FIG. 4 is top perspective view.

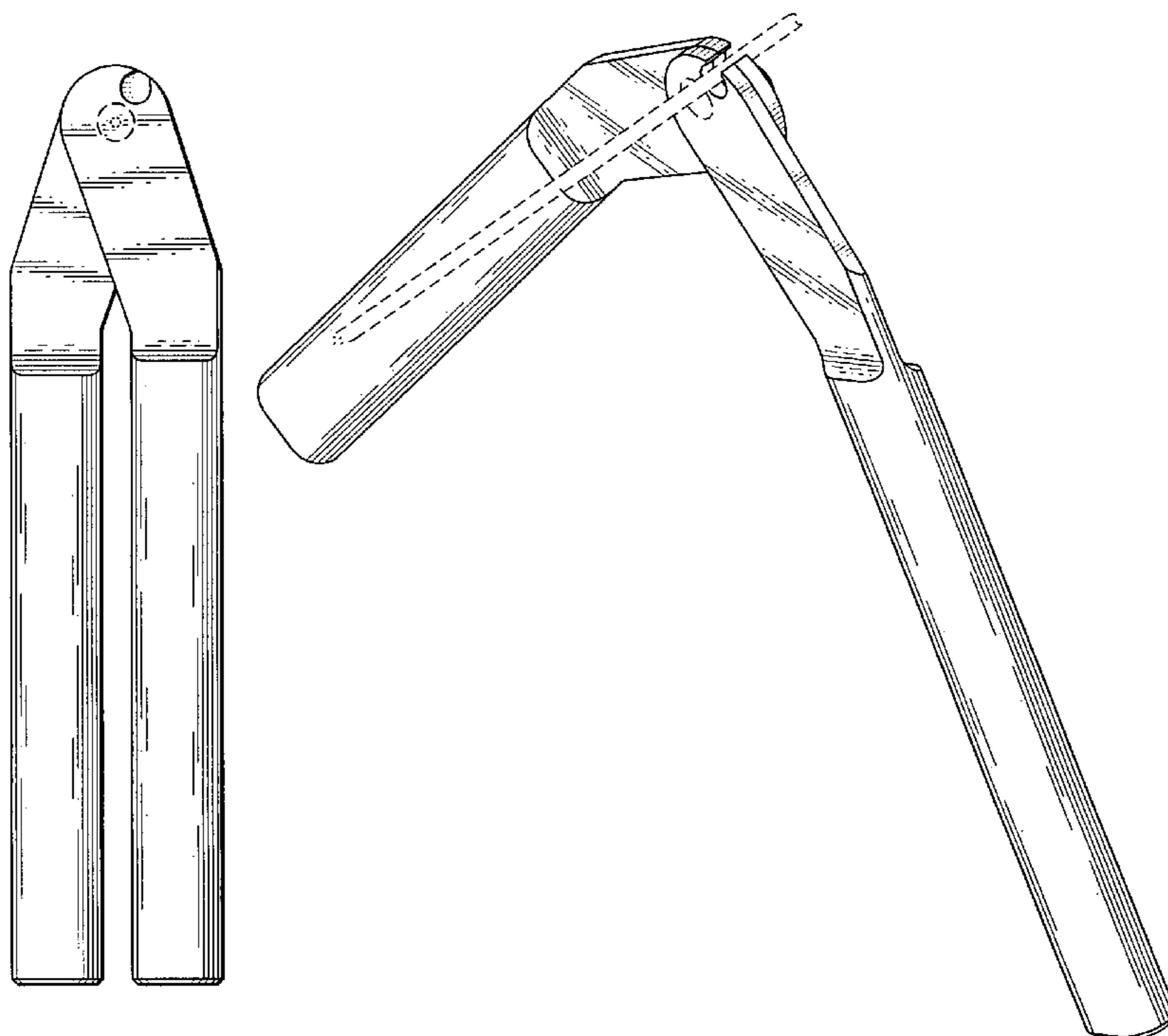
FIG. 5 is front perspective view.

