FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, shown in the closed condition;

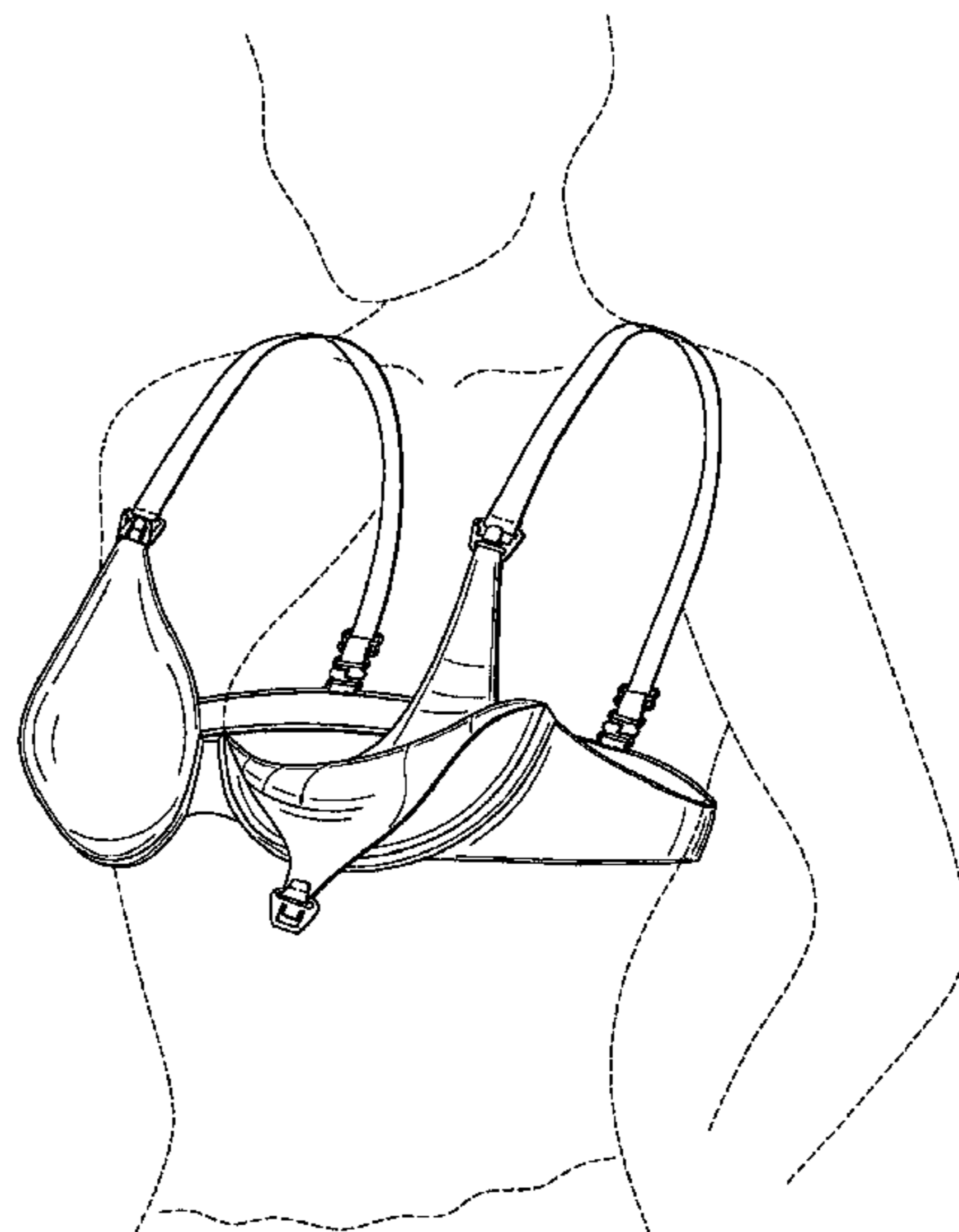
