(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an infant shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an infant shoe, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

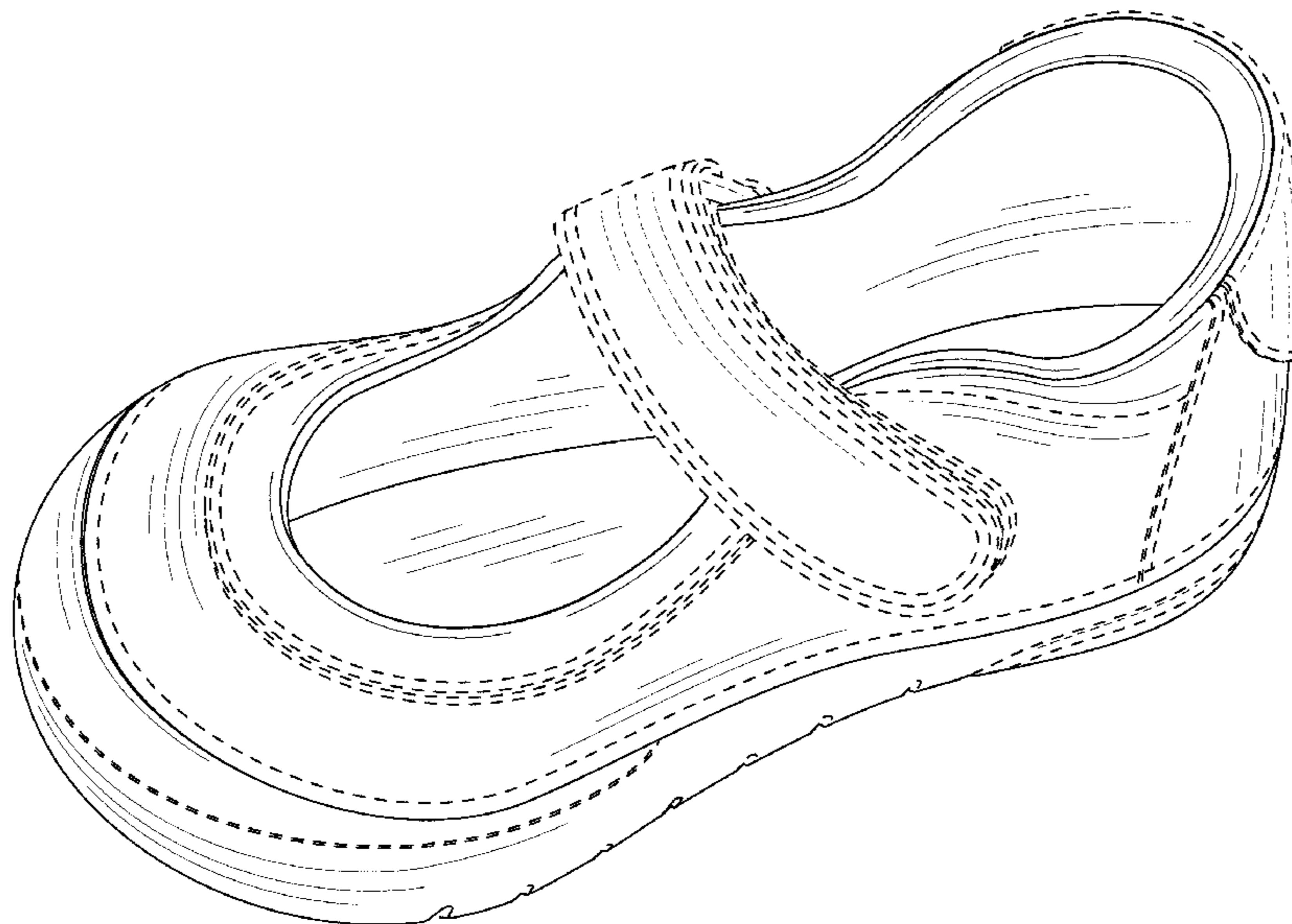
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1.

