FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a connector for fluid supply for patient infusion, according to a second embodiment.

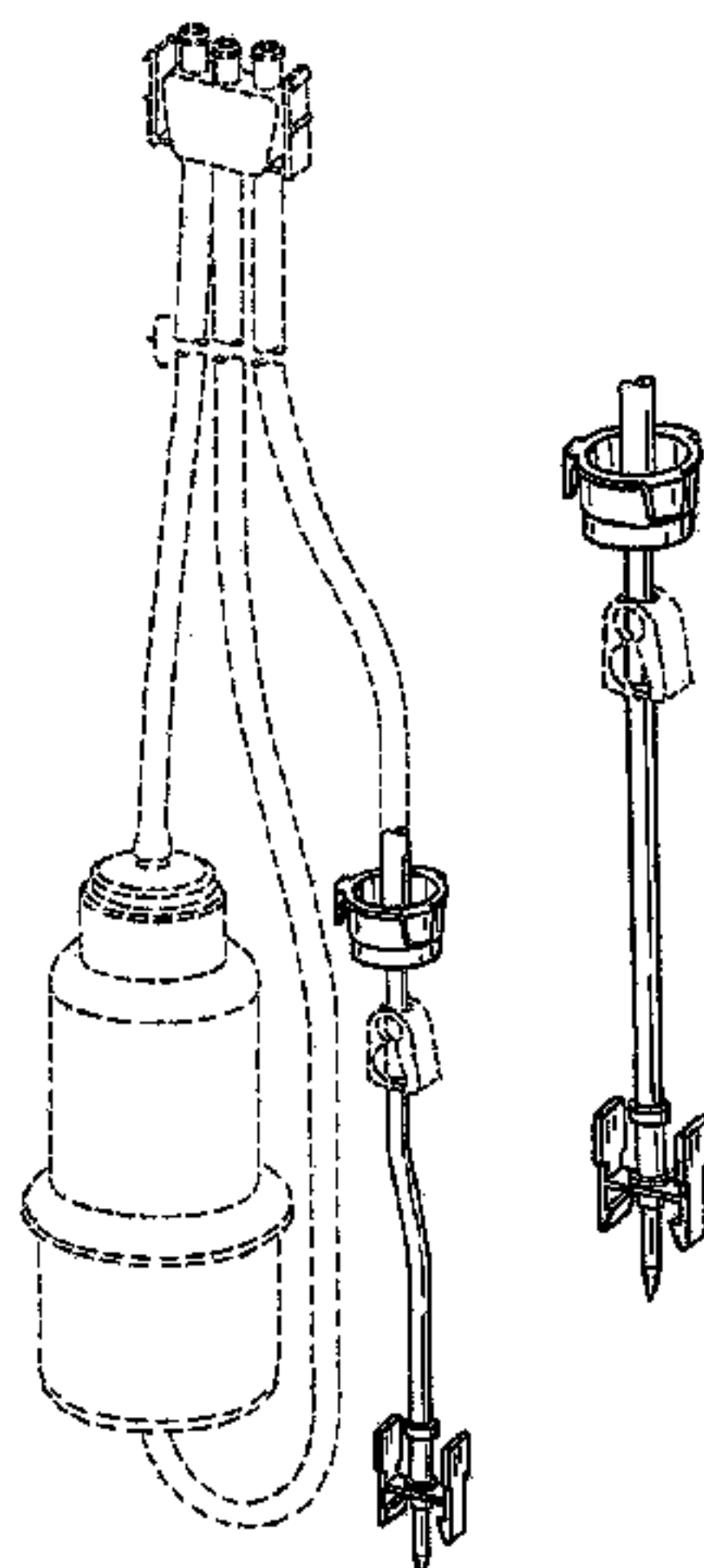

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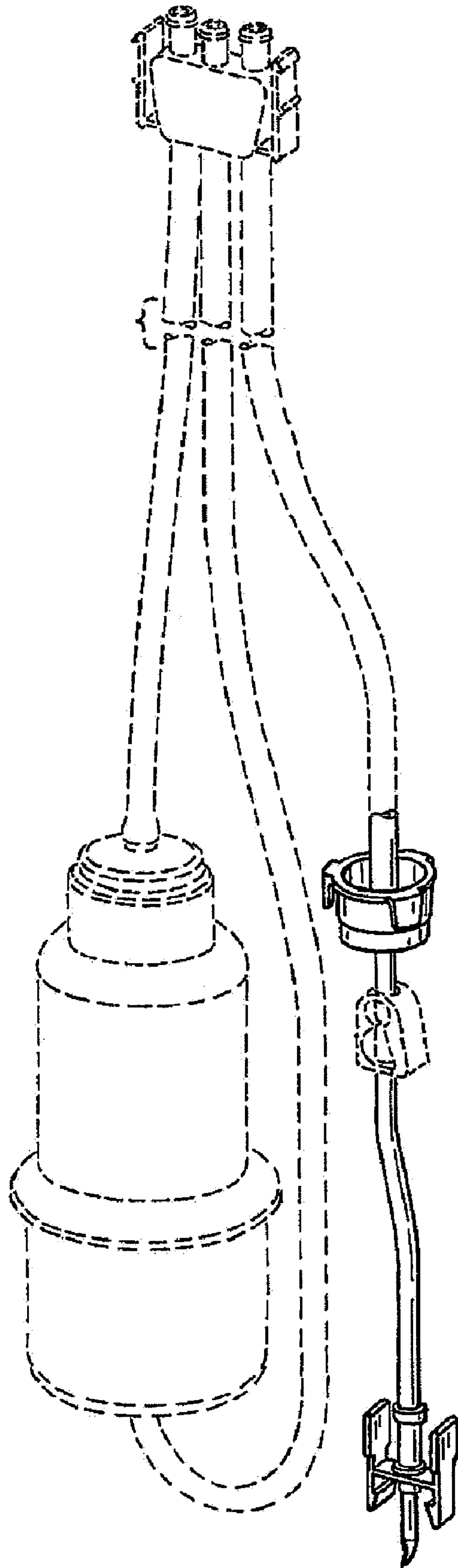

