(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a utility hook, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a utility hook showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the hook of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the hook of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a side view of the hook of FIG. 1, the other side being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 5 is a top view of the hook of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the hook of FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a utility hook showing our new design.

FIG. 8 is a front view of the hook of FIG. 7.

FIG. 9 is a rear view of the hook of FIG. 7.

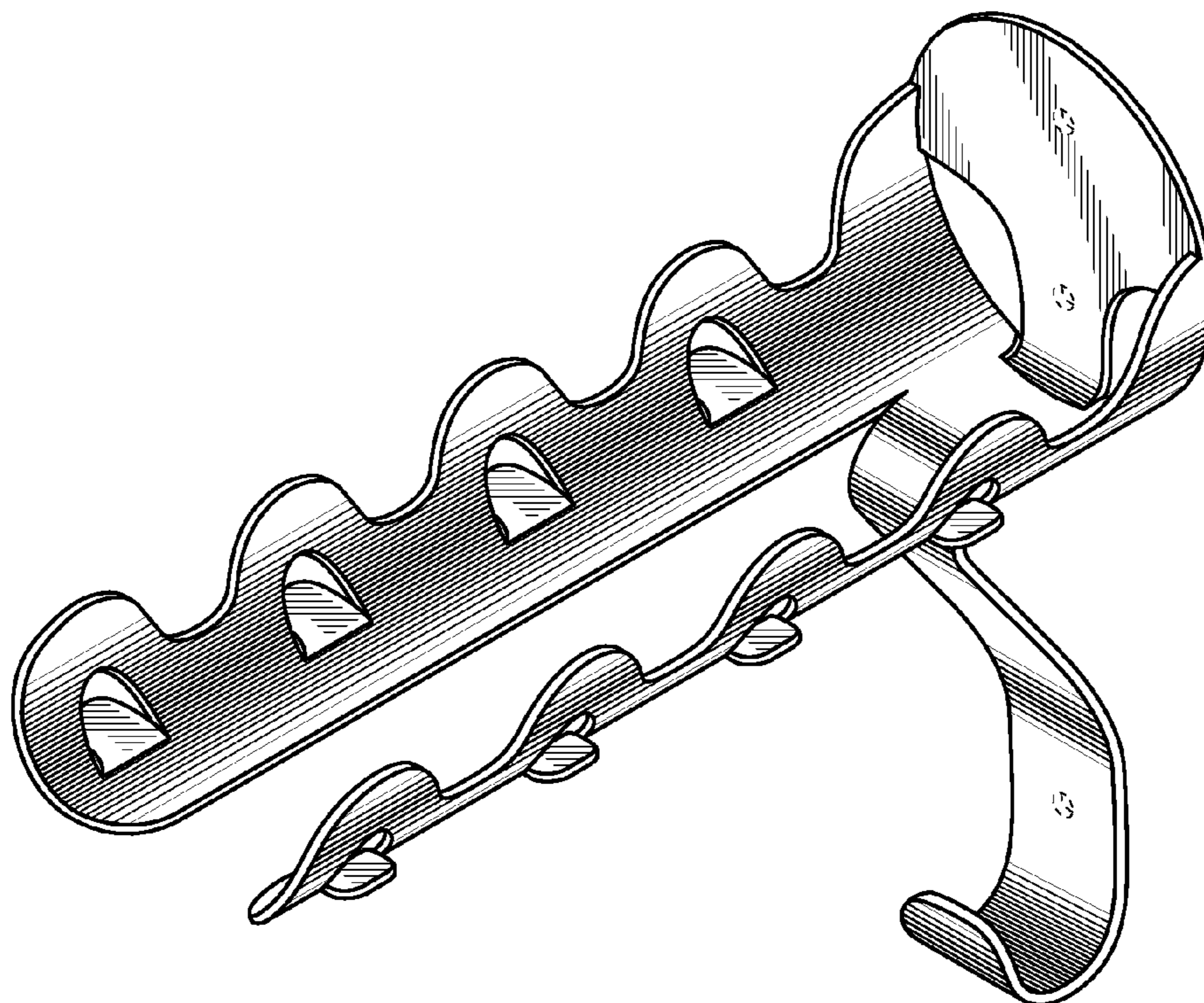
FIG. 10 is a side view of the hook of FIG. 7, the other side being a mirror image thereof.

