The ornamental design for a personal video display device, as shown and described herein.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the personal video display device shown in FIG. 1.

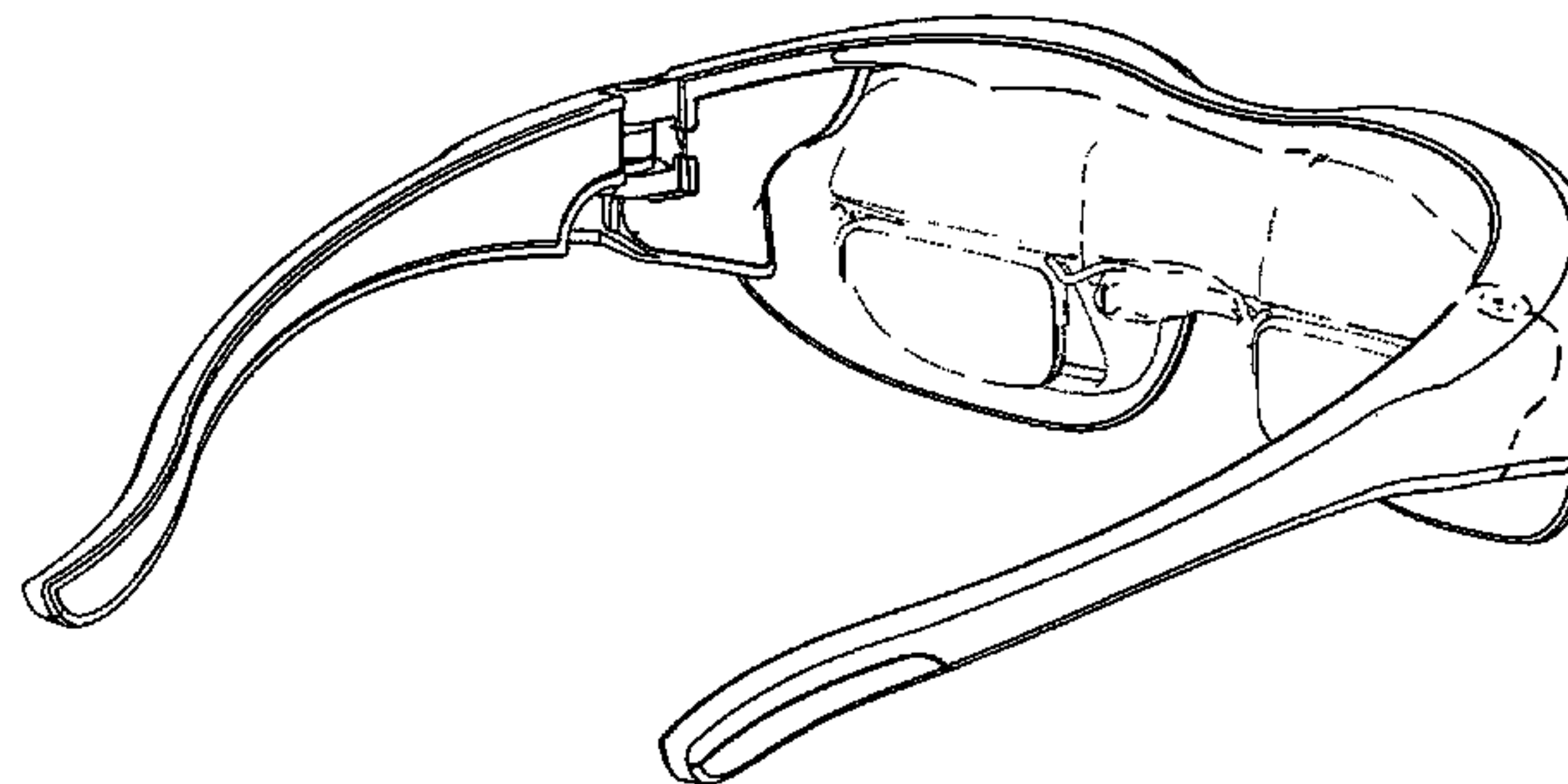