The ornamental design also includes the mirror images of drawings, i.e., the design of an infant shoe suitable for being worn on the right foot. The elements shown in dashed lines form no part of the claimed design.

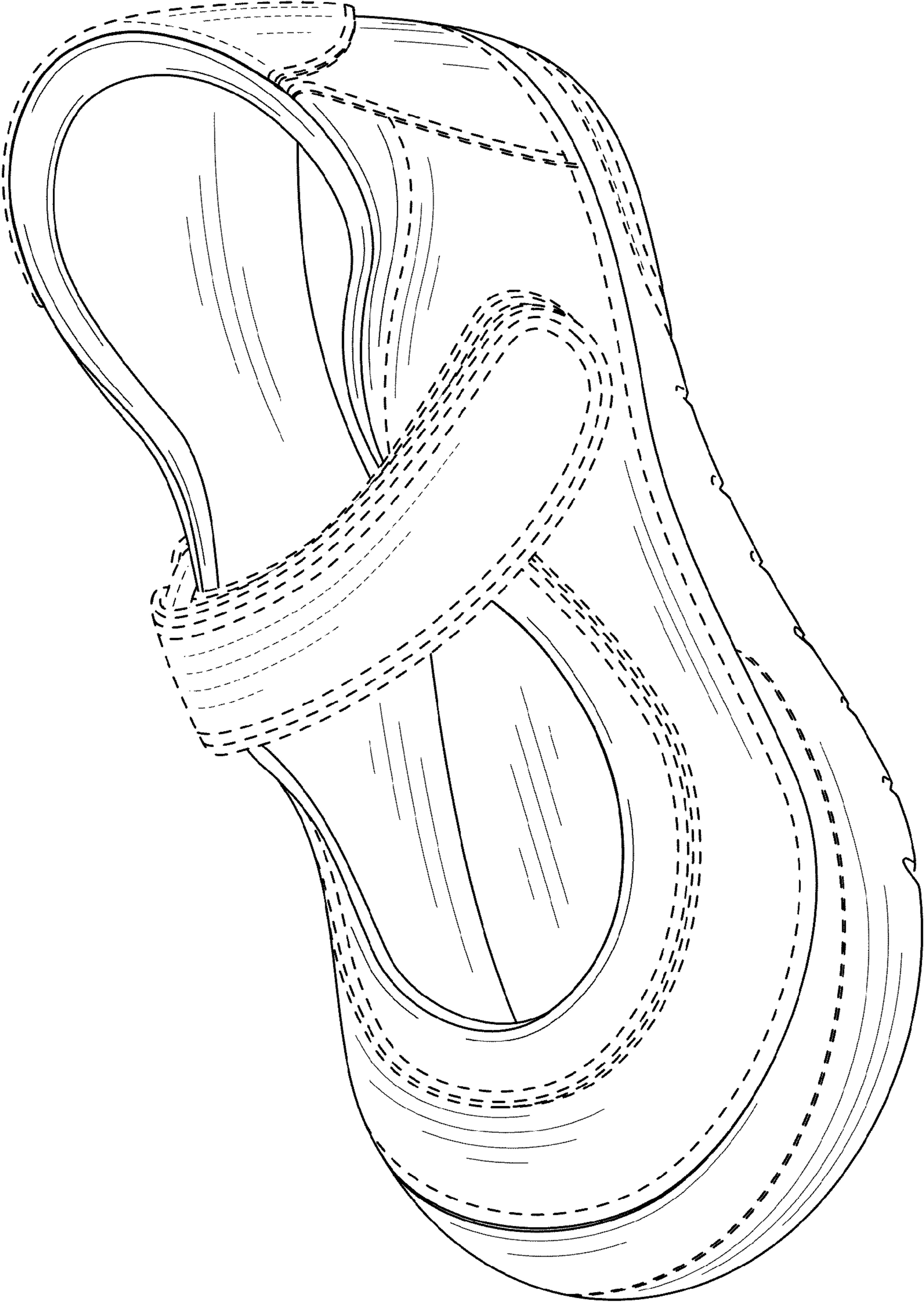

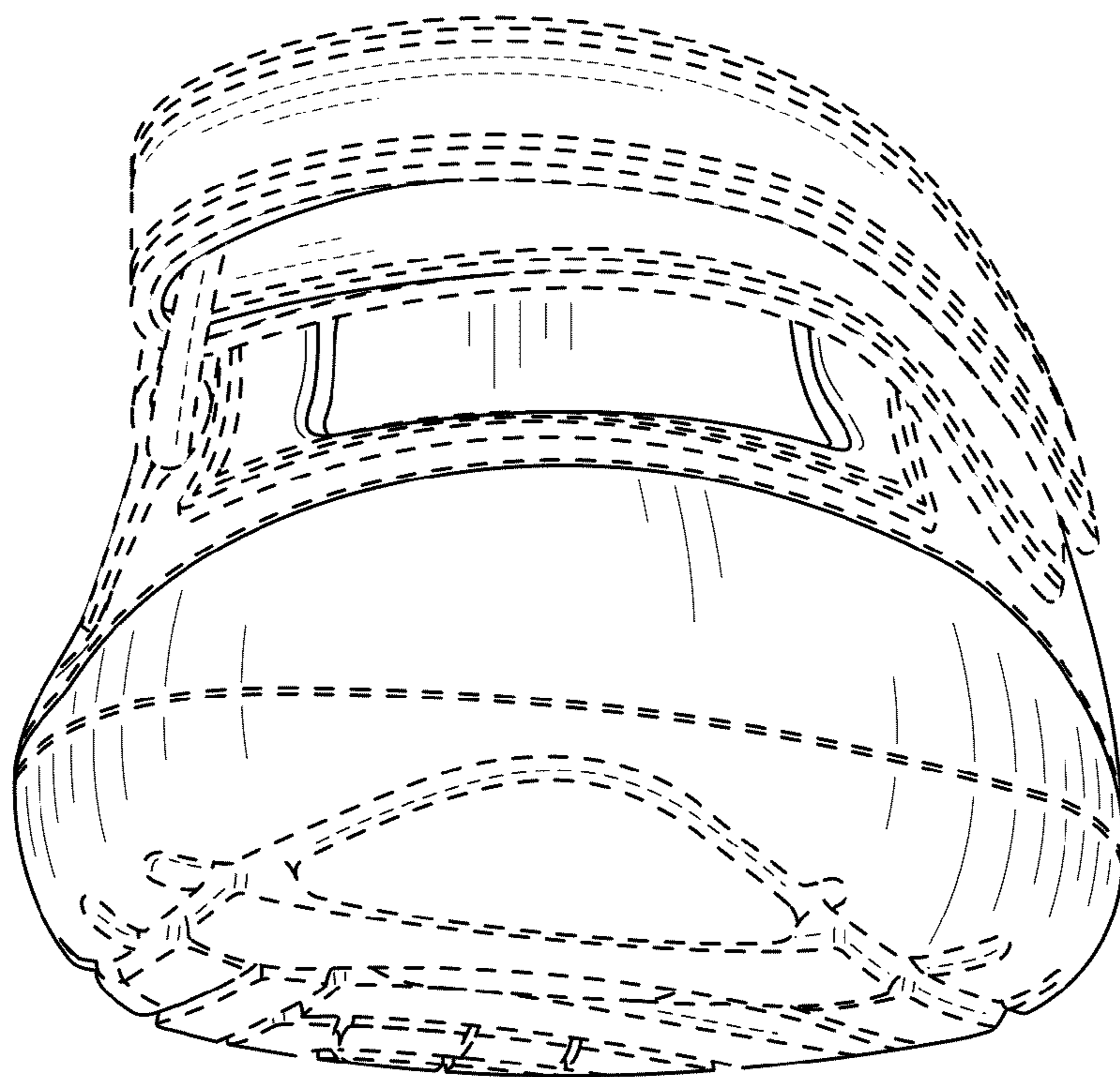

