What is claimed is the ornamental design for a vehicle mounted tailgate party tent, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a vehicle mounted tailgate party tent, showing the new design;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

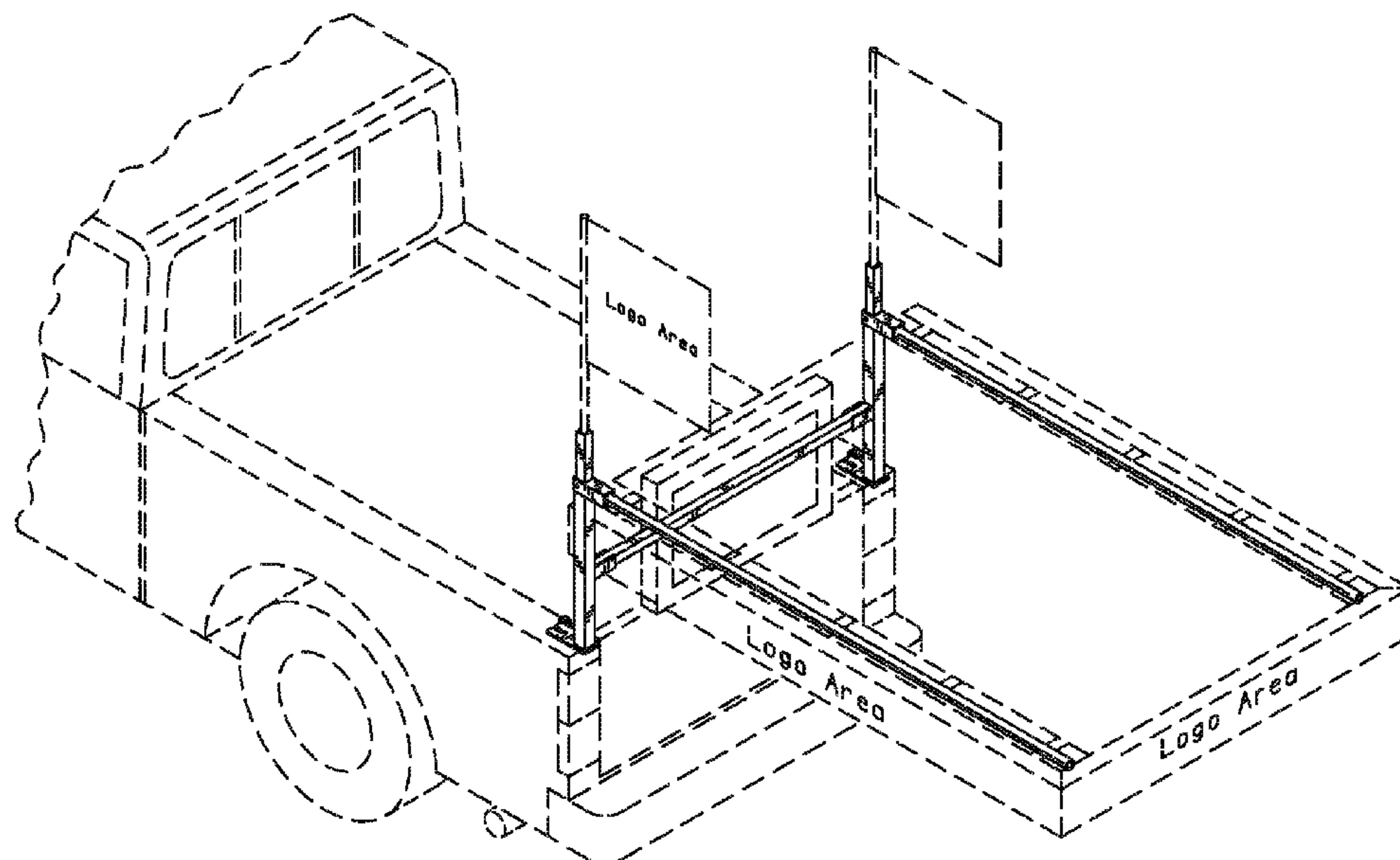
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

