(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a breast nodule stabilization device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a breast nodule stabilization device, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

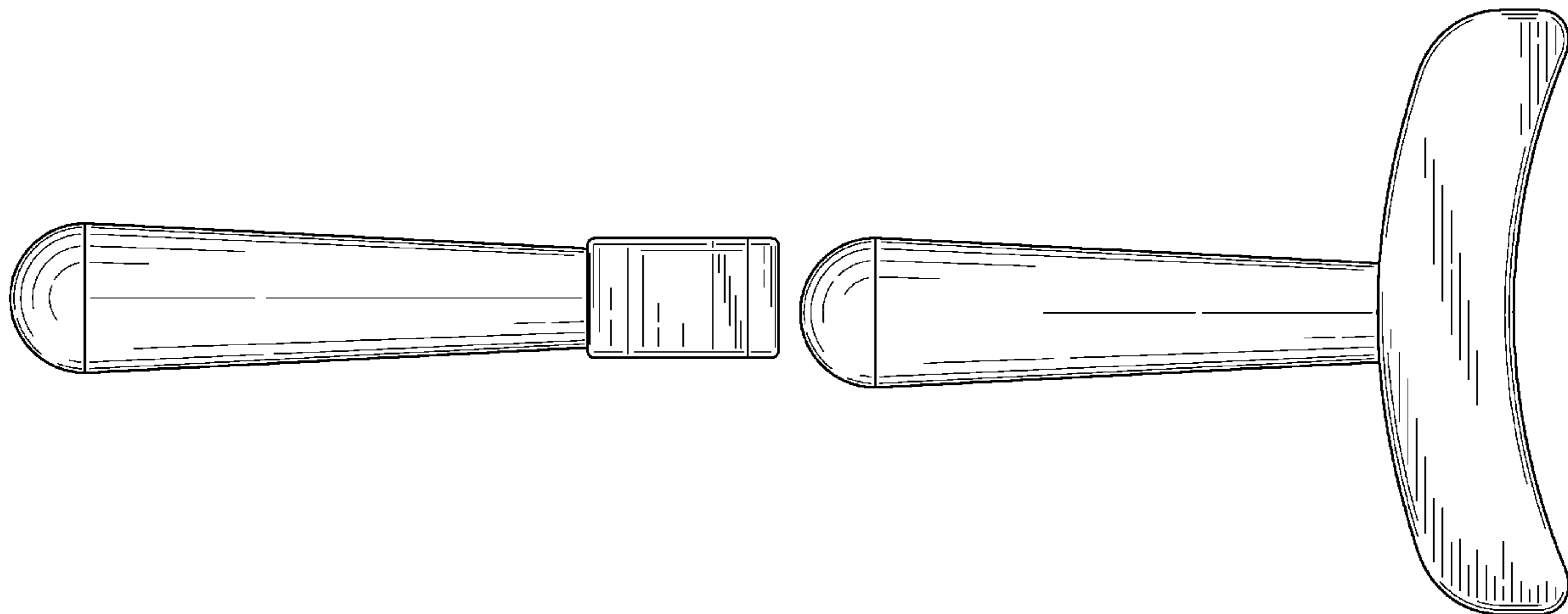