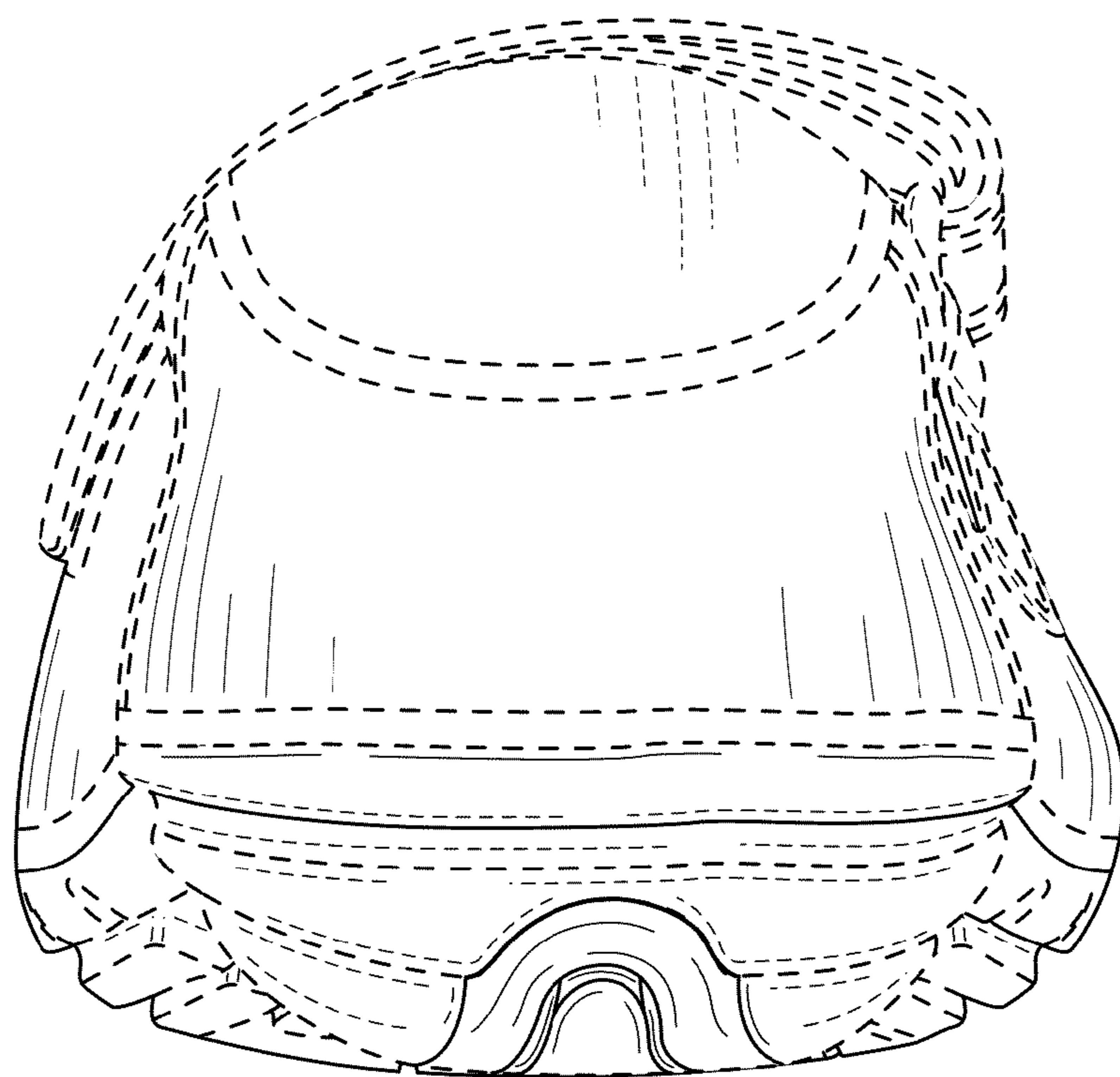

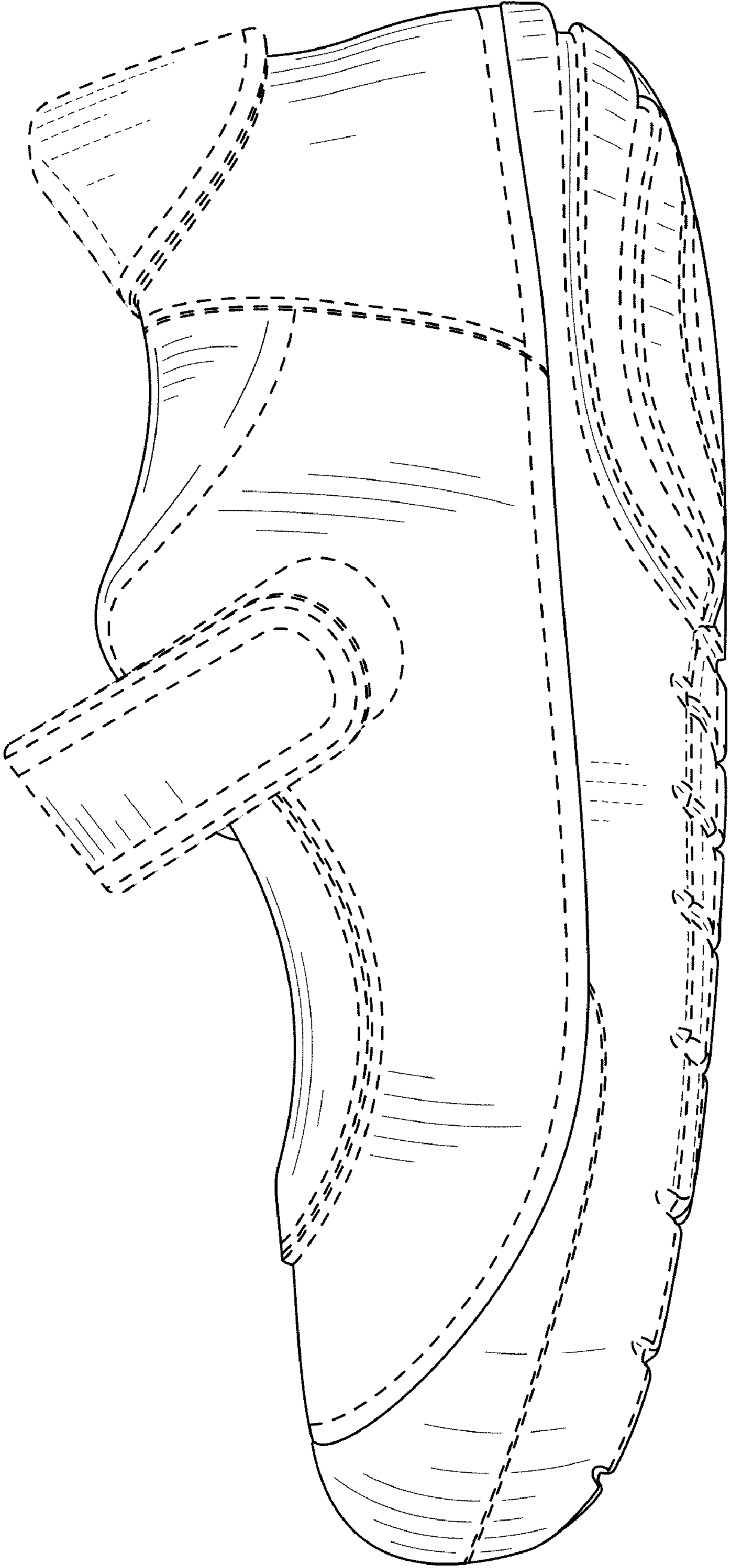

