(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a soldier's prayer and creed decorative memorabilia item, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a soldier's prayer and creed decorative memorabilia item showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof, the broken lines form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 3 is an alternate rear view;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view is a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view is a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a soldier's prayer and creed decorative memorabilia item showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof, the broken lines form no part of the claimed design;

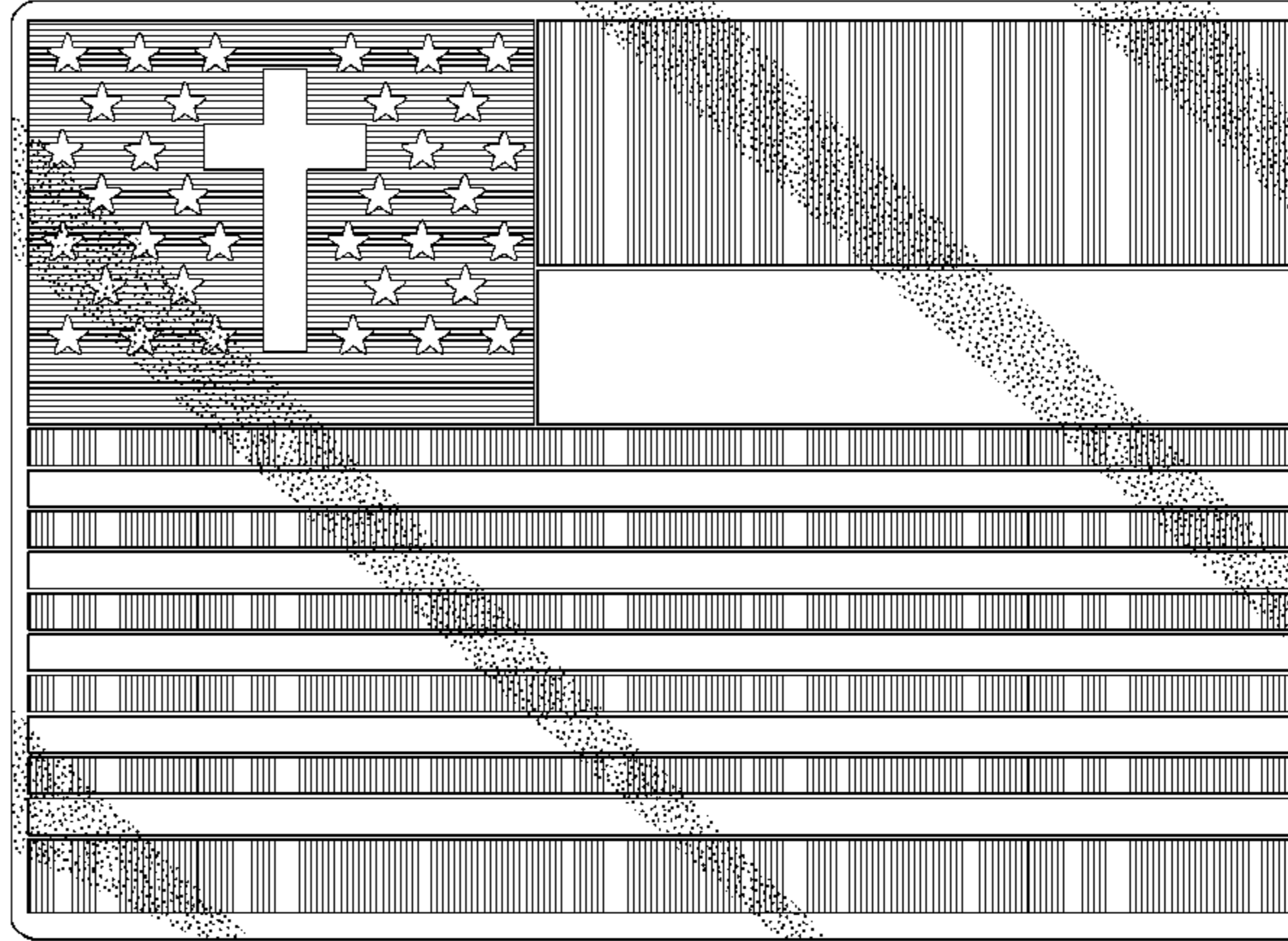
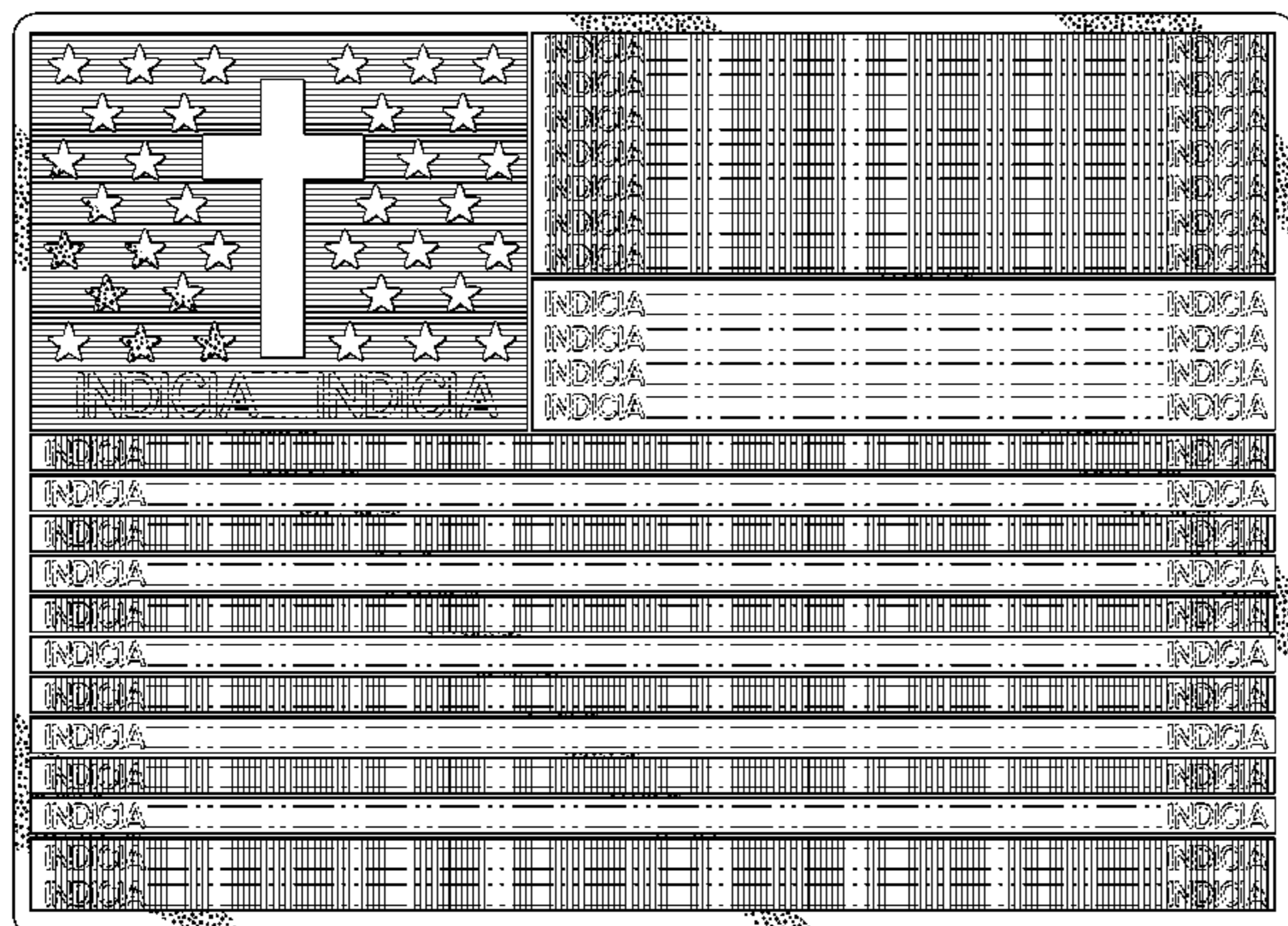
FIG. 8 is an alternate rear view.