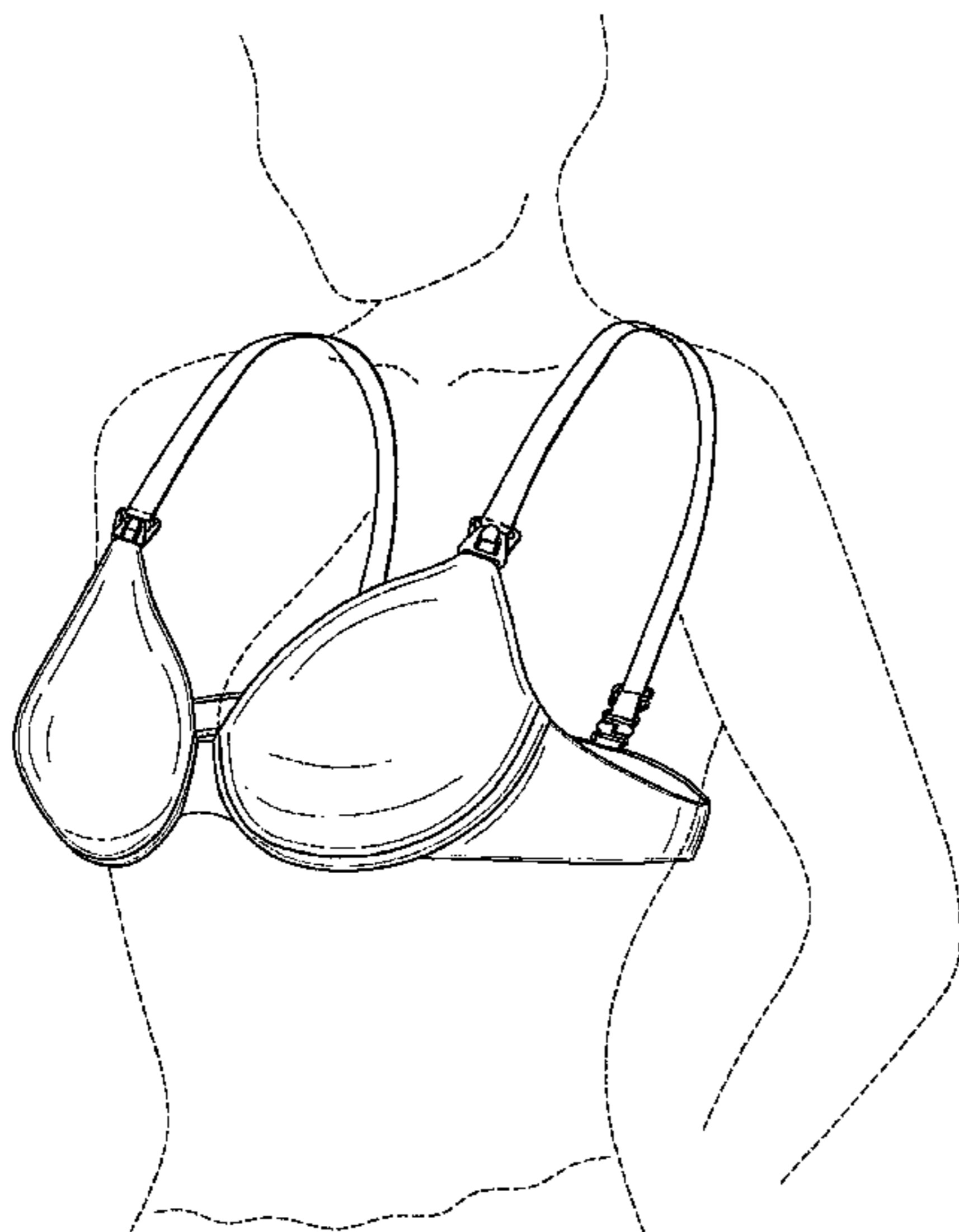