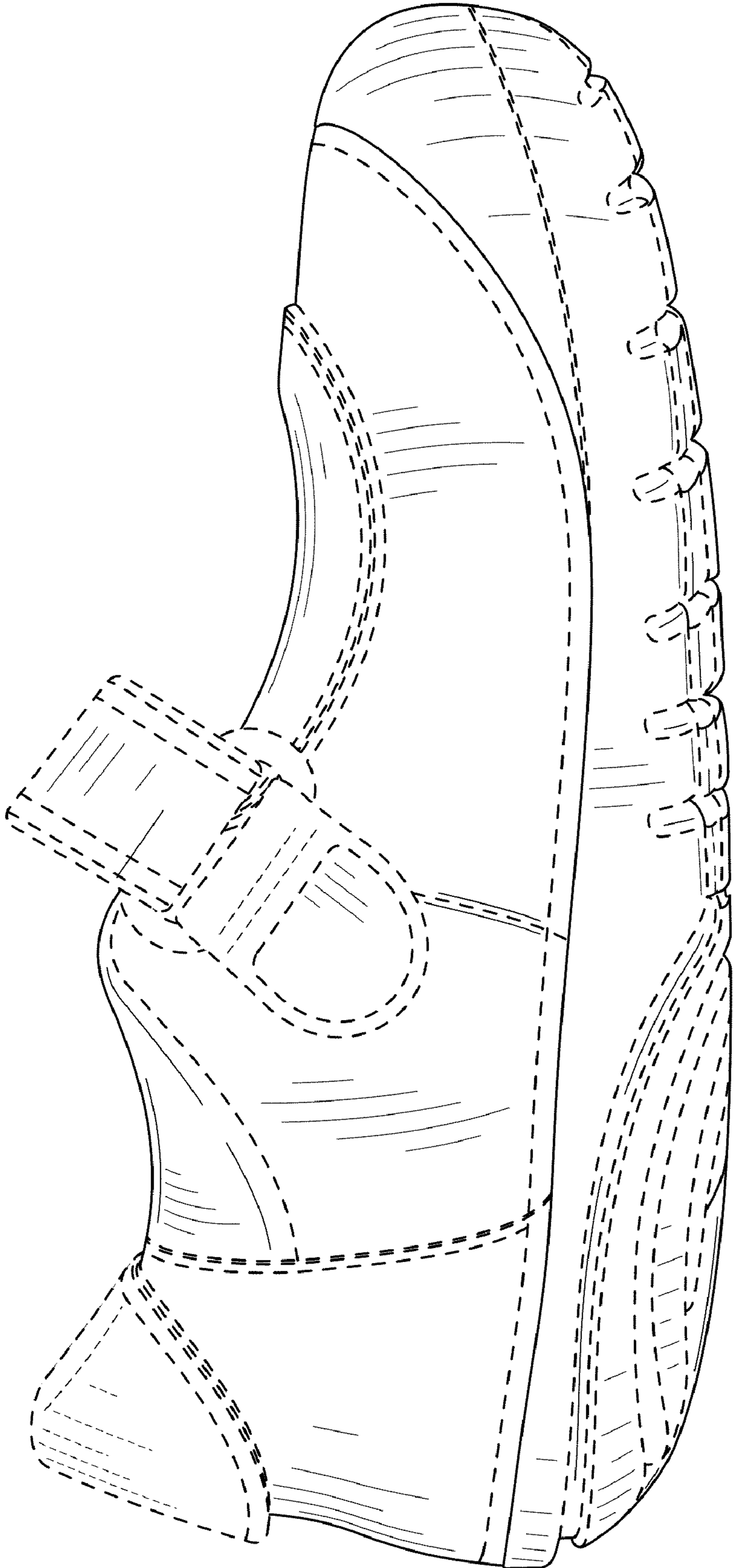

