FIG. 4 is a first side thereof;

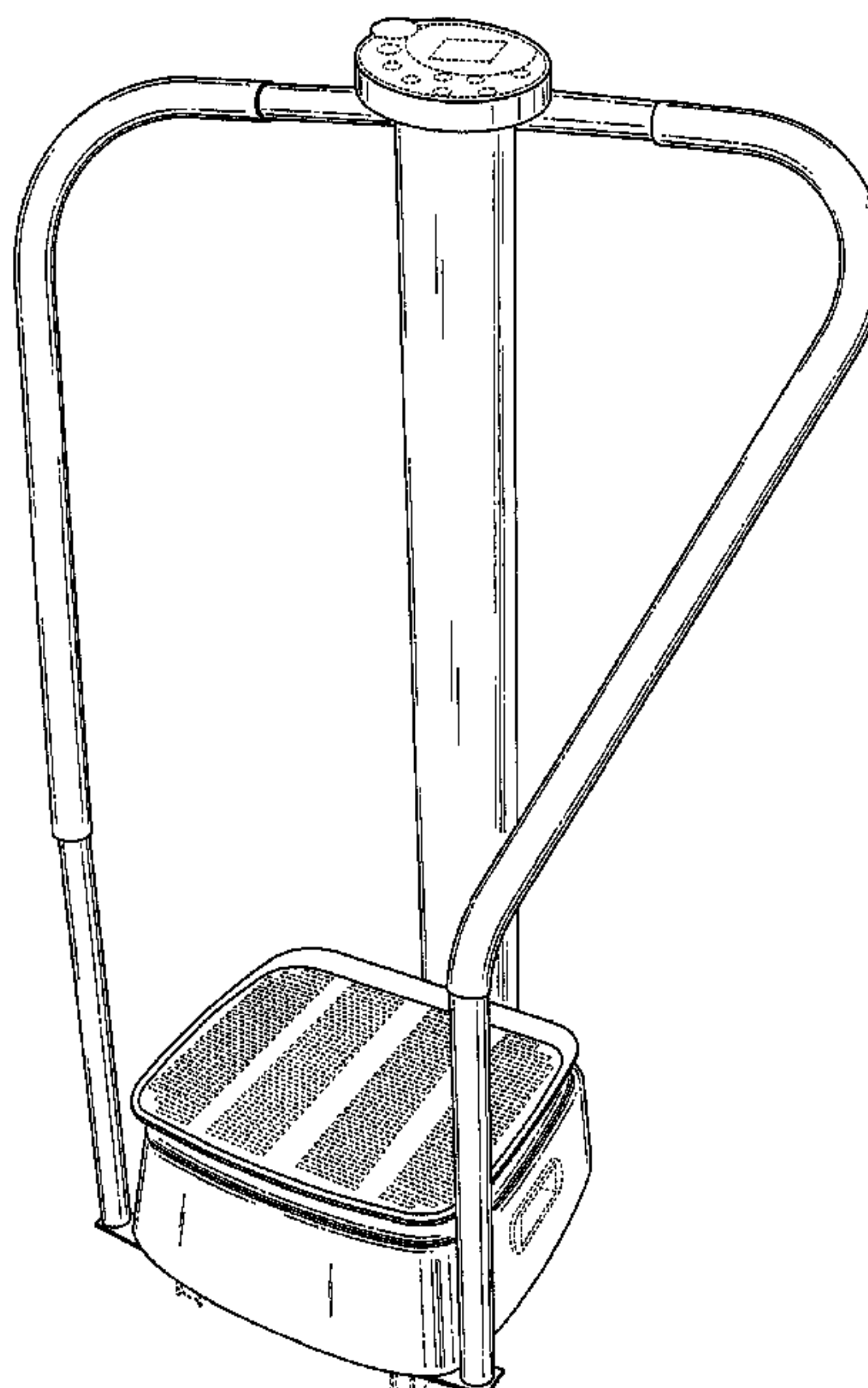
