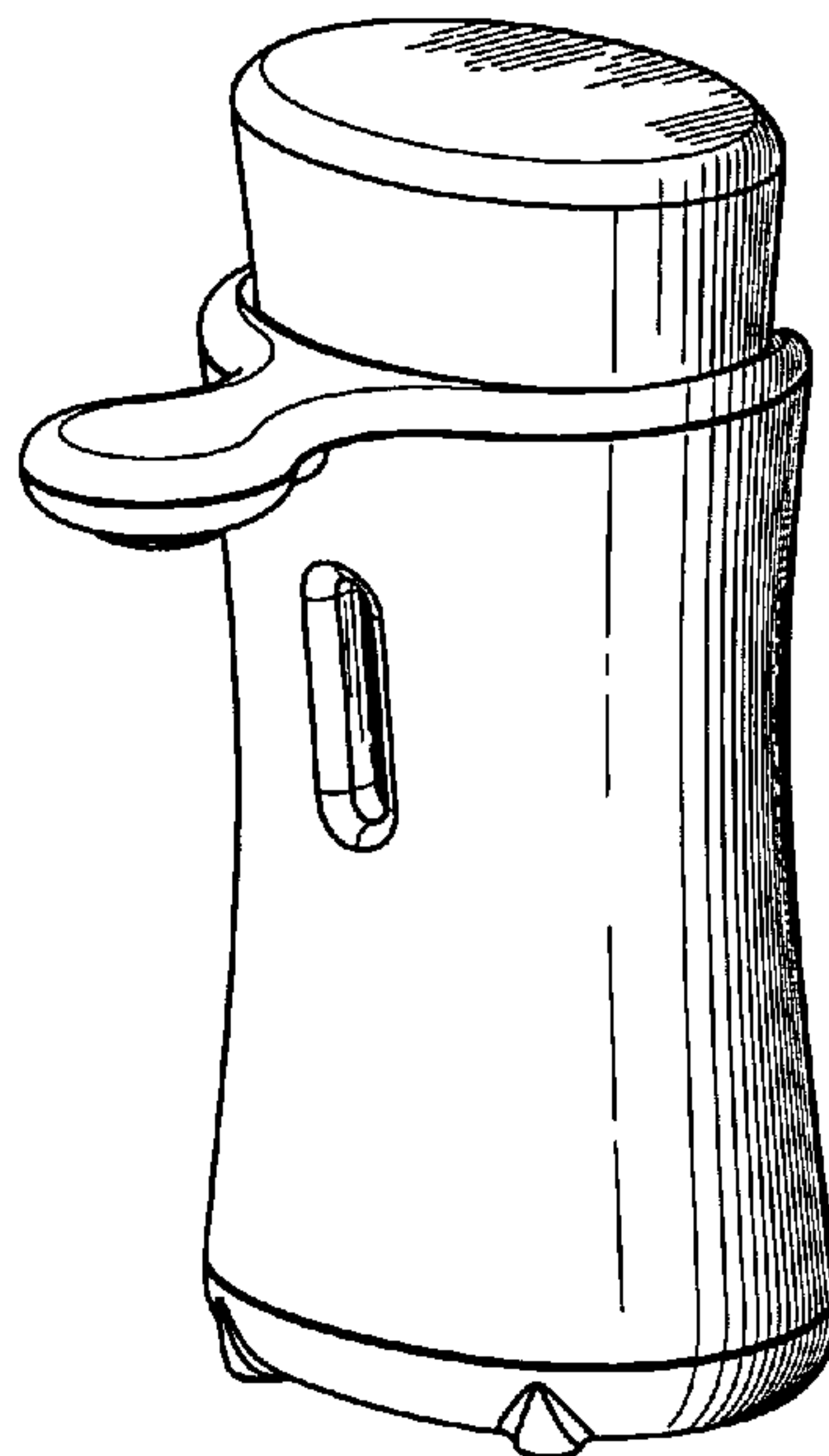
The ornamental design for a dispenser with refill, as shown  
and described.

