FIG. 2 shows a front elevation view thereof;

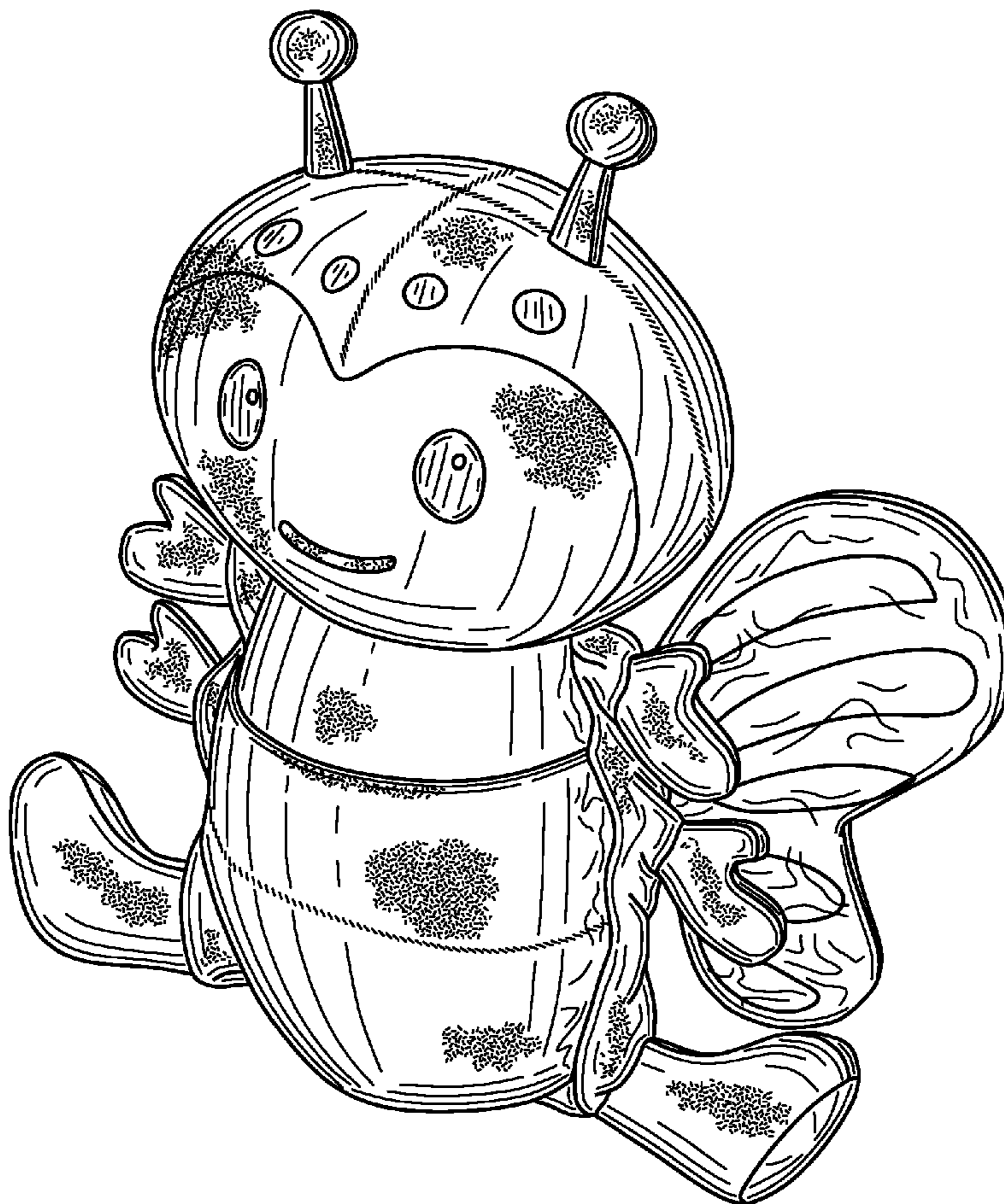
FIG. 3 shows a rear