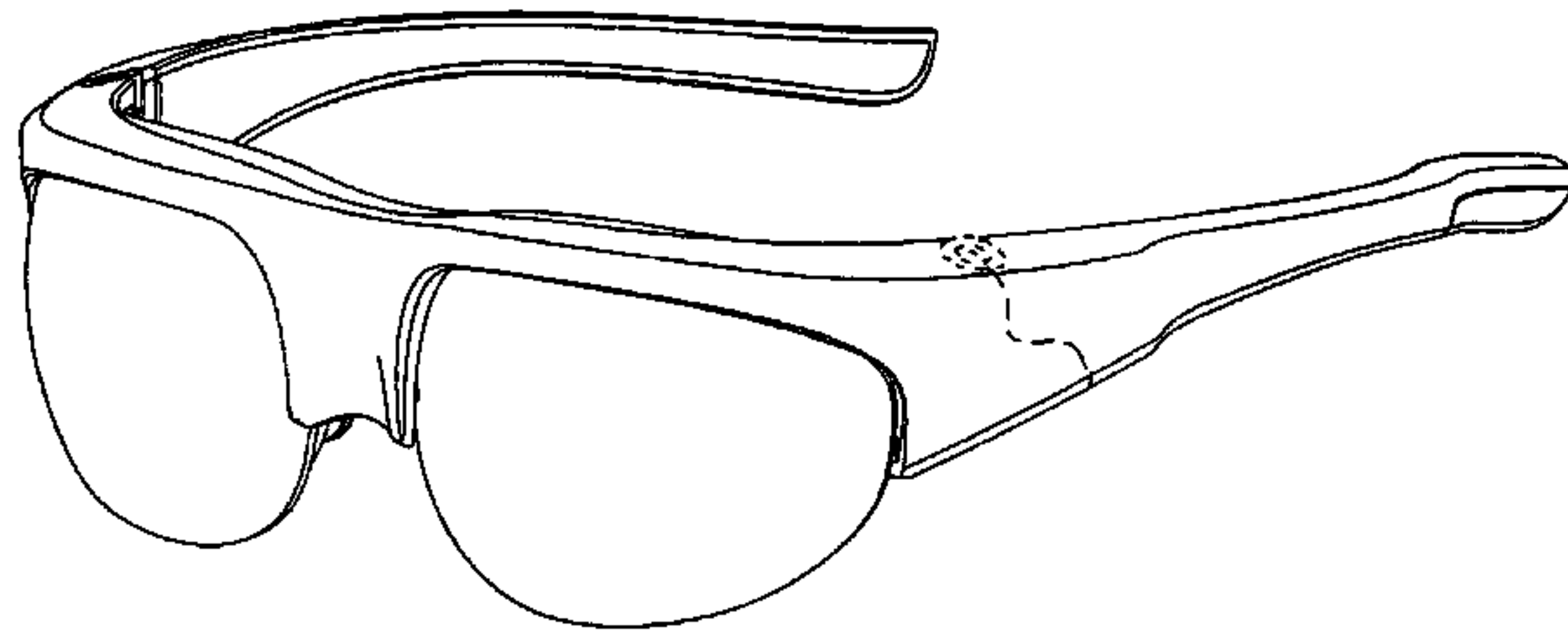
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the