The ornamental design for a leash holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right side perspective view of a leash holder, shown in use;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the leash holder; and,

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the leash holder.

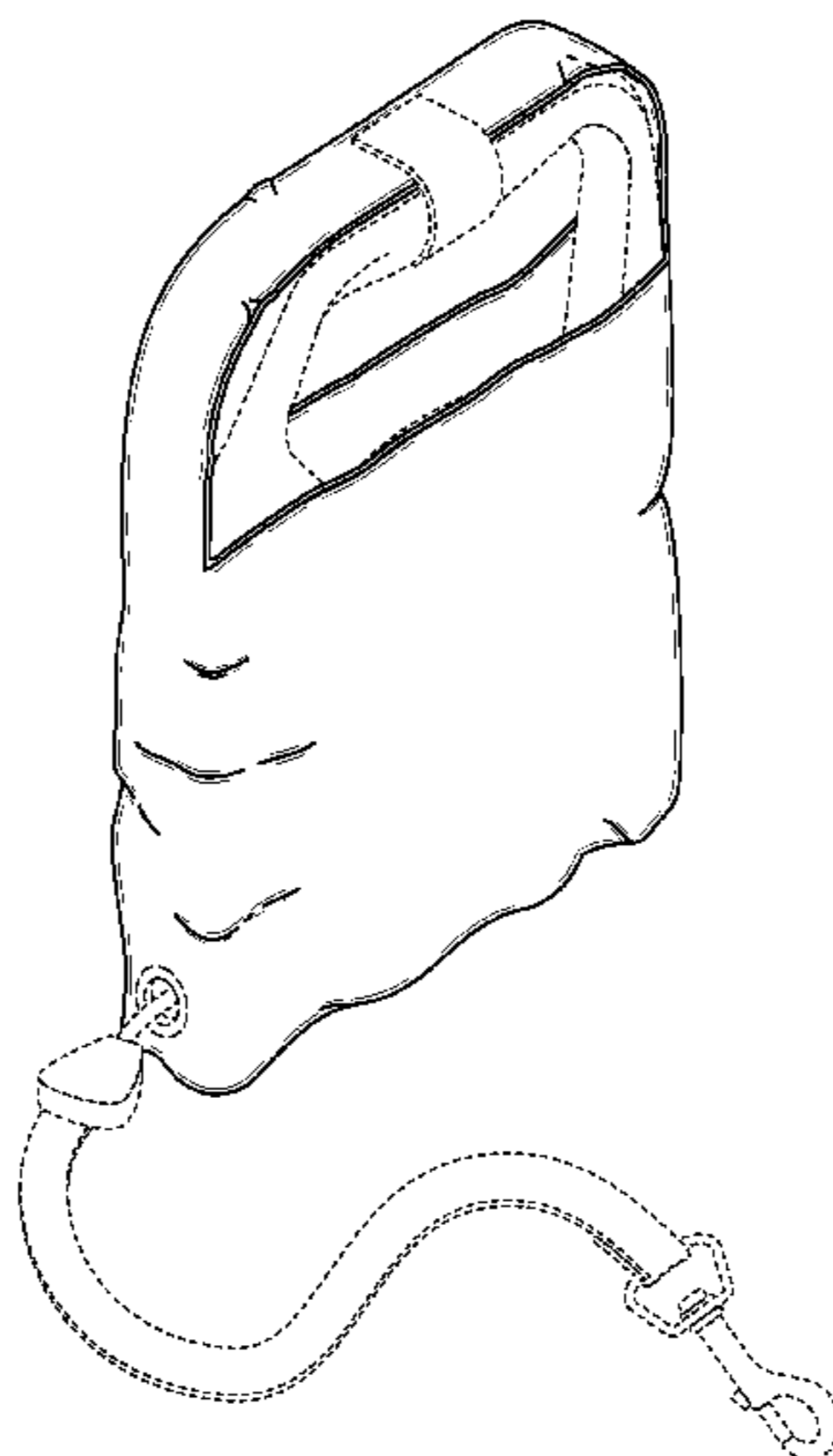
The broken lines showing an upper handle strap and a lower hole in certain of the Figures are for illustrative purposes only and does not form part of the claimed design.

