FIG. 7 is a back side view of the absorbent article or package with surface indicia as shown in FIG. 1.

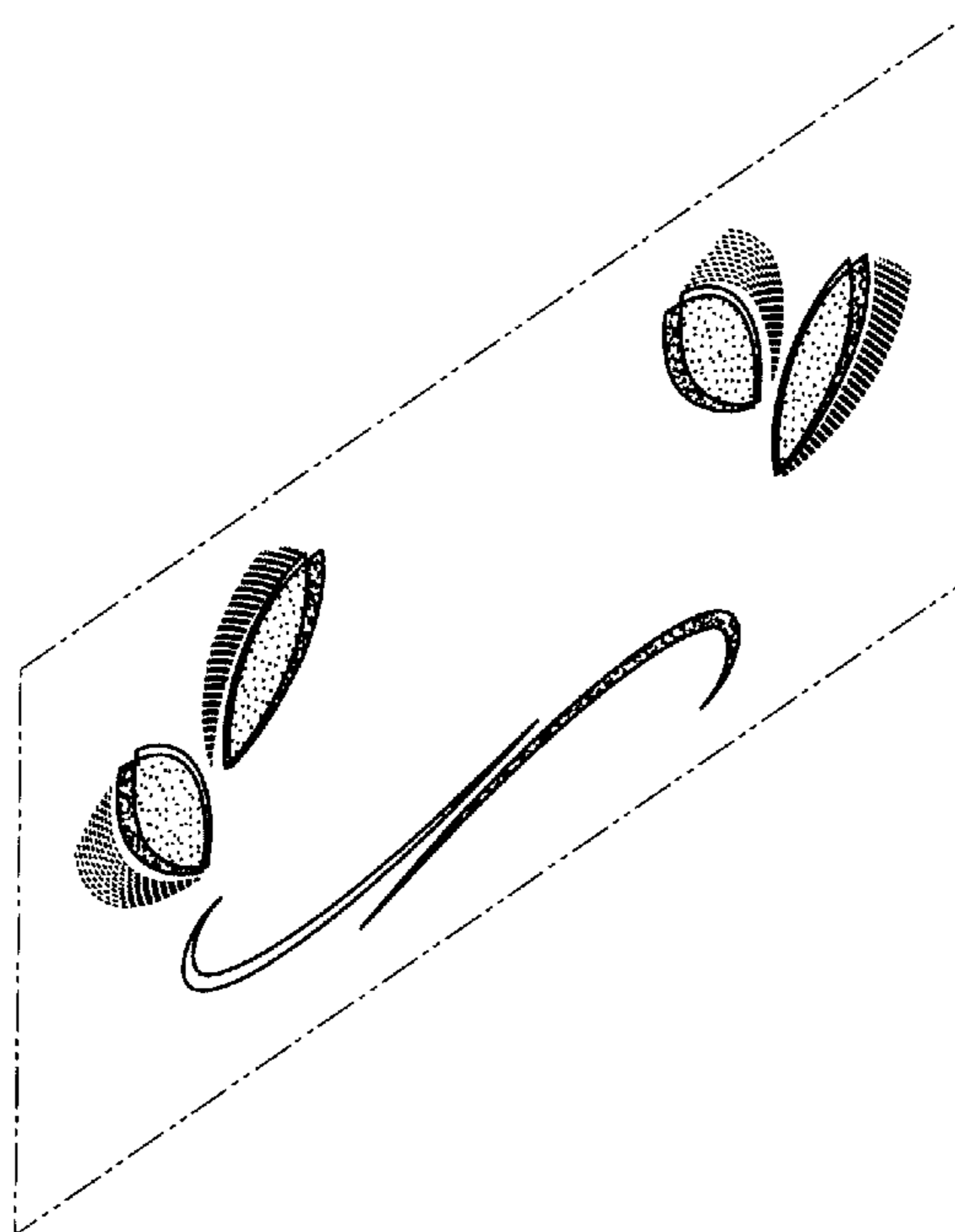