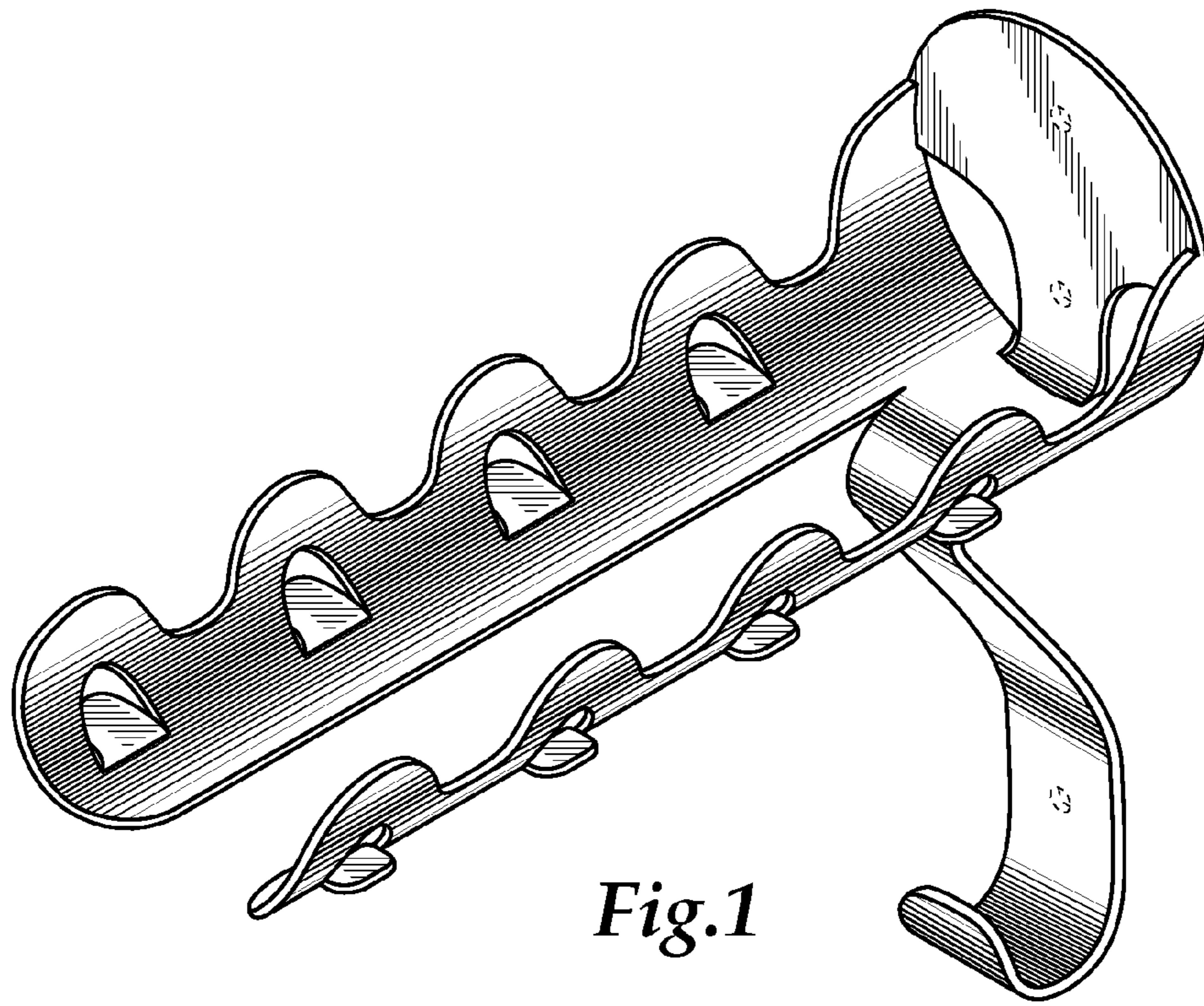

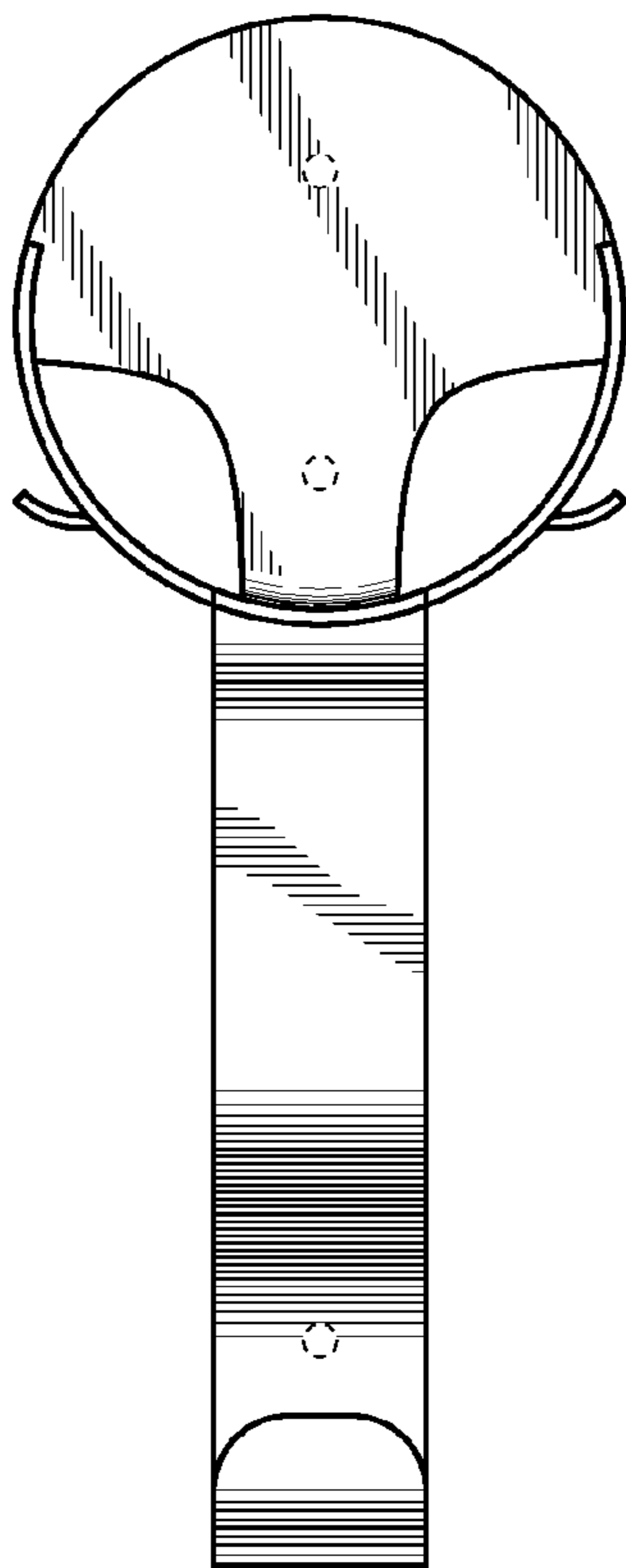