elevation view thereof;

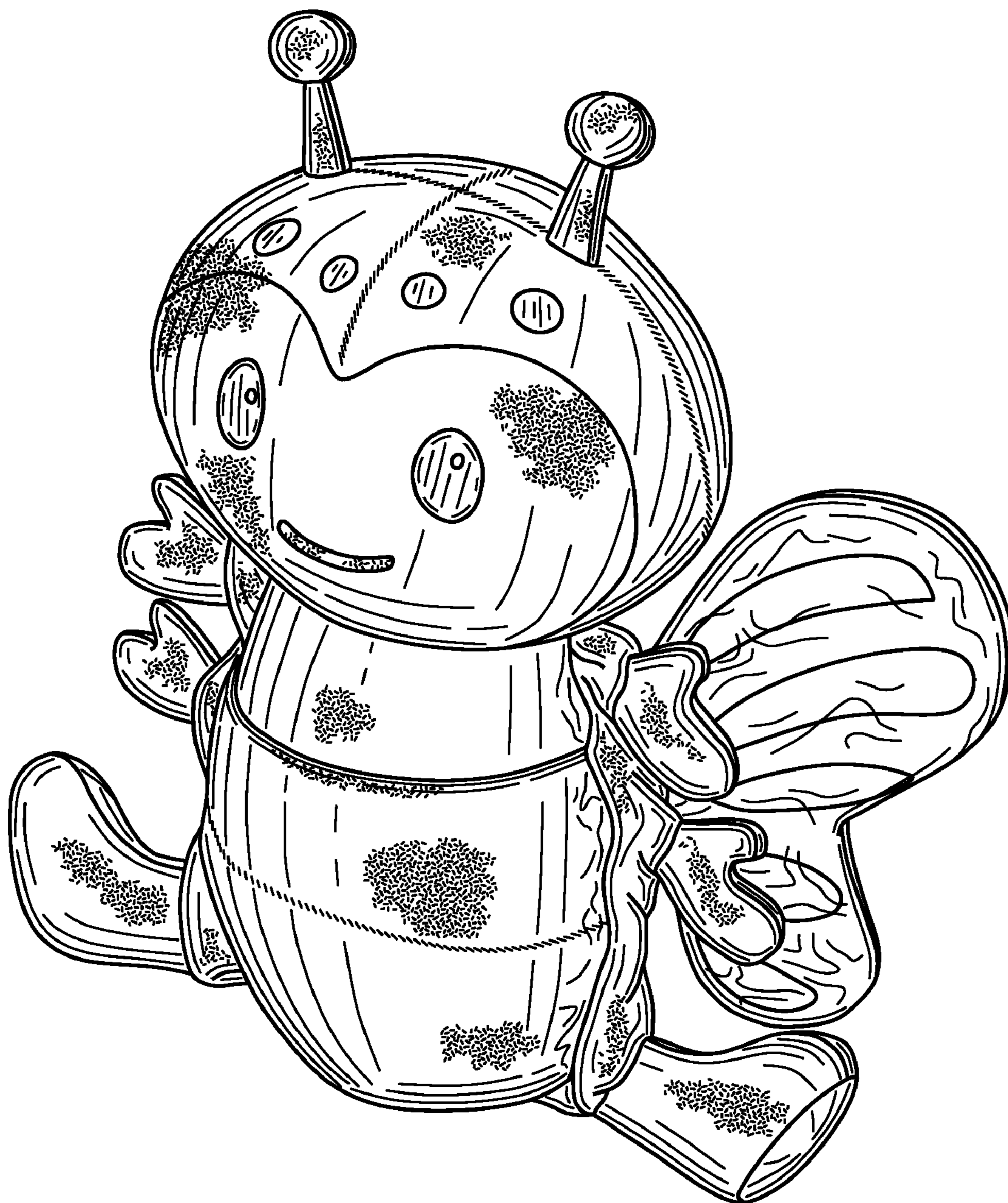

