DESCRIPTION

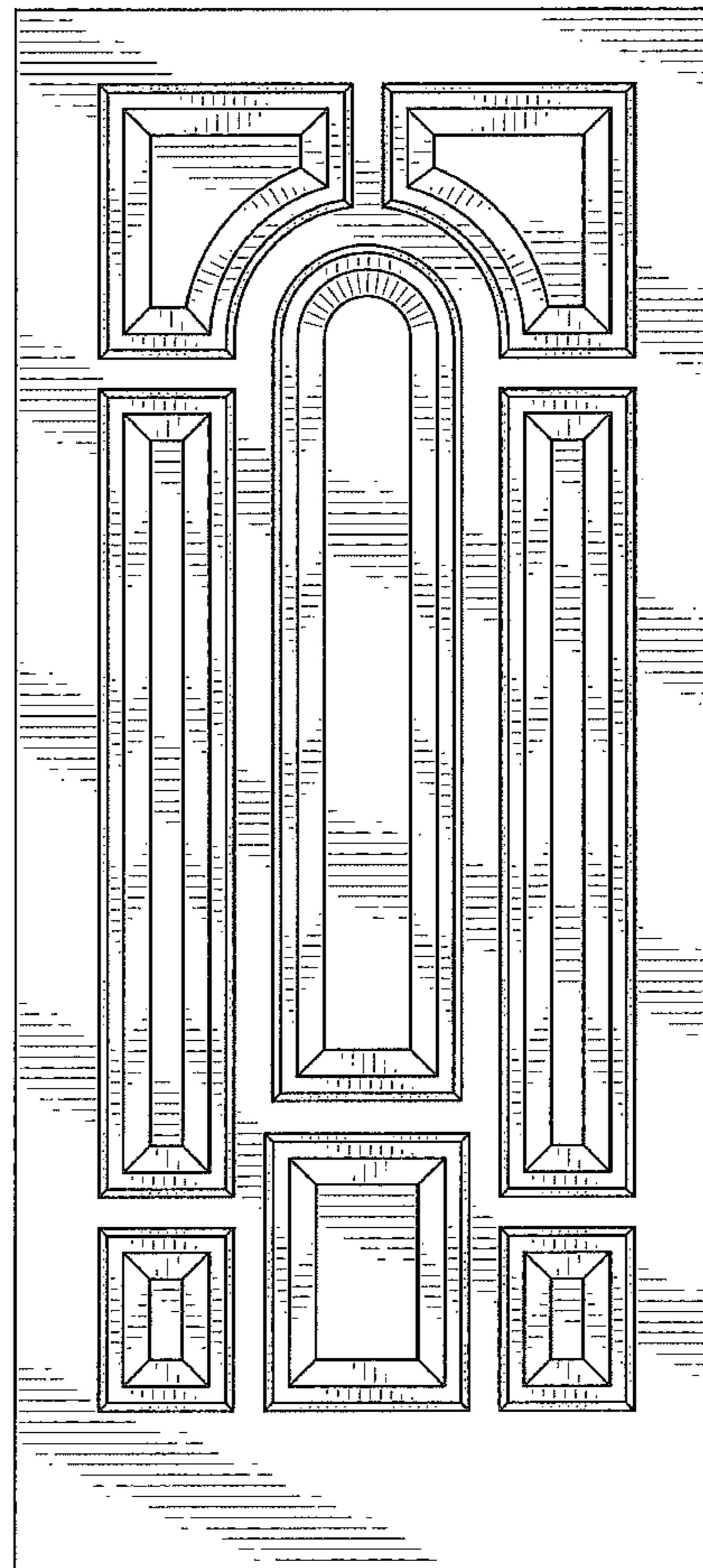
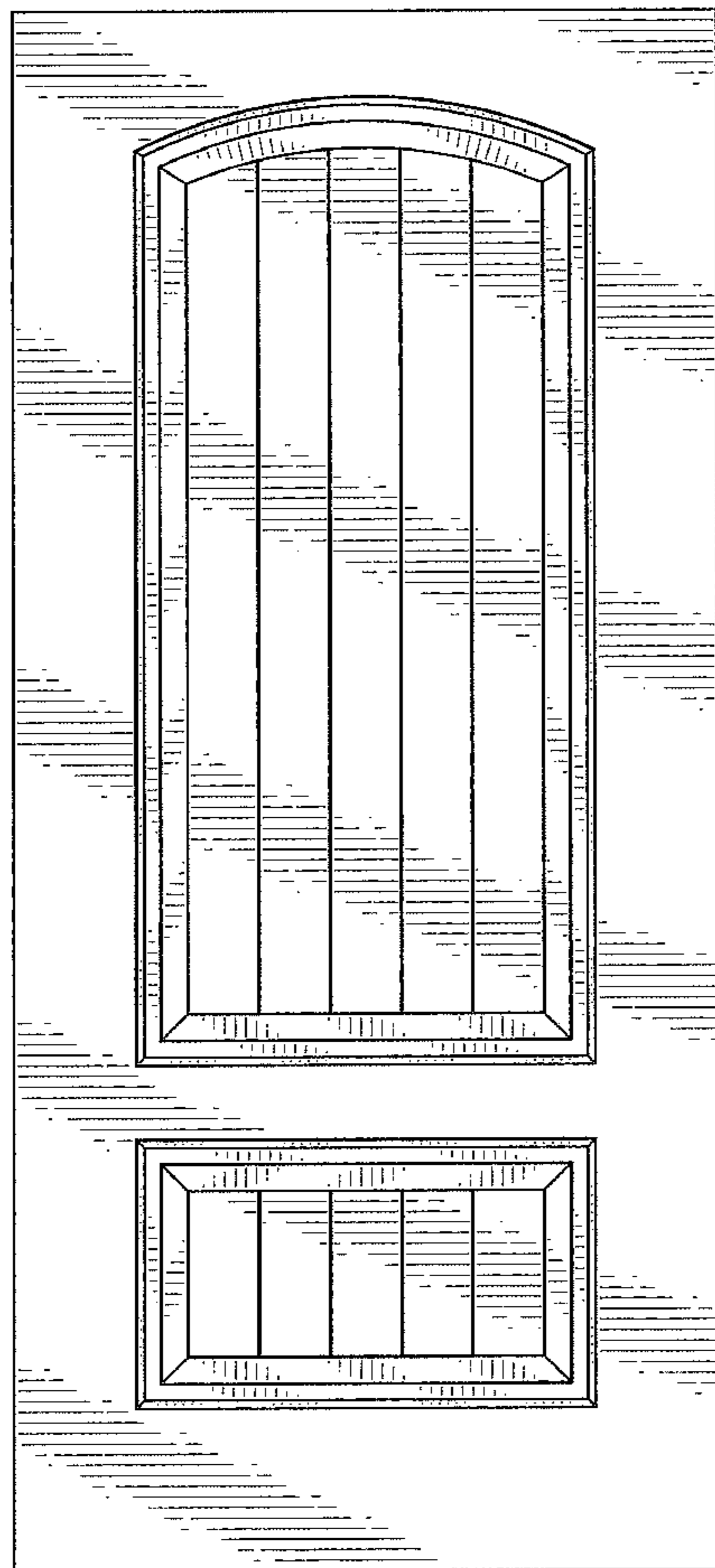
