of FIG. 1;

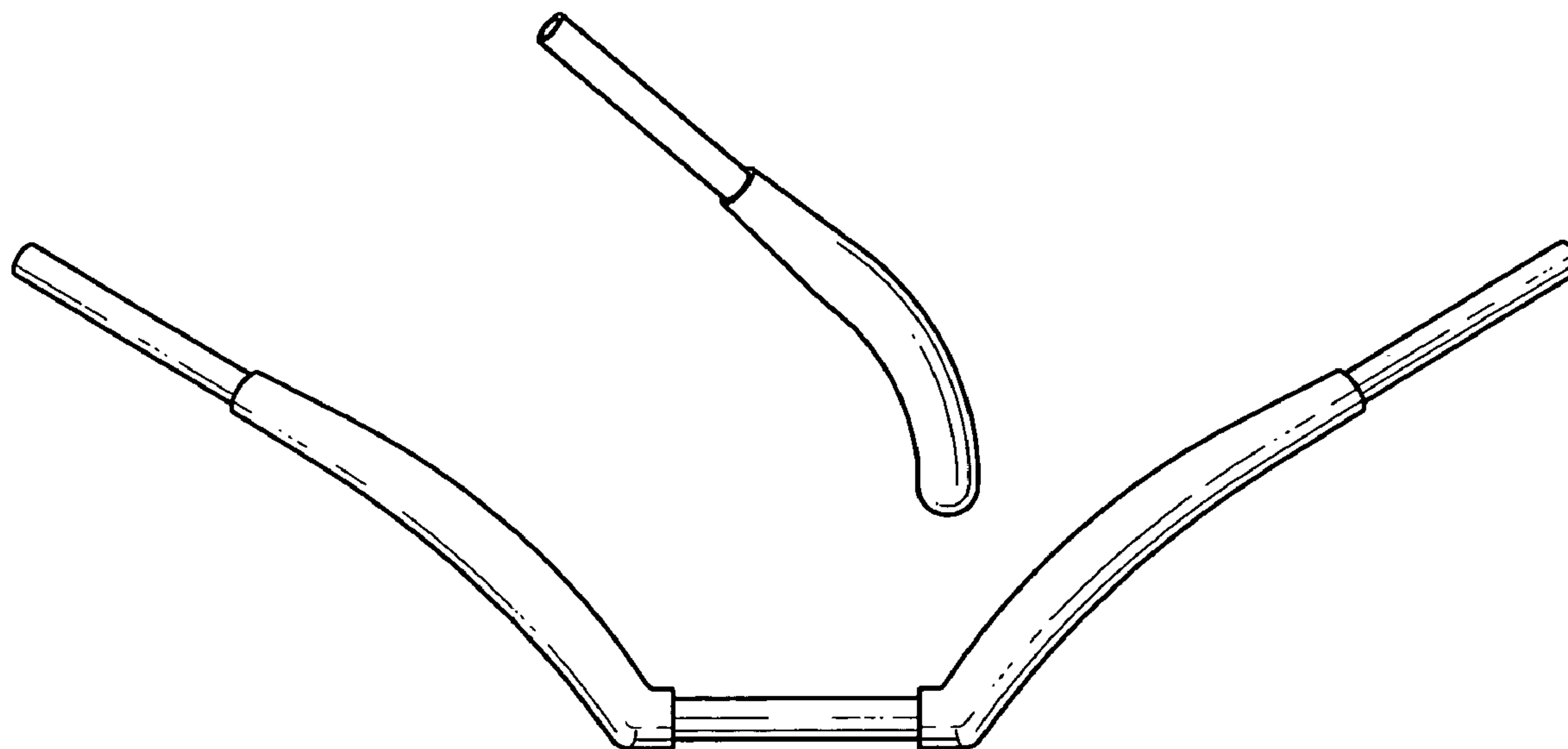
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