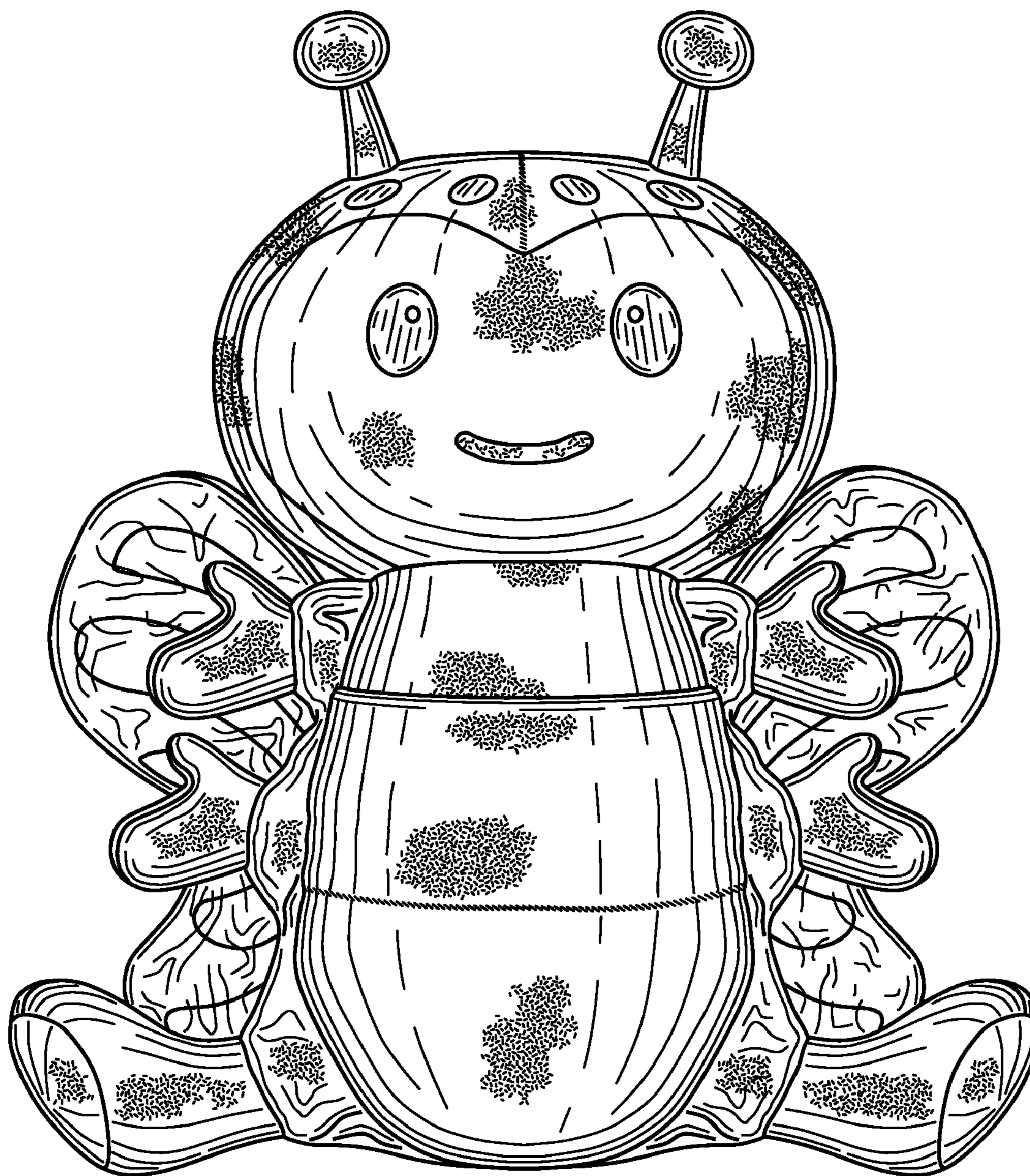