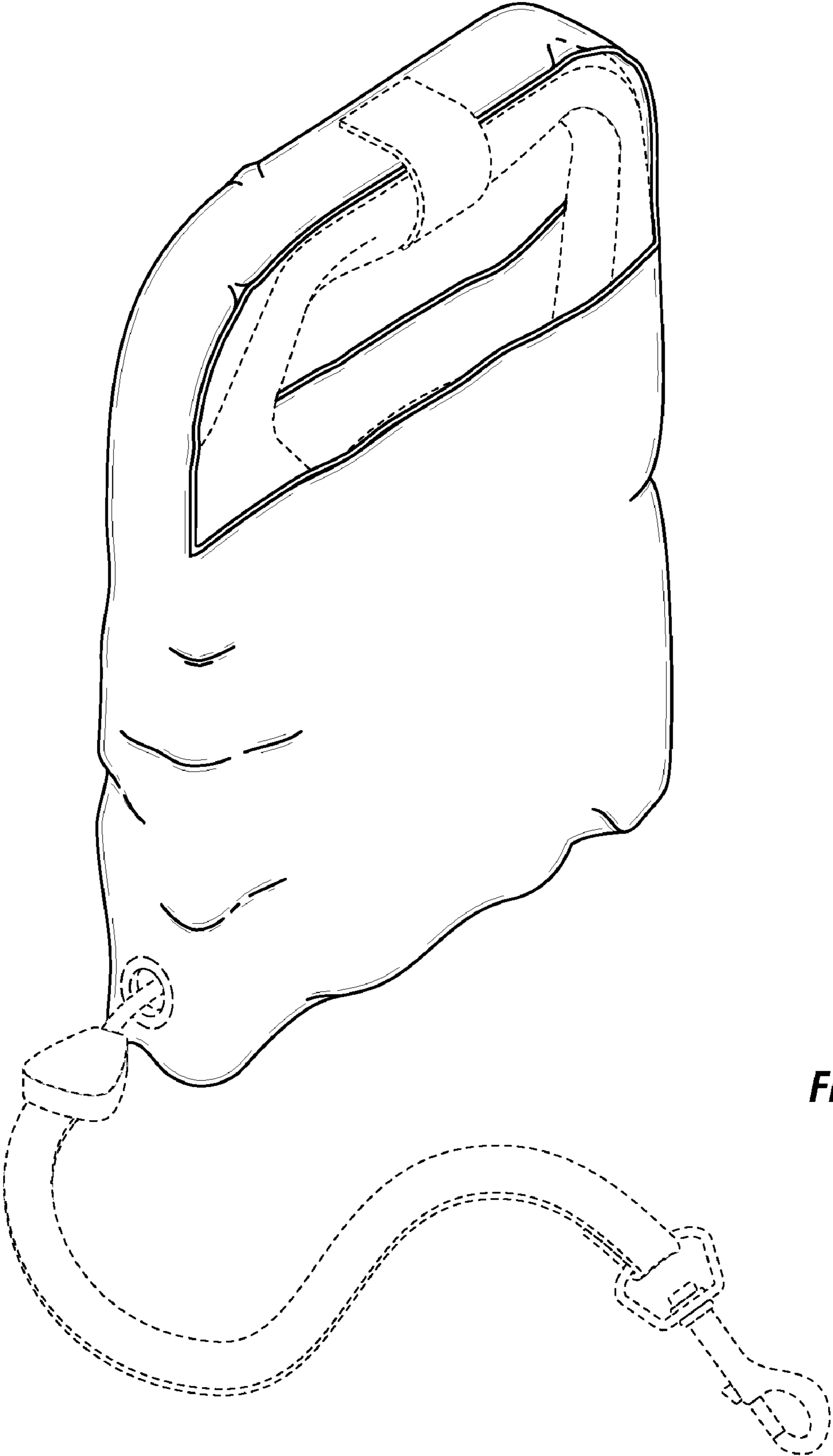

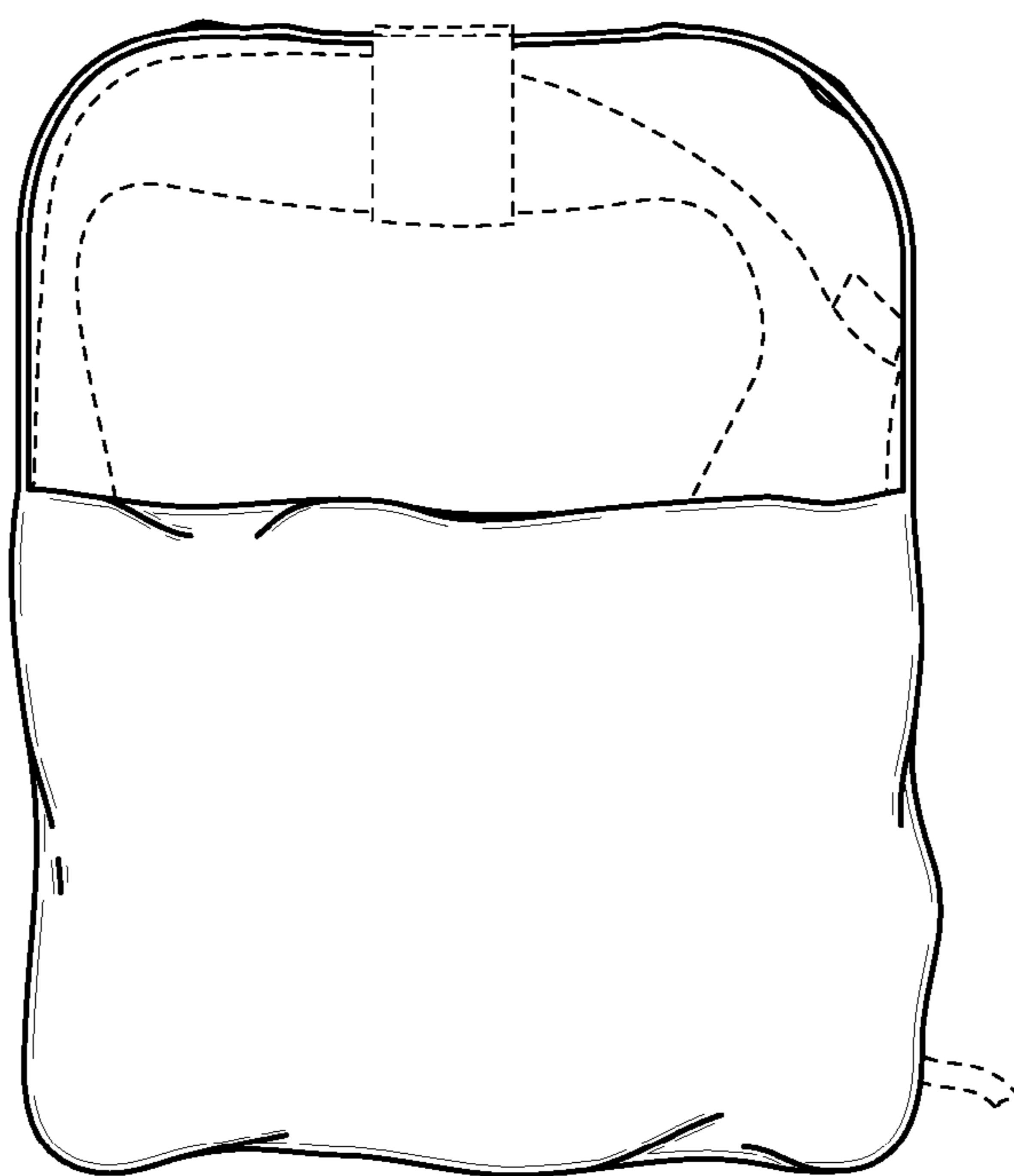