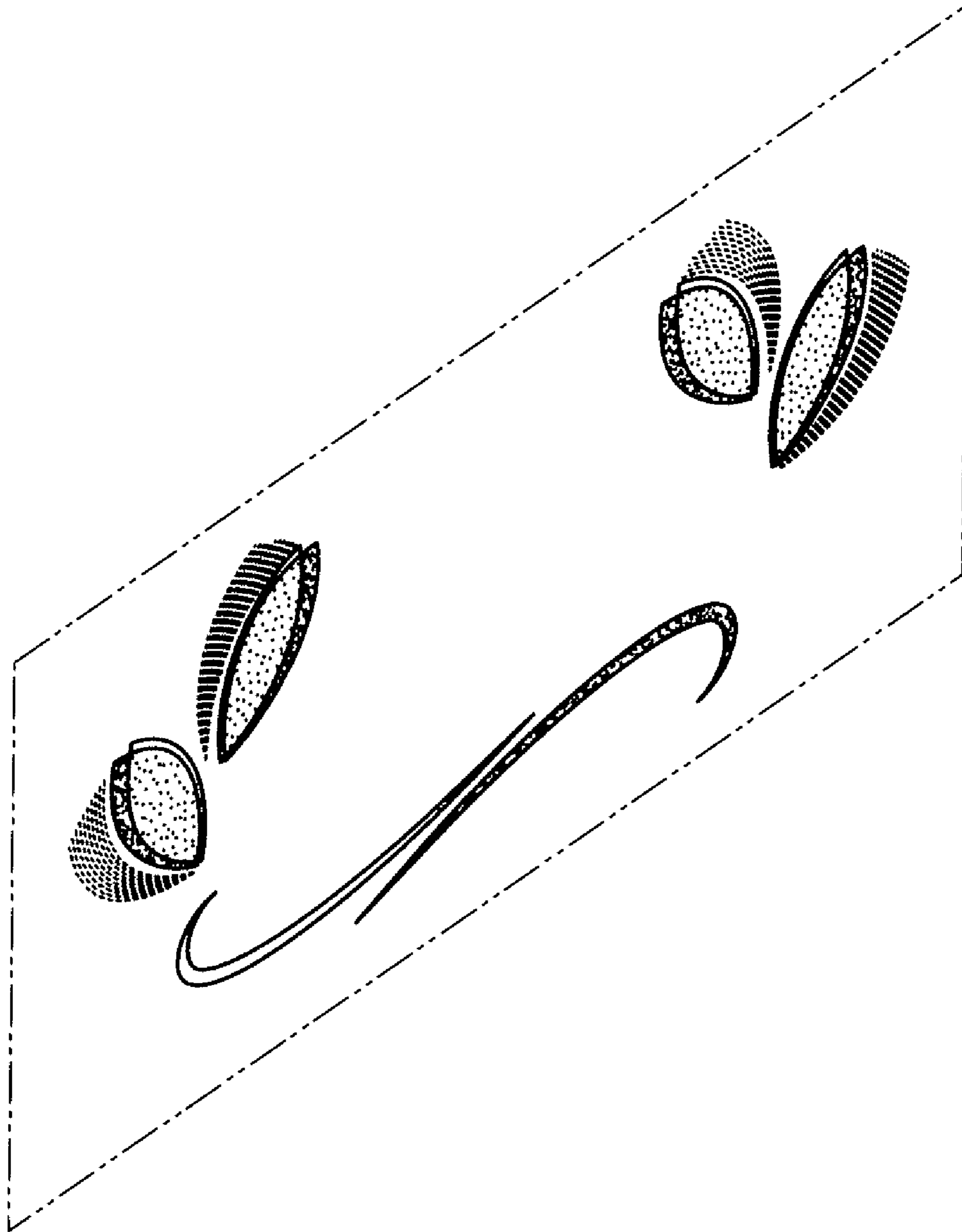