personal video display device shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

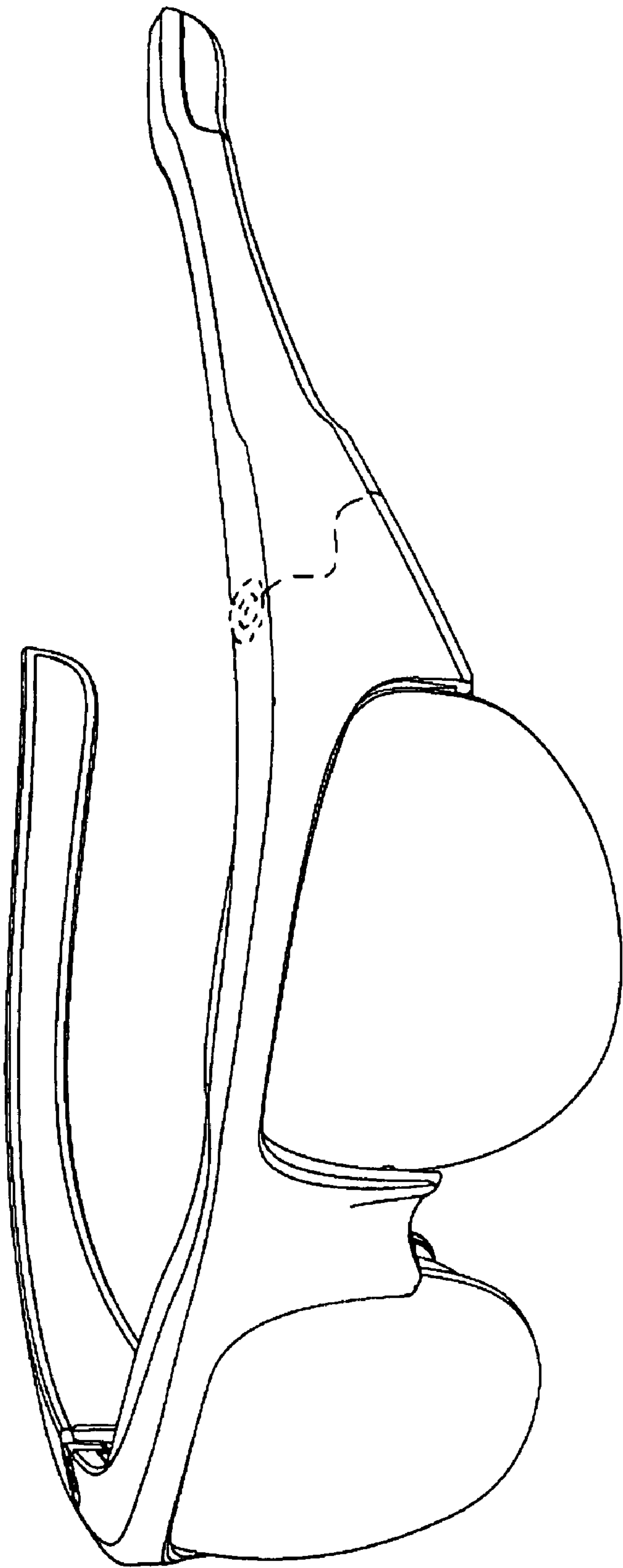