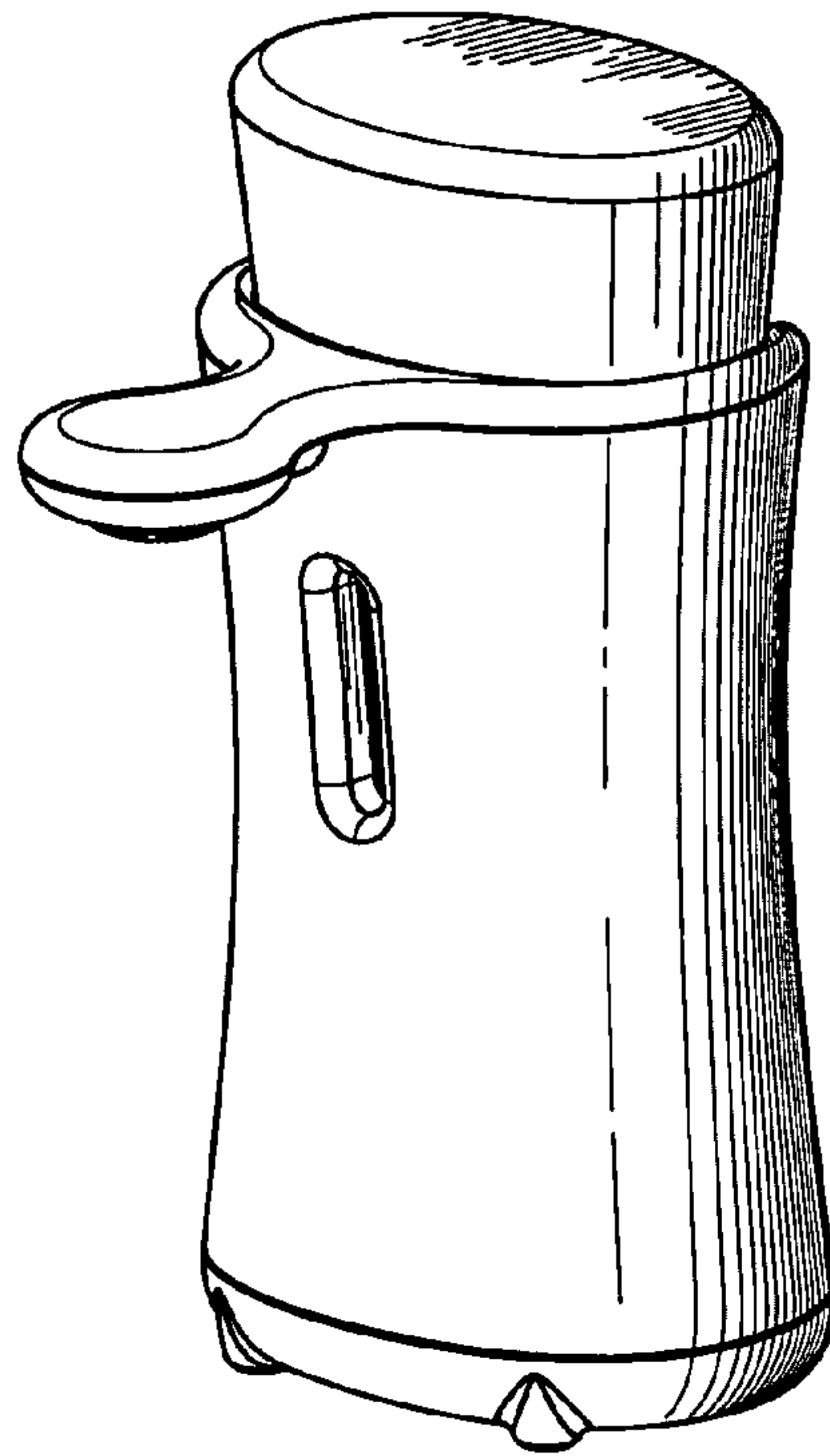
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the new design.