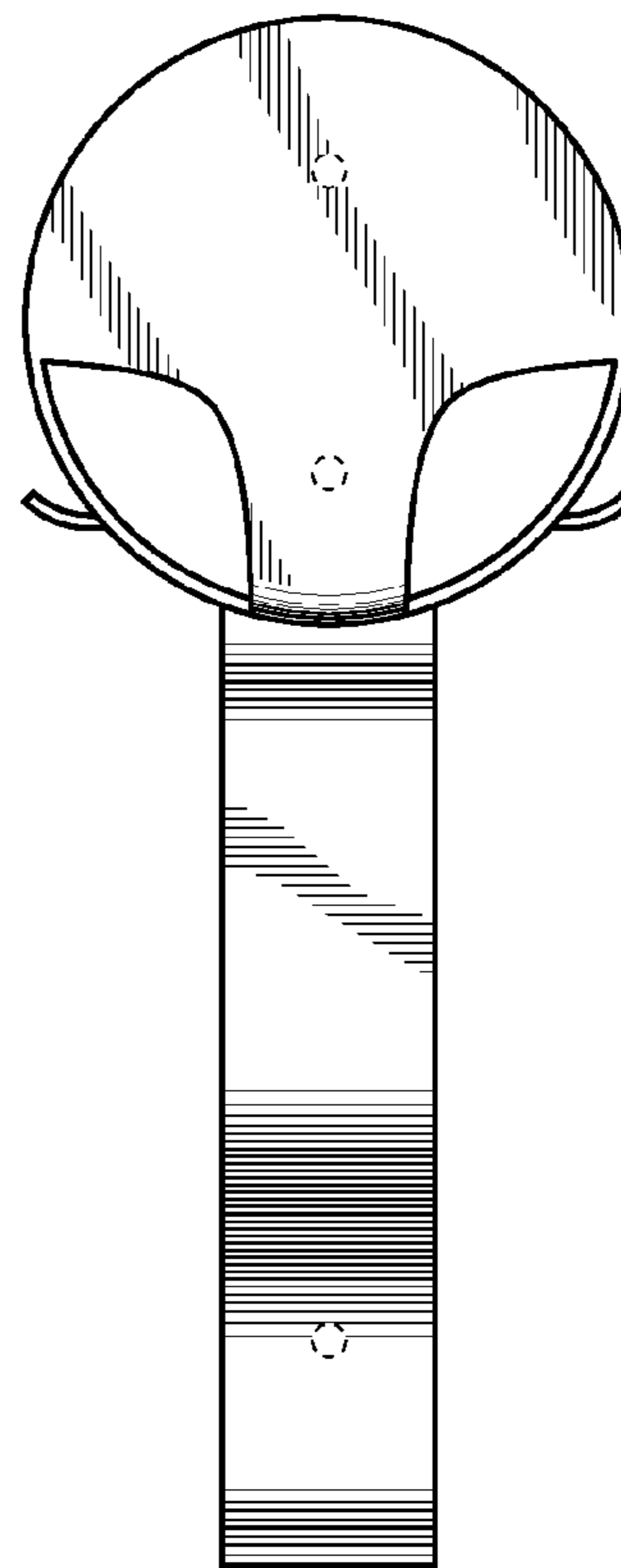