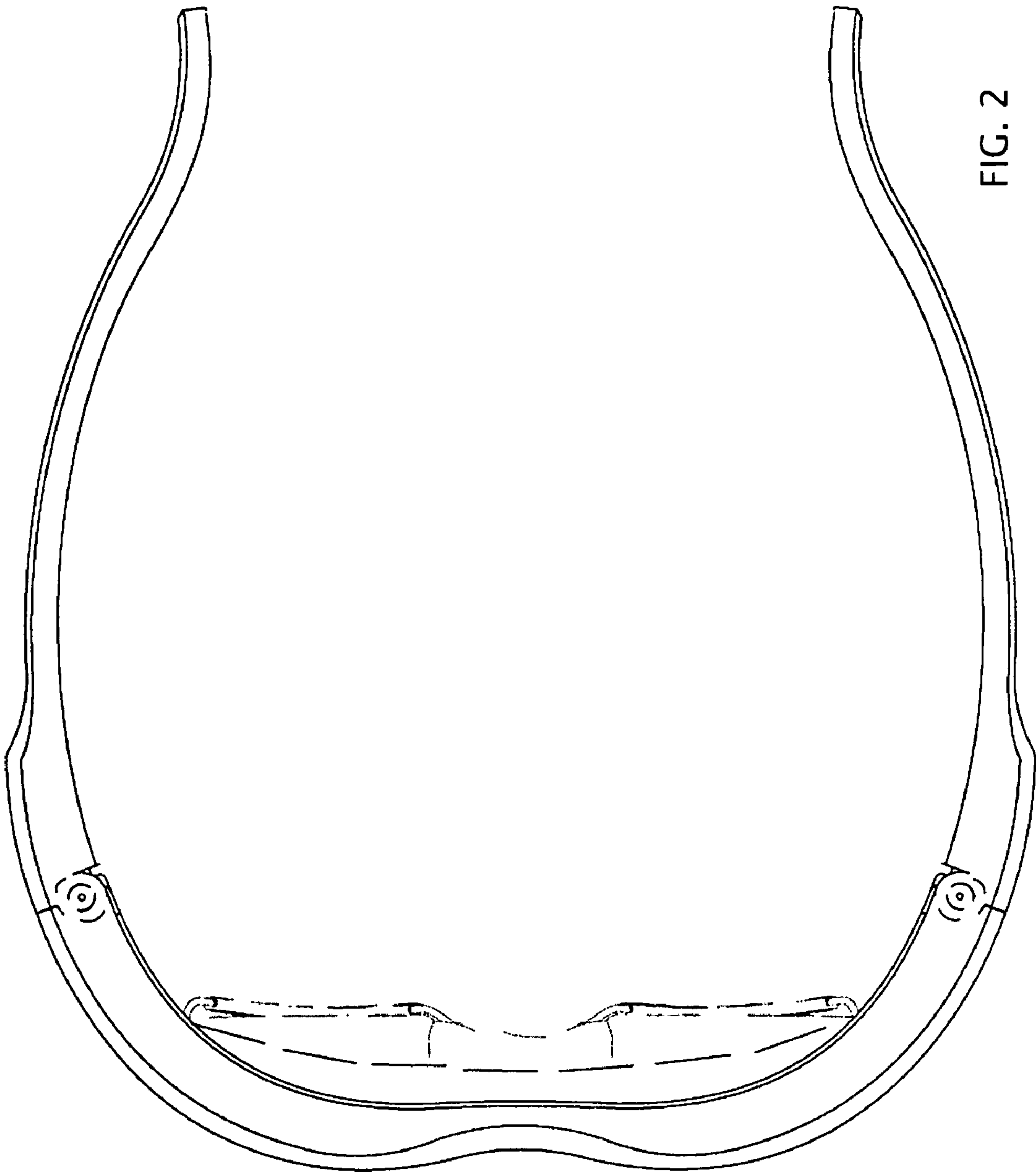

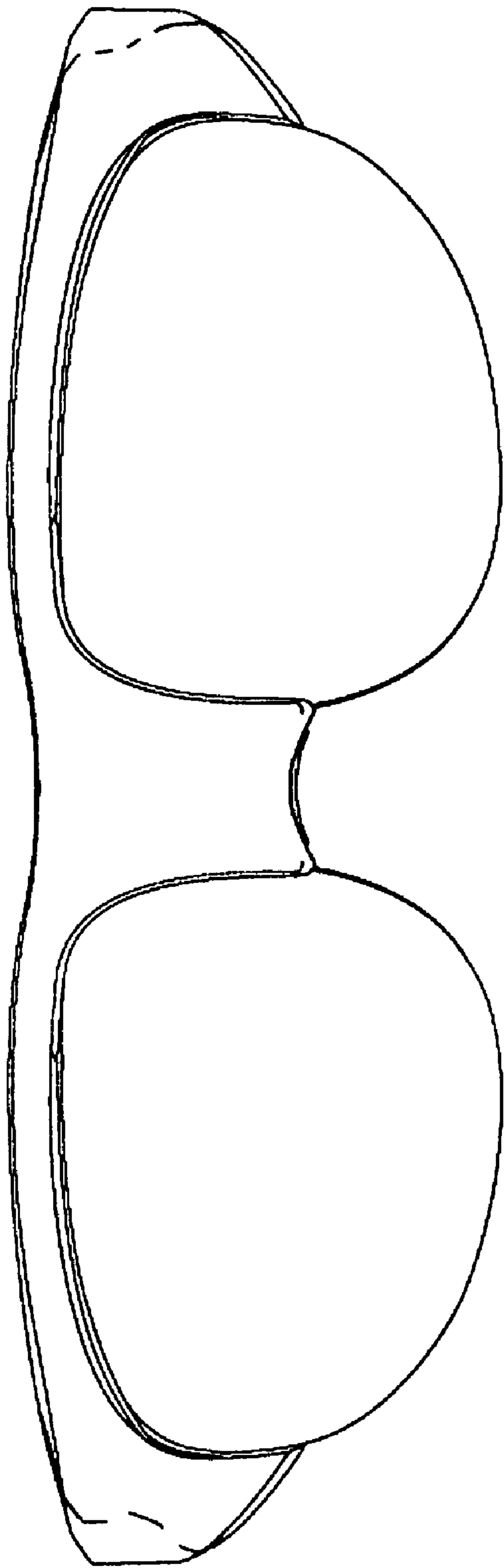