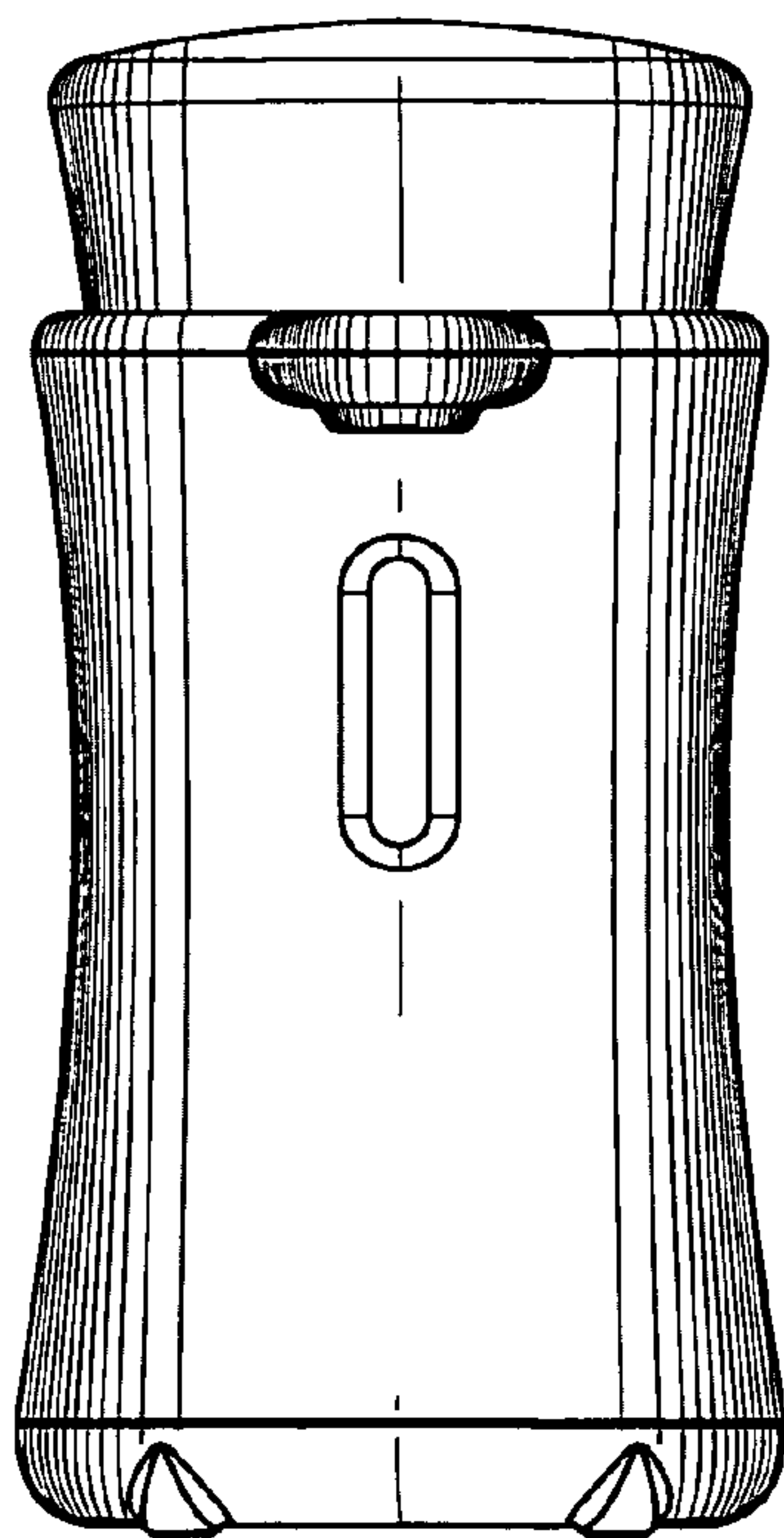

