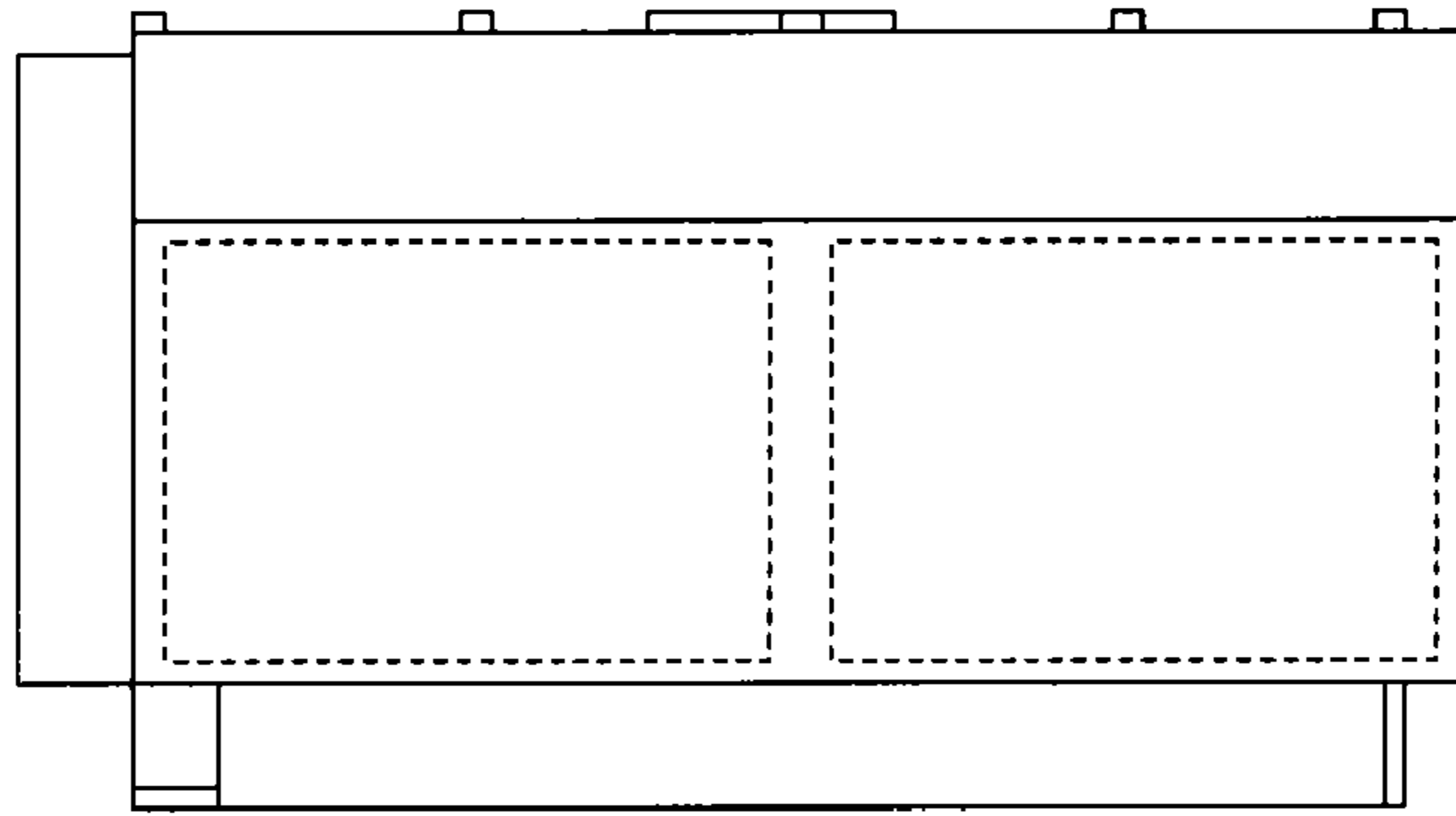