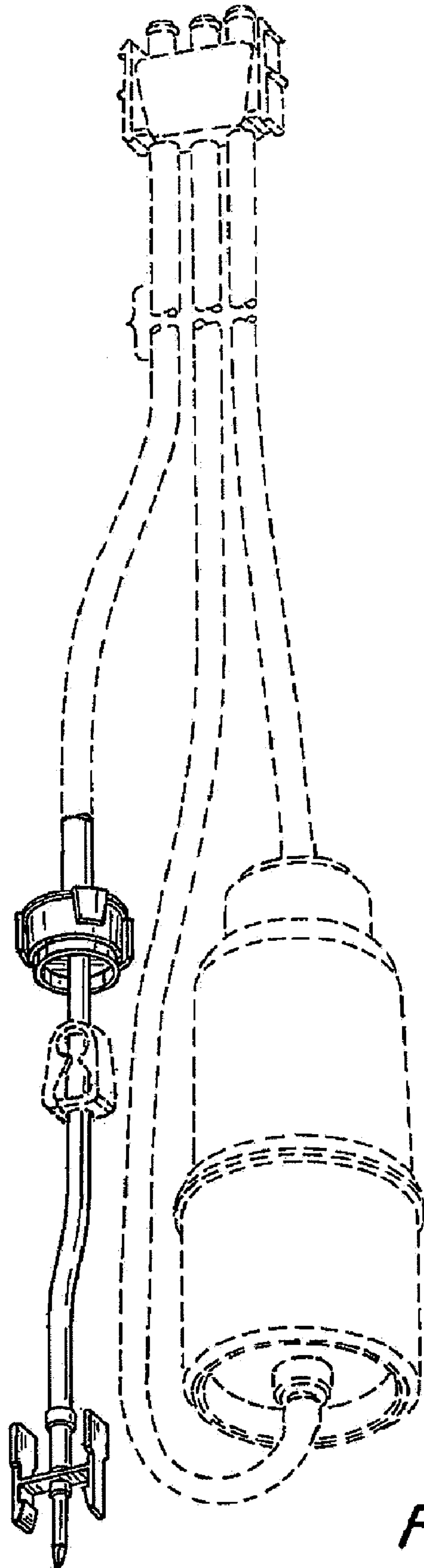

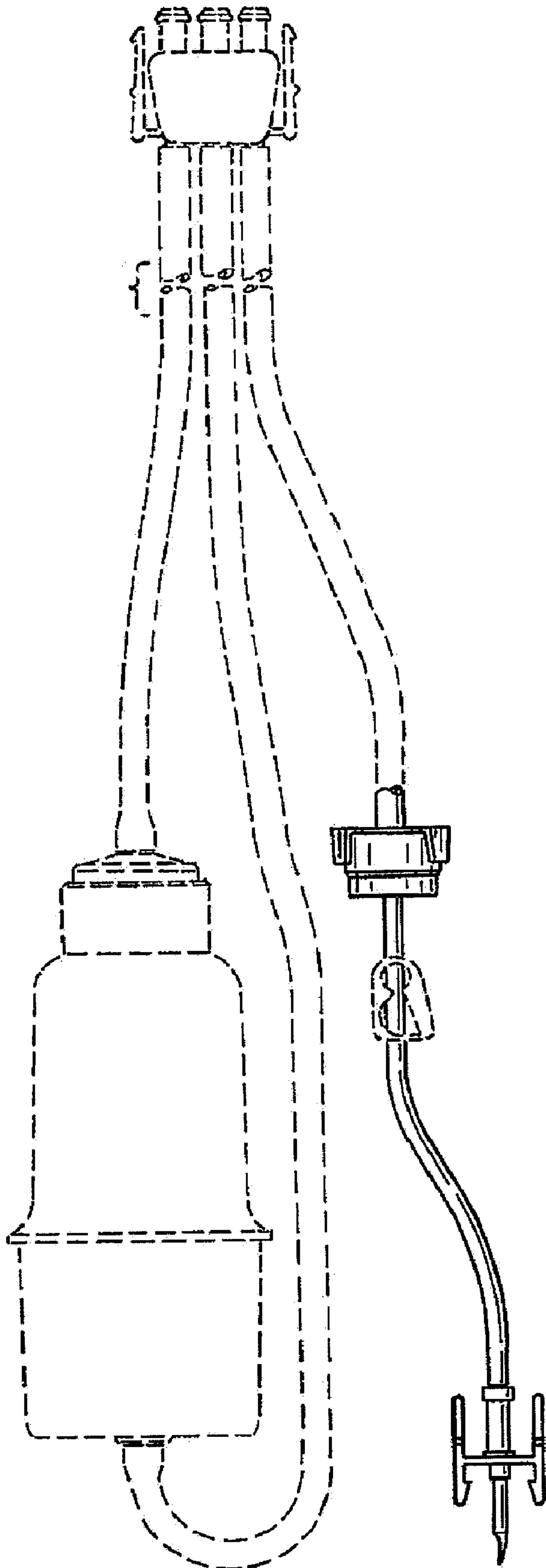