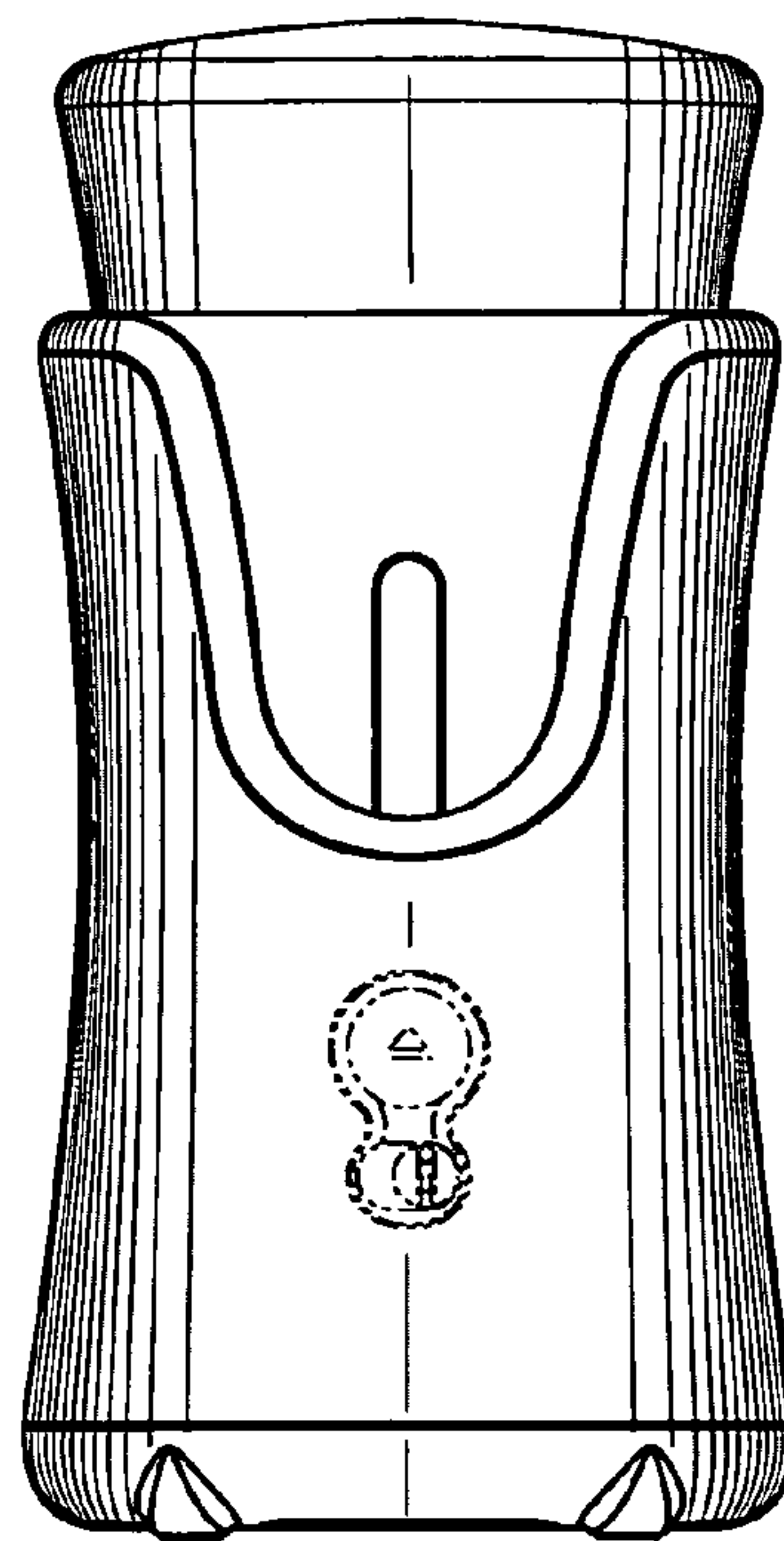