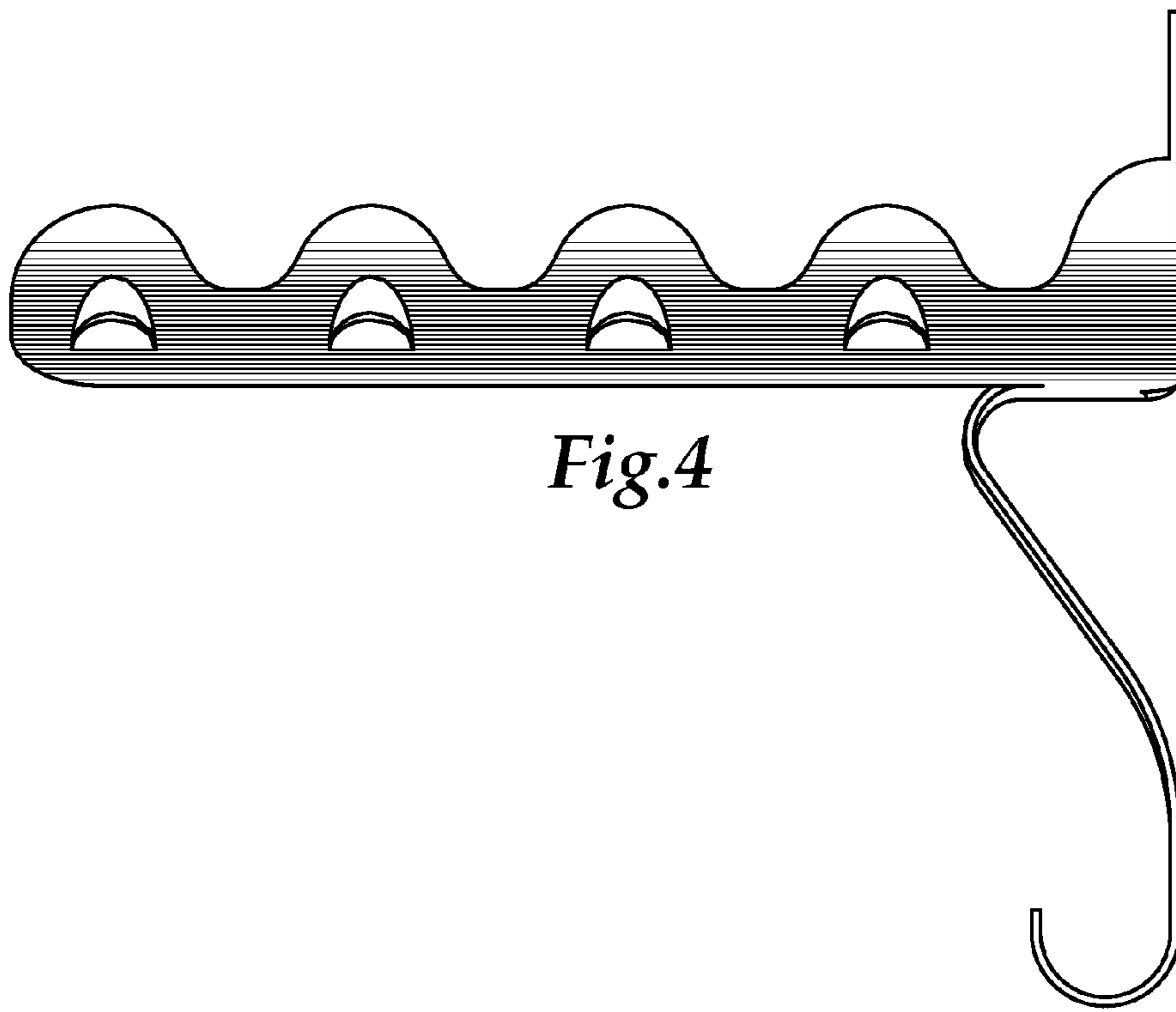

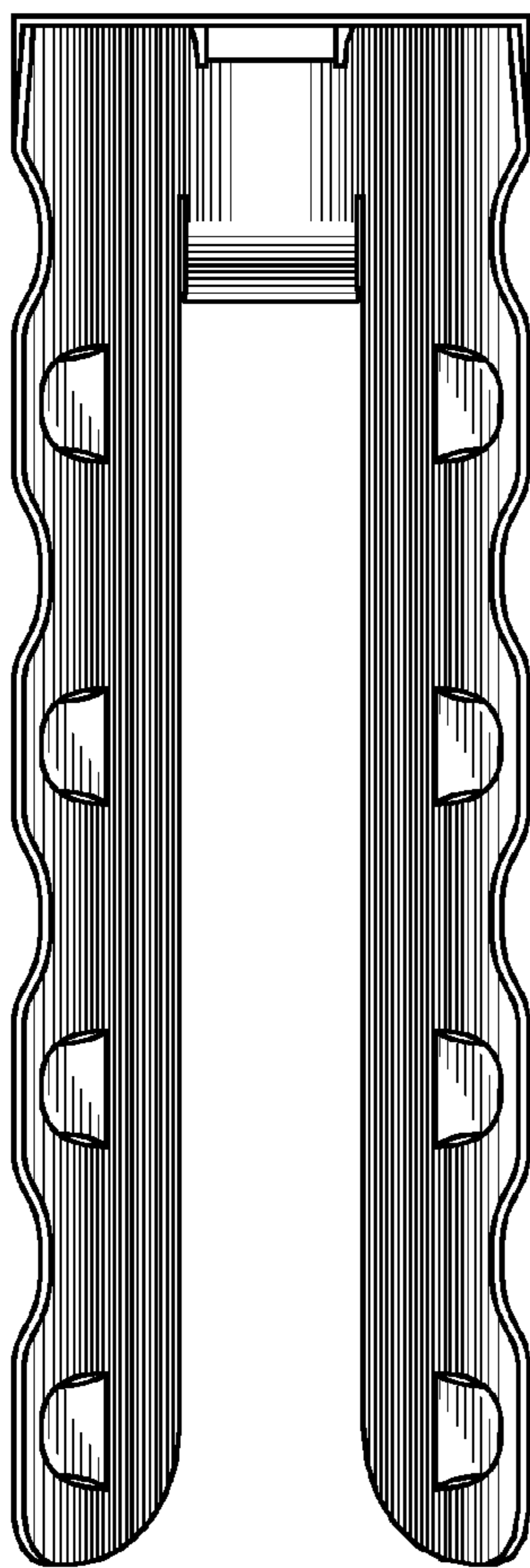