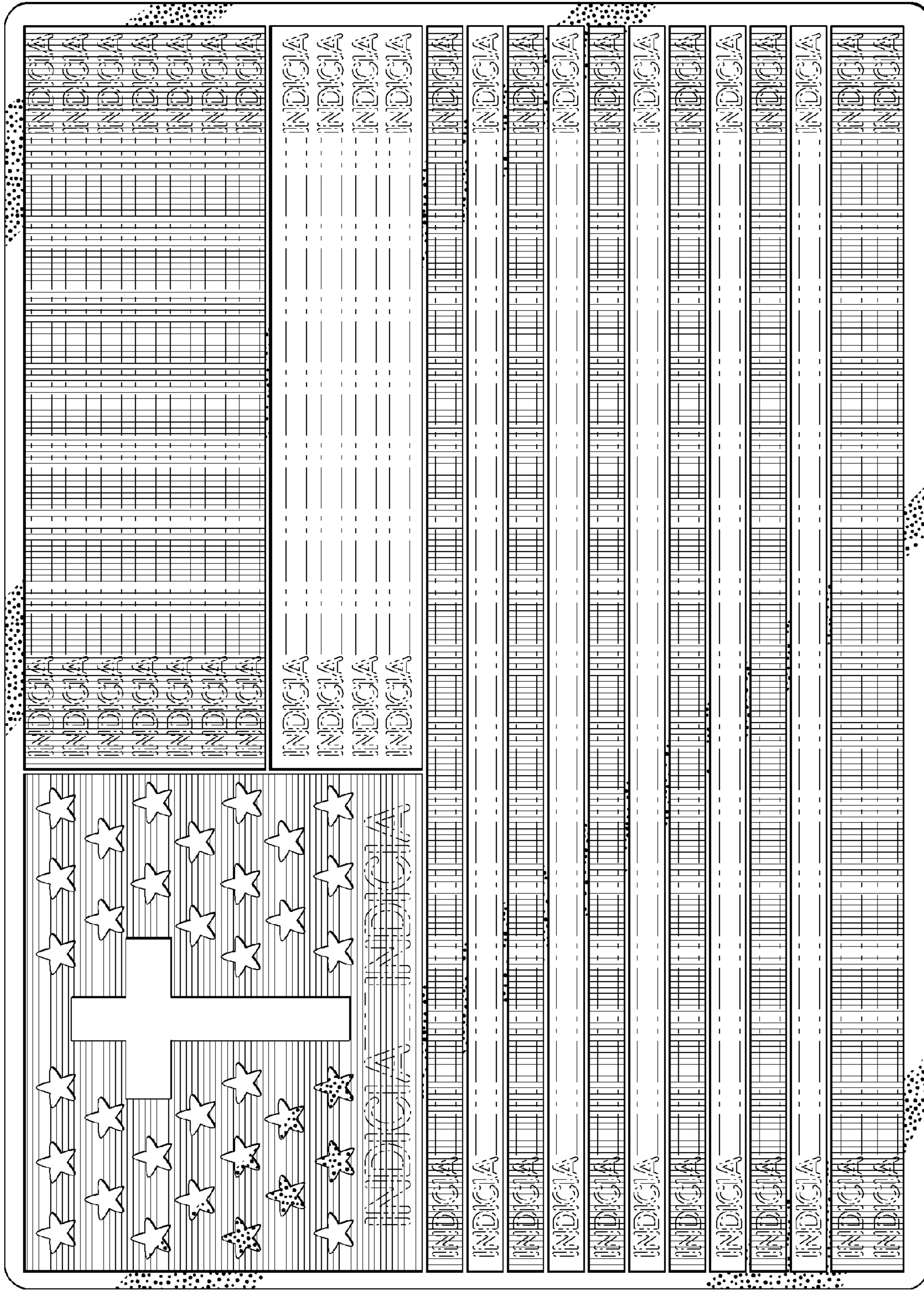