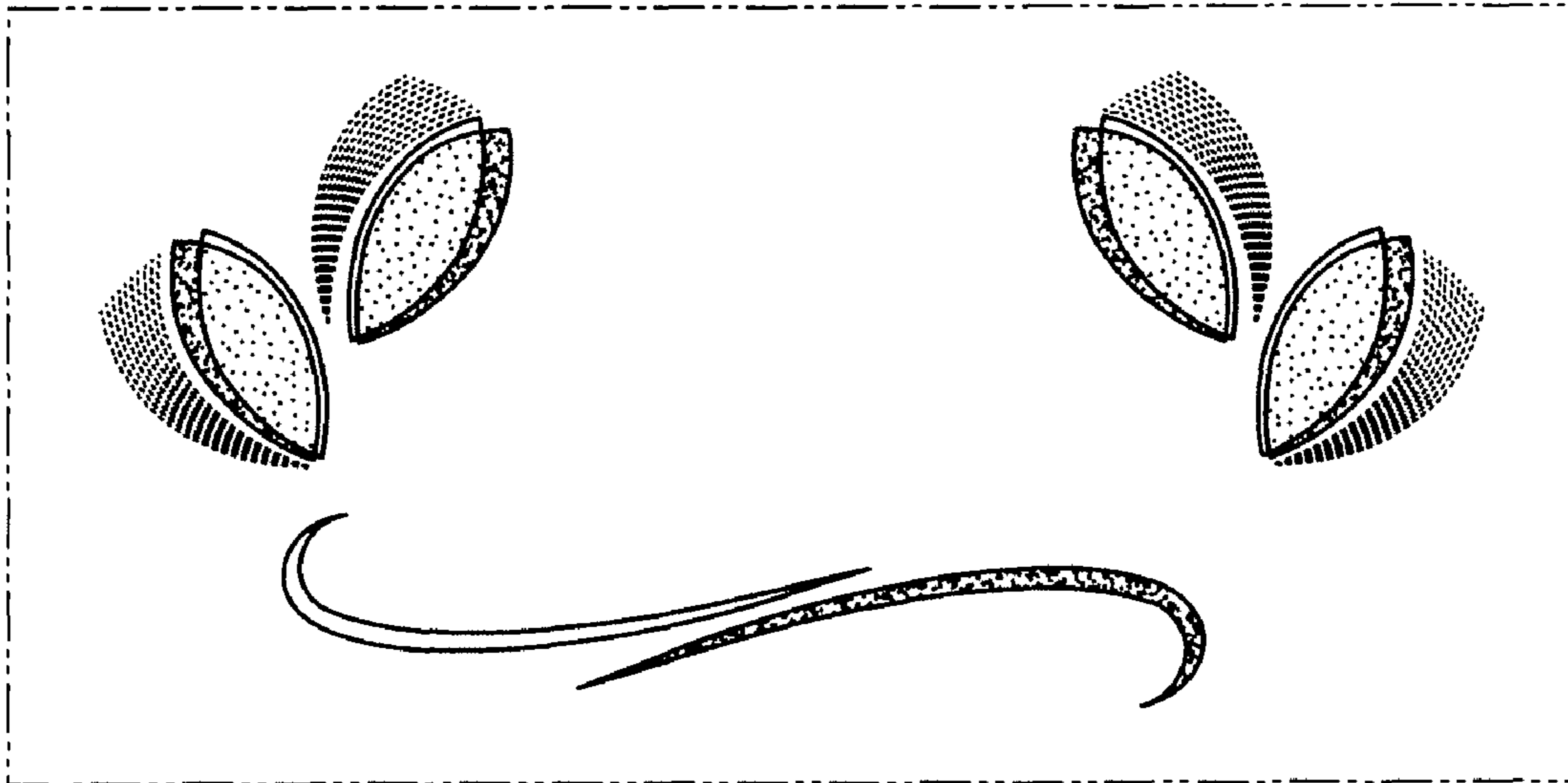

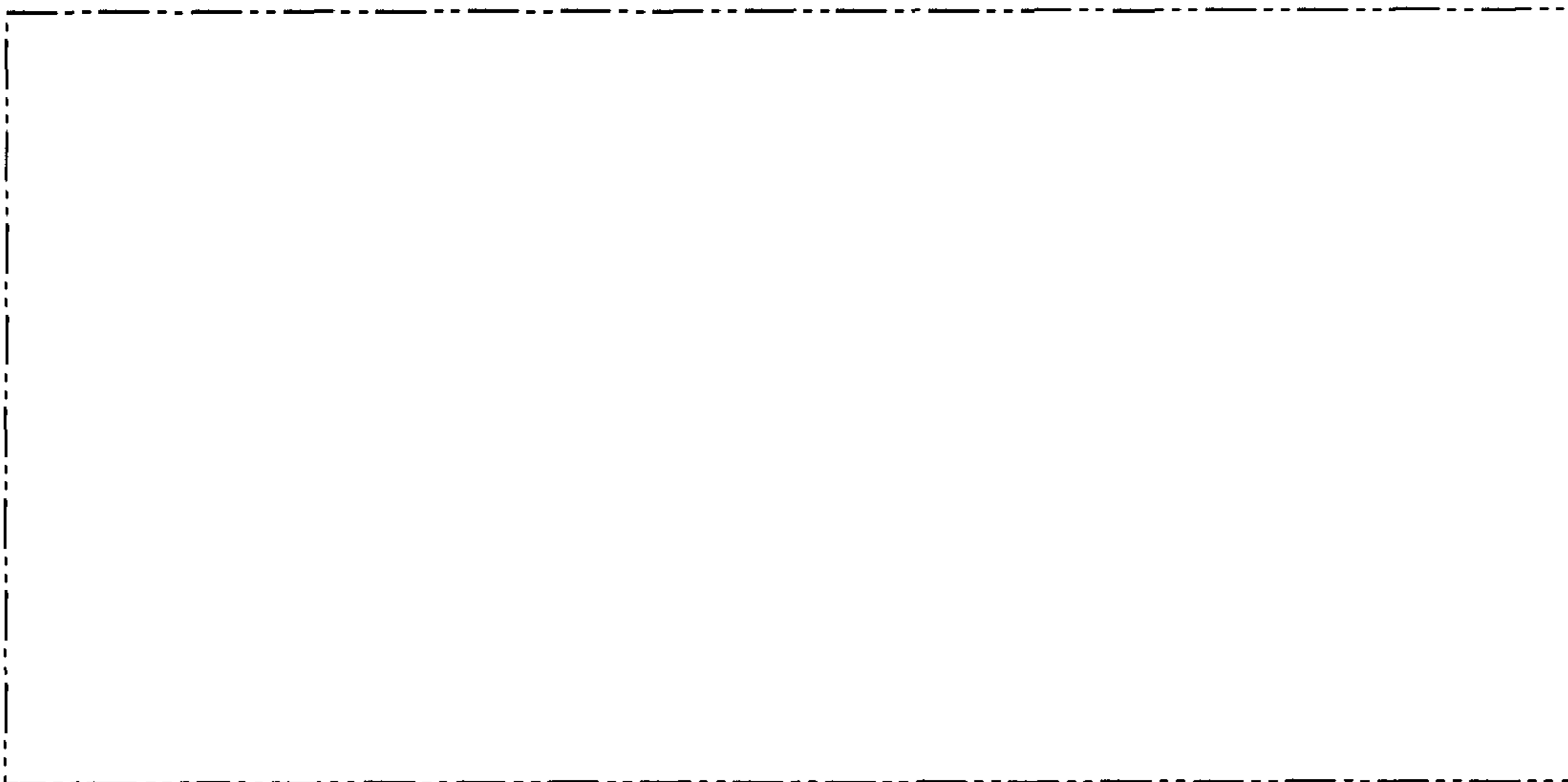