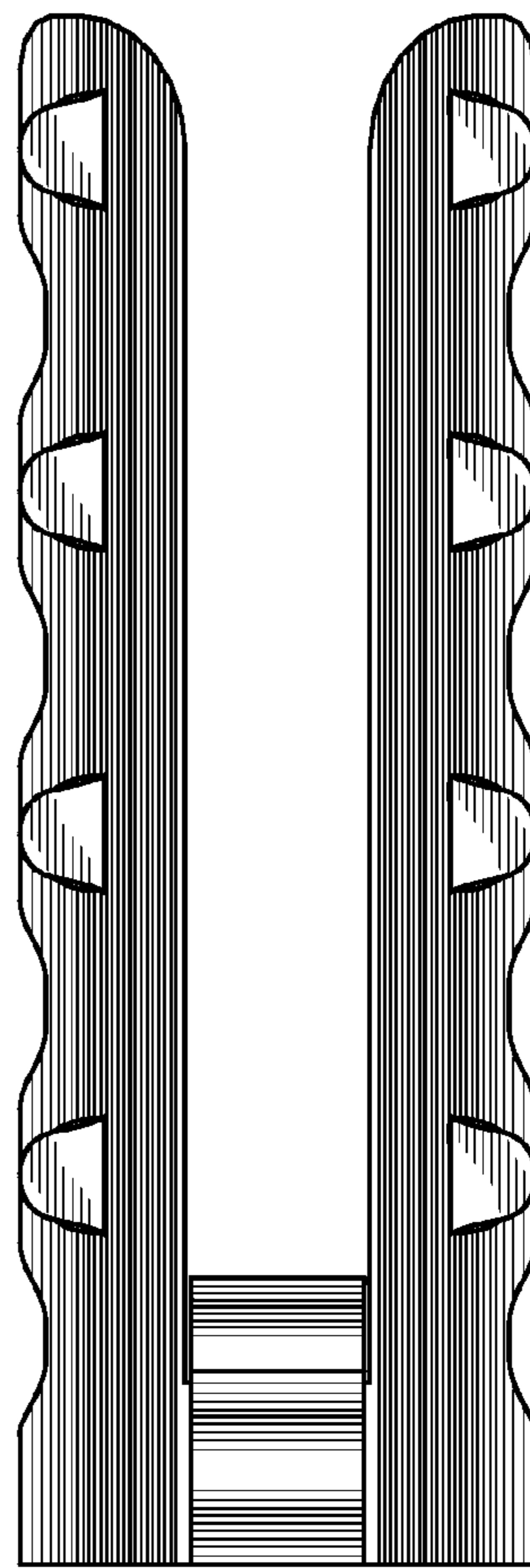

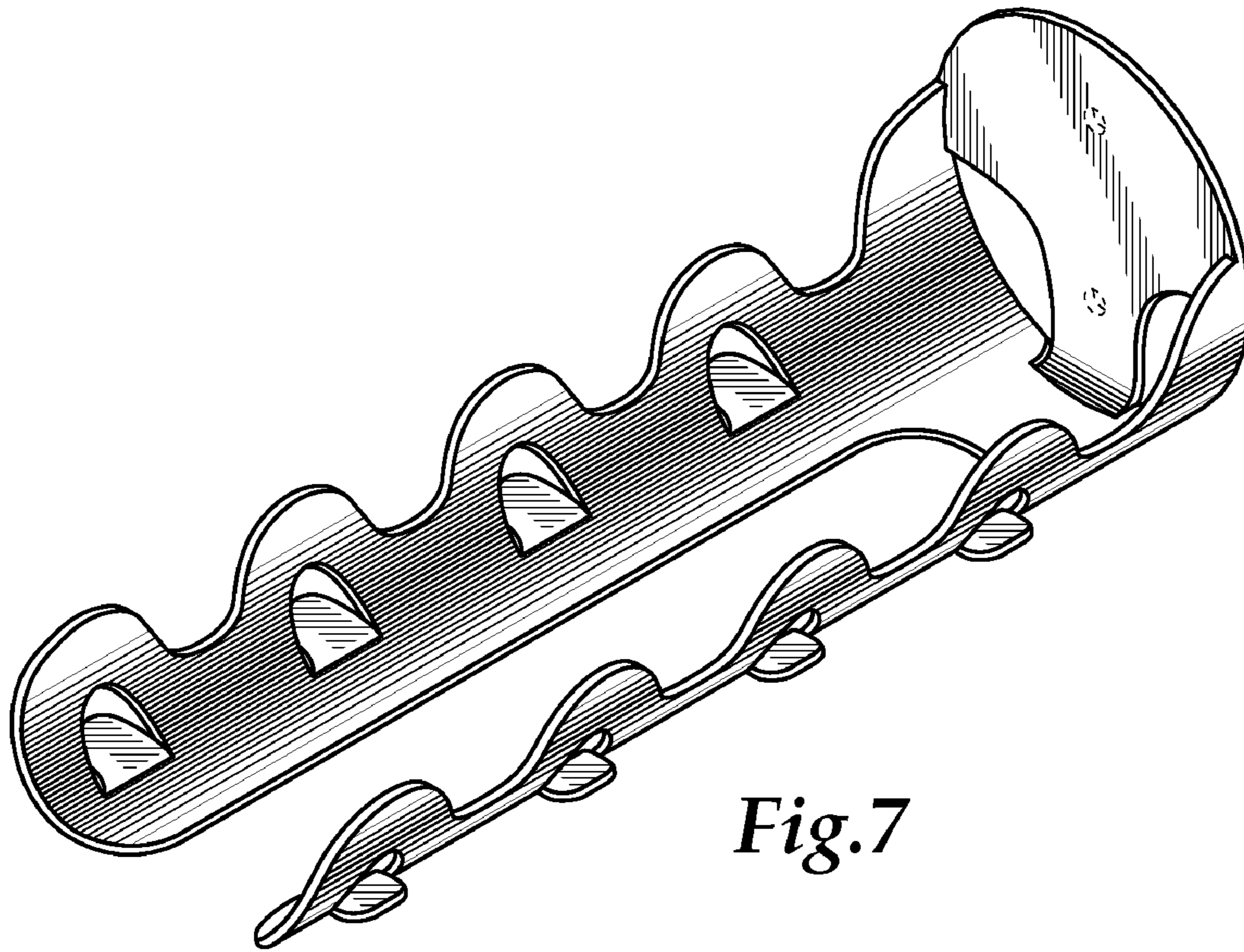