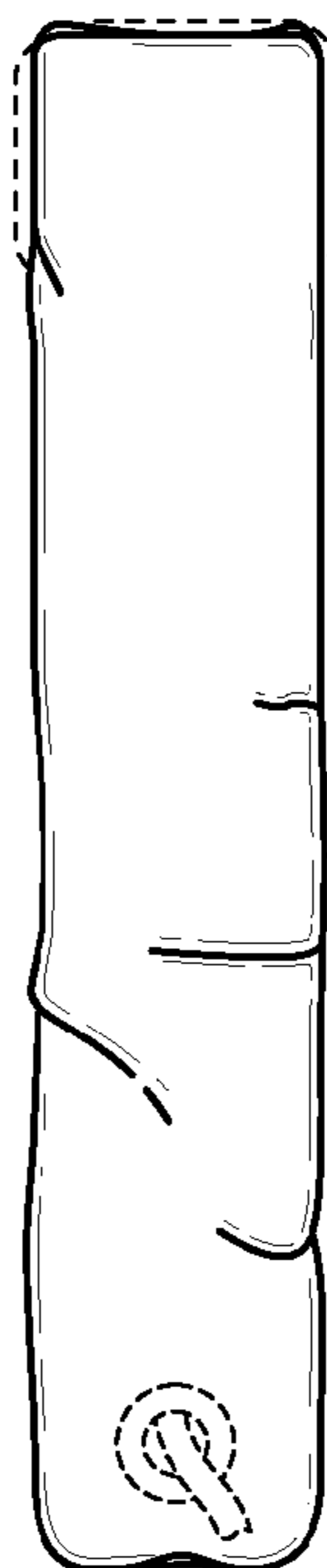

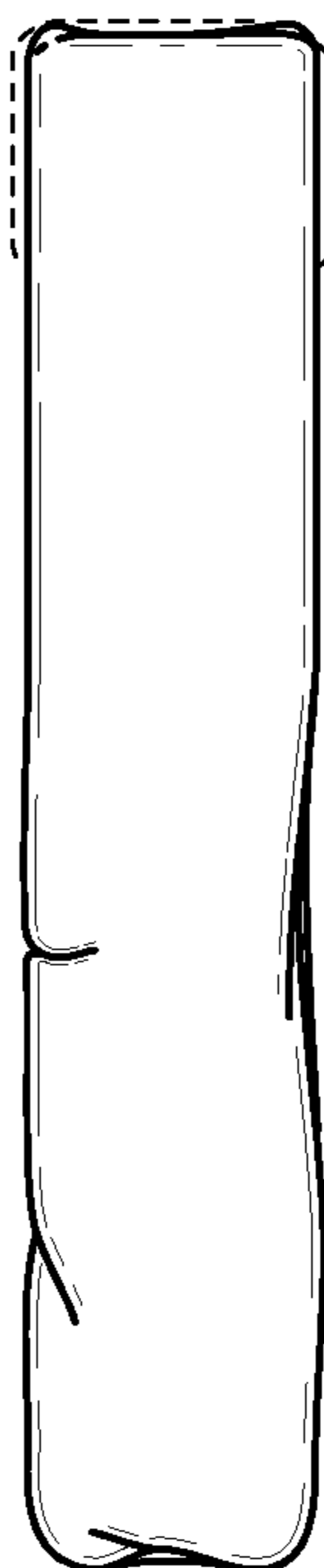