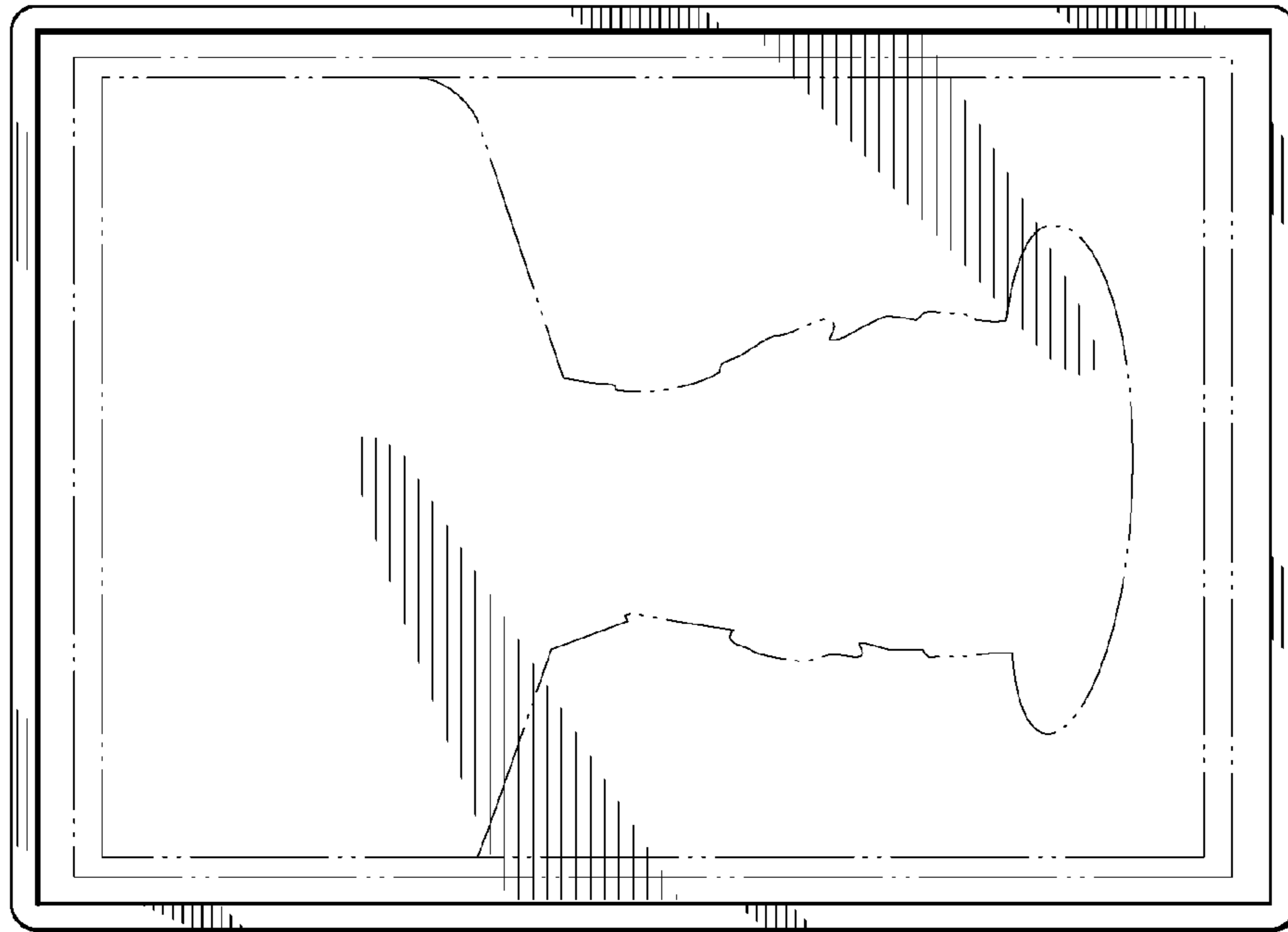

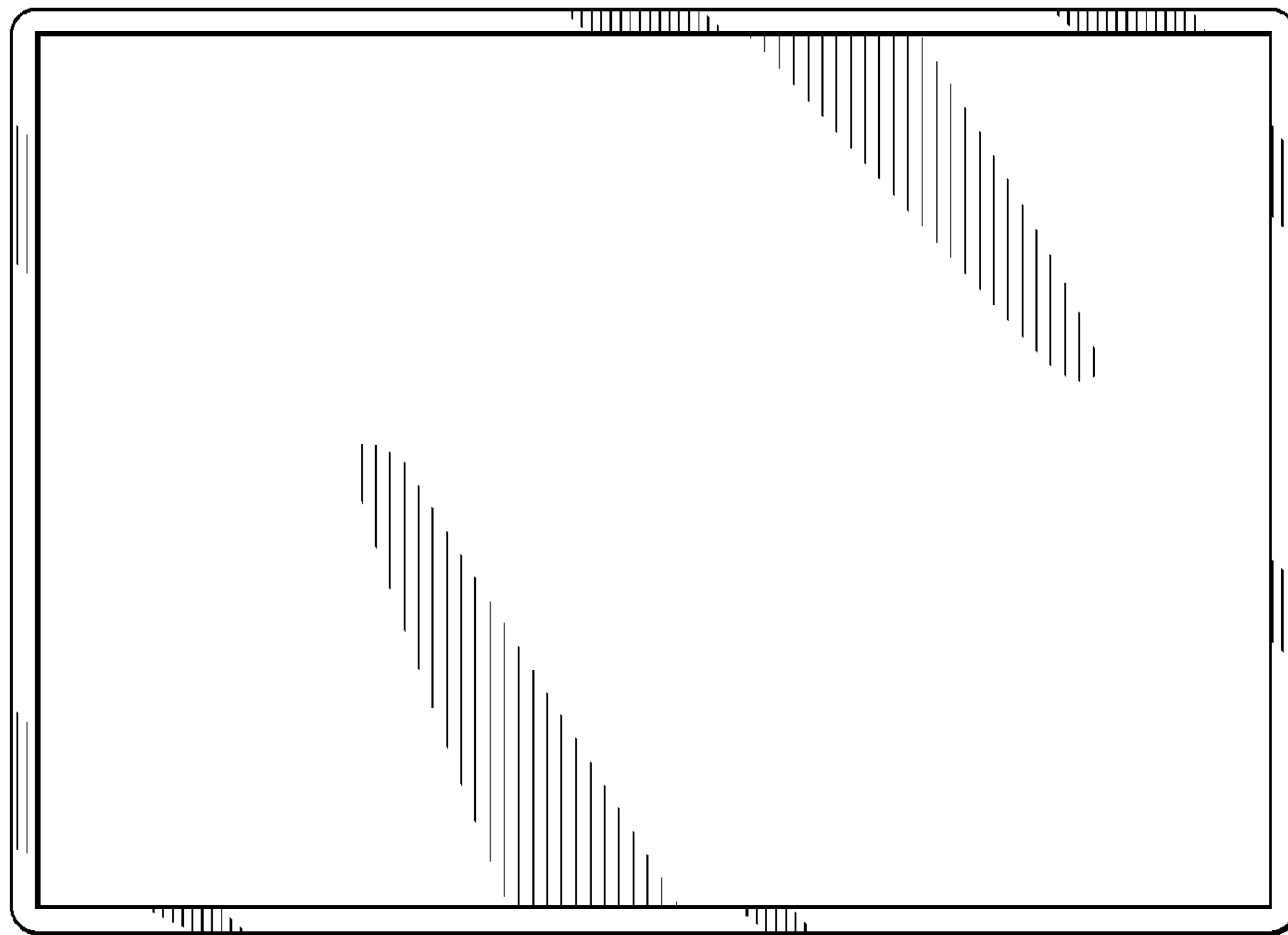