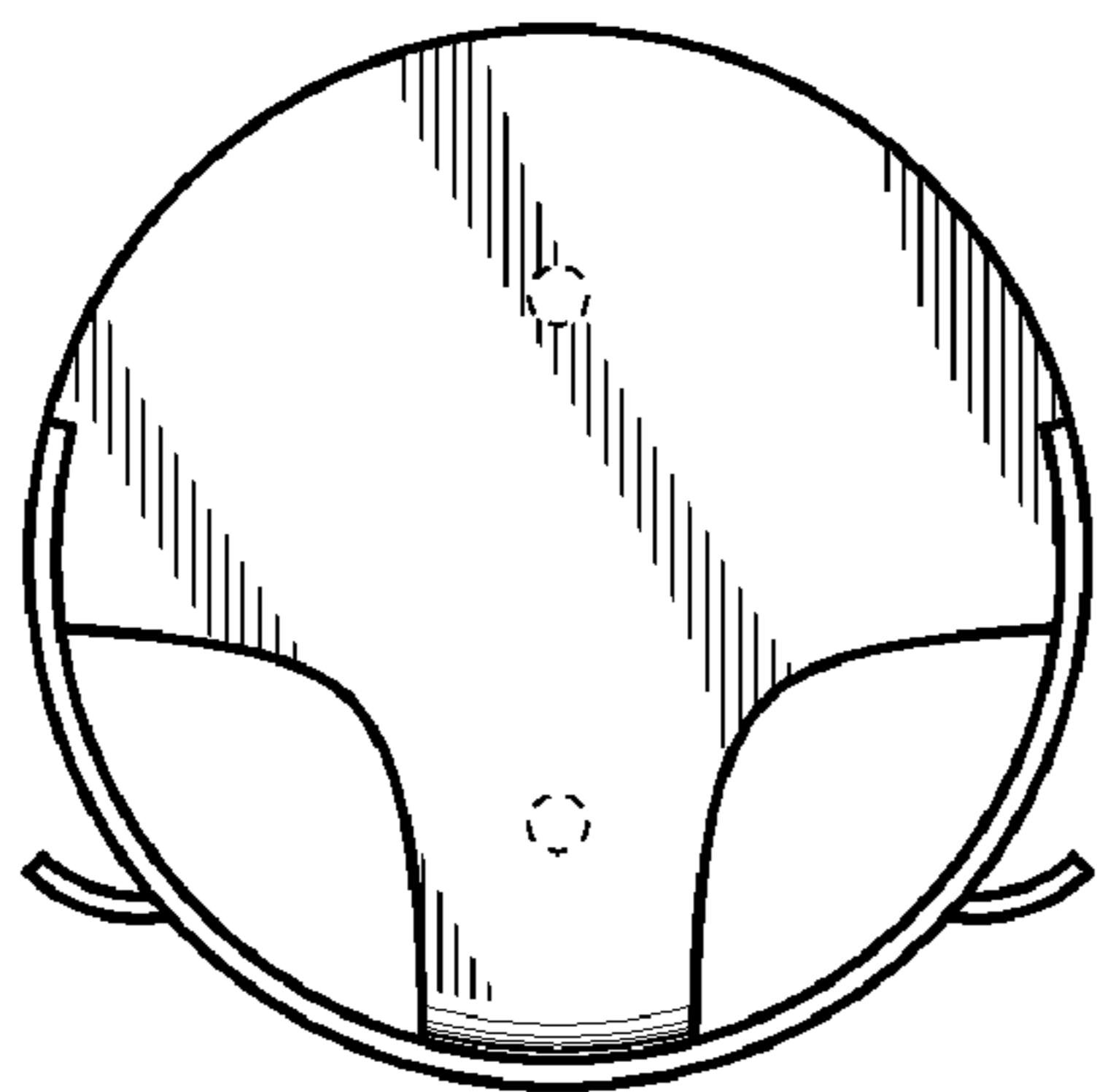

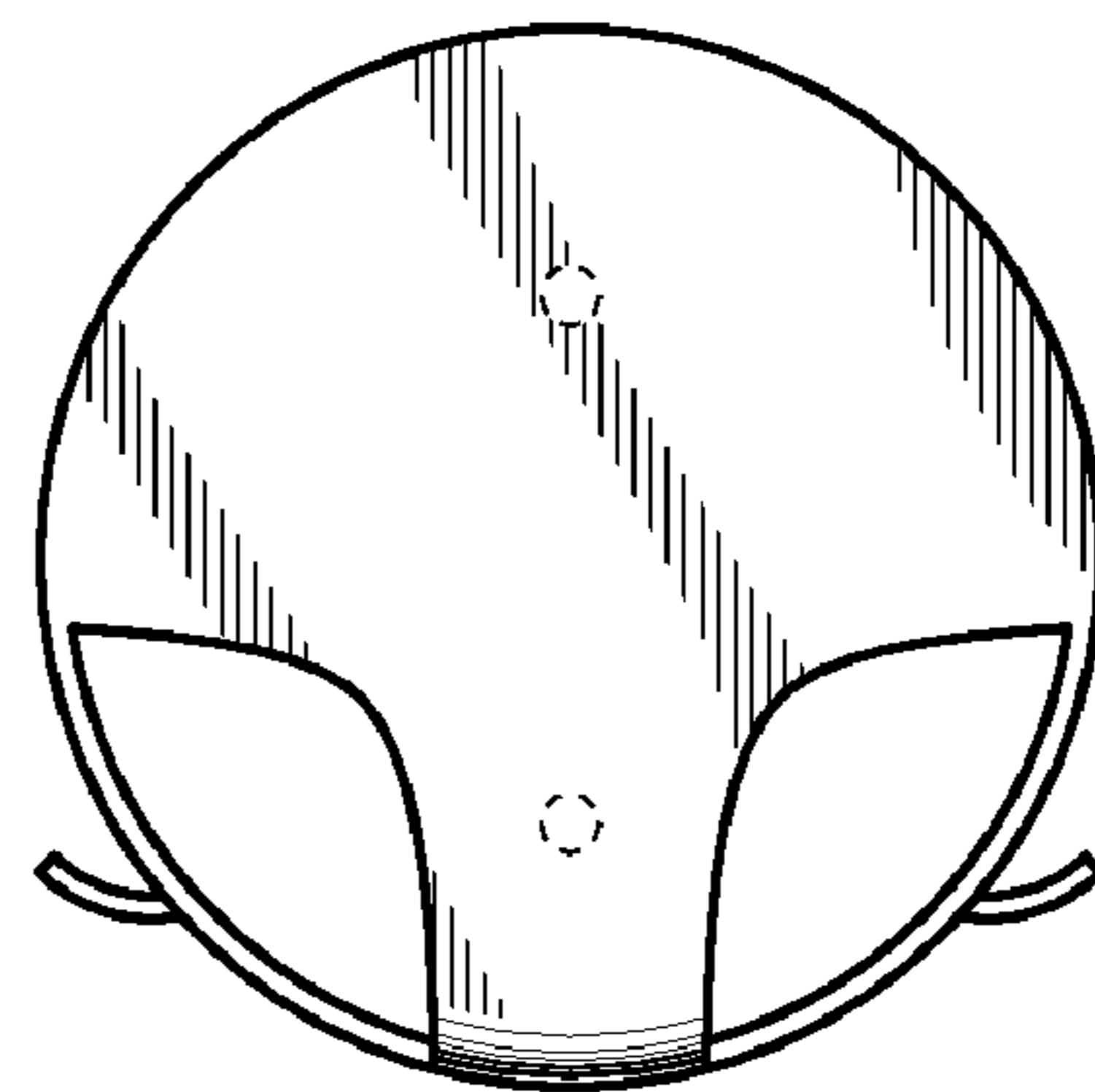