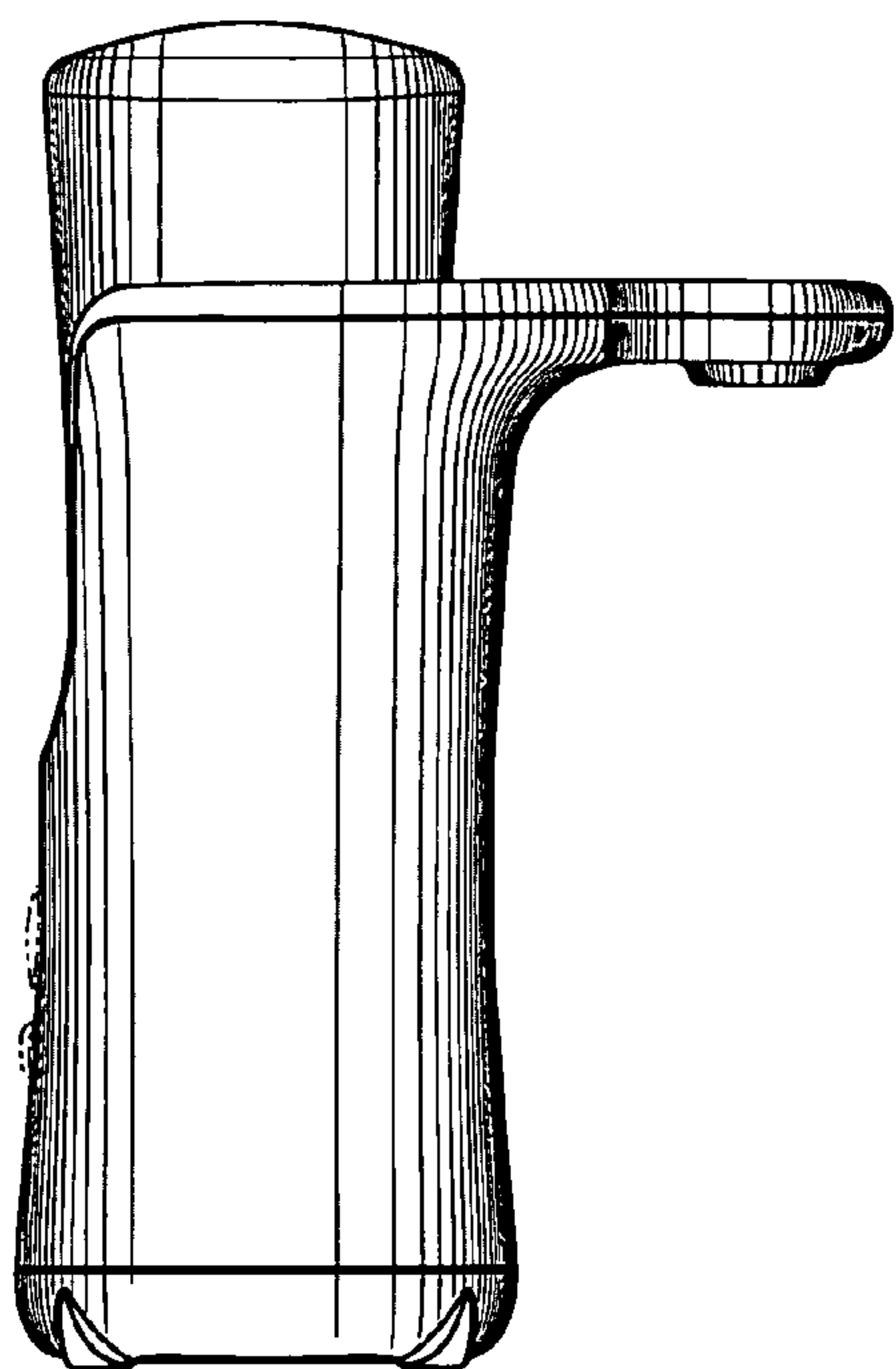

