DESCRIPTION

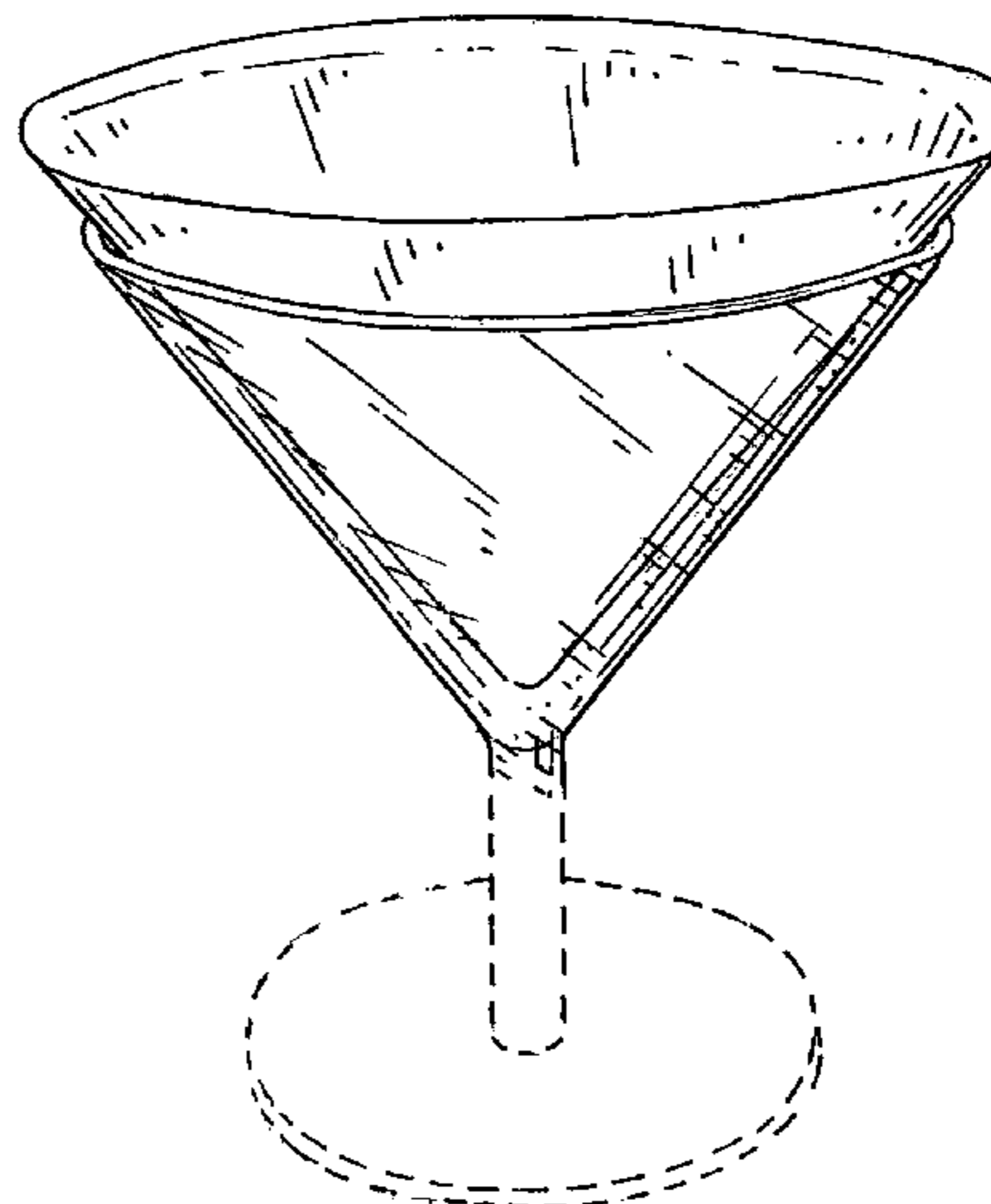
