invention.

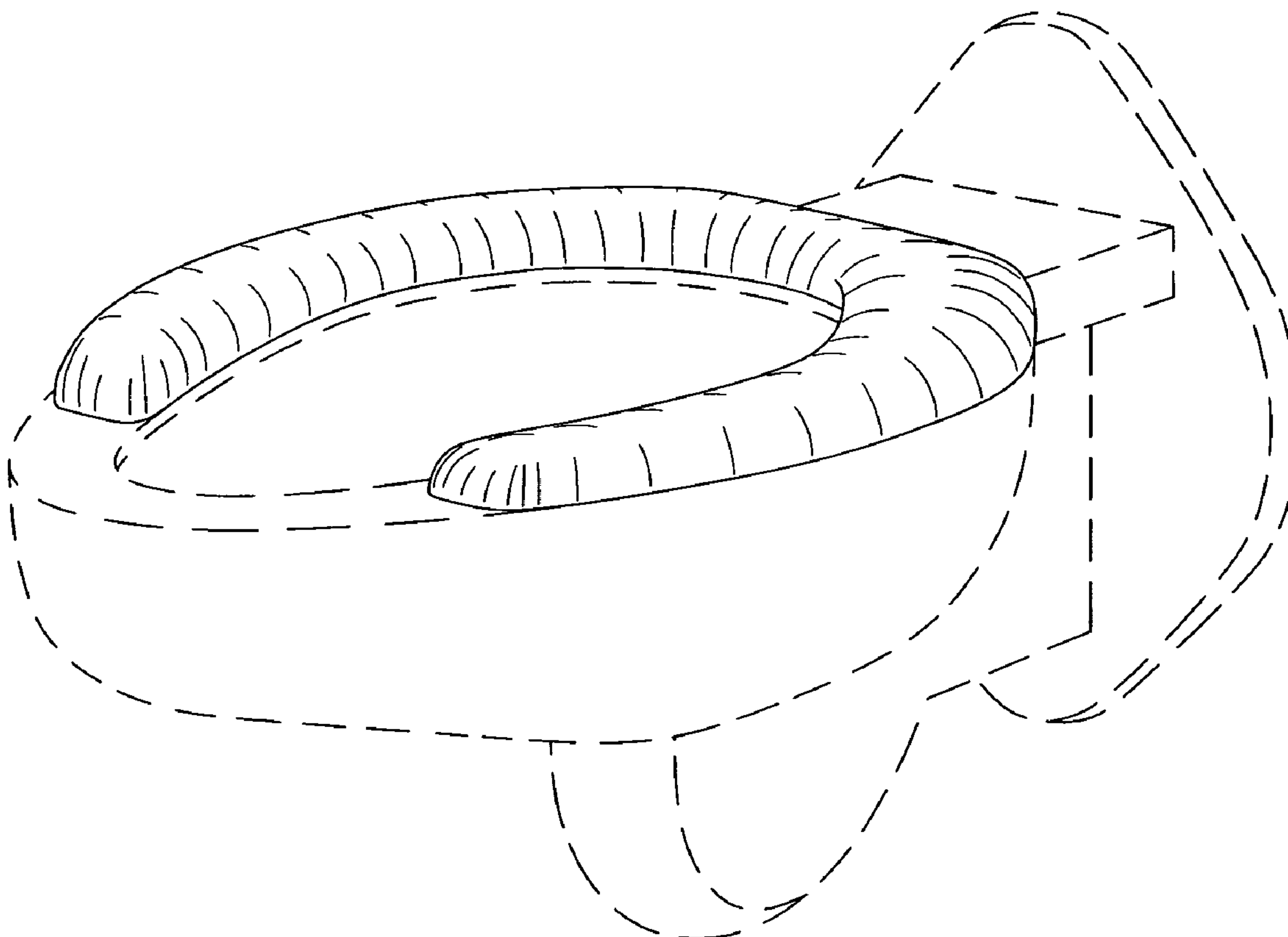
FIG. 5 is a front view of the