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof;

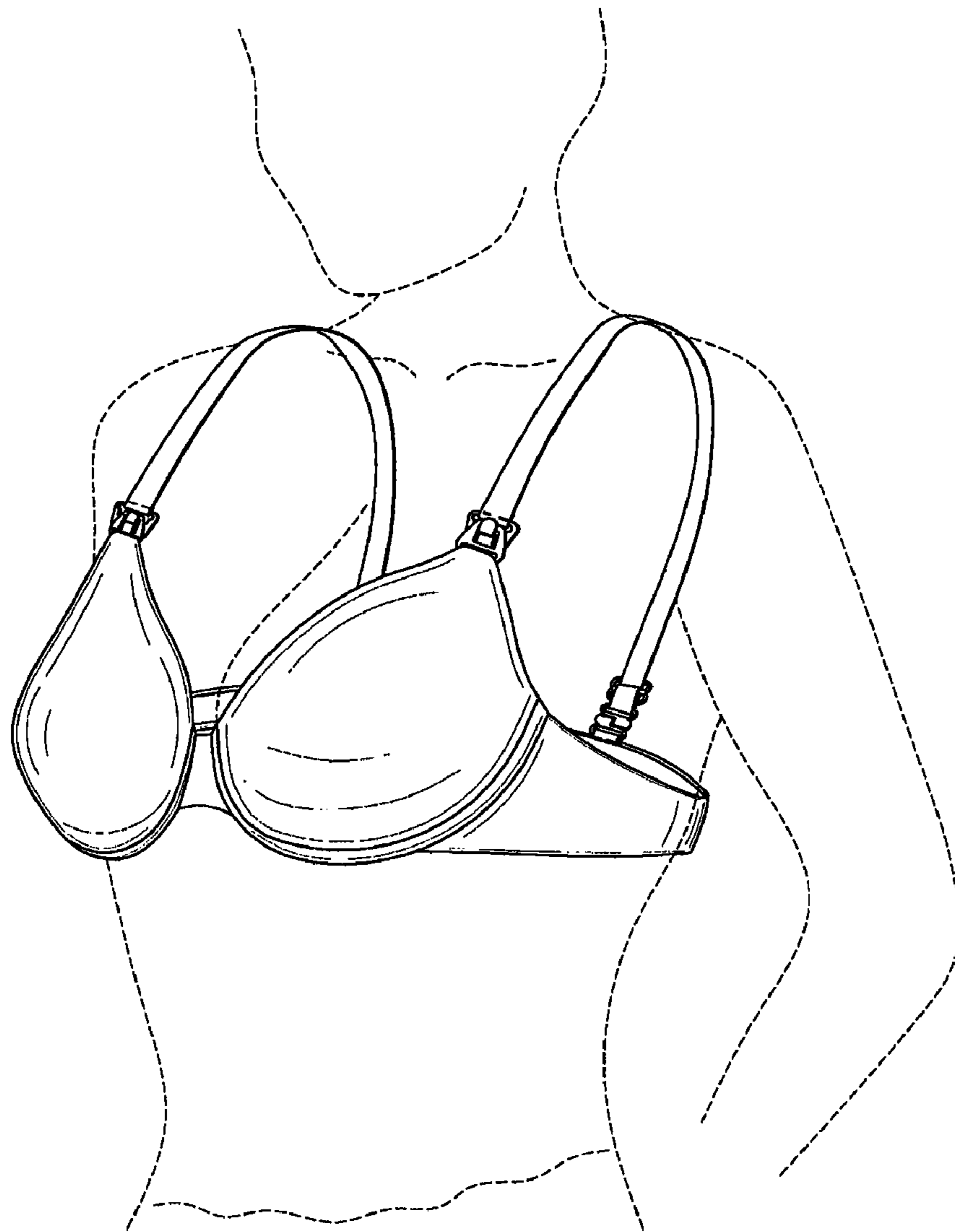

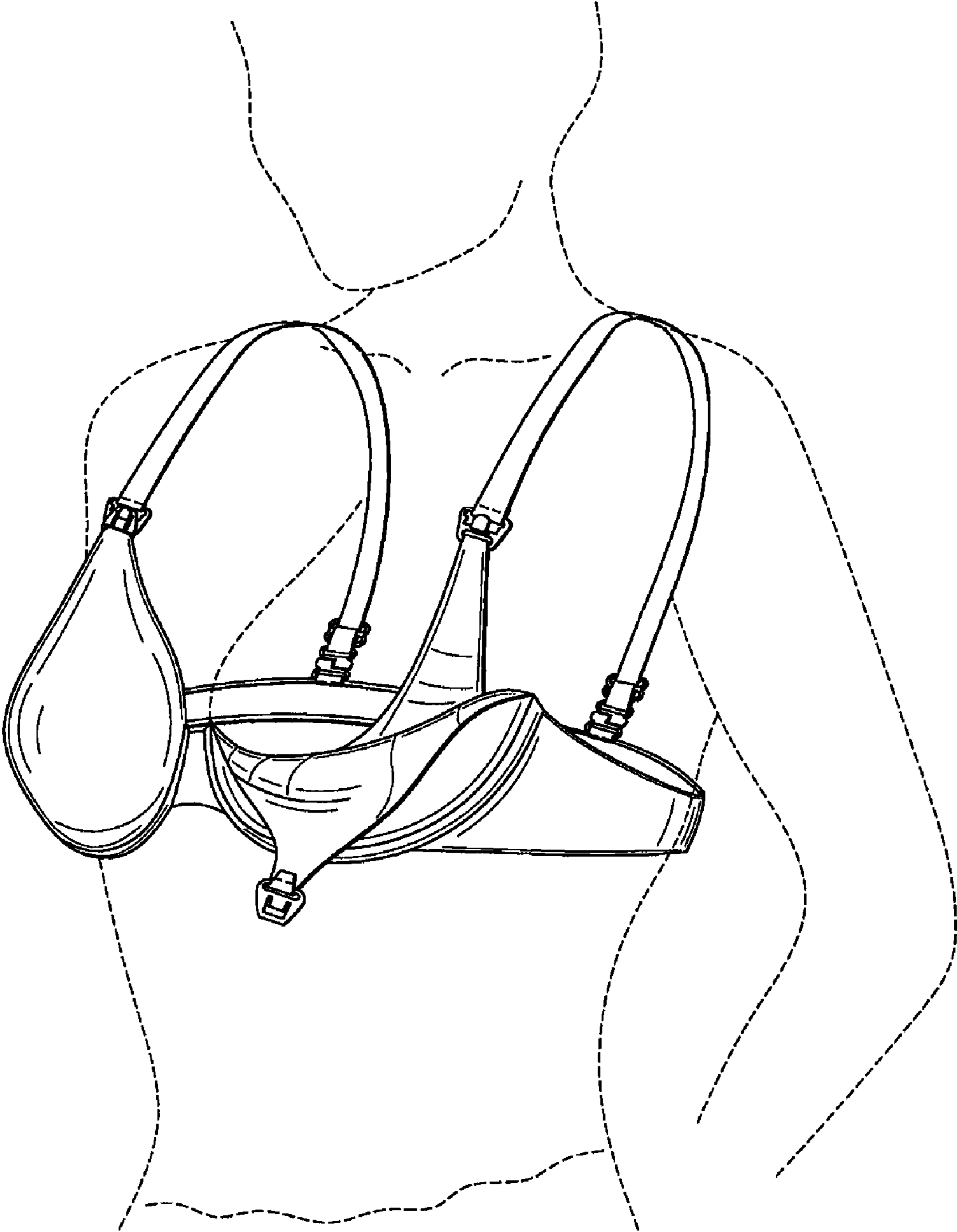