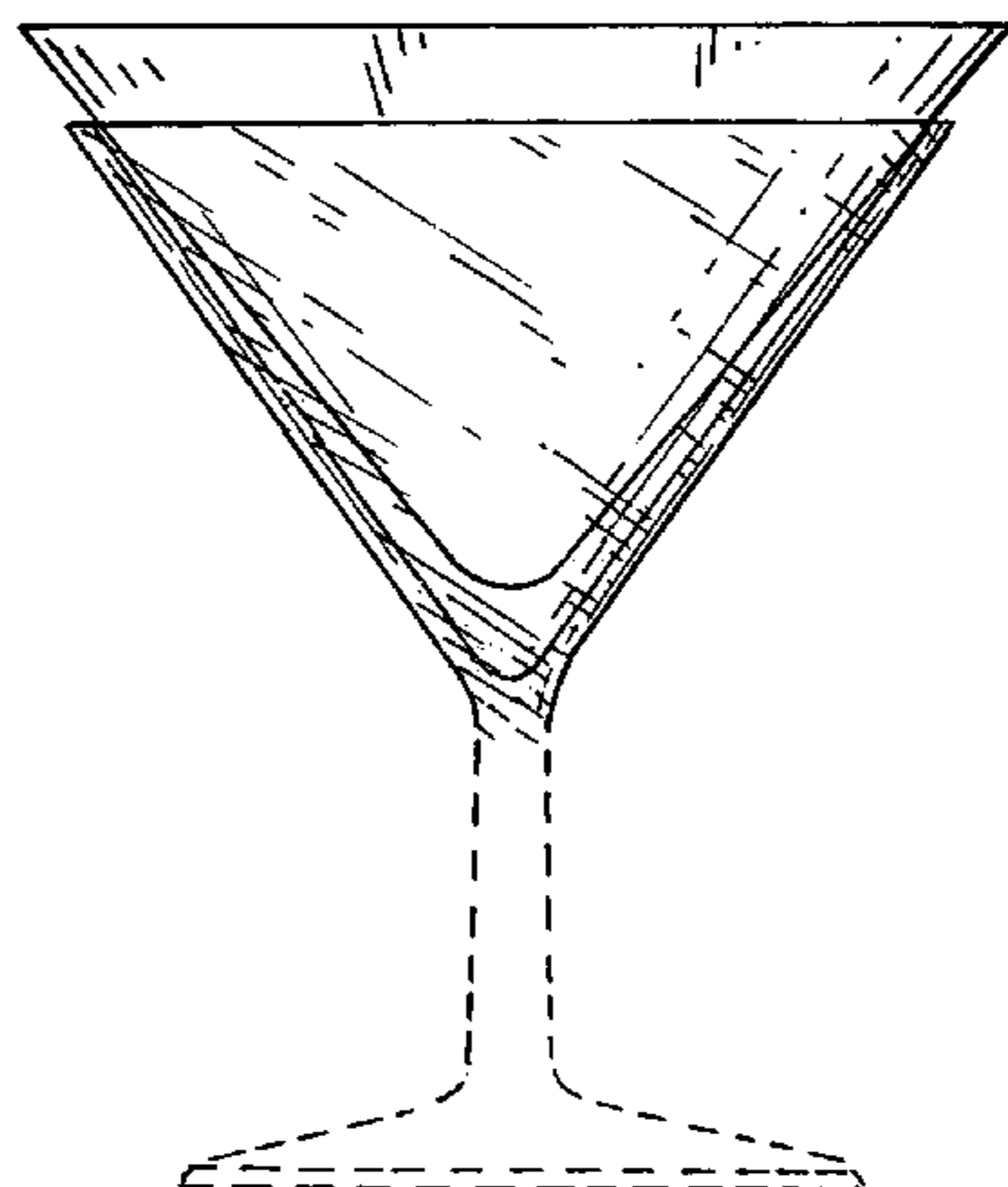
FIG. 1 is a top elevational