FIG. 5 is a second side thereof;

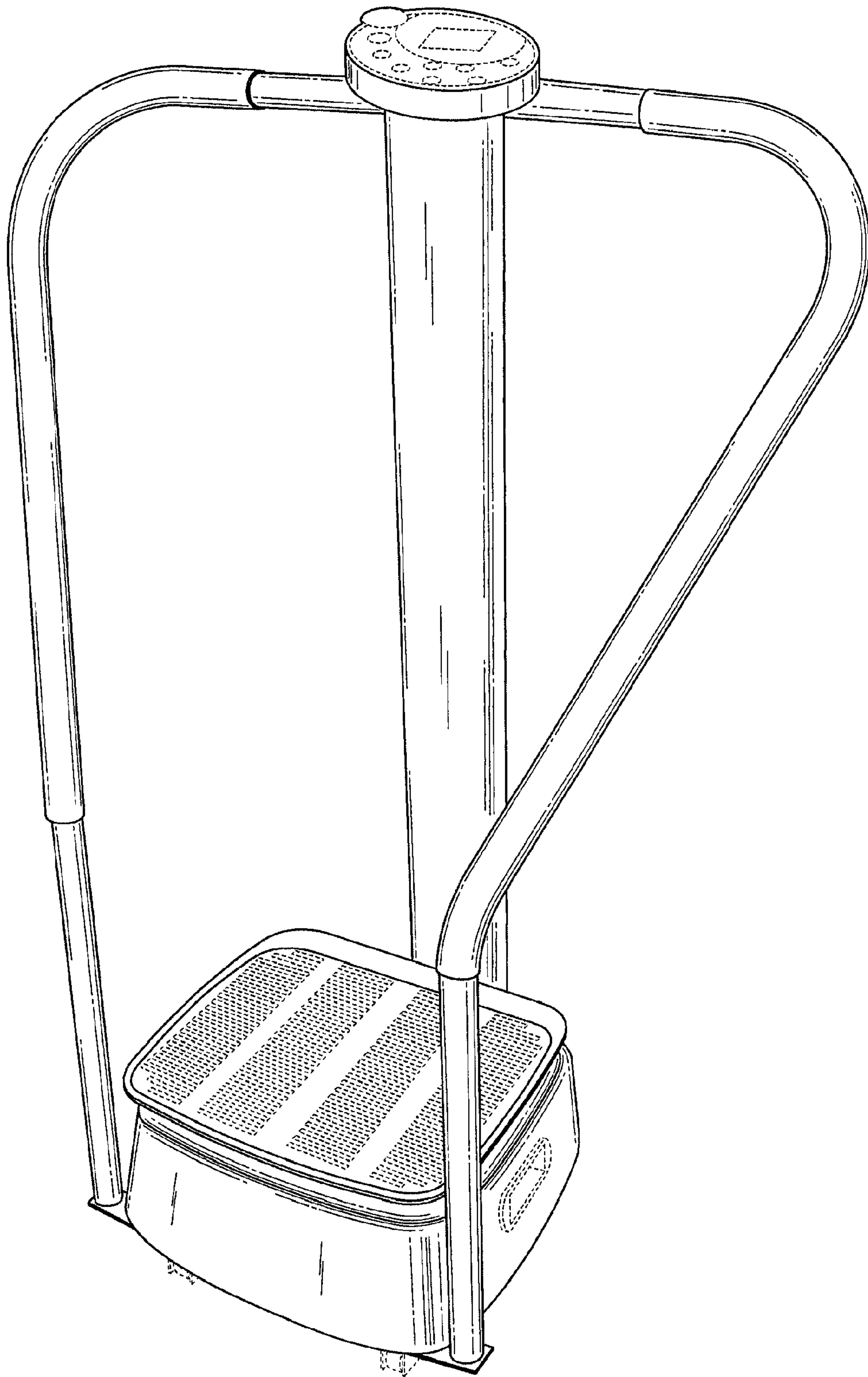

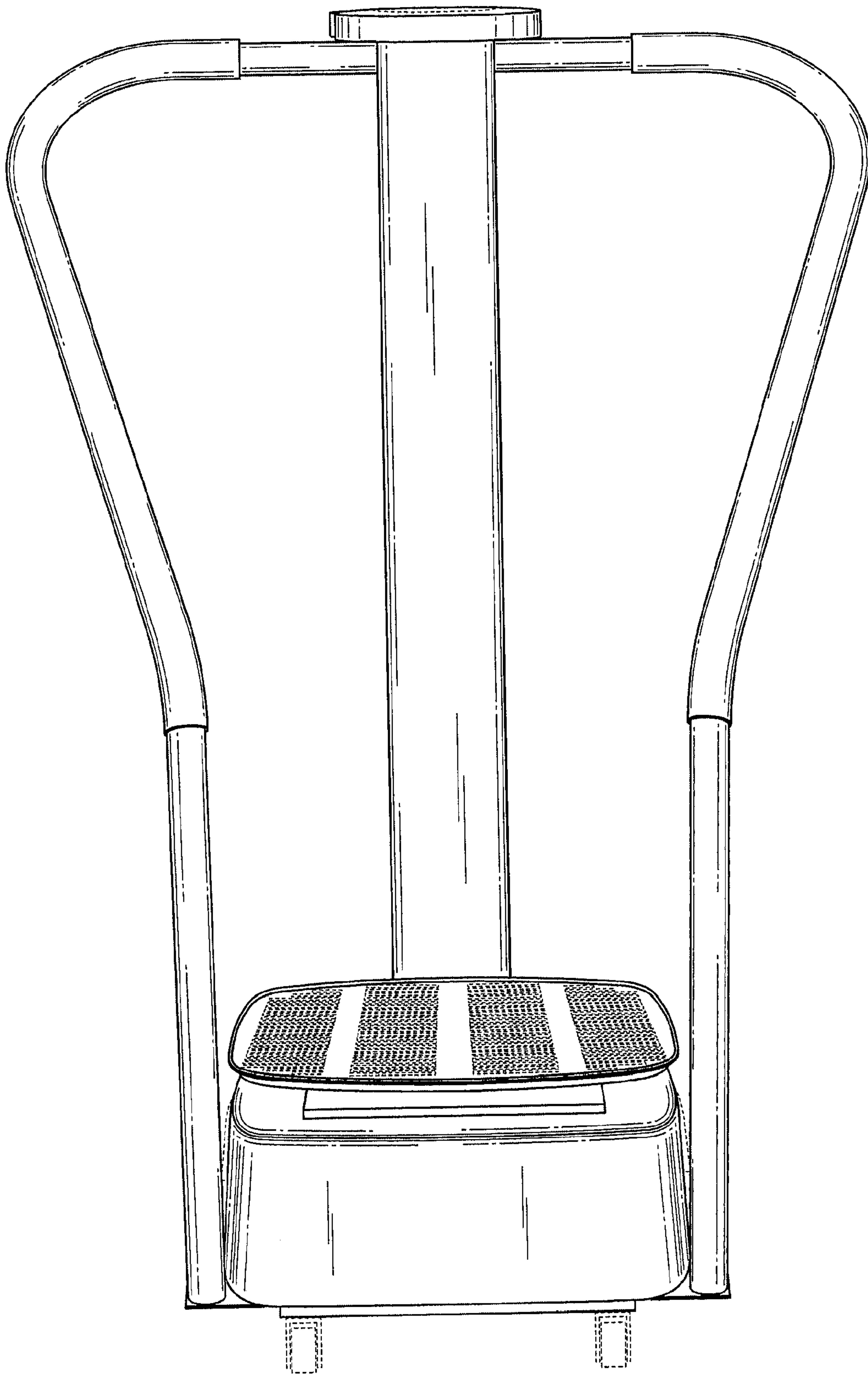

