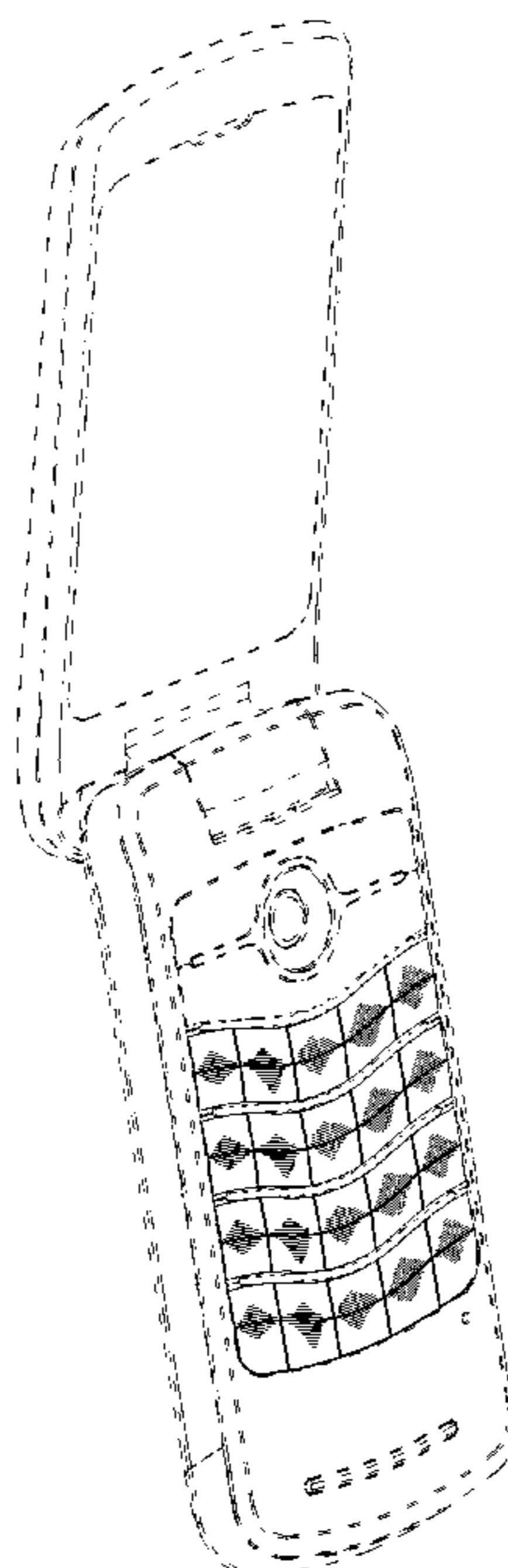
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a keyboard for a hand-held electronic device; and,

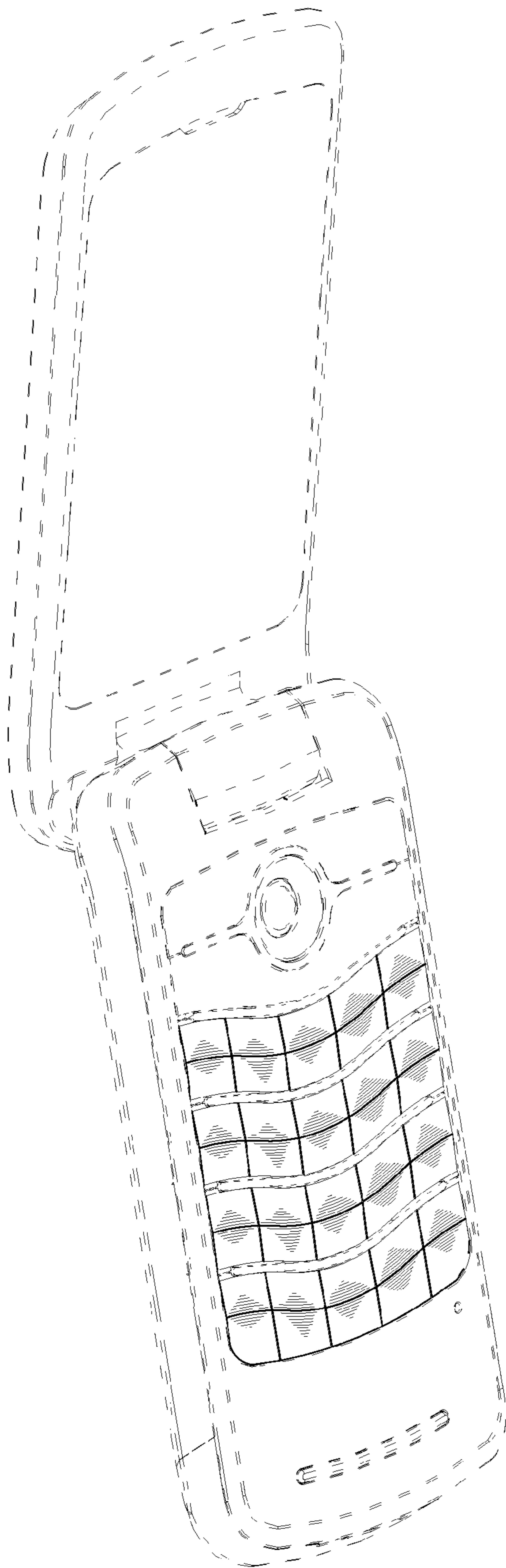

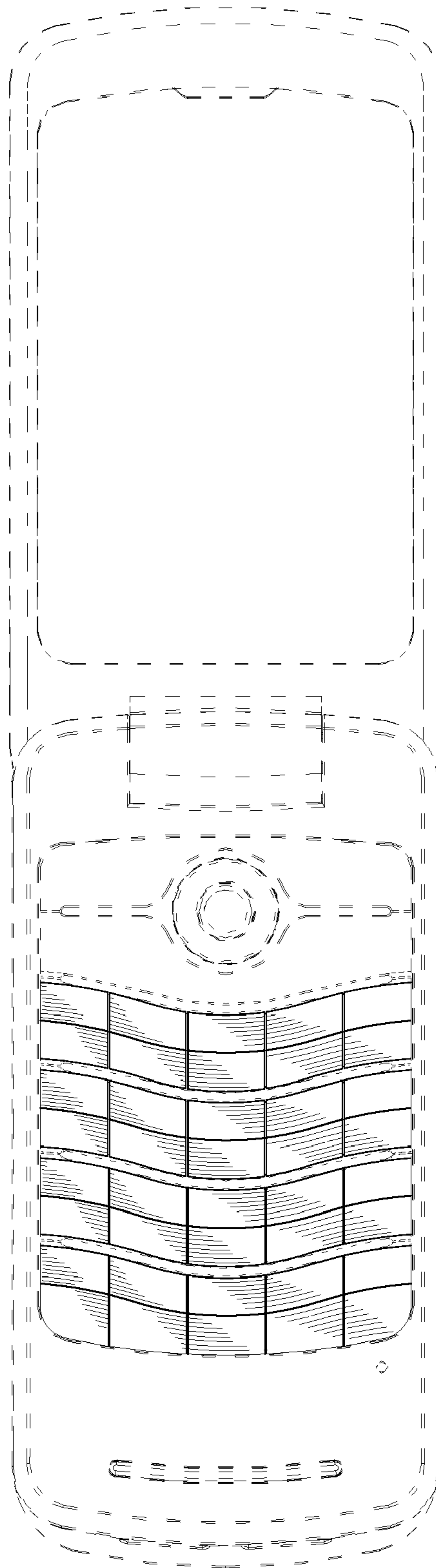