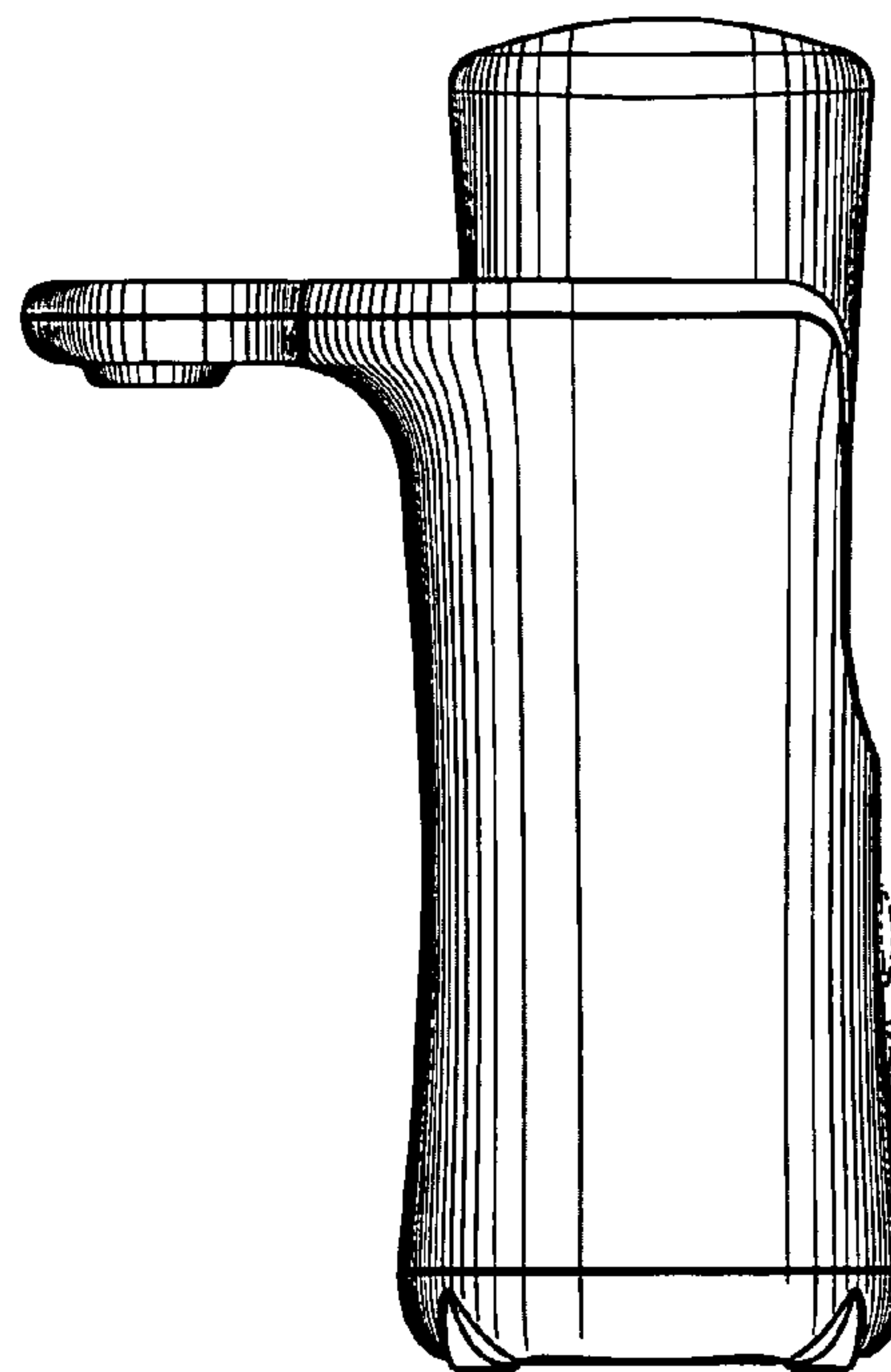