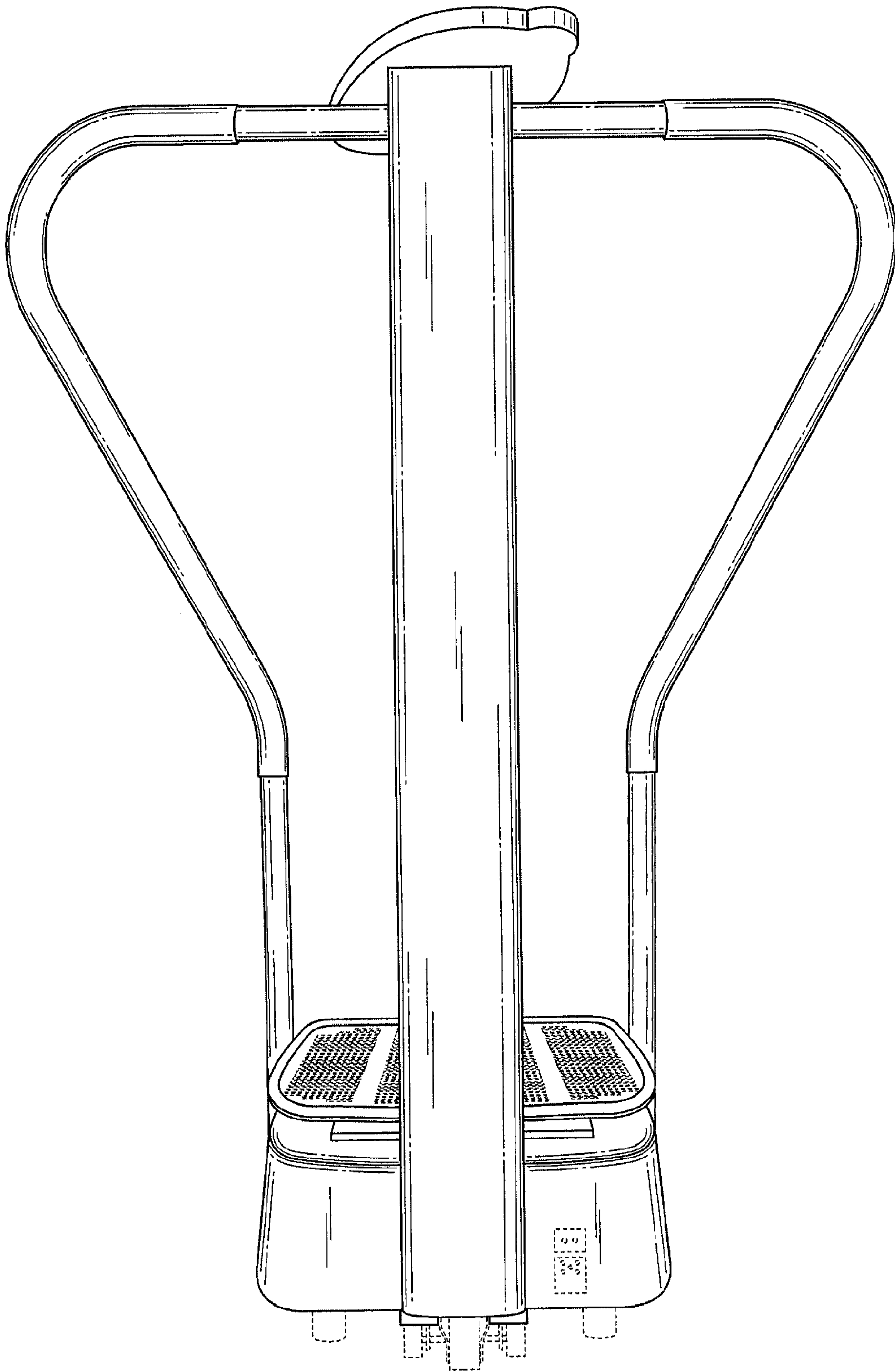