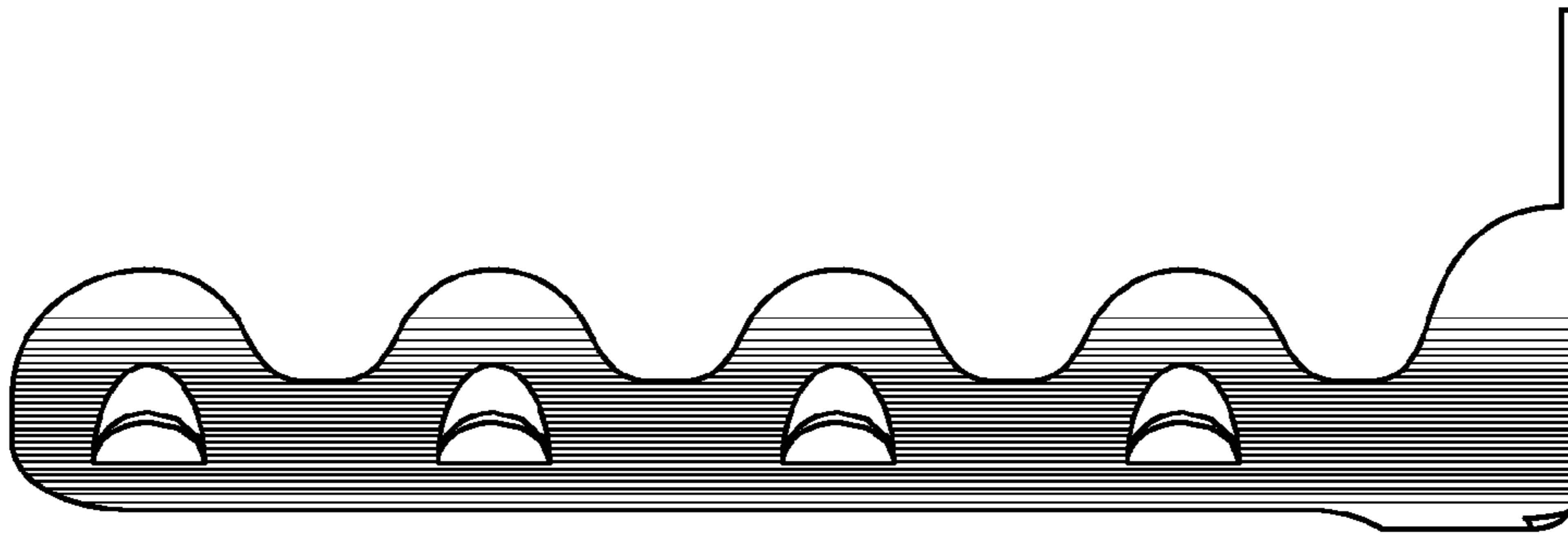