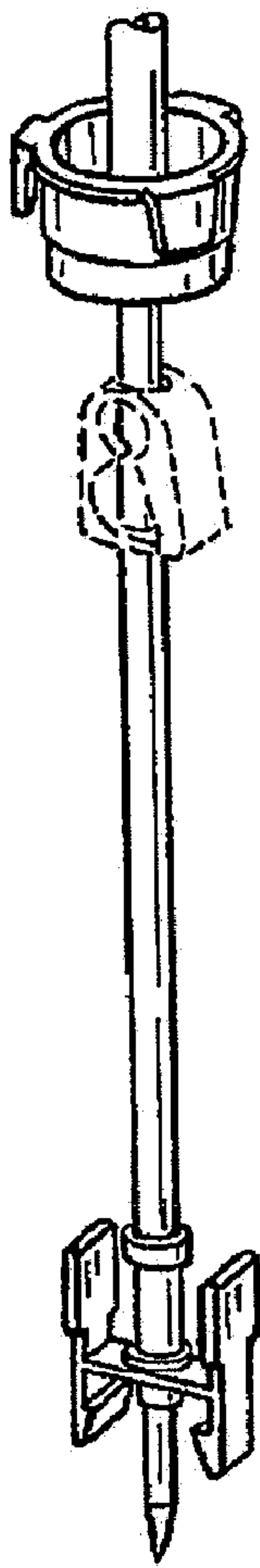

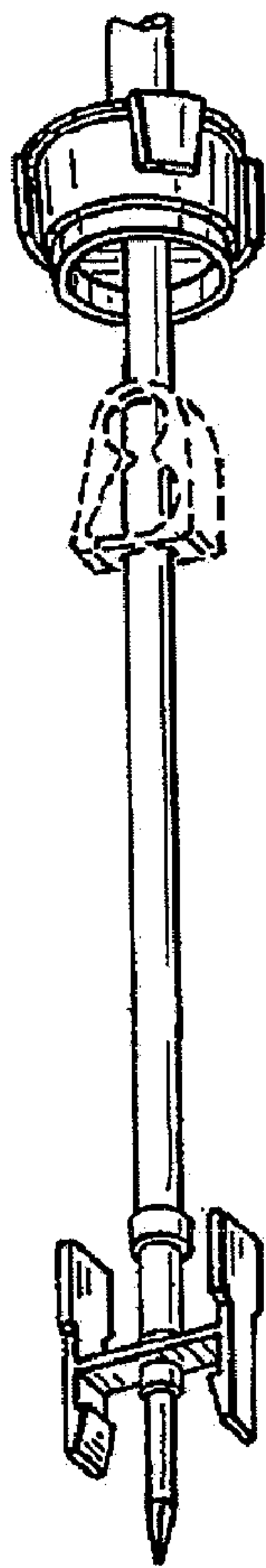

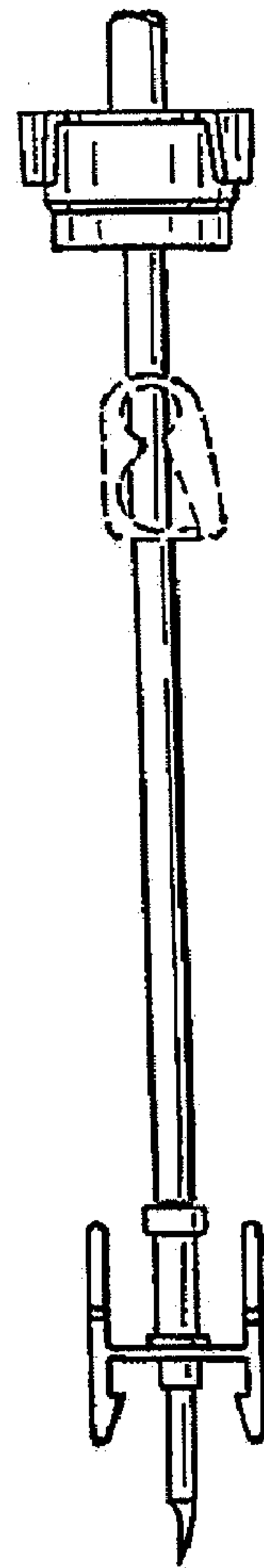