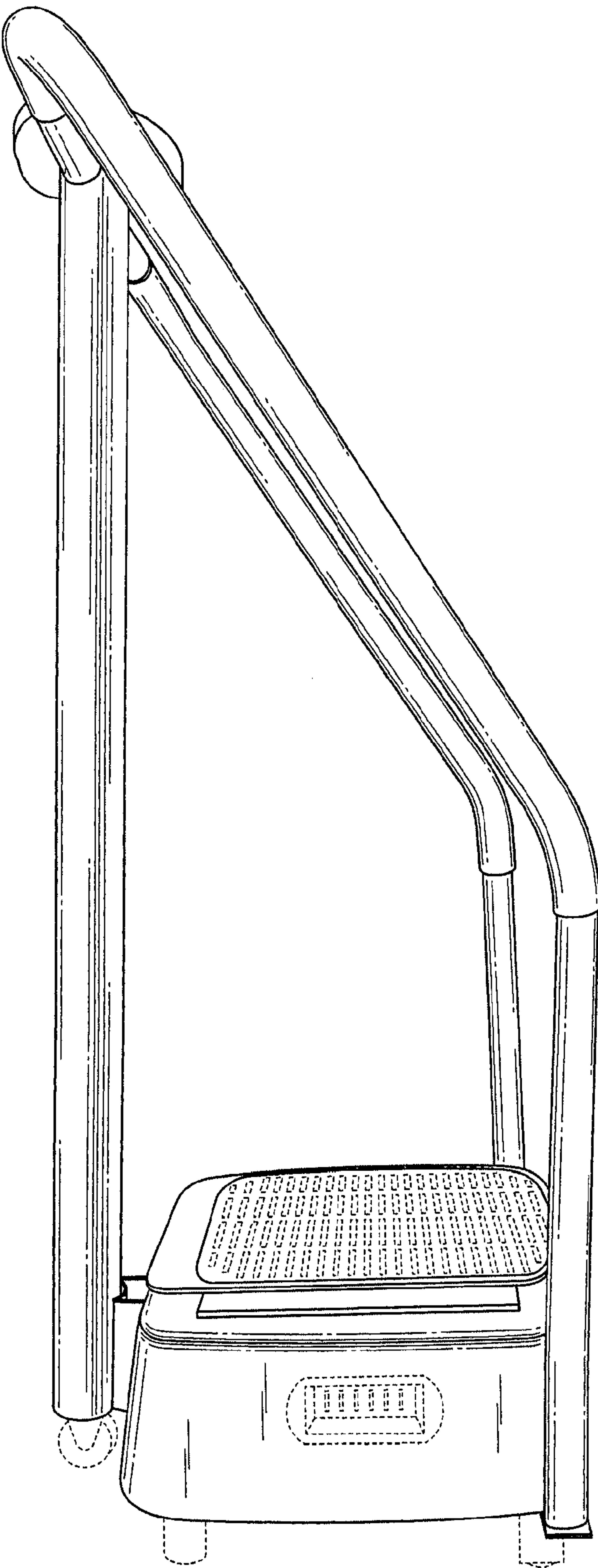