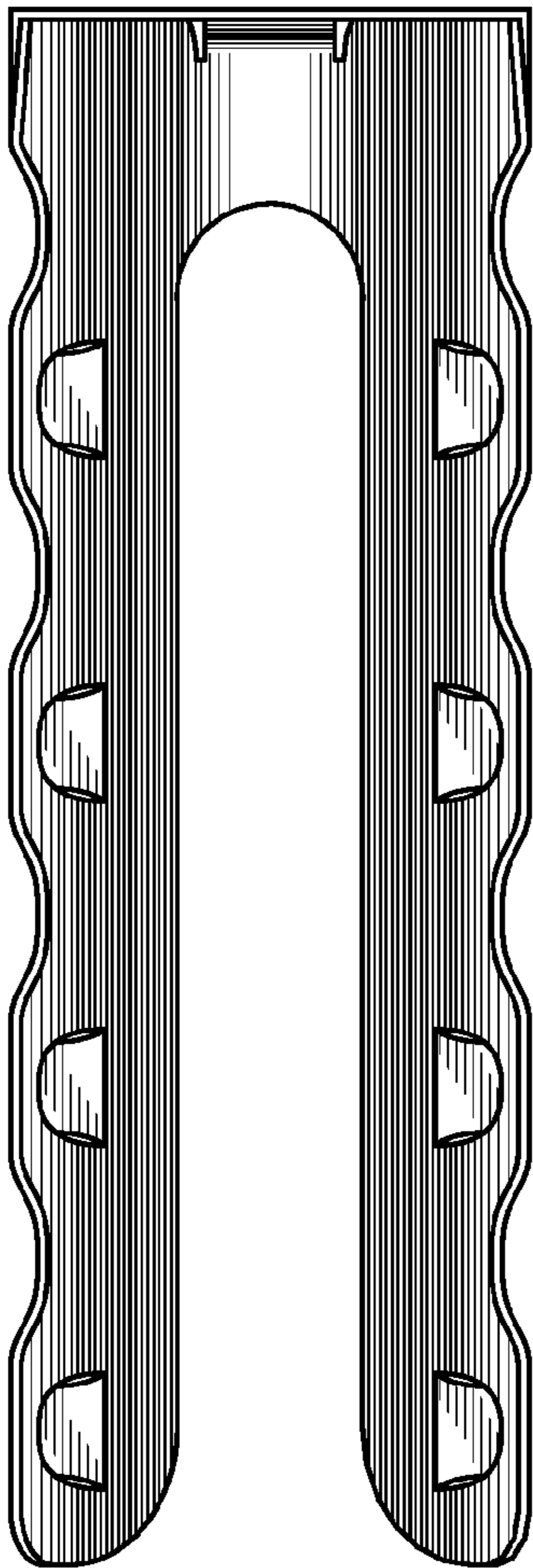

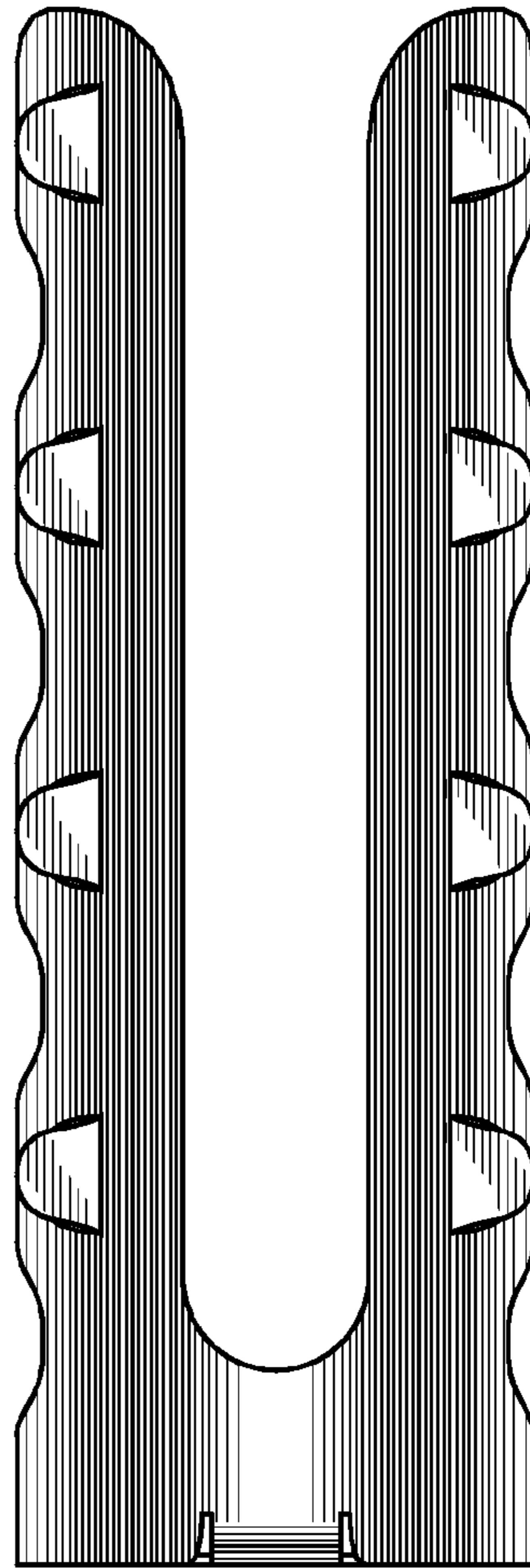