toilet seat cover of the present

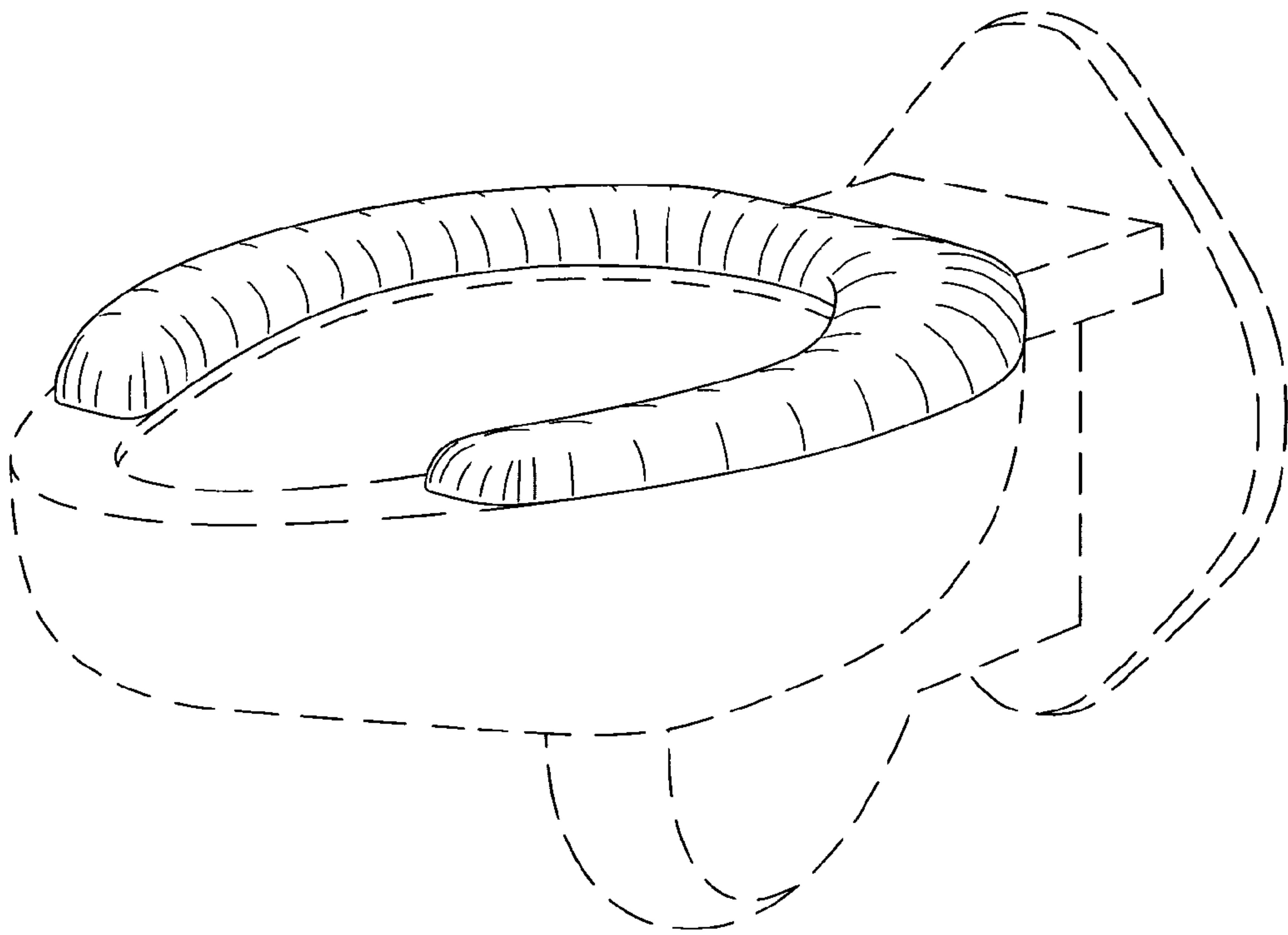