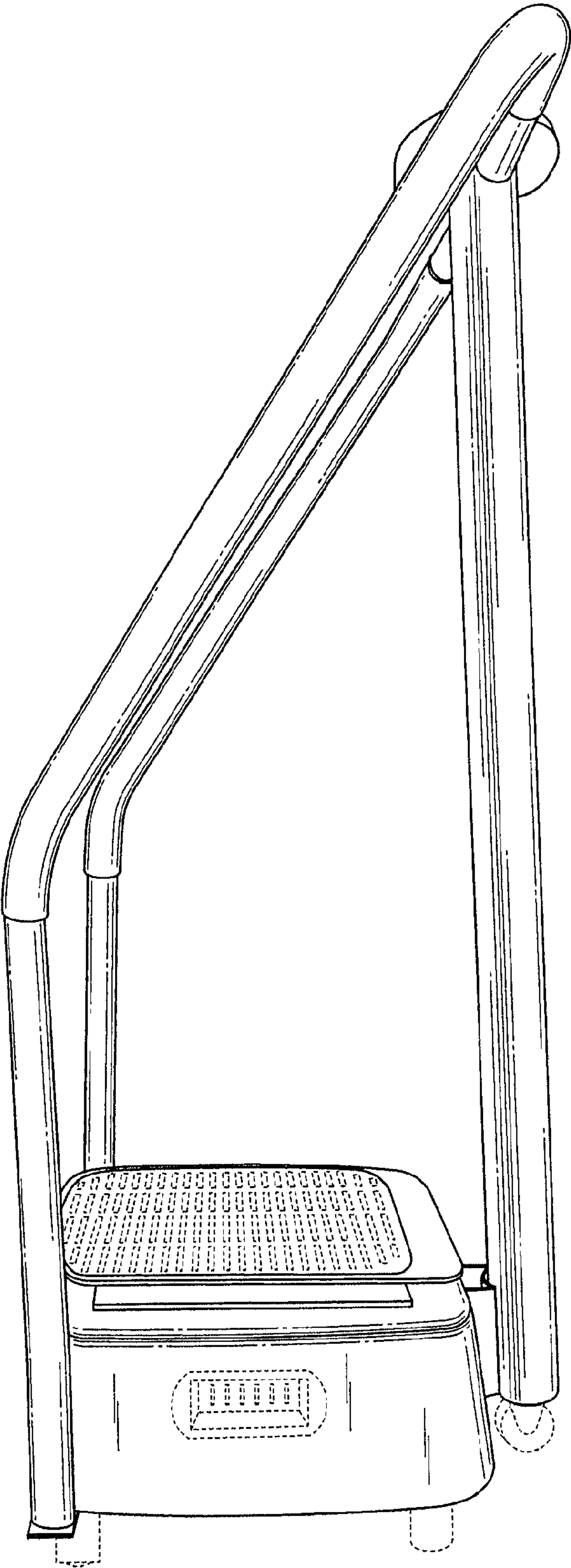

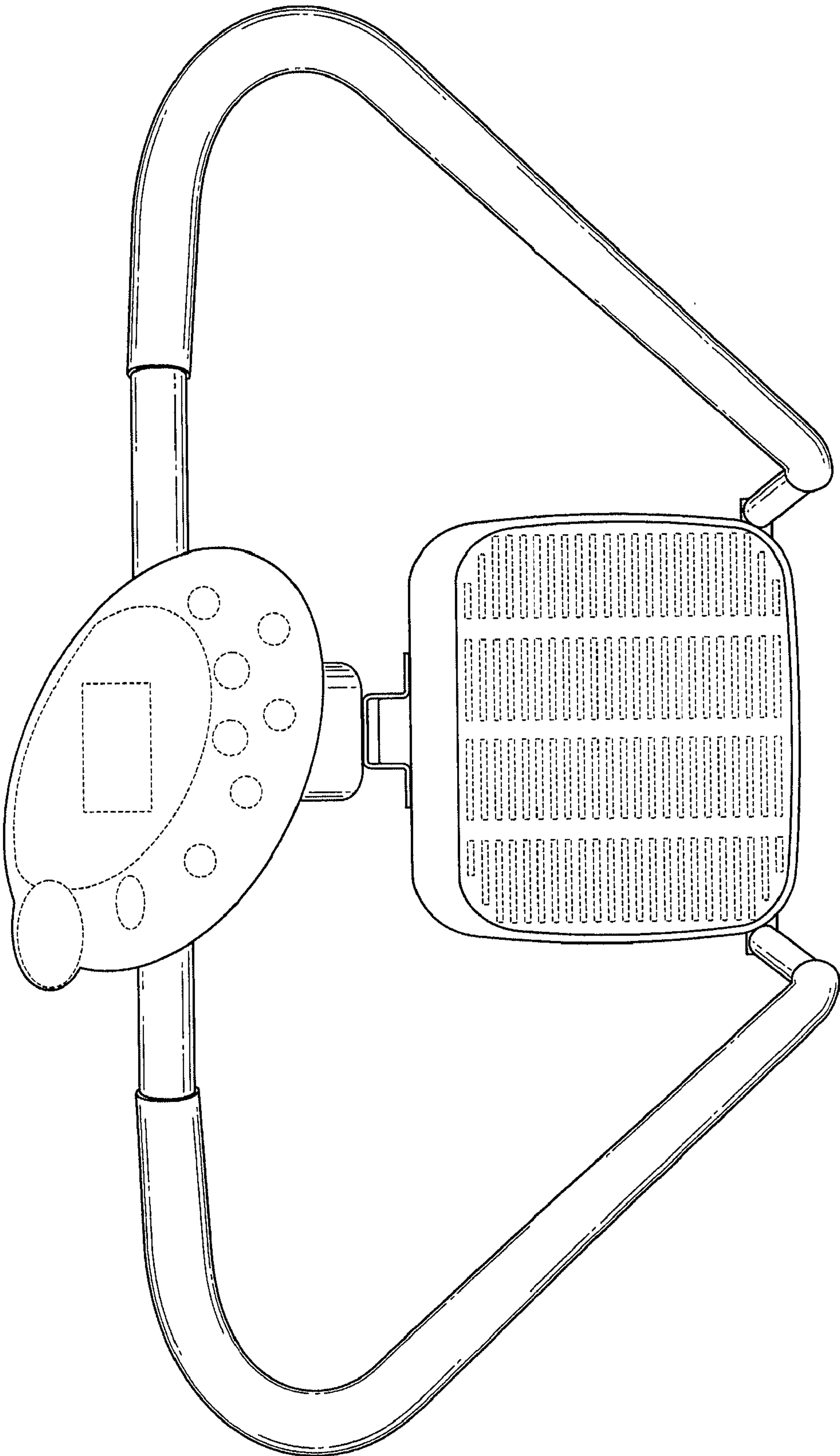