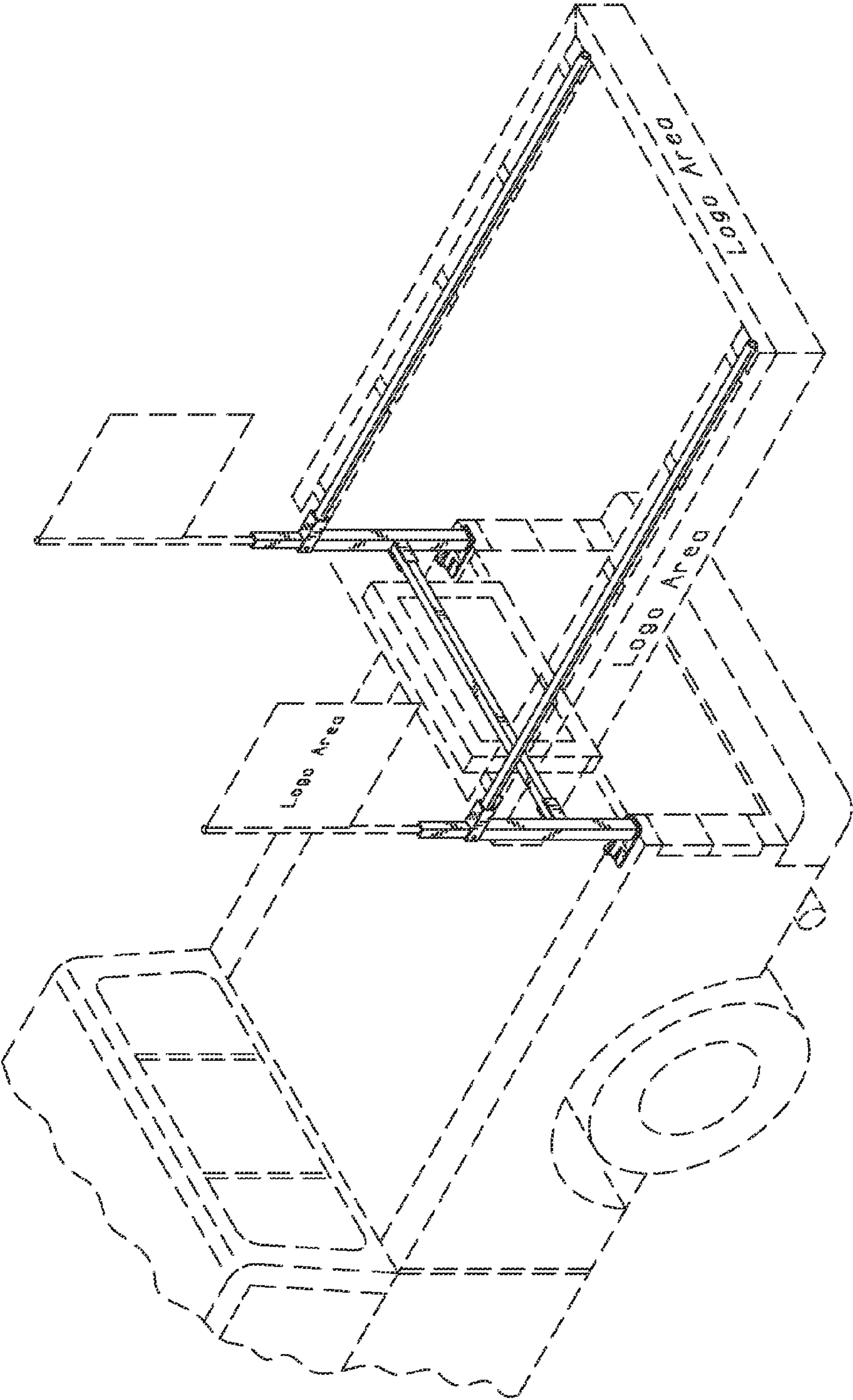
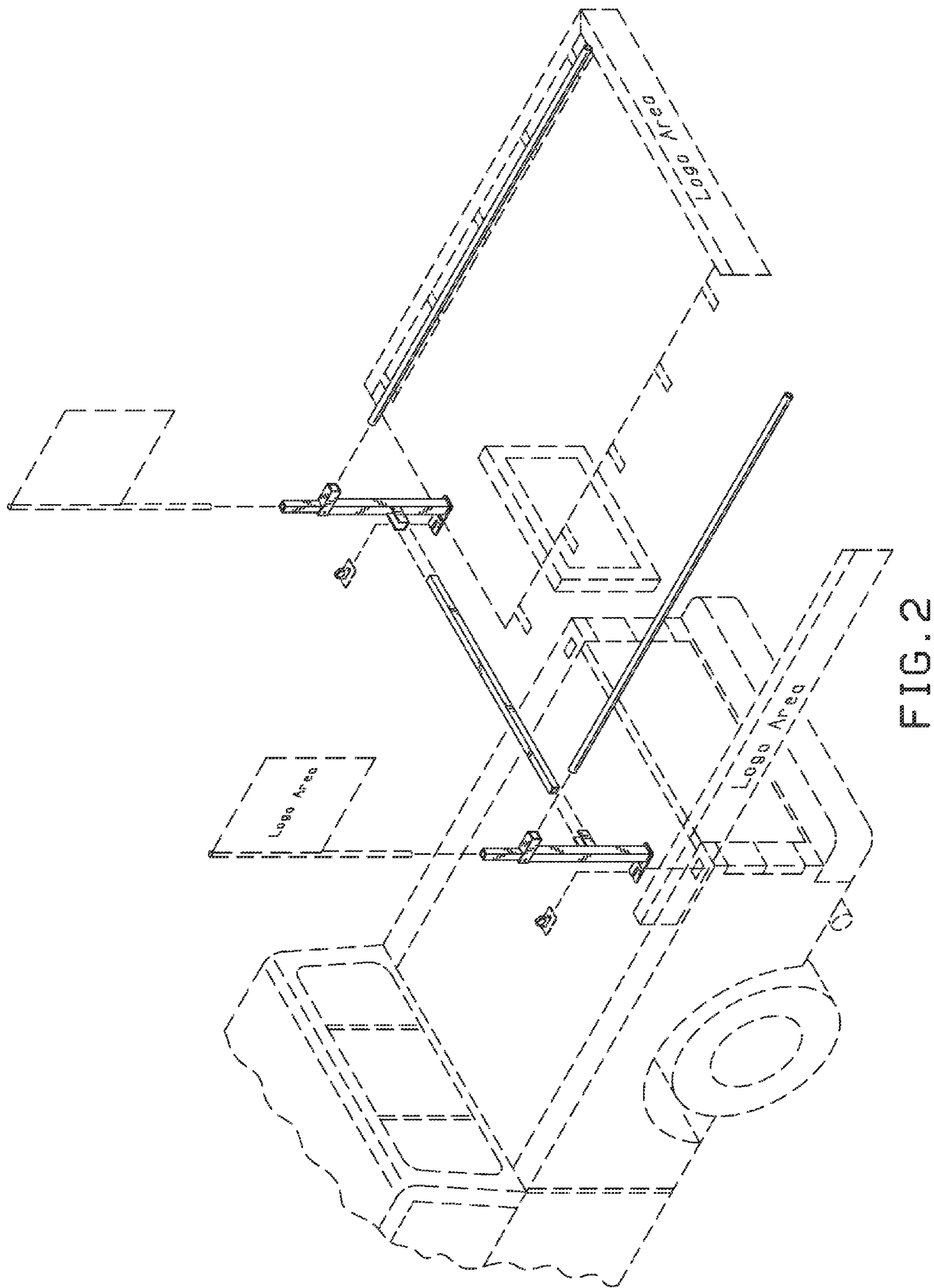