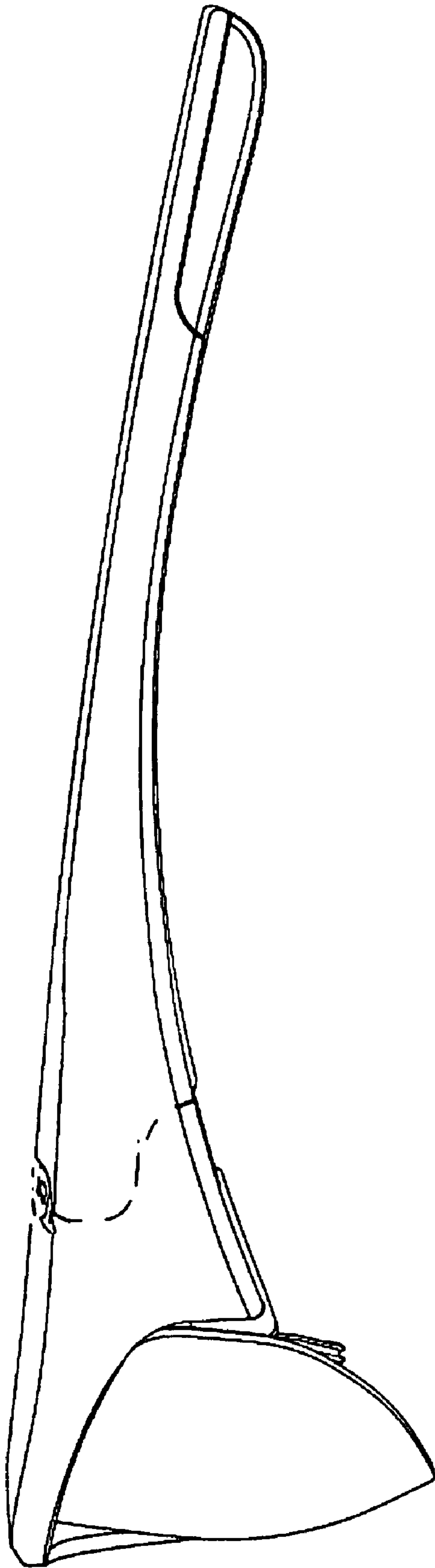

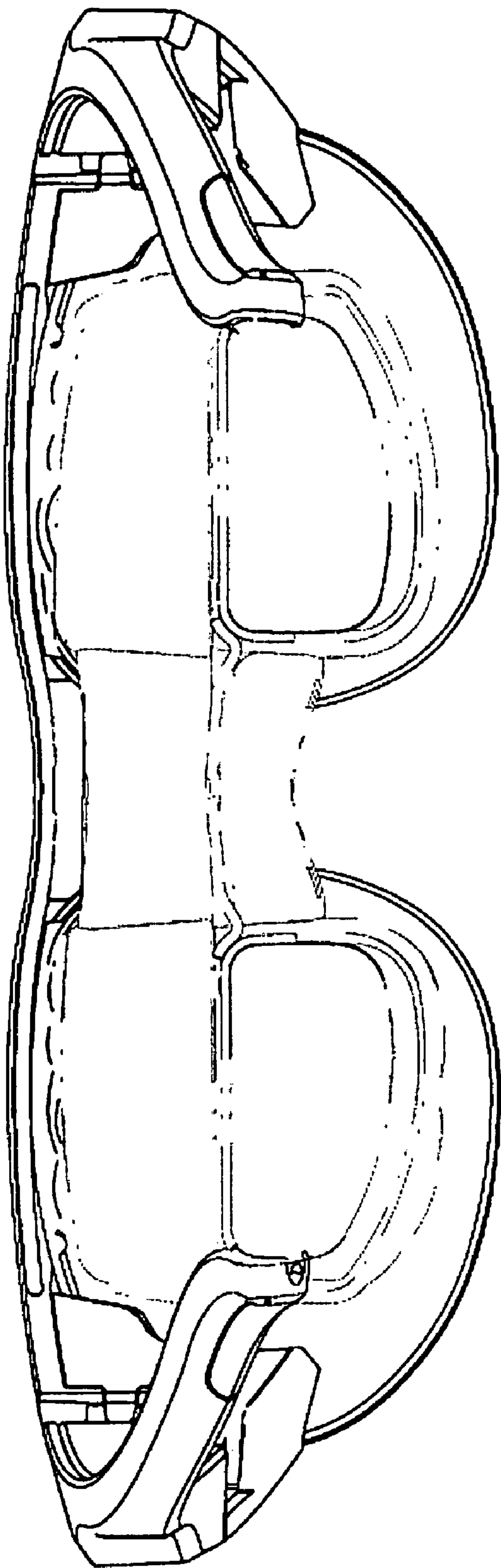

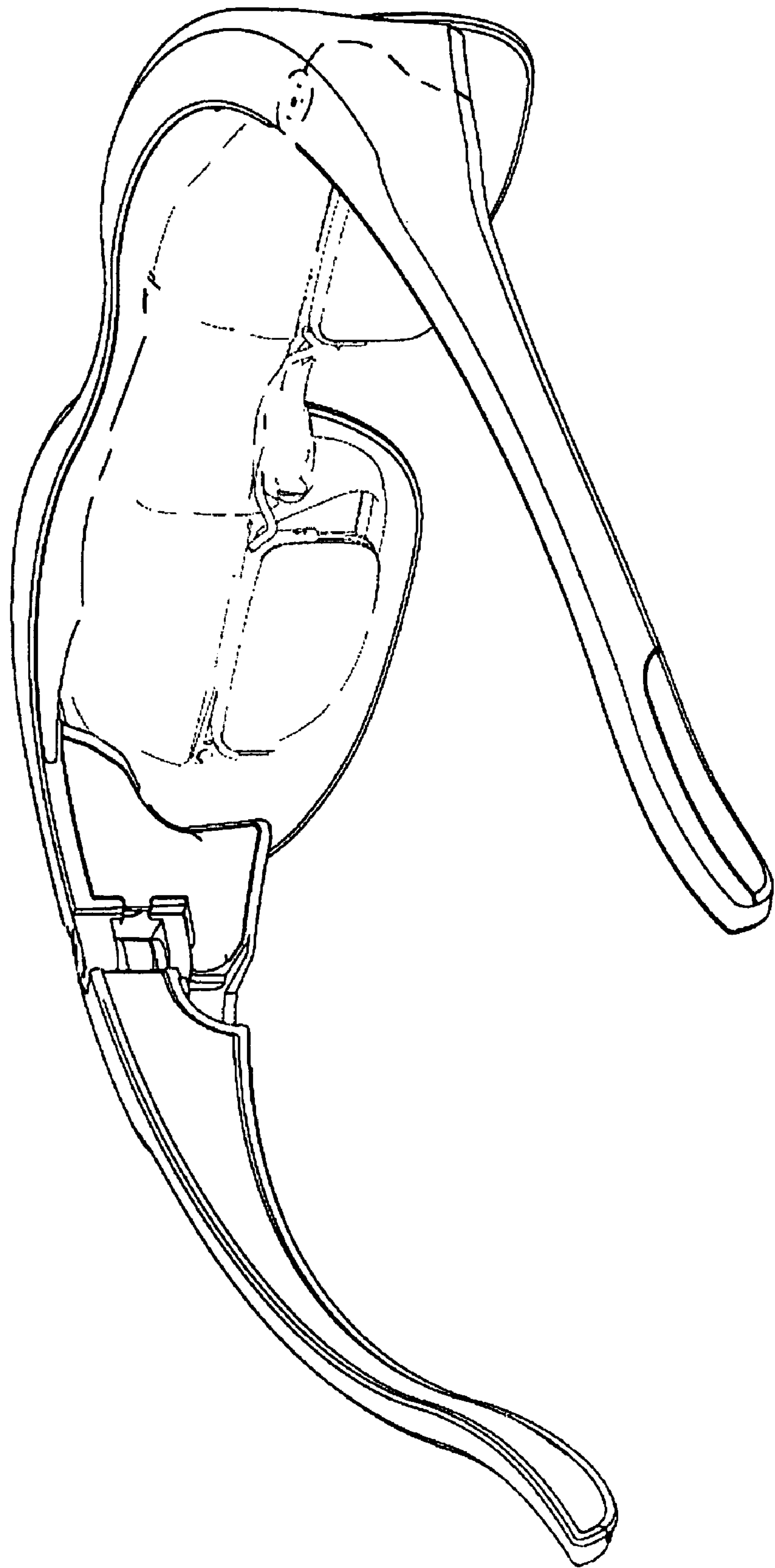