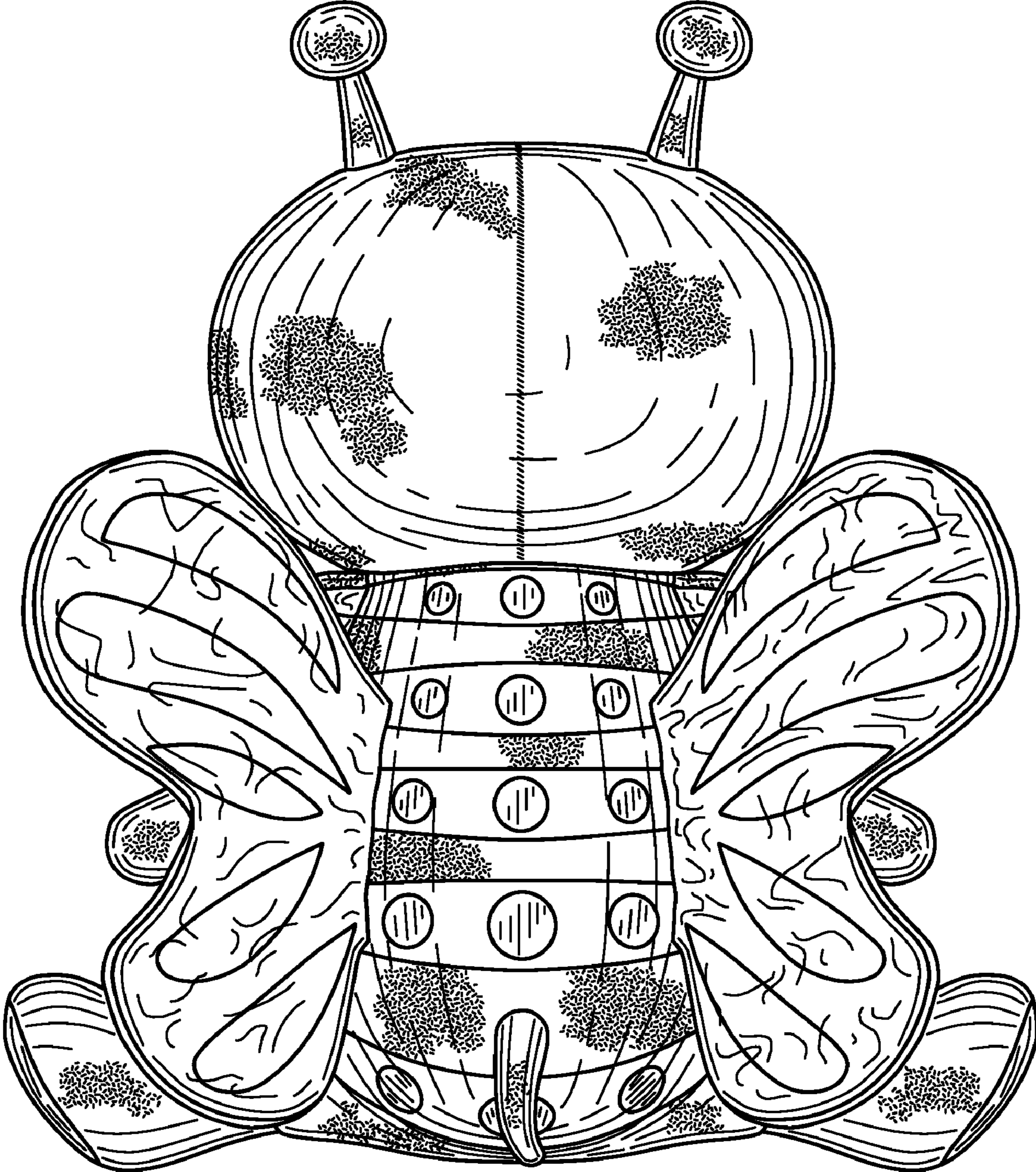