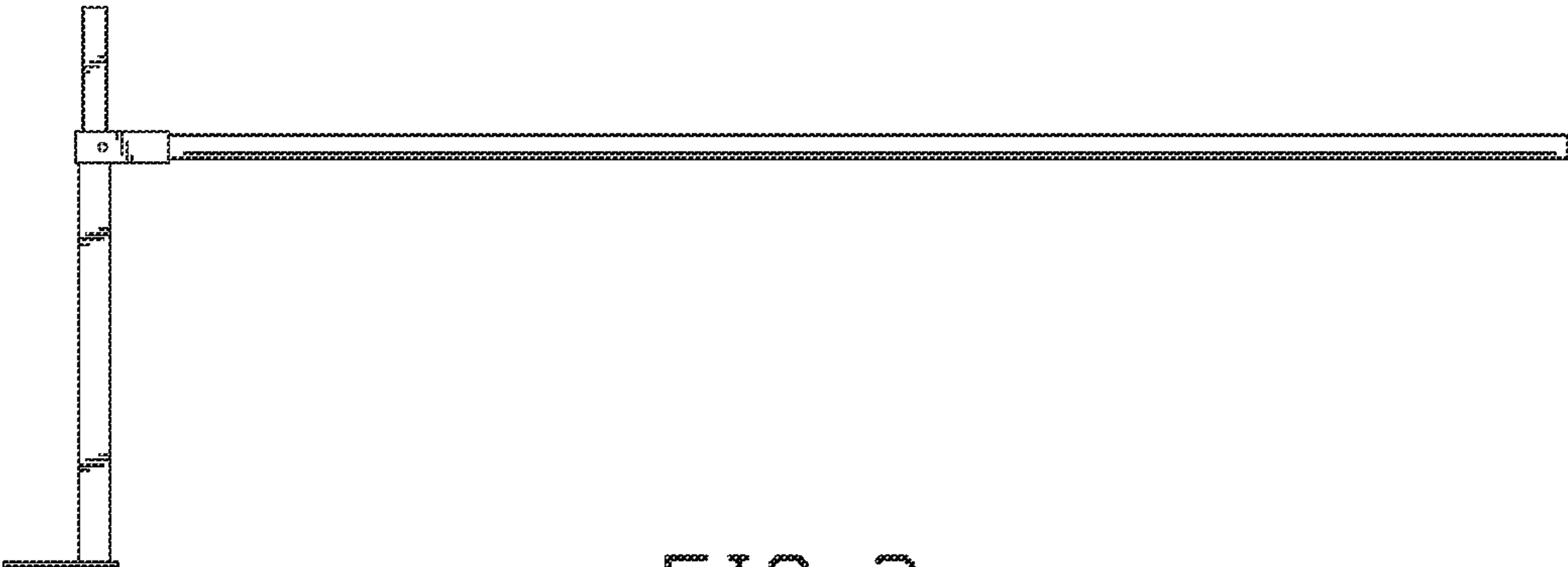

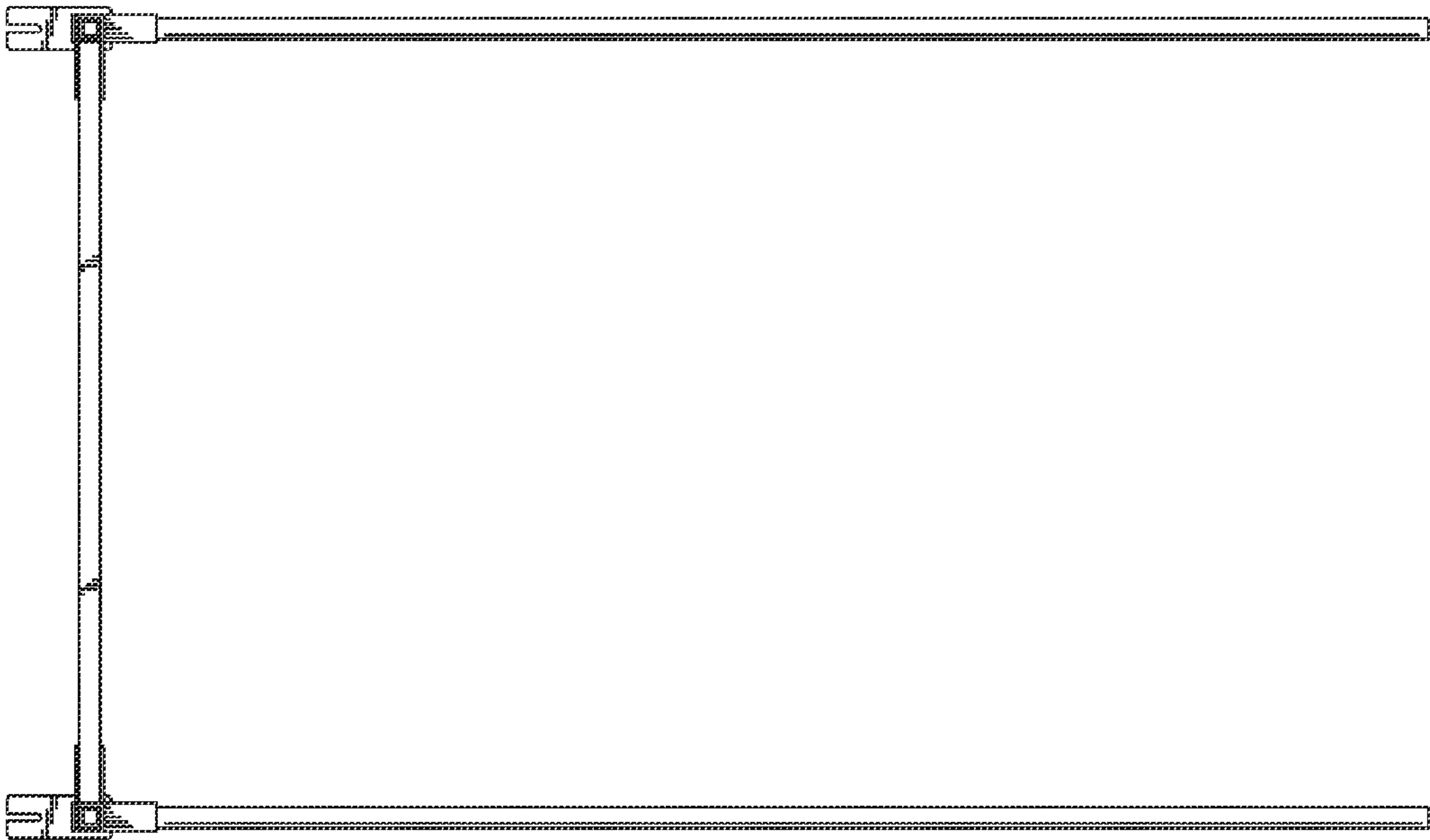

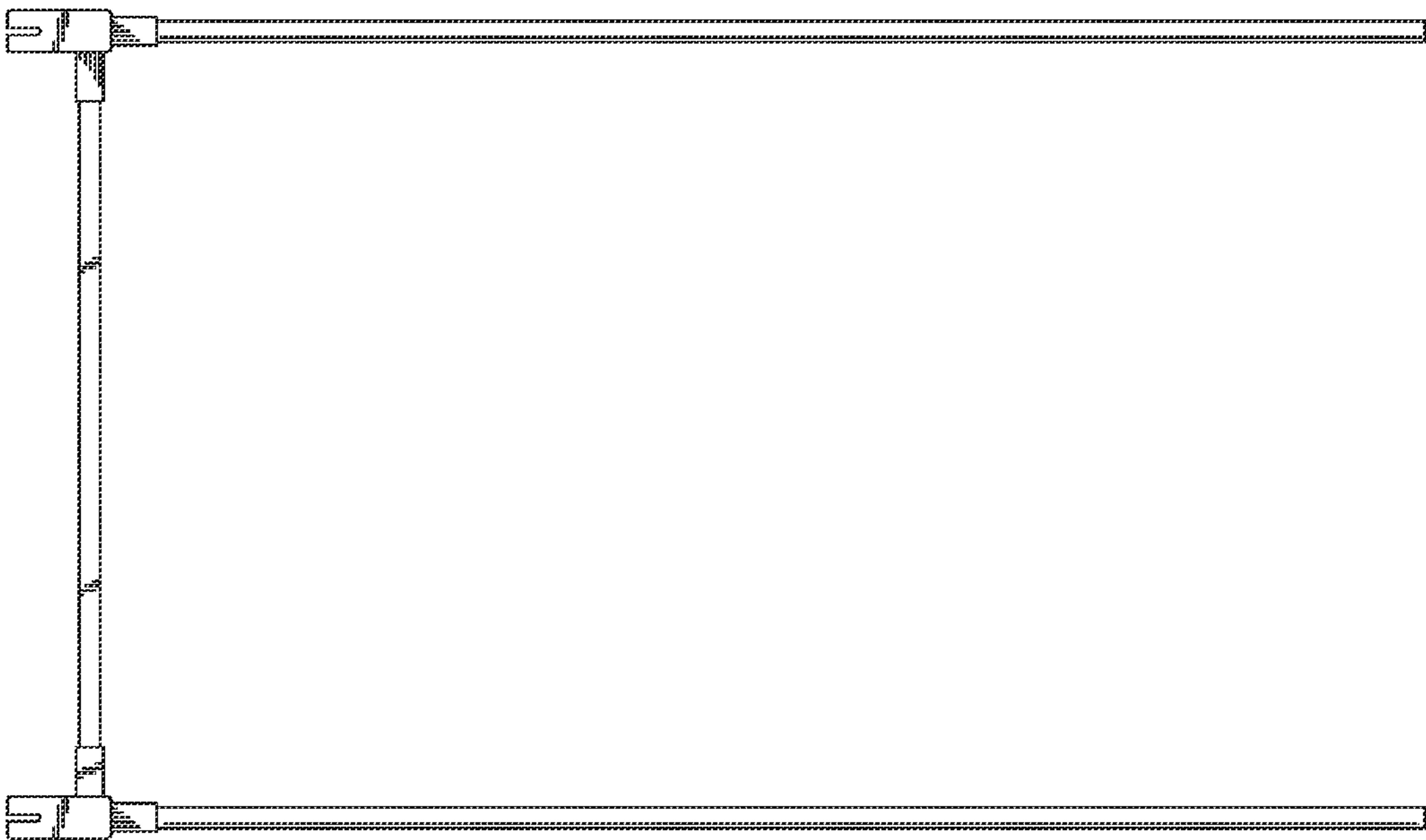