view of an edible beverage container showing the new design;

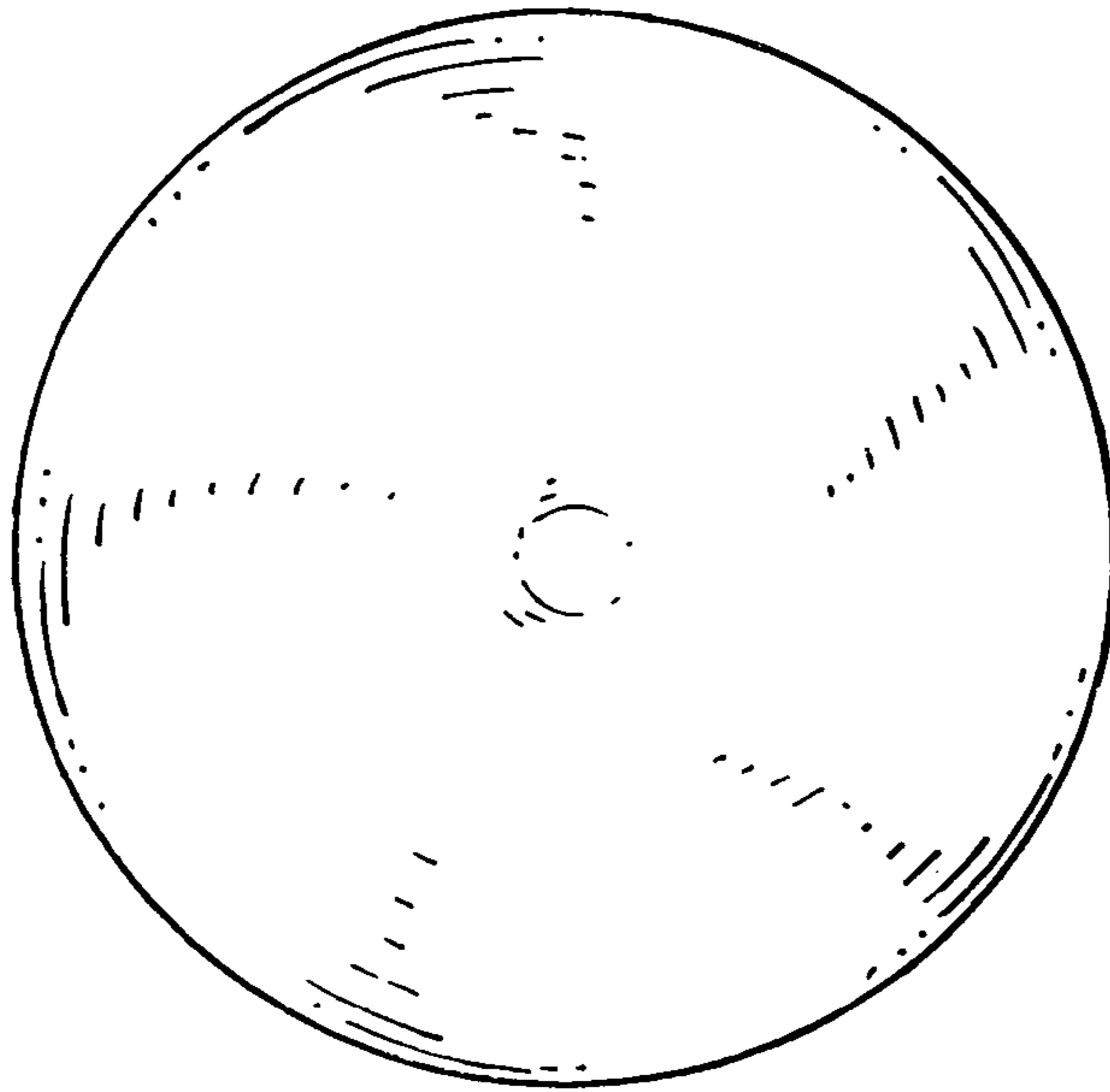

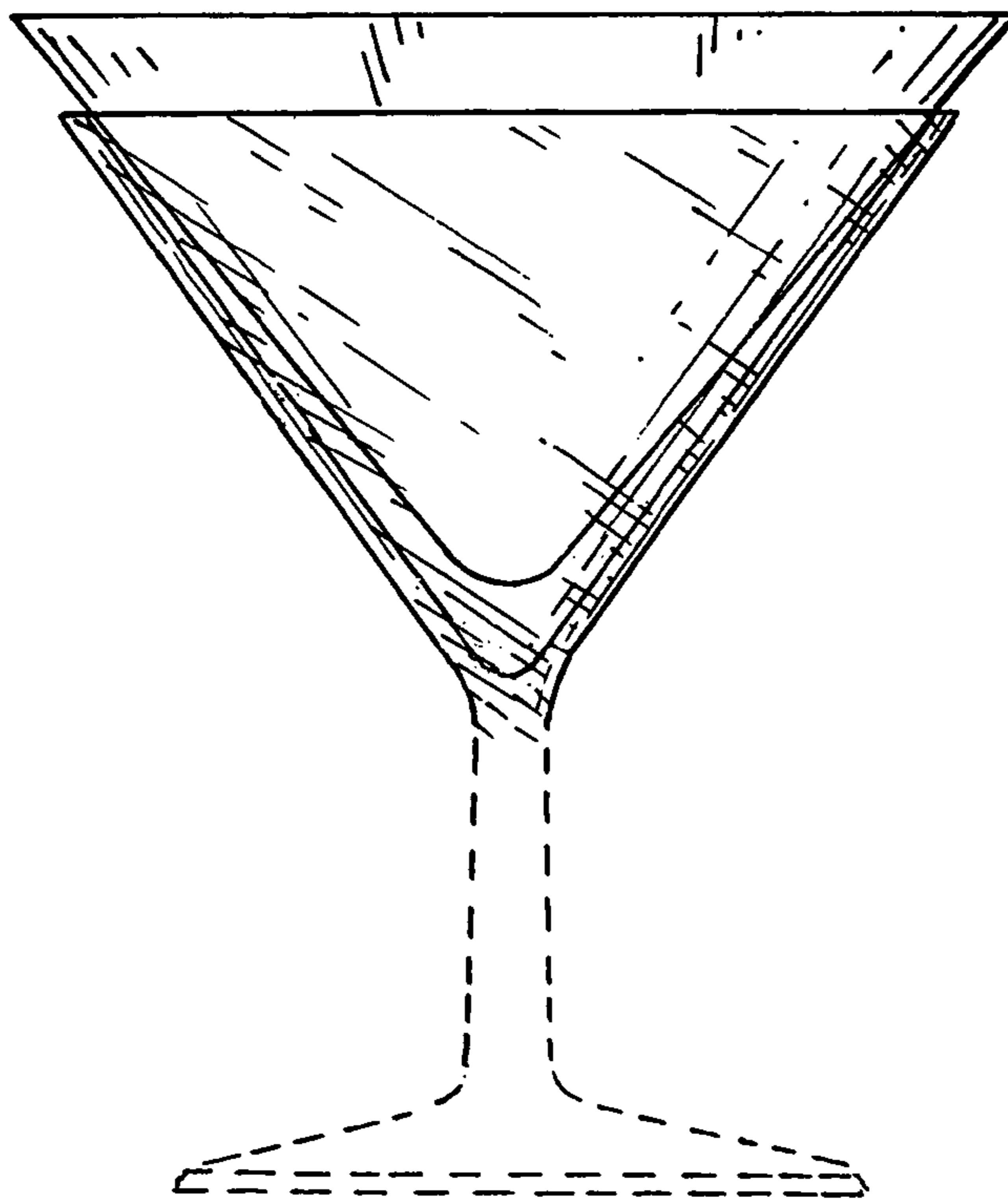