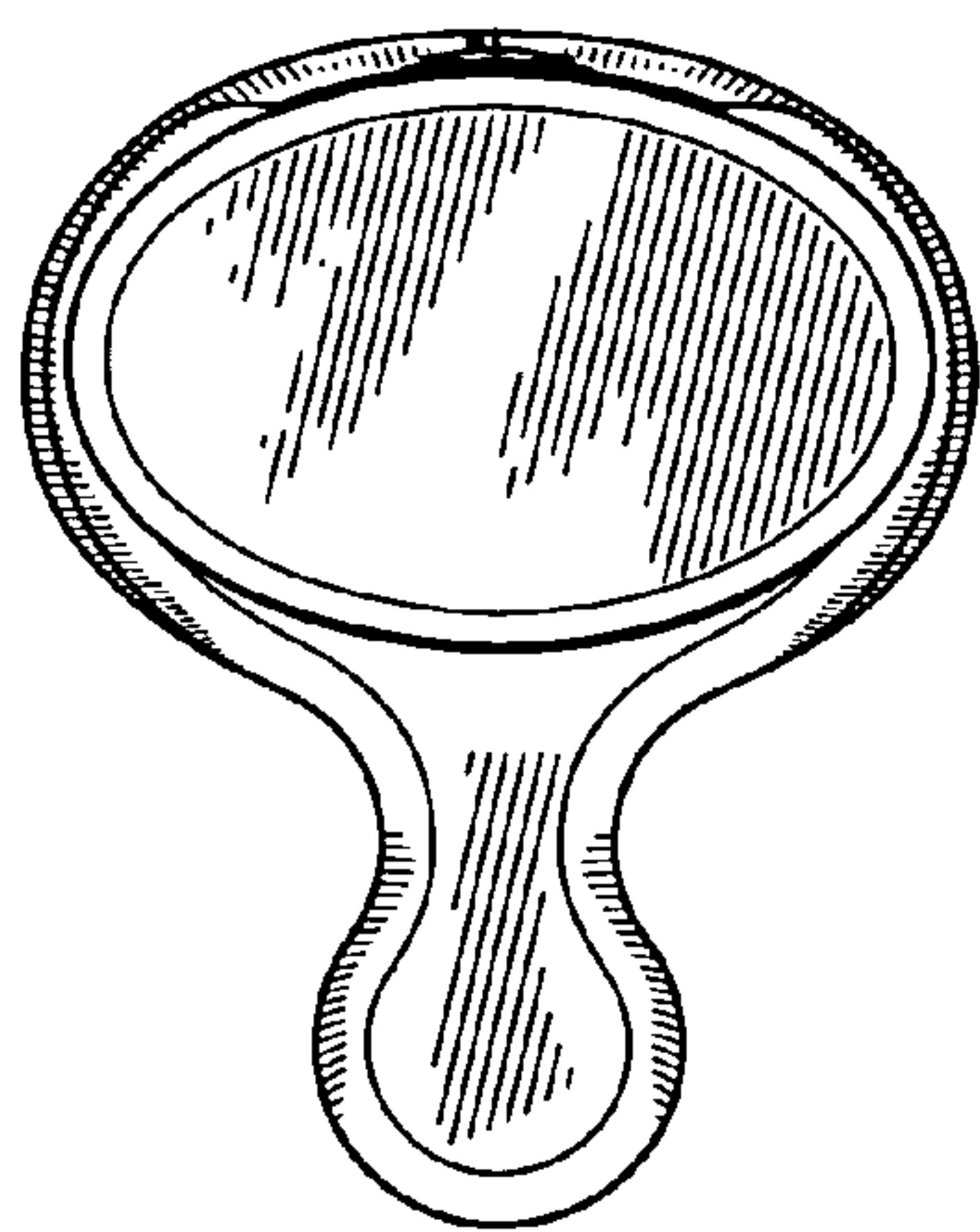