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

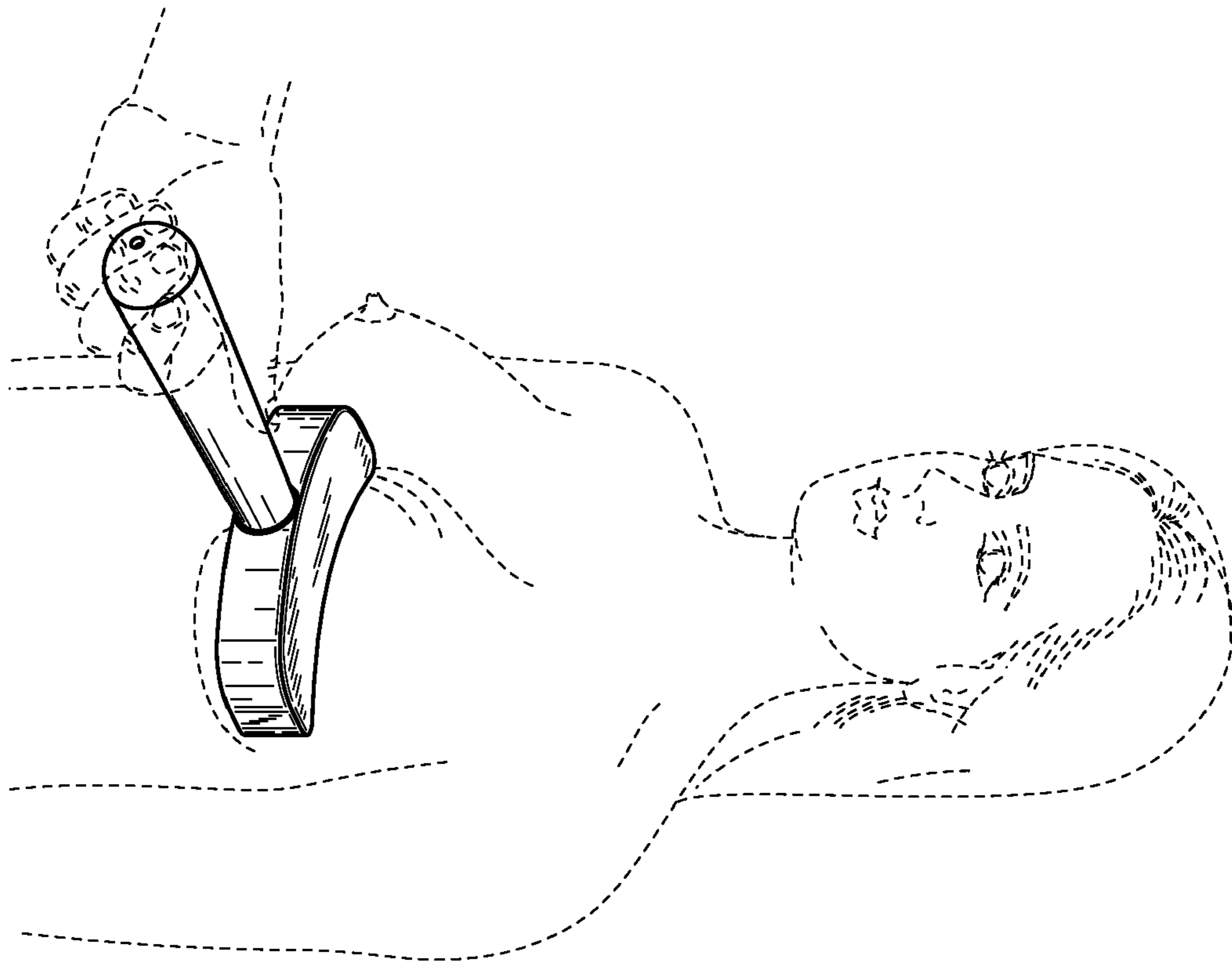

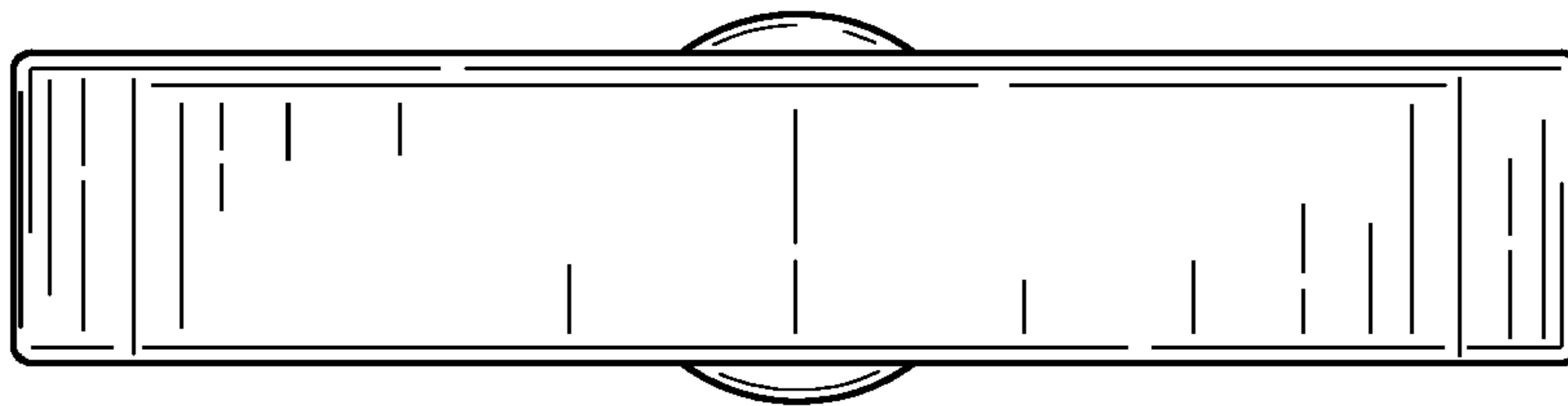