the handlebar assembly of
FIG. 1;

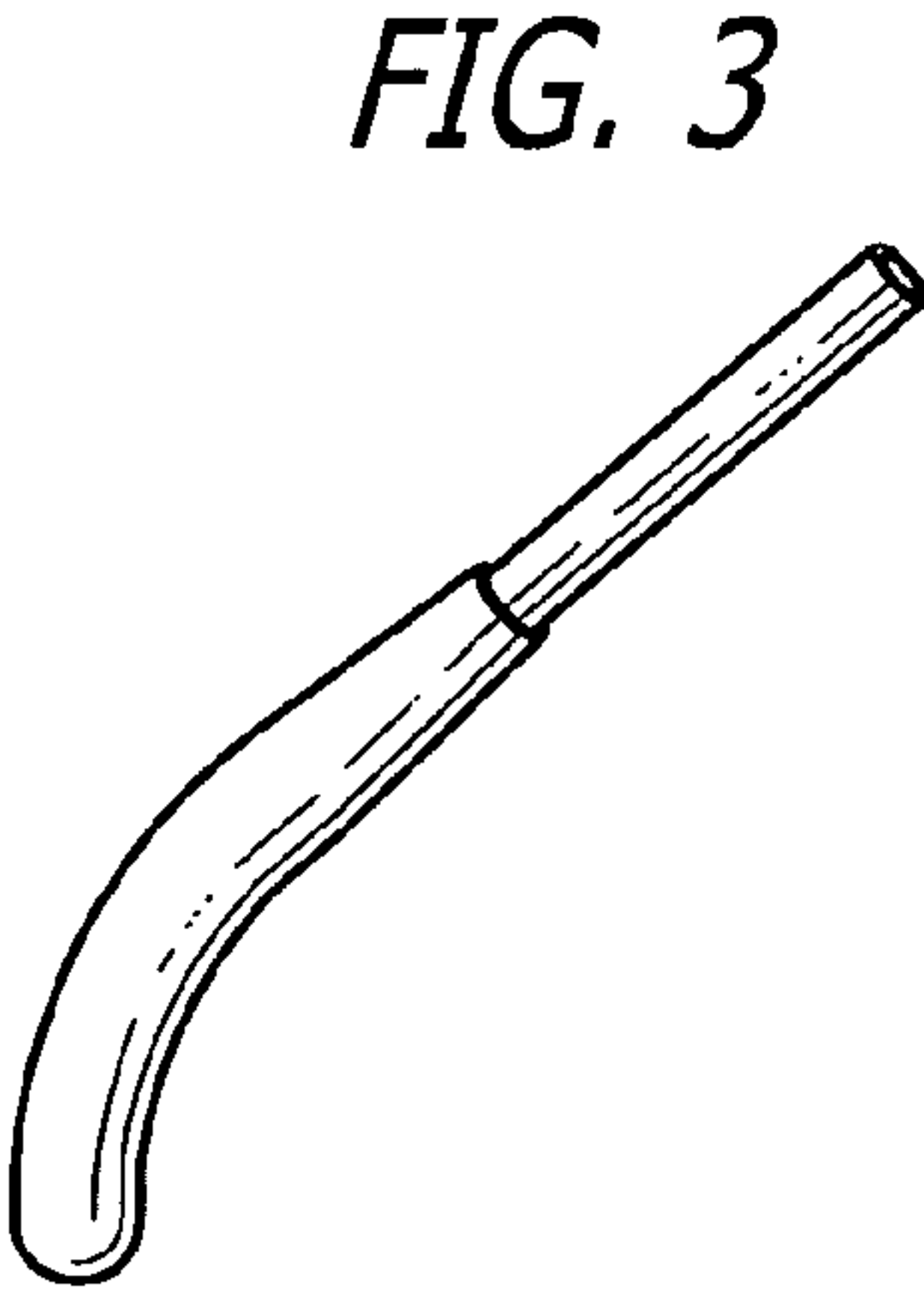
