The ornamental design for a cleansing article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a cleansing article showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken lines showing opposing cleaning heads, a strap and recessed areas illustrate portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

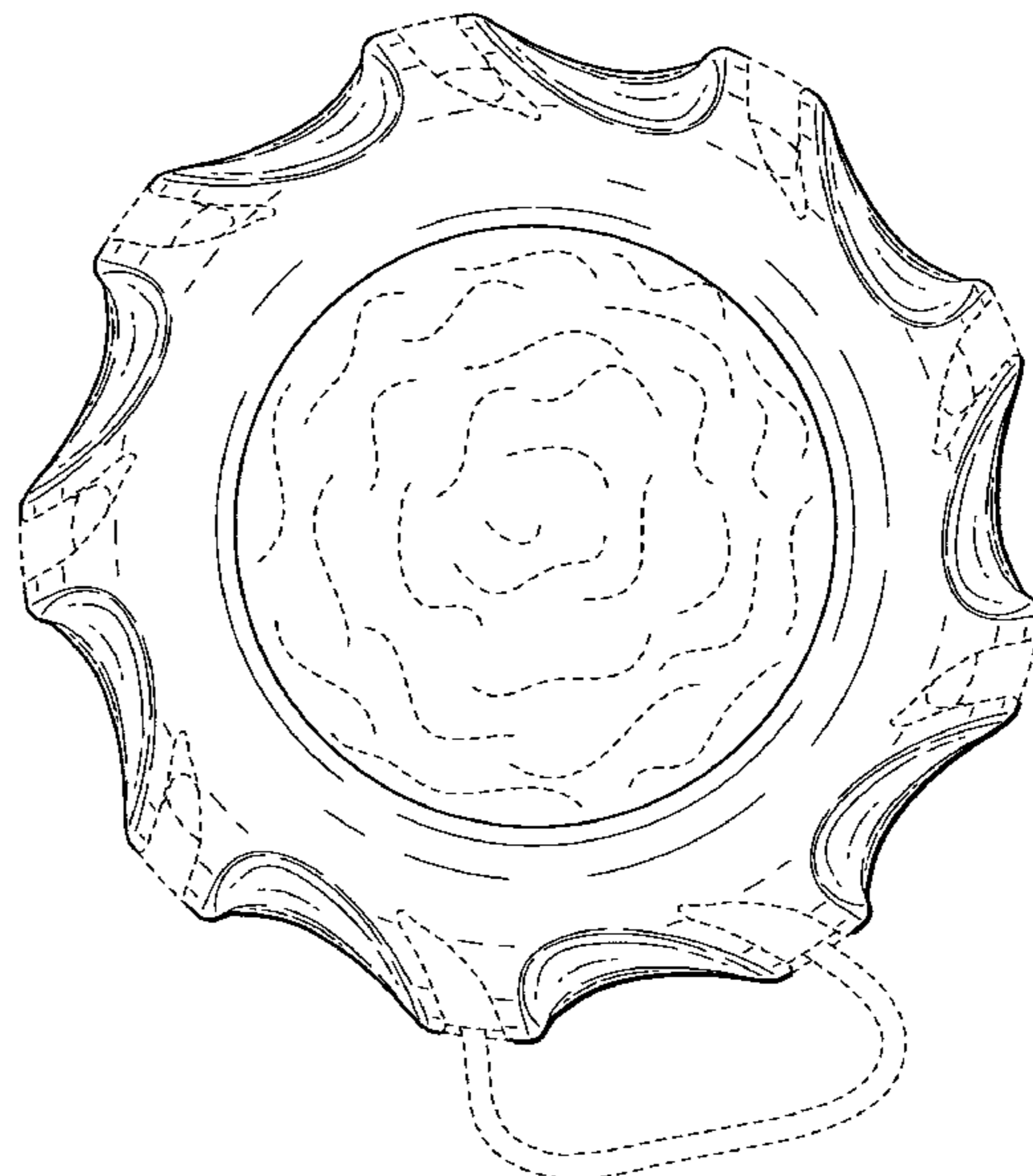