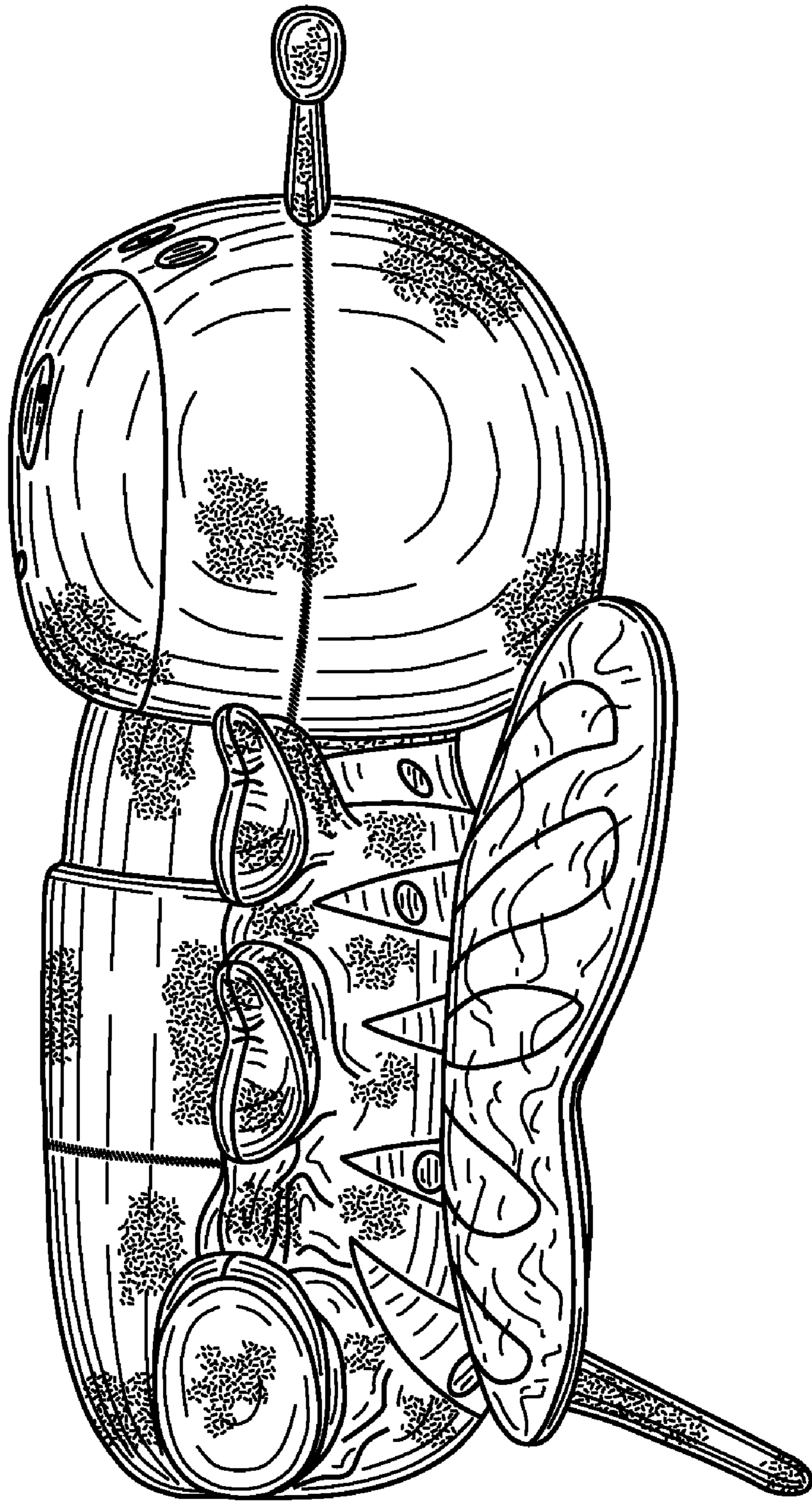

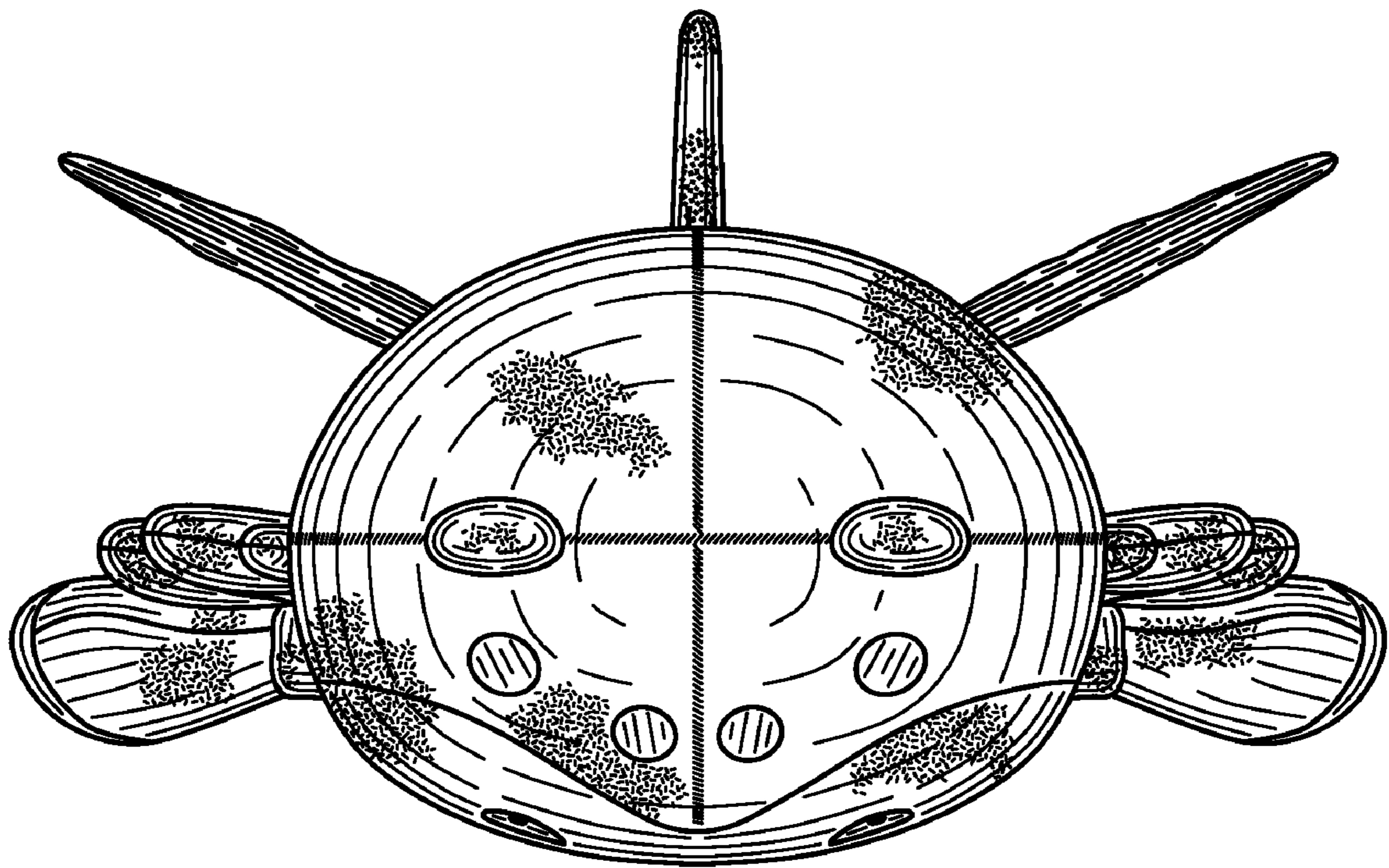