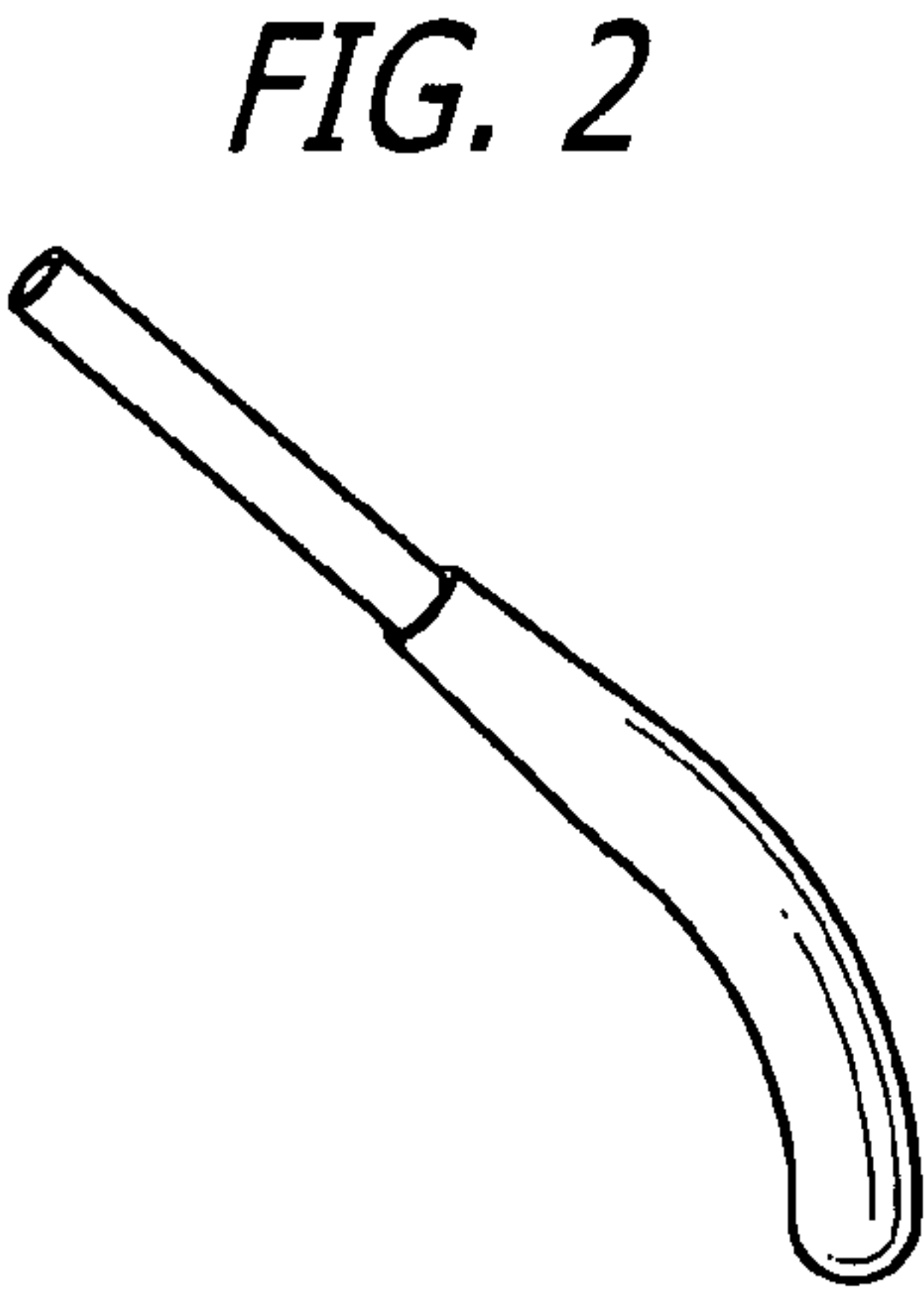
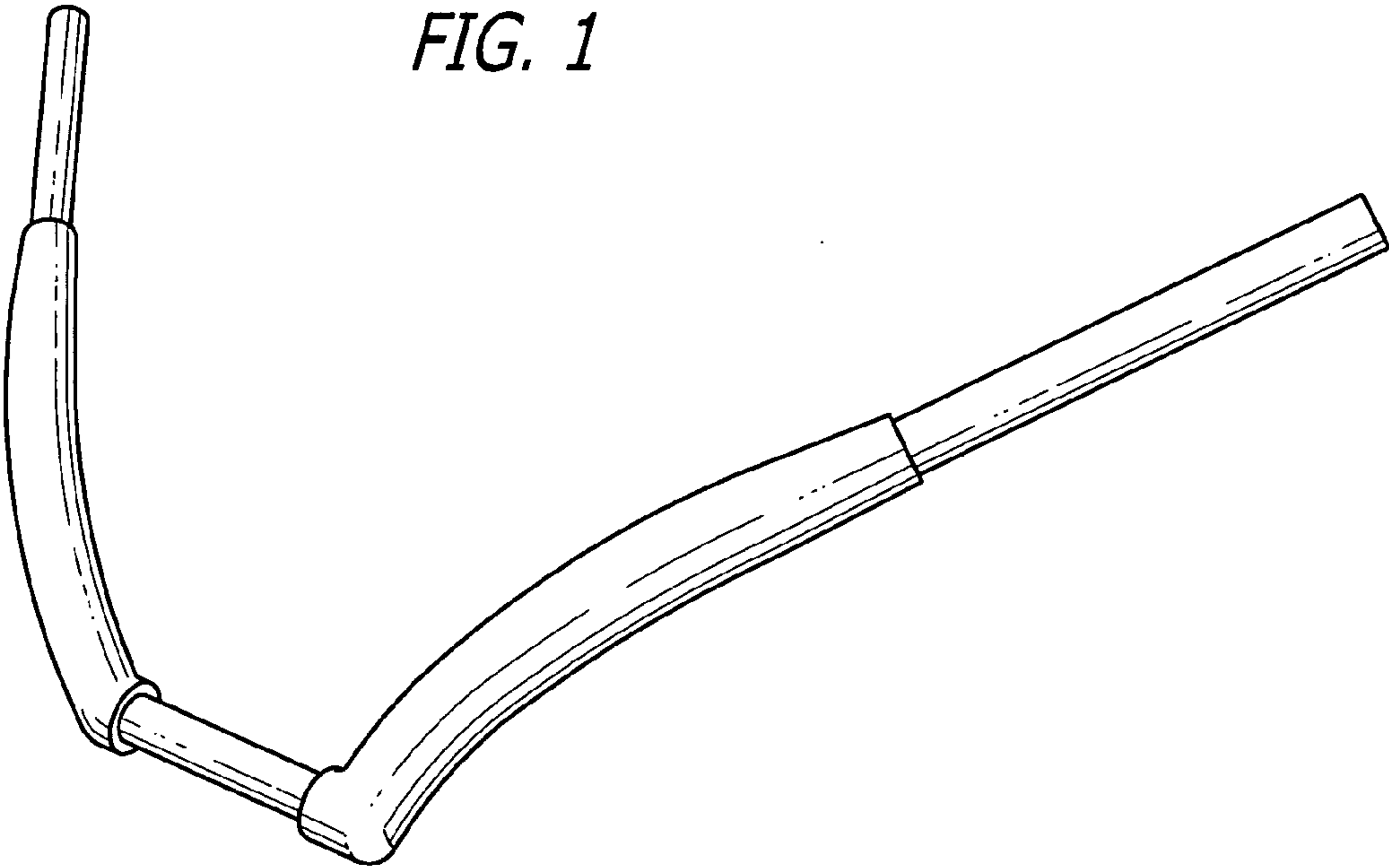