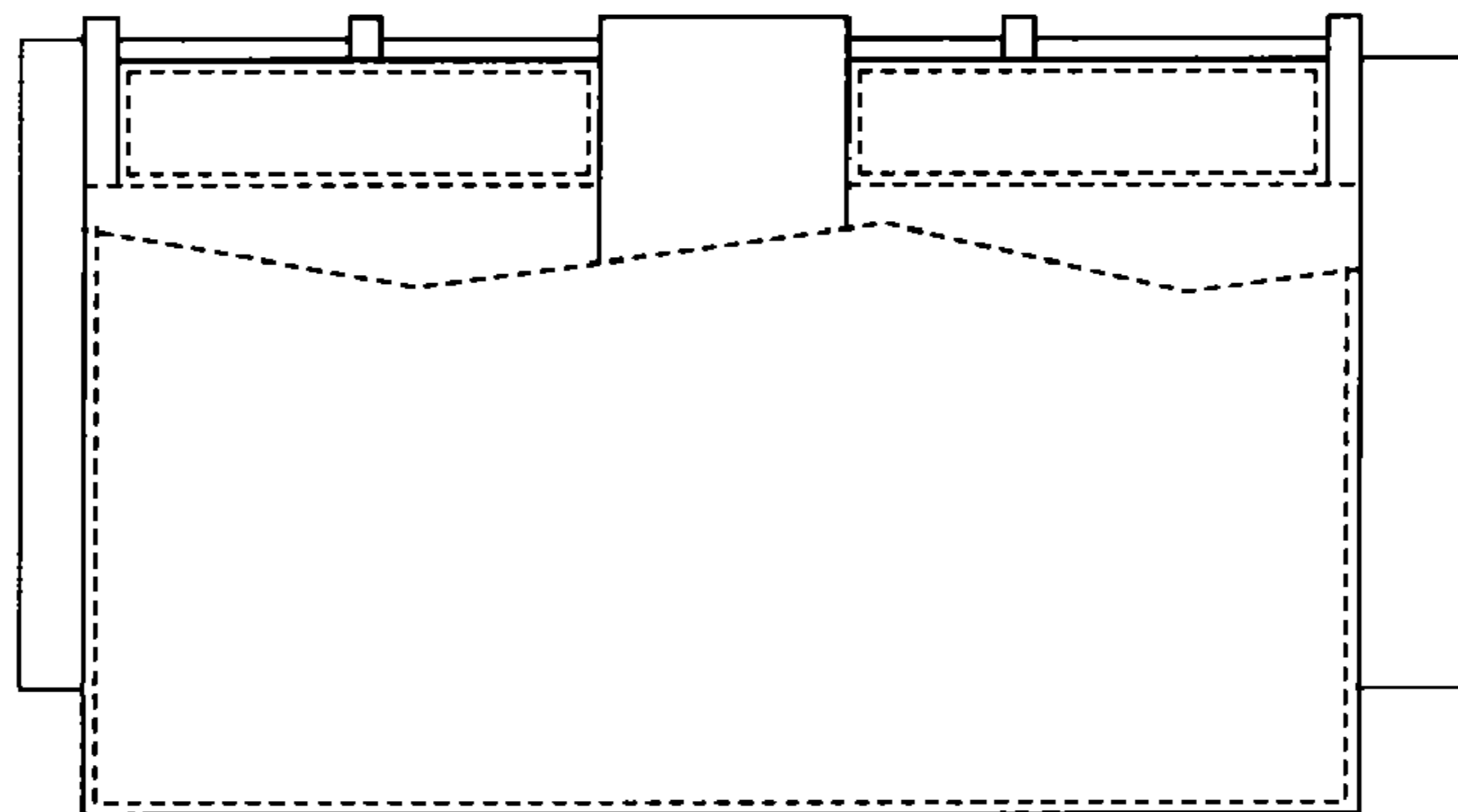