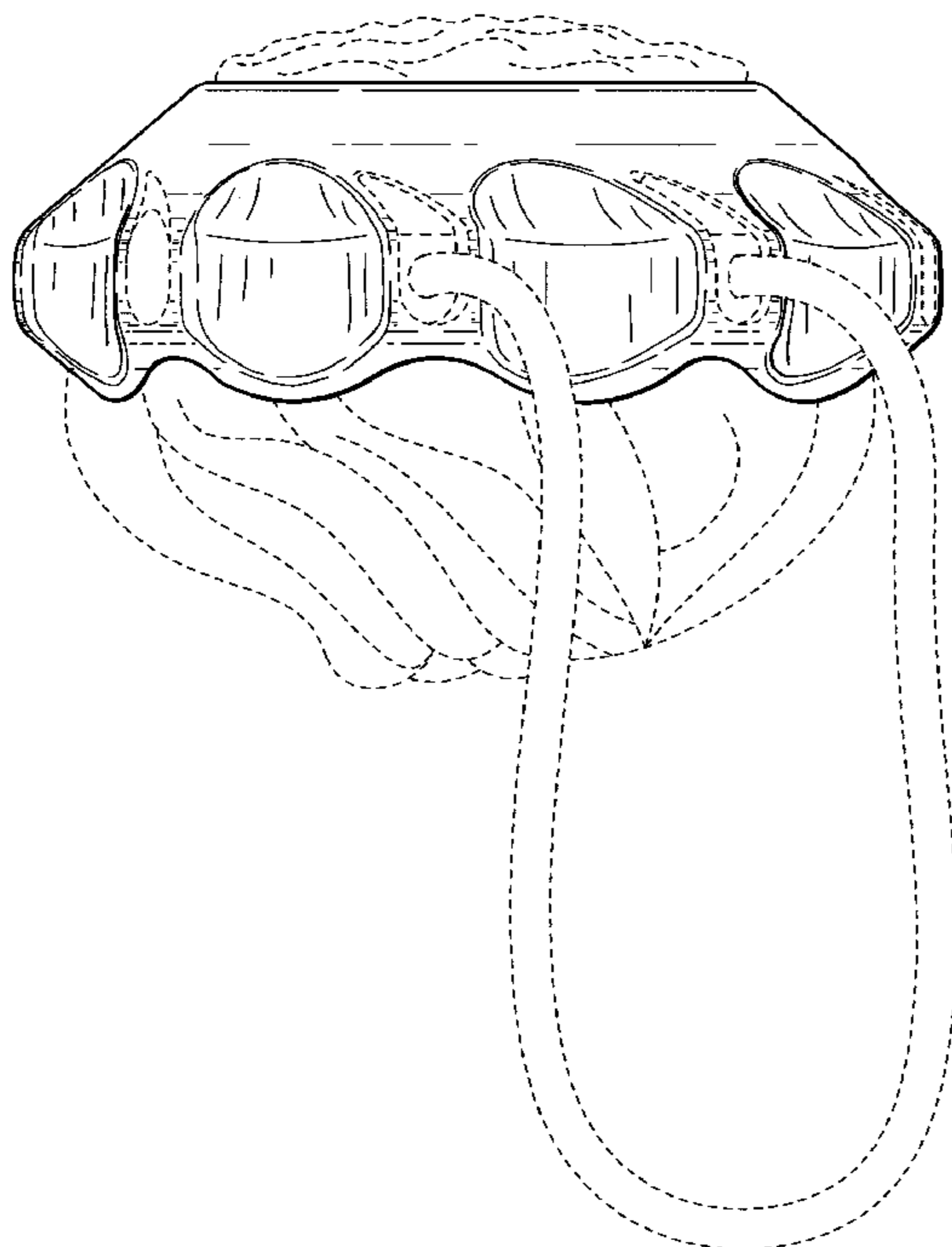

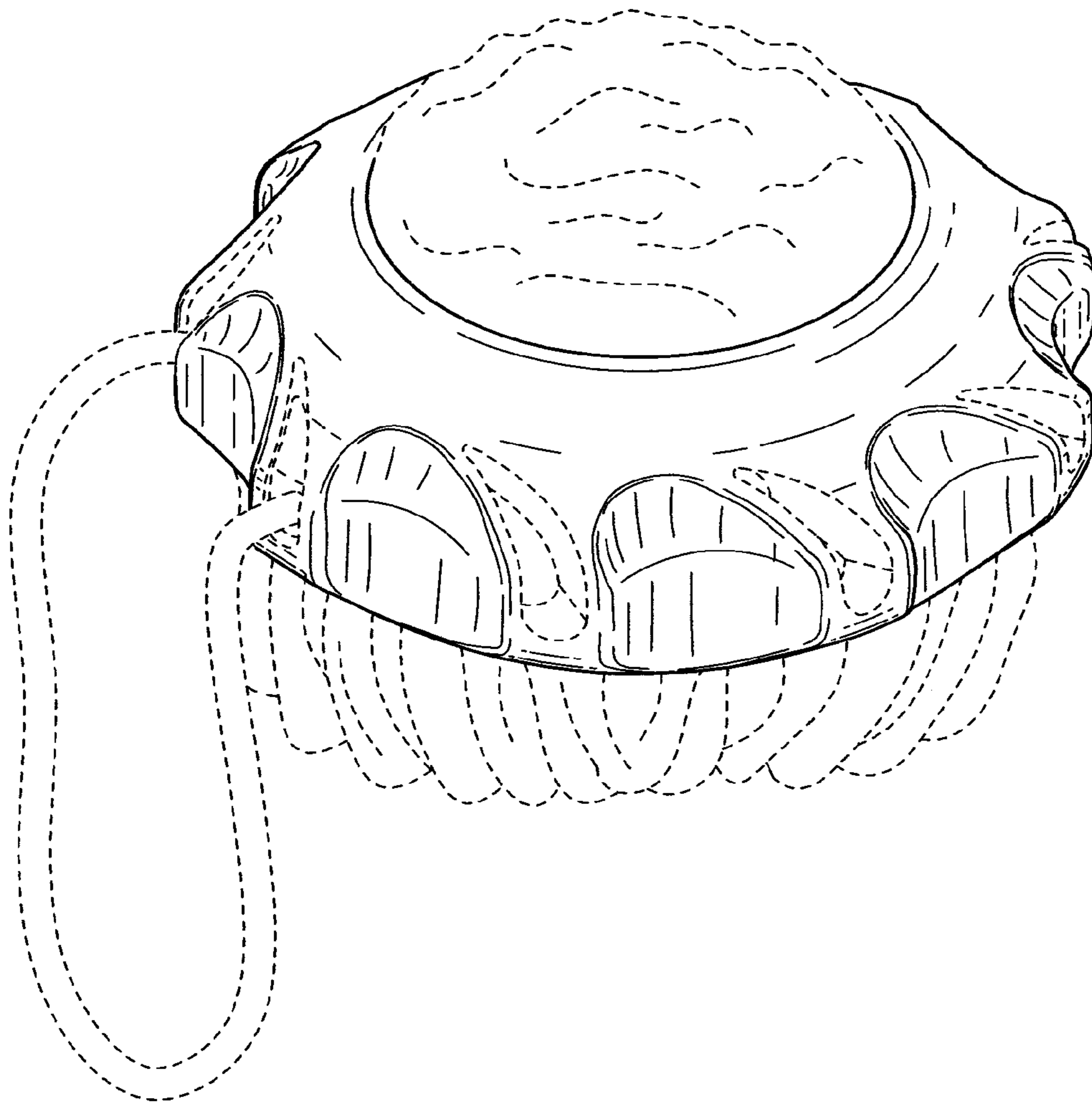