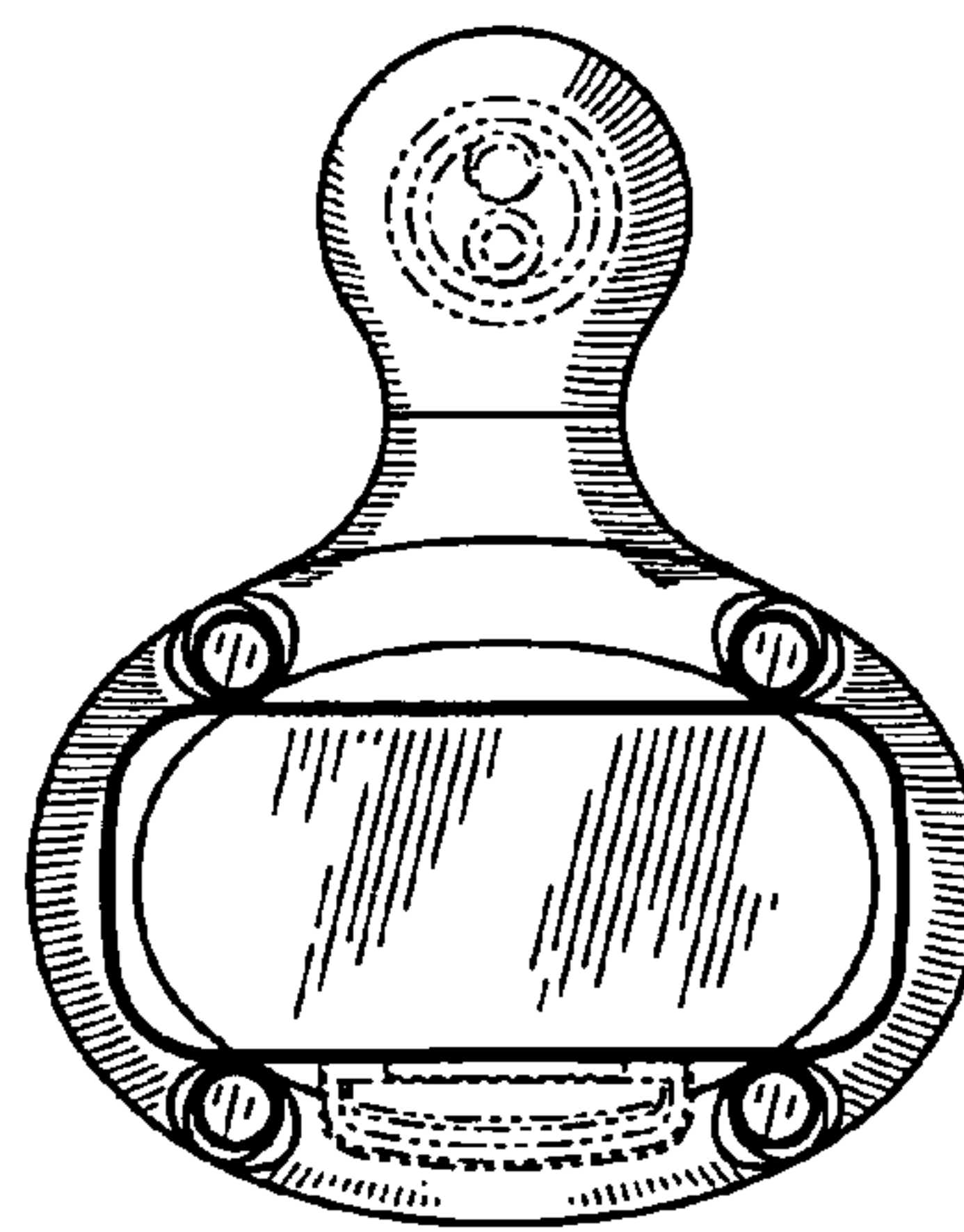