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the handlebar assembly of

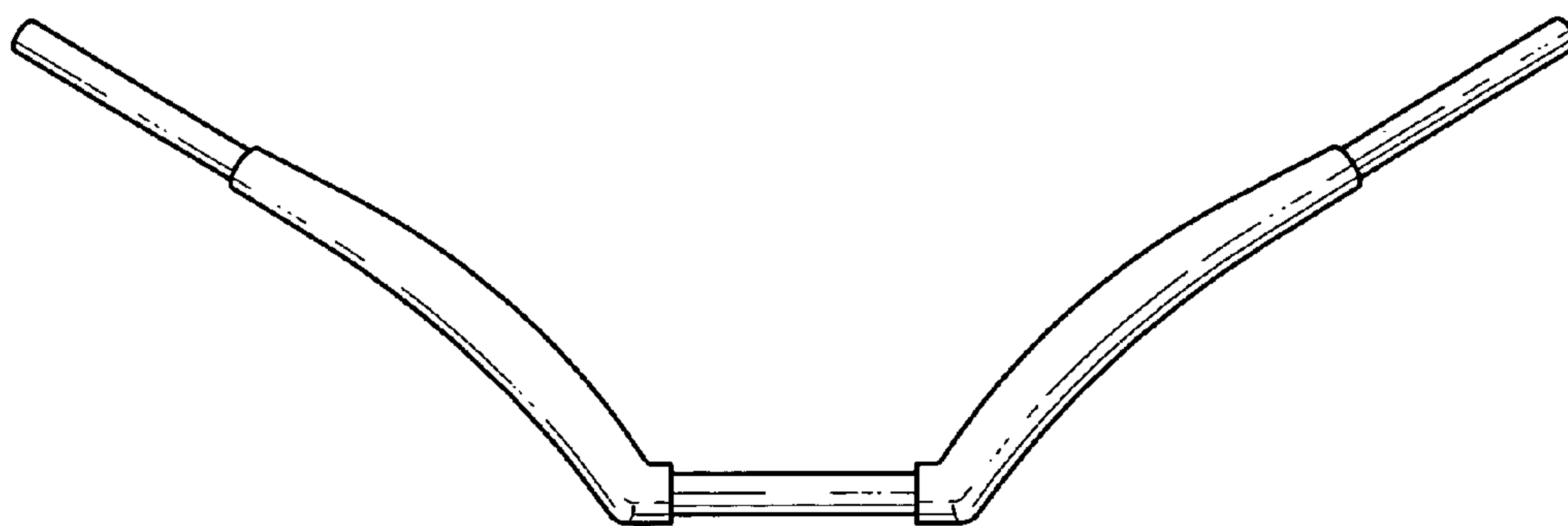

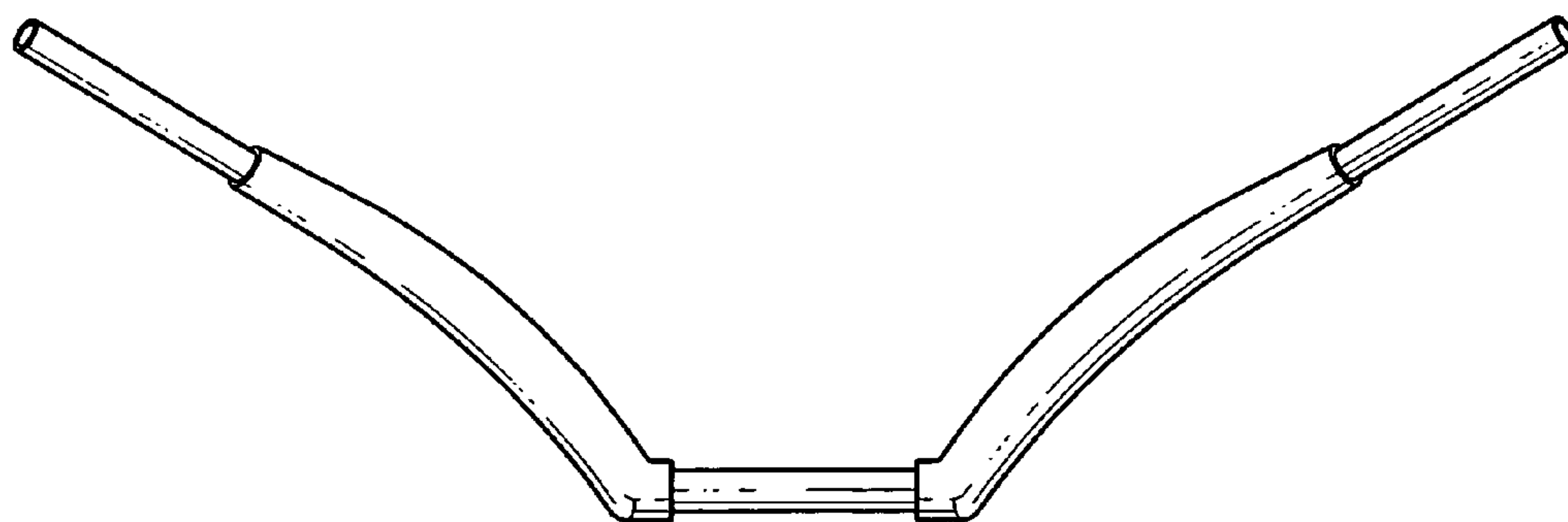