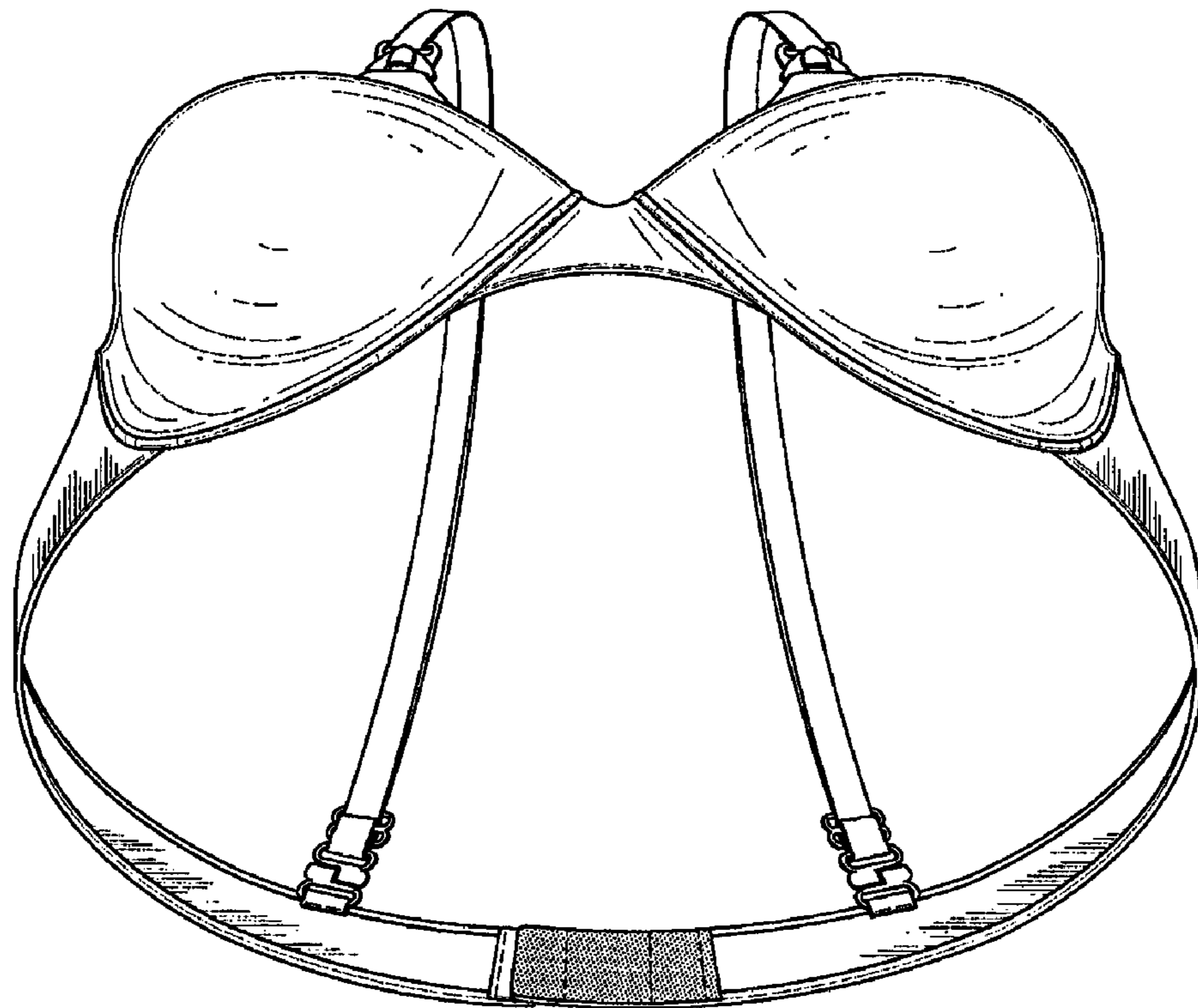