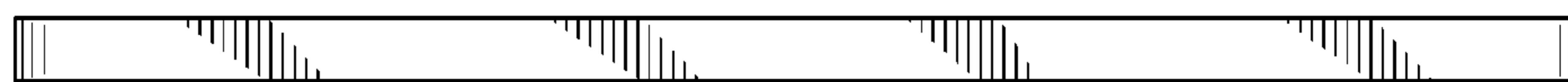

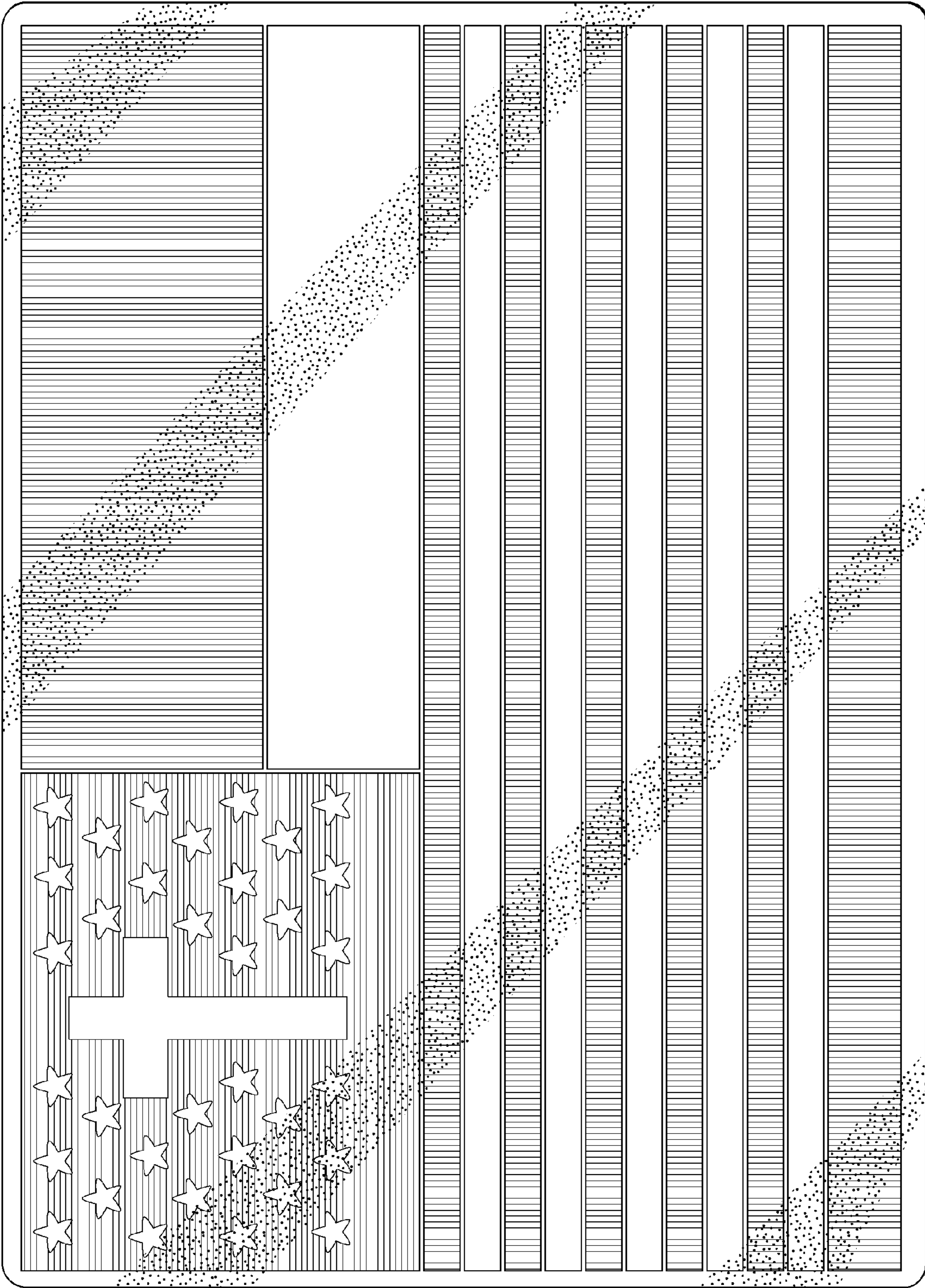