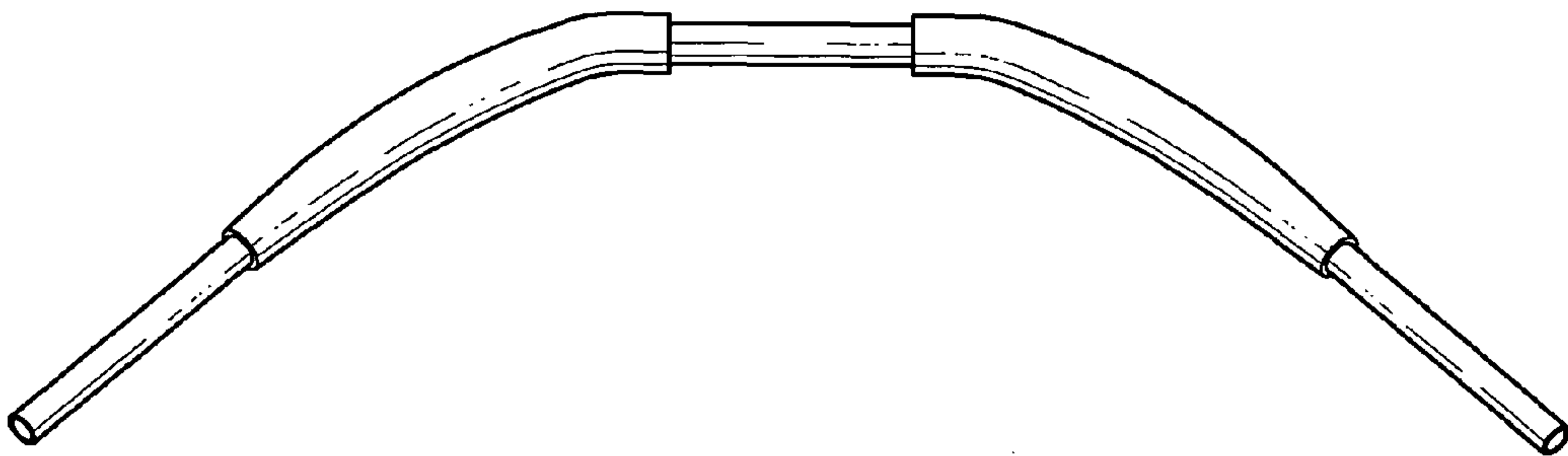

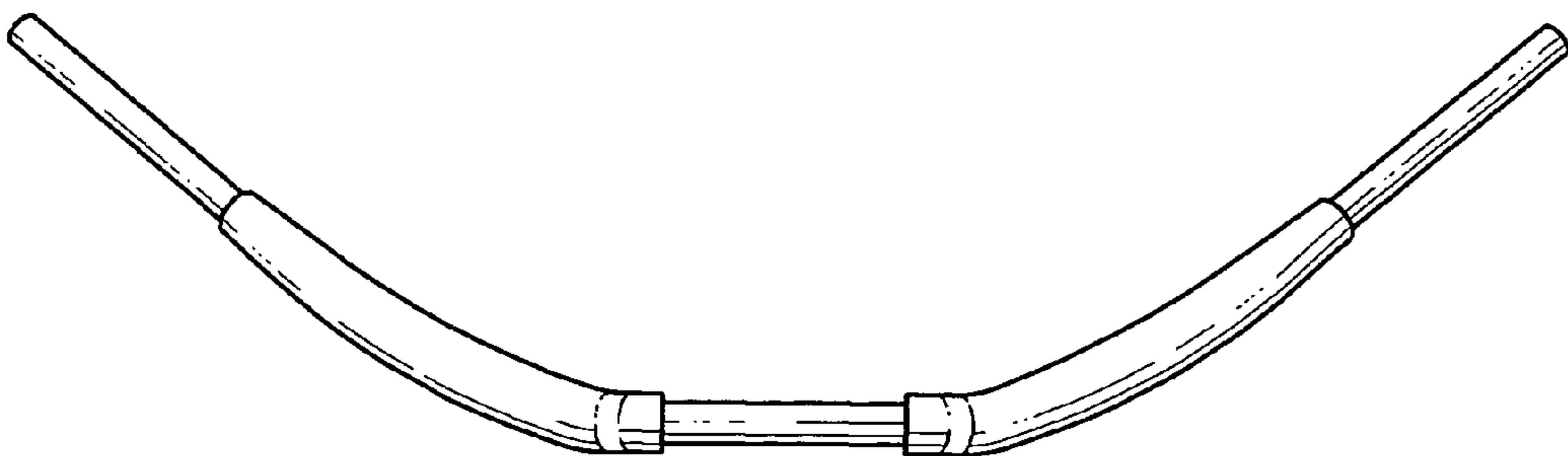