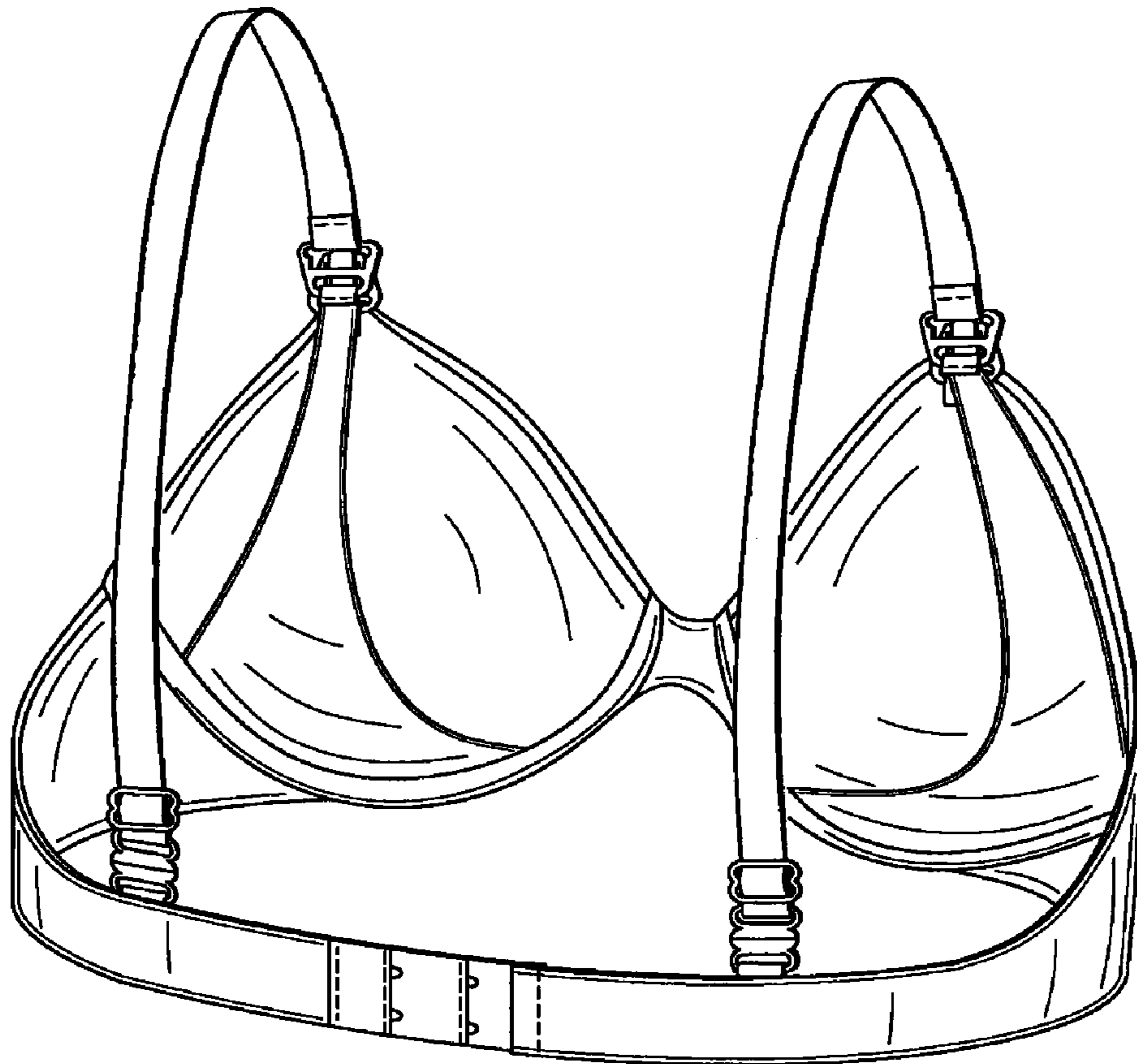

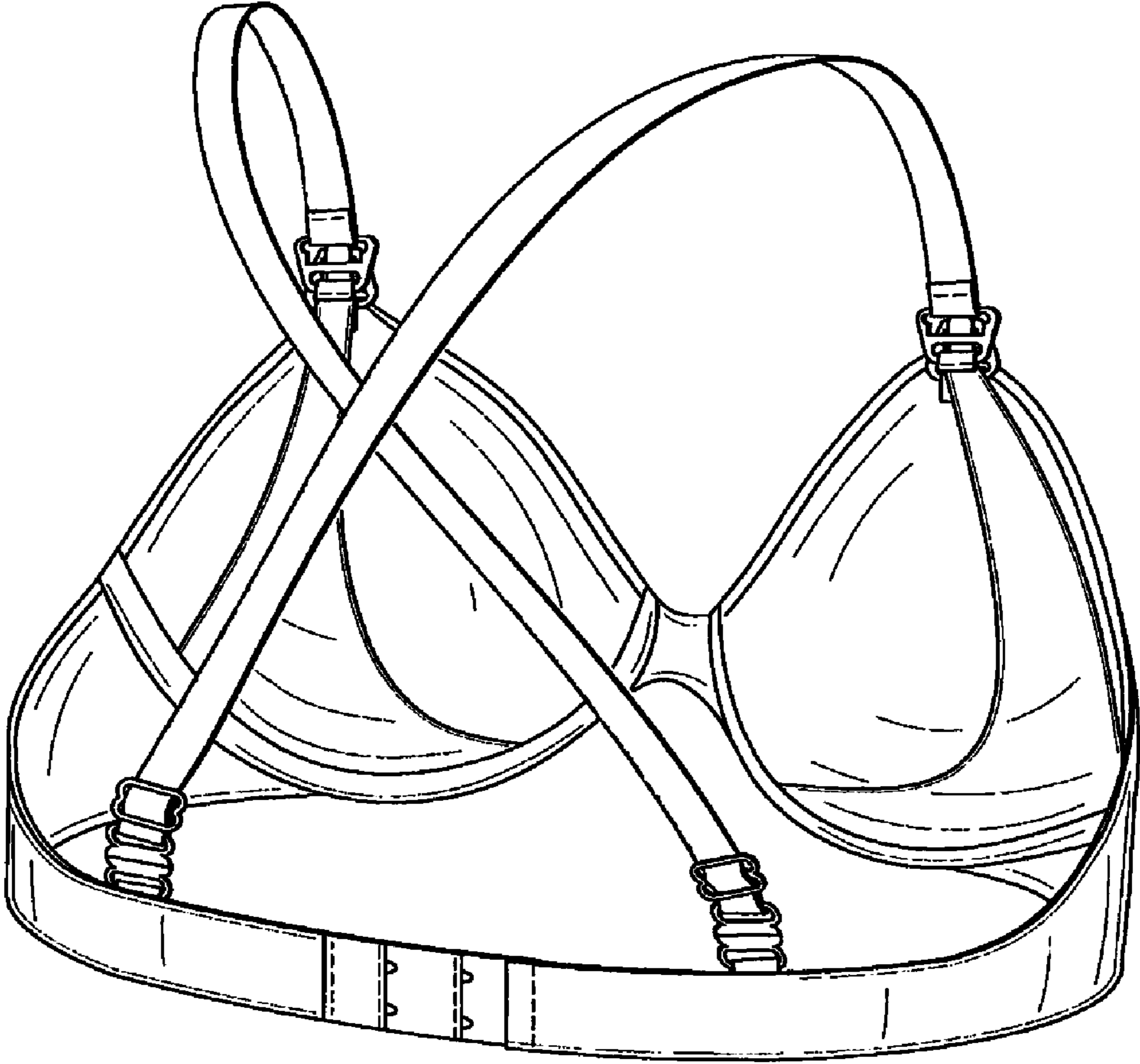