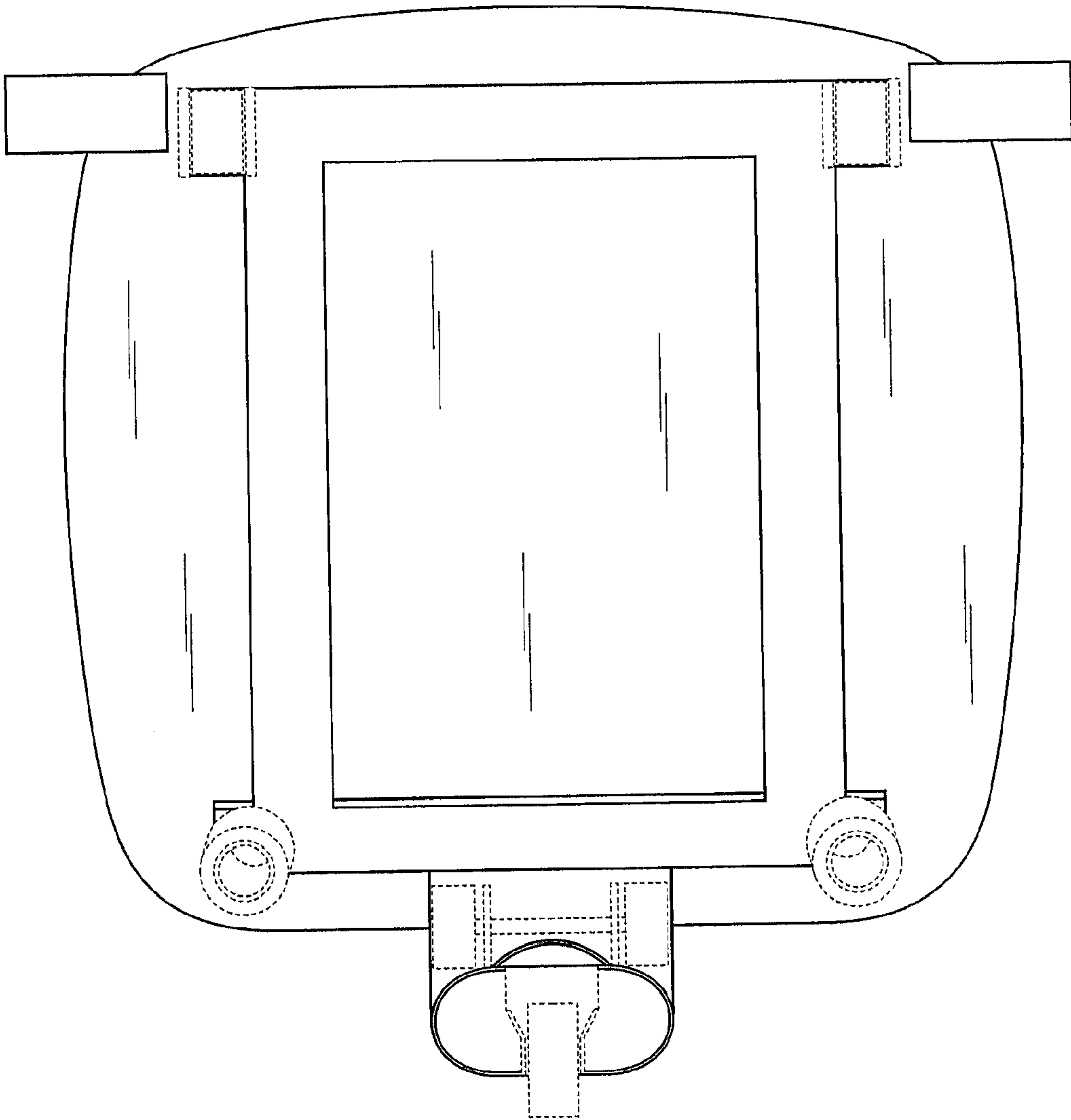