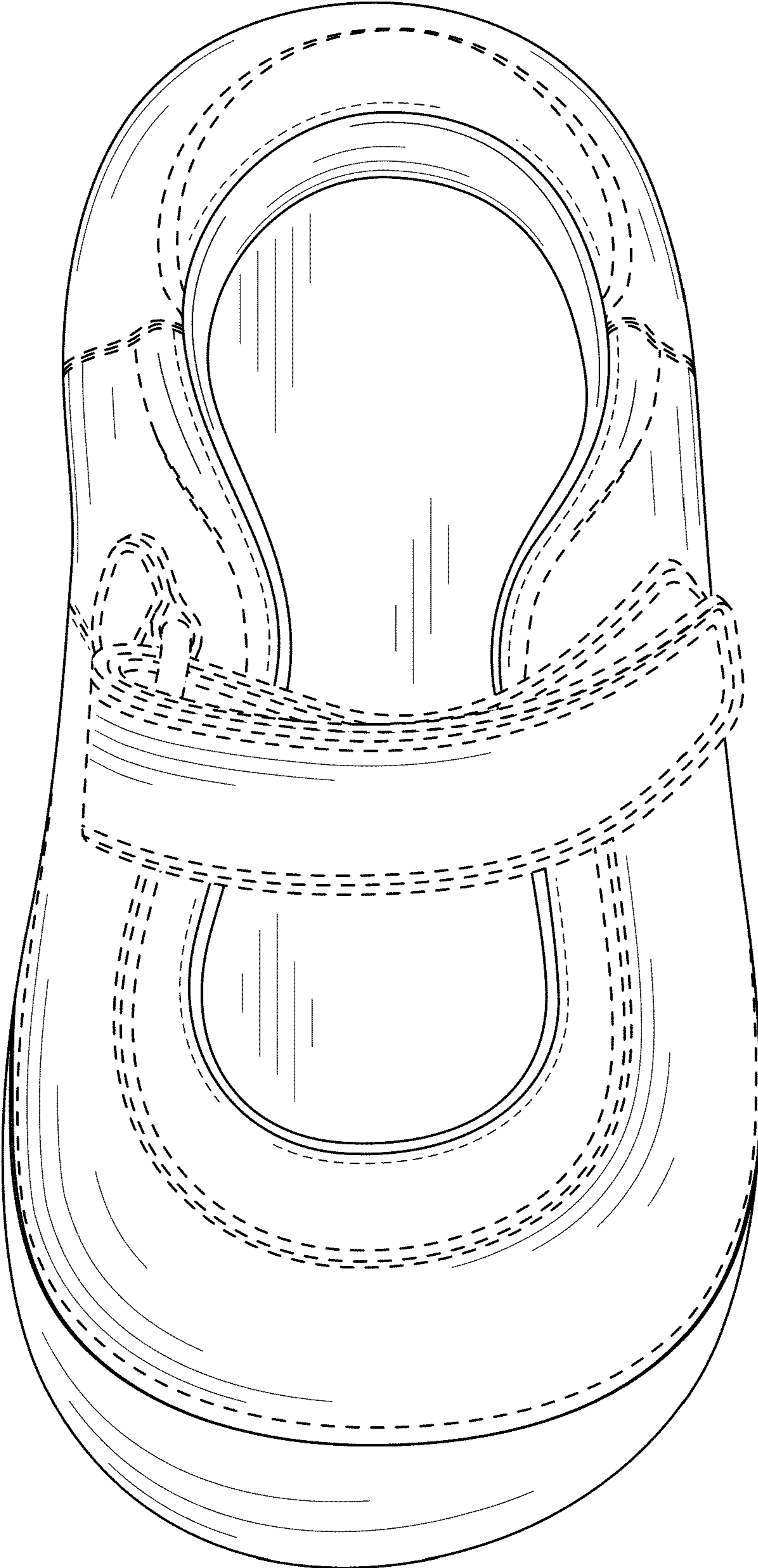

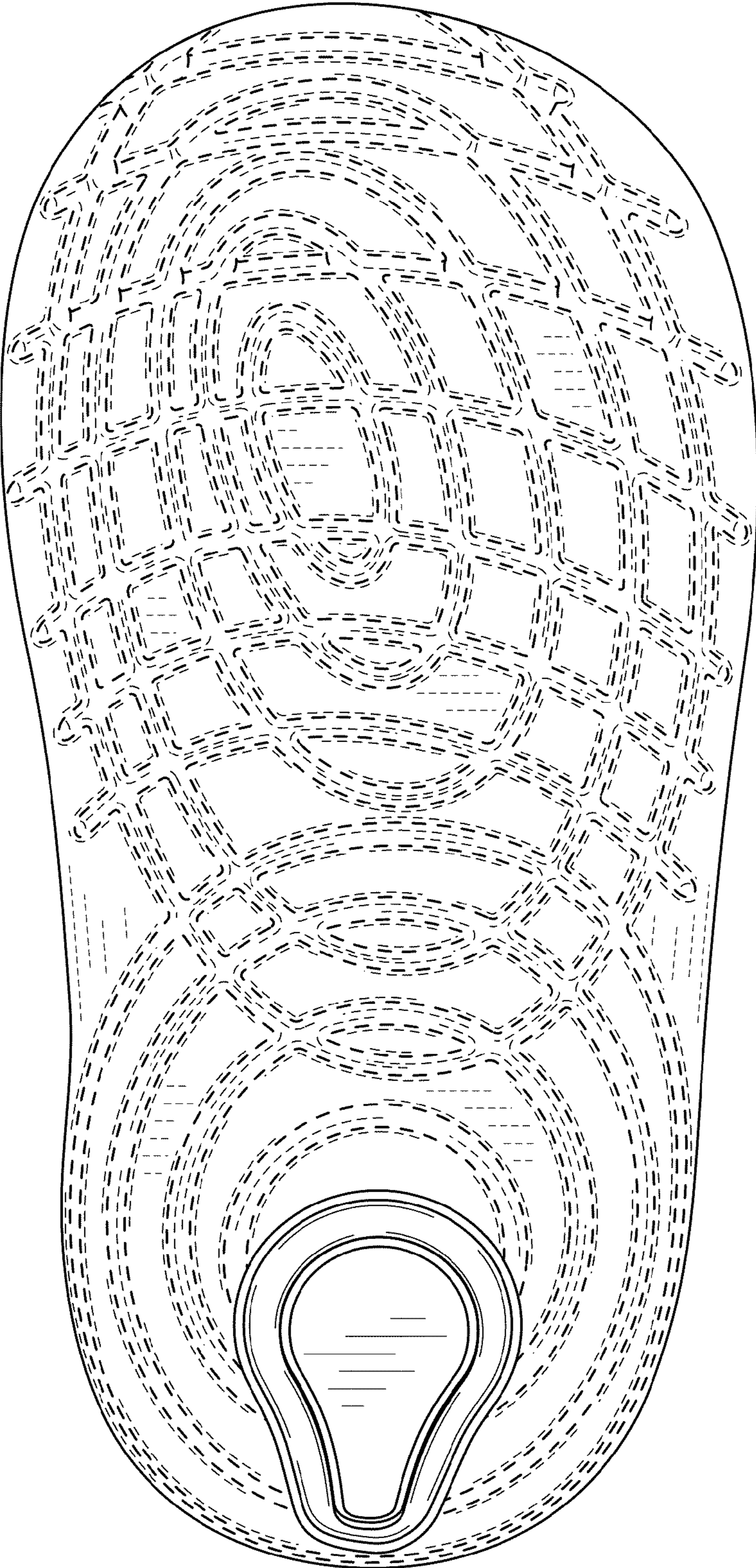