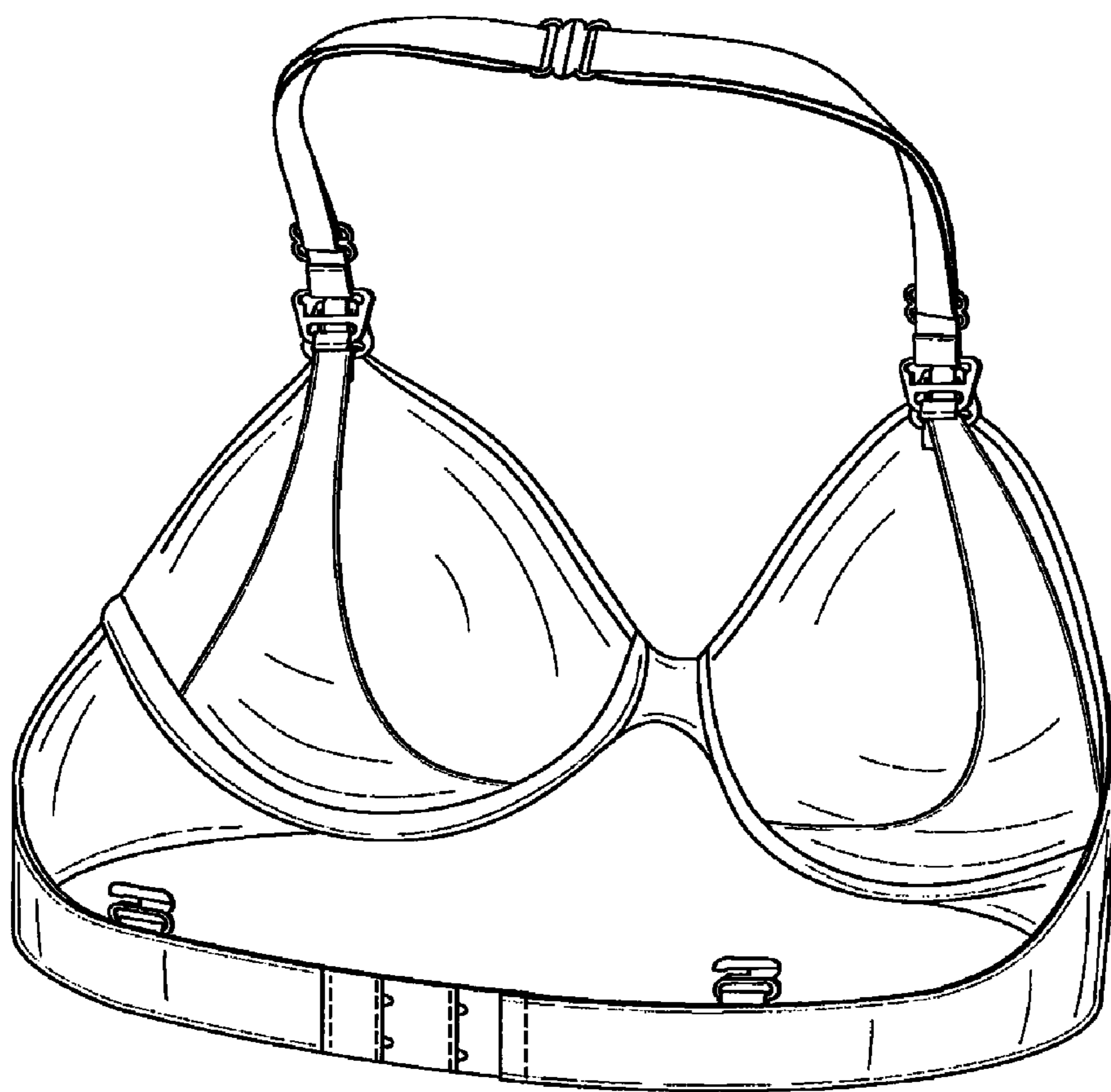