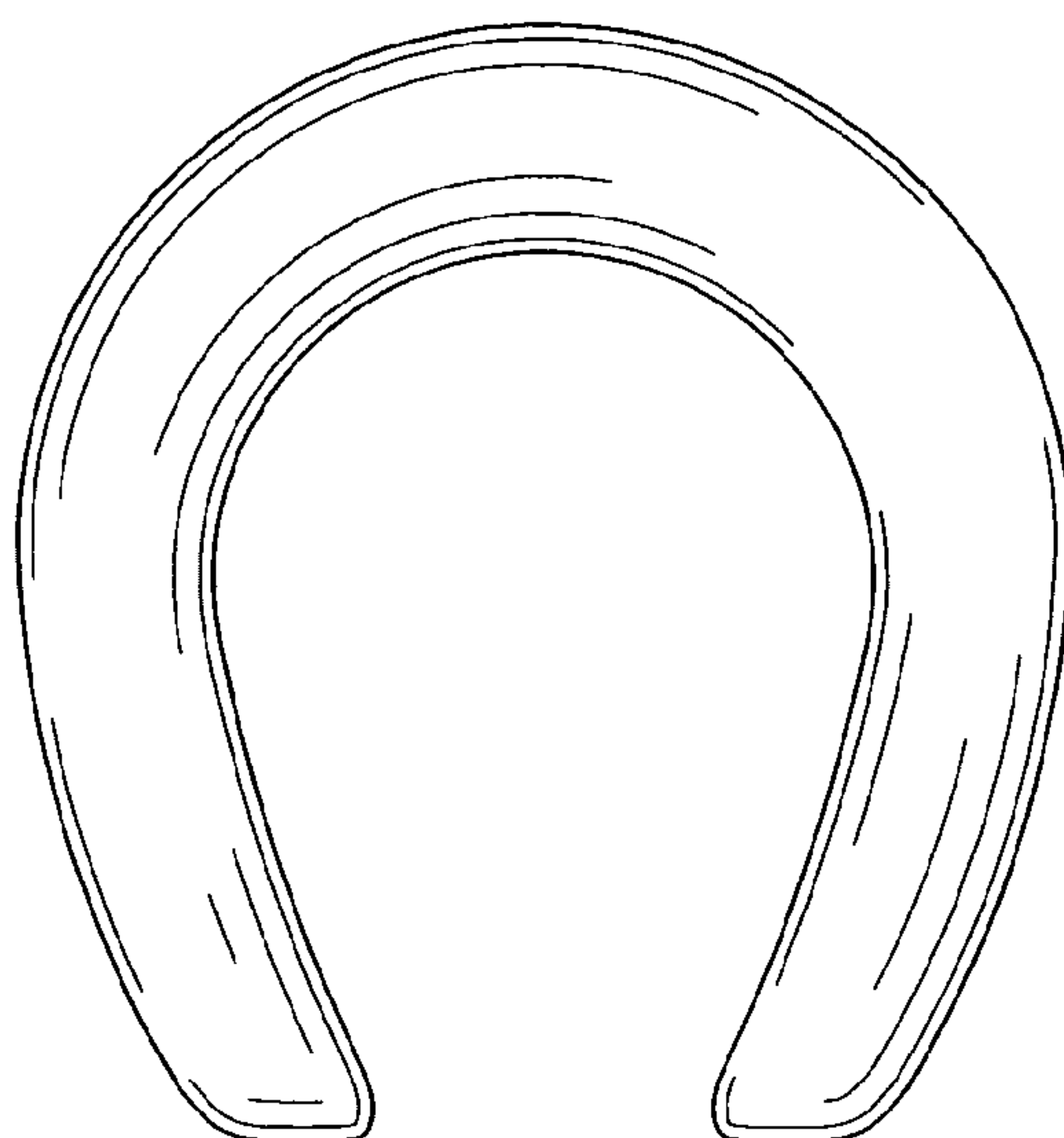

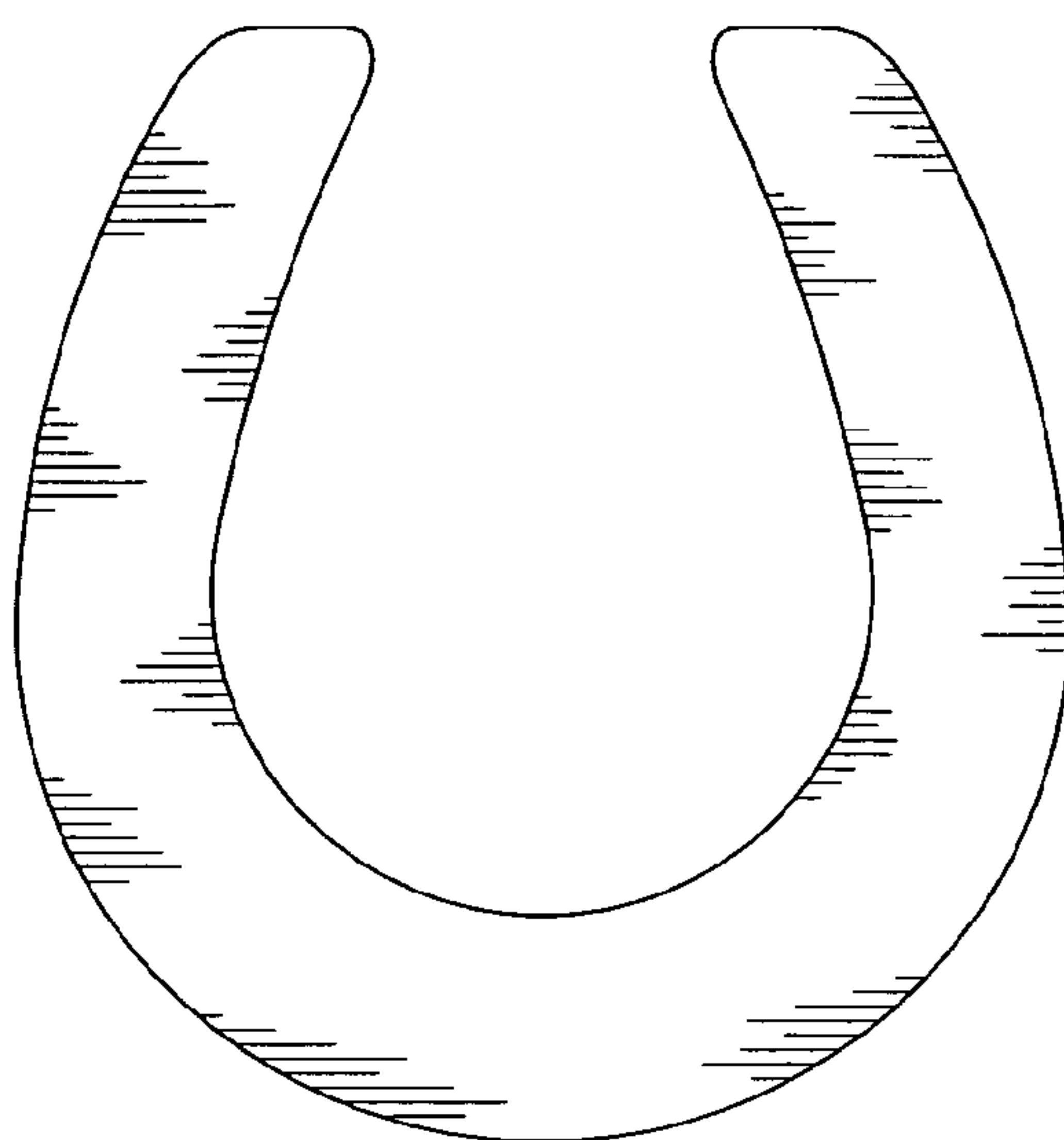