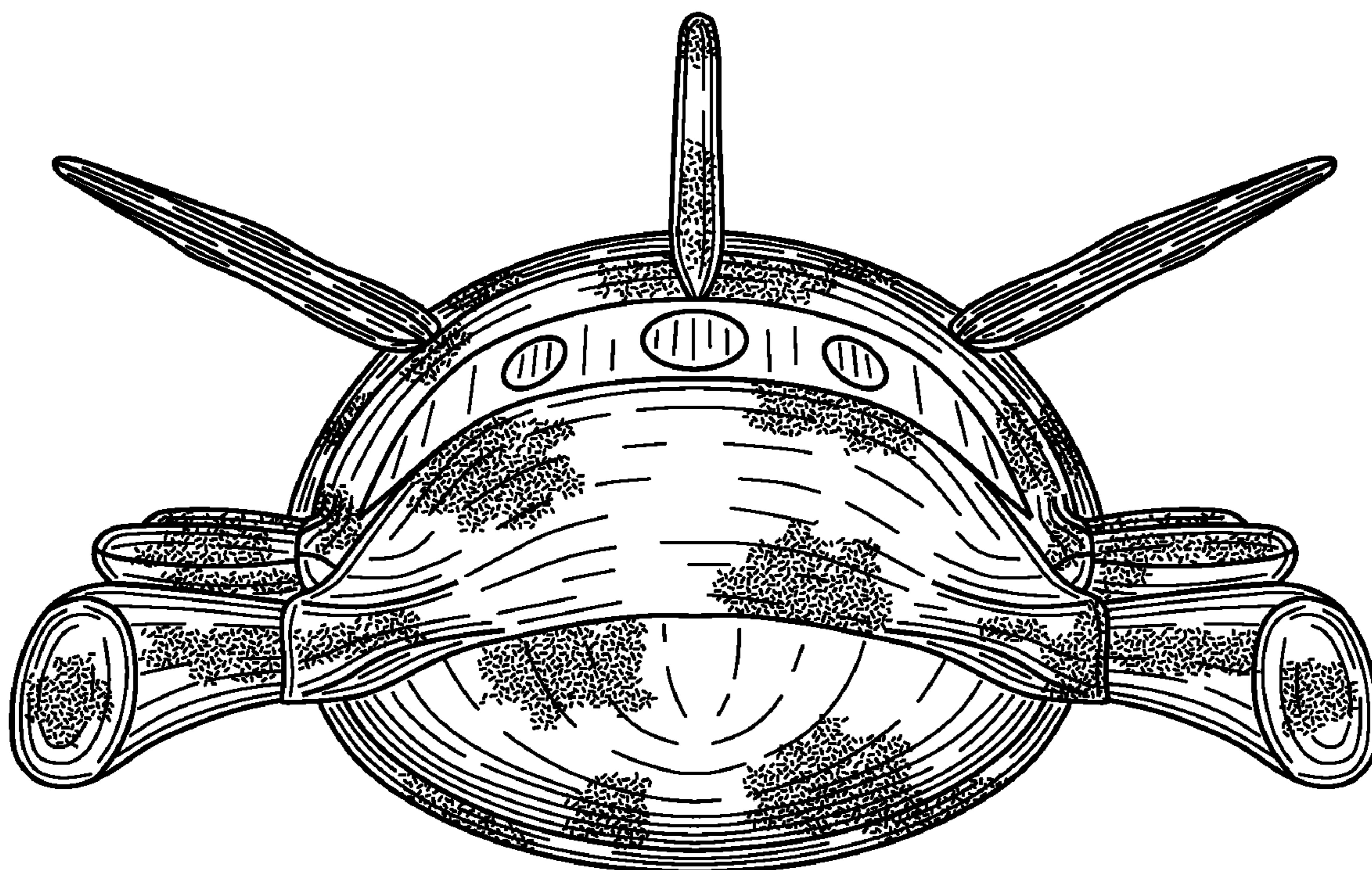