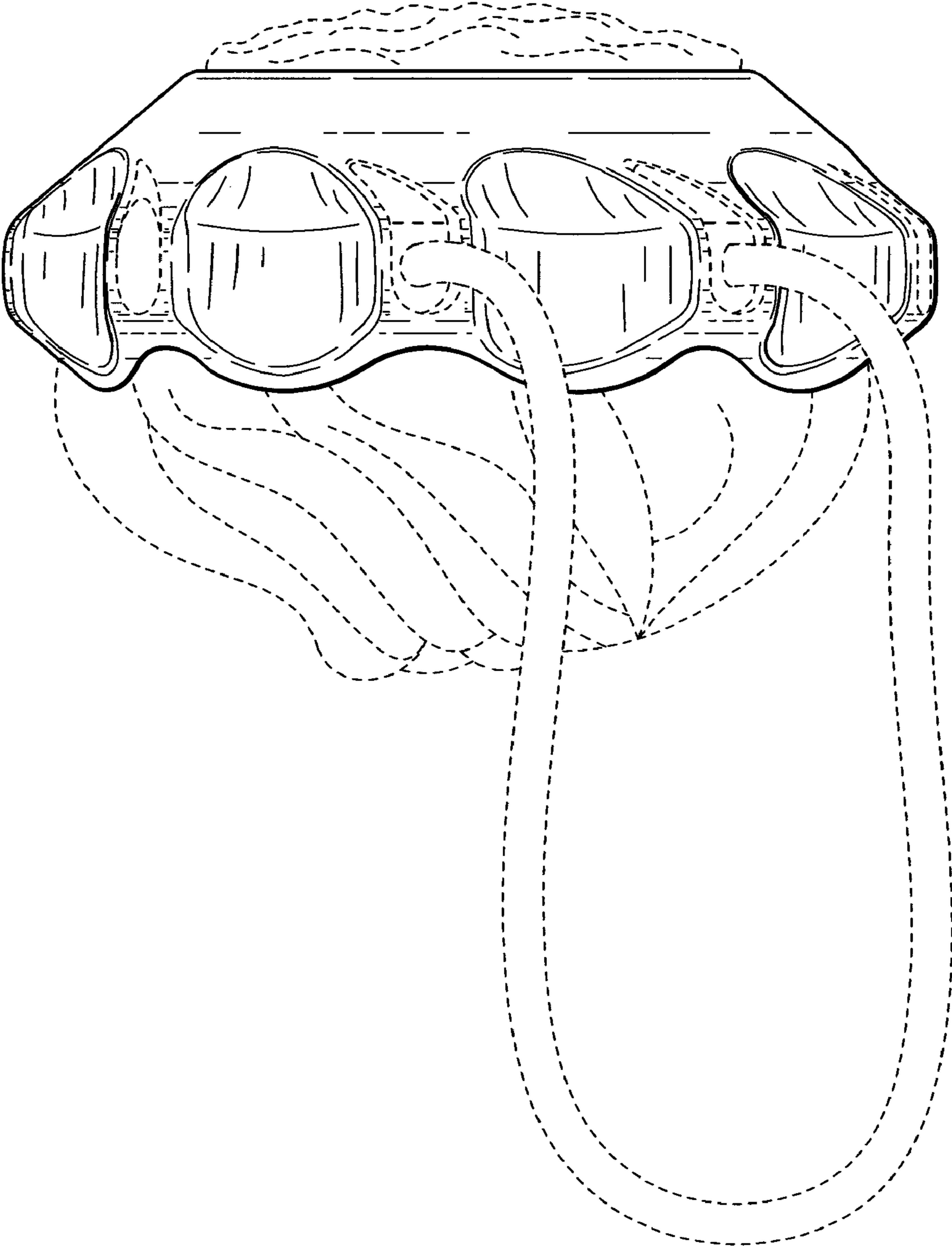

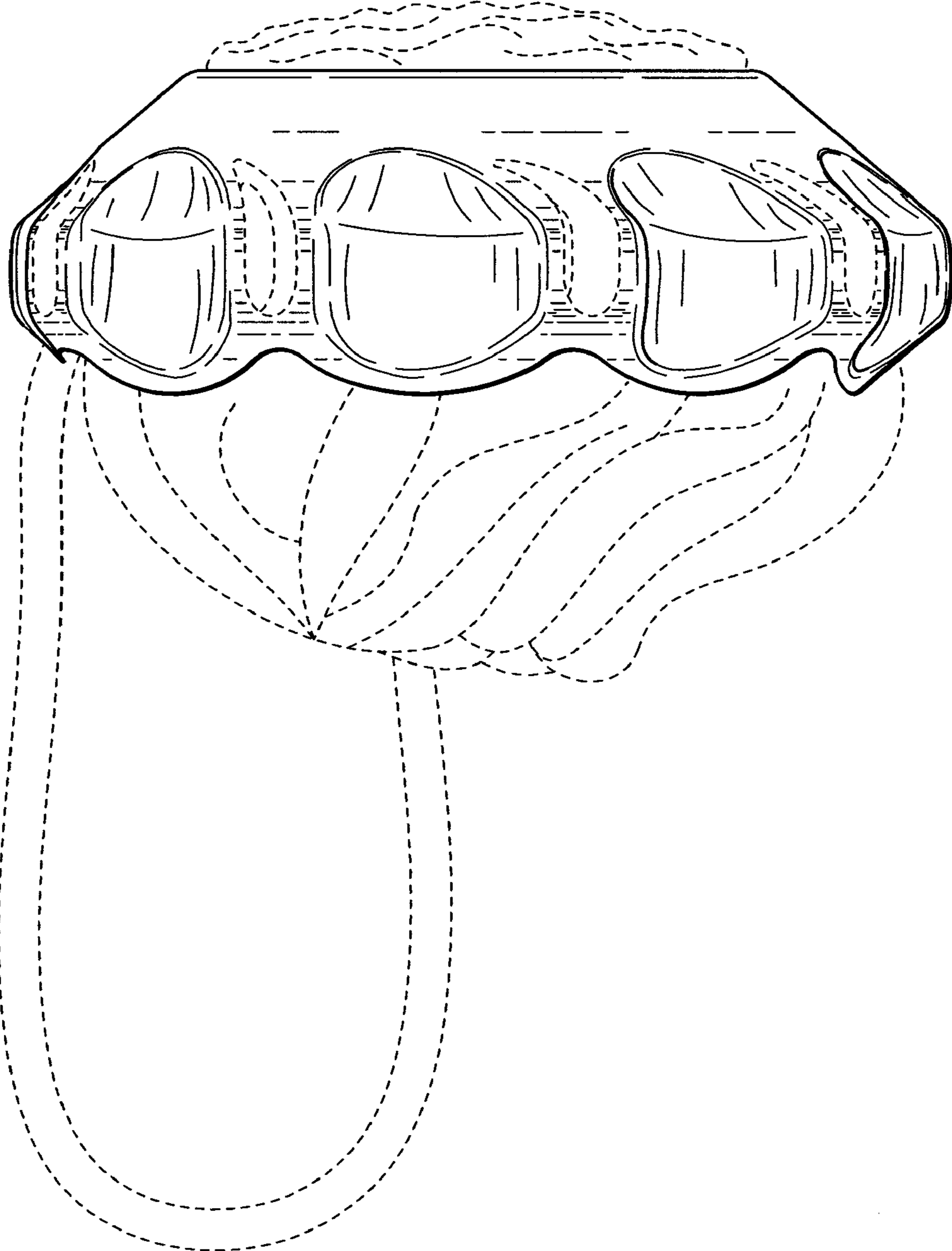