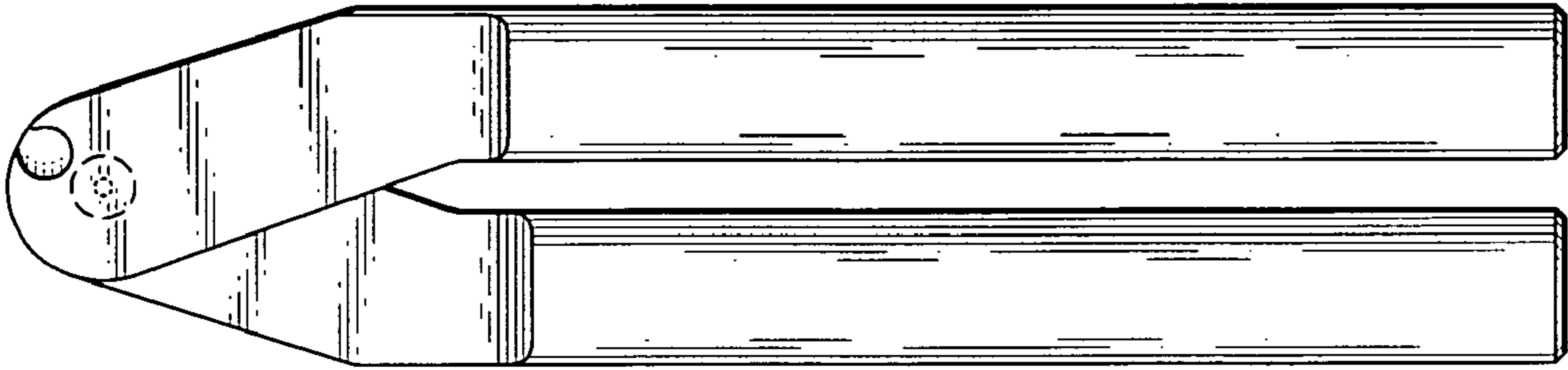

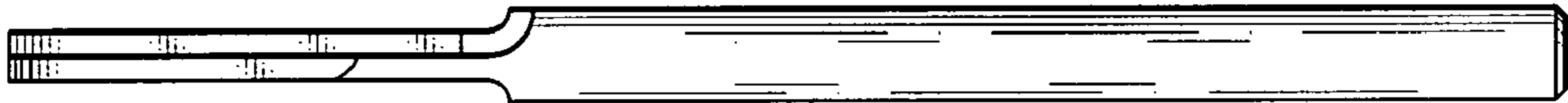