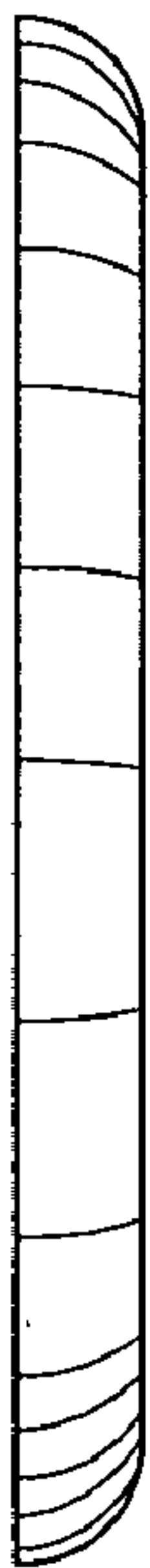

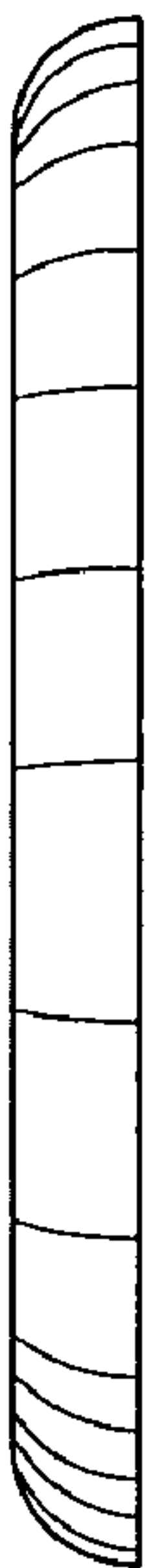