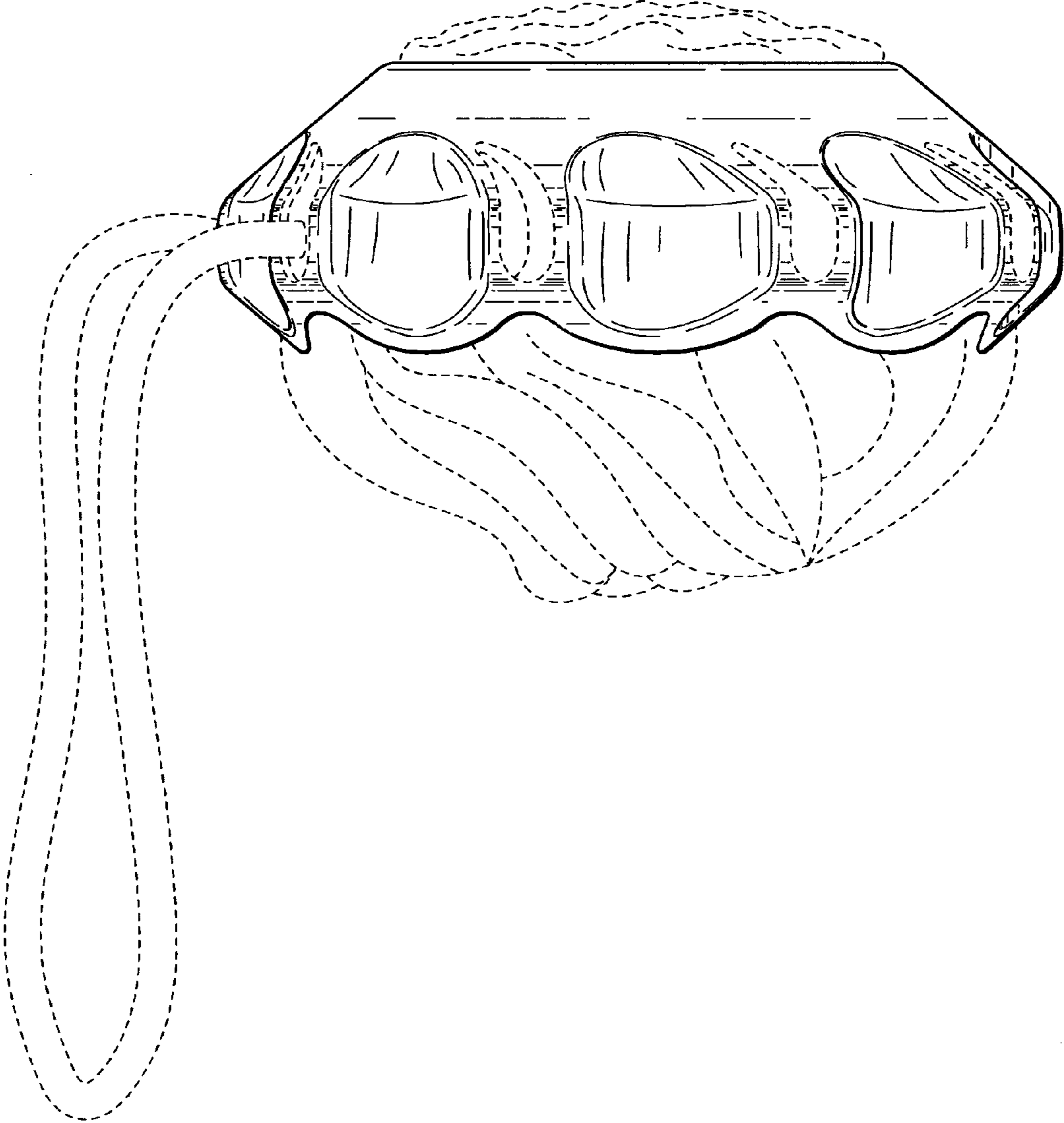

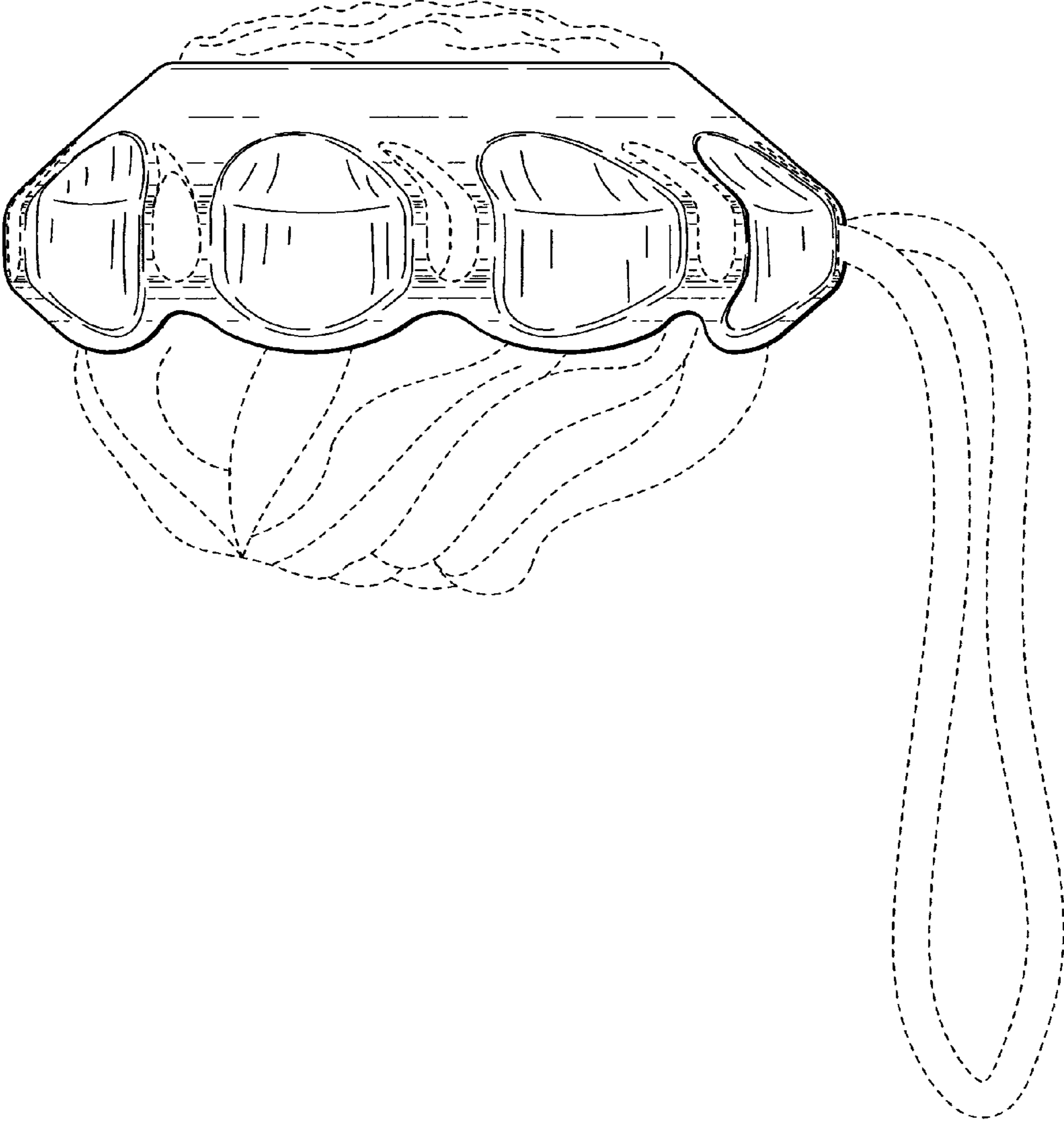