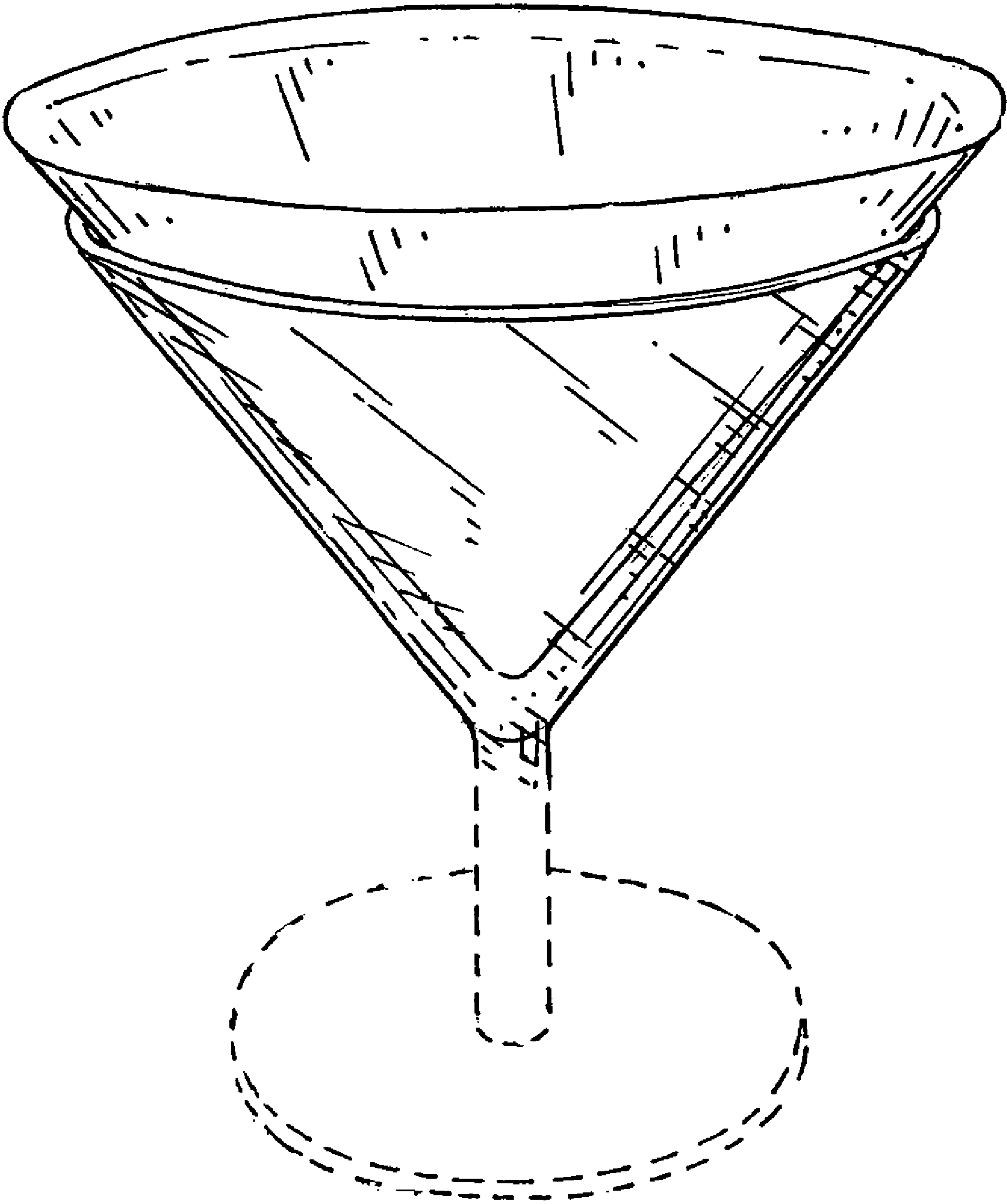