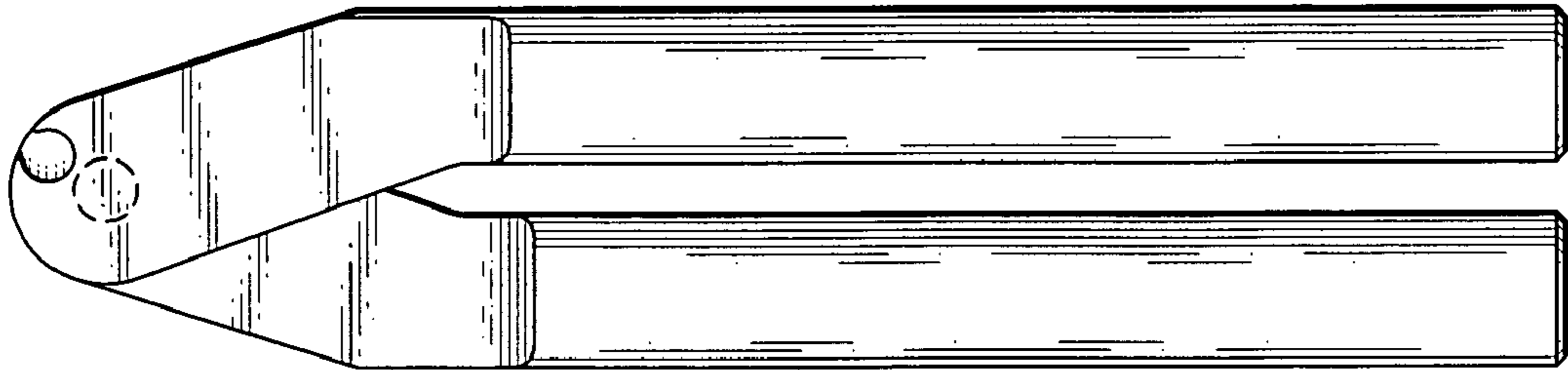

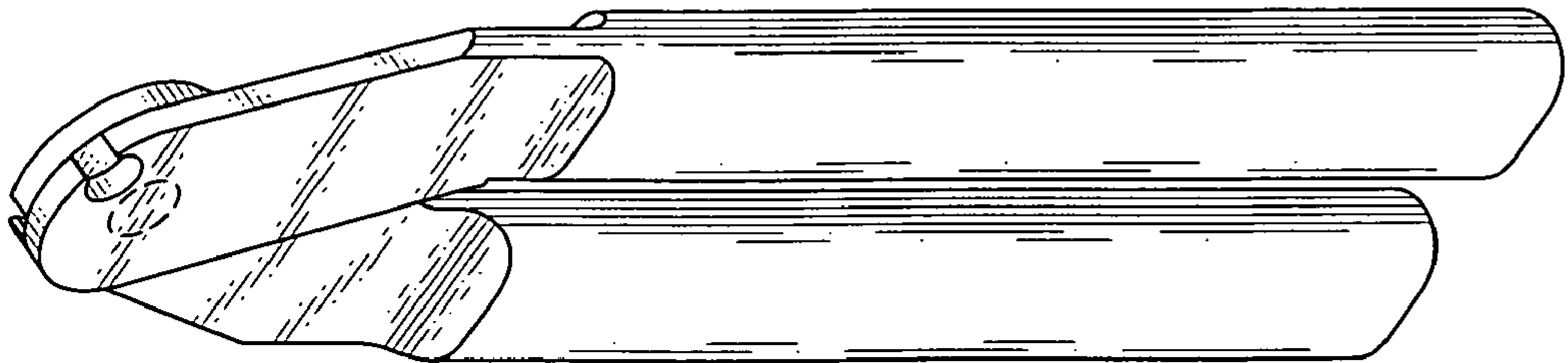

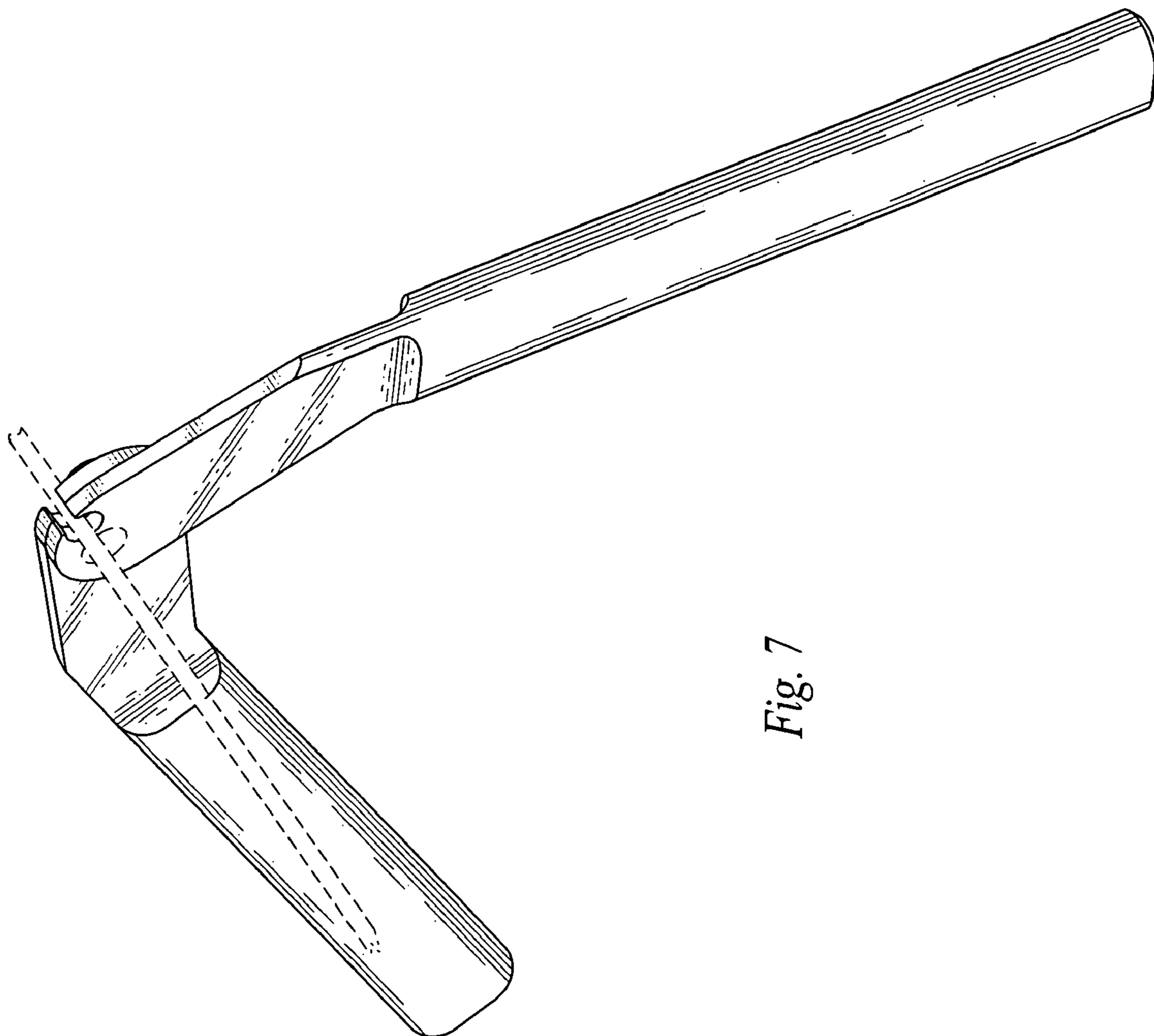