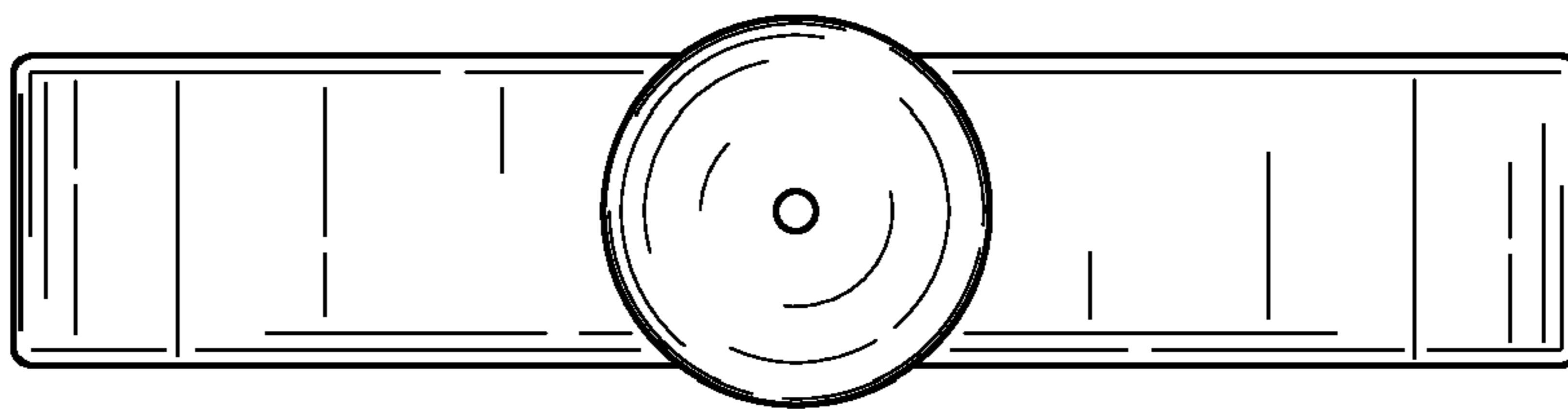

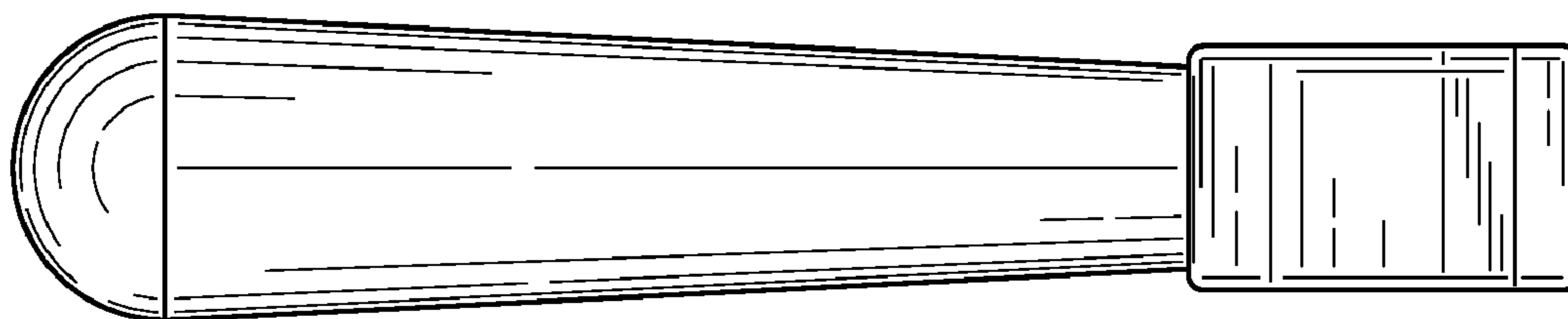

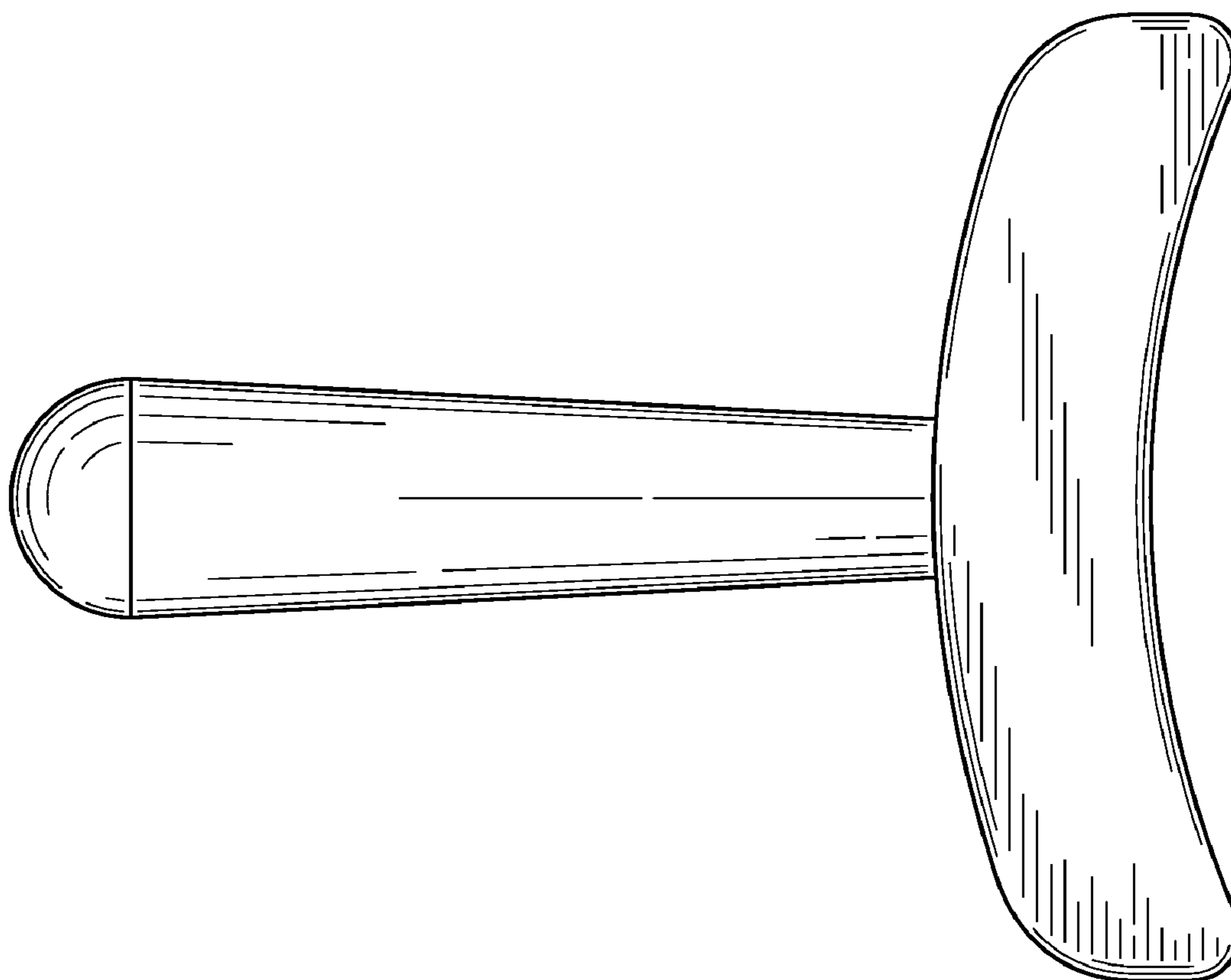