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a door in accordance with the present invention;

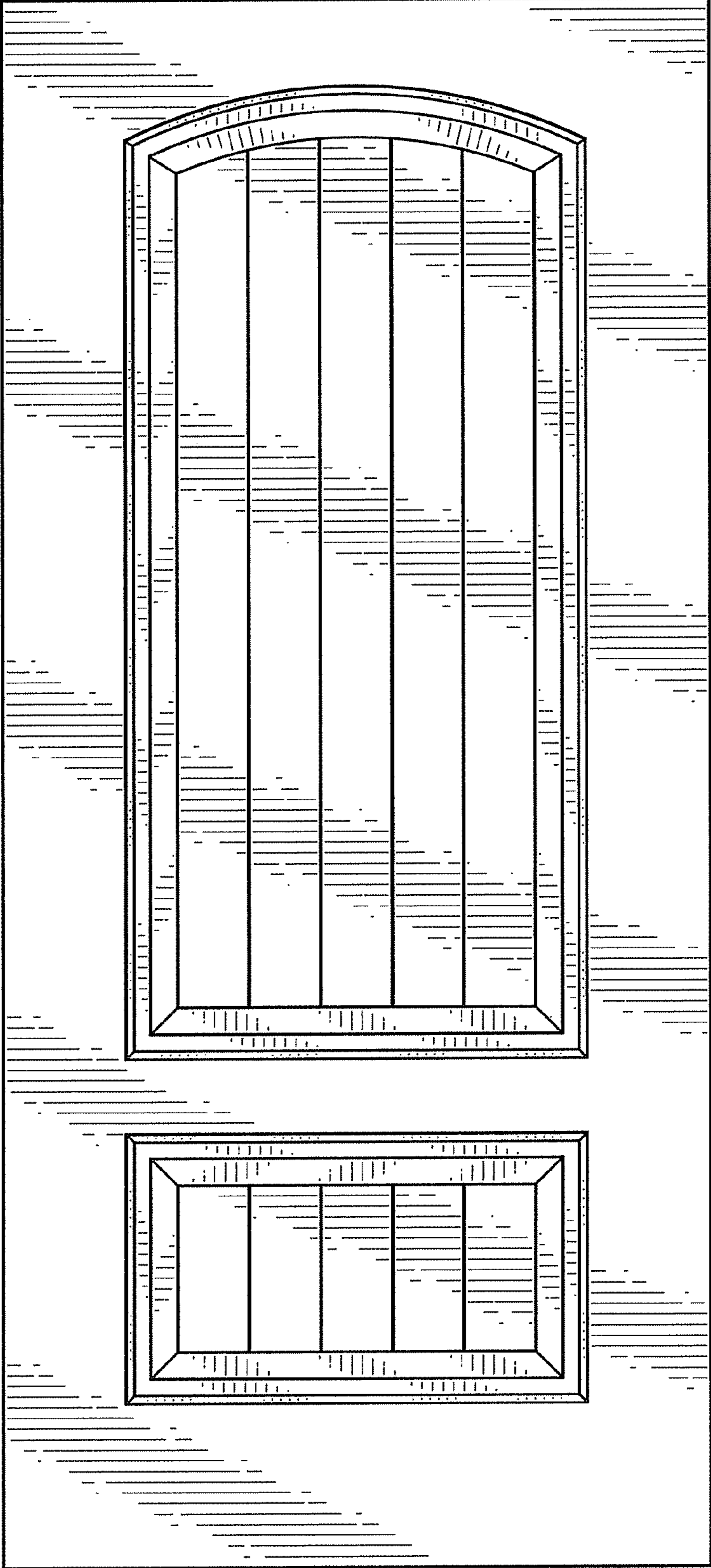

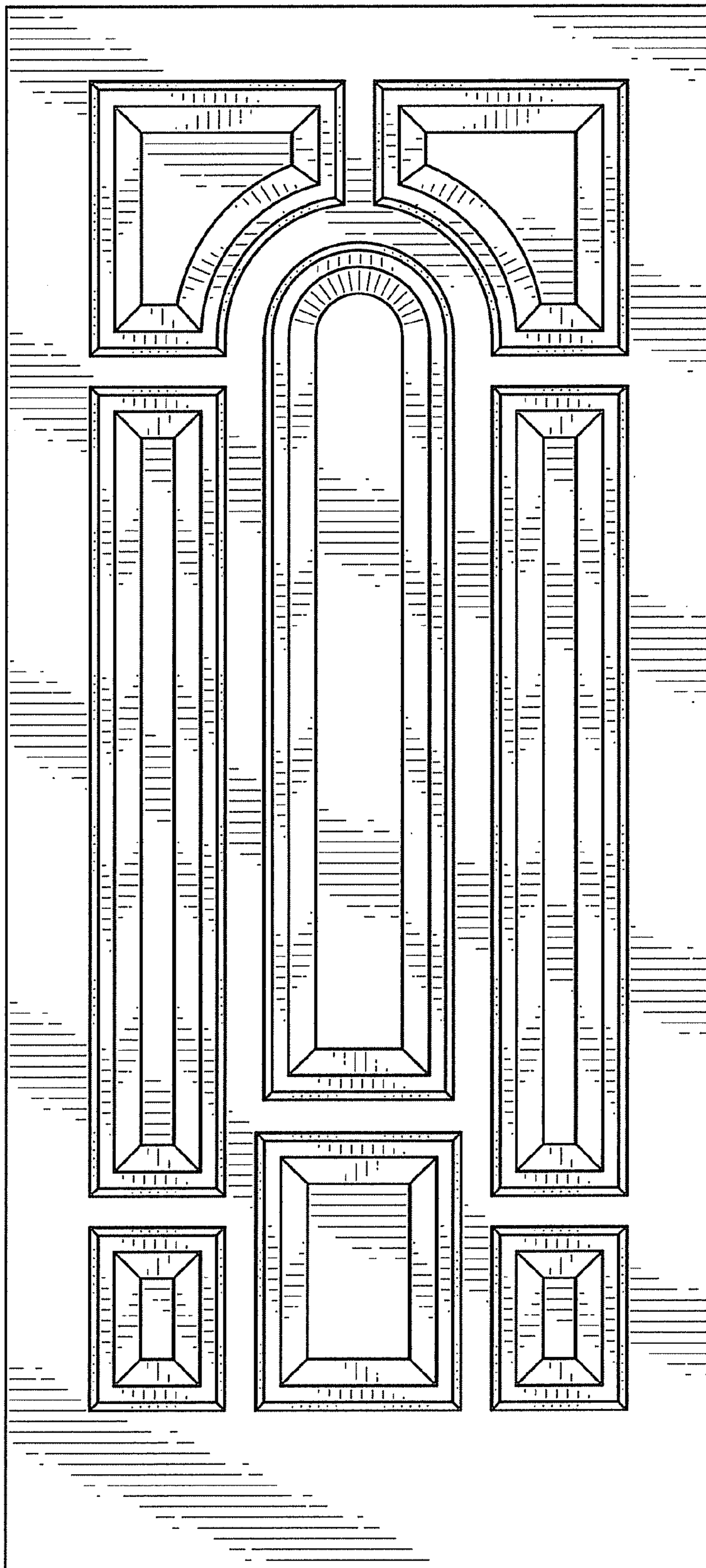

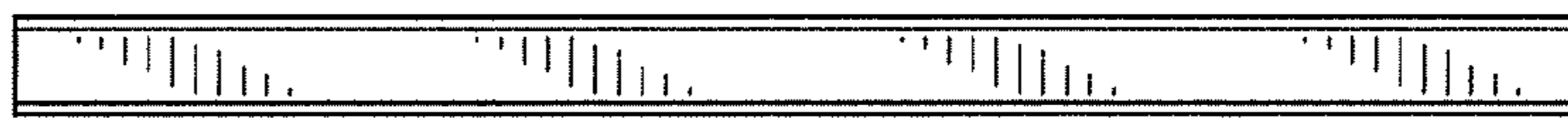