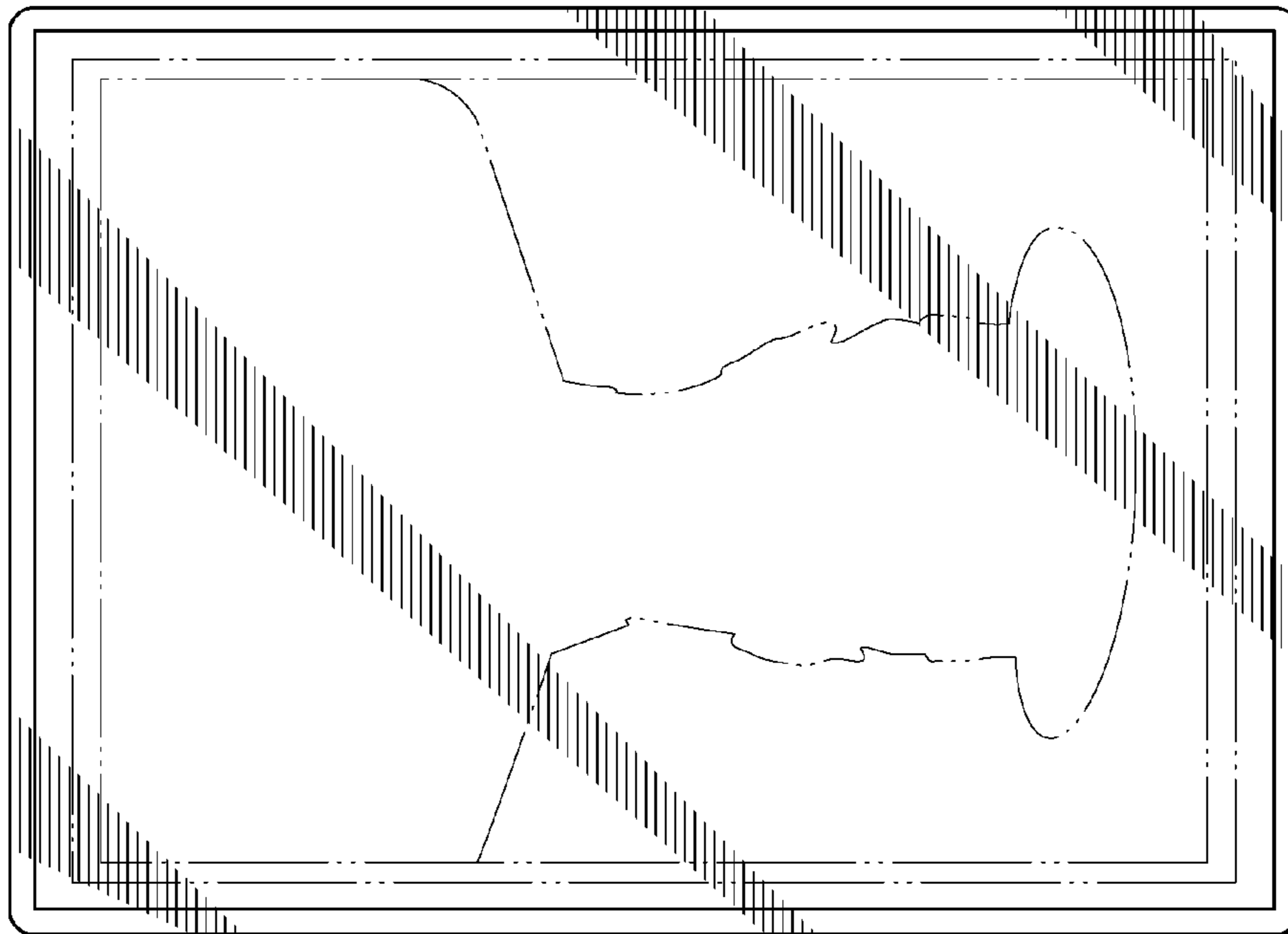

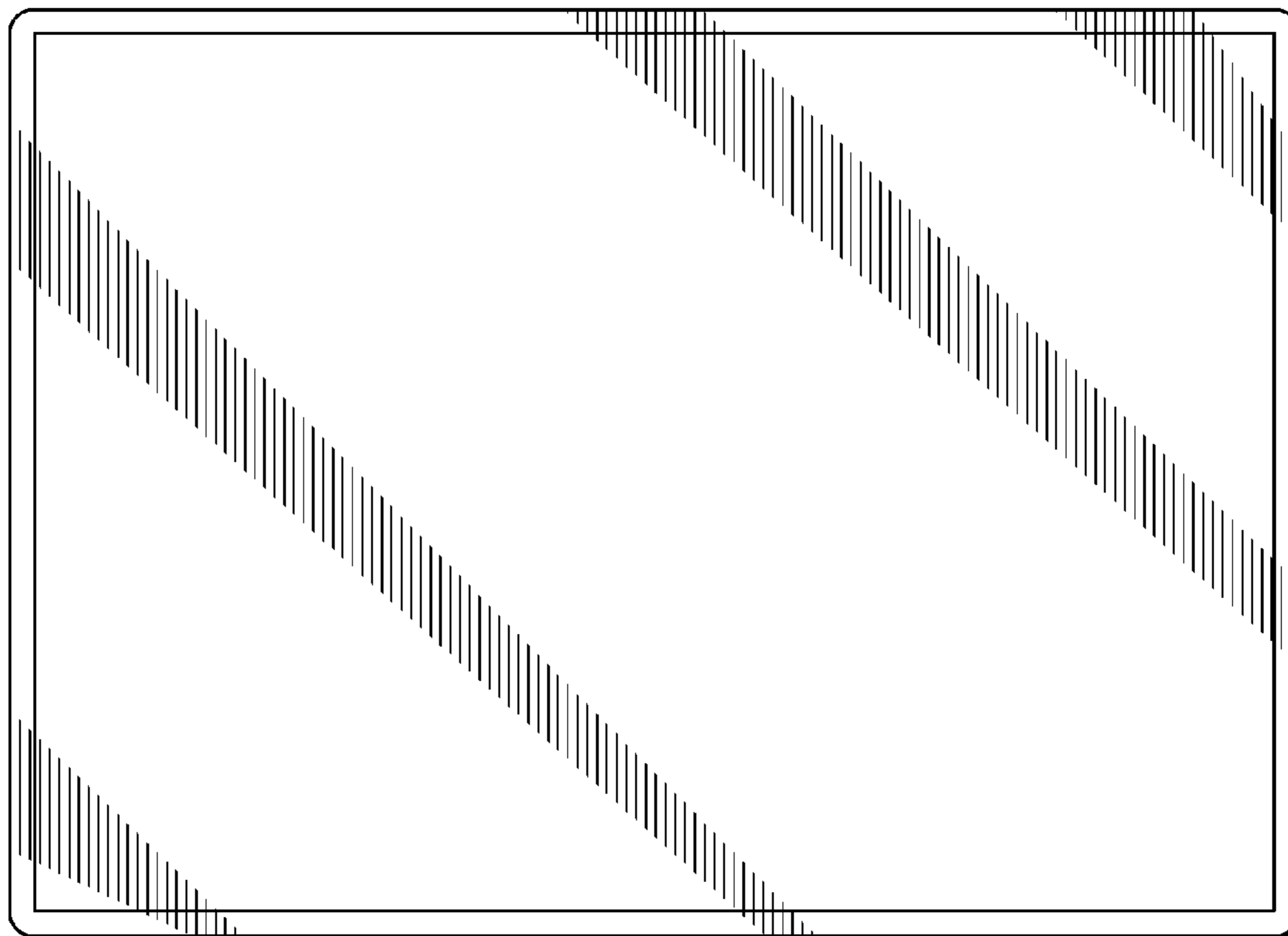

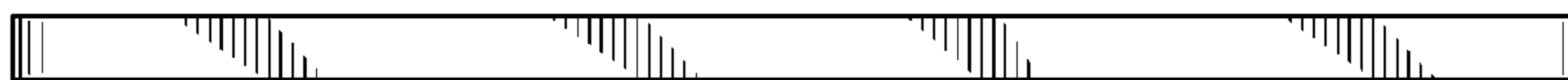