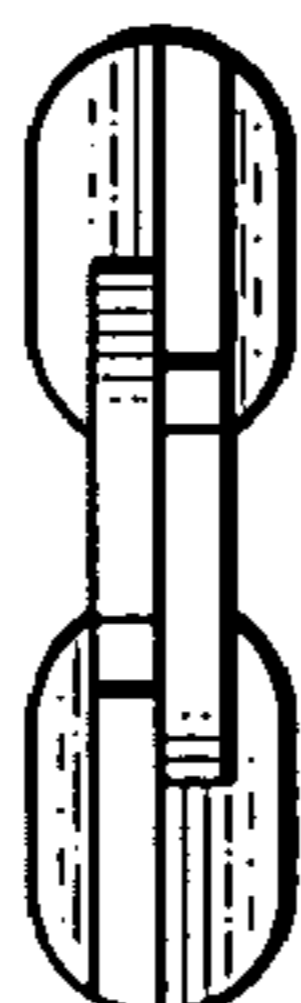

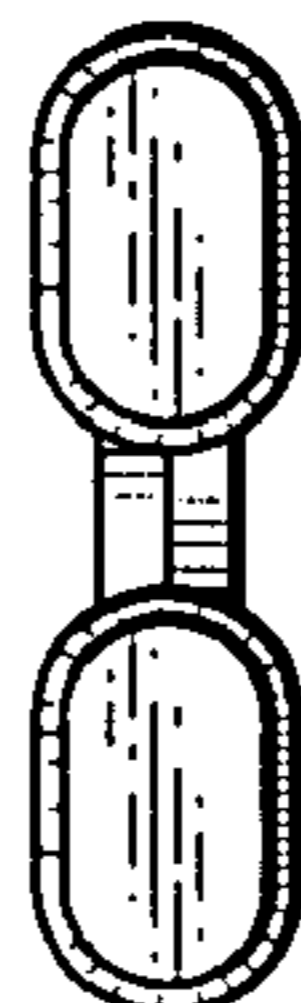
